

No. 1

Chain. Make loop in thread, insert needle, pick up thread and draw through loop. Continue to length desired.

No. 2

Single Crochet. Put hook through stitch, pick up thread, draw through, pick up thread again and draw through both stitches on hook.

No. 3

Half Treble Crochet. Thread over hook, put through stitch, thread over hook and draw thread through all three stitches on hook.

No. 4

Double Crochet. Thread over needle once, put hook through stitch, thread over hook and draw through stitch, thread over hook, draw through two stitches, thread over hook and draw through remaining two stitches.

No. 5

Treble Crochet. Same as double crochet except that thread should be put around needle twice and work off two stitches at a time.

No. 6

Double Treble Crochet. Same as double except that thread should be put around needle three times and work off two stitches at a time.

No. 7

Picot. Make a chain of four stitches, fasten with sc in first stitch of chain.

No. 8

Slip Stitch. Put thread through work, pick up thread, draw through both stitches at once.

No. 9

Mesh or Space. Make one double in stitch, ch two, miss two stitches, double in next stitch.

No. 10

Block. A block is used in filet crochet, there being four doubles to a block.

No. 11

Cluster. Make three or four trebles in stitch, keeping last stitch of each treble on hook, then put thread over needle and draw through all remaining loops.

No. 12


Cross Treble. Thread over needle twice, insert in stitch, thread over needle, draw through two stitches, thread over needle, miss two or three stitches, insert hook thread over needle, draw through two stitches; thread over needle, draw through two stitches; thread over needle, draw through two remaining stitches; chain three, make one double in center of double.

Directions for Edge on Cover of Book

1ST ROW—2 sc in each hole of hemstitching.
2ND ROW—Sc in st of first row, ch 7, dc in same st as sc, ch 2 miss 4 st, sc in next st, ch 3 miss 4 st, dc in next, turn; 2 dc over 2 ch, 1 dc in dc, ch 2, dc in 3rd dc of 7 ch, turn ch 5—3 sp—ch 2 miss 4 st, sc in next, ch 3 miss 4 st. dc in next, turn, 2 dc over 3 ch, dc in dc, 1 sp, 1 bl, 1 sp,

turn ch 5, 5 sp, miss 4 st, dc in next, ch 5 dc in same st as last dc made ch 2 miss 4 st, sc in next, ch 3 miss 4 st, dc in next, turn; 2 dc in sp, dc in dc, ch 2, 1 dc, in 3rd st of 5 ch repeat from, *.

3RD ROW-1 sc 1 picot, 1 sc, in each sp.



1ST ROW—2 sc in each hole of hemstitching. Make 6 dc in every seventh hole.

2ND ROW—Fasten in 6th st from shell, * ch 2, quadruple tr, (4 times around needle) in first dc, 3 dc in center of quadruple tr, picot, miss 1 dc, quadruple tr in next dc, 3 dc in center of quadruple tr, picot, repeat twice, ch 2, miss 5 st, 3 sc in next 3 st, repeat from *.

No. 301

1ST ROW-2 sc in each hole of hemstitching

2ND ROW—Start with cross tr, ch 3, 8 dc over 3 ch; * turn, ch 4, miss 1 dc, sc in next, repeat around shell, dc in base of cross tr, ch 2, miss 3 st, sc in next; turn, ch 4, fasten with sc in last loop on shell; turn ch 4, sc in 4 ch just made, miss 3 st, dc in next; turn, ch 3, 8 dc over 4 ch; repeat from *.

No. 302

1ST ROW—2 sc in each hole of hemstitching.

2ND ROW—Sc in sc, * ch 2, miss 3 st, dc in next, ch 3, dc in same st, ch 2, miss 3 st, sc in next, repeat from *.

3RD ROW—3 dc in dc of second row, 3 picots * 3 dc in next dc, 3 dc in next dc, 3 picots, repeat from *.

No. 303

1ST ROW-2 sc in each hole of hemstitching.

2ND ROW—3 sc in 3 sc, * ch 5 miss 4 st, dc in next st, ch 5 miss 4, 3 sc in next 3 st, repeat from *.

3RD ROW—*1 sc, 1 half dc and 6 dc over 5 ch, 3 picots, dc back in base of first picot, 6 dc, 1 half dc, 1 sc, over next 5 ch, sc in sc, repeat from *.

No. 304

1ST ROW—2 sc in each hole of hemstitching, make a loop of 6 ch, every 7 holes.


2ND ROW—3 sc in 3 sc, this brings you within 3 st of loop, 2 dc in loop, ch 5, * sc in 2nd st from needle, 1 half dc in next st, 3 dc in next 3 st, 2 dc in loop, ch 6, 1 sc in 2nd st from needle, 1 half dc in next st, 4 dc in next 4 st, 2 dc in loop, ch 5, sc in 2nd st from needle, 1 half dc in next st, 3 dc in next 3 st, 2 dc in loop, miss 3 st of first row, 3 sc in next 3 st, 2 dc in next loop, ch 5, sc in point last made, repeat from *.

