CROCHET STITCHES

CHAIN STITCH

1—Catch thread with needle, forming a loop. Pull the thread with the needle through this loop to form first stitch. Continue chain to any desired length.

SLIP STITCH

2—Make row of chain stitches. Insert needle in last chain and pull thread through. Pull loop thus made through first loop.

SINGLE CROCHET

3—Make row of chain stitches. Insert needle in last chain and pull thread through, thus having two loops on needle. Wind thread once over needle and pull through the two loops.

DOUBLE CROCHET

4—Wind thread once around needle. Insert needle into chain and pull thread through; this leaves three loops on needle. Wind thread once around needle and pull through two. Wind thread again over needle and pull through two.

TREBLE CROCHET

5—Make same way as Double Crochet, only at first wind thread twice over needle and pull thread through three times—two and two and two.

DOUBLE TREBLE CROCHET

6—Make same way as Double Crochet, only at first wind thread three times over needle and pull thread through four times—two and two and two and two.

DOUBLE TRIPLE TREBLE CROCHET

7—Make same way as Double Crochet, only at first wind thread four times over needle and pull thread through five times—two and two and two and two and two.

PICOT

8—Make a chain. Skip three chains and make a Single Crochet. Chain four, catch back into the first chain. Wind thread once around needle and pull through both loops. Make three or four Single Crochet stitches or enough to make desired distance between picots and repeat.

HALF DOUBLE CROCHET

9—Use a double thread. Wind thread once around needle, insert into chain and pull loop through. Wind thread around needle again and pull through three loops at once.

MESH

10—Used in filet crochet work. Chains two stitches, skip two stitches, one double crochet into next stitch.

