MATERIALS:

3 ply BEEHIVE FINGERING, PATONISED.
12 ozs. Set of 4 No. 10 Queen Bee Knitting Needles
(points at both ends).

MEASUREMENTS: Approx. 44 ins. x 44 ins.

Tension: 8 sts. and 10 rows = 1 inch.

Check tension—see page 28.

For Washing Instructions—see page 29.

This shawl is made in 16 separate medallions and joined as instructed in the Make Up on page 17.

THE MEDALLIONS: Cast on 8 sts. (2, 2, 4). Join in round.
1st round: *Wl.fwd. K1. Repeat from * to end of round.
(16 sts. in round. (4, 4, 8).).

2nd and alternate rounds: Knit.

3rd round: *Wl.fwd. K3. Wl.fwd. K1. t.b.l. Repeat from * to end of round.

5th round: *Wl.fwd. K5. Wl.fwd. K1. t.b.l. Repeat from * to end of round.

7th round: *Wl.fwd. K7. Wl.fwd. K1. t.b.l. Repeat from * to end of round.

9th round: *Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K1. Repeat from * to end of round. (40 sts. in round. (10, 10, 20).).

11th round: *K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K2. Repeat from * to end of round.

13th round: *K2. Wl.fwd. K1. t.b.l. Wl.fwd. K3. Repeat from * to end of round.

15th round: *K3. Wl.fwd. K1. t.b.l. Wl.fwd. K4. Repeat from * to end of round.

17th round: *K4. Wl.fwd. K1. t.b.l. Wl.fwd. K5. Repeat from * to end of round.

19th round: *K5. Wl.fwd. K1. t.b.l. Wl.fwd. K6. Repeat from * to end of round.

21st round: *K6. Wl.fwd. K1. t.b.l. Wl.fwd. K7. Repeat from * to end of round.

23rd round: *K7. Wl.fwd. K1. t.b.l. Wl.fwd. K8. Repeat from * to end of round. (144 sts. in round. (36, 36, 72).).

25th round: *Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K5. Wl.fwd. K3. Wl.fwd. K5. K2tog. P1. Repeat from * to end of round.

26th and alternate rounds: *K17. P1. Repeat from * to end of round.

27th round: *Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K4. Wl.fwd. K5. Wl.fwd. K4. K2tog. P1. Repeat from * to end of round.

29th round: *Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K3. Wl.fwd. K1. Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K1. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K1. Wl.fwd. K3. K2tog. P1. Repeat from * to end of round.

31st round: *Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K2. Wl.fwd. K3. Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. Wl.fwd. K3. Wl.fwd. K2. K2tog. P1. Repeat from * to end of round.

33rd round: *Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K1. Wl.fwd. K11. Wl.fwd. K1. K2tog. P1. Repeat from * to end of round.

35th round: *Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. Wl.fwd. K1. Wl.fwd. (Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K1. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K1. Wl.fwd.) twice. K2tog. P1. Repeat from * to end of round.

37th round: Sl.1. *(Wl.fwd. K3. Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o.) twice. Wl.fwd. K3. Wl.fwd. K2tog. Slip this last st. of right hand needle onto the left hand needle. Slip the 2nd st. on left hand needle over the 1st. st. Slip this st. back to right hand needle thus having 1. st. in place of 3 and so closing the petal over the purled st. of previous round. (Be very careful not to drop the Wl.fwd. before the 2 sts. knit tog. when transferring the sts.). Repeat from * to end of round, being sure to close the last petal with the st. slipped at the beginning of the round.

38th and 40th rounds: Knit.

39th round: *Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K1. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K1. Repeat from * to end of round.

41st round: *K1. (Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. Wl.fwd. K3) twice. Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. Wl.fwd. K2. Repeat from * to end of round.

42nd round: Knit.

To make the corners: Knit first 8 sts. of round onto 3rd needle. Proceed:—

1st row: K1. (Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K1. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K1. Wl.fwd.) twice. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K1. K2tog. K1. Turn. Working backwards and forwards on these 17 sts. continue:—

2nd row: P17.

3rd row: K1. (Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. Wl.fwd. K3. Wl.fwd.) twice. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. K1.

4th row: P2tog. P11. P2tog.

5th row: K1. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K1. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K1. Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K1. K2tog. K1.

6th row: P11.

VANDYKE LACE BORDER

(ILLUSTRATED ON PAGE 1)

MATERIALS:

2 ply BEEHIVE FINGERING, PATONISED.
6 ozs. Two No. 7 and two No. 4 Knitting Needles.

MEASUREMENTS: Approx. 48 ins. x 48 ins.

Tension: 7 sts. and 8 rows=1 inch with No. 7 needles.

Check tension—see page 28.

For Washing Instructions—see page 29.

THE CENTRE: With No. 4 needles cast on 180 sts.

1st row: *K1. (Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o.) 3 times. K3. Repeat from * to end of row.

2nd and alternate rows: K1. Purl to last st. K1.

3rd row: *K2. (Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o.) 3 times. K2. Repeat from * to end of row.

5th row: *K3. (Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o.) 3 times. K1. Repeat from * to end of row.

7th row: *K4. (Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o.) 3 times. Repeat from * to end of row.

9th row: *K2. (K2tog. Wl.fwd.) 3 times. K2. Repeat from * to end of row.

11th row: *K1. (K2tog. Wl.fwd.) 3 times. K3. Repeat from * to end of row.

12th row: K1. Purl to last st. K1.

Repeat these 12 rows until work measures 42 ins. from beginning ending with purl row. Cast off loosely.

THE BORDER: With No. 7 needles cast on 10 sts.

1st row: Sl.1. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. (Wl.fwd.) twice. (That is, wind wool twice around needle. In following row each loop will be worked as a st. thus making 2 sts.) K2tog. K1.

2nd row: Sl.1. K1. (K1. P1) into the double Wl.fwd. of previous row. (That is knit into 1 loop and purl into 2nd loop of the double Wl.fwd.) K2. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog.

3rd row: Sl.1. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K4.

4th row: Inc. 1. st. in 1st. st. K5. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog.

5th row: Sl.1. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. *(Wl.fwd.) twice. K2tog. Repeat from * once. K1.

6th row: Sl.1. K1. *(K1. P1) into the double Wl.fwd. of previous row. K1. Repeat from * once. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog.

7th row: Sl.1. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K7.

8th row: K9. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog.

9th row: Sl.1. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. *(Wl.fwd.) twice. K2tog. Repeat from * twice. K1.

10th row: K2. *(K1. P1) into the double Wl.fwd. of previous row. K1. Repeat from * twice. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog.

11th row: Sl.1. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K10.

12th row: K3. K2tog. K7. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog.

13th row: Sl.1. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. *(Wl.fwd.) twice. K2tog. Repeat from * 3 times. K1.

14th row: K2. *(K1. P1) into the double Wl.fwd. of previous row. K1. Repeat from * 3 times. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog.

15th row: Sl.1. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K13.

16th row: (K3. K2tog.) twice. K5. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog.

17th row: Sl.1. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. *(Wl.fwd.) twice. K2tog. Repeat from * 4 times. K1.

18th row: K2. *(K1. P1) into the double Wl.fwd. of previous row. K1. Repeat from * 4 times. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog.

19th row: Sl.1. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K16.

20th row: The st. on the right hand needle after casting off is counted as 1. st. Cast off 13 sts. loosely. K5. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. Repeat these 20 rows until work measures approx. 4½ yds. ending with 20th pattern row. Cast off.

TO MAKE UP: Beginning at one corner, sew the border around the centre, gathering it at the corners to keep work flat. Sew evenly to keep seam from binding. Sew the cast-off edge of the border to the cast-on edge. Roll shawl in a damp towel for several hours, then spread out flat, pinning each point out separately with rustless pins and leave until dry.



RAISED LEAF LACE BORDER

CIRCULAR SHAWL

☆ *One Hundred Years Old* ☆

(ILLUSTRATED ON OPPOSITE PAGE)

MATERIALS:

3 ply BEEHIVE FINGERING, PATONISED.
13 ozs. Two No. 9 Queen Bee Knitting Needles.

MEASUREMENTS: Approx. 48 ins. in diameter.

Tension: $7\frac{1}{2}$ sts. and 10 rows = 1 inch.

Check tension—see page 28.

For Washing Instructions—see page 29.

THE CENTRE: Cast on 120 sts. Knit 2 rows. Proceed:—

1st row: K4. Turn. 2nd row: Sl.1. K3.
3rd row: K6. Turn. 4th row: Sl.1. K5.
5th row: K8. Turn. 6th row: Sl.1. K7.

Continue in this manner, that is working over 2 more sts. every alternate row to Sl.1. K.117.

Next row: K4. *Wl.fwd. K2tog. Repeat from * to end of row.

Next row: Knit. This completes one pattern.

Work 11 more patterns. Cast off loosely.

Sew the cast-on edge to the cast-off edge. Thread wool around centre edge and draw up and fasten securely.

THE BORDER: Cast on 30 sts. Knit 1 row. Proceed:—

1st row: K4. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice. (Wl.fwd.) twice. (That is, wind wool twice around needle. In following row each loop will be worked as a st. thus making 2 sts.). K2tog. K18.

2nd row: K9. (K1. P1. K1) into front of next st. (thus inc. 2 sts.). K9. (K1. P1) into the double Wl.fwd. of previous row. (That is knit into 1 loop and purl into 2nd loop of the double Wl.fwd.). K3. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K2.

3rd row: K4. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K12. P3. K9.

4th row: K10. Wl.fwd. K1. Wl.fwd. K15. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K2.

5th row: K4. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice. (Wl.fwd.) twice. K2tog. (Wl.fwd.) twice. K2tog. K7. P5. K9.

6th row: K11. Wl.fwd. K1. Wl.fwd. K11. P1. K2. P1. K3. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K2.

7th row: K4. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K14. P7. K9.

8th row: K12. Wl.fwd. K1. Wl.fwd. K19. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K2.

9th row: K4. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice. *(Wl.fwd.) twice. K2tog. Repeat from * twice. K7. P9. K9.