No. 305

1ST ROW—2 sc in each hole of hemstitching.

2ND ROW—Sc in sc, * ch 4, miss 3 st, cluster in next, ch 4, miss 3 st, sc in next, ch 4, miss 3, cluster in next st, repeat.

3RD ROW—Dc in top of cluster * ch 3, dc in same st, repeat twice, dc in next cluster, ch 3, dc in same st, repeat twice, dc in next cluster, repeat.



1ST ROW—Sc in hole of hemstitching, 3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc in next hole, 2 sc in each hole for 5 holes, 3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc in next hole, repeat.

2ND ROW—3 dc, 3 picots, 3 dc over 3 ch, ch 3, a cluster of 2 dc between shells, ch 3, 3 dc, 3 picots, 3 dc over next 3 ch, repeat.

No. 307

1ST ROW-2 sc in each hole of hemstitching.

2ND ROW—4 dc in sc, ch 2, miss 4 st, 4 dc in next st, repeat.

3RD ROW—Dc in first dc of shell, * ch 5, fasten back in 4th st for picot, ch 1, dc in same st, as first dc, ch 2, sc in last dc of shell, ch 2, dc in first dc of next shell, repeat from *.

No. 308

1ST ROW—Sc in hole of hemstitching, make 3 picots of 5 ch each, sc in same hole, 2 sc in each hole for 9 holes, 3 picots in next, repeat.

2ND ROW—Fasten in 7th st from picots, ch 5, sc in 4th st from needle for picot, ch 1, cluster of 3 tr in first picot, ch 5, sc in 4th st from needle for picot ch 1, cluster in next picot, repeat once, ch 5, sc in 4th st from needle, ch 1, miss 6 st, 2 sc in next 2 st, repeat.

No. 309

1ST ROW—2 sc in each hole of hemstitching.

2ND ROW—Sc in sc, ch 3, miss 3 st, * dc in next st, bullion st over dc just made, (thread around needle, under dc, around needle, under dc three or four times, thread around needle and draw through all loops on needle, fasten with sl st). Ch 2, miss 3 st, sc, picot, sc in next st; ch 3, miss 3 st, dc in next, bullion st over dc, repeat.

3RD ROW—3 dc in last st of 3 ch, to the right of bullion st, * ch 3, 3 dc in first st of 3 ch, to left of bullion st, 3 dc in last st of next 3 ch, repeat from *.

No. 310

1ST ROW-2 sc in each hole of hemstitching.

2ND ROW—Dc in sc, * 2 dc in next 2 st, keeping last st of each dc on needle until the three dc are made, then take off 3 st, thread over needle take off last two st, ch 2, cross tr, ch 2, dc in base of cross tr, repeat from *.

3RD ROW—* 3 dc in st at the right of cross tr, ch 5, sc in 4th st from needle, ch 2, 4 dc in st at the left of cross tr, sc in top of cluster, repeat from *.

No. 311

1ST ROW-2 dc in each hole of hemstitching.

2ND ROW—Sc in sc, ch 8, sc in 6th st from needle, * ch 2, miss 3 st of first row, dc in next, miss 3 st, dc in next, ch 7 sc back in 5th st, repeat from *.

3RD ROW—3 dc, 3 picots, 3 dc in picot of 2nd row, 3 dc, 3 picots, 3 dc in next picot, repeat.



1ST ROW-2 sc in each hole of hemstitching.

2ND ROW—Sc in sc, * ch 2, miss 3 st, dc in next st, ch 2, cross tr, ch 2, dc in base of cross tr, ch 2, miss 3 st, 5 sc in next 5 st, repeat from *.

3RD ROW—* 3 dc over 2 ch, picot dc over next 2 ch, picot, 4 dc over 3 ch at top, picot, 3 dc over 2 ch, picot, 3 dc over last 2 ch, sc in third sc of second row, repeat from *.

1ST ROW-2 sc in each hole of hemstitching.

2ND ROW—Sc in sc, ch 3, miss 4 st, dc in next, ch 4, sc in same st as dc, ch 3 miss 4 st, dc in next, repeat from *.

3RD ROW—Sc in top of dc, ch 3, 2 dc in same st, sc in top of next dc, ch 3, 2 dc in same st, sc in top of next dc, repeat.

No. 314

1ST ROW-2 sc in each hole of hemstitching.

2ND ROW—4 dc in 4 sc of first row, * ch 3, miss 4 st, sc in next, ch 10, sc in last dc just made, ch 2, make dc, with picot between, 7 times over 10 ch, ch 2, sc in third st from base of 10 ch, miss 4 st, 4 dc in next 4 st, repeat from *.

No. 315

1ST ROW-2 sc in each hole of hemstitching.

2ND ROW—Sc in sc, ch 9, sc in 6th st from needle, turn, ch 3, 2 dc in loop, take last st of the two dc off needle at same time, ch 3, sc in loop; repeat twice; ch 3, miss 6 st, sc in next, ch 9, sc in 6th st from needle, turn; ch 3, 2 dc in loop, fasten with sc in last cluster made, ch 3, sc in loop, repeat twice, ch 3, miss 6 st, sc in next, repeat.

