To change the size of an edging for another purpose, use any J. & P. Coats or Clark's O.N.T. Thread other than the one specified; consult chart for size of hook for each thread.

MATERIALS:

J. & P. Coats Tatting-Crochet, Size 70, 2 balls of White Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 13 . . A rolled edge handkerchief, 12 inches square.

Attach thread to any corner. 1st rnd: sc in same corner, sc closely around (16 sc to 1 inch), having 5 sc in each corner. Join with sl st to first sc. 2nd rnd: SI st in next sc, ch 5, dc in same sc, ch 7, in next sc make dc, ch 2 and dc (shell made); ch 7, shell in next sc, * ch 7, skip next 8 sc, shell in next sc. Repeat from * across to within 7 sc of next 5-sc group at corner, ch 7, skip next 8 sc, (shell in next sc, ch 7) 3 times; skip next 8 sc, shell in next sc. Continue working in pattern, making corners as previous corner was made. Join to 3rd ch of ch-5. 3rd rnd: SI st in sp of shell, ch 5, dc in same sp, * ch 7, shell in sp of next shell. Repeat from * around. Join to 3rd ch of ch-5. 4th rnd: SI st in sp of shell, ch 7, * holding back on hook the last loop of each tr, make 5 tr in next sp,

thread over and draw through all loops on hook (cluster made), ch 4, dc in sp of next shell, ch 4. Repeat from * around. Join to 3rd ch of ch-7. 5th rnd: Sl st to center of next sp, sc in same sp, * ch 5, sc in next sp, ch 7, sc in next sp. Repeat from * around. Join. 6th rnd: Sl st in next loop, ch 8, in same loop make (dc, ch 5) twice and dc; * ch 3, sc in next loop, ch 3, in next loop make (dc, ch 5) 3 times and dc. Repeat from * around. Join to 3rd ch of ch-8. Break off.

MATERIALS:

J. & P. Coats or Clark's O.N.T. Mercerized Sewing Thread, Size 50, 2 spools of White. Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 15 . . A rolled edge handkerchief, 11 inches square.

1st rnd: Attach White to any corner, 5 sc in same corner, sc closely

around (24 sc to 1 inch), making 5 sc in each corner. Join with sl st to first sc made. 2nd rnd: SI st in next 2 sc, ch 7, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr, make 2 tr in same place as last sl st, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (cluster made); ch 3, tr in same place, * ch 3, skip next 3 sc, cluster in next sc, ch 3, skip next 3 sc, tr in next sc. Repeat from * across side, ending with cluster in 4th sc from center sc of 5-sc group at corner, ch 3, in center sc of 5-sc group make tr, ch 3, cluster, ch 3 and tr; ch 3, skip next 3 sc, cluster in next sc. Continue working as before, making corners as previous corner was made. Join to 4th ch of ch-7. 3rd rnd: SI st in next sp, sc in same sp, * ch 5, sc in next sp, ch 7, sc in next sp. Repeat from * around. Join. 4th rnd: SI st in next loop, ch 4, tr in same loop, ch 4, in same loop make (cluster, ch 4) twice; * sc in next loop, ch 4, cluster in next loop, ch 4. Repeat from * around, making corners as before and ending with sc in last loop, ch 4. Join with sl st to top of ch-4. Break off.

MATERIALS:

J. & P. Coats or Clark's O.N.T. Mercerized Sewing Thread, Size 50, 1 spool each of White, No. 25 Steel and No 73-C Maize . . . Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 15 . . . A rolled edge handkerchief, 113/4 inches square.

1st rnd: Attach Steel to edge of handkerchief and sc closely around (24 sc to 1 inch). Join and break off. 2nd rnd: Attach White to 12th sc preceding center sc of any corner, sc in same place, ch 6, skip 5 sc and complete a cross st as follows: Thread over 4 times, insert hook in next sc and draw thread through (6 loops on hook), thread over and take off 2 loops at a time twice, then thread over, skip 1 sc, insert hook in next sc, draw thread through (6 loops on hook), thread over and take off 2 loops at a time 5 times; ch 3, dc in center point of the cross, thus completing the cross. Ch 6, skip 2 sc, sc in next sc, * ch 6, skip 5 sc, make a cross st over next 3 sc (leaving 1 sc free between spokes of cross), ch 6, skip 5 sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from * across to within 12 sc of center sc of next corner. Complete corners and remaining sides as before. Join and break off. 3rd rnd: Attach Steel to ch-3 sp of any cross, in same sp make 3 sc, ch 5 and 3 sc; * ch 6, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr, make a tr in next 2 sps, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (joint tr made), ch 6, in next sp make 3 sc, ch 5 and 3 sc. Repeat from * around. Join and break off. 4th rnd: Attach Maize to ch-6 sp preceding any joint tr, sc in same sp, * sc in next sp, ch 5, in next loop make sc, ch 3, sc, ch 5, sc, ch 3 and sc; ch 5, sc in next sp. Repeat from * around. Join and break off.

