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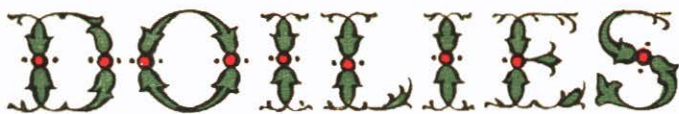

BUFFET SET No. 1 IN "CROCHETED CLUNY" — Illustration on Front Cover

MATERIALS REQUIRED:

Lily SKY-TONE Mercerized Crochet Cotton, Art. 123:—

1½ balls White; and

DAISY Mercerized Crochet Cotton, Art. 65:—

2 skeins White; or

DAISY Mercerized Crochet Cotton, Art. 97:—

2 balls White; and

Steel crochet hooks Nos. 10 and 12.

For a set of smaller doilies for a small buffet, use DAISY size 20 for Large Doily and size 30 or 50 for Small Doilies, with Nos. 12 and 14 hooks.

LARGE DOILY—(Size - 18 inches)—Starting in center with SKY-TONE and No. 10 hook, ch 8, join with sl st to form ring.

1st rnd—* Ch 11, sk 2 ch sts, sc in next 2 ch, hdc in next ch, dc in next 4 ch, hdc in next ch, sc in next ch. sc in ring. Repeat from * 7 times (8 petals). Fasten off. **2nd rnd**—Join to tip of 1 petal, (ch 10, sc in next petal) 8 times. **3d rnd**—Ch 1, sc in next lp. * (ch 3, sc) 4 times in same lp, ch 3, sc in next lp. Repeat from * around. Join with ch 1, hdc in 1st sc (40 lps). **4th rnd**—(Ch 3, sc in next lp) 39 times, ch 1, join with hdc in hdc at end of last row. **5th rnd**—(Ch 3, sc in next lp) 3 times, * (ch 9, sk 2 ch, sc in next 2 ch, hdc in next ch, dc in next 2 ch, hdc in next ch, sl st in next ch) 3 times, sk last 2 petals, sl st at base of 1st petal, sc in same ch-3 lp, (ch 3, sc in next lp) 5 times. Repeat from * around. End with 2 ch-3 lps, sl st to center of next (center) ch-3 lp. **6th rnd**—Ch 8, sc in tip of 1st petal, * (ch 8, sc in next petal) twice, ch 3, tr in center ch-3 lp between petal-groups, ch 3, sc in next petal. Repeat from * around, join with ch-3, sl st in 5th st of ch-8. **7th rnd**—Ch 1, * 3 sc in next ch-3 sp, (ch 3, sc) 4 times in next ch-8 sp, (ch 3, sc) 4 times in next sp, ch 3, 3 sc in next ch-3 sp (9 ch-3 lps made). Repeat from * around, sl st in 1st 3 sc, sl st and sc in next ch-3 lp. **8th rnd**—* (Ch 3, sc in next lp) 8 times, ch 3, sk 6 sc, sc in next lp. Repeat from * around, join to 1st sc. Sl st and sc in next lp. **9th rnd**—* (Ch 3, sc in next lp) 7 times, ch 5, sk ch-3 between groups, sc in next ch-3 lp. Repeat from * around, join to 1st sc. Sl st and sc in next lp. **10th rnd**—* (Ch 3, sc in next lp) 6 times, ch 8, sk ch-5 lp, sc in next ch-3 lp. Repeat from * around, join to 1st sc. Sl st and sc in next lp. **11th rnd**—Make 5 ch-3 lps in each group, ch 12 between groups. End as before. **12th rnd**—* (Ch 3, sc in next lp) 4 times, ch 8, dc in next ch-12 lp, ch 8, sc in next ch-3 lp. Repeat from * around. End as before. **13th rnd**—* (Ch 3, sc in next lp) 3 times, ch 10, sc in left end of next lp, ch 3, sc in next lp, ch 10, sc in next ch-3 lp. Repeat from * around. End as before. **14th rnd**—* (Ch 3, sc in next lp) twice, ch 12, sc in left end of next lp, (ch 3, sc in next lp) twice, ch 12, sc in next ch-3 lp. Repeat from * around. End as before. **15th rnd**—* Ch 3, sc in next lp, ch 13, sc in left end of next lp, (ch 3, sc in next lp) 3 times, ch 13, sc in next ch-3 lp. Repeat from * around. End as before. **16th rnd**—* Ch 14, sc in left end of next lp, (ch 3, sc in next lp) 4 times, ch 14, sc in next ch-3 lp. Repeat from * around, join with sl st in 1st sc, ch 1, sc in same sc. **17th rnd**—* Ch 15, sc in left end of next lp, (ch 3, sc in next lp) 5 times, ch 15, sc in next sc between lps. Repeat from * around, join to 1st sc, ch 1, sc in same sc. **18th rnd**—* Ch 15, (sc, ch 3, sc) in left end of next lp, (ch 3, sc in next lp) 6 times, ch 3, sc in same ch-15 lp, ch 15, sc in next sc between lps. Repeat from * around, join to 1st sc, ch 1, sc in same sc. **19th rnd**—* Ch 15, (sc, ch 3, sc) in left end of next lp, (ch 3, sc in next lp) 9 times, ch 3, sc in same ch-15 lp, ch 15, sc in next sc between lps. Repeat from * around, join to 1st sc, sl st in next 10 ch sts, sc in same lp. **20th rnd**—* (Ch 3, sc) twice in bal. of ch-15 lp, (ch 3, sc in next lp) 12 times, (ch 3, sc) twice in same ch-15 lp, ch 5, sc in next ch-15 lp. Repeat from * around. Join to 1st sc, sl st and sc in next lp. **21st rnd**—* (Ch 3, sc in next lp) 15 times, ch 3, sc in next ch-5 lp, ch 3, sc in next ch-3 lp. Repeat from * around. Join to 1st sc, sl st and sc in next lp. **22d rnd**—(Ch 3, sc in next lp) repeated around, join to 1st sc. sl st and sc in next lp. **23d & 24th rnds**—Repeat 22d rnd

twice (136 3-ch lps). **25th rnd**—Ch 12, sk 2 ch, sc in next 2 ch, hdc in next ch, dc in next 4 ch, hdc in next ch, sl st in next ch, * ch 11, sk 2 ch, in following ch sts make (2 sc, 1 hdc, 4 dc, 1 hdc and 1 sl st) twice, sk last 2 petals, sl st at base of 1st petal, ch 1, sc in next ch-3 lp, (ch 3, sc in next lp) 4 times, ch 12, sl st back in tip of last petal, ch 1, sc in 1st 2 sts of ch-12. In following ch sts make 1 hdc, 6 dc, 1 hdc and 1 sl st; (ch 13, sk 2 ch, in following ch sts make 2 sc, 1 hdc, 6 dc, 1 hdc and 1 sl st) twice, sk last 2 petals, sl st at base of 1st petal, ch 1, sc in next ch-3 lp, (ch 3, sc in next lp) 4 times; ch 10, sl st back in tip of last petal, ch 1, sc in 1st 2 sts of ch-10, in following ch sts make 1 hdc, 4 dc, 1 hdc and 1 sl st; (ch 11, sk 2 ch, in following ch sts make 2 sc, 1 hdc, 4 dc, 1 hdc and 1 sl st) twice, sk last 2 petals, sl st at base of 1st petal, ch 1, sc in next ch-3 lp, (ch 3, sc in next lp) 3 times, ch 7, sl st back in tip of last petal, ch 1, sc in 1st 2 sts of ch-7, in following ch sts make 1 hdc, 2 dc, 1 hdc and 1 sl st; (ch 9, sk 2 ch, in following ch sts make 2 sc, 1 hdc, 2 dc, 1 hdc and 1 sl st) twice, sk last 2 petals, sl st at base of 1st petal, sc in same ch-3 lp, (ch 3, sc in next lp) 3 times; ch 10, sl st back in last petal, ch 1, sc in 1st 2 sts of ch-10, in following ch sts make 1 hdc, 4 dc, 1 hdc and 1 sl st. Repeat from * around. Join and fasten off. Tack 1st and last petals tog. **26th rnd**—32 Flowers. Join to these tacked petals, ch 13, sc in next petal, (ch 8, tr between next 2 petals, ch 8, sc in next petal) repeated around, join to 5th st of ch-13, sl st in next 4 ch sts, sc in same lp. **27th rnd**—* Ch 7, sl st in 1 lp of 4th ch from hook for a p, ch 8, p, ch 4, sc in next ch-8 lp. Repeat from * around. Join and fasten off. **28th rnd**—Join to center of next p-lp, (ch 7, p, ch 8, p, ch 4, sc in next p-lp) repeated around. Join and fasten off. **29th rnd**—Repeat 28th rnd. **30th rnd**—Join to center of next lp, (ch 10, sc in next lp) repeated around, join. **31st rnd**—Ch 1, sc in next lp (ch 3, sc) 2 times in same lp (ch 3 sc) 4 times in next lp (6 lps made) 6 sc in half of next lp, ch 10, 6 sc in left half of next lp. * Sc in next lp (ch 3 sc) 4 times in same lp, (ch 3, sc) 5 times in next lp (9 lps made) 6 sc in half of next lp, ch 10, 6 sc in left half of next lp. Repeat from * around ending with sc (ch 3, sc) 3 times in last lp. Join to 1 sc and sl st back to 1st 3 ch lp. **32d rnd**—* (Ch 3, sc in next lp) 8 times, sk 1 sc, sc in next 6 sc, 5 sc in half of next ch-10 lp, (ch 9, sk 2 ch sts, in bal. of ch make 2 sc, 1 hdc, 2 dc, 1 hdc and 1 sl st) 3 times, sk last 2 petals, sl st at base of 1st petal, 5 sc in bal. of ch-10 lp, sc in next 6 sc, sc in next ch-3 lp. Repeat from * around, join to 1st sc. sl st and sc in next ch-3 lp. **33d rnd**—(Ch 3, sc in next lp) 6 times, ch 1, dc in next lp; ch 3, turn, sc in next ch-3 lp, (ch 3, sc in next lp) 4 times, ch 1, dc in next lp; * ch 3, turn, sc in next ch-3 lp, (ch 3, sc in next lp) 4 times, (ch 8, sc in next petal) 3 times, ch 10, dc in next ch-3 lp, ch 1, sc in next lp, (ch 3, sc in next lp) 5 times, ch 1, dc in next lp; ch 3, turn, sc in next ch-3 lp, (ch 3, sc in next lp) 4 times, ch 1, sc in next ch-10 lp. Repeat from * around, join with ch 8, sl st at end of 1st ch-3 lp in top row, sl st and sc in 1st ch-3 lp. **34th rnd**—(Ch 3, sc in next lp) 3 times, ch 1, dc in next lp; ch 3, turn, sc in next ch-3 lp, ch 3, sc in next lp, ch 1, dc in next lp; * ch 3, turn, sc in next ch-3 lp, ch 3, sc in next lp, ch 9, sc in next ch-8 lp, (ch 10, sc in next lp) 3 times, ch 11, dc in next ch-3 lp, ch 1, sc in next lp, (ch 3, sc in next lp) twice, ch 1, dc in next lp; ch 3, turn, sc in next ch-3 lp, ch 3, sc in next lp, ch 1, sc in next ch-11 lp. Repeat from * around, join with ch-9, sl st at end of 1st ch-3 lp in top row, sl st and sc in 1st ch-3 lp. **35th rnd**—* Ch 3, sc in next lp, 5 sc in next ch-9 lp, ch 5, sl st in last sc for a p. 5 sc in bal. of lp, (6 sc, a p, 5 sc) in each of next 3 lps, (5 sc, a p, 5 sc) in next lp, sc in next ch-3 lp. Repeat from * around, join to 1st sc. Fasten off.