10th row: K13. Wl.fwd. K1. Wl.fwd. K13. (P1. K2) twice. P1. K3. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K2.

11th row: K4. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K17. P11. K9.

12th row: K14. Wl.fwd. K1. Wl.fwd. K24. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K2.

13th row: K4. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice. *(Wl.fwd.) twice. K2tog. Repeat from * twice. (Wl.fwd.) twice. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. K7. P13. K9.

14th row: K9. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K9. K2tog. K9. (P1. K2) 3 times. P1. K3. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K2.

15th row: K4. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K20. P11. K9.

16th row: K9. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K7. K2tog. K22. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K2.

17th row: K4. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice. *(Wl.fwd.) twice. K2tog. Repeat from * twice. (Wl.fwd.) twice. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. (Wl.fwd.) twice. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. K7. P9. K9.

18th row: K9. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K5. K2tog. K9. (P1. K2) 4 times. P1. K3. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K2.

19th row: K4. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K23. P7. K9.

20th row: K9. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K3. K2tog. K25. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K2.

21st row: K4. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice. *(Wl.fwd.) twice. K2tog.* Repeat from * to * twice. **(Wl.fwd.) twice. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o.** Repeat from ** to ** twice. K7. P5. K9.

22nd row: K9. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K1. K2tog. K9. (P1. K2) 5 times. P1. K3. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K2.

23rd row: K4. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K26. P3. K9.

24th row: K9. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. K28. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K2.

25th row: K4. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice. *(Wl.fwd.) twice. K2tog.* Repeat from * to * twice. **(Wl.fwd.) twice. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o.** Repeat from ** to ** 3 times. K17.

26th row: K19. (P1. K2) 6 times. P1. K3. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K2.

27th row: K4. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K39.

28th row: The st. on the right hand needle after casting off is counted as 1. st. Cast off 18 sts. loosely. K23. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K2. Repeat these 28 rows 37 times. Cast off.

TO MAKE UP: Sew the cast-on edge of the border to the cast-off edge. Sew evenly in position around centre. Roll in damp towel for several hours, then spread out flat, pinning each point out separately with rustless pins and leave until dry.



BEAUTIFUL LACE DIAMOND

with
MATCHING BORDER

(ILLUSTRATED ON OPPOSITE PAGE)

MATERIALS:

2 ply BEEHIVE FINGERING, PATONISED.
7 ozs. White. Two No. 7 Queen Bee Knitting Needles.

MEASUREMENTS: Approx. 45 ins. x 45 ins.

Tension: 7 sts. and 8 rows = 1 inch.

Check tension—see page 28.

For Washing Instructions—see page 29.

THE CENTRE: Cast on 3 sts. 1st row: W.r.n. Knit to end of row. Repeat 1st. row until there are 71 loops up each side of work.

Next row: W.r.n. K3tog. Knit to end of row. Repeat last row to 3 sts. on needle. Cast off.

The shawl may be made larger by repeating the 1st. row as given for centre until extra loops, divisible by 10 and 1 over—i.e., 81 loops, 91 loops, etc.—are obtained at each side. Then for every extra 10 loops there will be one more pattern in the border at each side of the shawl.

THE BORDER: With right side of work facing, pick up and knit the loops from one side. Knit 1 row. Proceed:—

1st row: W.r.n. K1. *(Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o.) twice. K1. (K2tog. Wl.fwd.) twice. K1. Repeat from * to end of row.

2nd and alternate rows: W.r.n. Purl to last st. K1.

3rd row: W.r.n. K3. *Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. Wl.fwd. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K3. Repeat from * to end of row.

5th row: W.r.n. K5. *Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K1. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K5. Repeat from * to end of row.

7th row: W.r.n. K7. *Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. Wl.fwd. K7. Repeat from * to end of row.

9th row: W.r.n. K7. *K2tog. Wl.fwd. K1. Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K5. Repeat from * to last 2 sts. K2.

11th row: W.r.n. K2. *Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K3. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K3. Repeat from * to last 9 sts. Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K3. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K2.

13th row: W.r.n. K2. *(Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o.) twice. K1. (K2tog. Wl.fwd.) twice. K1. Repeat from * to last st. K1.

15th row: W.r.n. K4. *Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. Wl.fwd. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K3. Repeat from * to last st. K1.

17th row: W.r.n. K1. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K1. *(Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o.) twice. K1. (K2tog. Wl.fwd.) twice. K1. Repeat from * to last 3 sts. Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K1.

19th row: W.r.n. K1. K2tog. *Wl.fwd. K3. Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. Wl.fwd. K2tog. Repeat from * to last 6 sts. Wl.fwd. K3. Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K1.

20th row: W.r.n. Purl to last st. K1.

Repeat these 20 rows twice, then 1st. to 19th rows inclusive once.

Next row: K1. Purl to last st. K1. (150 sts. on needle). Cast on 20 sts. (These 20 sts. form beginning of the Lace Edging).

THE LACE EDGING: 1st row: K2. Wl.fwd. K1. (Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o.) 3 times. K2. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K3. K2tog. Turn. (The last 2 sts. knit together are 1. st. from the Lace Edging and 1. st. from the Border, thus attaching the Lace Edging to the Border of the Shawl. The Lace Edging is attached in this manner every alternate row as instructed).

2nd and alternate rows: Sl.1. K4. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. Purl to last 2 sts. K2.

3rd row: K2. Wl.fwd. K3. (Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o.) 3 times. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K3. K2tog. Turn.

5th row: K2. Wl.fwd. K5. (Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o.) twice. K2. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K3. K2tog. Turn.

7th row: K2. Wl.fwd. K7. (Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o.) twice. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K3. K2tog. Turn.

9th row: Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K1. Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K3. (K2tog. Wl.fwd.) 3 times. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K3. K2tog. Turn.

11th row: Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K1. Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K1. (K2tog. Wl.fwd.) 3 times. K2. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K3. K2tog. Turn.

13th row: Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K1. Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) twice. Wl.fwd. K3. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K3. K2tog. Turn.

15th row: Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K2. (K2tog. Wl.fwd.) 3 times. K2. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K3. K2tog. Turn.

16th row: Sl.1. K4. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. Purl to last 2 sts. K2.

These 16 rows complete one pattern. Repeat these 16 rows until all sts. from the Border have been worked up. Slip the sts. of the Lace Edging on spare needle to be carried forward for the next Border.

With right side of work facing begin again from the beginning of the Border. After working each Border pick up sts. of last row of Lace Edging and continue in pattern.

When the 4 sides are completed, cast off sts. of Lace Edging. Sew together the cast-on and cast-off edges of Lace Edging.

TO MAKE UP: Lay the Shawl flat on a table right side up. Sew together corners of Border by sewing in herringbone st. as follows:—

Thread a wool needle with a length of wool approx. 1 yd. long and join in the first loop of piece on right hand side at lower edge. Leave a length of about 3 ins. to darn in afterwards. Cross to the left piece and bring needle up through the first loop. *Pass needle under the bar just made and cross to right piece bringing needle up through next loop. Pass needle under bar and up through next loop on left piece. Repeat from * up the work to beginning of Border. Darn in end of wool. Join other three sides in same manner. Roll in a damp towel for several hours, then spread out flat, pinning each point out separately with rustless pins and leave until dry.



DELICATELY PATTERNED LACE

(The simplest shawl to knit)

(ILLUSTRATED ON OPPOSITE PAGE)

MATERIALS:

2 ply BEEHIVE FINGERING, PATONISED,
8 ozs. Two No. 7 Queen Bee Knitting Needles.

MEASUREMENTS: Approx. 45 ins. x 45 ins.

Tension: 7 sts. and 8 rows = 1 inch.

Check tension—see page 28.

For Washing Instructions—see page 29.

THE CENTRE: Cast on 128 sts. Knit 19 ins. even in Garter st. Cast off loosely.

THE BORDER: Join wool and pick up and knit 128 sts. evenly along one side of the Centre. Purl 1 row. Proceed:—

****1st row:** Inc. 1. st. in 1st. st. *Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. Wl.fwd. K3. Repeat from * to last st. Inc. 1. st. in last st.

2nd and alternate rows: K1. Purl to last st. K1.

3rd row: Inc. 1. st. in 1st. st. K1. *K3. Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. Wl.fwd. Repeat from * to last 2 sts. K1. Inc. 1. st. in last st.

5th row: Inc. 1. st. in 1st. st. K2. *Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. Wl.fwd. K3. Repeat from * to last 3 sts. Wl.fwd. K2tog. Inc. 1. st. in last st.

6th row: K1. Purl to last st. K1.**
Repeat from ** to ** 15 times, then from 1st. to 4th rows once.
Cast off loosely.

Work a Border on each of the remaining 3 sides to correspond.

THE LACE EDGING: Cast on 8 sts.

*****1st row:** K2. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K2. Wl.fwd. K2.

2nd and alternate rows: W.r.n. K2tog. Knit to end of row.

3rd row: K2. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K3. Wl.fwd. K2.

5th row: K2. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K4. Wl.fwd. K2.

7th row: K2. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K5. Wl.fwd. K2.

9th row: K2. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K6. Wl.fwd. K2.

11th row: K2. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K5. Wl.fwd. K3tog. K1.

13th row: K2. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K4. Wl.fwd. K3tog. K1.

15th row: K2. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K3. Wl.fwd. K3tog. K1.

17th row: K2. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K2. Wl.fwd. K3tog. K1.

19th row: K2. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K3tog. K1.

20th row: W.r.n. K2tog. Knit to end of row.

Repeat these 20 rows 18 times.

To make mitred corner: 1st row: K2. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K2. Wl.fwd. K2.

2nd and alternate rows: W.r.n. K2tog. K6. Turn.

3rd row: K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K3. Wl.fwd. K2.

5th, 7th and 9th rows: K6. Wl.fwd. K2.

11th, 13th, 15th, 17th and 19th rows: K4. Wl.fwd. K3tog. K1.

20th row: W.r.n. K2tog. K6. (8 sts. on needle).**

Repeat from *** to *** 3 times. Cast off loosely.

