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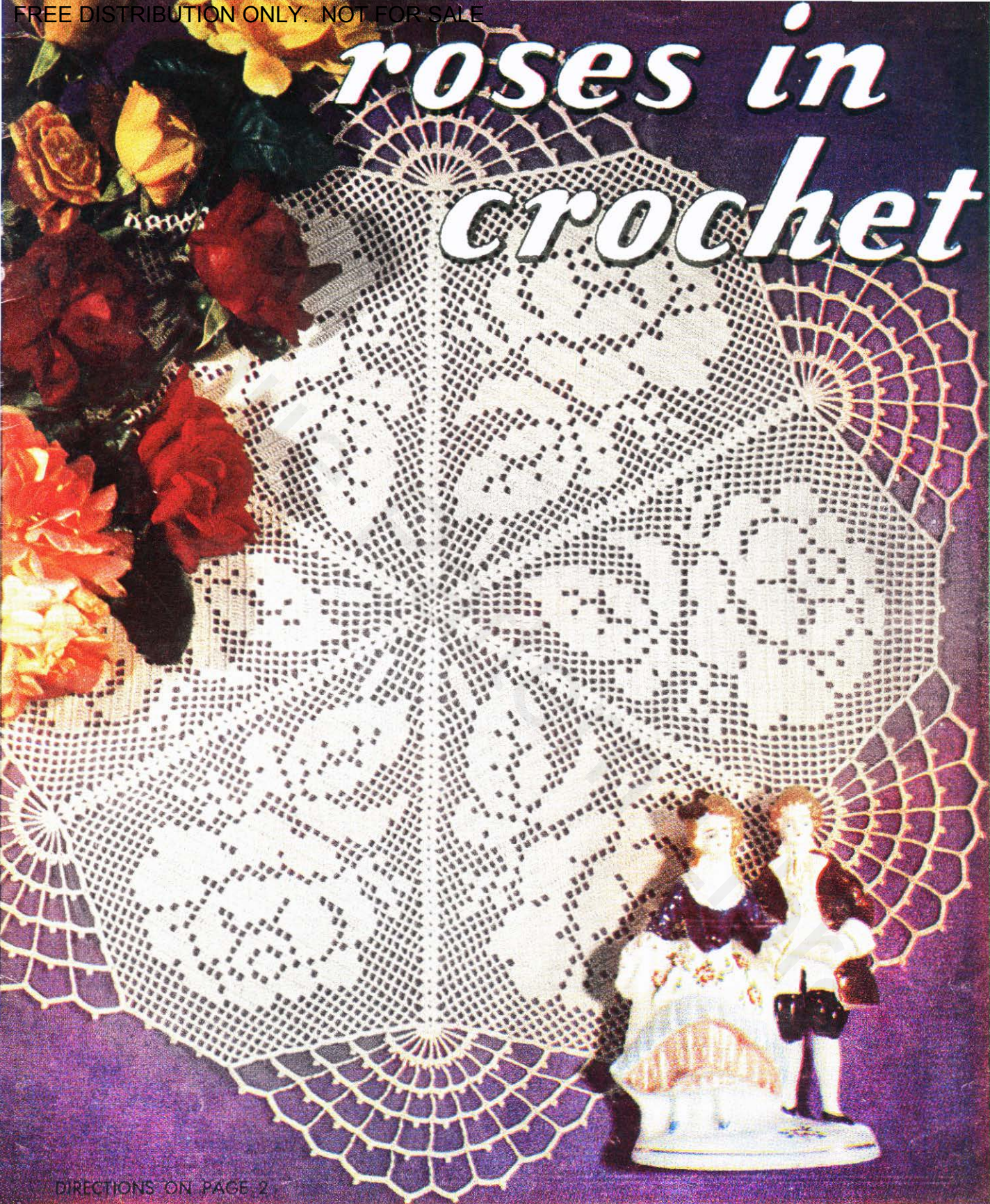

DIRECTIONS ON PAGE 2.

Hexagon Filet Doily — — — — No. 1

MATERIALS REQUIRED:

DAISY Mercerized Crochet Cotton, Art. 65:—

3 skeins Ecrú, size 20.

or

2 skeins Ecrú, size 30;

or

Lily MERCROCHET Cotton, Art. 161:—

2 balls of Ecrú, size 20;

and

No. 12 Steel Crochet Hook with Size 20, No. 13 with Size 30.

CHART ON PAGE 11

SIZE: — 21 inches in Size 20, 19 inches in Size 30.

Starting in center ch 7, dc in 6th ch from hook, (ch 2, dc in same st) 4 times, ch 1, join with hdc in 3d st of ch-5. Mark the right side of this rnd as right side of doily.

RND 2—Ch 5, turn, (in next ch-2 sp make dc, ch 2, dc; ch 2) 5 times, dc in next sp, ch 1, join with hdc in 3d st of 1st ch-5.

RND 3—Ch 3, turn, dc in 1st ch-1 sp, (ch 2, dc in next sp, ch 2, in next sp make a shell of 2 dc, ch 2 and 2 dc) 5 times, ch 2, dc in next sp, ch 2, 2 dc in next sp, ch 1, join with hdc in top of 1st ch-3.

RND 4—Ch 3, turn, 2 dc in 1st ch-1 sp (half-shell made), (ch 2, sk 1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 2, in center sp of next shell make a shell of 3 dc, ch 2 and 3 dc) 5 times, ch 2, sk 1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 2, complete 1st shell with 3 dc, ch 1, hdc in top of 1st ch-3.

RND 5—Ch 3, turn, 2 dc in 1st ch-1 sp, * ch 2, sk 2 dc of shell, dc in next dc, (ch 2, dc in next dc) twice, ch 2, ** make a 3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc shell in next shell, repeat from * 4 times and from * to ** again; end with 3 dc in next shell, ch 1, join with hdc in 1st ch-3. End all future rnds in this way.

RND 6—Ch 3, turn, 2 dc in 1st ch-1 sp, * ch 2, sk 2 dc of shell, dc in next dc, (ch 2, dc in next dc) 4 times, ch 2, ** a shell in next shell. Repeat from * 4 times and from * to ** again, end as in last rnd.

RND 7—Ch 3, turn, 2 dc in 1st ch-1 sp, * ch 2, sk next sp, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next sp, dc in next dc (1 blk made), (ch 2, dc in next dc) 3 times (3 sps made), ch 2, ** a shell in next shell, repeat from * 4 times and from * to ** again, end as in last rnd.

RND 8—Repeat Rnd 7 to *. * Ch 2, sk 2 dc of shell, dc in next dc, (ch 2, dc in next dc) 3 times, ch 2, dc in next

4 dc, ch 2, dc in 1st dc of next shell, ch 2, ** a shell in same shell. Repeat from * 4 times and from * to ** again, end as in last rnds.

RND 9—Repeat Row 7 to *. * Ch 2, sk next sp, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in next 4 dc, (ch 2, dc in next dc) 4 times, ch 2, ** a shell in next shell, repeat from * 4 times and from * to ** again, end as in last rnds.

RND 10—Repeat Row 7 to *. * Ch 2, sk 2 dc of shell, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next sp, dc in next dc, (ch 2, dc in next dc) twice, ch 2, dc in next 4 dc, (ch 2, dc in next dc) twice, ch 2, ** a shell in next shell, repeat from * 4 times and from * to ** again, end as in last rnds. Continue, following chart, turning each rnd, thru Rnd 37.

POINT: ROW 1—Ch 4, turn, * sk 2 dc of shell, dc in next dc, 8 sps, 3 blks, 1 sp, 3 blks, 4 sps, 5 blks, 1 sp, 6 blks, 9 sps, dc in center of next shell.

ROW 2—Ch 4, turn, sk 1st sp, dc in next dc, 8 sps, 6 blks, 1 sp, (1 blk, 2 sps) twice, 3 blks, 1 sp, 1 blk, 1 sp, 4 blks, 7 sps, dc in next dc. Continue as in Chart for 13 more rows (thru Row 15). Fasten off. Without turning attach to a shell on Rnd 37, ch 4 and repeat from * in Row 1 across each section.

BORDER—With right-side-facing, attach to 1st dc on last row of one section, * (3 sc in each of next 3 sps, ch 5, sl st in last sc for a p) 3 times, (3 sc in next sp) 3 times, (4 sc in next sp) 15 times, sc in shell (mark this sc with a pin), (4 sc in next sp) 3 times.

Fan—Ch 2, turn, tr tr in marked sc, (ch 2, tr tr in same sc) 8 times, ch 2, sk 11 sc, sl st in next sc.

ROW 2—Ch 1, turn, (sc, p, sc) in each ch-2 sp, sc in each tr tr. (4 sc in next sp on Point) 3 times.

ROW 3—Ch 5, turn, dtr between 1st 2 ps, (ch 5, dtr between next 2 ps) 8 times, ch 5, sk 11 sc, sl st in next sc.

ROW 4—Ch 1, turn, (3 sc, p, 3 sc) in each ch-5 sp, sc in each dtr. (4 sc in next sp on Point) 3 times.

ROW 5—Repeat Row 3 but with ch-8 sps.

ROW 6—Repeat Row 4 but with (5 sc, p, 5 sc) in each ch-8 sp.

ROW 7—Repeat Row 3 but with ch-11 sps.

ROW 8—Repeat Row 4 but with (6 sc, p, 6 sc) in each ch-11 sp.

ROW 9—Repeat Row 3 but with ch-14 sps.

ROW 10—Ch 1, turn, (8 sc, p, 8 sc) in each sp, sc in each dtr. Repeat from * around doily, join and fasten off.

Stretch and pin doily right-side-down in a true circle.

Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

Rose Bud Buffet Set ----- No. 2

MATERIALS REQUIRED:

DAISY Mercerized Crochet Cotton, Art. 65:
1 skein each White, Emerald Green, Yellow and Shd. Yellows, Size 20;

or

SKY-TONE Mercerized Crochet Cotton, Art. 123:—
1 ball each White, Emerald Green, Yellow and Shd. Yellows;

and

No. 10 or No. 12 Steel Crochet Hooks.

LARGE DOILY—(Size — 18 inches): Starting in center with White SKY-TONE and No. 10 hook ch 8, join with sl st to form ring.

1st RND—Ch 6, (dc in ring, ch 3) 7 times, join to 3d st of ch-6.

2d RND—Ch 3, 2 dc in same place, (3 dc in next sp, 3 dc in next dc) repeated around, join to ch-3, sl st in next dc.

3d RND—Ch 6, dc in same dc, (ch 4, sk 5 dc, in next dc make dc, ch 3, dc) 7 times, ch 4, join to 3d st of ch-6.

4th RND—Ch 3, (5 dc in next sp, dc in next dc, 4 dc in next sp, dc in next dc) repeated around, join to ch-3, sl st in next 2 dc.

5th RND—Ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, * ch 7, sk 1 dc, holding back the last lp of each dtr on hook, make dtr in next dc, sk 4 dc, dtr in next dc, thread over and draw thru all 3 lps on hook (Cluster made), ch 7, sk 1 dc, dc in next 3 dc; repeat from * around, join to ch-3, sl st in next dc.

6th RND—Ch 3, * (dc in next dc, dc in next sp) made into a Cluster, 7 dc in bal. of sp, ch 5, 7 dc in next sp, (dc in same sp, dc in next dc) made into a Cluster, dc in next dc; repeat from * around, end with 2-dc Cluster, join to ch-3.

7th RND—Ch 3, dc in next Cluster, * ch 9, sk 7 dc, in center st of next ch-5 lp make dc, ch 5, dc; ch 9, sk 7 dc, dc in next 3 dc; repeat from * around, end with 1 dc, join to ch-3.