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MATERIALS:

J. & P. Coats or Clark's O.N.T. Mercerized Sewing Thread, Size 50, 2 spools of White and 1 spool of No. 7 Bluebird . . . Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 15 . . . A rolled edge handkerchief, 12 inches square.

1st rnd: Attach Blue to edge of handkerchief and sc closely around (24 sc to 1 inch). Join and break off. 2nd rnd: Attach White to 16th sc preceding center sc at any corner, ch 8, dc in 6th ch from hook, (skip 1 sc, dc in next sc, ch 5, dc in last dc made)

15 times; * skip 3 sc, dc in next sc,
ch 5, dc in last dc made. Repeat from * across side, ending with dc in 16th sc

preceding center sc of next corner. Work remaining corners and sides the same way. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch-8. 3rd and 4th rnds: Ch 8, dc in 6th ch from hook, * ch 5, dc in last dc made, dc in next dc. Repeat from * around. Join. Break off at end of 4th rnd. 5th rnd: Attach Blue to any dc, sc in same place, * ch 7, sc in next dc. Repeat from * around. Join and break

MATERIALS:

J. & P. Coats or Clark's O.N.T. Mercerized Sewing Thread, Size 50, 2 spools of White and 1 spool of No. 39-A Redcherry . . . Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 15 . . A rolled edge handkerchief, 12 inches

1st rnd: Attach Redcherry to corner of handkerchief and sc closely around (24 sc to 1 inch), making 3 sc in each corner. Join with sl st to first sc. Break off 2nd rnd: Attach White to first sc, sc in same place, ch 4, skip 1 sc, sc in next sc, * ch 6, skip 4 sc, tr in next sc, ch 5, dc in last tr made, tr in same sc as last tr, ch 6, skip 4 sc, sc in next sc, ch 4, skip 2 sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from * across to within 4 sc of corner 3-sc group, ending with ch 6, skip 4 sc, sc in next sc, ch 4, skip 1 sc, sc in next sc. Work other sides and corners the same way. Join with sl st to first sc. 3rd rnd:

Sl st in next loop, ch 7, in same loop make (d tr, ch 2) 4 times; * skip next sp, in next loop make (d tr, ch 2) 5 times; skip next sp, tr tr in next loop, ch 2. Repeat from * across to next corner loop, ending with ch 2, in corner loop make (d tr, ch 2) 5 times. Work other sides and corners the same way. Join last ch-2 with sl st to 5th ch of ch-7. Break off. 4th rnd: Attach Redcherry to first sp, sc in same sp, (ch 7, dc in last sc made, sc in next sp) 3 times; * sc in next sp, (ch 7, dc in last sc made, sc in next sp)
5 times. Repeat from * across to corner, ending with sc in last sp preceding corner d tr group, (ch 7, dc in last sc made, sc in next sp) 10 times. Complete rnd, working other corners the same way. Join and break

MATERIALS:

J. & P. Coats or Clark's O.N.T. Mercerized Sewing Thread, Size 50, 1 spool each of No. 159 Rouge and White . . . Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 15 . . . A rolled edge handkerchief, 12 inches square.

1st rnd: Attach Rouge to edge of handkerchief and sc closely around (24 sc to 1 inch). Join with sl st to first sc. Break off. 2nd rnd: Attach White to first sc, sc in same place, * ch 4, sc in 3rd ch from hook (picot), ch 2, picot, ch 1, skip 6 sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from * around. Join with sl st to first sc. Break off. 3rd tnd: Attach Rouge to ch-2 sp between picots, sc in same place, * ch 9, sc in next sp between picots. Repeat from * around. Join and break off.