TO MAKE UP: Sew up the 4 corners of border. Sew the cast-off edge of the lace edging to the cast-on edge. Placing mitred corners to corners of shawl, sew evenly around being careful to keep seam from binding. Roll shawl in a damp towel for several hours, then spread out flat, pinning each point out separately with rustless pins and leave until dry.

MATERIALS:

2 ply BEEHIVE FINGERING, PATONISED,
12 ozs. Two No. 10 Queen Bee Knitting Needles.

MEASUREMENTS: Approx. 48 ins. in diameter.

Tension: 8½ sts. and 10 rows = 1 inch.

Check tension—see page 28.

For Washing Instructions—see page 29.

THE CENTRE: Cast on 80 sts.

1st row: K4. Turn.

2nd row: Sl.1. K3.

3rd row: K6. Turn.

4th row: Sl.1. K5.

5th row: K8. Turn.

6th row: Sl.1. K7.

Continue in this manner, that is working over 2 more sts. every alternate row to Sl.1. K79. This completes one pattern. Work 11 more patterns. Cast off loosely.

Sew the cast-on edge to the cast-off edge. Thread wool around centre edge and draw up and fasten securely.

THE BORDER: Cast on 89 sts.

1st row: K5. P84.

2nd row: K84. Turn.

3rd row: P84.

4th row: K84. Turn.

5th row: K84.

6th row: P84. Turn.

****7th row:** K1. *Wl.fwd. K2tog. Repeat from * to last st. P1.

8th row: P84. K5.

9th row: K89.

10th row: K84. Turn.

11th row: P84.

12th row: K1. Wind wool around right hand needle 3 times.

K6. Pass the 5th, 4th then 3rd sts. over the 6th st. K82.

13th row: K5. P80. (P1. K1. P1) all into loop wound around

needle in previous row. K1.

14th row: K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K81. Turn.

15th row: K84.

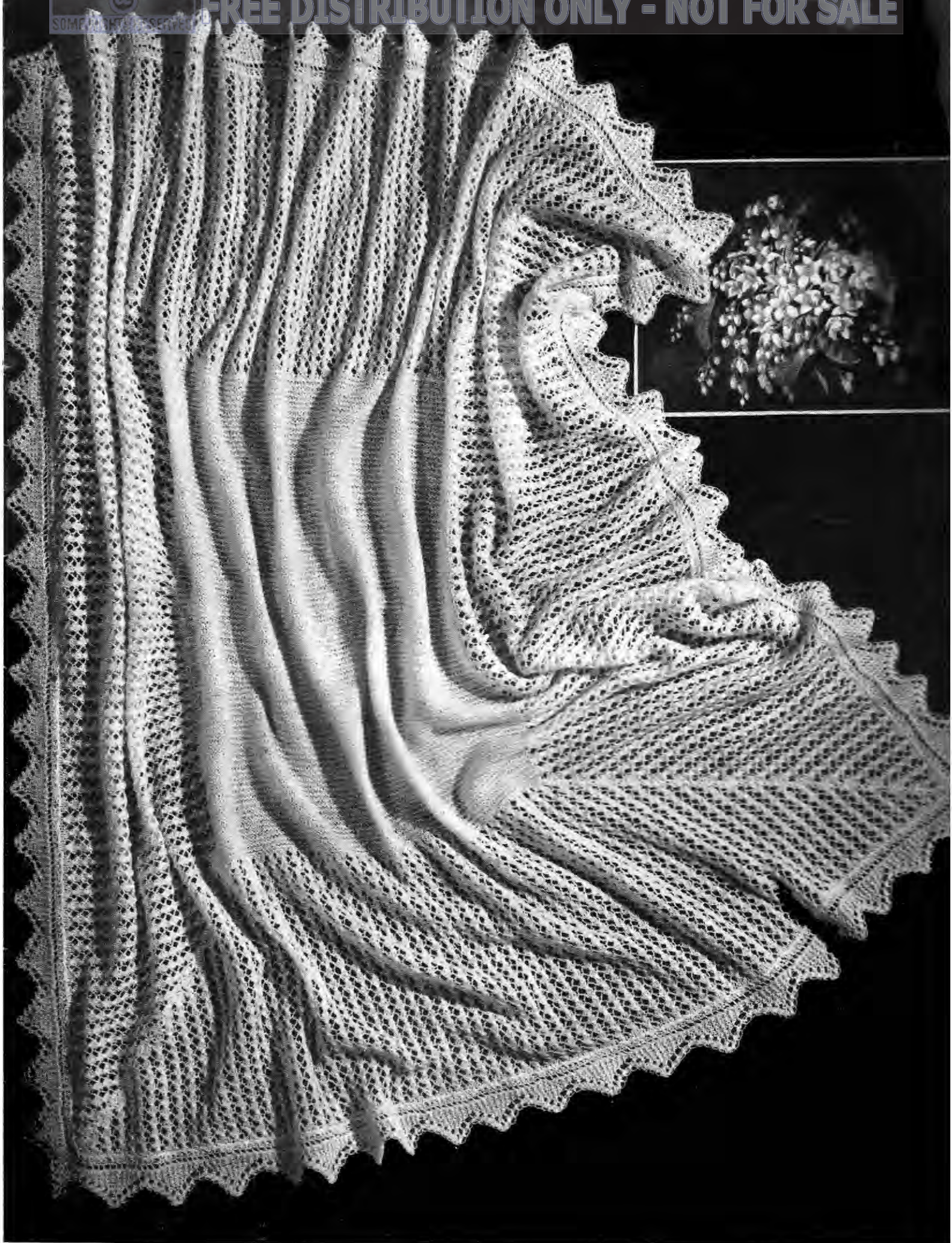
16th row: P84. Turn.**

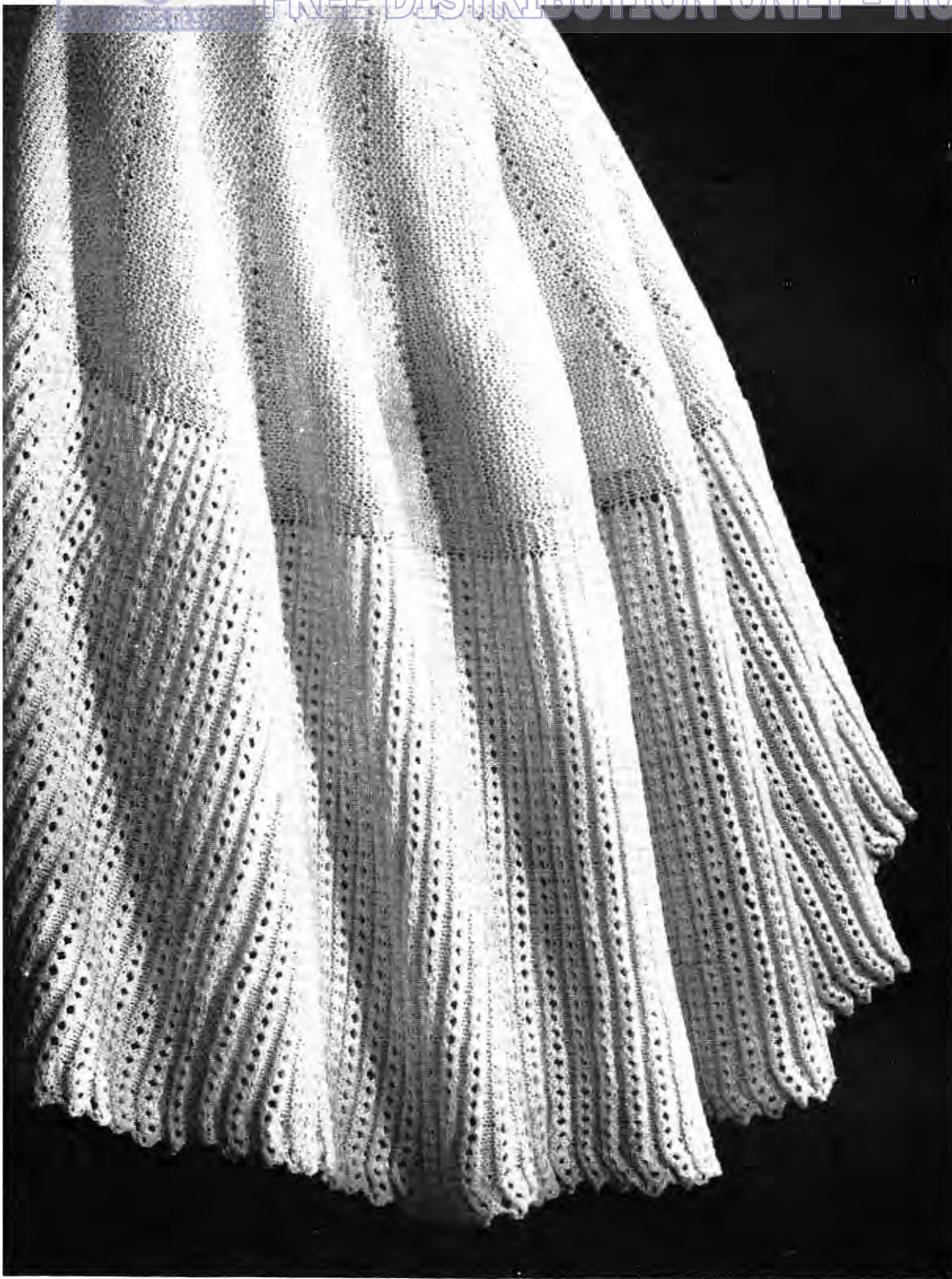
The 7th to 16th rows complete one "Fluted" pattern.

Repeat from ** to ** 167 times, then from 7th to 9th rows inclu-

sive once. Cast off. Sew the cast-on edge to the cast-off edge.

TO MAKE UP: Sew the border evenly around the centre, sewing 14 fluted patterns to each pattern of the centre. Roll in a damp towel for several hours, then spread out, pinning each point out separately with rustless pins and leave until dry.