SMALL DOILY—(Size - 16 inches)—Repeat with DAISY and No. 12 hook. Make 2 Doilies. Stretch and pin doilies right-side-down in true circle. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

MATERIALS REQUIRED:

DAISY Mercerized Crochet Cotton, Art. 65:—
2 skeins each Lt. Green and Shd. Yellows, size 30; or
DAISY Mercerized Crochet Cotton, Art. 97:—
2 balls each Lt. Green and Shd. Yellows, size 30; or
Lily MERCROCHET Cotton, Art. 161:—
2 balls each Bright Nile Green and Shd. Yellows, size 30; and
Steel crochet hook No. 13.

SIZE:—18 to 20 inches.

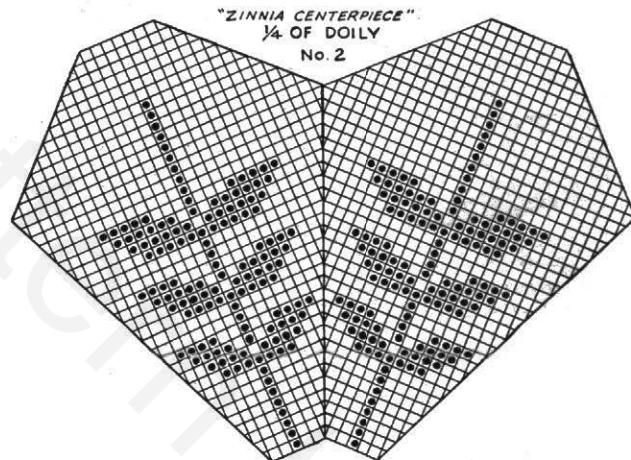
CENTER—Starting in center with Lt. Green, ch 9, join with sl st to form ring. *1st rnd*—Ch 1, 16 sc in ring, join with sl st in 1st sc. *2nd rnd*—(Ch 29, sc in next sc, ch 31, sc in next sc) repeated around (16 lps). Fasten off on back of ring. *3d rnd*—Join to one ch-29 lp, (ch 7, sc in next lp) 16 times. *4th rnd*—Ch 3, dc in same st, * dc in next sp, ch 2, dc in center of same sp, ch 2, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next sc, ch 2, dc in center of next sp, ch 2, dc in left end of same sp, 2 dc in next sc. Repeat from * around, ending with 1 dc, join with sl st in top of ch-3. *5th rnd*—Ch 3, turn, dc in next dc, * (ch 2, dc in next dc) twice, ch 2, dc in next ch-3 (corner) sp. (ch 2, dc in next dc) twice, ch 2, dc in next 4 dc. Repeat from * around, ending with 2 dc, join to 1st ch-3. *6th rnd*—Ch 3, turn, dc in next 2 dc, * (ch 2, dc in next dc) twice, ch 2, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next (corner) dc, (ch 2, dc in next dc) twice, ch 2, dc in next 4 dc. Repeat from * around, ending with 1 dc, join to 1st ch-3. *7th rnd*—Ch 3, turn, dc in next dc, * (ch 2, dc in next dc) 3 times, ch 1, dc in next ch-2 (corner) sp, ch 1, dc in next dc, (ch 2, dc in next dc) twice, ch 2, dc in next 4 dc. Repeat from * around, ending with 2 dc, join to 1st ch-3. *8th rnd*—Ch 3, turn, dc in next 2 dc, * (ch 2, dc in next dc) 8 times (8 sps made), dc in next 3 dc. Repeat from * around, join to 1st ch-3. *9th rnd*—Ch 3, turn, dc in next dc, * make 4 sps to corner dc, ch 3, dc in same corner dc, make 4 sps and 1 blk. Repeat from * around, join. *10th rnd*—Ch 3, turn, dc in next 2 dc, * make 4 sps, ch 2, dc in corner ch-3, ch 2, dc in next dc, 4 sps, 1 blk. Repeat from * around, join. *11th rnd*—Ch 3, turn, dc in next dc, * make 5 sps to corner dc, ch 3, dc in same corner dc, 5 sps, 1 blk. Repeat from * around, join. *12th rnd*—Ch 3, turn, dc in next 2 dc, (2 dc in next sp, dc in next dc) 3 times (3 blks made), * 2 sps, ch 2, dc in next ch-3 corner sp, ch 2, dc in next dc, 2 sps, 7 blks. Repeat from * around, join. *13th rnd*—Turn, sl st in next dc, ch 3, * 4 blks, 2 sps to corner dc, ch 2, dc in same corner dc, 2 sps, 4 blks, 1 sp. Repeat from * around, join final ch-2 to top of 1st ch-3. *14th rnd*—Ch 3, turn, 2 dc in next sp, dc in next dc, * 1 sp, 4 blks, 1 sp, ch 1, dc in corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, dc in next dc, 1 sp, 4 blks, 1 sp, 1 blk. Repeat from * around, join. *15th rnd*—Ch 5, turn, dc in next dc, 1 sp, * 4 blks, 2 sps around corner, 4 blks, 2 sps, 1 blk, 2 sps. Repeat from * around, ending with 3 dc, join to 3d st of 1st ch-5. Continue, following Chart, thru 31st rnd, making corners in order as in 9th thru 15 rnds, and turning each row. Turn. **ROW 32**—Ch 4, sk corner dc, dc in next dc. 13 sps, 1 blk, 13 sps, tr in next (corner) dc. **ROW 33**—Ch 4, turn, sk tr and 1st dc, dc in next dc, 12 sps, 1 blk, 12 sps, tr in next dc. Continue, following Chart, thru Row 42. Fasten off. Join to corner dc of next side of Center and repeat Rows 32 thru 42. Repeat on other 6 sides.

FRILL—Join Green in angle between any 2 points, * (4 sc in next sp) 11 times, (3 sc in next sp) 7 times, (4 sc in next sp) 11 times. Repeat from * 7 times, join to 1st sc. *2d rnd*—Ch 8, sk 1 sc, dc in next sc, (ch 5, sk 1 sc, dc in next sc) 19 times up to corner, * (ch 5, dc in next sc) 4 times, (ch 5, sk 1 sc, dc in next sc) 10 times, (ch 5, dc in next sc) 4 times, (ch 5, sk 1 sc, dc in next sc) 20 times, ch 5, dc in 1st sc on next side, (ch 5, sk 1 sc, dc in next sc) 20 times. Repeat from * around, join to 3d st of 1st ch-8. *3d rnd*—Sl st to center of next lp, ch 9, dc in next lp. (ch 6, dc in next lp) repeated around, join to 3d st of 1st lp. *4th rnd*—Sl st to center of next lp, ch 10, dc in next lp, (ch 7, dc in next lp) repeated around, join. Fasten off. *5th rnd*—Repeat with Shd. Yellow, starting with ch-11 and making ch-8 lps around. Join

and fasten off. *6th rnd*—Repeat with Green, starting with ch-12 and making ch-9 lps around. Join. *7th rnd*—Start with ch-13 and make ch-10 lps around. Join. *8th rnd*—Start with ch-14 and make ch-11 lps around. Join and fasten off. *9th rnd*—Join Shd. Yellow, start with ch-15 and make ch-12 lps around. Join and fasten off.