MATERIALS:

J. & P. Coats Tatting-Crochet, Size 70, 2 balls of White and 1 ball of No. 26-B Bright Nile Green . . wards Steel Crochet Hook No. 13 . A rolled edge handkerchief, 10 inches square.

Starting at narrow edge with White, ch 8. 1st row: Tr in 8th ch from hook. Ch 3, turn. 2nd row: Tr in tr, Ch 7, turn. Repeat 2nd row until piece measures slightly longer than outer edges of handkerchief, having an even number of loops on each side.

HEADING . . . 1st rnd: Attach White to first loop made, ch 9, tr in same loop, * ch 4, in next loop make tr, ch 5 and tr. Repeat from * across until Heading is same length as one side of handkerchief, ending with ch 4.

To form corner: Make tr in each of the next 3 loops, ch 4, in next loop make tr, ch 5 and tr. Continue working as before, forming corners as previous corner was formed, ending

rnd with ch 4. Join with sl st to 4th ch

of ch-9. Break off. EDGING . . . 1st rnd: Attach Nile Green to any loop on other side, ch 13,

in same loop make (tr, ch 9) 4 times and tr: * ch 3, sc in next loop, ch 3, in next loop make (tr, ch 9) 5 times and tr. Repeat from * around, ending with sc in last loop, ch 3. Join to 4th ch of ch-13. Break off. 2nd rnd: Attach White to first loop on any scallop, ch 4, tr in same loop, ch 4, dc in last tr made, * holding back on hook the last loop of each tr, make 2 tr in next loop, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (cluster made), ch 4, dc in tip of last cluster made, in next loop make cluster, ch 4, dc in tip of last cluster made and cluster (ch 4, dc in tip of last cluster made, cluster in next loop) twice; cluster in first loop of next scallop. ch 4, dc in tip of last cluster made.

Repeat from * around, ending with cluster in last loop. Join and break off. Sew in place.

MATERIALS:

J. & P. Coats Tatting-Crochet, Size 70, 6 balls of No. 4 Pink . . . Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 13 . . . A rolled edge handkerchief, 11 inches square.

Attach thread to any corner. 1st rnd: 5 sc in same corner, sc closely around, having 200 sc on each side and 5 sc in each corner. 2nd rnd: SI st in next 2 sc, ch 4, ** (dc in next sc, ch 1) twice; skip next sc, dc in next sc, (ch 1, skip next sc, dc in next sc) 22 times (25 sps); * draw next sc) 22 times (25 sps); loop on hook out to measure 1/8 inch, thread over and draw loop through, insert hook between single and double loops and draw a loop through, thread over and draw through 2 loops on hook (knot st made); make another knot st, skip next 2 sc, dc in next sc, (ch 1, skip next sc, dc in next sc) 25 times. Repeat from * once more, make 2 knot sts, skip next 2 sc, dc in next sc, (ch 1, skip next sc, dc in next sc) 23 times; (ch 1, dc in next sc) twice; make 2 knot sts, dc in same sc as last dc was made (corner), ch 1. Repeat from ** around. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch-4. 3rd rnd: Sl st in next ch and in next dc, ch 4, dc in next dc, * (ch 1, dc in next dc) 22 times (23 sps); make 2 knot sts, sc under double loop of next knot st, to right of the knot, sc under double loop of next knot st, to the left of the same knot, make 2 knot sts, skip next dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in next dc. Repeat from * around. Join to 3rd ch of ch-4. 4th rnd: SI st in next ch and in next dc, ch 4, dc in next dc, * (ch 1, dc in next dc) 20 times (21 sps); (make 2 knot sts, sc in double loop of next knot st, to the right of the knot, sc in double loop of next knot st, to the left of the same knot) twice; make 2 knot sts, skip next dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in next dc. Repeat from * around. Join. 5th rnd: Sl st in next ch and in next dc, ch 4, dc in next dc, * (ch 1, dc in next dc) 19 times (19 sps); (make 2 knot sts, sc in double loop of next knot st, to the right of the knot, sc in double loop of next knot st, to the left of the same knot) 3 times; make 2 knot sts, skip next dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in next dc. Repeat from * across to corner, make 2 knot sts, sc under double loop of next 2 knot sts, make 2 knot sts, sc under double loop of next knot st, to the right of the knot, make 2 more knot sts, sc under double loop of next

knot st, to the left of the same knot (2 knot sts increased at corner). Complete rnd in pattern. Join. Continue to work in pattern, increasing 2 knot sts directly above previous increases on each corner and having 2 sps less on each sp group and 2 knot sts more between each sp group until 14 rnds are completed. Join and break off.

