

Materials Required: AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" FAST HEAVY MERCERIZED CROCHET COTTON, Article 140

1 ball each White and Forest Green or colors of your choice. Steel crochet hook No. 1

7 mason jar rings

Approximate size of mat 10 inches in diameter.

MOTIF: CENTER SECTION—With White ch 6, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 12 s c in ring, join.

2nd Round—Ch 3 (counts as part of 1st popcorn st), 3 d c in same space, slip loop off hook, insert in 3rd st of ch, pull loop through, ch 1 to tighten st, * ch 2, skip 1 s c, popcorn st in next s c (popcorn st: 4 d c in same space, drop loop from hook, insert in 1st d c, pull loop through, ch 1 to tighten st), repeat from * 4 times, ch 2, join in 1st popcorn st, cut thread.

3rd Round—Attach Green in any popcorn st, * ch 4, s c in next loop, ch 4, sl st in next popcorn st, repeat from * 4 times, ch 4, s c in next loop, ch 1, d c in top of next popcorn st (this brings thread in position for next round).

4th Round—* Ch 4, s c in next loop, repeat from * 10 times, ch 4, sl st in d c, cut thread.

5th Round—Over a mason jar ring, with White work 6 s c, 1 s c over ring and any loop of center section, * 6 s c over ring, 1 s c over ring and next loop of center section, repeat from * 10 times, join, cut thread.

6th Round—Attach Green and work 1 s c in each s c, join, cut thread.

2nd MOTIF—Work 1st 5 rounds same as 1st motif.

Next Round—Attach Green in any s c, s c in same space, * drop loop from hook, insert hook in back loop of 1 s c of 1st motif, pull loop through, s c in next s c of 2nd motif, repeat from * 5 times, work 1 s c in each remaining s c, join, cut thread.

Join 3rd motif to 2nd motif in same manner, leaving 22 s c free for inner edge of 2nd motif. Work 2 more motifs joining in same manner. Work 6th motif in same manner but joining 6 sts on opposite side to 1st motif leaving 22 s c free on inner edge of each motif. Work a center motif in same manner joining in last round as follows: attach Green in any s c, s c in same space, join next 6 sts to 6 center sts at inner edge of any motif, *1 s c in each of the next 8 s c on center motif, join next 6 sts of center motif to 6 center sts on next motif, repeat from *4 times, 1 s c in each of the next 8 s c of center motif, join, cut thread.

Materials Required: AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "GEM" MERCERIZED CROCHET COTTON, Article 35, size 30

1 ball each Iridescent No. 1, Shaded Browns and Nile Green Steel crochet hook No. 12

1 pr. hemstitched pillow cases

With Green ch 4, s c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s c in each st of ch, ch 1 to turn each row.

2nd Row—Working in s c, increase 1 st at beginning of row and 3 sts at end of row.

3rd, 4th and 5th Rows—Working in s c increase in last st in each row.

6th Row—Increase 1 s c in 1st s c.

7th Row-1 s c in each of the next 7 s c, turn.

8th Row—Decrease 1 st at beginning of row (to decrease: insert hook in next st, pull loop through, insert hook in next st, pull loop through, thread over and pull through all loops at one time).

9th Row—Decrease 1 st at beginning and end of row. Work 1 row even.

11th Row—Decrease 1 st at beginning of row, increase 1 st at end of row. Work 1 row even.

13th Row—Repeat 11th row.

14th Row—Increase 1 st at beginning of row, decrease 1 st at end of row.

15th Row—Decrease 1 st at beginning of row, increase 2 sts at end of row.

16th Row—Repeat 14th row.

17th Row—Repeat 11th row.

18th Row—Increase 1 st at beginning of row.

19th Row-Repeat 15th row. Work 1 row even.

21st Row-Repeat 11th row.

22nd Row-1 s c in each s c, ch 24, turn.

23rd Row—S c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s c in each of the next 2 sts, 1 d c in each of the next 3 sts, 1 tr c in each of the next 8 sts, 1 d c in each of the next 3 sts, 1 s c in each of the next 3 sts, 1 sl st in each of the next 3 sts, 1 sl st in each of the next 3 sts, 1 sl st in each of the next 3 sts, 1 sl st in each of the next 7 s c.