ZINNIA—With Shd. Yellow, ch 7, join with sl st to form ring. *1st rnd*—Ch 1, 12 sc in ring, join with sl st in back lp of 1st sc. *2d rnd*—(Ch 3 and working in back lps, 3 dc in next sc, ch 3, sc in next sc) 6 times. *3d rnd*—(Ch 3, sc in back lp of sc between next 2 petals) 6 times. *4th rnd*—Sc in next lp, * ch 3, (3 dc, ch 3, sc) in same lp, ch 3, 3 dc in both lps of next sc between lps, ch 3, sc in next lp. Repeat from * around (12 petals). *5th rnd*—Repeat Row 3 (12 lps). *6th rnd*—(Ch 4, in next lp make 4 tr, ch 4, sc) 12 times. *7th rnd*—(Ch 4, sc in back lp of sc between next 2 petals) 12 times. *8th rnd*—* Ch 4, in next lp make 4 tr, ch 4, sc, ch 4, tr; 2 tr in next sc, in next lp make tr, ch 4, sc, ch 4, 4 tr; ch 4, sc in next sc. Repeat from * around (18 petals). *9th rnd*—Repeat Row 7 (18 lps). *10th rnd*—(Ch 4, in next lp make 5 tr, ch 4, sc) 18 times. Fasten off. Make 8 Zinnias.

Sew a Zinnia on each stem 3 rows below start of Frill. Starch Doily, stretch and pin center right-side-up in true shape. As starch stiffens, pin ruffle into even ripples, rolling it down towards center of doily between Zinnias. Let stand until dry.