MATERIALS:

J. & P. Coats Tatting-Crochet, Size 70, 1 ball each of No. 9 Yellow and No. 18 Shaded Lavenders . . . Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 13 . . . A round scalloped handkerchief (each scallop to measure 1 inch at base).

Attach Yellow to base of any scallop. 1st rnd: Make 24 sc across each scallop. Join with sl st to first sc. Break off. 2nd rnd: Attach Shaded Lavenders to 4th sc on any scallop, ch 8, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr, make 2 tr in 4th ch from hook, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (cluster made), * ch 4, 2 tr cluster in 4th ch from hook, skip next 4 sc, sc in next sc, (ch 4, 2 tr cluster in 4th ch from hook) twice; skip next 4 sc, sc in next sc, (ch 4, 2 tr cluster in 4th ch from hook) twice; skip next 4 sc, tr in next sc, skip next 7 sc, tr in next sc, ch 4, 2 tr cluster in 4th ch from hook. Repeat from * around. Join to 4th ch of starting chain. 3rd rnd: Sl st in next 4 ch, ch 4, 2 tr cluster in last sl st made, * ch 4, 2 tr cluster in 4th ch from hook, sc in tip of next cluster group, ch 4, 2 tr cluster in tip of same cluster group. Repeat from * around. Join and break off. **4th rnd:** Attach Yellow to tip of any cluster group, sc in same place, * ch 15, sc in tip of next cluster group. Repeat from * around. Join. 5th rnd: Sl st to center of next loop, sc in same loop, * ch 9, in next loop make sc, ch 5 and sc. Repeat from * around, ending with sc, ch 5 in same loop as first sc was made. Join to first sc. 6th rnd: Sl st to center of next loop, sc in same loop, * ch 15, sc in next ch-9 loop. Repeat from * around. Join. 7th rnd: Sl st to center of next loop, sc in same loop, ch 11, in next loop make sc, ch 5 and sc. Repeat from * around. Join. 8th rnd: SI st to center of next loop, sc in same loop, * ch 17, sc in next ch-11 loop. Repeat from Join and break off.

MATERIALS:

J. & P. Coats Tatting-Crochet, Size 70, 4 balls of No. 48 Hunter's Green and 3 balls of White . . . Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 13 . . . A linen handkerchief, 12 inches square.

FIRST MOTIF... Starting at center with Green, ch 8. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: Ch 6, (tr in ring, ch 2) 11 times. Join with sl st to 4th ch of ch-6. 2nd rnd: Ch 4, tr in next tr, * ch 3, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr, make tr in same tr as last tr was made, tr in next tr, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (joint tr made). Repeat from * around, ending wtih ch 3. Join and break off.

SECOND MOTIF... Work as for First Motif until first rnd is completed. 2nd rnd: Ch 4, tr in next tr, ch 1, sl st in any sp on First Motif, ch 1, make a joint tr by making a tr in same tr as last tr and in next tr on Second Motif. Complete rnd as for First Motif (no more joinings).

Make necessary number of motifs to reach across side of handkerchief, joining as Second Motif was joined to First Motif and having 5 sps free on each side of joining.

To form corner: Join next motif as before, leaving 9 sps free between joinings.

Make necessary number of motifs, joining as before. Join last motif to First Motif.

HEADING . . . Attach White to 3rd free sp on inner edge of any side motif, ch 6, dc in same sp, * ch 3, make a joint tr by making a tr in Continued on page 7

next 2 sps, ch 3, make a joint d tr by making a d tr in same sp as last tr and in first free sp on next motif, ch 3, make a joint tr by making tr in same sp as last d tr and in next sp, ch 3, in next sp make dc, ch 3 and dc. Repeat from * across to within corner motif, ending with joint tr, holding back on hook the last loop of each d tr, make d tr in same sp as last tr, in free sp on corner motif and in first free sp on next motif, thread over and draw through all loops on hook. Work around remaining sides and corners the same way. Join and break off.