THE CENTRE: Cast on 2 sts.
1st row: Inc. 1. st. in 1st. st. K1.
2nd row: Inc. 1. st. in 1st. st. Knit to end of row.
Repeat 2nd row to 102 sts. on needle.
Next row: K1. K2tog. Knit to end of row.
Repeat last row to 2 sts. on needle. K2tog. Fasten off.

THE BORDER: Beginning at one corner, cast on 55 sts.
1st row: K4. P48. Turn. Cast on 4 sts. Turn. Working across remaining 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

2nd row: K6. P3tog. (K1.P1.K1) all into front of next st. (thus inc. 2 sts.). Turn.

3rd row: Sl.1. purlways. P3. Inc. 1. st. in each of next 4 sts. K2.

4th row: K10. *(K1. P1. K1) all into next st. P3tog. Repeat from * once. Turn.

5th row: Sl.1. P7. K10.

6th row: K10. *P3tog. (K1. P1. K1) all into next st. Repeat from * twice. Turn.

7th row: Sl.1. P11. K10.

8th row: The st. on the right hand needle after casting off is counted as 1. st. Cast off 7 sts. loosely. K3. *(K1. P1. K1) all into next st. P3tog. Repeat from * 3 times. Turn.

9th row: Sl.1. P15. Cast on 4 sts. K2tog. K1.

10th row: K6. *P3tog. (K1. P1. K1) all into next st. Repeat from * 4 times. Turn.

11th row: Sl.1. P19. Inc. 1. st. in each of next 4 sts. K2.

12th row: K10. *(K1. P1. K1) all into next st. P3tog. Repeat from * 5 times. Turn.

13th row: Sl.1. P23. K10.

14th row: K10. *P3tog. (K1. P1. K1) all into next st. Repeat from * 6 times. Turn.

15th row: Sl.1. P27. K10.

16th row: Cast off 7 sts. K3. *(K1. P1. K1) all into next st. P3tog. Repeat from * 7 times. Turn.

17th row: Sl.1. P31. Cast on 4 sts. K2tog. K1.

18th row: K6. *P3tog. (K1. P1. K1) all into next st. Repeat from * 8 times. Turn.

19th row: Sl.1. P35. Inc. 1. st. in each of next 4 sts. K2.

20th row: K10. *(K1. P1. K1) all into next st. P3tog. Repeat from * 9 times. Turn.

21st row: Sl.1. P39. K10.

22nd row: K10. *P3tog. (K1. P1. K1) all into next st. Repeat from * 10 times. Turn.

23rd row: Sl.1. P43. K10.

24th row: Cast off 7 sts. K3. *(K1. P1. K1) all into next st. P3tog. Repeat from * 11 times. K4. These 24 rows complete ¼ of corner. Repeat these 24 rows once. (The remaining ¼ is worked at the end of the border). Proceed:—

1st row: K4. P48. Cast on 4 sts. K2tog. K1.

2nd row: K6. *P3tog. (K1. P1. K1) all into next st. Repeat from * to last 4 sts. K4.

3rd row: K4. P48. Inc. 1. st. in each of next 4 sts. K2.

4th row: K10. *(K1. P1. K1) all into next st. P3tog. Repeat from * to last 4 sts. K4.

5th row: K4. P48. K10.

6th row: K10. *P3tog. (K1. P1. K1) all into next st. Repeat from * to last 4 sts. K4.

7th row: K4. P48. K10.

8th row: Cast off 7 sts. K3. *(K1. P1. K1) all into next st. P3tog. Repeat from * to last 4 sts. K4. These 8 rows complete one pattern for side. Work 11 more complete patterns.

Work the 24 rows of corner 3 times, then the 8 rows of side 12 times. Repeat from *** to *** twice, then repeat the 24 rows of corner once. Cast off loosely. Sew the cast-off edge to the east-on edge.

TO MAKE UP: Sew the border around the centre being careful to keep the seam from binding. Roll in a damp towel for several hours, then spread out flat, pinning each point out separately with rustless pins and leave until dry.

1st row: K3. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K4. Wl.fwd. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K3.

2nd row: Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K4. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K4.

3rd row: K2. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K7. Wl.fwd. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K3.

4th row: Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K6. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1.

5th row: K3. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K3. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K3. Wl.fwd. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K3.

6th row: Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K5. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K4.

7th row: K2. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K5. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. K2tog. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) twice. K2.

8th row: Wl.fwd. (K2tog.) twice. Wl.fwd. K2tog. Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. Wl.fwd. K7. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1.

9th row: K3. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K5. (K2tog. Wl.fwd.) twice. K2tog. K2.

10th row: Wl.fwd. (K2tog.) twice. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) twice. K3. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K4.

11th row: K2. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K4. (K2tog. Wl.fwd.) twice. K2tog. K2.

12th row: Wl.fwd. (K2tog.) twice. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) twice. K4. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1.

These 12 rows complete one pattern. Repeat pattern 32 times. Knit 1 row. Cast off loosely. **Do not break wool.**

THE BORDER: Having 1. st. on needle pick up and knit 1. st. in each ridge along straight edge of Lace Edging. (200 sts. on needle). Proceed:—

1st and 2nd rows: K2tog. Knit to end of row. (198 sts. on needle).

3rd row: Knit.

4th row: K14. *Wl.fwd. K2tog. K22. Repeat from * to last 16 sts. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K14. Repeat 3rd and 4th rows twice.

10th row: K10. *K2tog. Wl.fwd. K2. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K15. Repeat from * to last 20 sts. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K2. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K11.

11th, 13th and 15th rows: Knit.

12th row: K9. *K2tog. Wl.fwd. K3. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K2. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K13. Repeat from * to last 21 sts. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K3. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K2. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K10.

14th row: K8. *K2tog. Wl.fwd. K4. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K3. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K11. Repeat from * to last 22 sts. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K4. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K3. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K9.

16th row: K7. *K2tog. Wl.fwd. K5. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K4. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K9. Repeat from * to last 23 sts. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K5. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K4. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K8.

17th row: K7. *K2tog. Wl.fwd. K13. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K7. Repeat from * to last 23 sts. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K13. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K6.

18th row: K5. *K2tog. Wl.fwd. K3. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K2. Wl.fwd. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K3. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K5. Repeat from * to last st. K1.

19th row: K5. *K2tog. Wl.fwd. K17. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K3. Repeat from * to last 25 sts. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K17. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K2. K2tog.

46th row: K3. K2tog. Wl.fwd. *K19. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. K2tog. Wl.fwd. Repeat from * to last 24 sts. K19. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. K2tog.

47th row: K1. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K21. *Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. Wl.fwd. K21. Repeat from * to last 4 sts. Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. K1.

48th and 49th rows: Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog. (169 sts. on needle).

50th row: Knit.

51st row: K11. *Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. Wl.fwd. K21. Repeat from * to last 14 sts. Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. Wl.fwd. K9. K2tog.

52nd row: K8. *K2tog. Wl.fwd. K3. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K17. Repeat from * to last 16 sts. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K3. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K7. K2tog.

53rd row: K7. *K2tog. Wl.fwd. K5. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K15. Repeat from * to last 16 sts. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K5. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K5. K2tog.

67th row: K10. Wl.fwd. K2tog. *(K3. P1) twice. K3. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K9. Wl.fwd. K2tog. Repeat from * to last 21 sts. (K3. P1) twice. K3. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K6. K2tog.

68th row: K8. *Wl.fwd. K2tog. K3. K2tog. (Wl.fwd.) twice. K2tog. K2. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K11. Repeat from * to last 24 sts. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K3. K2tog. (Wl.fwd.) twice. K2tog. K2. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K9. K2tog.

69th row: K11. *Wl.fwd. K2tog. K3. P1. K3. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K13. Repeat from * to last 20 sts. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K3. P1. K3. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K7. K2tog.