8th RND—Ch 3, * (dc in next dc, dc in next sp) made into a Cluster, 8 dc in bal. of sp, dc in next dc, in next sp make 2 dc, 3 dc in center st and 2 dc; dc in next dc, 8 dc in next sp, (dc in same sp, dc in next dc) made into a Cluster, dc in next dc; repeat from * around; end with 2-dc Cluster, join to ch-3.

9th RND—Ch 3, dc in next dc, (ch 15, sk 12 dc, sc in next dc, ch 15, sk 12 dc, dc in next 3 dc) repeated around; end with 1 dc, join to ch-3.

10th RND—Ch 3, * (dc in next dc, dc in next sp) made into a Cluster, 10 dc in $\frac{3}{4}$'s of same sp, ch 6, sl st in 1 lp of 4th ch from hook for a p, ch 3, dc in next sc, ch 6, p, ch 3, 10 dc in left $\frac{3}{4}$'s of next sp, (dc in same sp, dc in next dc) made into a Cluster, dc in next dc; repeat from * around; end with Cluster, join to ch-3.

11th RND—Ch 3, dc in next dc, * ch 12, sk 9 dc, sc in end dc, ch 6, p, ch 3, in dc between p-lps make tr, ch 6, p, ch 3 and tr; ch 6, p, ch 3, sc in next dc, ch 12, sk 9 dc, dc in next 3 dc; repeat from * around; end with 1 dc, join to ch-3.

12th RND—Ch 3, * (dc in next dc, 2 dc in next sp) made into a Cluster, 6 dc in $\frac{2}{3}$ 'ds of same sp, ch 7, p, ch 4, tr in next tr, ch 6, p, ch 8, p, ch 3, tr in next tr, ch 7, p, ch 4, 6 dc in left $\frac{2}{3}$ 'ds of next sp, (2 dc in same sp, dc in next dc) made into a Cluster, dc in next dc; repeat from * around; end with 3-dc Cluster, join to ch-3.

13th RND—Ch 5, tr in next dc, * ch 4, sk 5 dc, tr in end dc, ch 7, p, ch 4, tr in next tr, ch 7, p, ch 4, in center st of next p-lp make tr, ch 6, p, ch 3 and tr; ch 7, p, ch 4, tr in next tr, ch 7, p, ch 4, tr in next dc, ch 4, sk 5 dc, tr in next 3 dc; repeat from * around; end with 1 tr, join to ch-5.

14th RND—Ch 5, 2 tr in same place, * 2 tr in next tr, sk ch-5, sl st in next tr, ch 12, p, ch 4, tr in next tr, ch 7, p, ch 4, tr in next tr, ch 6, p, ch 8, p, ch 3, tr in next tr, ch 7, p, ch 4, tr in next tr, ch 7, p, ch 9, sl st in next tr, 2 tr down in next tr, 3 tr in next tr; repeat from * around,

15th RND—Ch 5, (tr in next 2 tr made into a Cluster) twice, * sl st in 5th st of next p-lp, ch 12, p, ch 4, tr in next tr, ch 7, p, ch 4, tr in next tr, ch 7, p, ch 4, in center st of next p-lp make tr, ch 6, p, ch 8, p, ch 3 and tr; (ch 7, p, ch 4, tr in next tr) twice, ch 7, p, ch 9, sl st in 5th ch to left of next p, tr in next 2 tr made into a Cluster, tr in next 3 tr made into a Cluster, tr in next 2 tr made into a Cluster; repeat from * around, join to 1st Cluster.

16th RND—Ch 5, tr in next Cluster, sl st in 5th st of next p-lp, ch 12, p, ch 4, tr in next tr, (ch 7, p, ch 4, tr in next tr) twice, * ch 7, p, ch 4, in center st of next p-lp make tr, ch 6, p, ch 8, p, ch 3 and tr; (ch 7, p, ch 4, tr in next tr) 3 times, ch 7, p, ch 9, sl st in 5th st past next p, ** tr in next 3 Clusters made into a Cluster, sl st in 5th st of next p-lp, ch 4, remove hook from lp, insert it back in 5th st up previous p-lp, catch lp and draw thru (joining-sl st made), (ch 7, p, ch 4, tr in next tr) 3 times; repeat from * around, ending at **: tr down in next tr, sk ch-5, join to next tr, sl st in next 5 ch, make a joining-sl st back in 5th st up previous p-lp.

17th RND—Ch 7, tr in same st, (ch 2, tr) 3 times in same st, * (ch 7, p, ch 4, tr in next tr) 4 times, ch 7, p, ch 4, in center st of next p-lp make tr, ch 6, p, ch 8, p, ch 3 and tr; (ch 7, p, ch 4, tr in next tr) 4 times, ch 7, p, ch 4, tr between next 2 p-lps, (ch 2, tr) 4 times in same place; repeat from * around, join to 5th st of ch-7.

18th RND—Ch 11, p, ch 3, tr in next tr, (ch 6, p, ch 3, tr in next tr) 3 times. * (ch 7, p, ch 4, tr in next tr) 5 times, ch 7, p, ch 4, in center st of next p-lp make tr, ch 6, p, ch 8, p, ch 3 and tr; (ch 7, p, ch 4, tr in next tr) 6 times, (ch 6, p, ch 3, tr in next tr) 4 times; repeat from * around, join to 5th st of 1st p-lp.

19th RND—Ch 12, p, ch 4, tr in next tr, (ch 7, p, ch 4, tr in next tr) repeated around with an extra lp of tr, ch 6, p, ch 8, p, ch 3 and tr added on each point as in previous rnds; join to 5th st of 1st p-lp. Fasten off.

20th RND—Attach Emerald Green to any tr, ch 3, 2 dc in same tr, * (ch 7, p, ch 4, 3 dc in next tr) repeated to center st at next point, ch 7, p, ch 4, 3 dc in same st; repeat from * around; join to ch-3. Fasten off.

ROSE-BUD: 1st Petal Group—With Yellow SKY-TONE ch 7, join with sl st to form ring. Ch 3, 15 dc in ring, join to ch-3.

Petal—(Ch 4, sc in same st, ch 4, sc in next st) 3 times, ch 4, sc in same st (7 lps).

ROW 2—Ch 4, turn, sc in 1st lp, (ch 2, sc in next lp) 6 times. Repeat Row 2 four times (thru Row 6).

ROW 7—Ch 4, turn, sc in 1st lp, (ch 2, sc in next lp) 5 times, ch 1, hdc in end lp.

ROW 8—Ch 3, turn, sc in next ch-2 lp, (ch 2, sc in next lp) repeated across to 2d lp from end, ch 1, hdc in end lp. Repeat Row 8 twice (thru Row 10, - 4 lps left). Cut, leaving a 1-inch end.

2nd Petal—(Turn, attach to next st on center and repeat 1st Petal) 3 times (4 petals made).

Edge—With same side facing, attach to center between any 2 petals, * work sc up side of next petal to top, sc and 2 hdc in 1st lp in Row 10, 3 dc in next lp, dc in next sc, ch 2, sl st in last dc for a p, 3 dc in next lp, 2 hdc and 1 sc in next lp, work sc down side of petal, sl st in center between petals; repeat from * around petals; fasten off.

2d Petal Group—With Shd. Yellows SKY-TONE, ch 6, join with sl st to form ring. Ch 2, 11 hdc in ring, join to ch-2.

* Repeat Petals of 1st Group thru 3 petals; repeat Edge. *

3d Petal Group—With Shd. Yellows SKY-TONE, ch 7, join with sl st to form ring. Ch 1, 12 sc in ring, join to 1st sc. Repeat 2d Petal Group from * to *. Lap petals tightly, tuck into a tube for center of bud, sew on top of 2d Group, tacking those petals up around bud center. Sew on top of 1st Group, tacking petals into a bud shape.

Make 8 Roses
STEM AND CALYX—With Green, ch 35, sc in 2d ch from hook, hdc in next 29 ch, dc in next 3 ch, (2 dc in end ch) made into a Cluster, * Ch 10, sk 1 ch, sc in next 4 ch, hdc in next ch, dc in next 3 ch, sl st in end ch, ** sc in bar of end dc of stem, repeat from * twice. Fasten off. Sew one on base of each Rose.

LEAF—With Green, ch 6, sk 1 ch, sc in next 4 ch, 3 sc in



end ch, sc in next 3 sts on other side of ch. Work all following rows in back lps only.

ROW 2—Ch 3, turn, sc in 1st 4 sc, 3 sc in next (center) sc, sc in next 4 sc.

ROW 3—Ch 3, turn, sc in 1st 5 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc.

ROW 4—Ch 3, turn, sc in 1st 6 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc.

ROW 5—Ch 3, turn, sc in 1st 7 sc, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 6 sc. Repeat Row 5 six times (thru Row

Rose Doily in Crocheted Tatting ——— No. 3

MATERIALS REQUIRED:

DAISY—Mercerized Crochet Cotton, Art. 65 (skeins)

1 skein Lt. Blue
and
1 skein Lt. Yellow.

Size 30:—

or

Lily MERCROCHET Cotton, Art. 161:—

2 balls Baby Blue and 1 ball Yellow, Size 20:—

No. 13 Steel Crochet Hook.

Size — 16 inches.

RING (R)—To form a Ring in Crocheted Tatting, make a chain of specified length marking one st with a pin as directed.

(**EXAMPLE—Ch 38 marking 26th st with a pin**). To do this ch 27 (one more st than the one to be marked). Put a pin in 2d ch form hook (the 26th st of ch),—pressing it down to the head. Continue the chain, counting from 28 thru 38. Remove hook from lp, remove pin, insert hook in marked ch st (the pin enlarges the st so it can be seen easily), catch lp at end of ch and draw thru to form a Ring out to left of chain.

CENTER ROSE—Starting in center with Lt. Blue ch 11, join with sl st to form a circle. Ch 1, 3 sc in circle, ch 3, sl st in last sc for a p, (2 sc in circle, p) 6 times, sc in circle, join with sl st in 1st sc, ch 1, hdc in same st for final p (8 ps).

RND 2—Ch 1, turn, sc in p, (ch 3, sc in next p) 7 times, ch 3, sl st in 1st sc.

RND 3—Ch 1, turn, sc in same st with sl st, (3 sc in next sp, sc in next sc) 7 times, 3 sc in next sp, sl st in 1st sc.

RND 4—Ch 1, turn, sc in same st, (ch 5, sc in next sc between lps) 7 times, ch 5, sl st in 1st sc.

RND 5—Ch 1, turn, sc in same st, (6 sc in next sp, sc in next sc) repeated around, join to 1st sc. Repeat Rnds 4 and 5 with these increases:

RNDS 6-7—Make 7-ch lps. 8 sc in each lp.

RNDS 8-9—9 ch lps. 10 sc in each.

RNDS 10-11—11-ch lps. 12 sc in each.

RNDS 12-13—13-ch lps. 15 sc in each.

RNDS 14-15—15-ch lps. 18 sc in each.

RNDS 16-17—17-ch lps. 21 sc in each.

RNDS 18-19—19-ch lps. 23 sc in each.

RNDS 20-21—21-ch lps. 25 sc in each.

RNDS 22-23—23-ch lps. 28 sc in each.

RNDS 24-25—26-ch lps. 31 sc in each.

RNDS 26-27—29-ch lps. 34 sc in each.

RNDS 28-29—32-ch lps. 37 sc in each.

RNDS 30-31—35-ch lps. 40 sc in each.

RND 32—38-ch lps.

RND 33—Ch 1, turn, sc in same st, * in next lp make (7 sc, ch 4, sl st in last sc for a p) 5 times and 7 sc; sc in next sc; repeat from * around, join to 1st sc. Fasten off.

SMALL ROSE—Center—Ch 10, join with sl st to form circle. Ch 3, 23 dc in circle, join to ch-3. Fasten off.