SCALLOPED EDGE . . . 1st rnd: Attach White to first free sp on outer edge of any motif on side, 5 sc in same sp, 5 sc in each of next 4 sps, * 2 sc in each of next 2 sps joining motifs, 5 sc in each of next 5 sps. Repeat from * around, making 5 sc in each free sp on corner motifs. Join and break off. 2nd rnd: Attach Green to 3rd sc on any side motif, sc in same place, * draw loop on hook out to measure 1/8 inch, thread over and draw loop through, insert hook between single and double loops and draw a loop through, thread over and draw through 2 loops on hook (knot st made), make another knot st, (skip 2 sc, sc in next sc, make 2 knot sts) 8 times; skip 4 sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from * to corner, (make 2 knot sts, skip 2 sc, sc in next sc) 15 times; work around remaining sides in same manner. Join and break off. 3rd rnd: Skip first knot st, attach White to next knot st, sc in same place, * (make 2 knot sts, sc in next knot) 5 times; make 2 knot sts, insert hook in next 3 knots, draw loop through, thread over and draw through all loops on hook, make 2 knot sts, sc in next knot. Repeat from * to corner, ending with sc through 3 knot sts, (make 2 knot sts, sc in next knot) 13 times. Work around remaining sides in same manner. Join and break off.

Attach White to edge of handkerchief, sc closely around, making 3 sc in each corner. Join and break off. Sew

edging in place.

MATERIALS:

J. & P. Coats or Clark's O.N.T. Mercerized Sewing Thread, Size 50, 4 spools of No. 13 Navy and 1 spool of No. 108 Coral . . . Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 15 . . . A rolled edge handkerchief, 12 inches square.

FIRST SCALLOP . . . With double strand of Navy, ch 43. 1st row: Half dc in 6th ch from hook, ch 2, dc in next ch, ch 2, (tr in next ch, ch 2) 3 times; (skip next ch, tr in next ch, ch 2) 14 times; (tr in next ch, ch 2) twice; dc in next ch, ch 2, half dc in next ch, ch 5, sl st in last ch. Break off (24 sps). 2nd row: Attach single strand of Coral to 7th sp, sc in same

sp, * ch 7, sc in next sp. Repeat from * across to within last 6 sps. Ch 7, turn. 3rd, 4th and 5th rows: Sc in first loop, * ch 7, sc in next loop. Repeat from * across. Ch 7, turn. At end of 5th row, do not ch to turn. Break off.

SECOND SCALLOP . Navy, ch 43, half dc in 6th ch from hook, ch 2, dc in next ch, ch 2, tr in next ch, ch 1, sl st in 4th sp of first row of First Scallop, (tr in next ch, ch 2) twice; (skip next ch, tr in next ch, ch 2) 14 times; (tr in next ch, ch 2) twice; dc in next ch, ch 2, half dc in next ch, ch 5, sl st in last ch. Break off. Attach Coral and work as for First Scallop.

Make 5 more scallops in same way, joining each scallop as Second Scallop was joined to First Scallop.

CORNER SCALLOP . With Navy, ch 53. 1st row: Half dc in 6th ch from hook ch 2, dc in next ch, ch 2, tr in next ch, ch 1, sl st in 4th sp of last scallop made, (tr in next ch, ch 2) twice; (skip next ch, tr in next ch, ch 2) 19 times; (tr in next ch, ch 2) twice; dc in next ch, ch 2, half dc in next ch, ch 5, sl st in last ch. Break off (29 sps). Attach Coral and work as for other scallops. Continue in this manner, making 7 smaller scallops on each side and larger scallops at corners. Join last scallop to first scallop.

EDGING . . . Attach double strand of Navy to first loop on any scallop, sc in same place, * ch 5, sc in 3rd ch from hook (picot made), ch 2, sc in next loop. Repeat from * across scallop, sc in first loop on next scallop. Work across each scallop the same way. Join and break off.

Sew Edging around handkerchief.

MATERIALS:

J. & P. Coats Tatting-Crochet, Size 70, 3 balls of White . . . Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 13 . . . A handkerchief, 12 inches square.

FIRST MOTIF ... Starting at center, ch 7. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: Ch 4, tr in ring, ch 7, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr, make 2 tr in ring, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (cluster made); (ch 7, cluster in ring) 6 times; ch 7. Join to top of starting chain. Break off.

SECOND MOTIF . . . Starting at center, ch 7. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: Ch 4, tr in ring, ch 7, cluster in ring, ch 3, sl st in any loop on First Motif, ch 3, cluster in ring on Second Motif. Complete rnd, no more joinings.