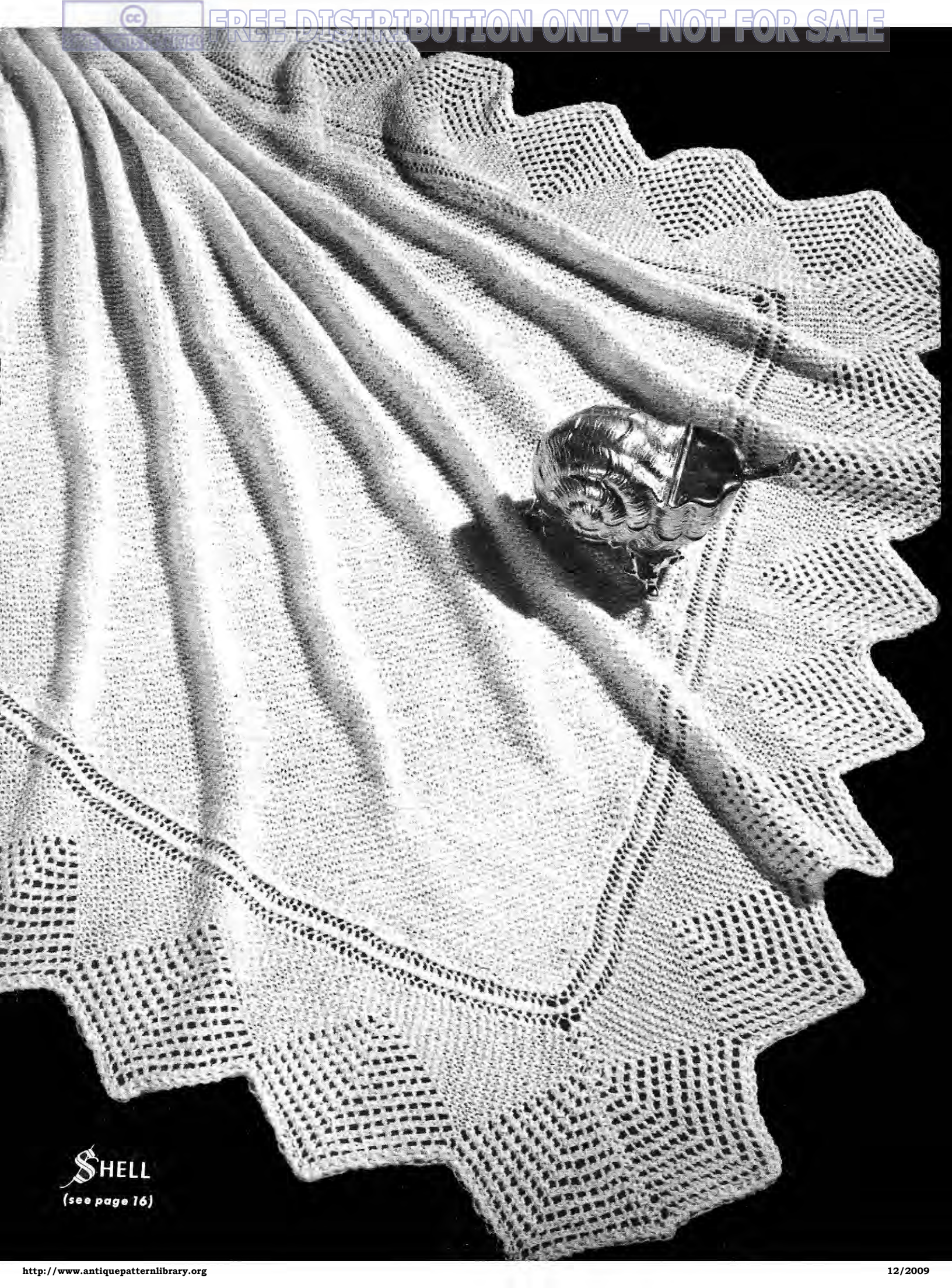

Tension: 7 sts. and 9 rows = 1 inch.

Check tension—see page 28.

For Washing Instructions—see page 29.

THE CENTRE: Cast on 2 sts.

1st row: Inc. 1. st. in 1st. st. K1.

2nd row: Inc. 1. st. in 1st. st. Knit to end of row. Repeat 2nd row until side edge of work measures 28 ins.

Next row: K1. K2tog. Knit to end of row.

Repeat last row to 2 sts. on needle. K2tog. Fasten off.

THE BORDER: Cast on 27 sts. Knit 1 row. Proceed:—

1st row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K16. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice.

2nd and alternate rows: K2. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. Knit to end of row, being sure to knit the w.r.n. at beginning of previous row as 1. st.

3rd row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) twice. Wl.fwd. K15. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice.

5th row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 3 times. Wl.fwd. K14. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice.

7th row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 4 times. Wl.fwd. K13. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice.

9th row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 5 times. Wl.fwd. K12. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice.

11th row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 6 times. Wl.fwd. K11. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice.

13th row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 7 times. Wl.fwd. K10. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice.

15th row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 8 times. Wl.fwd. K9. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice.

17th row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 9 times. Wl.fwd. K8. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice.

19th row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 10 times. Wl.fwd. K7. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice.

21st row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 11 times. Wl.fwd. K6. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice. (Centre of Shell, 38 sts. on needle).

23rd row: W.r.n. (K2tog.) twice. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 11 times. K6. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice.

25th row: W.r.n. (K2tog.) twice. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 10 times. K7. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice.

27th row: W.r.n. (K2tog.) twice. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 9 times. K8. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice.

29th row: W.r.n. (K2tog.) twice. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 8 times. K9. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice.

31st row: W.r.n. (K2tog.) twice. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 7 times. K10. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice.

33rd row: W.r.n. (K2tog.) twice. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 6 times. K11. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice.

35th row: W.r.n. (K2tog.) twice. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 5 times. K12. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice.

37th row: W.r.n. (K2tog.) twice. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 4 times. K13. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice.

39th row: W.r.n. (K2tog.) twice. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 3 times. K14. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice.

41st row: W.r.n. (K2tog.) twice. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) twice. K15. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice.

43rd row: W.r.n. (K2tog.) twice. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K16. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice.

44th row: K2. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K20. (These 44 rows complete one Shell Pattern). Work 5 more complete patterns, then 1st. to 12th rows inclusive of next pattern. (33 sts. on needle).

To make mitred corner: 1st row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 7 times. Wl.fwd. K10. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Turn.

2nd row: Sl.1. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K27.

3rd row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 8 times. Wl.fwd. K9. Turn.

4th, 6th and 8th rows: Sl.1. Knit to end of row.

5th row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 9 times. Wl.fwd. K6. Turn.

7th row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 10 times. Wl.fwd. K3. Turn.

9th row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 11 times. Turn.

10th row: W.r.n. K25. (Centre of Shell, 38 sts. on needle).

11th row: W.r.n. (K2tog.) twice. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 10 times. Turn.

12th and alternate rows: Sl.1. Knit to end of row.

13th row: W.r.n. (K2tog.) twice. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 9 times. Turn.

15th row: W.r.n. (K2tog.) twice. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 8 times. Turn.

17th row: W.r.n. (K2tog.) twice. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 7 times. Turn.

19th row: W.r.n. (K2tog.) twice. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 6 times. Turn.

9th row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 3 times. Turn.

11th row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 4 times. Turn.

13th row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 5 times. Turn.

15th row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 6 times. Turn.

17th row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 7 times. Turn.

19th row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 8 times. Turn.

21st row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 9 times. Turn.

23rd row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 10 times. Turn.

25th row: W.r.n. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 11 times. Turn. (Centre of Shell).

27th row: W.r.n. (K2tog.) twice. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 11 times. Turn.

29th row: W.r.n. (K2tog.) twice. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 10 times. K3. Turn.

31st row: W.r.n. (K2tog.) twice. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 9 times. K6. Turn.

33rd row: W.r.n. (K2tog.) twice. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 8 times. K9. Turn.

35th row: W.r.n. (K2tog.) twice. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 7 times. K10. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. Turn.

36th row: Sl.1. K1. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K26.
Work the 33rd to 44th rows inclusive of Border Pattern.
This completes mitred corner. ¶
Repeat from ¶ to ¶ 3 times. Cast off loosely.

TO MAKE UP: Sew the cast-off edge of the border to the cast-on edge. Placing mitred corners to corners of centre, sew evenly around being careful to keep seam from binding. Roll shawl in a damp towel for several hours, then spread out flat, pinning each point out separately with rustless pins and leave until dry.

10th row: P5.

11th row: K1. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. K1.

12th row: K3tog. Fasten off, leaving an end approx. 8 ins. long for sewing.

Slip next 17 sts. onto a thread. Working on next 19 sts. join wool and work the 1st. to 12th rows of corner.
Repeat from ** to ** twice. Leave remaining 17 sts. on a thread. Make 15 more Medallions to correspond.

THE BORDER: With 2 needles cast on 24 sts.

1st row: K4. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice. P3. (K1. Wl.fwd.) twice. K1. P3. w.r.n. P2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd.) twice. (That is, wind wool twice around needle. In following row each loop will be worked as a st. thus making 2 sts.). K2.

2nd row: K2. (K1. P1) into the double Wl.fwd. of previous row. (That is knit into 1 loop and purl into 2nd loop of the double Wl.fwd.). K1. w.o.n. P2tog. K3. P5. K3. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice. K4.

3rd row: K4. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice. P3. K2. Wl.fwd. K1. Wl.fwd. K2. P3. w.r.n. P2tog. K5.

4th row: The st. on the right hand needle after casting off is counted as 1. st. Cast off 2 sts. loosely. K3. w.r.n. P2tog. K3. P7. K3. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice. K4.

5th row: K4. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice. P3. K3. Wl.fwd. K1. Wl.fwd. K3. P3. w.r.n. P2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd.) twice. K2.

6th row: K2. (K1. P1) into the double Wl.fwd. of previous row. K1. w.r.n. P2tog. K3. P9. K3. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice. K4.

7th row: K4. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice. P3. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K5. K2tog. P3. w.r.n. P2tog. K5.

8th row: Cast off 2 sts. loosely. K3. w.r.n. P2tog. K3. P7. K3. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice. K4.

9th row: K4. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice. P3. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K3. K2tog. P3. w.r.n. P2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd.) twice. K2.

10th row: K2. (K1. P1) into the double Wl.fwd. of previous row. K1. w.r.n. P2tog. K3. P5. K3. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice. K4.

11th row: K4. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice. P3. Sl.1. K1. p.s.s.o. K1. K2tog. P3. w.r.n. P2tog. K5.

12th row: Cast off 2 sts. loosely. K3. w.r.n. P2tog. K3. P3. K3. (Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1) twice. K4. (24 sts. on needle). Repeat these 12 rows until work measures approx. 4½ yds. ending with 12th pattern row. Cast off.

TO MAKE UP: Slip 17 sts. of one medallion onto a needle and 17 sts. of another medallion onto another needle. Place the two needles together, wrong sides facing and graft the two medallions together. For Grafting, see page 28. With the ends of wool left at corners, sew the corner seams being careful to match patterns and keep seams elastic. Join medallions together in this manner to form a square 4 medallions by 4 medallions. With right side of work facing join wool to each group of 17 sts. left on a thread around outside edge and cast off loosely. Beginning at one corner, sew the border around the shawl, gathering it at the corners to keep work flat. Sew evenly to keep seam from binding. Sew the cast-off edge of the border to the cast-on edge. Roll shawl in a damp towel for several hours, then spread out flat, pinning into shape with rustless pins and leave until dry.

THE CENTRE: Cast on 295 sts.

Knit 5 rows Garter st.

6th row: (right side of work). K6. Wl.fwd. ★Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. w.r.n. P2. w.o.n. Repeat from ★ to last 9 sts. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. Wl.fwd. K6.

7th row: K6. ★P3. K2. Repeat from ★ to last 9 sts. P3. K6. Repeat 6th and 7th rows until work measures approx. 36½ ins. from beginning ending with 7th row.

Knit 6 rows Garter st. Cast off loosely.

THE BORDER: Cast on 22 sts.

1st row: Sl.1. K7. Slip next 3 sts. onto the spare needle, letting this needle fall to back of work. Knit next 3 sts. Bring the 3 sts. forward and knit them. (The working of 6 sts. in this manner will be termed "Twist Back" throughout). (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) 3 times. Wl.fwd. K2.