Petal—Ch 13, form a Ring (see directions above) in 13th ch from hook, ch 1, in R make (4 sc, ch 3, sl st in last sc for a p) 3 times and 4 sc; sl st in base of R.

RND 2—Ch 5, turn, sc in 1st p, (ch 5, sc in next p) twice, ch 5, sl st in base of R.

RND 3—Ch 1, turn, sc in same st, (7 sc in next sp, sc in next sc, a ch-3 p) 3 times, 7 sc in next sp, join with sl st in 1st sc.

RND 4—Ch 1, turn, sc in same st, (ch 9, sc in next p) 3 times, ch 9, sl st in 1st sc.

RND 5—Ch 1, turn, sc in same st, (12 sc in next sp, sc in next sc, a ch-3 p) 3 times, 12 sc in next sp, sl st in 1st sc, sl st in 1 dc on Center. Fasten off. Make 5 more petals, joining one to every 4th dc around Center.

Stamens—With Lt. Yellow ch 6, join with sl st to form circle. Ch 1, sc in ring, * draw out lp on hook $\frac{1}{4}$ inch long, insert hook in single back strand of long lp, thread over and draw thru, thread over and draw thru 2 lps on hook (Knot St made). Make another Knot St, sc in circle. Repeat from * 9 times. Fasten off. Sew in center of Small Rose. Make 8 Small Roses.

BORDER—Work around Center Rose from left-to-right.

RND 1—With Lt. Blue ch 13, form a R in 13th ch from hook, ch 1, in half of R make 4 sc, a ch-4 p, 4 sc keeping lp on hook, insert hook in center p on one section of Center Rose, thread over and draw thru p and lp on hook (joining-sl st made). Always make joinings in this way,—without removing hook from lp. In bal. of R make 4 sc, p, 4 sc; sl st in base of R. Mark this R with a safety pin. * Ch 38 marking 26th st with a pin, R in marked st, ch 1, (4 sc, p, 4 sc) in half of R, sk 1 p to right on Center Rose, join to next p, (4 sc, p, 4 sc) in bal. of R, sl st in base of R. Repeat from * around, joining a R to 1st, 3d and 5th ps on each section of Center Rose (24 Rs). Ch 25, join to 1st R.

RND 2—Work from right-to-left. Ch 1, in each lp around make (8 sc, p) 3 times and 8 sc. Join and fasten off.

RND 3—Repeat Rnd 1 of Border, joining 1st R to center p on lp to left of marked R, then join a R to center p on each lp around.

RND 4—Work from right-to-left. Ch 1, * (8 sc, p, 8 sc) in half of next lp, join to center p on 1 petal of a Small Rose, (8 sc, p, 8 sc) in bal. of lp, (8 sc, p, 8 sc) in half of next lp, join to next petal on same Small Rose, (8 sc, p, 8 sc) in bal. of lp, (8 sc, p, 8 sc) in half of next lp, ch 18, R in 18th ch from hook, ch 1, in R make 5 sc, p, (3 sc, p) 4 times and 5 sc; sl st in base of R; (8 sc, p, 8 sc) in bal. of lp; repeat from * around, join and fasten off.

FILL-IN MOTIF—Attach to 2d p to left of R between any 2 Roses, ch 23 marking 6th ch, R in marked st, ch 1, 6 sc in R, join to next p to right, 6 sc in R, join to 1st p on next R, (6 sc, p, 6 sc) in bal. of R, sl st in base of R, * ch 32 marking 15th ch, R in marked st, ch 1, 6 sc in R, join to last p on last R, 6 sc in R, join to next p on next R, 6 sc in R, ** p, 6 sc in R, sl st in base of R. Repeat from * twice and from * to ** again, join to next p on last Rnd, 6 sc in bal. of R, sl st in base of R, ch 5, join to next p on last Rnd.

RND 2—Ch 1, 6 sc in 1st ch-5 sp, (in next lp make 9 sc, p, 9 sc) 4 times, 6 sc in next sp, sl st in p. Fasten off. Repeat between all Roses.

EDGE—Attach to 1st free petal on one Rose, * (ch 22, sc in next petal) 3 times, ch 10, sc in 2d p on Fill-in Motif, ch 18, sc in next p, ch 10, sc in 1st free petal on next Rose. Repeat from * around, join.

RND 2—* In each of next 3 lps make (8 sc, p) 3 times and 8 sc; (6 sc, p, 6 sc) in next sp, in next lp make (6 sc, p) 3 times and 6 sc; (6 sc, p, 6 sc) in next sp. Repeat from * around, join and fasten off.

Wind Lt. Pink into 3 balls. Starting in center with one ball ch 7, join with sl st to form ring. Ch 3, 19 dc in ring, join to ch-3.

NEXT RND—Ch 8, sc in next dc, ch 10, sc in next dc, ch 12, sc in next dc, ch 14, sk 1 dc, sc in next dc, (ch 7, sl st in 4th ch from hook for a p, ch 10, p, ch 4, sk 1 dc, sc in next dc) 3 times, (ch 8, p, ch 11, p, ch 5, sk 1 dc, sc in next dc) 3 times, drop but do not cut. Attach 2d Ball to next dc, (ch 4, sc in next lp) 3 times, ch 6, sc in next lp, ch 8, sc in next lp, (ch 9, sc in next lp) 5 times and drop. Attach 3d Ball to same dc where 2d Ball was attached, 5 sc in next sp, sc in next sc, 4 hdc in next sp, hdc in next sc, 4 dc in next sp, dc in next sc, 6 dc in next sp, dc in next sc, (9 dc in next sp, dc in next sc) 5 times (ending 1 sp short of end of last Ball).

2d RND: 1st Ball—Pick up 1st Ball, (ch 9, p, ch 12, p, ch 6, sk 3 sts, sc in next st) 4 times. Mark end of each repeat section to avoid confusion. (Ch 6, p, ch 6, p, ch 12, p, ch 6, p, ch 3, sk 4 dc, sc in next dc) 4 times, (ch 7, p, ch 7, p, ch 12, p, ch 7, p, ch 4, sk 5 dc, sc in next dc) 6 times, drop.

2d Ball—(Ch 9, sc in next p-lp) 5 times, (ch 10, sc in next lp) 3 times, (ch 11, sc in next lp) 4 times, (ch 12, sc in next lp) twice, drop.

3d Ball—(9 dc in next sp, dc in next sc) 6 times, (10 dc in next sp, dc in sc) 3 times, (11 dc in next sp, dc in sc) 4 times, (12 dc in next sp, dc in sc) twice, drop.

3d RND: 1st Ball—* (Ch 6, p) 3 times, ch 11, p, (ch 6, p) twice, ch 3, ** sk 6 dc, sc in next dc. Repeat from * once. (Repeat from * to **, sk 7 dc, sc in next dc) twice. *** (Ch 6, p) 3 times, ch 12, p, (ch 6, p) twice, ch 3, sk 8 dc, sc in next dc. Repeat from *** once. (Repeat last p-lp, sk 9 dc, sc in next dc) 4 times. (Ch 7, p, ch 6, p, ch 6, p, ch 12, p, ch 6, p, ch 6, p, ch 4, sk 10 dc, sc in next dc) 7 times, drop.

2d Ball—(Ch 13, sc in next lp) 3 times, (ch 14, sc in next lp) twice, (ch 15, sc in next lp) twice, (ch 16, sc in next lp) 10 times, drop.

3d Ball—(13 dc in next sp, dc in sc) 3 times, (14 dc in next sp, dc in sc) twice, (15 dc in next sp, dc in sc) twice, (16 dc in next sp, dc in sc) 10 times, drop.

4th RND: 1st Ball—* Ch 7, p, (ch 6, p) twice, ch 13, p,

(ch 6, p) twice, ch 4, sk 11 dc, sc in next dc. Repeat from * 8 times. ** Ch 8, p, (ch 6, p) twice, ch 13, p, (ch 6, p) twice, ch 5, sk 11 dc, sc in next dc. Repeat from ** 8 times. (Repeat last p-lp increasing center sp to ch-14) 5 times, drop.

2d Ball—(Ch 16, sc in next lp) 23 times, drop.

3d Ball—(16 dc in next sp, dc in sc) 23 times, drop.

5th RND: 1st Ball—* Ch 8, p, (ch 6, p) twice, ch 14, p, (ch 6, p) twice, ch 5, sk 11 dc, sc in next dc. Repeat from * 3 times. Make 9 p-lps increasing to ch-9 at beginning and ch-6 at end. (Inc. to ch-15 in center. Sk 12 dc, sc in next dc) 9 times. Inc. to ch-16 in center for 9 p-lps, drop.

2d Ball—(Ch 16, sc in next lp) 31 times, drop.

3d Ball—(16 dc in next sp, dc in sc) 31 times, drop.

6th RND: 1st Ball—(Repeat last p-lps but inc. to ch-17 in center. Sk 12 dc, sc in next dc) 9 times. Inc. to ch-18 in center for 9 p-lps. * Ch 8, p, (ch 6, p) 3 times, ch 14, p, (ch 6, p) 3 times, ch 5, sk 12 dc, sc in next dc. Repeat from * 4 times. Inc. to ch-15 in center for 5 p-lps. Inc. to ch-16 in center for 5 p-lps. Inc. to ch-9 at beginning and ch-6 at end for 7 p-lps, drop.

2d Ball—(Ch 16, sc in next lp) 40 times, drop.

3d Ball—(16 dc in next sp, dc in sc) 40 times, drop.

7th RND: 1st Ball—* Ch 9, p, (ch 6, p) 3 times, ch 17, p, (ch 6, p) 3 times, ch 6, sk 12 dc, sc in next dc. Repeat from * 19 times. Ch 9, p, (ch 6, p) twice, ch 25, sk 12 dc, sc in next dc. Fasten off.

2d Ball—(Ch 16, sc in next lp) 20 times, ch 17, sc in end lp. Fasten off.

3d Ball—(16 dc in next sp, dc in sc) 20 times, 17 dc in next sp, dc in sc, 25 dc in end sp, sk 3 dc, sl st in next dc. Fasten off.

No. 1 - ROSE—With Shd. Pinks ch 7, join with sl st to form ring. Ch 1, 12 sc in ring, join to 1st sc.

2d RND—(Ch 1, 3 dc in next sc, ch 1, sc in next sc) 6 times. Cut 8 inches long and use to sew rose on center circle of doily. Make 19 more roses, joining into a straight row with a sl st (after center dc on 1 petal) in center dc on a petal in previous rose. Sew on doily from 1st Rose around spiral on dc-row.

No. 2 - ROSE—Repeat except start with ch-8 ring and make 4 dc in each petal. Make 10, join to each other and to last rose in 1st group. Sew around spiral.

No. 3 - ROSE—Start with ch-9 ring and make 5 dc in each petal. Make 10, join to each other and to last rose in 2d group. Sew around spiral.

No. 4 - ROSE—Repeat No. 1 - Rose thru 2d Rnd.

3d RND—(Ch 3 behind petals, sc in back lp of sc between next 2 petals) 5 times, ch 3, sl st in next sc.

4th RND—(Ch 1, in next ch-3 sp make 5 dc, ch 1, sc) 6 times. Cut 8 inches long. Make 12, joining roses in last rnd.

No. 5 - ROSE—Repeat No. 2 - Rose thru 2d Rnd.

3d RND—Make ch-4 lps.

4th RND—Inc. to 6 dc in each petal. Make 12.

No. 6 - ROSE—Repeat No. 3 - Rose thru 2d Rnd.

3d RND—Make ch-4 lps.

4th RND—Inc. to 7 dc in each petal. Make 16.

No. 7 - ROSE—Repeat No. 3 - Rose thru 2d Rnd.

3d RND—Make ch-5 lps.

4th RND—Inc. to 9 dc in each petal. Make 25.

No. 8 - ROSE—Repeat No. 5 - Rose thru 4th Rnd.