Make necessary number of motifs to measure same as side of handkerchief, joining as Second Motif was joined to First Motif, leaving 3 loops free between joinings.

To form corner: Make another motif as before and join to last motif. leaving 4 loops free for outer edge of corner motif. Work in this manner all around, forming corners as before.

EDGING . . . 1st rnd: Attach thread to center free loop of any motif on side, sc in same place, * ch 6, tr in next 2 free loops, ch 6, sc in next loop. Repeat from * across side to within corner motif, ending with sc in center free loop on last motif on side. Now work across corner motif as follows: Ch 6, tr in next 2 free loops, ch 6, sc in next loop, ch 7, tr in same loop as last sc was made, tr in next loop, ch 7, sc in same loop as last tr was made, ch 6, tr in next 2 free loops. Continue working across sides and corners in this manner. How to Make Hairpin Lace

Step 1—Make a loop at end of ball thread (Fig. 1).

Step 2—Insert hook in loop and wind ball thread around right prong of staple (Fig. 1).

Step 3—Thread over hook and draw through loop, keeping loop at center (Fig. 1).

Step 4—Raise hook to a vertical position and turn staple to the left (Fig. 2).

Step 5—Thread over hook and draw through loop on hook (Fig. 3).

Step 6—Insert hook in loop of left prong (Fig. 4).

Sew center of hairpin lace together. 2nd rnd: Sl st in next sp, sc in same sp, ch 7, skip 1 sp, sc in next sp, * ch 10, skip 2 sps, (dc in next sp, ch 2) 10 times; dc in next sp, ch 10, skip 2 sps, sc in next sp, ch 7, skip 1 sp, sc in next sp, ch 3, skip next sp, holding back on hook the last loop of each st, make dc in next loop tr in next 4 loops and dc in next loop, thread over and draw through all loops on hook, ch 3, skip next sp, sc in next sp, ch 3, sl st in previous ch-7 loop, ch 3, skip next sp, sc in next sp. Repeat from * around. Join last ch-7 loop to first ch-7 loop. Break off. 3rd rnd: Attach Green to any ch-10 sp, sc in same sp, ch 5, * (sc in next dc, ch 2) 10 times; sc in next dc, ch 10, holding back on hook the last loop of each d tr, make 2 d tr in next sp, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (cluster made), tr tr in next 2 sps, cluster in next sp, ch 10. Repeat from * 3 more times; (sc in next dc, ch 2) 10 times; sc in next dc, ch 5, sc in the next 2 ch-10 sps (corner made). Complete rnd, forming corners as before. Join to first sc. 4th rnd: Sc in next sp, ch 5, (sc in next sc, ch 3) 10 times; sc in Step 7—Thread over hook and draw loop through (2 loops on hook), thread over and draw through 2 loops.



Make necessary number of motifs to fit around handkerchief (do not join motifs).

Joining of Motifs: 1st rnd: Attach thread to any loop on any motif, make 10 sc in same loop and in each of the next 7 loops; make 10 sc in any loop on next motif and in each of the next 7 loops. Join necessary number of motifs in same way to reach across one side of handkerchief.



Join to top of ch-4. 3rd rnd: Sl st in next tr, ch 4, cluster over next 4 tr, ch 9, sc in next sp, ch 4, sl st in first half free loop on Corner Motif, ch 4, skip 1 tr on next tr group, cluster over next 5 tr, (ch 9, sc in next sp, ch 9, skip 1 tr, cluster over next 5 tr) twice; ch 9, sc in next sp, ch 9. Join to tip of first cluster. Break off.

SECOND SMALL MOTIF Work as for First Small Motif until first rnd is completed. 2nd rnd: Sl st in next tr, ch 4, cluster over next 4 tr, ch 9, sc in next sp, ch 4, sl st in first free sp on preceding motif, ch 4, skip 1 tr on Second Small Motif, cluster over next 5 tr, ch 4, sl st in first free sp on Corner Motif, ch 4, sc in next sp on Second Small Motif, ch 4, sl st in next sp on Corner Motif, ch 4, skip 1 tr on Second Small Motif, cluster over next 5 tr, complete rnd, no more

Make 3 more Small Motifs and join to preceding Small Motif and Corner Motif as before.