24th Row—Increase 1 st at beginning of row, increase 2 sts at end of row (33 s c).

25th Row-Repeat 18th row.

26th Row-Increase 1 s c at end of row.

27th Row-Repeat 18th row.

28th Row-Repeat 26th row.

29th Row-Repeat 14th row.

30th Row—Repeat 26th row.

31st Row—Repeat 14th row.

32nd Row—Repeat 11th row. Repeat the last 2 rows twice.

 $\mbox{\bf 37th}$ $\mbox{\bf Row}{\longrightarrow}\mbox{--Increase}$ 1 st at beginning of row, decrease 2 sts at end of row.

38th Row—Repeat 11th row.

39th Row-Repeat 37th row. Work 1 row even.

41st Row-Repeat 37th row.

42nd Row—Decrease 2 sts at beginning of row. Work 1 row even, cut thread.

44th Row—Attach Iridescent, ch 3, d c in 1st s c, ch 3, 2 d c in same space, * skip 3 s c, 2 d c, ch 3, 2 d c (shell) in next s c, repeat from * 7 times, ch 3 to turn each row.

45th Row—Work a shell in each of the next 8 shells, s c in last shell.

46th Row—Work 8 shells, turn.

47th Row—Work 7 shells, s c in last shell. Work 1 row even, turn.

49th Row—Ch 4, 1 tr c, ch 3, 2 tr c in next shell, 2 tr c, ch 3, 2 tr c (tr c shell) in next shell, work 5 more shells, ch 3, 2 tr c in same space as last shell (an increase), ch 4 to turn each row. Remainder of tail is worked with tr c shells.

Repeat last row 4 times ending last row with s c in last shell (a decrease), ch 4. turn.

55th Row—2 tr c, ch 3, 2 tr c in 1st shell, * shell in next shell, repeat from * across row, working 2 shells with ch 3 between in last shell, ch 4, turn. Work 1 row even working a shell in each ch 3 loop.

57th Row-Same as 55th row.

58th and 59th Rows—Work even omitting last shell in last row, ch 4, turn.

60th Row—Work 2 shells with ch 3 between in 1st shell, shell in each shell, s c in last shell, ch 4, turn.

61st and 62nd Rows—Repeat 58th and 59th rows.

63rd Row-Work 6 shells, ch 4, turn.

64th Row—Shell in 1st shell, ch 3, 2 tr c in same shell, shell in each of the next 4 shells, turn.
65th Row—SI st to 2nd shell, shell in same loop, shell in

each ch 3 loop, ch 3, 2 tr c in last ch 4 loop, ch 4, turn. **66th and 67th Rows**—Work 2 shells with ch 3 between in 1st ch 3 loop, shell in each shell omitting last shell, ch 4, turn.

68th Row—1 tr c, ch 3, 2 tr c in 2nd tr c, ch 3, shell in next ch 3 loop, shell in each of the next 5 shells, turn.

69th Row—SI st to 2nd shell, ch 4, tr c in same shell, shell in each of the next 4 loops, ch 4, turn.

70th Row—Shell in each shell, 2 shells with ch 3 between in last shell, turn.

71st Row—SI st over the first 3 shells, ch 4, shell in next shell, ch 4, sl st between next 2 shells, cut thread.

Attach thread in 1st ch 4 loop of 57th row, ch 4 working down side of tail, shell over each of the next 3 rows, s c in 2nd tr c of 60th row, ch 4, turn.

2nd Row—Shell in each of the next 2 shells, ch 4, turn.
3rd Row—1 tr c, ch 3, 2 tr c in loop of shell, shell in next shell, shell over ch 4 loop at end of row, shell in 1st shell of 61st row, 2 tr c in next shell already worked in, s c over ch 4 of next row, ch 4, turn.

4th Row—Shell in each of the next 3 shells, ch 4, turn.
5th Row—2 shells with ch 3 between in 1st shell, shell i

5th Row—2 shells with ch 3 between in 1st shell, shell in each of the next 2 shells, shell over ch 4 loop, shell in next shell, turn.

6th Row—SI st to 2nd shell, shell in same shell, shell in each ch 3 loop, turn.

7th Row—SI st to 2nd shell, shell in same shell, shell in next 3 shells, turn.