5th RND—(Ch 6, sc in back lp of sc between next 2 petals) 5 times, ch 6, sl st in next sc.

6th RND—(Ch 1, in next ch-6 sp make 9 dc, ch 1 and sc) 6 times. Cut 8 inches long. Make and join enough (38 to 40) to complete spiral.

Stretch and pin doily right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

 2 skeins each Rose Pink and Lt. Pink, Size 20;

 2 skeins each Rose Pink and Lt. Pink, Size 30;
 or
 Lily MERCROCHET Cotton, Art. 161:—
 3 balls each Beauty Pink and Baby Pink, Size 20;
 and
 No. 12 Steel Crochet Hook for Size 20, No. 13 for Size 30.
 15 inch square pink linen.

SIZE: 22 inches in Size 20, 19 inches in Size 30.

GAUGE: Each motif measures 3¼ inches square in Size 30, 3⅝ inches in Size 20.

MOTIF—Starting in center with Rose Pink (or Beauty Pink) ch 10, join with sl st to form ring.

RND 1—Ch 5, (dc in ring, ch 2) 11 times, join to 3d st of ch-5 (12 sps).

RND 2—In each sp around make sc, ch 1, 2 dc, ch 1 and sc.

RND 3—Sl st around bar of starting chain in 1st rnd (inserting hook from back to front), ch 6, (dc around bar of next dc in Rnd 1, ch 3) repeated around, join to 3d st of ch-6.

RND 4—In each sp around make sc, ch 1, 3 dc, ch 1 and sc.

RND 5—Sl st around bar of starting chain on last dc-rnd, ch 6, (dc around bar of next dc in previous dc-rnd, ch 3) repeated around, join to 3d st of ch-6.

RND 6—In each sp around make sc, ch 1, 5 dc, ch 1 and sc.

RND 7—Repeat Rnd 5, starting with ch 7 and having ch 4 sps around, join.

RND 8—In each sp around make sc, ch 1, 2 dc, 3 tr, 2 dc, ch 1 and sc; join and fasten off.

RND 9—Attach Lt. Pink to center tr on any petal, ch 7, * (dc, ch 9, dc) in center tr on next petal, ch 4, (dc, ch 11, dc) in next petal, ch 4, ** (dc, ch 9, dc) in next petal, ch 4, repeat from * twice and from * to ** again, dc in same petal where rnd started, ch 4, join with tr in 3d st of ch-7, drop but do not cut. Sk next ch-9 lp, attach Rose Pink 1/3 up on next ch-11 lp, *** ch 7, holding back the last lp of each tr on hook make 2 tr in 7th ch from hook, thread over and draw thru all 3 lps on hook at the same time (Cluster made), ch 4, sl st in Cluster for a p, ch 6, sl st at base of Cluster, sc in same ch-11 lp. Repeat from *** 3 times. Fasten off on back. (Sk next 2 ch-9 lps and repeat these 4 petals on next ch-11 lp) 3 times.

RND 10—Pick up Lt. Pink, ch 10, * (dc, ch 9, dc) in 5th (center) st of next ch-9 lp, sc in 1st petal, ch 11, sc in next petal, ch 13, sc in next petal, ch 11, sc in next petal, ** (dc, ch 9, dc) in center st of next ch-9 lp, ch 7 and repeat from * twice and from * to ** again, dc in same st where rnd started, ch 4, join with tr in 3d st of ch-10.

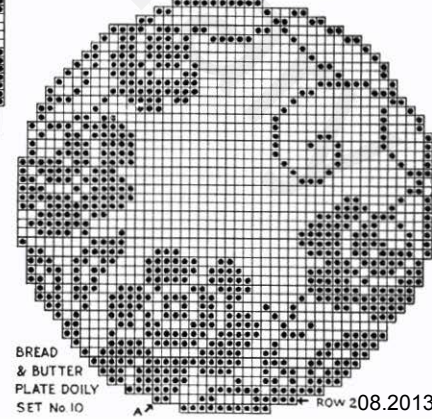
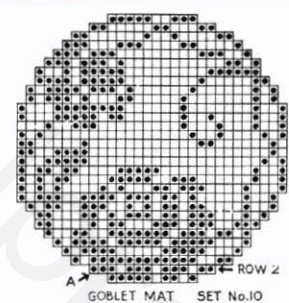
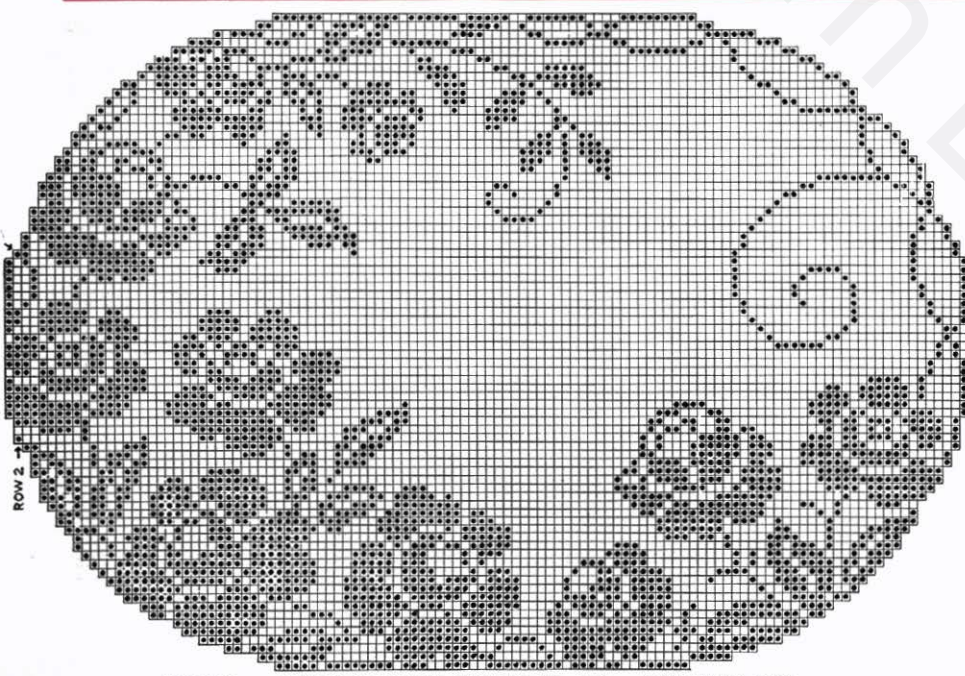
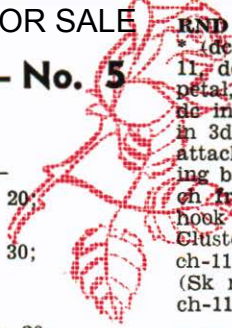
RND 11—* Ch 10, sc in next ch-9 lp, ch 8, sc in next lp, ch 11, (dc, ch 6, dc) in 7th (center) st of next lp, ch 11, sc in next lp, ch 8, sc in next lp, repeat from * around, join.

RND 12—* In next sp make 5 sc, ch 4, sl st in last sc for a p, and 5 sc; (4 sc, p, 4 sc) in next sp, (6 sc, p, 6 sc) in next sp, ** (2 sc, p, 3 sc, p, 2 sc) in corner sp, (6 sc, p, 6 sc) in next sp, (4 sc, p, 4 sc) in next sp, repeat from * around, join and fasten off.

2d MOTIF—Repeat to ** in 12th Rnd, (2 sc, p, 3 sc) in corner sp, ch 2, sl st in 1st p on a corner sp of 1st Motif, ch 2, sl st back in last sc (joining-p made), 2 sc in bal. of sp, 6 sc in next sp, ch 2, sl st in next p on 1st Motif, ch 2, sl st back in last sc, 6 sc in bal. of sp. Join the next 5 ps in same way to the matching ps on 1st Motif, then complete rnd as for 1st Motif.

Join 20 Motifs into a hollow square (6 on each side), joining adjacent sides as 2d Motif was joined to 1st Motif. Make 4 more Motifs, joining one in each inside corner.

Stretch and pin lace right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth. Sew inside edge on linen square. Cut linen ¼ inch outside stitching, turn edge back and hem down on back of crochet edge.