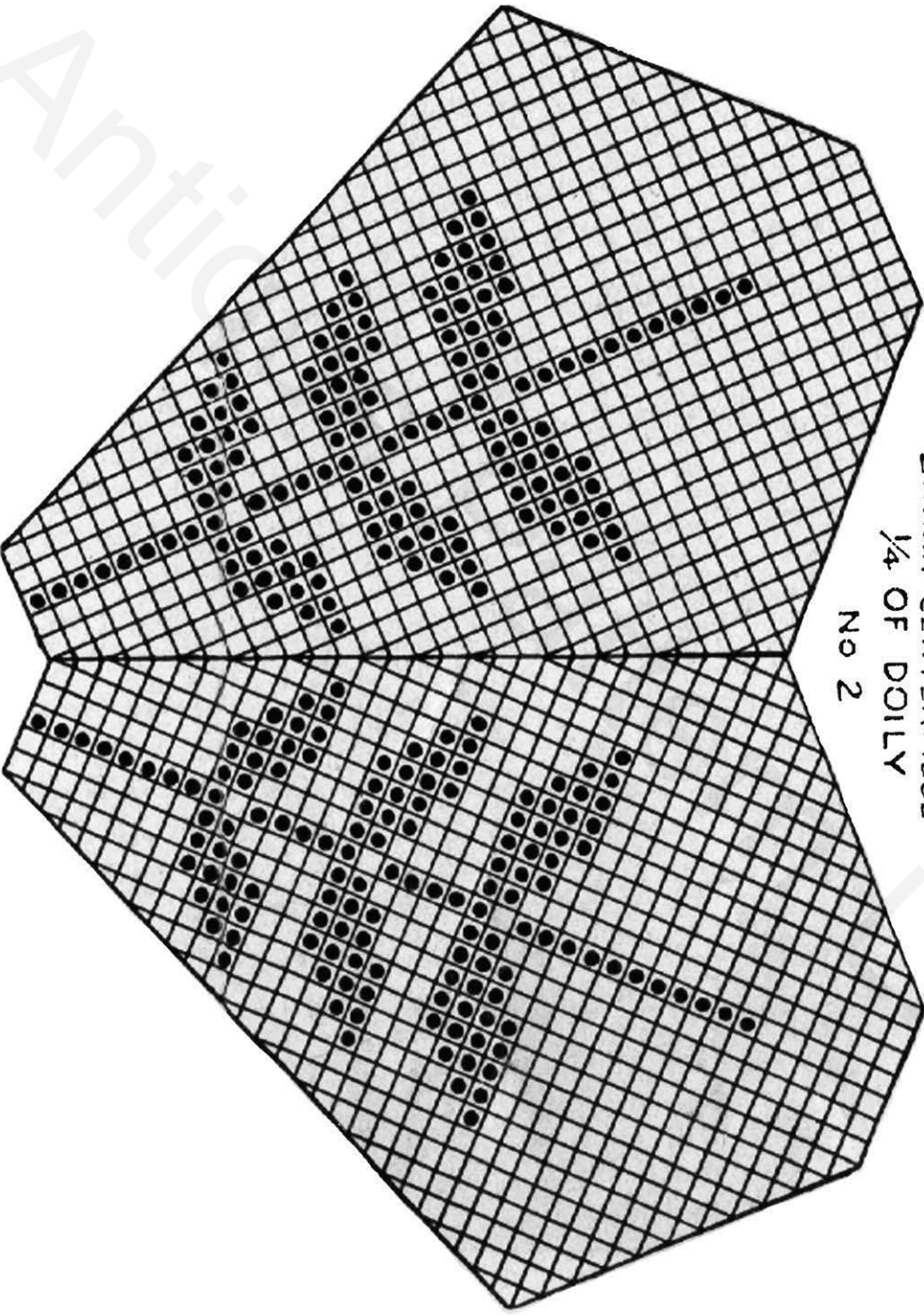

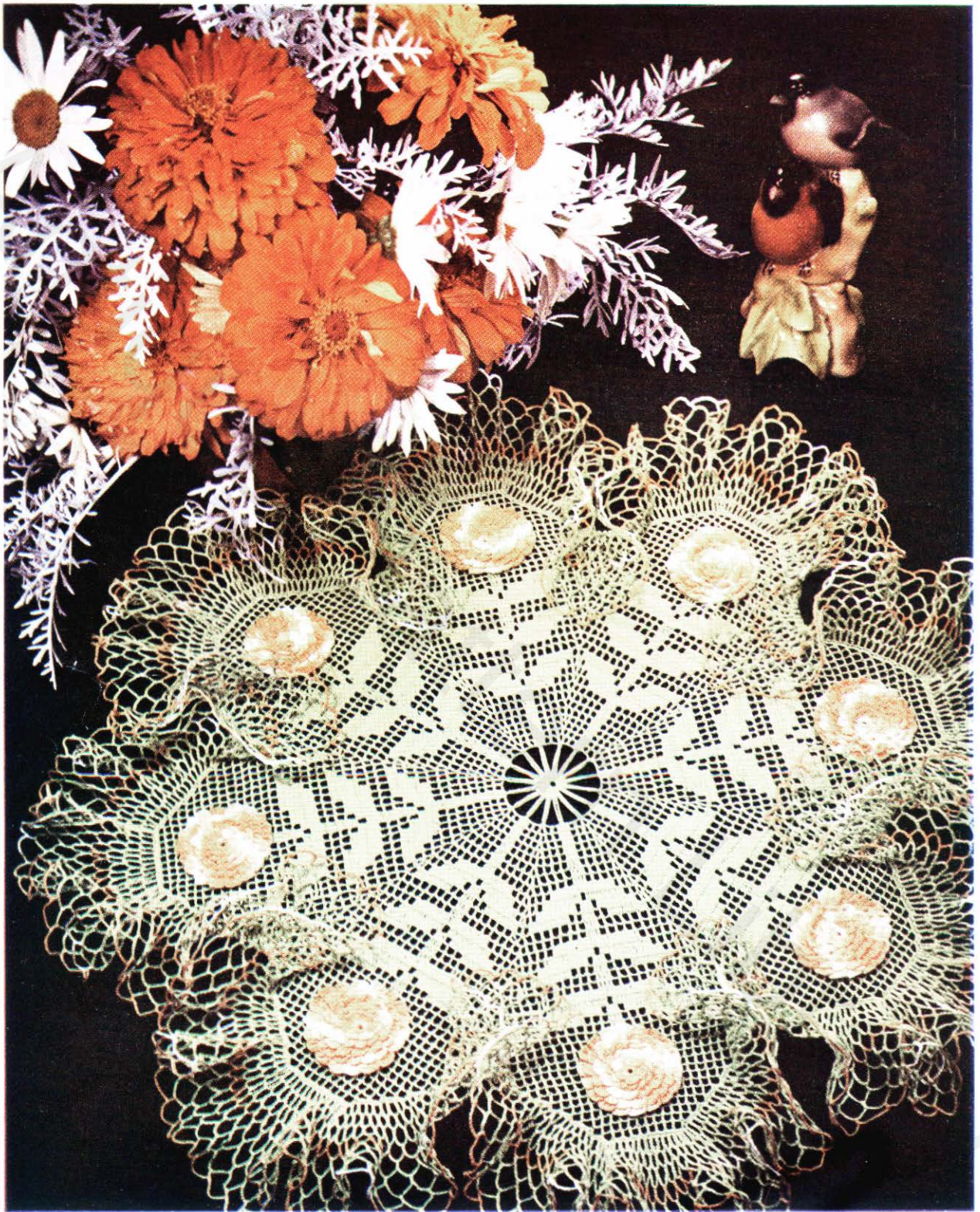

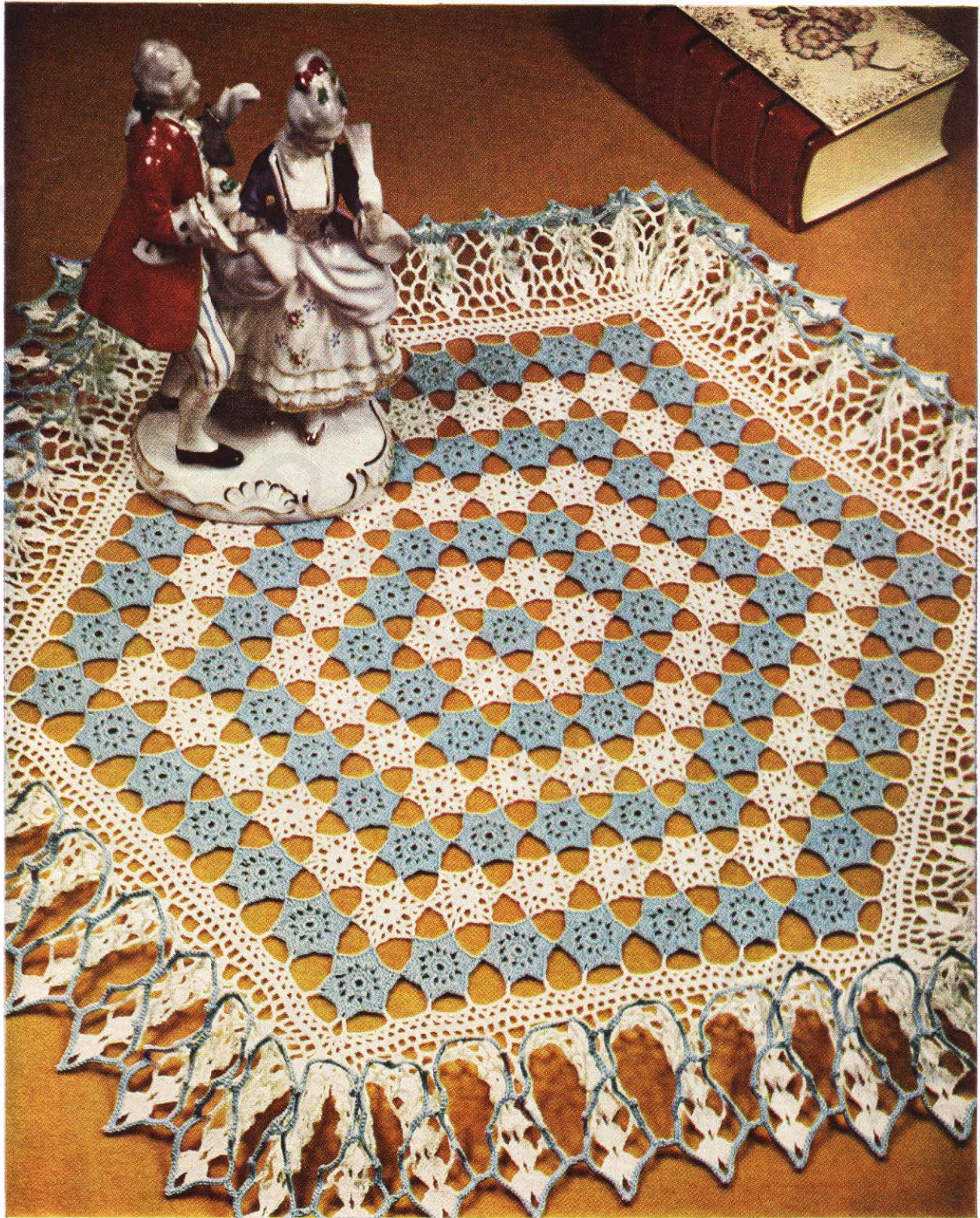

MATERIALS REQUIRED:

DAISY Mercerized Crochet Cotton, Art. 65:—
2 skeins White and

1 skein Turquoise, size 30; or

DAISY Mercerized Crochet Cotton, Art. 97:—

2 balls each White and Turquoise, size 30; or

Lily MERCROCHET Cotton, Art. 161;—

2 balls each White and Turquoise, size 30; and

Steel crochet hook No. 13.

SIZE:—17 to 19 inches.

Starting in center:—**COLORED MOTIF**—With Turquoise, ch 8, join with sl st to form ring. *1st rnd*—Ch 1, 12 sc in ring, join with sl st in 1st sc. *2d rnd*—Ch 1, sc in same st, (sc in next 2 sc, ch 6, sc in same sc with last sc) 5 times, sc in next 2 sts, ch 4, join with hdc in 1st sc. *3d rnd*—Ch 3, (in next ch-6 lp make 4 dc, ch 3, 4 dc) 5 times. In final lp make 4 dc, ch 3, 3 dc, join with sl st in top of 1st ch-3. Cut 6 inches long, thread to a needle and fasten off on back.

WHITE MOTIF—With White repeat 1st and 2d rnds. *3d rnd*—Ch 3, (in next ch-6 lp make dc, ch 2, dc, ch 3, dc, ch 2, dc) 5 times. In final lp, make dc, ch 2, dc, ch 1, sl st in a corner ch-3 on Colored Motif, ch 1, dc back in same lp on White Motif, ch 2, join with sl st in top of 1st ch-3. Fasten off in same way, carrying thread down back to center ring to fasten. * Make another White Motif, joining it to the next corner on Colored Motif and to the next free corner on previous White Motif. Repeat from * 3 times. Make a 6th White

Motif, joining it to 1st and 5th White Motifs and to remaining corner on Center Motif,—completing row. *3d ROW*—Make a Colored Motif, joining it to 1 corner each on 2 adjoining White Motifs. * Make another Colored Motif, joining it to 1 corner of previous Colored Motif and to the next corner of same White Motif. Make another Colored Motif, joining it to one corner of previous Colored Motif, to the corner of same White Motif and to the next corner of the following White Motif. Repeat from * around, joining 12th Motif to 1st Motif. *4th ROW*—Make 18 White Motifs (1 more on each side than in last row), always starting each row by joining 1st Motif to 1 corner each of 2 adjoining Colored Motifs. *5th ROW*—24 Colored Motifs (1 more on each side than in last row), starting in same way as in last row. *6th ROW*—30 White Motifs. *7th ROW*—36 Colored Motifs.

RUFFLE—Join White to center point on one corner Motif, ch 8, dc in same place, * (ch 10, dc in next point, ch 8, dc in 1st point on next Motif) 6 times, ch 10, (dc, ch 5, dc) in next (corner) point. Repeat from * around, join to 3d st of ch-8. *2d rnd*—Sc in next sp, ** (ch 4, sc in same sp) 3 times, * ch 4, sc in next sp, (ch 4, sc in same sp) 3 times, ch 4, sc in next sp, (ch 4, sc in same sp) twice. Repeat from * across to next corner sp. Repeat from ** around, ch 4, join to 1st sc. *3d rnd*—Sl st to center of next lp, ch 4, hdc in next (corner) lp, * ch 3, hdc in same lp, (ch 2, hdc in next lp) repeated to center lp at next corner. Repeat from * around, ch 2, join to 2d st of ch-4. *4th rnd*—3 sc in next sp, * 5 sc in next (corner) ch-3 sp, (3 sc in next sp) repeated to last sp before corner sp. Repeat from * around. Sl st in 1st 2 sc. *5th rnd*—Ch 5, dc in next sc, (ch 2, dc in next sc) 3 times to center sc at corner, * ch 2, dc in same corner sc, (ch 2, dc in next sc) 4 times, (ch 2, sk 2 sc, dc in next sc) repeated across to last sp before corner sp, (ch 2, dc in next sc) 4 times to center sc at corner. Repeat from * around. ch 2, join to 3d st of ch-5. *6th rnd*—Sc in next sp, ch 3, * (dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in same sp, (ch 5, dc in next sp) 3 times, ch 5, in next sp make a 2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc (shell) ch 5, dc in next sp, ch 5, sk 1 sp, dc in next sp. ** Ch 5, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in 2nd sp, (ch 5, dc in 2nd sp) 3 times. Repeat from ** 5 times. Skip next sp and make shell in next sp, ch 5, dc in 2nd sp, ch 5, dc in 2nd sp. Repeat from * around, ch 5, join to top of ch-3, sl st to center sp of same shell. *7th rnd*—Ch 5 * (2 tr, ch 3, 3 tr) in same place (ch 6, dc in next sp) 4 times, ch 6. In next shell make a 3 tr, ch 3, 3 tr in shell. Continue with ch 6, dc, in each ch-5 sp and shell in each shell of previous row. Join to top of ch-5, slip st to center of same shell. *8th rnd*—Repeat last row except have ch 7 instead of ch-6. Join to top of ch-5 and sl st to center of same shell. *9th rnd*—Ch 5, (3 tr, ch 5, 4 tr) in same place, ch 8, dc in next space. Continue around having a 4 tr, ch 5, 4 tr in each shell and ch-8, dc in each ch-7 sp. Join, sl st to center of same shell. *10th rnd*—Repeat last row but with ch-9 lps between shells. *11th rnd*—Ch 5, (4 tr, ch 6, 5 tr) in same shell, ch 10, dc in next sp. Repeat around with 5 tr, ch 6, 5 tr in each shell and ch-10 in each ch 9 sp. Join and fasten off.