8th Row—SI st to 2nd shell, shell in same shell, shell in next shell, 2 shells with ch 3 between in next shell, ch 3, 2 tr c over last ch 4 loop, ch 4, turn.

9th Row-Work even omitting last shell, turn.

10 th Row—SI st to 2nd shell, shell in same shell, shell in each of the next 2 shells, turn.

11th Row—SI st to 2nd shell, shell in same shell, shell in last shell, cut thread.

CREST—Attach Green in 1st row of s c at back of head, ch 9, 4 s c in 2nd st from hook, cut thread. Attach thread in same space, ch 13, 4 s c in 2nd st from hook, cut thread. Attach thread in same space, ch 9, 4 s c in 2nd st from hook, cut thread.

With Black embroider eye using French Knot.

Applique peacock to pillow case as illustrated. Cut away material from underneath tail part of bird, leaving 1/28 inch to turn under and overcast.

EDGE—Attach Green at side of tail and work a row of s c around lower edge of pillow case to opposite side, ch 5, turn.

2nd Row—Skip 3 s c, s c in next s c, * ch 5, skip 3 s c, s c in next s c, repeat from * to same space at opposite side.

3rd Row—Ch 1, turn, 3 s c in 1st loop, ch 3, sl st in top of last s c for picot, 2 s c in same loop, * 3 s c in next loop, ch 3, sl st in top of last s c for picot, 2 s c in same space, repeat from * all around to same space at opposite side, cut thread.

BRANCH—With Shaded Browns ch 80, s d c in 3rd st from hook (s d c: thread over hook, insert in st, pull through, thread over and pull through all loops at one time), 1 s d c in each remaining st of ch, cut thread. Work another branch in same manner starting with ch 40. Work 4 more branches in same manner, starting with ch 25, then work one starting with ch 15. Sew in position on case as illustrated. Work another pillow case in same manner.



Materials Required: AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY The Famous "PURITAN" MERCERIZED CROCHET COTTON, Article 40 or "DE LUXE" Quality MERCERIZED CROCHET COTTON, Article 346 2 balls Shaded Yellows or The Famous "PURITAN" STAR SPANGLED MERCERIZED CROCHET COTTON, Article 40 4 balls Yellow Spangle or color of your choice. Steel crochet hook No. 7

Turkish bath towel 1 Turkish wash cloth

Ch 38, d c in 4th st from hook, 1 d c in each remaining st of ch.

2nd Row-Ch 3, turn, 1 d c in each d c. Repeat the 2nd row 6 times.

9th Row—Ch 6, turn, 2 d c in same space keeping last loop of each d c on hook, thread over and pull through all loops at one time (a 2 d c cluster st), * ch 1, skip 4 d c, 2 d c cluster st in next d c, ch 3, 2 d c cluster st in same space, repeat from * 5 times, ch 1, skip 4 d c, 2 d c cluster st in next d c, ch 3, d c in same space.

10th Row—Ch 6, turn, 2 d c cluster st in same space with ch 6, * ch 1, skip the ch 3 loop, 2 d c cluster st in next ch 1 space, ch 3, 2 d c cluster st in same space, repeat from * across row ending row with ch 1, 2 d c cluster st in 3rd st of end ch, ch 3, d c in same space.

Repeat the last row 16 times.

Next Row-Ch 3, turn, 2 d c in 1st loop, * s c in next ch 3 loop, ch 3, 2 d c in same loop (shell), repeat from * across www.antiquefacteralibrary with s c in 3rd st of end ch, ch 3, turn.

Next Row-2 d c in same space, s c in ch 3 loop of next shell, * ch 3, 2 d c in same space, s c in ch 3 loop of next shell, repeat from * across row, then work a row of s c down side of basket to within 2nd row from lower edge, work a shell over side of next row, across lower edge and over opposite side of same row finishing remainder of side

HANDLE—Ch 139, 2 d c in 4th st from hook, skip 2 sts of ch, s c in next st, * ch 3, 2 d c in same space (shell), skip 2 sts of ch, s c in next st, repeat from * across ch working 1 s c in end ch, 6 d c in same space, working on other side of ch work in shells to correspond to 1st side, cut thread.

