5th Row—Work thread up to 3rd d. c., ch. 5 in 9th d. c., 1 sl. st., \*ch. 5, 1 sl. st., ch. 3, 1 sl. st. in next l.\*, rep. twice, ch. 5 to 3rd d. c.

6th Row—Same as 4th r.

7th Row—Same as 5th r., ch. 6 instead of 5 over 11 d. c.

d. c. Sth Row—11 d. c. over 6 chs., 1 sl. st. in next l., ch. 6 over every l., 1 sl. st., 11 d. c.







2nd Row—1 s. m., add 1 d. c., 1 o. m. over same, ch. 7 going back to last d. c. of s. m., in., 5 sl. st., 2 p., 5 sl. st. in this l., 1 s. m., add 1 d. c., 1 o. m.

Baste design on linen carefully, firish with buttonbole stitch, cut linen from underneath design, work over seam again to make it firm.

Size 2 Coronation Braid.

Measure off 24 medallions of C. B., cut, form circle and fasten. Inner Part—1st Row—3 d. c. in each one of the 12 loops of C. B., close. 2nd Row—Ch. 4, 1 d. c., ch. 1 bet. every 3 d. c. 3rd Row—1 sl. st. over every other st. Continue until center is completed. Outer Edge—1st Row—1 sl. st., ch. 3, 9 d. c. over 1st l. of C. B., ch. 1, 10 d. c. anext l., rep. 2nd Row—4 loops of 3 chs. each over 10 d. c., 3 sl. st. bet. scallops. 3rd Row—Ch. 4 over every l. of 3 chs. bel. count 24 loops. 4th Row—Ch. 6, 1 sl. st. over every other loop, count 12 loops. 5th Row—11 sl. st. in 1st loop, 5 sl. st. in 2nd loop, ch. 6, fasten over 1st loop, 13 sl. st. in this new loop, 6 sl. st. in remaining loop.