Repeat from * around, ending with ch 6, sl st in tip of first cluster made. 10th rnd: Sc in same place as sl st, ** ch 5, skip 3 sc, tr in next sc, * ch 2, tr in same sc. Repeat from * 2 more times, ch 5, sc in tip of next cluster. Repeat from ** around, ending with ch 5. Join. 11th rnd: Ch 6, dc in same place as sl st, ch 3, 4 sc in ch-5 loop, sc in ch-2 sp, ch 3, in next ch-2 sp make dc, ch 3 and dc; ch 3, sc in next ch-2 sp, 4 sc in next ch-5 loop, ch 3; in next sc make dc, ch 3 and dc. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 3. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch-6 first made. 12th rnd: SI st in ch-3 sp, ch 6, dc in same sp, * ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 2, skip 2 sc, sc in next sc, ch 2, sc in next sp, ch 3; in next sc, ch 3; in next ch-3 sp (between dc's) make dc, ch 3 and dc. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 3, sl st in 3rd ch of ch-6 first made. Join and break off.

Place motif on handkerchief corner, having 10 scallops free. Cut away material, allowing for a rolled hem. Sew in place on 10th rnd.

Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch-3 first made. 2nd rnd: Ch 10 and complete a cross st as follows: Thread over twice, insert hook in 8th ch from hook, draw thread through (4 loops on hook), thread over once, skip 1 dc and insert hook in next dc, draw thread through (6 loops on hook), thread over and take off 2 loops at a time, 5 times; * ch 3, thread over 4 times, insert hook in next dc and draw thread through (6 loops on hook), thread over and take off 2 loops at a time twice, then thread over, skip 1 dc, insert hook in next dc, draw thread through (6 loops on hook), thread over and take off 2 loops at a time, 5 times; ch 3, dc in center point of the cross, thus completing the cross. Repeat from * around (8 cross sts). Join last ch-3 with sl st to 7th ch of ch-10. 3rd rnd: 5 sc in each sp. Join. 4th to 7th rnds incl: Sc in each sc of previous rnd. Join. 8th rnd: Ch 4, dc in first sc, * ch 1, dc in next sc. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 1. Join with sl st to 3rd ch of ch-4 first made. 9th rnd: Ch 10 and complete cross st as before, skipping 2 dc between each leg of cross st and inserting hook under ch-1 sp, ch 3, skip 2 dc, make a cross st as before, inserting hook in ch-1 sps and skipping dc between each leg of cross st. Work in this manner around (20

to 7th ch of ch-10 first made. 10th rnd: SI st in first 2 sts of first sp, ch 5, * dc in same sp, ch 3, sc in next sp, ch 3, dc in next sp, ch 2. Repeat from * around. Join last ch-3 with sI st to 3rd ch of ch-5 first made. 11th rnd: Ch 6, dc in same sp, * ch 4, sc in next sc of previous rnd, ch 4, dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 3, dc in same sp. Repeat from * around, joining with sI st to 3rd ch of ch-6 first made. Break off.

Place motif on corner of handkerchief, having 12 scallops free. Cut out material in back of motif, leaving ½ inch for hem. Sew motif in place. Turn hem under and sew neatly in place.

Repeat from * across to center sc of next corner, ending with ch 1, in center sc make (dc, ch 1) 4 times; dc in next sc and work around remaining sides the same way, ending with ch 1, sl st in next free sp on motif. Ch 5, turn. 3rd row: SI st in center sp of next scallop on motif, work in cross st pattern as for motif, do not skip any sps between cross sts at corners, sc in center loop of next scallop on motif. Ch 3, turn. 4th row: Work as for 10th rnd of motif, ending with ch 3, sl st in same sp on motif as last sl st was made. Ch 3, turn. 5th row: Work as for 11th rnd of motif, ending with ch 3, sl st in same sp on motif as last sl st was made. Break off.

Now work around as follows: 1st rnd: Attach thread to center sp of first free scallop on motif, sc in same sp, * ch 9, sc in center sp of next scallop. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 3, tr in first sc. 2nd rnd: * Ch 10, sc in next sp. Repeat from * around, increasing 2 loops at each corner—to inc 1 loop, make sc, ch 9 and sc in same sp—and ending with ch 3, tr in tr. 3rd rnd: * Ch 11, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join and break off.