Edge—Join Turquoise to 1st tr on one shell, ch 1, sc in same tr, sc in next 4 tr, 4 sc in half of next sp, ch 5, sl st in last sc for a p, 3 sc in bal. of sp, sc in next 5 tr, (6 sc, a p, 5 sc) in each of next 8 sps, 6 sc in half of next sp, ch 2, sl st back in 8th p from hook, ch 2, sl st back in last sc, 5 sc in bal. of sp, * sc in next 5 tr, (4 sc, a p, 3 sc) in center of shell, sc in next 5 tr, (6 sc, a p, 5 sc) in each of next 2 sps, 6 sc in half of next sp, ch 2, sk last joining of ps, sl st back in 2d previous p, ch 2, sl st back in last sc, 5 sc in same sp, (6 sc, a p, 5 sc) in each of next 5 sps, 6 sc in half of next sp, ch 2, sl st back in 1st p to left of last shell, ch 2, sl st back in last sc, 5 sc in bal. of same sp. Repeat from * around. Fasten off. Tack 1st and last ripples tog. in pattern. Starch doily. When partially dry, stretch and pin it right-side-up in true shape, putting a pin in each shell point around ruffle. Crush a small piece of tissue paper and tuck in each top ripple of ruffle. Let stand until dry.

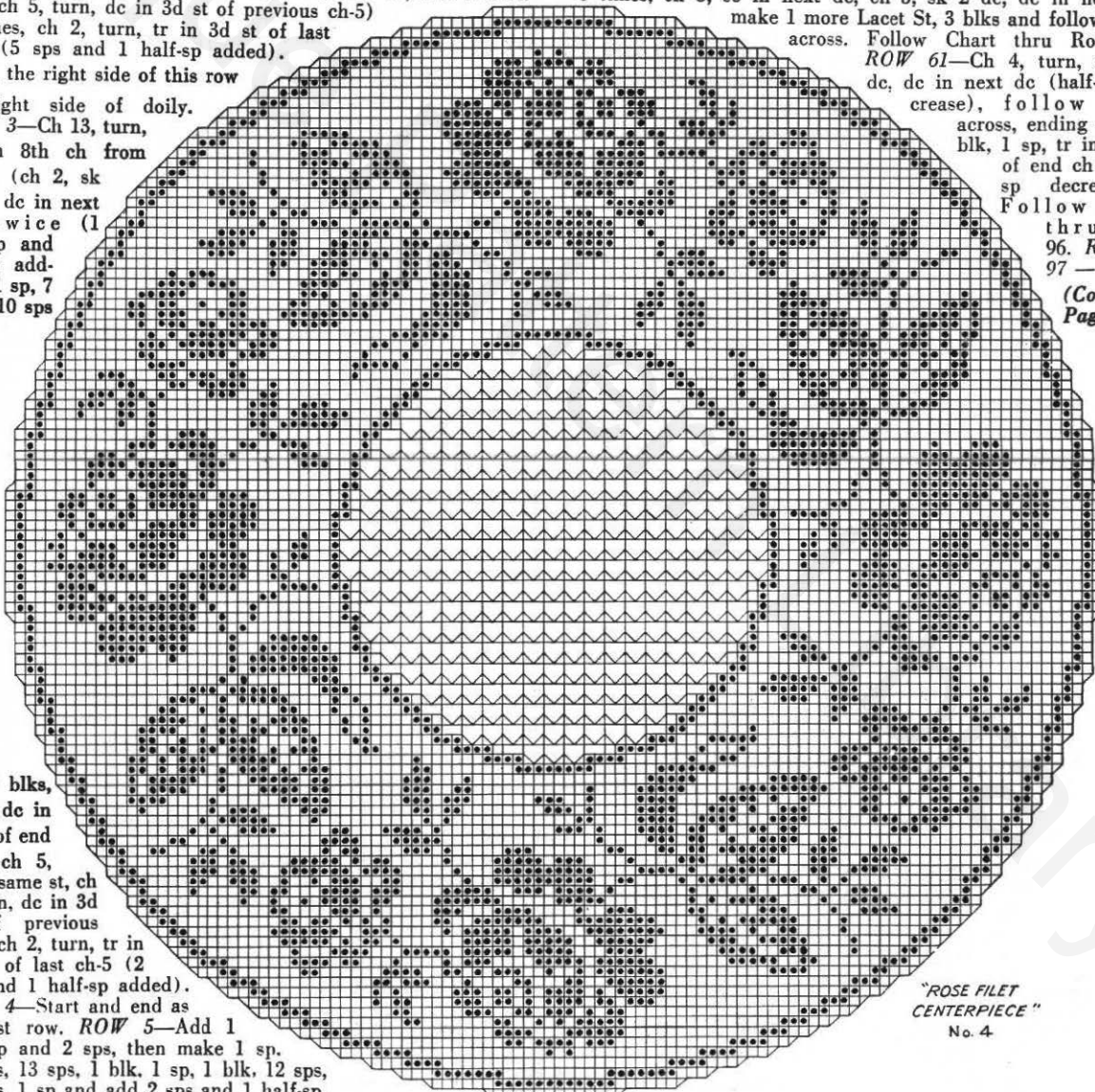

Follow Chart thru Row 19. **ROW 20**—Ch 5, turn, sk tr, dc in next dc (1 sp made), 2 blks and follow Chart across, ending with 1 sp even. Follow Chart thru Row 33. **ROW 34**—To make Lacet St Center, (ch 3, sk 2 dc, sc in next dc, ch 3, sk 2 dc, dc in next dc) 3 times (3 Lacet Sts made). Follow Chart across. **ROW 35**—Across Center, make 1 sp, ch 5, sk 5 dc, dc in next dc, (ch 5, dc in next dc) 3 times, ch 5, sk 5 dc, dc in next dc, 1 sp, 4 blks and follow Chart across. **ROW 36**—Across Center make 1 Lacet St, ch 3, sk 2 dc, sc in next dc, ch 3, dc in next dc, (ch 3, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 3, dc in next dc) 5 times, ch 3, sc in next dc, ch 3, sk 2 dc, dc in next dc, make 1 more Lacet St, 3 blks and follow chart across. Follow Chart thru Row 60.

ROW 61—Ch 4, turn, sk 1st dc, dc in next dc (half-sp decrease), follow Chart across, ending with 1 blk, 1 sp, tr in 3d st of end ch (half-sp decreased). Follow Chart thru Row 96. **ROW 97**—Ch 1,