EDGE—Ch 6, 2 d c in 6th st from hook keeping last loop of each d c on hook, thread over and pull through all loops at one time, ch 3, 2 d c cluster st in same space.

2nd Row—Ch 5, turn, 2 - 2 d c cluster sts with ch 3

between in ch 3 loop.

3rd Row-Same as 2nd row, then ch 3 and without turning and working across lower edge, work 6 d c with ch 1 between

each d c in next loop, s c in 1st ch made, ch 3, turn.

4th Row—S c in next ch 1 space between next 2 d c, * ch 4, s c in next ch 1 space, repeat from * 3 times, ch 3, skip 1 loop, 2 - 2 d c cluster sts with ch 3 between in next loop, ch 5, turn.

5th and 6th Rows—2 - 2 d c cluster sts with ch 3 between in next loop, ch 5 to turn each row.

7th Row—2 - 2 d c cluster sts with ch 3 between in next

loop, ch 3 and working across lower edge, work 6 d c with ch 1 between each d c in next loop, ch 1, s c in next loop of previous scallop, ch 3, turn. Repeat from 4th row for length desired ending with 4th row of pattern, do not ch 5 at end of last row, cut thread.
With "STAR" MERCERIZED SEWING THREAD, sew to lower

edge of towel. Sew basket in position on towel as illustrated leaving top of basket open for face cloth. Sew handle in position on towel.


EDGE FOR FACE CLOTH—Ch 6, 2 d c in 6th st from hook leaving last loop of each d c on hook, thread over and pull through all loops at one time, ch 3, 2 d c cluster st in same

space, ch 5, turn.

2nd Row—2 - 2 d c cluster sts with ch 3 between in the ch 3 loop, ch 5, turn.

3rd Row-SI st in 3rd st from hook for picot, ch 2, 2 - 2 d c cluster sts with ch 3 between in loop between cluster sts of previous row, ch 5, turn. Repeat the 2nd and 3rd rows for length desired omitting ch 5 at end of last row, cut thread. Sew around face cloth as illustrated.





The Butterfly Corner

The Red and White Handkerchief Edging

Materials Required — AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" TATTING MERCERIZED CROCHET COTTON,

Article 125 1 ball each White and Bright Red or colors of your choice 1 Handkerchief

Steel crochet hook No. 13

With Red ch 5, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 10 s c

in ring, join, drop Red.

Attach White in 1st s c, * ch 4, 3 d tr c (3 times over hook) in same space, 3 d tr c in next s c, ch 4, sl st in same space, sl st in next s c, repeat from * 4 times, cut White thread.

Next Row—Pick up Red, ch 4, 1 s c in each of the 6 d tr c of 1st petal, ch 4, sl st in 1st row between petals, * ch 4, 1 s c in each of the 6 d tr c of next petal, ch 4, sl st in 1st row between petals, repeat from * 3 times, cut thread. Work a 2nd flower joining center of one petal to center of any petal of 1st flower in last row. Work a 3rd flower joining to 2nd flower in same manner leaving 1 petal free at lower edge and 2 petals at outside edge. Work a 4th flower same as 1st flower.

Sew the 3 flowers in corner as illustrated leaving 2 entire petals of side flowers extend over the hem of handkerchief. Sew 4th flower between the 2 upper flowers as illustrated. Attach White in hem next to flower to left at corner flower and working around handkerchief, * ch 5, skip 1/4 inch space, s c in next space, repeat from * to corner having an uneven number of loops on side, ch 7, s c in same space (corner), ch 5, skip 1/4 inch space, s c in next space, repeat from * all around having an uneven number of loops on each side not counting corner loop and working all corners same as 1st corner, working to flower on last side, cut thread.

2nd Row-Attach White in 1st loop on opposite side, * ch 6, cluster st in next loop (cluster st: 4 d c in same space keeping last loop of each d c on hook, thread over and pull through all loops at one time), ch 6, s c in next loop, repeat from * across side to corner loop, ch 6, 2 cluster sts with ch 6 between in corner loop, ch 6, s c in next loop, * ch 6, cluster st in next loop, ch 6, s c in next loop, repeat from * all around to flower at opposite side working all corners same as 1st corner, cut thread.