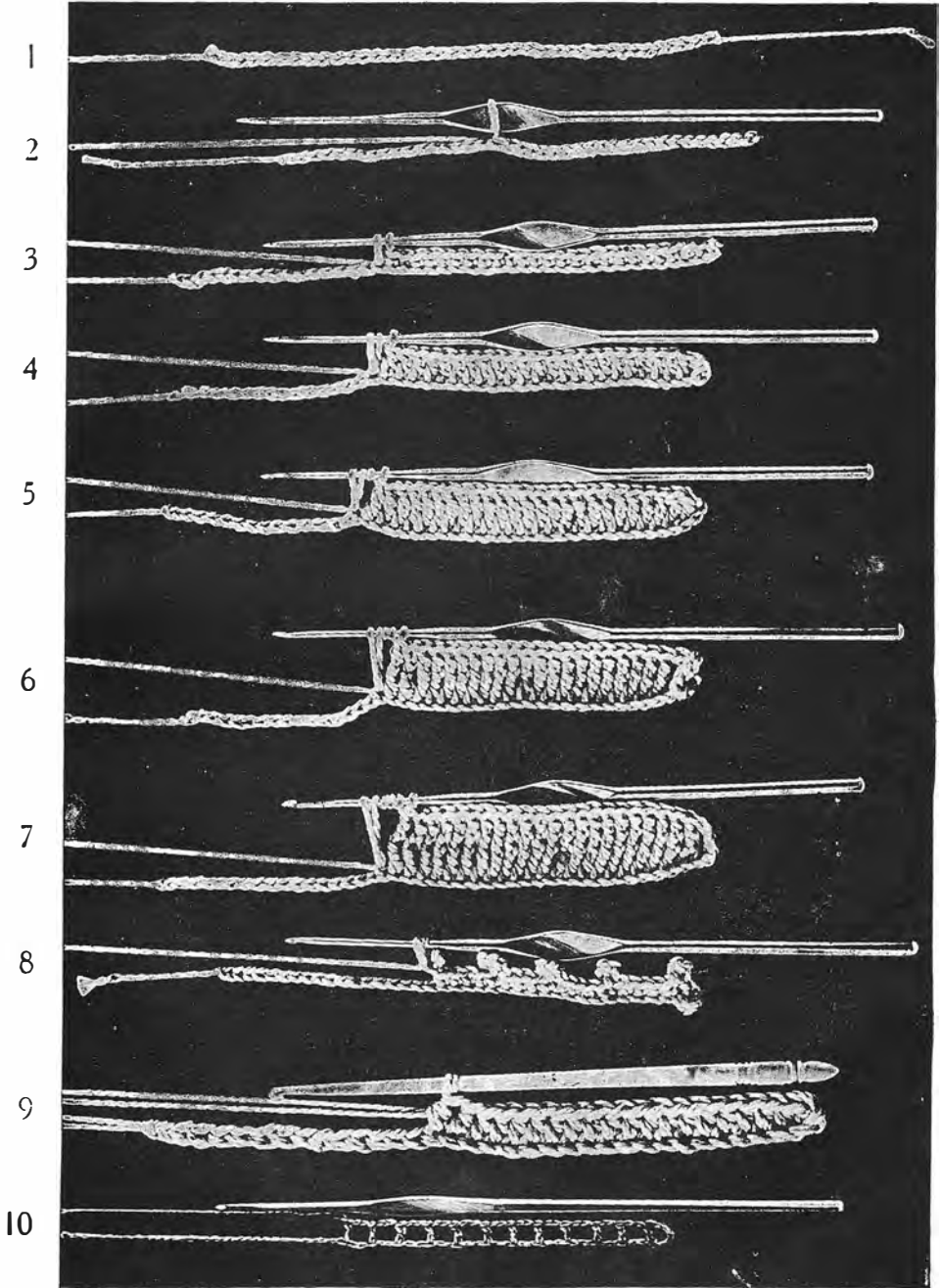

CROCHET STITCHES

ILLUSTRATED



HEAVY IRISH TEA COSEY No. 1036

Materials required: 3 balls ROYAL SOCIETY White Crochet Cotton, size 3; Crochet Hook No. 7

Wind cotton 16 times around cardboard 2 inches long; take it off; 64 s.c. around the 16 loops, join with sl.st. This forms a ring.

1st row—1 s.c. into each, taking up back rib.

2nd row—ch. 3, 2 d.c. into 2 following sts., 2 d.c. into next, repeat all around until 84 d.c. are made, taking up back rib; join with sl.st. Turn.

3rd row—ch. 7, 1 s.c. into 6th d.c., repeat 10 times. Turn.

4th row—8 s.c. into each of the 11 holes; 21 s.c. into following sts., take up back rib.

5th row—ch. 16, 1 s.c. into the last st. of first hole, 1 s.c. into 1st st. of 2nd hole; Repeat 10 times. 21 s.c. into the following sts.

6th row—24 s.c. into each hole; 33 s.c. into following sts.

7th row—ch. 3, form p., 5 s.c., one into each, 5 s.c. into 2nd scallop from the 8th s.c., 1 p., 5 s.c. into same scallop, repeat across, after last p. 1 s.c. into each st. until 1st p. is reached.

8th row—ch. 8, 8 s.c. between the 2 p. skipping first and last st; repeat 10 times, 1 s.c. into each st. up to first hole.

9th row—10 s.c. into hole, 6 s.c. one into each, skipping first and last st., repeat 10 times, 11 s.c. into each st. to end of row.

10th row—10 s.c. sk. 1, 2 s.c., 1 p., sk. 1., 10 s.c. sk. 1., 2 s.c., 1 p. Repeat around till solid bar. 1 s.c. into each until 2 sts. before p. are left.

11th row—ch. 8, 10 s.c. from 3rd st. of p., ch. 8. Repeat till solid bar, 1 s.c. into each until 1 st. before hole is left.

12th row—1 s.c. into hole, 8 s.c. sk. first and last st. Repeat till solid bar. 1 s.c. into each, until 4 sts. before hole are left.

13th row—1 p., 2 s.c., sk. 2. 11 s.c., sk. 2, 2 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c., sk. 2, 11 s.c. Repeat till bar, 1 s.c. into each until 2 sts. before p. are left.