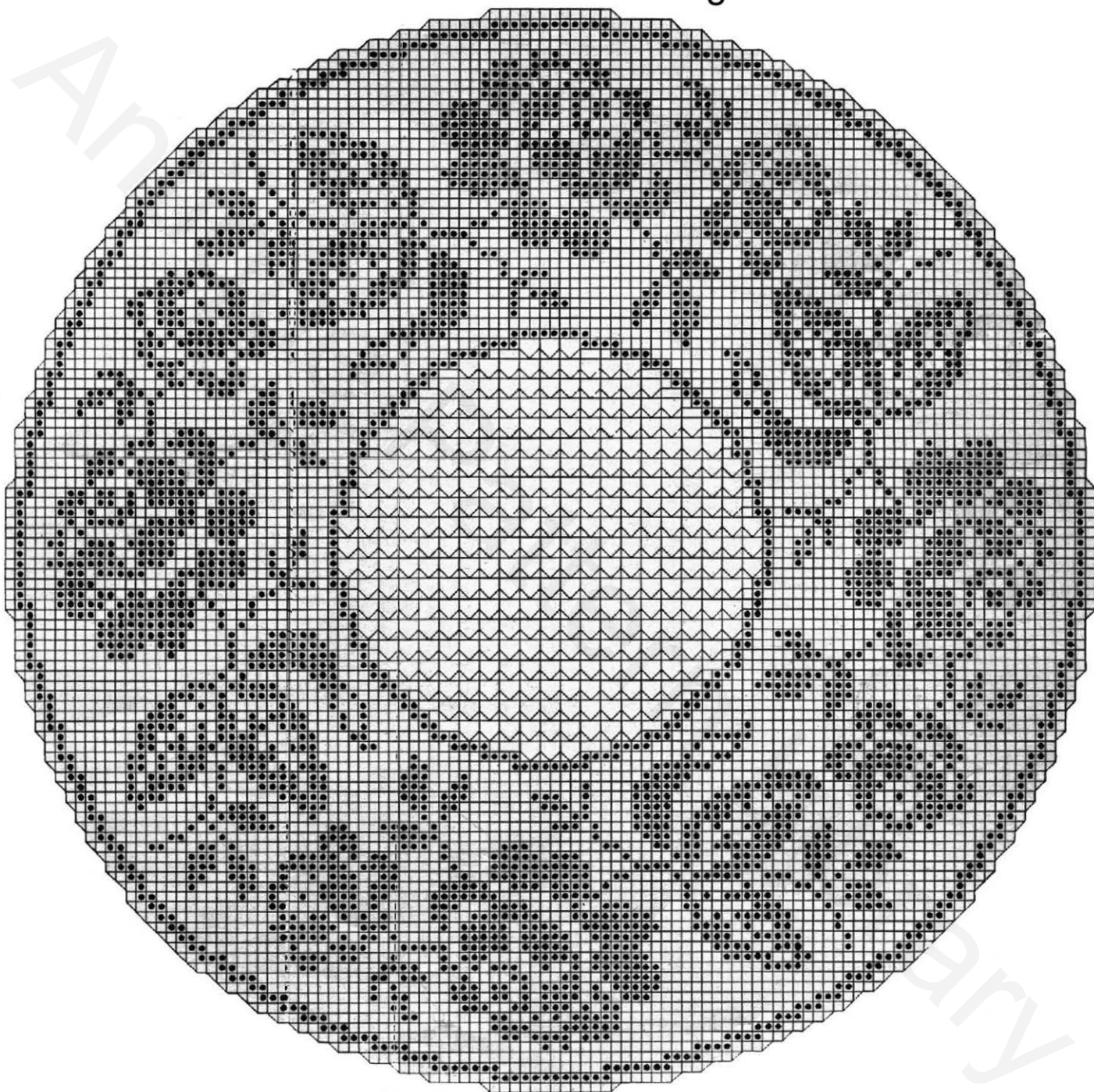

Cut and rip excess ch, leaving 2 ch past last dc, and with row untwisted, sew this end to 3d st of 1st ch-8. Ch 2, dc in same st, ch 2, sk 2 ch of same ch-8, dc in next ch. (All rows end at exact corner). *2d rnd*—Ch 5, turn, sk 1st dc, dc in next dc, * (2 dc in next sp, dc in next dc) twice (2 blks made), (ch 2, dc in next dc) twice (2 sps made), 2 blks, 14 sps, 1 blk, 10 sps, ** 2 blks, 2 sps and 2 blks; ch 2, (dc, ch 5, dc) in 3d (center) st of corner ch-5, 1 sp. Repeat from * to ** twice, 2 blks, 2 sps, 2 blks, 1 sp, a ch-5 corner sp, 1 sp. Repeat from * around, ending with ch-2, join with dc in 3d st of 1st ch-5 (final corner sp made). Mark the right side of this row as right side of doily. *3d rnd*—Ch 5, turn, sk 1st dc, dc in next dc, * 1 blk, ch 5, sk 5 dc, dc in next dc (long sp made), 2 blks, ch 5, sk 5 dc, dc in next dc, 1 blk, 10 sps, 1 blk, 7 sps, 1 blk, 4 sps. ** Repeat from * once, 1 blk, 1 long sp, 2 blks, 1 long sp, 1 blk, 1 sp, a corner sp, 1 sp. Repeat from * to ** once, 1 blk, 1 long sp, 2 blks, 1 long sp, 1 blk, 1 sp, a corner sp, 1 sp. Repeat from * around and end as in last rnd. *4th rnd*—Ch 5, turn, sk 1st dc, dc in next dc, * 1 blk, ch 5, dc in next ch-5 sp, ch 2, dc in next dc, 2 blks, ch 2, dc in next ch-5 sp, ch 5, sk 3 dc, dc in next dc, 1 blk, 3 sps, 4 blks, 3 sps, 1 blk, 10 sps, ** 1 blk, 1 long sp, 1 sp, 2 blks, 1 sp, 1 long sp, 1 blk, 1 sp, a ch-5 corner sp, 1 sp. Repeat from * to ** twice, 1 blk, 1 long sp, 1 sp, 2 blks, 1 sp, 1 long sp, 1 blk, 1 sp, a ch-5 corner sp, 1 sp. Repeat from * around. End as in 2d rnd. Follow Chart thru 12th rnd. *13th rnd*—In center of each flower make a ch-3 sp. *14th rnd*—In center of each flower make ch 4, dc in center ch-3 sp, ch 4, sk 1 dc, dc in next dc. *15th rnd*—In center of each flower make ch 4, sc in center dc, ch 4, dc in next dc. *16th rnd*—In center of each flower make ch 4, dc in center sc, ch 4, dc in next dc. *17th rnd*—In center of each flower, (ch 2, dc in next ch-4 sp) twice, ch 2, dc in next dc. Follow Chart thru final 26th rnd.

EDGE—Without turning, make sc in each dc around, 2 sc in each ch-2 sp, 6 sc in each corner ch-5 sp. Join and fasten off. **INNER EDGE**—Join to base of 2d dc to right of 1 corner, ch 3, 2 dc in next sp, * holding back the last lp of each dc on hook, make dc in next dc, dc in next sp, dc in corner st, dc in next sp, dc in next dc, thread over and draw thru all 6 lps on hook (corner Cluster made), (2 dc in next sp, dc in next dc) repeated across thru 2d sp before next corner. Repeat from * around, join to 1st Cluster. Fasten off. Stretch and pin lace right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth. Baste and hem inner edge of lace down closely on linen. Cut cloth ¼ inch outside stitching, turn edge back next to lace and hem down on back of dc-row.



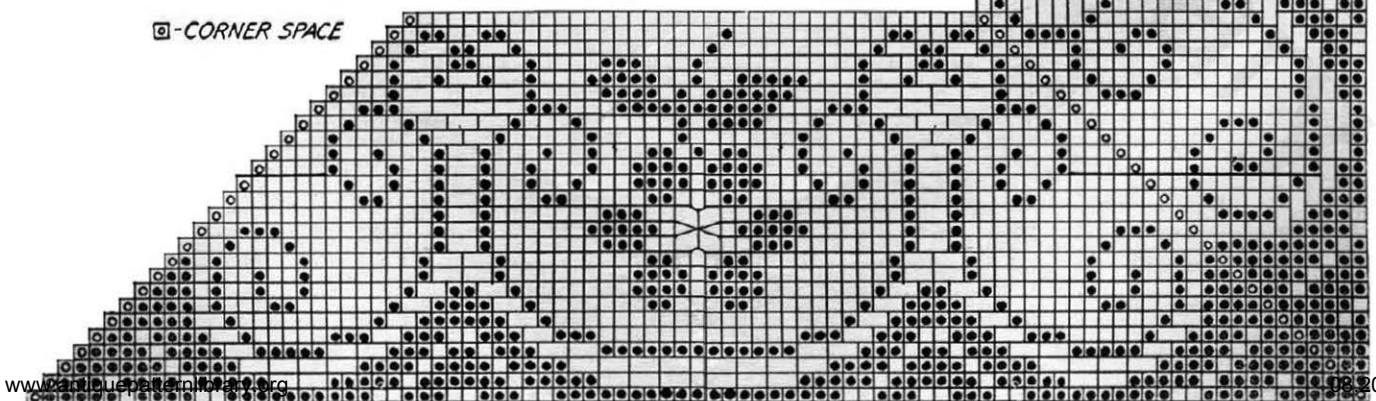

Repeat from * 7 times. Cut 6 inches long, thread to a needle and fasten off on back. *4th rnd*—Join White to tip of last petal, * ch 10, sc in next petal, ch 6, sk next sc, dc in next hdc down side of petal, ch 2, sk 2 sts, dc in next st, dc in 3d st up next petal, ch 2, sk 2 sts, dc in next st; ch 3, turn, sk last 3 dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in 3d st of next ch-6; ch 5, turn, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in next dc, ch 3, sc in tip of next petal. Repeat from * 3 times. *5th rnd*—Sc in next ch-10 sp, ch 7, a 2-dtr Cluster in same sp. (ch 5, a 3-dtr Cluster) 5 times in same sp (6 Clusters made), * ch 5, sc in next corner, (ch 5, a 3-dtr Cluster) 6 times in next ch-10 sp. Repeat from * around. End with ch 5, join with sl st in top of 1st Cluster. *6th rnd*—Ch 1, 3 sc in half of next lp, ch 15, sc in next lp, * (ch 7, sc in next lp) twice, ch 15, 3 sc in left half of next lp, 3 sc in half of next lp, ch 19, remove hook, insert it back in 5th ch of 19-ch, counting up from last sc, catch lp and pull thru,—forming a ring,—ch 1, sc, hdc and 2 dc in ring, ch 2, sl st back in 4th st up previous ch-15 lp, ch 2, sl st back in last dc, 4 dc in ring, ch 4, sl st in last dc for a p, ** in bal. of ring make 4 dc, a ch-9 p, (4 dc, a ch-4 p) twice, 2 dc, hdc and sc; sl st at base of ring, ch 4, 3 sc in left half of next ch-5 lp, 3 sc in half of next lp, ch 4, sl st back in last p on ring, ch 11, sc in next ch-5 lp. Repeat from * around. Join final p on final ring to 4th st of 1st ch-15, then complete row and join to 1st sc. Fasten off.