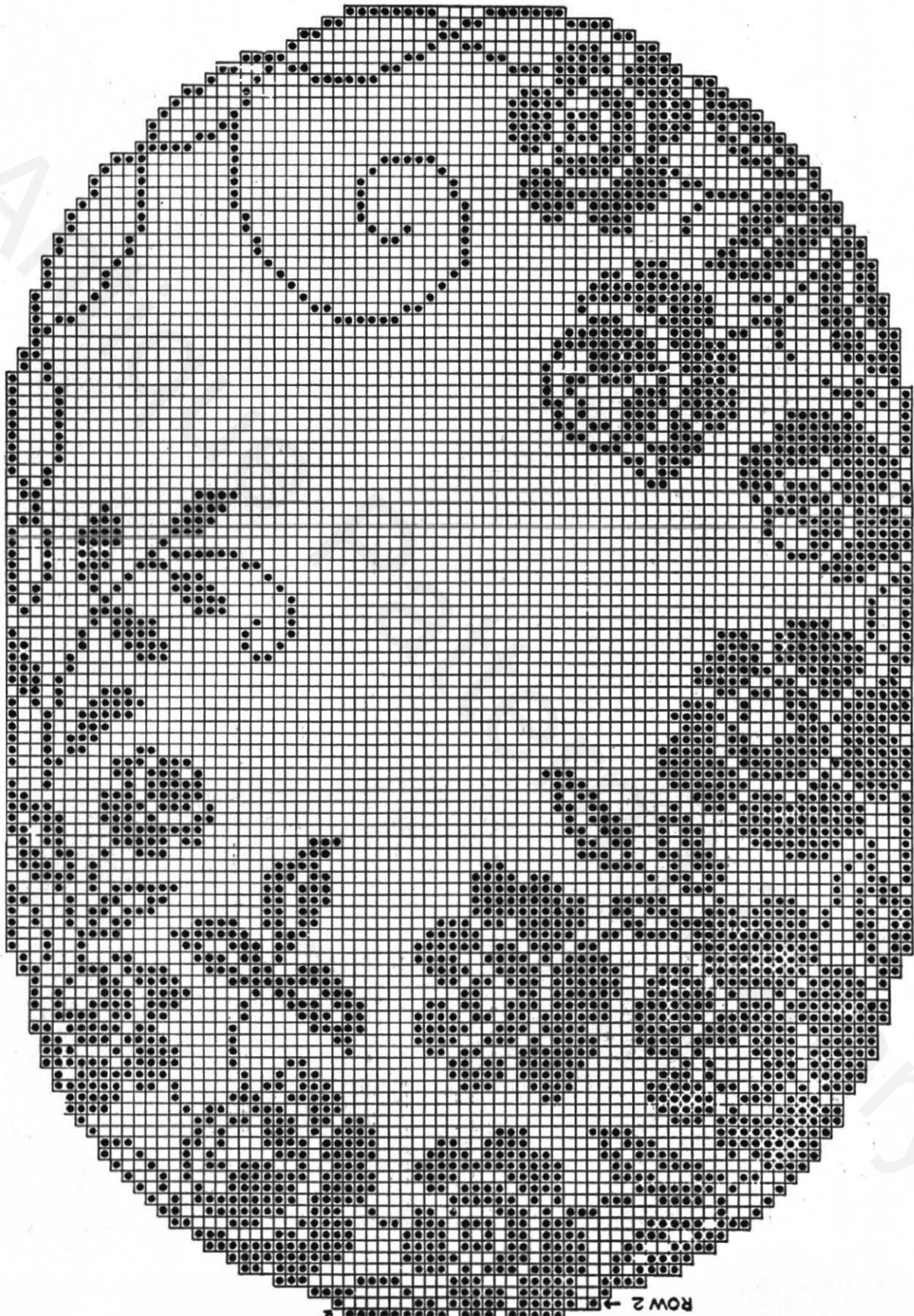
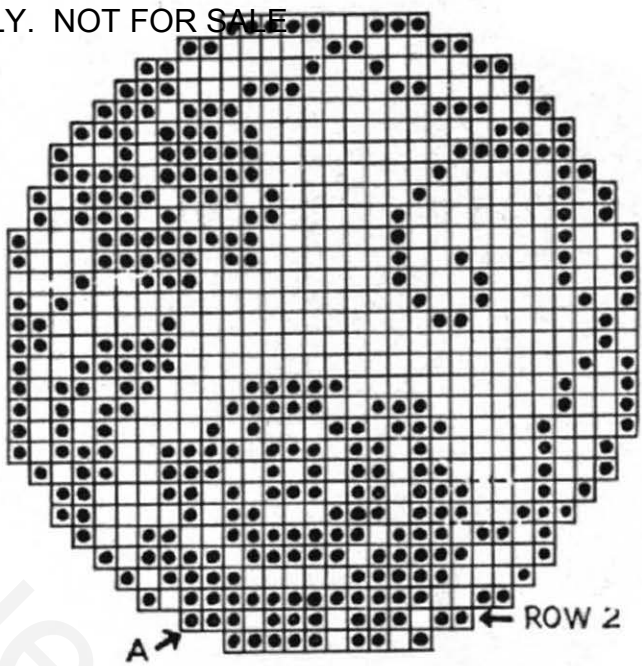
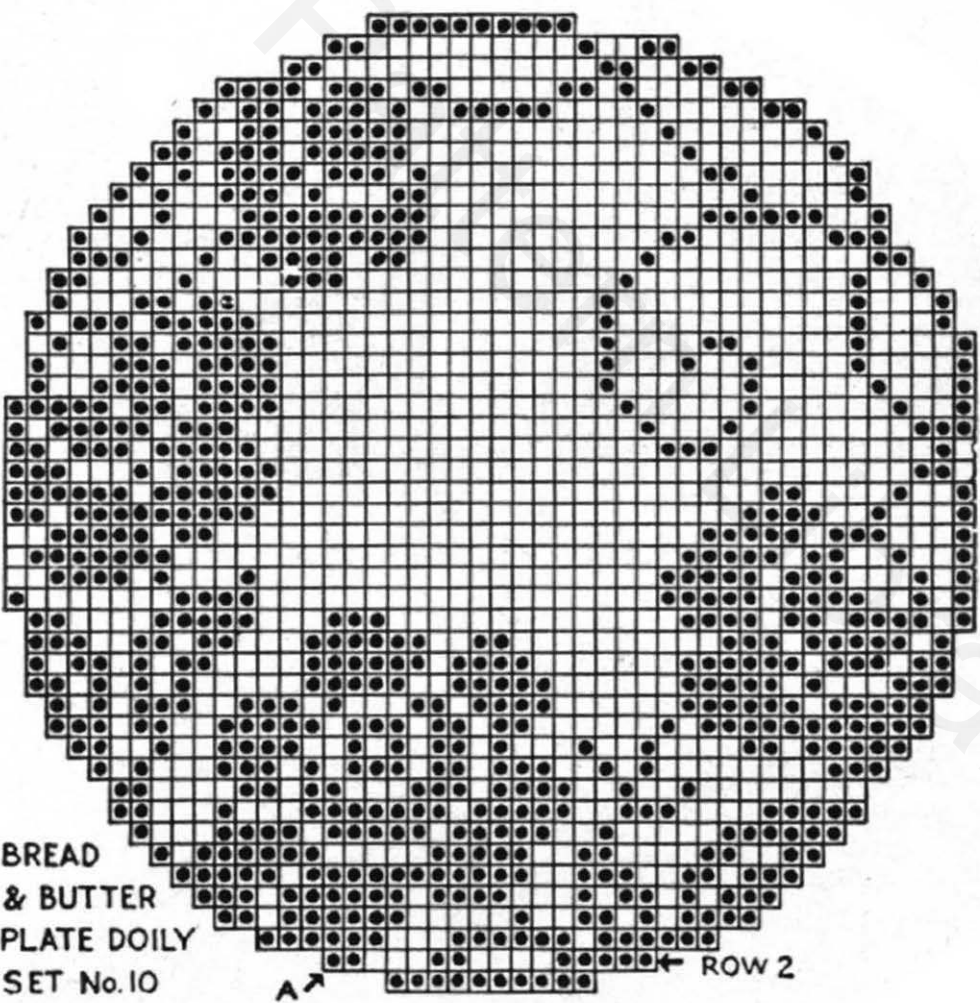


CHART FOR SPRING ROSES TABLE DAILY SET - No.10 SHOWN ON BACK COVER

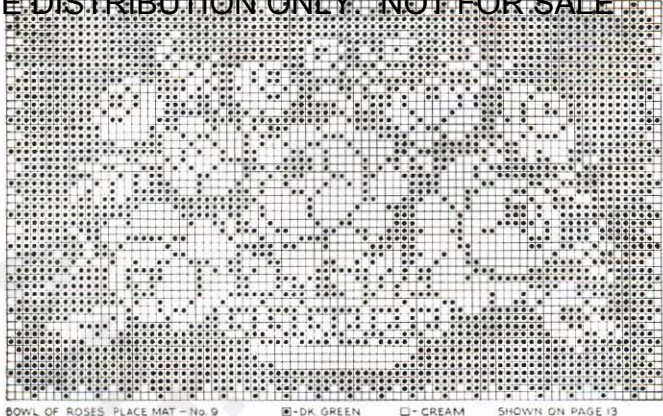

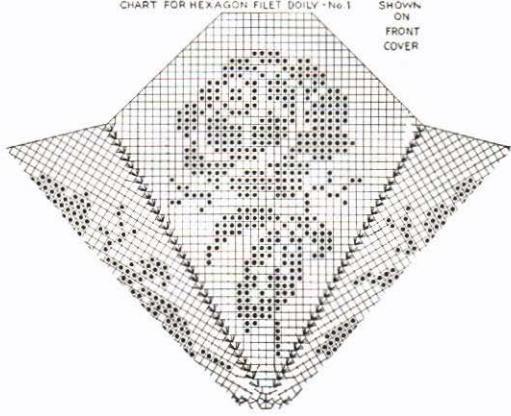

MATERIALS REQUIRED:

Lily SKY-TONE Mercerized Crochet Cotton, Art. 123:-
 5 balls Salmon Rose and
 1 ball each Cream and Lt. Green.
 No. 10 Steel Crochet Hook.
 Size — 13 x 19 inches.

With Salmon Rose make a chain 25 inches long.

ROW 1—Sk 1st 4 ch, * dc in next 5 ch, holding back the last lp of each dc on hook made dc in next 2 ch, thread over and draw thru all 3 lps on hook at the same time (a 2-dc Cluster made), ** sk 3 ch, sl st in next ch, ch 3, repeat from * for 18 inches (or other desired length), ending at **, dc in next ch. Cut and rip excess chain.

ROW 2—Ch 3, turn, sk 1st dc, * (dc in next Cluster, dc in next dc) made into a Cluster, dc in next 4 dc, ** dc in next ch-3, ch 3, sl st in same ch-3, sk sl st at base of ch-3, repeat from * across ending at **, 2 dc in end ch-3.

ROW 3—Ch 3, turn, dc in 1st dc, * dc in next 4 dc, (dc in next 2 dc) made into a Cluster, ** sl st in next ch-3, ch 3, dc in same ch-3, repeat from * across ending at **, dc in end ch-3. Repeat Rows 2 and 3 for 12 inches (or other desired width) making an even number of rows. Fasten off.

Edge—Attach Cream to last dc, ch 3, turn, dc in same dc, repeat Row 3 from * across to corner, ** 5 dc in corner, work dc across end (5 dc to every 2 rows); 5 dc in corner, ** repeat Row 3 across long side; repeat from ** to **, join to ch-3. Fasten off.

ROSE: Front Row—With Sal. Rose ch 7, join with sl st to form ring. Ch 3, 17 dc in ring, join to ch-3.

Petal—Ch 3, 3 tr in same st, (4 tr in next dc) twice.

ROW 2—Ch 4, turn, 3 tr in 1st tr, tr in next 10 tr, 4 tr in end tr.

ROW 3—Ch 4, turn, tr in each tr, 2 tr in end ch-4.

ROW 4—Ch 1, turn, sc in 1st tr, hdc in next tr, dc in next tr, 2 tr in next tr, tr in next 11 tr, 2 tr in next tr, dc in next tr, hdc in next tr, sc in end tr.

ROW 5—Ch 1, turn, sc in 1st st, * hdc in next st, dc in next 3 sts, 5 dc in next st, dc in next 3 sts, hdc in next st, sc in next st, * repeat from * to *. Fasten off. (Attach to next dc on center and repeat Petal) 5 times.

Edge—Attach Cream between any 2 petals, * make sc around next petal to 4th st before center sc, hdc in next 3 sts, dc in center sc, hdc in next 3 sts, make sc around bal. of petal, sl st between petals. Repeat from * around. Fasten off.

Back Row—With Sal. Rose ch 10, join with sl st to form ring. Ch 6, (dc in ring, ch 3) 9 times, join to 3d st of ch-6.

RND 2—Ch 9, (dc in next dc, ch 6) 9 times, join to 3d st of ch-9.

RND 3—Ch 7, (dc in next sp, ch 4, dc in next dc, ch 4) repeated around, join to 3d st of ch-7.

RND 4—Ch 8, (dc in next dc, ch 5) repeated around, join to 3d st of ch-8. Sl st in next sp, * ch 5, 5 tr in same sp, tr in next dc, 5 tr in next sp. Repeat Petal beginning with Row 2. Attach to next sp on center and repeat from * around (9 petals). Repeat Edge.

Center—With Sal. Rose ch 7, join with sl st to form ring. Ch 3, 17 dc in ring, join to ch-3.

RND 2—Ch 3, 5 dc in same st, (dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc) 8 times, 3 dc in next dc.

RND 3—Ch 3, turn, dc in each dc (31) with 3 dc in end dc, 3 dc in end ch-3.

RND 4—Ch 3, turn, dc in each dc, dc in end ch (38 dc). Repeat for Rnd 5 (39 dc).

RND 6—Ch 3, turn, (dc in 1st 3 dc) made into a Cluster, (dc in next 3 dc, dc in next 2 dc made into a Cluster) 6 times, dc in next 3 dc, dc in 3 end dc made into a Cluster.

RND 7—Ch 1, turn, sk 1 dc, sc in next dc, hdc in next 2 dc, * (dc in next 2 dc, dc in next 2 dc made into a Cluster) * 5 times, dc in next 2 dc, hdc in next 2 dc, sc in next st.

RND 8—Ch 1, turn, sk 1 st, sc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts, repeat last rnd from * to * 4 times, hdc in next 2 sts, sc in next st. Fasten off.

Edge—Attach Cream to center circle, (3 sc in end of next row) 5 times, sc in next row, * hdc in next st, (3 dc in next st) 3 times, hdc in next st, sc in next st, repeat from * twice, make sc down to center. Fasten off. Lap into a roll and tack. Sew off-center on 6-petal piece, then sew these on 9-petal piece. Tack Rose on upper left corner of doily.

LEAF—With Lt. Green, ch 7, sk 1 ch, sc in next 5 ch, 3 sc in end ch, sc in next 3 sts on other side of ch.

ROW 2—Ch 4, sl st in 4th ch from hook for a p, ch 1, turn, dc in 1st 4 sc, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next sc, dc in next sc, hdc in next sc, sc in next sc.

ROW 3—Ch 4, p, ch 1, turn, dc in 1st 5 sts, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 2 sts, hdc in next st, sc in next st.