14th row—ch. 8, 11 s.c. from 3rd st. after p. ch. 8 and repeat till bar. 1 s.c. into each until 1 st. of row is left.

15th row—12 s.c. into hole, 9 s.c., sk. first and last st., 12 s.c. into hole and repeat till bar. 1 s.c. into each.

16th row—3 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c., sk. 2. 5 s.c., sk. 2 and repeat till bar. 1 s.c. into each until 2 sts. before p. are left.

17th row—ch. 6, 1 s.c. into first p. ch. 6. 1 s.c. into 3rd p., ch. 6. 3 s.c. into 5 s.c., sk. first and last st. ch. 6 and repeat till bar. 1 s.c. into each.

18th row—8 s.c. into 1st hole, 8 s.c. into next, 4 s.c. into 3rd hole, turn; ch. 6, 1 s.c. into center of 1st scallop, ch. 6. 1 s.c. into center of next scallop, turn, 8 s.c. into 1st hole, 4 s.c. into next, turn, ch. 6, 1 s.c. into center of scallop, turn, 8 s.c. into hole, 4 s.c. into each unfinished scallop, 1 s.c. into center of the 3 s.c., repeat till bar. 1 s.c. into each.

19th row—4 s.c. 1 p., 4 s.c. 1 p., repeat till center of last scallop is reached, ch. 11, sk. 1, 5 s.c. 1 p., 5 s.c. Continue row till starting point is reached.

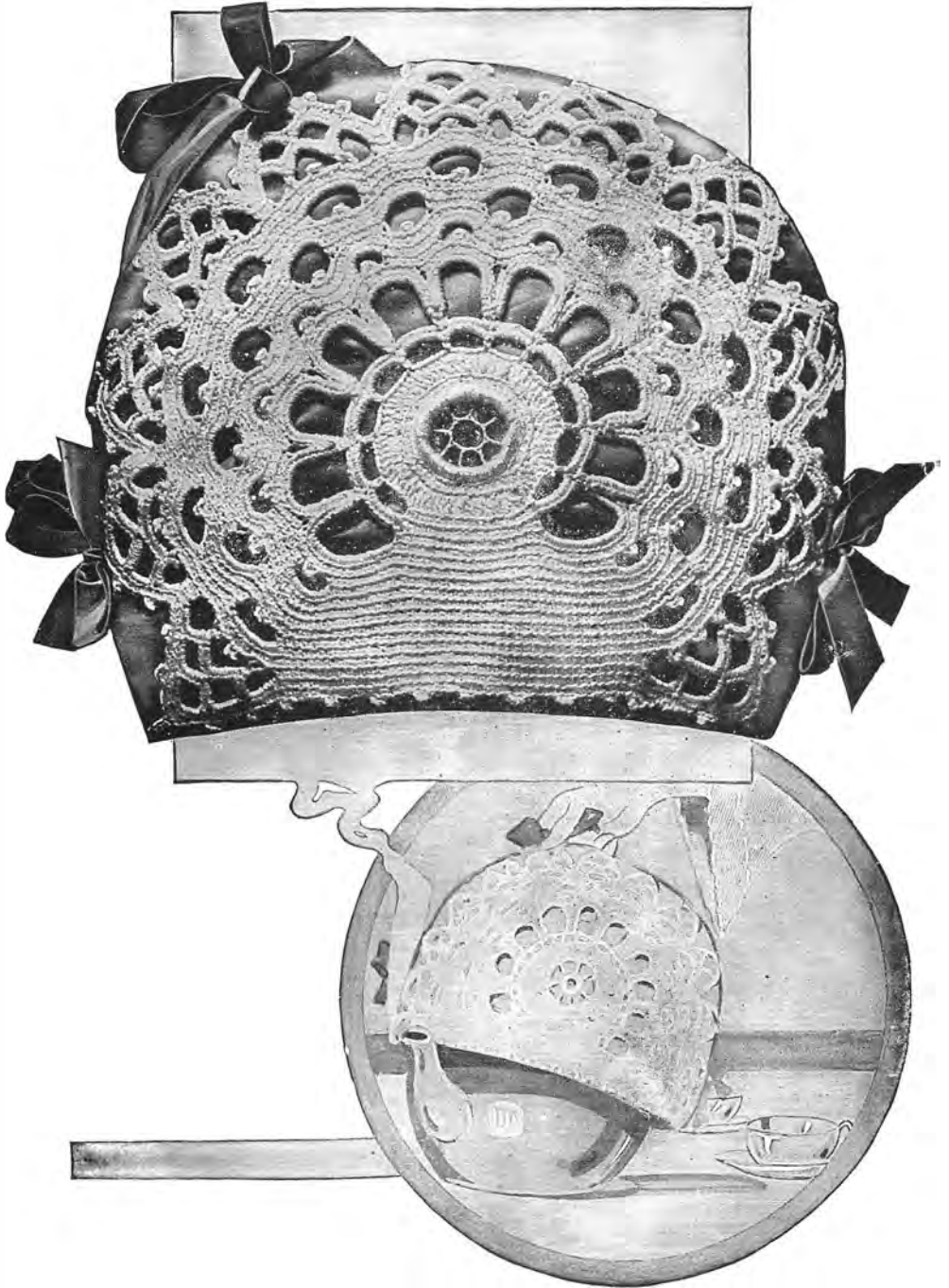
Into center hole make a lace stitch with the sewing needle. Start at the wrong side. Divide hole in 8 parts, make 1 button hole st. into each part, then draw thread again through each loop, pull hole together and finish off.