2nd row: K9. P9. w.o.n. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1.

3rd row: Sl.1. K13. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) twice. Wl.fwd. K2.

5th row: Sl.1. K4. Slip next 3 sts. onto the spare needle, letting this needle fall to front of work. Knit next 3 sts. Take the 3 sts. back and knit them. (The working of 6 sts. in this manner will be termed "Twist Front" throughout). K3. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K2. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) twice. Wl.fwd. K2.

6th row: K11. P9. w.o.n. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1.

7th row: Sl.1. K13. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K3. (Wl.fwd. K2tog.) twice. Wl.fwd. K2.

8th row: K12. P9. w.o.n. K2tog. Wl.fwd. K2tog. K1.

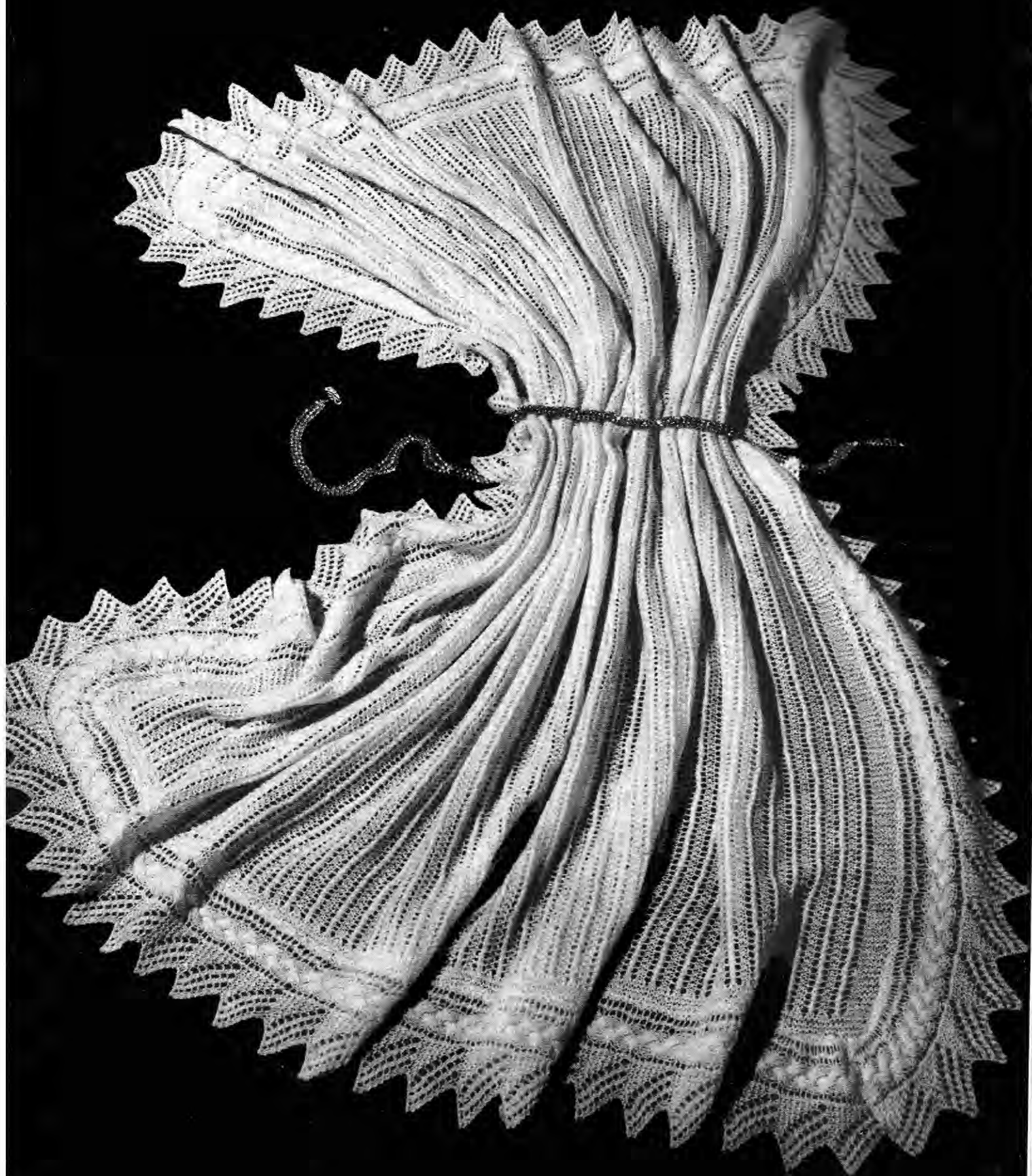

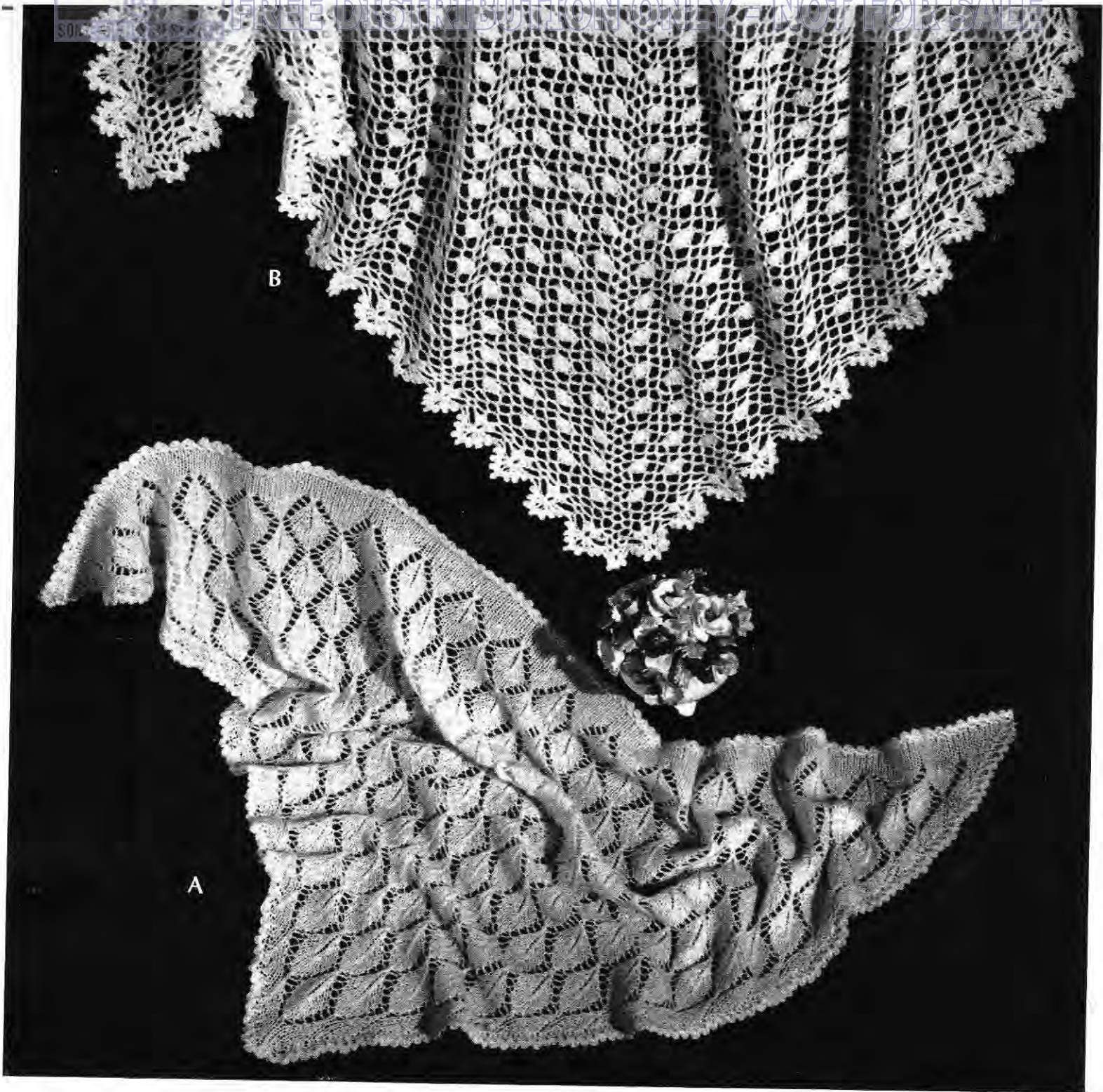

Ch. 1 more st. Shell in Shell. Ch. 3. Repeat from * to * to 3rd Shell. Ch. 1 more st. Shell in Shell. Working along base of shawl, Ch. 3. Repeat from * to * to 1st. Shell. Ch. 1 more st.

Miss next space. 1. s.c. in next space.* Repeat from * to * to 2nd Shell. Ch. 3. Shell in Shell. Ch. 3. 1. s.c. in next space. Repeat from * to * to 3rd Shell. Ch. 3. Shell in Shell. 3rd round: 1. s.c. in 1st. Shell. Ch. 3. 1. s.c. in s.c. just worked. 1. s.c. in Shell. (This makes 1 Picot). Work 2 more Picots in Shell. Ch. 4. Miss 2 spaces. *1. s.c. in 1st. d.c. of next group. Work a Picot in each d.c. and the Ch. 2 space between groups, (7 Picots) working the last s.c. in next space. Ch. 2. Miss 1 space.* Repeat from * to * to space before 2nd Shell. Ch. 2 more sts. Miss 1 space. 1. s.c. in Shell. Work 3 Picots in Shell. Ch. 4. Miss 2 spaces. Repeat from * to * to 3rd Shell. Ch. 2 more sts. Miss 1 space. 1. s.c. in Shell. Work 3 Picots in Shell. Ch. 4. Miss 2 spaces. Repeat from * to * to 1st. Shell, omitting last Ch. 2. Fasten off.