No. 316

1ST ROW-2 sc st in each hole of hemstitching.

2ND ROW—A cluster of 3 tr in sc, * ch 7, 3 tr in same st, miss 4 st, tr in next, ch 3, tr in same st as tr just made, miss 4 st, cluster in next, repeat from *.

3RD ROW—Fasten in 2nd st of 7 ch, * ch 6, sc in 6th st of 7 ch, ch 3, sc in 3 ch, ch 3, sc in 2nd st of 7 ch, repeat from *.

4TH ROW—* 2 sc, picot 2 sc, picot, 2 sc, picot, 2 sc over 6 ch, 2 sc over 3 ch, 2 sc over next 3 ch, repeat from *.

No. 317

1ST ROW-2 sc in each hole of hemstitching.


2ND ROW—Sc in sc, picot, miss 3 st, dc in next st, 3 picots, dc in same st as previous dc, picot, miss 3 st, 3 sc in next 3 st, repeat from *.

No. 318

1ST ROW—Sc in hemstitching, make a cluster of 3 picots, sc in same hole as first sc, 2 sc in next 7 holes, 3 picots, repeat.

2ND ROW—Dc in 7th st from picots, miss 2 st, dc in next st, dc in 1st picot, ch 3, * 4 dc over dc; dc in next picot, ch 3, 4 dc over dc; d in 3rd picot, ch 3, 4 dc over dc, miss 2 st of first row, dc in next, miss 3 st, dc in next st, dc in picot, repeat from *.

1ST ROW—2 sc in each hole of hemstitching for 8 holes, * turn, ch 6, miss 5 st, sc in next, ch 6, miss 5 st, sc in next, turn; 8 sc over 6 ch, 4 sc over next 6 ch, turn; ch 6, sc in 5th sc of first loop, turn, 8 sc over 6 ch, 4 sc over 6 ch, 2 sc in each hole for 8 holes, repeat from *.

2ND ROW—Dc in first sc of top loop, * ch 1, dc in next 3 st, 3 picots, dc in base of first picot, dc with 1 ch between in next 4 st, dc in next loop, repeat from *.

No. 320

1ST ROW-2 sc in each hole of hemstitching.

2ND ROW—Dc in sc, * ch 3, dc in same st as first d, miss 3 st, dc in next st, ch 3, 4 dc over dc, miss 3 st, dc in next st, repeat from *.

3RD ROW—Sc over 3 ch, * 3 dc in each st of 3 ch with 1 ch between, dc in each of the 4 dc with 1 ch between, ch 1 sc over 3 ch, ch 1, repeat from *.

No. 321

1ST ROW—2 sc in each hole of hemstitching for 6 holes, turn; ch 7, miss 6 st, sc in next st; turn; 10 sc over 7 ch, * 2 sc in each hole of hemstitching for 10 holes, turn; ch 7, miss 6 st, sc in next st, turn; 10 sc over 7 ch, continue from *.

2ND ROW—Sc in 3rd st from loop, dc in sc in loop, *; picot, dc, picot, dc, around loop (10 times), sc in 3rd st from loop, miss 3 st, dc in next, picot, dc in same st, dc, repeat twice, miss 3 st, sc in next st, dc in next loop, repeat from *.

No. 322

1ST ROW-2 sc in each hole of hemstitching.

2ND ROW—Sc in st in first row, ch 3, miss 3 st, dc in next st, * make 4 sc over dc, sc in base of dc, ch 3, miss 3, dc in next, repeat from *.

3RD ROW—2 dc in top of dc, * picot, 2 dc in same st as first 2 dc, 2 dc in top of next dc, repeat from *.

No. 323

1ST ROW-2 sc in each hole of hemstitching.

2ND ROW—Dc in st of first row, * ch 4, dc back in base of 4 ch, dc in same st as first dc, miss 3 st, dc in next st, repeat from *.


3RD ROW—Sc over loop of 4 ch, ch 2, dc over next 4 ch, ch 3, 4 dc over dc just made, dc over next 4 ch, ch 3, 4 dc over dc just made, repeat.

2ND ROW—Sc in sc, ch 2, * miss 3, dc in next, ch 2, cross treble, ch 2, dc in base of cross treble, ch 2, miss 3, sc in next, sl st for 5 st, ch 2, repeat from *

3RD ROW—Sc in space of 2 ch, * ch 3, 2 dc in same space, work off all dc together, picot, ch 3, sc in same space, sc in next space, repeat from * around 5 spaces ch 2, sc in third st between shells, ch 2, 3 dc in next space, picot, ch 3, sc in same space, repeat.





2ND ROW—Sc in 4th stitch from shell, ch 1, tr in first dc of shell, tr in 2nd dc of shell, work off both tr together, ch 5, fasten back in 4th st for picot, ch 1, tr in 2nd dc, tr in 3rd dc, continue around shell, ch 1, sc st in st, half way between shells.