Make other side for Cosy the same way, join both sides by sewing the center picots of scallops together.

Line Cosy with white or colored satin, placing a heavy padding inside to retain heat.

CROCHET WITH EMBROIDERED ROSES.

Materials required: 1 ball ROYAL SOCIETY White Crochet Cotton, size 5; Crochet Hook No. 7

- 1st row**—ch. 5, join to ring, ch. 3, 15 d.c. into ring, join with sl.st.
2nd row—ch. 3, 2 d.c. into each st., until 30 d.c., join with sl.st.
3rd row—ch. 3, 2 d.c. into one st., 1 d.c. into next, continue around, join with sl.st.
4th row—ch. 3, 2 d.c. into one st., 2 d.c. into the next 2 sts., join with sl.st.
5th row—ch. 3, 2 d.c. into one st., 3 d.c. into the next 3 sts., join with sl.st.
6th row—ch. 3, 2 d.c. into one st., 9 d.c. into next 9 sts., join with sl.st.
7th row—ch. 3, 15 d.c. into 15 sts., 2 d.c. into one st. until 92 d.c. are made. Join with sl.st.
8th row—ch. 3, 11 d.c. into sts., ch. 2, sk. 1, 22 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 1, 22 d.c., continue around. Join with sl.st.
9th row—ch. 3, 10 d.c. into sts., ch. 2, 3 d.c. into hole, ch. 2, sk. 1, 20 d.c. ch. 2, 3 d.c. and repeat around. Join with sl.st.
10th row—ch. 3, 9 d.c. ch. 2, 3 d.c. into 1st hole, ch. 2, 3 d.c. into next hole, ch. 2, sk. 1, 18 d.c. Repeat around. Join with sl.st.
11th row—ch. 3, 8 d.c. into sts., ch. 2, 3 d.c. into 1st hole, ch. 2, 3 d.c. into next, ch. 2, 3 d.c. into 3rd hole, ch. 2, 16 d.c. Repeat around. Join with sl.st.
12th row—ch. 3, 7 d.c., ch. 2, 3 d.c. into hole. Repeat into each hole, 14 d.c. Continue around. Join with sl.st.
13th row—ch. 3, 6 d.c., ch. 2, 3 d.c. Repeat into each hole, 12 d.c. Continue around.
14th row—ch. 3, 5 d.c., ch. 2, 3 d.c. into holes. Repeat into each hole. 10 d.c.
15th row—ch. 3, 4 d.c., ch. 2, 3 d.c. into holes, 8 d.c.
16th row—ch. 3, 3 d.c., ch. 2, 3 d.c. into holes, 6 d.c.
17th row—ch. 3, 2 d.c., ch. 2, 3 d.c. into holes, 4 d.c.
18th row—ch. 3, 1 d.c., ch. 2, 3 d.c. into holes, 2 d.c.
19th row—ch. 1, 1 s.c. into d.c., 3 tr.c., finish together, ch. 5, form p. of 4 chs., 3 tr.c., finish together, ch. 5, p. 3 tr.c., finish together. All into 2nd hole. Ch. 1, sk. 1 hole and repeat the same into 4th hole. After 5 scallops are made, 2 s.c. into 2 d.c. Continue around. Join with sl.st. Finish off.
- To make extensions for bottom of basket, fold 6th and 7th row together, 2 d.c. between 1st, 1 d.c. between next st. Join with sl.st. one row of s.c. into each st.