2nd row: *(1. d.c. Ch. 1) 3 times in the single d.c. of previous row. 1. d.c. in centre d.c. of 3 d.c. group. Ch. 1. Repeat from * to end of row, working 1. d.c. in 3rd st. of turning Ch. of previous row. Ch. 4. Turn.

3rd row: (1. d.c. Ch. 1) in last d.c. of previous row. *1. d.c. in centre d.c. of next 3 d.c. group. Ch. 1. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) 3 times in next d.c. Repeat from * to end of row, working (1. d.c. Ch. 1) twice in 3rd st. of turning Ch. of previous row. Ch. 4. Turn. Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows until work measures approx. 35 ins. from beginning ending with 3rd row.

Next round: *Work 1. d.c. in each space and each d.c. of previous row, then 5 d.c. in corner. Working along side of shawl, work 1. d.c. in end of each row and 2 d.c. in each space, then 5 d.c. in corner. Repeat from * once. Join with s.s. in top of turning Ch. of previous row. Fasten off.

THE BORDER: Ch. 15 sts.

1st row: 1. d.c. in 6th Ch. from hook. Ch. 1. Miss 2 sts. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) 3 times in next st. Miss 2 sts. 1. d.c. in next st. Ch. 1. Miss 2 sts. 1. d.c. in last st. Ch. 4. Turn.

****2nd row:** 1. d.c. in 2nd d.c. Ch. 1. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) 3 times in centre d.c. of 3 d.c. group. 1. d.c. in next d.c. Ch. 5. Turn.

3rd row: 1. d.c. in 1st. d.c. Ch. 1. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) 3 times in centre d.c. of 3 d.c. group. 1. d.c. in next d.c. Ch. 1. 1. d.c. in 3rd st. of turning Ch. of previous row. Ch. 4. Turn.

4th row: 1. d.c. in 2nd d.c. Ch. 1. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) 3 times in centre d.c. of 3 d.c. group. 1. d.c. in next d.c. Ch. 3. Do not turn but work along side of border as follows:—

Repeat from ** to ** until work measures approx. 4½ yds. ending with 6th row and omitting turning Ch. in last row. Fasten off.

Sew the beginning of border to end of border. Roll shawl in a damp towel for several hours, then spread out flat, pinning each scallop out separately with rustless pins and leave until dry.

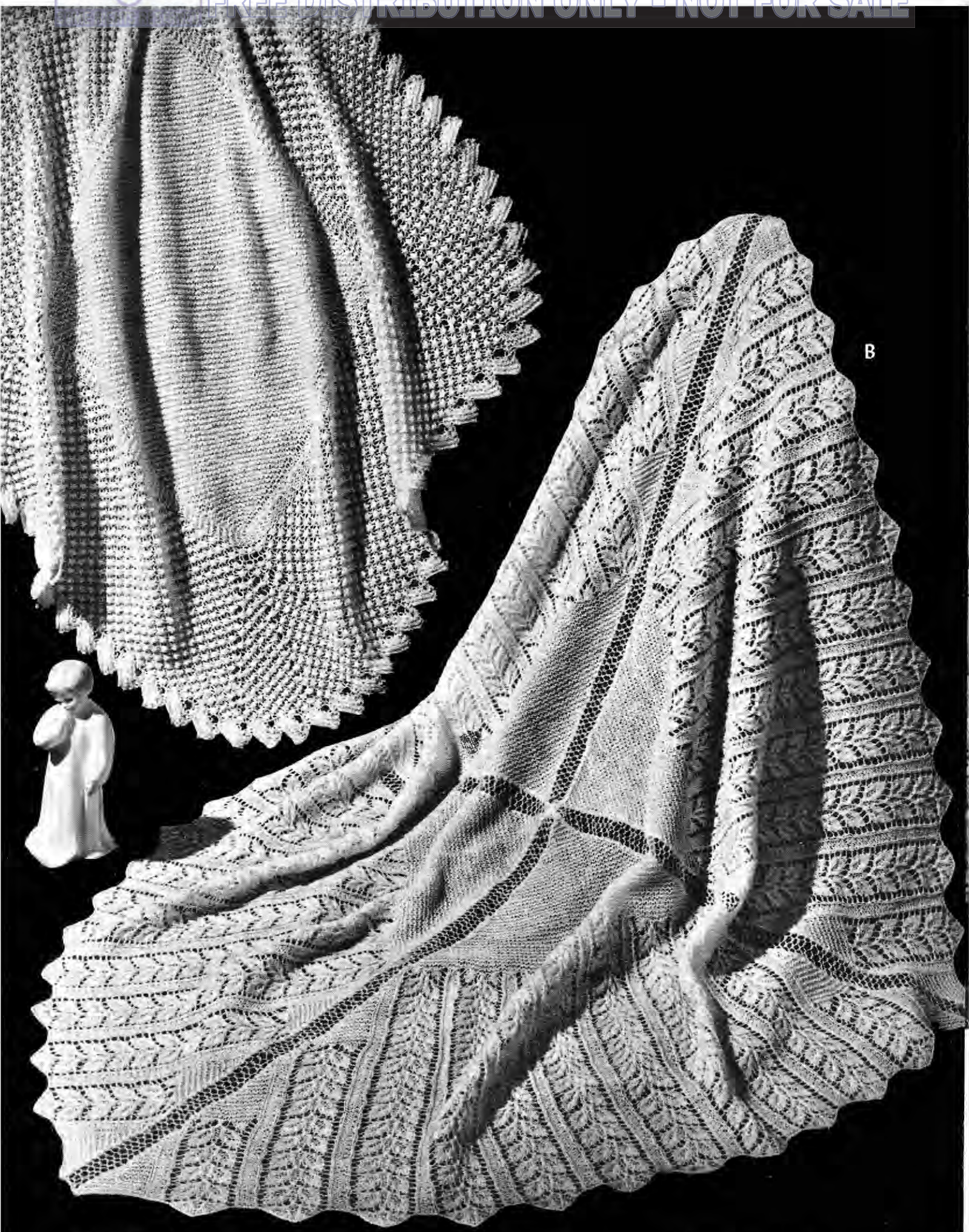

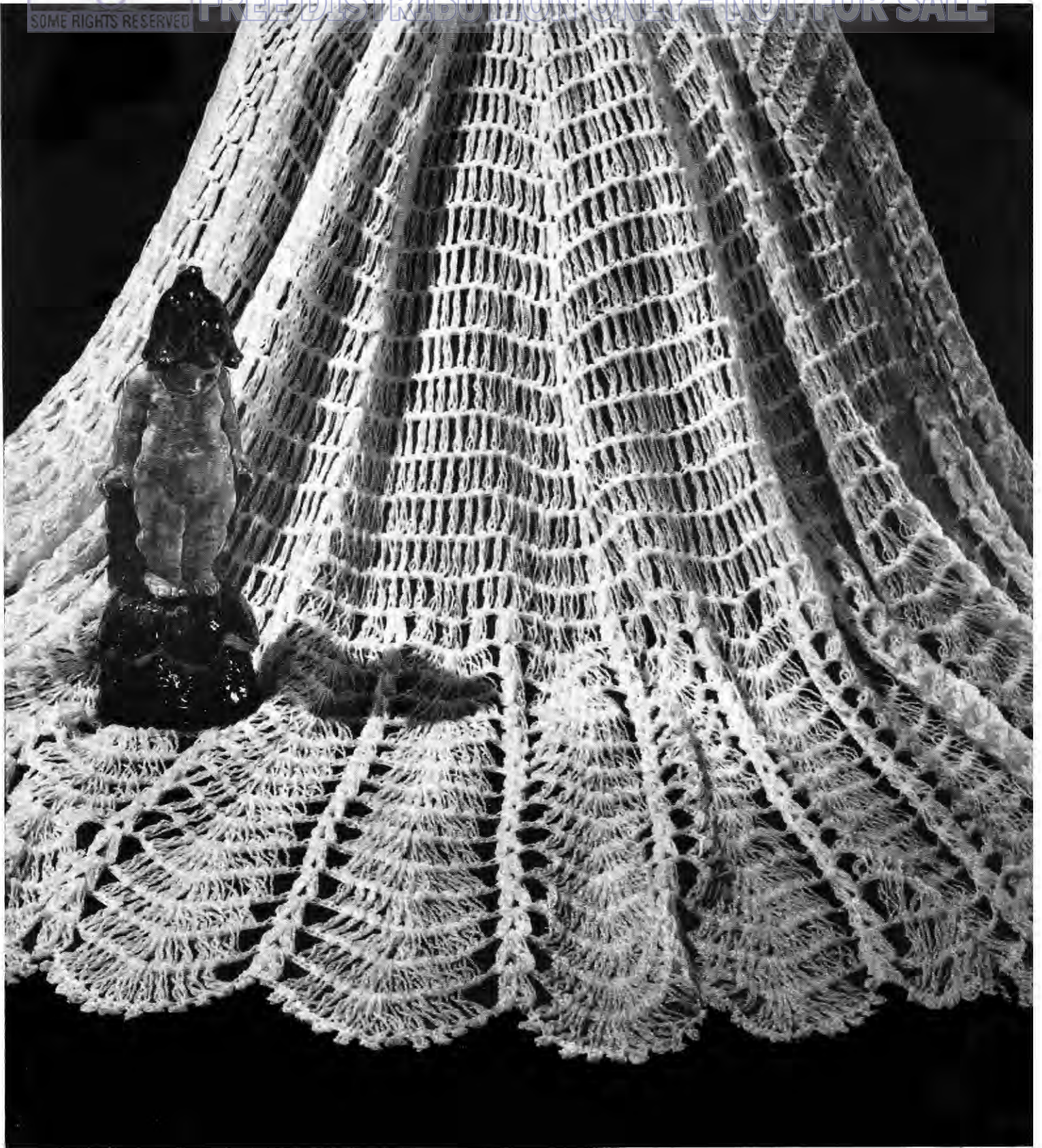

Beginning at centre, Ch. 6 sts. Join in ring with s.s.