3rd Row—Attach Red in same space where 1st row was started, ch 6, s c in top of 1st cluster st, ch 3, s c in same space, ch 6, sl st in next s c, * ch 6, s c in top of next cluster st, ch 3, s c in same space, ch 6, sl st in next s c, repeat from * to the s c before corner, ch 6, s c in top of 1st cluster st at corner, ch 3, s c in same space, ch 5, s c in next loop, ch 5, s c in top of next cluster st ut come, st. 2, s c in same space, * ch 6, sl st in next s c, ch 6, s c in top of next cluster st, ch 3, s c in same space, repeat from * around next 3 sides working all corners same as 1st corner on the state of the s next loop, ch 5, s c in top of next cluster st at corner, ch 3, and working to flower on last side, cut thread.

Materials required: AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY For Handkerchiefs-Needle STAR Tatting Cotton Article 125 Pillow Cases or Towels-GEM Crochet Cotton Article 35, Size 30 or The Famous "PURITAN" MERCERIZED CROCHET COTTON, Article 40 or "DELUXE" Quality MERCERIZED CROCHET COTTON, Article 346 Shaded Yellows and Nile Green or Lt. Green or Colors of Your Choice

BODY-With Green ch 3, 3 d c in 3rd st from hook, ch 1,

2nd Row—1 s c in each st (4 s c), ch 1, turn.

3rd Row—2 s c in 1st s c, 1 s c in each of the next 2 s c, 2 s c in next s c, ch 1, turn.

4th Row-1 s c in each s c. Repeat the last row 13 times. Next Row—Decrease 1 s c at beginning and end of row

(4 s c), ch 2, turn.

Next Row—* Thread over hook, insert in next s c, pull through and work off 2 loops, repeat from * twice, thread over and pull through all loops at one time, ch 28 for feeler, insert hook in 2nd st from hook, pull loop through, * insert hook in next st of ch, pull loop through, repeat from * twice, thread over and pull through all loops at one time, cut thread leaving an end, thread into needle and fasten securely. Attach thread in same space on head and work another feeler in same manner.

Attach Shaded Yellows in 8th row from lower edge of body, * ch 5, skip 1 row, s c in next row, repeat from * 3 times (4 loops), ch 5, turn.

2nd Row-3 d c, ch 3, 3 d c in 1st loop, ch 4, skip 1 loop, 3 d c, ch 3, 3 d c (shell) in next loop, ch 1, shell in next

loop, ch 5, turn.

3rd Row—Shell in center of 1st shell, ch 5, skip the ch 1 space, shell in center of next shell, ch 3, 7 d c over next loop, ch 3, shell in center of next shell, ch 5, turn.

4th Row—Shell in center of shell, ch 3, 1 d c in each of the next 7 d c with ch 1 between each d c, ch 3, shell in center of next shell, ch 4, s c in next loop, ch 4, shell in shell, ch 5, turn.

5th Row-Shell in shell, ch 5, s c in next s c, ch 5, shell in next shell, ch 4, s c between 1st 2 d c, * ch 3, s c between next 2 d c, repeat from * 4 times, ch 4, shell in next shell,

6th Row-Shell in shell, ch 6, skip 1 loop, s c in next loop, * ch 3, s c in next loop, repeat from * 3 times, ch 6, 3 d c, ch 3, 3 d c, ch 3, 3 d c in center of next shell, ch 6, s c in next s c, ch 6, shell in next shell, ch 5, turn.

7th Row—Shell in shell, ch 6, s c in next s c, ch 6, skip 1 loop, shell in next ch 3 loop, ch 5, turn.

8th Row-6 d c in center of 1st shell, 6 d c in center of next shell, ch 1, turn.

Next Row-1 s c in each of the 12 d c, cut thread, this completes lower wing.

Attach thread in 1st free ch 3 loop of 6th row next to lower Continued on Page 10

3rd Round—Ch 3, * 5 d c in next mesh, d c in next d c, repeat from * all around ending with 5 d c in last mesh, join in 3rd st of ch.

4th Round—Ch 4, 1 tr c in each of the next 5 d c, * ch 5, 1 tr c in each of the next 6 d c, repeat from * all around, ch 5, join in 4th st of ch.