HANDLE FOR BASKET.

Ch. 6, join to ring, 7 s.c. into ring. Continue until handle is 23 inches long, taking up back rib. Draw a thin wire through it and attach handle to the inside of basket near bottom.

Materials required for Embroidery:

1311 Pink Celesta, 2 skeins; 1313 Pink Celesta, 1 skein; 1331 Green Celesta, 1 skein

Make three roses on each solid triangle of basket. To make roses, follow instructions given for those on candle shade.

SMALL BON BON BASKET No. 1046

Materials required: ROYAL SOCIETY White Crochet Cotton, size 5—1 ball for 5 baskets

Ch. 4, join to ring, 7 s.c. into ring, 2 s.c. into each until 14 s.c. 2 s.c. into one, 1 s.c. into next until 21 s.c., 2 s.c. into one, 2 s.c. into next two st. until 28 s.c., 3 s.c. into the three following sts., 2 s.c. into the next st., repeat until 36 s.c., join with sl.st.

TOP OF BASKET.

- 1st row**—ch. 4, 1 d.c. into next s.c., skip 1, 1 d.c. into next, ch. 1, 1 d.c. into same, skip 1, 1 d.c., ch. 1, 1 d.c. into same. Repeat all around. Join into the 2nd ch. of ch. 4 at beginning.
2nd row—ch. 4, 1 d.c. into first space of ch. 1, ch. 1, 1 d.c. into same, 1 d.c. into next space, ch. 1, 1 d.c. into same. Repeat all around and join at beginning.
3rd, 4th, 5th row—the same as 2nd, but make between each d.c. ch. 1.
6th row—1 s.c. into first space, ch. 5, form picot, 1 s.c. into next space. Repeat all around.
- To make extension of bottom of basket, 3 d.c. through last row of s.c. and spaces of first row of top of basket.

HANDLE FOR BASKET.

Ch. 3, join to ring, 3 s.c. into ring, 1 s.c. into each st., continue until 7 inches are made, by crocheting handle always catch the back rib only. Pull some very fine wire through handle and attach handle to the inside of basket.

For raised rose, follow instructions for those on candle shade.

Materials required for Embroidery (sufficient for 5 Baskets):

1311 Pink Celesta, 1313 Pink Celesta, 1331 Green Celesta—1 skein of each

FOR STIFFENING BASKETS.

Dissolve 2 ozs. of clear white sheet gelatine (which may be obtained at any drug store) in 1 pint of hot water.

Strain the solution through a white cloth before using and keep as hot as possible without boiling.

Immerse basket in hot solution and squeeze out all superfluous ^{5 in.} moisture with a clean white cloth. Keep cloth in the hand while shaping basket. Have ^{5 in.} dy some circles of cardboard (1½-inch for small basket and 3¼-inch for large basket). Before setting away to dry, place the cardboard in bottom of basket. This helps to shape it. Avoid handling more than is necessary and set away on a clean plate to dry.