2d MOTIF—Repeat to **. 4 dc in ring, ch 4, sl st in 1 lp of center st of a corner p on 1st Motif, ch 4, sl st back in last dc on 2d Motif, 4 dc in ring, ch 2, sl st in next p on 1st Motif, ch 2, sl st back in last dc, in bal. of ring make 4 dc, a ch-4 p, 2 dc, hdc and sc; sl st at base of ring, ch 4, 3 sc in left half of next ch-5 lp, 3 sc in half of next lp, ch 4, sl st back in last p on ring, ch 5, sl st in next ch-11 lp on 1st Motif, ch 5, sc back in next ch-5 lp on 2d Motif, (ch 3, sl st in next ch-7 lp on 1st Motif, ch 3, sc back in next lp on 2d Motif) twice, ch 5, sl st in next lp on 1st Motif, ch 9, 3 sc back in left half of next lp on 2d Motif, 3 sc in next lp, ch 19 and form a ring as before in 5th st, ch 1, sc, hdc and 2 dc in ring, ch 2, sl st back in 4th st of ch-9, ch 2, sl st back in last dc, 4 dc in ring, ch 2, sl st in next p on 1st Motif, ch 2, sl st back in last dc, 4 dc in ring, ch 4, sl st in 1 lp of center st of next (corner) p on 1st Motif, ch 4, sl st back in last dc. Complete row as for 1st Motif.

Make 4 rows of 6 Motifs, joining adjacent sides as 2d Motif was joined to 1st Motif (where 4 corners meet, join 3d and 4th corners to joining of previous 2 corners).

EDGE—Join White to center p at 1 corner, * ch 11, sc in next p, ch 11, sc in next ch-11 lp, ch 11, dc in next 2 ch-7 lps, ch 11, sc in next ch-11 lp, ch 11, sc in next p, ch 11, sc between ps at joining of Motifs. Repeat from * around, join and fasten off. *2d rnd*—Join Salmon Rose to 1st lp on one side, 12 sc in each lp around. *3d rnd*—Sl st to 4th sc on next lp, ch 5, (tr in next 2 sc) made into a Cluster, * (ch 5, sl st in 1 lp of 4th ch from hook for a p) 3 times, ch 2, (tr in next 3 sc) made into a Cluster, ch 1, sk 1st 3 sc on next lp, (tr in next 3 sc) made into a Cluster. Repeat from * to corner. Around corner, (ch 5, p) 4 times, ch 2, sk 1st 3 sc on 1st lp on next side, (tr in next 3 sc) made into a Cluster. Repeat from * around. End with corner 4-p lp and join to 1st Cluster. Fasten off.

Stretch and pin doily right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

Blues ch 164 slightly looser than usual. *ROW 1*—Sk 5 ch, dc in next 2 ch, then make a slanting dc back in ch just previous to 2 dc, (sk 1 ch, dc in next 2 ch, a slanting dc back in skipped ch) repeated across (53 dc-groups), end with dc in end ch. *ROW 2*—Ch 3, turn, sk 1st 2 dc, dc in next 2 dc, a slanting dc back in dc just previous to these 2 dc, (sk 1 dc, dc in next 2 dc, a slanting dc back in skipped dc) repeated across, dc in end ch. Repeat Row 2 for 18 inches (when stretched), always being careful that each dc-group is directly above a dc-group in previous row. *Final Row*—Ch 1, turn, sl st in each st across. Fasten off.

Pocket—With Lt. Blue, ch 70. *ROW 1*—Sk 4 ch, dc in remaining 66 ch. *ROW 2*—Ch 3, turn, sk 1st dc, dc in remaining 66 sts. Repeat Row 2 for 6 inches. **Edge**—Ch 1, turn, sc in 1st dc, * hdc in next 2 dc, dc in next 2 dc, (tr in next dc, 2 tr in next dc) twice, tr in next 5 dc, (2 tr in next dc, tr in next dc) twice, dc in next 2 dc, hdc in next 2 dc, sc in next dc. Repeat from * twice. Fasten off. ** Working across other side of starting ch at bottom of pocket, make sc in 1st st and repeat Edge from * to **.

Cherry—With Scarlet Pearl Cotton ch 5, 7 dc in 5th ch from hook. *ROW 2*—Ch 3, turn, dc in 7 dc, dc in end ch. *ROW 3*—Ch 3, turn, sk 1st dc, holding back the last lp of each dc on hook, make dc in next 7 dc, thread over and pull thru all lps on hook (Cluster made). Fasten off on back. Make 7 Cherries.

Leaf—With Shd. Green Pearl Cotton, ch 18, sc in 2d ch from hook, hdc in next ch, dc in next 2 ch, tr in next 7 ch, dc in next 2 ch, hdc in next 2 ch, sc in next ch, (sc, ch 3, sc) in

end ch. On other side of ch, make sc in next ch, hdc in next 3 ch, (dc in next 2 ch, 2 dc in next ch) 3 times, hdc in next 2 ch, sl st in end ch. Fasten off. Make 3 Leaves. *Stem*—Ch 14, sk 1 ch, sc in next 13 ch. Fasten off. Sew 3 leaves to one end of stem. *Cherry Stems*—Starting at top Cherry, with Shd. Green ch 30, sk 1 ch, sl st in next 29 ch. Fasten off. *2d Cherry*—Ch 35, sk 1 ch, sl st in next 34 ch. Fasten off. *3d Cherry*—Repeat 1st stem. *4th & 5th Cherries*—Start with 38 ch for each stem. *6th Cherry*—Start with 23 ch. *7th Cherry*—Start with 29 ch. Gather stems tog. under leaves and arrange as in illustration, with a Cherry at outer end of each stem. Sew in place on Pocket. Sew sides and bottom of Pocket down on lower left corner of Doily $\frac{3}{8}$ inch from edge. Tack top edge down between scallops, forming 3 pockets for table silver.

Stretch and pin doily right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

Tie—Cut 4 strands of Scarlet 60 inches long, twist tightly, double and twist in opposite direction, making a 26 inch cord. Tie a knot 1 inch from each end and fringe ends. Tack center of cord to center of right end of doily. With silver in pockets, roll doily and tie cord around it in a bowknot.

Repeat from * to * along opposite side of ch. Ch 2, join with sl st in 5th st of next ch-7. *2d rnd*—Ch 7, turn, a dc, ch 2, dc shell in 1st ch-2 sp, * a shell in each of next 2 sps, ch 2, tr in next tr, ch 2, a shell in each of next 2 sps, (a shell in next shell) 26 times, a shell in next sp, ch 2, * tr in next (corner) tr, ch 2, a shell in next sp. Repeat from * to *, join to 5th st of 1st ch-7. *3d rnd*—Ch 8, turn, dc in next ch-2 sp, * (a shell in next shell) repeated across thru 2d sp before next corner tr, dc in next sp, ch 3, ** tr in next tr, ch 3, dc in next sp. Repeat from * around, ending at **, join to 5th st of 1st ch-8. *4th rnd*—Ch 7, turn, (a shell in 1st sp, a shell in each sp across side, ch 2, tr in corner tr, ch 2) repeated around, ch 2, join to 5th st of 1st ch-7. *5th & 6th rnds*—Repeat 4th rnd twice. Repeat 3d rnd once and 4th rnd 3 times in order, until Yellow is nearly used up or work is 10 inches wide stretched. Fasten off. Turn, join Lt. Green and continue until Green border is 1¼ inches wide. Fasten off.

FLOWER—(With Scarlet and No. 10 hook, ch 6. * 4 dc in 5th ch from hook, remove hook, insert it back in top ch preceding 4 dc, catch lp and pull thru (popcorn st made), ch 4, sl st at base of pc st, sl st in next ch (center st of flower), ch 5 and repeat from * thru 4 petals. Fasten off. Make 6 Flowers.

LONG LEAF SPRAY—With Green SKY-TONE and No. 10 hook, * ch 20, sk 1st ch, sc in next 2 ch, hdc in next ch, dc in next 5 ch, hdc in next ch, sl st in next 2 ch. ** Repeat from * twice. Ch 16 and make another leaf, sl st in next 4 ch sts, (ch 12, make a leaf, sk opposite leaf, sc in 8 ch between leaves) 3 times to end of stem. Fasten off. Make 8.

SHORT LEAF SPRAY—With Green SKY-TONE repeat from * to **. Ch 16, make a leaf, sl st in next 4 ch sts, ch 12, make a leaf, sk opposite leaf, sc in 8 ch of stem. Fasten off. Make 4.

Sew Flowers and Leaves around inner edge of Green Border:—Sew a flower and 2 Long Leaf Sprays on each corner, and a Flower and 2 Short Leaf Sprays on center of each long side, as in illustration. With Yellow Floss, make a large French Knot in center of each Flower.

Stretch and pin Doily right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

"FORGET-ME-NOT SWIRL" DOILY SET No. 9 - Illustration on Back Cover

MATERIALS REQUIRED:

DAISY Mercerized Crochet Cotton, Art. 65:—
 3 skeins White and
 5 skeins Med. Blue size 30; or
 DAISY Mercerized Crochet Cotton, Art. 97:—
 4 balls White and
 7 balls Med. Blue size 30; or
 Lily MERCROCHET Cotton, Art. 161:—
 4 balls White and
 7 balls Med. Blue size 30; and
 Lily Six Strand Floss:—
 16 skeins Dp. Yellow (sufficient for 4 Place Mats, 4 Bread and Butter Plate Doilies and 4 Glass Doilies).
 Steel crochet hook No. 13.

PLACE MAT—(Size:—Approximately 15 inches).