1st round: Ch. 4. *W.o.h. Draw up a loop in ring $\frac{1}{2}$ inch high. Complete this d.c. in usual manner. Ch. 1. tightly. Repeat from * 12 times. Join with s.s. in 3rd st. of Ch. 4 at beginning of round. Counting the Ch. 4 at beginning of round as a d.c. there are 14 d.c. in round.

2nd round: 1. s.s. in 1st. space. Ch. 4. *(1. d.c. Ch. 1) twice in each space to end of round, working last d.c. in same space as Ch. 4 at beginning of round. Ch. 1. Join with s.s. as before. (28 d.c. in round).

3rd round: 1. s.s. in 1st. space. Ch. 4. *(1. d.c. Ch. 1) twice in next space. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) in next space. Repeat from * to last space. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) twice in next space. Join with s.s. as before. (42 d.c. in round).

4th round: 1. s.s. in 1st. space. Ch. 5. *W.o.h. Draw up a loop in next space $\frac{3}{4}$ inch high. W.o.h. and draw up another loop in same space $\frac{3}{4}$ inch high. W.o.h. and draw through all 5 loops on hook, thus making a "Puff st.". Ch. 1. tightly. Work another (Puff st. Ch. 1) in same space. 1. d.c. ($\frac{3}{4}$ inch high). Ch. 1 in each of next 2 spaces. Repeat from * to end of round, joining with s.s. in 4th st. of Ch. 5 at beginning of round. The Ch. 5 counts as the last d.c. There are 14 groups of 2 Puff sts. in round with 2 d.c.'s between.

5th round: 1. s.s. in 1st. space. Ch. 5. *(Puff st. Ch. 1) twice in next space (the space between the Puff sts. of previous round), (1. d.c. Ch. 1) in each of next 3 spaces. Repeat from * to end of round, joining as before. There are still 14 groups of 2 Puff sts. in round but there are now 3 d.c.'s between.

Continue in this manner working 1 extra d.c. between the Puff st. groups every round until there are 22 d.c.'s between and being careful to work the sts, 1 inch high after the 9th round from beginning. Proceed:—

To make Border: 1st round: 1. s.s. in 1st. space. Ch. 5. *(Puff st. Ch. 1) twice in next space (the space between the Puff sts. of previous round). Miss 1 space. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) twice in next space. Miss 1 space. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) twice in next space. Miss 1 space. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) twice in next space. Miss 1 space. Repeat from * to end of round, joining as before.

2nd round: 1. s.s. in 1st. space. Ch. 5. *(Puff st. Ch. 1) twice in next space. Miss 1 space. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) in each of next 2 spaces. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) 4 times in next space. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) in each of next 2 spaces. Miss 1 space. Repeat from * to end of round, joining as before.

3rd round: 1. s.s. in 1st. space. Ch. 5. *(Puff st. Ch. 1) twice in next space. Miss 2 spaces. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) in each of next 2 spaces. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) 4 times in next space. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) in each of next 2 spaces. Miss 2 spaces. Repeat from * to end of round, joining as before.

4th round: 1. s.s. in 1st. space. Ch. 5. *(Puff st. Ch. 1) twice in next space. Miss 2 spaces. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) in each of next 2 spaces. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) 6 times in next space. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) in each of next 2 spaces. Miss 2 spaces. Repeat from * to end of round, joining as before.

5th round: 1. s.s. in 1st. space. Ch. 5. *(Puff st. Ch. 1) twice in next space. Miss 2 spaces. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) in each of next 3 spaces. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) 4 times in next space. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) in each of next 3 spaces. Miss 2 spaces. Repeat from * to end of round, joining as before. Repeat 5th round 5 times.

11th round: 1. s.s. in 1st. space. Ch. 5. *(Puff st. Ch. 1) twice in next space. Miss 2 spaces. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) in each of next 3 spaces. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) 6 times in next space. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) in each of next 3 spaces. Miss 2 spaces. Repeat from * to end of round, joining as before.

12th round: 1. s.s. in 1st. space. Ch. 5. *(Puff st. Ch. 1) twice in next space. Miss 2 spaces. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) in each of next 4 spaces. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) 4 times in next space. (1. d.c. Ch. 1) in each of next 4 spaces. Miss 2 spaces. Repeat from * to end of round, joining as before. Repeat 12th round twice.

15th round: 1. s.s. in 1st. space. Ch. 5. *(Puff st. Ch. 1) twice in next space. Miss 2 spaces. (1. d.c. in next space. Ch. 7. 1. s.c. in 1st. Ch. thus forming picot) in each of next 4 spaces. (1. d.c. picot) 4 times in next space. (1. d.c. picot) in each of next 4 spaces. Miss 2 spaces. Repeat from * to end of round, joining as before. Fasten off. Press very lightly with damp cloth and warm iron.

39th row: W.r.n. K3tog. Wl.fwd. K3. Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. Wl.fwd. K5. Wl.fwd. K1. P3. K1. Repeat from * 7th pattern row to last 14 sts. Wl.fwd. K5. Wl.fwd. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. (Wl.fwd. K3) twice.

40th row: W.r.n. K3tog. K13. P1. K3. P1. Repeat from * 8th pattern row to last 15 sts. K15. Repeat these 40 rows once, then 1st. to 39th rows inclusive once. (136 sts. on needle).

Next row: W.r.n. K3tog. (Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. K1) twice. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. K3. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. *K3. (Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. K1) twice. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. K3. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. Repeat from * to last 16 sts. K3. (Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. K1) twice. Sl.1. K2tog. p.s.s.o. K2. (81 sts. on needle).

Next row: W.r.n. K3tog. Knit to end of row. Repeat last row to 2 sts. on needle. K2tog. Fasten off. Make 3 more pieces exactly the same

TO MAKE UP: Lay 2 pieces flat on a table right sides up and loops made by the w.r.n. at beginning of every row facing. Sew together in herringbone st. as follows:—

Thread a wool needle with a length of wool approx. $1\frac{1}{2}$ yds. long and join in the first loop of piece on right hand side at lower edge. Leave a length of about 3 ins. to darn in afterwards. Cross to the left piece and bring needle **up** through the first loop. *Pass needle **under** the bar just made and cross to right piece bringing needle **up** through next loop. Pass needle **under** bar and **up** through next loop on left piece. Repeat from * up the work to points at top. Darn in end of wool. Join other 2 pieces in same manner. Join the 2 large pieces together in similar manner, darning in ends neatly in centre. Roll in a damp towel for several hours, then spread out flat, pinning each scallop out separately with rustless pins and leave until dry.

Helpful Information

Wl.fwd.—WOOL FORWARD.

This method is used in knitting. The wool is at the back of the work after knitting a st. and must be passed between the 2 needles to bring it to the front of the work as if for purling. Insert the point of the right hand needle into the next 2 sts. on the left hand needle and carrying the wool over and round the point of the right hand needle knit the 2 sts. together in the usual way. The wool is again at the back of the work ready for the next knit st.

W.R.N.—WOOL ROUND NEEDLE.

This method is used when making a Wl.fwd. st. in purling. The wool is already in front of the needle after purling a st. so wind the wool right round the right hand needle once before purling the following 2 sts. together.

W.O.N.—WOOL OVER NEEDLE.

This method is used when making a Wl.fwd. after purling a st. and before knitting the next st. The wool is already in front of the needle after the purling st. so leaving the wool in front, knit the next 2 sts. together in the usual way.

t.b.l.—THROUGH BACK OF LOOPS.

This method is often used instead of p.s.s.o. Insert the point of the right hand needle through the back of 2 loops on the left hand needle instead of the front and knit the 2 sts. together in the usual way. Instructions may also read "knit through back of st.". This makes a twisted st.

p.s.s.o.—PASS SLIPPED ST. OVER.

Used in Fancy patterns and as a method of decreasing. Put the point of the right hand needle into the next st. on the left hand needle and slip the st. onto the right hand needle without knitting it. Knit or purl the next st. then pull or pass the slipped st. over the knitted or purling st. and let it drop off the needle.

Sl. st.—SLIPPED ST.

Used when transferring a stitch from the left hand needle to the right hand needle, without knitting or purling it. Put the point of the right hand needle into the next st. on the left hand needle and pass the st. onto the right hand needle without knitting it. Always slip a st. knitways unless instructions tell you differently.

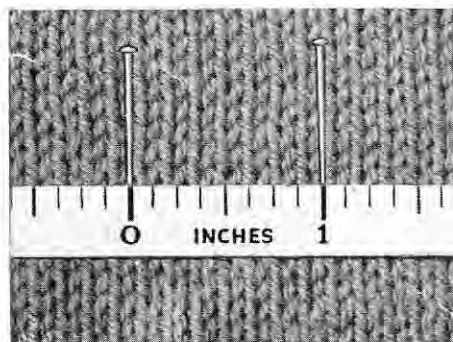
TO SEW SEAMS

Lay the edges of worked pieces together, flat, and sew on the wrong side, taking a st. with a st. Stretch the seams very slightly when sewing, otherwise they will not be as elastic as the rest of the work.

TO GRAFT STITCHES

★Inserting the wool needle as if for knitting into 1st. st. of front needle, draw it through the st. and slip the latter off the needle; inserting the needle, as if for purling into 2nd. st. of front needle, draw wool through and let the st. remain on the needle; taking the wool under front needle and inserting the wool needle, as if for purling, into 1st. st. of back needle, draw the wool through this st. and slip the latter off the needle; inserting the needle, as if for knitting, into the 2nd. st. of back needle, draw the wool through and let the st. remain on the needle; bring the wool forward under the needle and repeat from ★ until all sts. are worked off, darning in the end of wool securely.

To Check Tension -- most important



The garments in this book are worked to the exact tension given. They are closely knitted to insure a firm fabric that will wear better and keep its shape longer than a loosely knitted fabric. *Check your tension.* Before beginning your garment take the wool and needles specified. Cast on 20 stitches. Work 20 rows stocking stitch. Lay work flat on a table and place a ruler across the stitches. Count the number of stitches to one inch and compare with the tension given in the instructions. All given tension in Beehive instructions is measured over stocking stitch. If your tension is too loose try a size smaller needle. If your tension is too tight try a size larger needle.