FILET CROCHET SCARF No. 1040

Materials required: 6 balls ROYAL SOCIETY White Crochet Cotton, size 8; Crochet Hook No. 11

- 1st row—ch. 65, 1 d.c. into the 6th ch., ch. 2, 1 d.c. into the 7th ch., continue until 20 m. are made. Turn.
- 2nd row—Ch. 5, 1 d.c. into the 2nd sp., 2 more m., 4 d.c. into next sts., 16 m. Turn.
- 3rd row—5 m., 16 d.c., 6 m., 4 d.c., 3 m. Turn.
- 4th row—3 m., 7 d.c., 2 m., 28 d.c., 4 m. Turn.
- 5th row—4 m., 31 d.c., 1 m., 4 d.c., 4 m. Turn.
- 6th row—4 m., 4 d.c., 1 m., 28 d.c., 5 m. Turn.
- 7th row—3 m., 7 d.c., 5 m., 10 d.c., 1 m., 4 d.c., 5 m. Turn.
- 8th row—3 m., 16 d.c., 2 m., 16 d.c., 1 m., 7 d.c., 2 m. Turn.
- 9th row—2 m., 4 d.c., 1 m., 25 d.c., 1 m., 16 d.c., 2 m. Turn.
- 10th row—2 m., 13 d.c., 1 m., 28 d.c., 1 m., 4 d.c., 2 m. Turn.
- 11th row—2 m., 4 d.c., 1 m., 4 d.c., 6 m., 10 d.c., 1 m., 10 d.c., 2 m. Turn.
- 12th row—2 m., 10 d.c., 1 m., 10 d.c., 5 m., 4 d.c., 1 m., 4 d.c., 3 m. Turn.
- 13th row—3 m., 4 d.c., 1 m., 4 d.c., 1 m., 4 d.c., 3 m., 10 d.c., 1 m., 10 d.c., 2 m. Turn.
- 14th row—3 m., 7 d.c., 1 m., 10 d.c., 1 m., 4 d.c., 1 m., 7 d.c., 2 m., 4 d.c., 3 m. Turn.
- 15th row—3 m., 7 d.c., 1 m., 13 d.c., 1 m., 7 d.c., 1 m., 4 d.c., 5 m. Turn.
- 16th row—5 m., 7 d.c., 1 m., 7 d.c., 4 m., 7 d.c., 4 m. Turn.
- 17th row—5 m., 19 d.c., 1 m., 10 d.c., 5 m. Turn.
- 18th row—6 m., 13 d.c., 10 m. Turn.
- 19th row—20 m. Turn.
- 20th row—20 m.

1 row of d.c. all around (1 into each st. and 3 into corner st.). Make one other medallion the same way.

EDGE.