5th Round—Ch 4, 1 tr c in each of the next 5 tr c keeping last loop of each tr c on hook, thread over and work off all loops at one time, * ch 7, s c in center st of next loop, ch 7, 1 tr c in each of the next 6 tr c keeping last loop of each tr c on hook, thread over and work off all loops at one time, repeat from * all around ending with ch 7, s c in center st of next loop, ch 2, tr c in top of 1st cluster (this brings thread in position for next round).

6th Round-* Ch 9, s c in center st of next loop, repeat from * all around ending with ch 9, sl st in tr c.

7th Round—SI st to center st of loop, ch 4 (counts as part of 1st cluster st), tr c in same space, ch 3, 2 tr c in same space keeping last loop of each tr c on hook, thread over and work off all loops at one time (tr c cluster st), ch 3, tr c cluster st in same space, * ch 2, 3 tr c cluster sts with ch 3 between each cluster st in center st of next loop, repeat from * all around, ch 2, join.

8th Round—SI st into loop between 1st 2 cluster sts, ch 8, d c in next loop, * ch 6, skip 1 loop, d c in next loop, ch 5, d c in next loop, repeat from * all around, ending with d tr c (3 times over hook) in 3rd st of ch.

9th Round—Ch 4, 7 tr c over the d tr c just made, tr c in next st, * ch 4, skip 1 loop, 7 tr c over next loop, tr c in next d c, repeat from * all around, tr c in 4th st of ch.

10th Round—Ch 4, 2 tr c over tr c just made, ch 3, 3 tr c in same space, * ch 4, s c in center st of next tr c group, ch 4, 3 tr c, ch 3, 3 tr c (shell) in next loop, repeat from * all around ending with ch 4, s c in center st of next tr c group, ch 4, join in 4th st of ch.

11th Round—SI st to center of shell, ch 4, 2 tr c, ch 3, 3 tr c in same space, * ch 3, tr c in next s c, ch 3, shell in next shell, repeat from * all around ending with ch 3, tr c in

next's c, ch 3, join.

12th Round—SI st to center of shell, ch 4, 2 tr c, ch 3, 3 tr c in same space, * ch 4, 1 tr c in each of the next 2 loops keeping last loop of each tr c on hook, thread over and work off all loops at one time (tr c cluster), ch 4, shell in next shell, repeat from * all around ending to correspond, ch 4, join.





DIRECTIONS FOR STARCHING

Starch: Dissolve $\frac{1}{4}$ cup starch in $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of cold water. Boil about $\frac{1}{4}$ cups of water, remove from flame, then slowly stir the starch mixture into boiling water stirring constantly. Place back on flame until it thickens.

As soon as starch is cool enough to handle, dip doily and squeeze starch through it thoroughly. Wring out extra starch. The doily should be wet with starch but there should be none in the spaces. Pin center of doily in position according to size and leave until thoroughly dry. If steam iron is used iron ruffle after it is dry. If regular iron is used dampen ruffle slightly before pressing. Pin folds of ruffle in position and leave until thoroughly dry.

3rd Row-Shell in center of shell, ch 8, 1 tr c in 1st s c, * ch 1, skip 1 s c, tr c in next s c, repeat from * 8 times, ch 8, shell in center of next shell, ch 6, turn.

4th Row-Shell in center of shell, ch 8, s c in 1st tr c of pineapple, * s c in next ch 1 space, s c in next tr c, repeat from * 8 times, ch 8, shell in center of shell, ch 6, turn.

5th Row-Shell in shell, ch 8, tr c in 1st s c, * ch 1, tr c in next s c, repeat from * 17 times, ch 8, shell in center of next shell, ch 6, turn.



21st Row—Skip 1 st, decrease in next 2 sts, 1 s c in each remaining s c, increasing 1 s c in last s c, ch 3, turn.

22nd Row—S c in 2nd st from hook, s c in next st of ch, 1 s c in each of the next 5 sts, ch 1, turn.

23rd Row—Skip 1 st, 1 s c in each remaining s c increasing 1 s c in last s c, cut thread.

Work 2 more birds in same manner.

FLOWERS: With Tinted Pink and Yellow ch 6, join to form a ring, * ch 4, work 3 tr c in ring keeping last loop of each st on hook, thread over and work off all loops at one time, ch 4, s c in ring, repeat from * 3 times, cut thread. Work 7 more flowers in same manner.