ROW 4—Ch 4, p, ch 1, turn, dc in 1st 6 sts, a 2-dc, ch 2, 2-dc shell in shell, dc in next 3 sts, hdc in next st, sc in next st.

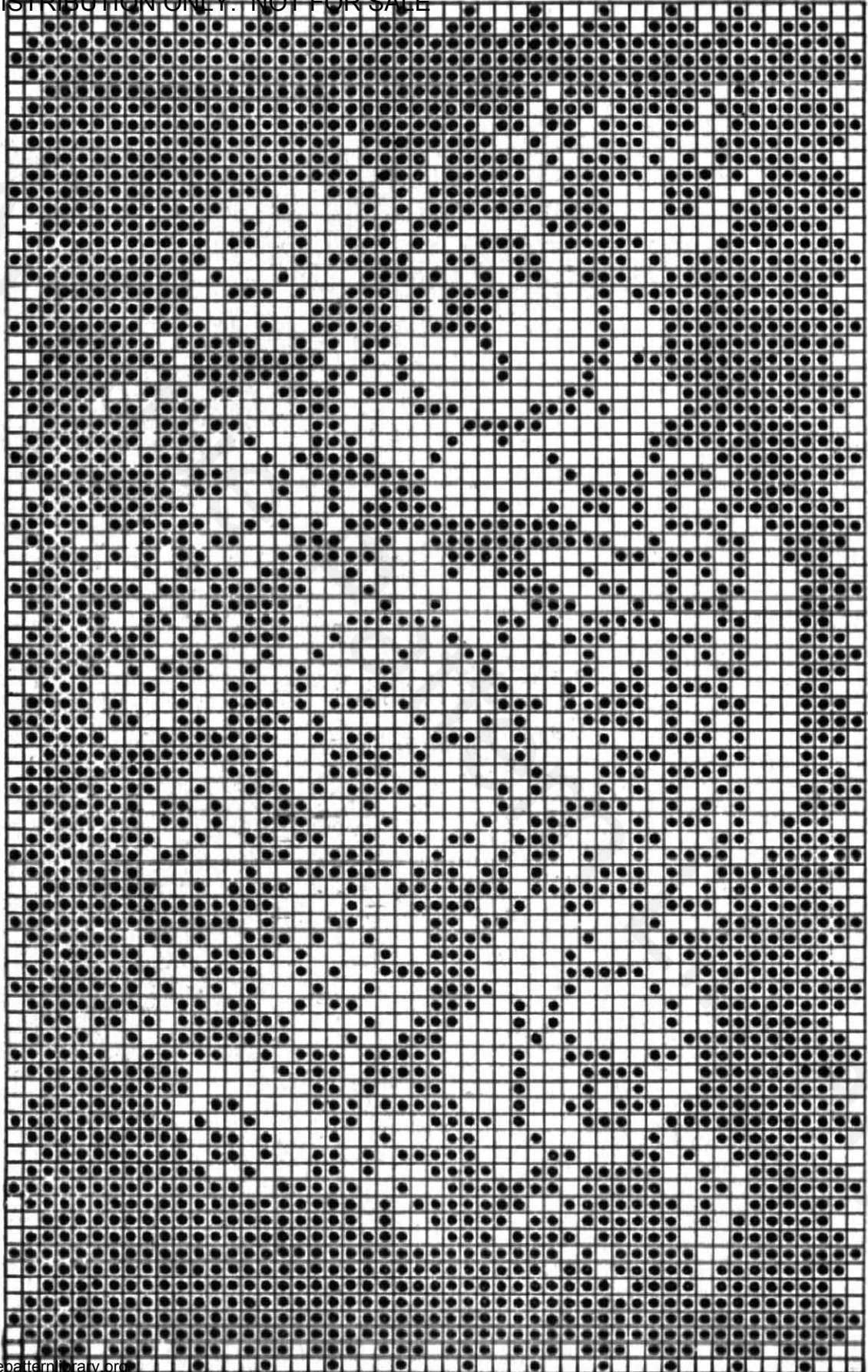
ROW 5—Ch 4, p, ch 1, turn, dc in 1st 7 sts, shell in shell, end row with 4 dc, 1 hdc and 1 sc.

ROW 6—Ch 4, p, ch 1, turn, dc in 1st 8 sts, shell in shell, end row with 4 dc, 1 hdc and 1 sc. Repeat 3 times.

ROW 10—Ch 4, p, ch 1, turn, dc in 1st 6 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in ch-2 sp. Fasten off. Make two.

LEAF WITH STEM—Repeat Leaf, ch 35, sc in 2d ch from hook, hdc in each ch to end, sc in leaf. Fasten off. Sew 1 Leaf on each side of Stem. Make a 2d Leaf Spray. Sew on doily as illustrated.

Stretch and pin doily right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.



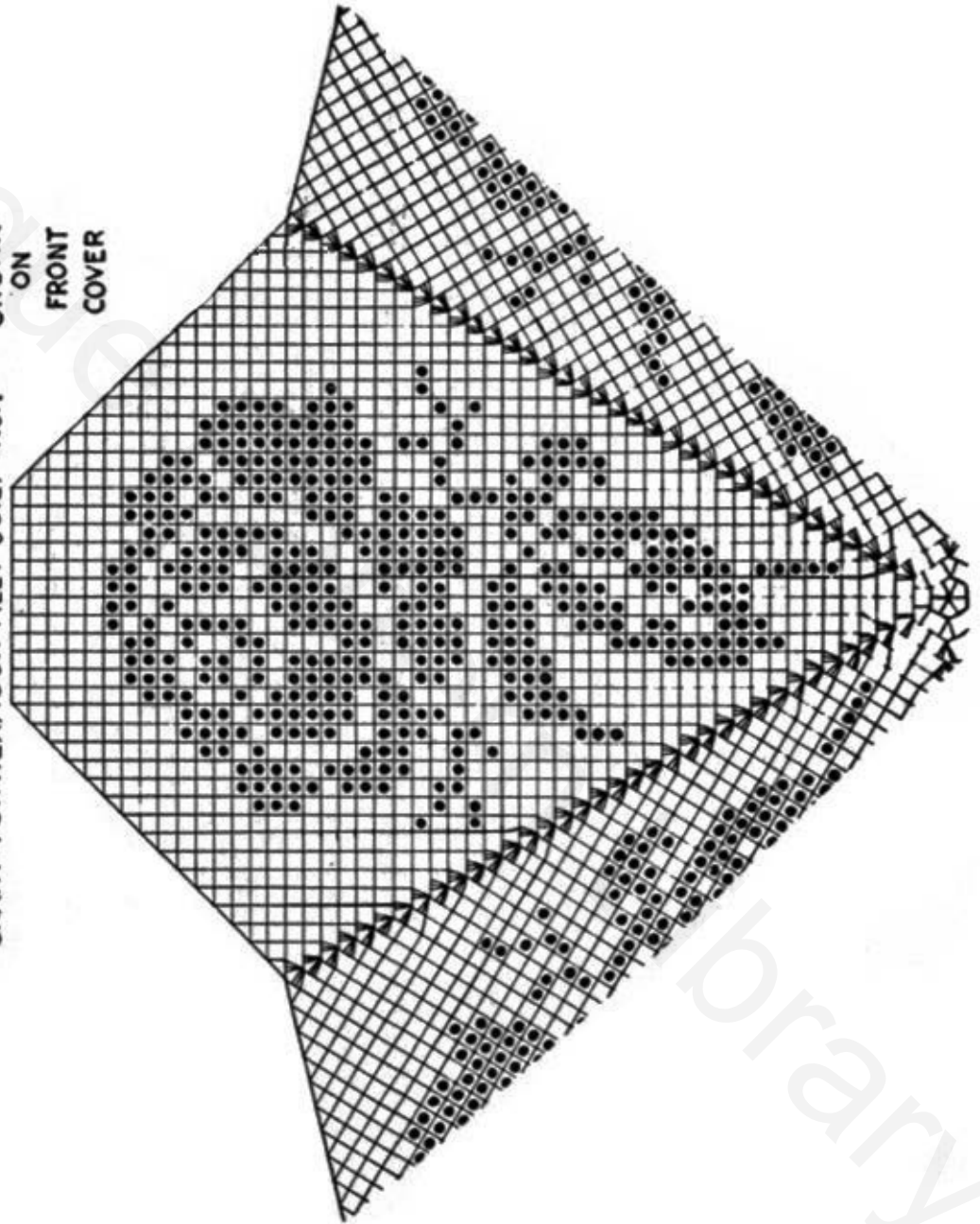

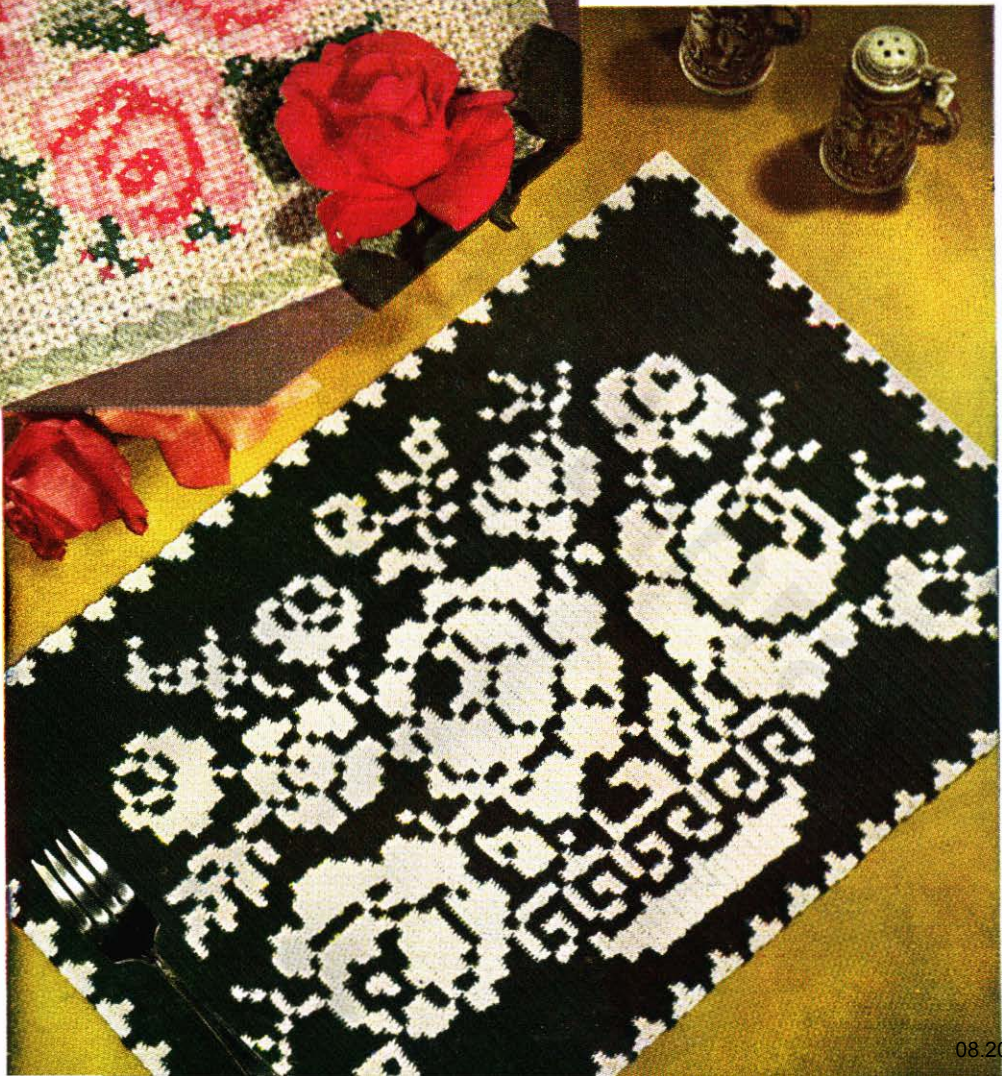

ROW 2—Ch 3 turn, sk 1st dc, dc in next 48 dc, * ch 7, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, dc in next dc) 8 times, * ch 7, dc in remaining 48 dc, dc in end ch-3.