- 1st row—ch. 18, 1 d.c. into the 7th st., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c. Make 2 more m. 2 d.c. at straight end. Turn.
- 2nd row—(*), ch. 3, 6 d.c., 3 m., ch. 5, 1 d.c. into same. Turn, 3 sl.st. into ch. 5.
- 3rd row—ch. 7, 1 d.c. into last sl.st., 3 m., 9 d.c. Turn.
- 4th row—ch. 3, 15 d.c., 2 m., ch. 5, 1 d.c. into same. Turn, sl.st. into each ch. until spoke.
- 5th row—ch. 5, sk. 2, 1 d.c., 3 m., 9 d.c. Turn.
- 6th row—ch. 3, 6 d.c., 4 m. Turn.
- 7th row—3 sl.sts. till spoke, ch. 5, sk. 2, 1 d.c., 3 m., 2 d.c. Turn.
- 8th row—ch. 3, 2 d.c., 2 m., 4 d.c., 1 m. Turn.
- 9th row—4 m., 2 d.c. Turn, repeat from (*) for 18 inches and begin corner.
- 1st row—ch. 3, 6 d.c., 3 m., ch. 5, 1 d.c. into same. Turn, 3 sl.sts.
- 2nd row—ch. 7, 1 d.c. into the last sl.st., 3 m., 7 d.c. Turn.
- 3rd row—ch. 3, 7 d.c., 2 m., 4 d.c., 1 m., ch. 5, 1 d.c. into same. Turn, 5 sl.sts. into ch. 5.
- 4th row—ch. 5, 4 m., 7 d.c. Turn.
- 5th row—ch. 5, 2 m., 4 d.c., 2 m. Turn.
- 6th row—3 sl.st. till sp., ch. 5, 4 m. Turn.
- 7th row—ch. 3, 4 d.c., 2 m. Turn.
- 8th row—3 sl.sts. till sp., ch. 5, 2 m. Turn.
- 9th row—ch. 5, 1 m. Turn.
- 10th row—sl.sts. until sp., ch. 5, 4 m., 7 d.c. This row is worked across the last 9 rows, join with 2 d.c. to first 2 d.c. of 1st row of corner. Turn.
- 11th row—ch. 3, 6 d.c., 4 m. Turn.
- 12th row—3 sl.sts., ch. 5, 4 m., 2 d.c. Turn.
- 13th row—ch. 3, 2 d.c., 2 m., 4 d.c., 1 m. Turn and repeat from the very beginning for 40 inches. Repeat corner. This finishes one half for scarf.
- After whole edge is complete, make 1 row of s.c. (Into the 3 holes between the 2 scallops 2 s.c. into each. Into the 2 next holes, 5 s.c. into each, into the point 8 s.c.)

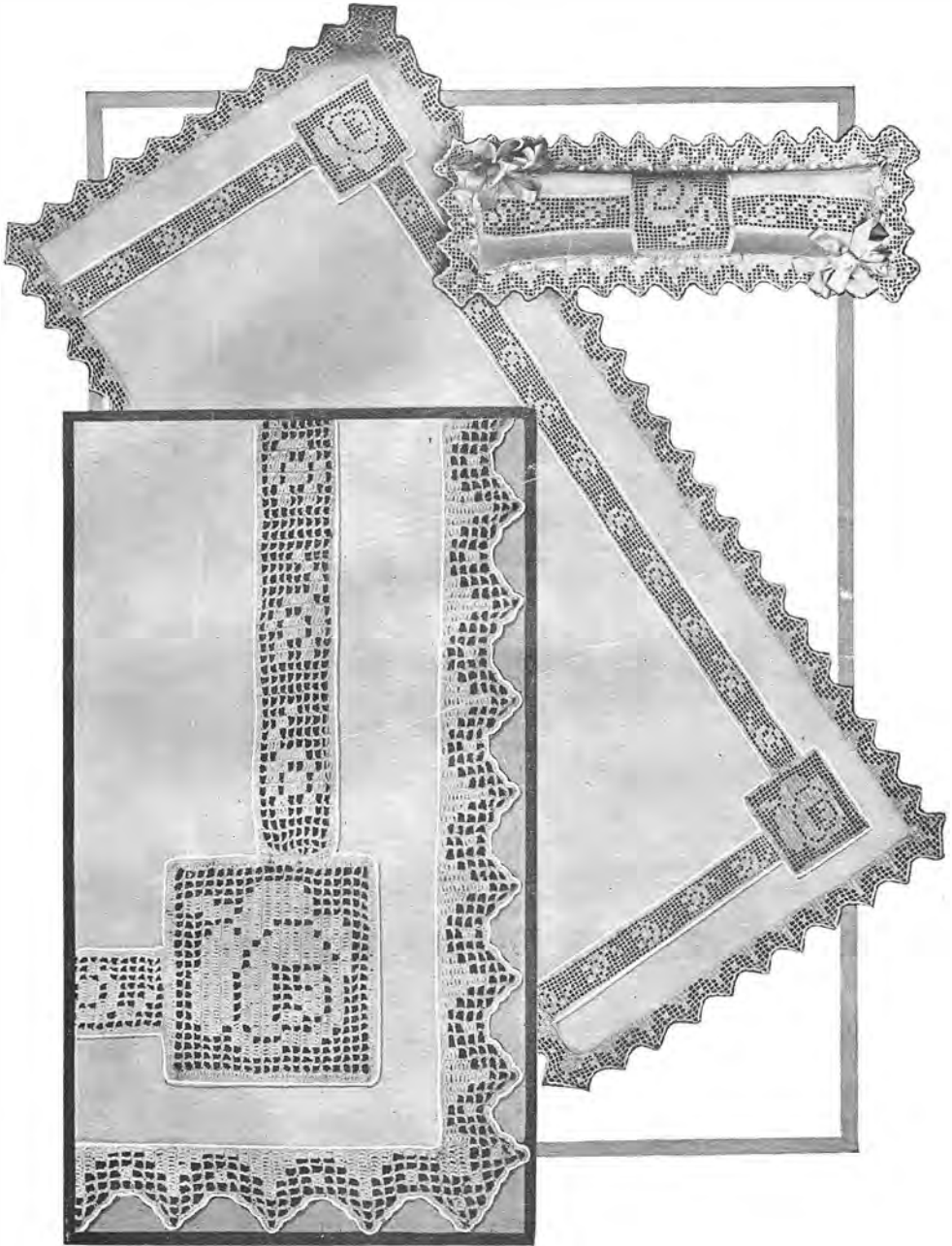
INSERTION.