Applique birds and flowers to pillow case as illustrated. With Yellow "STAR" SIX STRAND EMBROIDERY COTTON work a French Knot in center of each flower. Embroider a Black French Knot for eye. Embroider beak with Yellow using a straight st as illustrated.

EDGE: With White work a row of s c around lower edge of

pillow case, join.

2nd Row—Ch 7, tr c in same space, * skip 3 s c, tr c, ch 3, tr c in next st (shell), repeat from * all around, join in 4th st of ch.

3rd Row—Ch 7, tr c in same space, * shell in 1st tr c of next shell, repeat from * all around, join, cut thread.
4th Row—Attach Blue, * 2 s c in next loop, ch 3, 2 s c in same space, repeat from * all around, join in 1st s c, cut thread. Work another pillow case in same manner.

Work a joining motif in each of the next 7 spaces around center motif.

STRAP: Attach Blue in 3rd s c, s c in same space, 1 s c in next s c.

Next Row—1 s c in each s c. Repeat last row 4 times, cut thread. Skip 5 s c from strap of 8th row, attach thread in next s c and work other strap to correspond.

Attach Pink in 1st s c of 8th row, s c in same space, work 1 s c in each s c working under each strap. Work 1 row even in s c.

Next Row—Decrease 1 s c at the beginning and end of row (to decrease: insert hook in st, pull loop through, insert hook in next st, pull loop through, thread over and work off all loops at one time). Work 1 row even. Repeat last 2 rows once.

START SLEEVE: Working down side of bodice, skip 1 row, work 2 s c in each remaining row of Pink (10 s c), ch 1, turn. Working in s c, work 1 s c in each s c.

3rd Row—2 s c in next loop, ch 3, sl st in last s c for picot, 1 s c in same loop, 4 s c in next loop, ch 3, sl st in last s c for picot, 3 s c in same loop, tr c cluster st in next loop (cluster st: 3 tr c in loop keeping last loop of each st on hook, thread over and work off all loops at one time), ch 3, sl st in cluster st for picot, * ch 3, cluster st in same loop, ch 3 picot, repeat from * once, 4 s c, ch 3 picot, 3 s c in next loop, repeat from beginning 3 times, * 2 s c, ch 3 picot, 1 s c in next loop, repeat from * 3 times, * c luster st, ch 3, tr c cluster st in next loop, ch 3 picot, ch 3, tr c cluster st, ch 3 picot in same loop, * ch 3, 2 s c, ch 3 picot, 1 s c in next loop, repeat from * twice, repeat from ** to opposite side of skirt, join in 1st s c, cut thread.

HAT—With Pink ch 5, join to form a ring, ch 3 and work 3 d c, 5 tr c, 4 d c, 5 tr c in ring, join, cut thread.

2nd Row—Attach Iridescent in 1st d c, * ch 3, sl st in same space, ch 1, skip 1 st, sl st in next st, repeat from * all around.

3rd Row—* Ch 2, sl st in next ch 1 space, ch 3, keeping loop to front of work sl st in same space, repeat from * all around, cut thread.

4th Row—Attach Blue in ch 2 loop, * ch 3, s c in same space, repeat from * once, ch 3, s c in next loop, repeat from 1st * all around, join, cut thread. With "STAR" MERCERIZED SEWING THREAD, sew to top of head as illustrated. Embroider mouth with Red "STAR" SIX STRAND EMBROIDERY COTTON and neck and hat band with Black as illustrated.

BOUQUET—With Iridescent, ch 2, 6 s c in 2nd st from hook, join.

2nd Row—Keeping all loops to front of work, * ch 5, sl st in same space, ch 2, sl st in next s c, repeat from * all around.

6th Round-Working up side of petal center, work 1 tr c in each of the next 10 sts of petal center, ch 3, sl st in same space, sl st in top of petal center, then working down opposite side of petal center, ch 3 and picking up back loop of sts only, work 1 tr c in each of the next 10 s c, s c in next d c of previous round, repeat from beginning 7 times, cut White.