Starting in center with White, ch 9, join with sl st to form ring. *1st rnd*—Ch 1, 14 sc in ring, join with sc in 1st sc. *2d rnd*—Ch 5, dc in next sc, (ch 4, tr in next sc) twice, (ch 4, dtr in next sc) twice, (ch 4, tr tr in next sc) 6 times, (ch 4, a long tr in next sc) twice. To make a long tr, thread over 5 times, insert hook in next sc, thread over and draw thru sc, (thread over and draw thru 2 lps on hook) 6 times. Drop this thread, but do not cut. *2d Thread*—Join a 2d ball of thread to next sc, 3 sc and 3 hdc in next ch-5 sp, dc in next dc, (5 dc in next sp, dc in next st) 11 times. Drop this thread. *1st Thread*—Pick up 1st Thread, ch 4, a long tr in 1st sc on next ch-5 sp, (ch 4, a long tr in next st) twice, (ch 4, sk 1 dc, a long tr in next dc) 17 times. (Mark last long tr with a small safety pin to help in counting). (Ch 4, sk 2 dc, a long tr in next dc, ch 4, sk 1 dc, a long tr in next dc) 6 times. (Mark final long tr with pin). Drop this thread. *2d Thread*—* (4 dc in next sp, dc in next long tr) repeated around to 2d long tr from end of last row. Drop this thread. * *1st Thread*—(Ch 4, sk 2 dc, a long tr in next dc) 27 times. (Mark final long tr). (Ch 4, sk 3 dc, a long tr in next dc, ch 4, sk 2 dc, a long tr in next dc) 12 times. (Mark final long tr). Drop this thread. *2d Thread*—Repeat from * to *. *1st Thread*—**** (Ch 4, sk 3 dc, a long tr in next dc, ch 4, sk 2 dc, a long tr in next dc) 35 times. (Mark final long tr). Drop this thread. *2d Thread*—Repeat from * to *. *1st Thread*—*** (Ch 4, sk 3 dc, a long tr in next dc) 90 times around to 2d dc from end of last row. (Mark final long tr). Drop this thread. *2d Thread*—Repeat from * to *. *1st Thread*—(Ch 4, sk 3 dc, a long tr in next dc) 100 times. (Mark final long tr). Drop this thread. *2d Thread*—Repeat from * to *. *1st Thread*—** Ch 4, sk 4 dc, a long tr in next dc, (ch 4, sk 3 dc, a long tr in next dc) twice. ** Repeat from * to * around to 6th dc from end of last row. (Mark final long tr). Drop this thread. *2d Thread*—Repeat from * to *. *1st Thread*—Repeat from ** to ** around to 12th dc

from end of last row. (Mark final long tr). Drop this thread. *2d Thread*—Repeat from * to *. *1st Thread*—Repeat from ** to ** around to 13th dc from end of last row. (Mark final long tr). Drop this thread. *2d Thread*—Repeat from * to *. *1st Thread*—Repeat from ** to ** 6 times. (Mark final long tr). (Ch 4, sk 4 dc, a long tr in next dc, ch 4, sk 3 dc, a long tr in next dc) 46 times. Fasten off this thread. *2d Thread*—(4 dc in next sp, dc in next long tr) repeated around last row, 5 dc in end long tr, 12 dc over bar of same long tr, sk next 2 dc in row below, sl st in next dc. Fasten off.

FLOWER BRAID—With Blue, ch 8, join with sl st to form ring. (Ch 3, 2 dc in ring, ch 3, sc in ring) 4 times, ch 3, holding back the last lp of each dc on hook, make 3 dc in ring, thread over and draw thru all 4 lps on hook (Cluster made). *2d FLOWER*—Ch 9, hdc in 6th ch from hook, drawn down tightly, forming a ring, ch 3, 2 dc in ring, ch 3, sc in ring, ch 3, dc in ring, sl st in top st of 3 ch between flowers, turn work around in a counter-clockwise direction, keeping same side facing and keeping hook on side facing, so that uncompleted flower is to left and previous flower is to right. Ch 3, sc in ring, (ch 3, 2 dc in ring, ch 3, sc in ring) twice, ch 3, a 3-dc Cluster in balance of ring for 5th petal. Continue as for 2d Flower for required length. Sew 1st Flower on ring in center of doily, then sew Braid around and around on dc-row out to end of spiral and across end of last row. With Yellow Floss make a large French Knot in center of each Flower.

BREAD AND BUTTER PLATE DOILY—(Size:—Approximately 7 inches).—Repeat to ***. (Ch 4, sk 3 dc, a long tr in next dc) 23 times. Fasten off. Work dc-row around and end as for Place Mat. Repeat Braid.

GLASS DOILY—(Size:—Approximately 5 inches).—Repeat to ****. (Ch 4, sk 3 dc, a long tr in next dc, ch 4, sk 2 dc, a long tr in next dc) 7 times. Fasten off. Work dc-row around and end as for Place Mat. Repeat Braid.

Stretch and pin doilies right-side-down in true circle. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

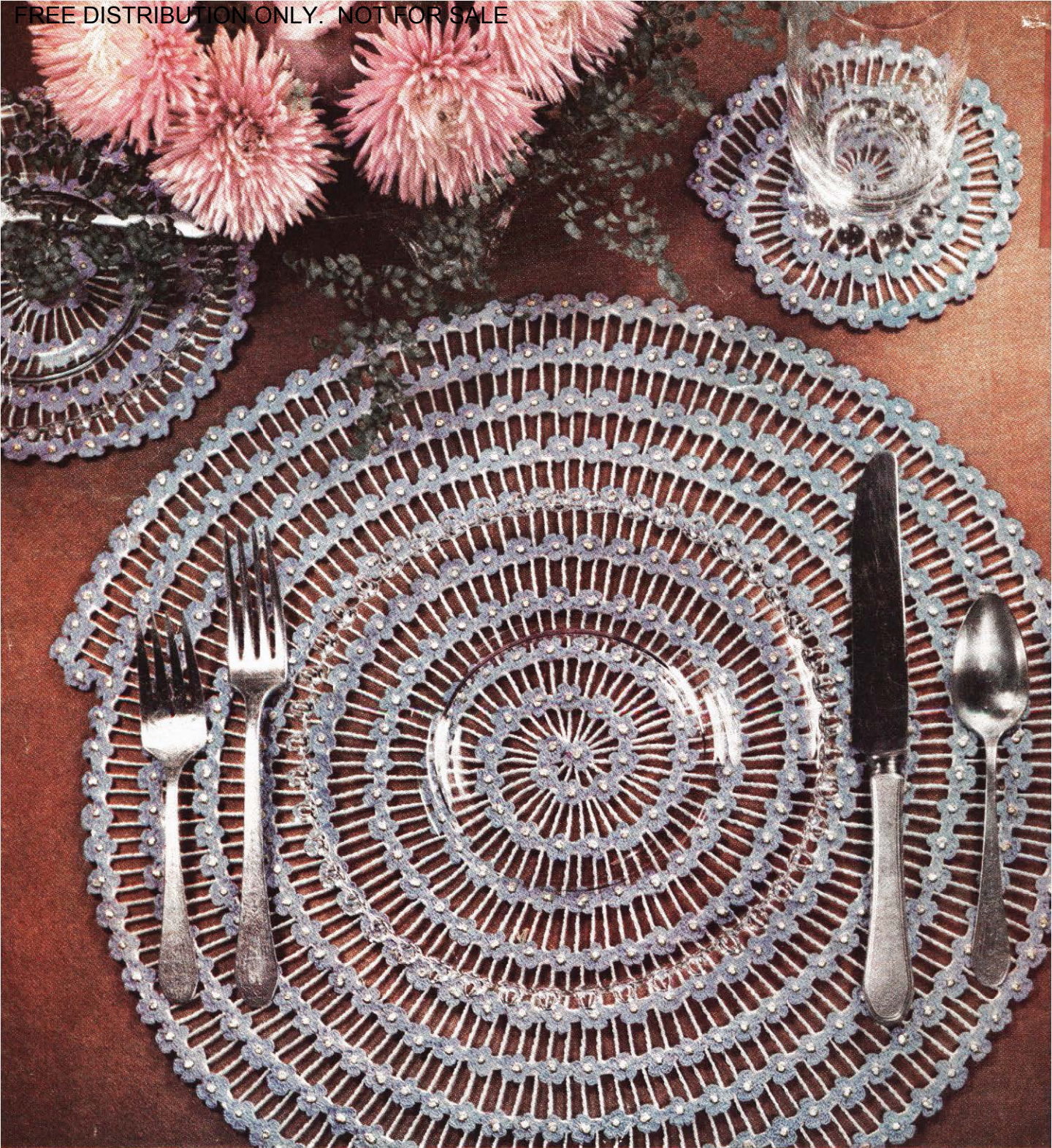
turn, sk tr, sl st across to 2d dc, ch 4, dc in next dc, 1 sp. 3 blks and follow Chart across. Follow Chart thru Row 108. In Rows 105 thru 108, ch 1, turn, sl st across to proper place to start each row.

EDGE—Ch 3 and work dc around doily, putting 2 dc in each ch-2 sp, 3 dc in each ch-4 sp and 1 dc in each st between sps. Join to top of ch-3. *2d rnd*—Ch 1, (sc in 12 dc, ch 5, sl st in last sc for a p) repeated around, join and fasten off. Stretch and pin doily right-side-down in a true circle. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.