ROW 3—Ch 3, turn, sk 1st dc, dc in next 48 dc, (ch 3, sc in next ch-7 lp, ch 3, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next sp, dc in next dc) * 8 times, ch 3, sc in next sp, ch 3, dc in next 48 dc, dc in end ch-3. Repeat Rows 2 and 3 thru Row 19 (solid corners should be square).

ROW 20—Ch 5, turn, sk 3 dc, dc in next dc, (** ch 7, sk 5 dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, dc in next dc) 5 times **; repeat from * to * in Row 2; ch 7, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, dc in next dc; repeat from ** to **.

ROW 21—Ch 3, turn, 2 dc in next sp, dc in next dc, repeat Row 3 from * to * across row, making final 3 dc in half of end ch-5.

ROW 22—Ch 5, turn, sk 3 dc, dc in next dc, (ch 7, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, dc in next dc) repeated across. Repeat Rows 21 and 22 until work is 14½ inches long, ending with Row 21.

NEXT ROW—Ch 5, turn, sk 3 dc, dc in next dc, * (ch 5, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, dc in next dc) 5 times, * (ch 7, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, dc in next dc) 9 times, repeat from * to *.

NEXT ROW—Ch 3, turn, 2 dc in 1st sp, dc in next dc, ** (5 dc in next sp, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next sp, dc in next dc) 5 times, ** repeat Row 3 from * to * 9 times; repeat from ** to ** in this row. Repeat Rows 2 and 3 nine times (to match other end). Fasten off.

Edge—Working across one long side, attach White to corner st, ch 3, dc in same st, ch 4, sl st in 1 lp of 4th ch from hook for a p, ch 1, 2 dc in same corner st, ** (ch 1, sk 1 row, in next row make 2 dc, ch 4, p, ch 1 and 2 dc) 9 times, (ch 1, make a shell in next sp) repeated to next corner square, (ch 1, sk 1 row, a shell in next row) 9 times, ch 1, a shell in corner st, * (ch 1, sk 3 dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 4, p, ch 1, 2 dc in next dc) 9 times, * (ch 1, a shell in sc between next 2 sps, ch 1, 2 dc in 2d dc of next block, ch 4, p, ch 1, 2 dc in next dc) repeated across to corner square, repeat from * to *, ch 1, a shell in corner st. Repeat from ** around, join and fasten off.

FLOWER—With White ch 5, join with sl st to form ring.
RND 1—Ch 4, (dc in ring, ch 1) 9 times, join to 3d st of ch-4.

RND 2—Ch 1, sc in same st, * ch 5, in next ch-1 sp make tr, ch 1, dtr, ch 1, tr tr; (ch 1, tr tr) twice in next dc, ch 1, in next sp make tr tr, ch 1, dtr, ch 1, tr; ch 5, sc in next dc, repeat from * around, join to 1st sc (5 petals).

RND 3—* 5 sc in next ch-5 sp, (3 hdc in next sp) twice, 3 dc in next sp, in next (center) sp make 2 dc, ch 3, sl st in last dc for a p and 1 dc; 3 dc in next sp, (3 hdc in next sp) twice, 5 sc in next sp, sl st in sc between petals, repeat from * 4 times, join and fasten off. Make 4. Sew one in center of each corner square.

LEAF—With White ch 22, * sc in 2d ch from hook, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, tr in next ch, dtr in next 5 ch, tr in next ch, dc in next ch, sl st in next ch; * ch 15, repeat from * to *, sl st in next 2 ch, ch 13, repeat from * to *, sl st in 9-ch stem. Fasten off. Make 16. Sew one on each corner of corner squares.

Stretch and pin doily right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

11). Sl st in next sc. Fasten off. Make 16 Leaves. Tack one on each side of stem 1½ inches from end.

Sew a Rose Spray on each point of Doily, tacking down the stem, tips of leaves and back of rose.

SMALL DOILY—(Size - 16 inches)—Repeat with DAISY and No. 12 hook. Make two.

Starch doilies. When partially dry, stretch and pin right-side-up in true shape. Make a stand-up frill in edge in angle between points and curl tips of rose petals over.

Hot Dish Mat Set — — — — — No. 8**

MATERIALS REQUIRED:

Lily SKY-TONE Mercerized Crochet Cotton, Art. 123:—
1 ball each Cream, Lt. Green and Salmon Rose;
and

Lily Six Strand Floss, Art. 21:—
3 skeins each Deep Rose and Pea Green, and
4 skeins each Rose, Pink and Emerald Green.
No. 0 Steel Crochet Hook.

LARGE MAT (SIZE - 7½ x 11½ inches): Using one strand of each color of SKY-TONE (Cream, Lt. Green and Sal. Rose), start at one end with ch 25.

ROW 1—Sk 1st st, sc in remaining 24 ch.

ROW 2—Ch 2, turn, hdc and sc in 1st sc, sc in next 22 sc, sc and hdc in end sc.

ROW 3—Ch 2, turn, hdc and sc in 1st hdc, sc in each st across with sc and hdc in end hdc. Do not work in end ch-2. Repeat Row 3 thru Row 9.

ROW 10—Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across (40 sc). Repeat Row 10 thru Row 58.

ROW 59—Ch 1, turn, draw up lps in 1st 2 sc, thread over and draw thru all 3 lps on hook at same time (1 sc decrease), sc in each sc across thru 3d sc from end, draw up lps in 2 end sc, thread over and draw thru all 3 lps on hook at same time (1 sc decrease). Repeat Row 59 seven times (thru Row 66).

ROW 67—Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc (24 sc).

Edge: RND 1—Ch 1, turn, work sc around edge, with 2 sc in corner; join and fasten off.

RND 2—With wrong-side-facing, attach 3 strands Lt. Green SKY-TONE, sc in next sc, * holding back the last lp of each dc on hook, make 3 dc in next sc, thread over and draw thru all 4 lps on hook at the same time, letting Cluster puff out on back (right side), sc in next 2 sc, repeat from * around, join and fasten off.

RND 3—Turn right-side-facing, attach one strand of each color of SKY-TONE and make sc in each st around with 2 sc in corners; join and fasten off.

EMBROIDERY—Using 3 lengths of Six Strand Floss threaded to a large, dull-pointed needle, embroider rose design in cross stitches, starting in the 11th row from ends and the 5th st from long sides (including Rnd 1 of Edge in counting).

SMALL MAT (SIZE - 7½ x 9½ inches)—Repeat Large Mat thru Row 10, repeat Row 10 thru Row 44, repeat Rows 59 thru 67 (53 rows total). Repeat Edge. Start embroidery in the 4th row from ends and the 5th st from long side (including Rnd 1 of Edge in counting). Pin Mats right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth. Line backs with cloth.

CHART FOR ROSE POINT—No. 8

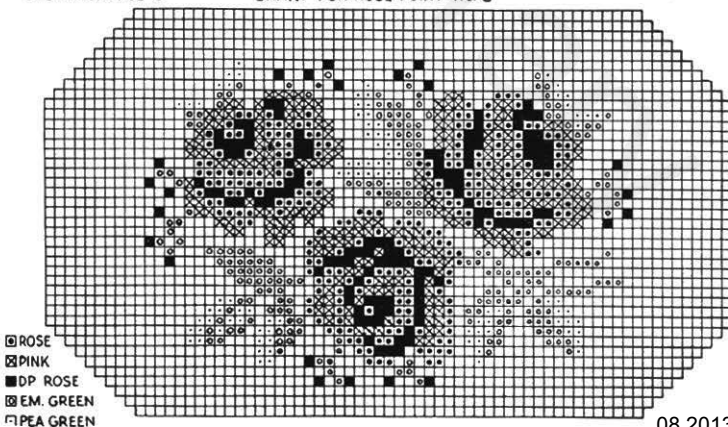
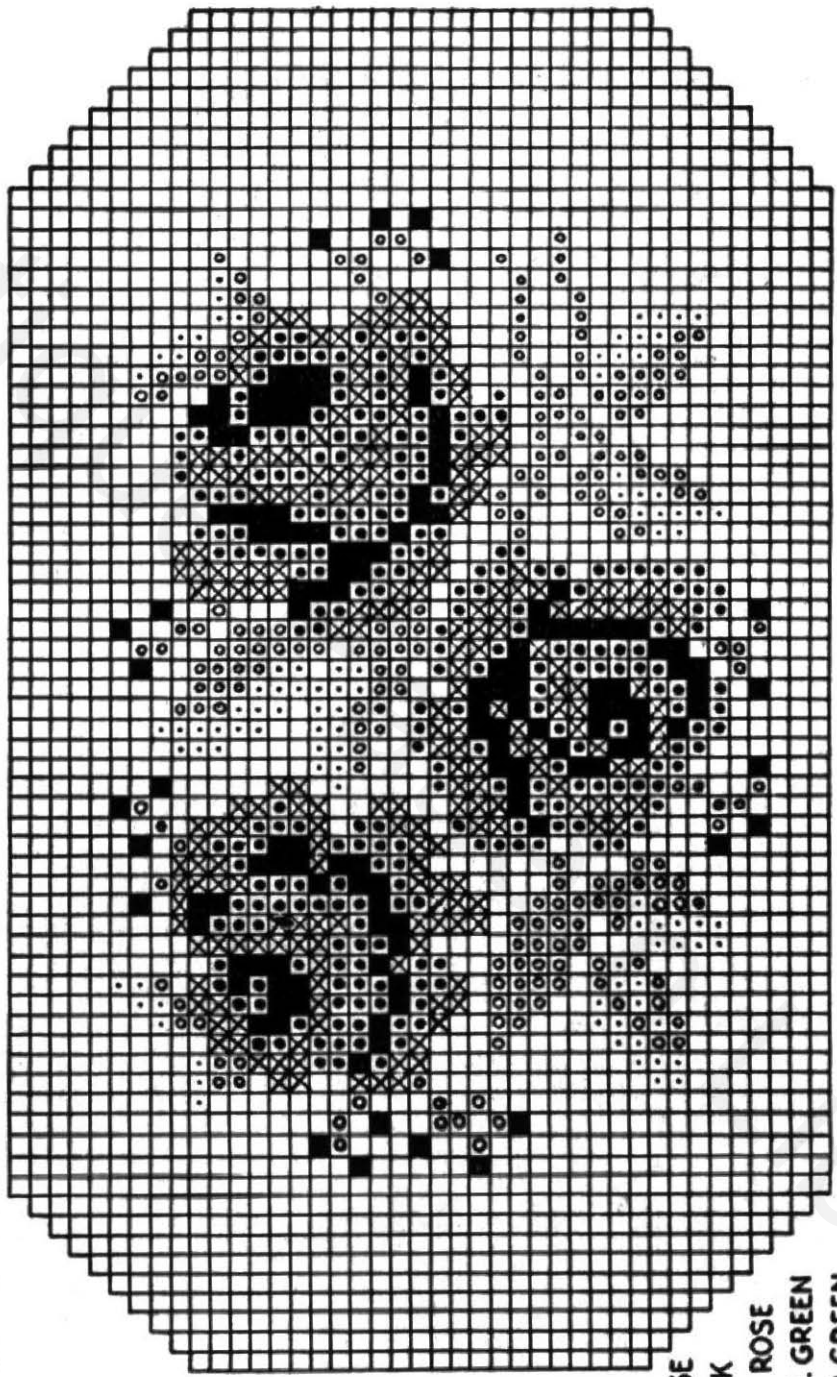

MATERIALS REQUIRED:

DAISY Mercerized Crochet Cotton, Art. 65; Size 30:
2 skeins White;

or

Lily MERCROCHET Cotton, Art. 161; Size 20:
3 balls White;
(Sufficient for 1 Place Mat, 1 Bread and Butter Plate
Mat and 1 Goblet Mat).