Next Round-Attach Yellow in 4th tr c from top of petal on left hand side, ch 3, tr c in 4th tr c from top on right hand side of next petal, ch 9, s c in center st at top of same petal, * ch 9, thread over hook twice, insert in 4th tr c from top on left hand side of same petal, pull through and work off 2 loops twice, thread over hook twice, insert in 4th tr c from top on right hand side of next petal, pull through and work off 2 loops twice, thread over and pull through all loops at one time, ch 9, s c in center st at top of same petal, repeat from * all around, ch 9, join in 1st tr c.

Next Round—3 s c over next loop, ch 3, sl st in last s c for picot, 3 s c, picot, 5 s c over same loop, s c in next s c, picot, 3 s c over next loop, ch 9, turn, skip 1 picot and 2 s c, sl st in next s c, ch 1, turn and work 3 s c, picot, 3 s c, picot, 3 s c, picot, 3 s c, picot, 3 s c over loop just made (outside loop), sl st in last s c of previous loop, 2 s c, picot, 3 s c, picot, 3 s c over remainder of loop, s c in next st, repeat from beginning all around, join, cut Yellow.

5th Row—SI st in each of the next 5 s c, drop Green, attach Yellow and work 1 s c in each of the next 23 s c, ch 1,

6th Row-1 s c in each s c, drop Yellow. When changing color always complete last half of st with next color.

Next Row-Pick up Green and working in s c work 2 rows Green, 2 rows Yellow, 2 rows Green, 2 rows Yellow, 2 rows Green, cut thread.

17th Row—Ch 5, turn, d c in same space, * skip 1 s c, 1 d c, ch 2, 1 d c (shell) in next s c, repeat from * across

18th Row—Ch 5, turn, d c in same space, * 1 d c, ch 2, 1 d c in 1st d c of next shell, repeat from * across row working a shell in 3rd st of end ch. Repeat last row 8 times, ch 4, turn.

27th Row-1 d c, ch 1, 1 d c in 1st shell, s c in 1st d c of next shell, * 3 d c with ch 1 between each d c in center of next shell, s c in 1st d c of next shell, repeat from * across top ending with 3 d c with ch 1 between each d c in last shell, then work a row of s c down side of basket, work around lower edge in same pattern as across top and work in s c up opposite side, cut thread.

HANDLE—With Green ch 109, s c in 2nd st from hook,

1 s c in each remaining st of ch, ch 4, turn.

2nd Row-D c in same space, ch 1, d c in same space, ch 1, d c in same space, * skip 2 s c, s c in next s c, skip 2 s c, 4 d c with ch 1 between each d c in next s c, repeat from * across row, cut thread. With "STAR" MERCERIZED SEWING THREAD, sew in position as illustrated leaving 5 scallops free

FLOWER—With Yellow ch 4, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 5 s c in ring, join, cut Yellow. Attach any color, * ch 2, 3 d c in same space, ch 2, s c in same space, s c in next s c, repeat from * 4 times, cut thread, All flowers are worked in same manner having 3 Blue, 3 Tinted Pink and Yellow, 3 Pink and 6 Yellow. The Yellow flowers have Green centers.

STEM-With Green ch 6, sl st between any 2 petals of flowers, ch 1, skip 1 st of ch, 1 sl st in each of the next 5 sts of ch, ch 8, sl st between any 2 petals of next flower of same Color, ch 1, skip 1 st of ch, 1 sl st in each of the next 7 sts, ch 6, sl st between any 2 petals of 3rd flower of same Color, ch 1, skip 1 st of ch, 1 sl st in each of the next 5 sts, cut Green. Join each Color in groups of 3 in same manner. Sew to top of basket as illustrated arranging Colors as desired having a Yellow group at each end of basket. Applique basket in position on pillow case about 1 inch above hemstitching at center. Work 2 more Yellow, 2 Pink and 2 Tinted Pink and Yellow flowers and sew in position as illustrated.

EDGE—With Green work a row of s c around hemstitched edge of pillow case, join, drop Green.

2nd Row—With Yellow 1 s c in each s c, join, cut Yellow. 3rd Row-Pick up Green, ch 4, 4 d c in same space with ch 1 between each d c, * skip 3 s c, s c in next s c, skip 3 s c, 5 d c with ch 1 between each d c in next s c, repeat from all around, join, cut thread. Work another pillow case in 08.2013 same manner.