No. 13 Steel Crochet Hook.

CHART ON PAGE 10

GAUGE—6 sps - 1 inch; 6 rows - 1 inch.

PLACE MAT—(SIZE: 12 x 18 inches)—Ch 65 and starting at "A" on Chart, sk 1 st, sl st in next 4 ch (on which to work 1 added blk in next row), sk 3 ch, dc in next 27 ch (9 blks), ch 2, sk 2 ch, dc in next 10 ch (1 sp and 3 blks), ch 2, sk 2 ch, dc in next 16 ch (1 sp and 5 blks).

ROW 2—Ch 16, turn, sk 1 ch, sl st in next 4 ch, sk 3 ch, dc in next 3 ch, ch 2, sk 2 ch, dc in next 3 ch, dc in next 13 dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next sp, dc in next 10 dc, 2 dc in next sp, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, dc in next 7 dc, (ch 2, sk 2 dc, dc in next dc) 5 times, ch 2, sk 2 dc, dc over next 4 sl sts inserting hook at base of sl sts (1 added blk).

ROW 3—Ch 19, turn, sk 1 ch, sl st in next 10 ch (on which to work 3 added blks in next row), sk 3 ch, dc in next 5 ch, dc in next 4 dc, continue, following Chart, with 1 blk, 4 sps, 1 blk, 3 sps, (5 blks, 1 sp) twice, ch 2, sk 2 dc, dc over next 4 sl sts.

ROW 4—Ch 22, turn, sk 1 ch, sl st in next 10 ch, sk 3 ch, dc in next 8 ch, dc in next 4 dc, make 2 sps, 5 blks, 3 sps, 3 blks, 4 sps, 4 blks and 3 sps, ch 2, sk 2 dc, dc over next 10 sl sts.

ROW 5—Ch 16, turn, sk 1 ch, sl st in next 4 ch, sk 3 ch, dc in next 6 ch, ch 2, sk 2 ch, dc in next 13 dc, follow Chart across, ending with dc over 10 end sl sts.

ROW 6—Ch 13, turn, sk 1 ch, sl st in next 7 ch, sk 3 ch, dc in next 2 ch, follow Chart across ending with dc over 4 end sl sts.

ROW 7—Ch 13, turn, sk 1 ch, sl st in next 4 ch, sk 3 ch, dc in next 5 ch, complete row ending with dc over 7 end sl sts.

ROW 8—Repeat Row 6.

ROW 9—Repeat Row 7.

ROW 10—Ch 10, turn, sk 1 ch, sl st in next 4 ch, sk 3 ch, dc in next 2 ch, dc in next dc, complete row ending with dc over 4 end sl sts. Repeat Row 10 thru Row 14.

ROW 15—Ch 6, turn, sk 4 ch, dc in next 2 ch, dc in next dc. End as in last rows.

ROW 16—Ch 7, turn, sk 1 ch, sl st in next 4 ch, sk 1st dc, dc in next 18 dc, complete row ending with 3 blks (10 dc) even.

ROW 17—Repeat Row 10. Follow Chart thru Row 33.

ROW 34—Ch 3, turn, sk 1st dc, dc in next 6 dc, complete row, ending even. Work even thru Row 81.

ROW 82—Ch 1, turn, sk 1st dc, sl st in next 3 dc, ch 3, 2 dc in next sp, dc in next dc, complete row. Follow Chart for bal. of doily. Where sps are dropped at beginning of a row, ch 1, turn, sk 1st dc, sl st across until starting place of next row is reached. End with Row 114, fasten off.

BREAD AND BUTTER PLATE MAT—(SIZE: 7½ inches)—**ROW 1**—Ch 44 and starting at "A" on Chart, sk 1 ch, sl st in next 10 ch, sk 3 ch, dc in next 30 ch.

ROW 2—Ch 22, turn, sk 1 ch, sl st in next 10 ch, sk next 3 ch, dc in next 8 ch, dc in next 7 dc, 4 sps, 2 blks, 3 sps and 2 blks.

ROW 3—Ch 19, turn, sk 1 ch, sl st in next 7 ch, sk 3 ch, dc in next 8 ch, dc in next 7 dc, 1 blk, 3 sps, 6 blks, 1 sp and 6 blks.

ROW 4—Ch 13, turn, sk 1 ch, sl st in next 4 ch, sk 3 ch, dc in next 5 ch, dc in next 7 dc, complete row ending with 2 added blks over 7 sl sts.

ROW 5—Ch 10, turn, sk 1 ch, sl st in next 4 ch, sk 3 ch, dc in next 2 ch, dc in next 7 dc, complete row ending with 1 added blk made over 4 sl sts. Complete doily in same way,—thru Row 46, fasten off.

GOBLET MAT—(SIZE - 5 inches):

ROW 1—Ch 41, sk 1 ch and starting at "A" on Chart, sl st in next 7 ch, sk 3 ch, dc in next 15 ch, ch 2, sk 2 ch, dc in next 7 ch, ch 2, sk 2 ch, dc in 4 end ch.

ROW 2—Ch 16, turn, sk 1 ch, sl st in next 7 ch, sk 3 ch, dc in next 5 ch, dc in next dc, (make 1 sp, 3 blks) 3 times.

ROW 3—Ch 13, turn, sk 1 ch, sl st in next 4 ch, sk 3 ch, dc in next 3 ch, ch 2, sk 2 ch, dc in next 37 dc, 2 sps, 2 blks.

ROW 4—Ch 10, turn, sk 1 ch, sl st in next 4 ch, sk 3 ch, dc in next 2 ch, dc in next dc, make 3 sps, 5 blks, 5 sps, 4 blks, 1 sp and 1 blk. Complete doily in same way, — thru Row 30, fasten off.

Stretch and pin doilies right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

"Bowl of Roses" Place Mat - No. 9

MATERIALS REQUIRED:

Lily SKY-TONE Mercerized Crochet Cotton, Art. 123:—
1 ball Cream and
3 balls Dk. Green.

CHART ON PAGE 11

No. 10 Steel Crochet Hook.

SIZE — 12 x 18 inches.

Starting at one end with Cream, make a chain 15 inches long. Beginning at "A" on Chart and working over a strand of Green, sk 1st 4 ch, dc in next 8 ch holding last 2 lps of final dc on hook, drop Cream on back, draw up Green thru the 2 lps on hook; working over Cream make dc in next 3 ch, hold last 2 lps on hook, drop Green on back, pull up Cream thru 2 lps. Always join other color in this way,—thru the last 2 lps of previous color, — always pulling it up taut first. Working over Green and following Chart where each square equals 3 dc, (make 9

Cream dc, drop on back, join Green and make 3 dc, drop on back) 11 times, join Cream and make 9 dc. Mark the right side of this row as the right side of doily. Cut and rip excess chain.

ROW 2—Ch 3, turn, carry Green around on wrong side, sk last dc, dc in next 5 dc, drop Cream on side facing, (join Green and make 9 dc, drop Green on side facing, join Cream and make 3 dc) 12 times, make 3 more Cream dc. Work over unused color at all times, keeping it pulled up taut, but not so tight it shortens rows.

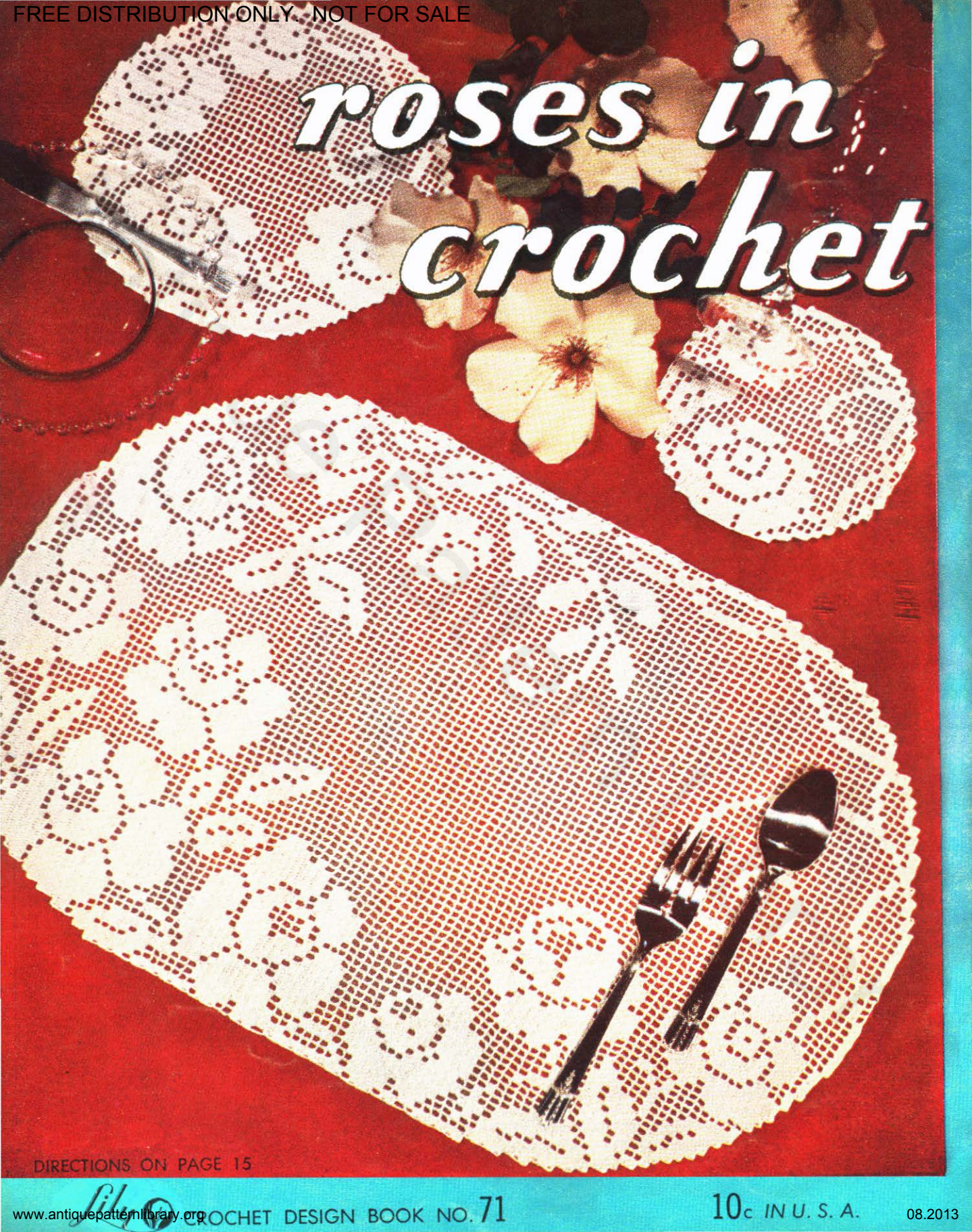
ROW 3—Keeping Green on side facing (wrong side of doily), ch 3, turn. Do this on alternate rows so unused color will not show on right side. Sk 1st dc, dc in next 2 dc, drop Cream on back, join Green and make 147 dc, drop Green on back, join Cream and make 3 dc, joining Green thru final 2 lps.

ROW 4—Ch 3, turn, carry Cream around on wrong side, sk 1st dc, dc in next 152 sts, joining Cream thru final 2 lps.

Continue, following Chart to end (Row 83). Fasten off both colors.

Stretch and pin doily right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.