- 1st row—ch. 29, sk. 3, 2 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., continue until 8 m. are made. Finish row with 3 d.c. Turn.
- 2nd row—ch. 3, 2 d.c., 8 m., always finish and begin row with 3 d.c. Turn.
- 3rd row—3 m., 4 d.c., 4 m. Turn.
- 4th row—5 m., 4 d.c., 2 m. Turn.
- 5th row—1 m., 4 d.c., 6 m. Turn.
- 6th row—6 m., 4 d.c., 1 m. Turn.
- 7th row—2 m., 10 d.c., 3 m. Turn.
- 8th row—2 m., 4 d.c., 2 m., 7 d.c., 1 m. Turn.
- 9th row—1 m., 4 d.c., 1 m., 7 d.c., 1 m., 4 d.c., 1 m. Turn.
- 10th row—3 m., 7 d.c., 1 m., 4 d.c., 1 m. Turn.
- 11th row—2 m., 4 d.c., 2 m., 4 d.c., 2 m. Turn.
- 12th row—2 m., 4 d.c., 2 m., 4 d.c., 2 m. Turn. Make 4 rows each of 8 m.
- 17th row—4 m., 4 d.c., 3 m. Turn.
- 18th row—2 m., 4 d.c., 5 m. Turn.
- 19th row—6 m., 4 d.c., 1 m. Turn.
- 20th row—1 m., 4 d.c., 6 m. Turn.
- 21st row—3 m., 10 d.c., 2 m. Turn.
- 22nd row—1 m., 7 d.c., 2 m., 4 d.c., 2 m. Turn.
- 23rd row—1 m., 4 d.c., 1 m., 7 d.c., 1 m., 4 d.c., 1 m. Turn.
- 24th row—1 m., 4 d.c., 1 m., 7 d.c., 3 m. Turn.
- 25th row—2 m., 4 d.c., 2 m., 4 d.c., 2 m. Turn.
- 26th row—2 m., 4 d.c., 2 m., 4 d.c., 2 m. Turn. Make 4 rows each of 8 m. and repeat from beginning for 31 inches, 2 more pieces each of 13 inches.

Place medallion in corner about $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches from edge, with center of rose pointing to corner. Join insertion to center of medallion.

ARABIAN CROCHET COLLAR No. 1042

Materials required: 1 ball ROYAL SOCIETY Tan Crochet 1010, size 5; Crochet Hook No. 7

MEDALLION.

Ch. 9, join to ring, 2 s.c., ch. 3, 2 s.c., ch. 3, 2 s.c. and continue until 8 loops in the ring are made. Join with sl.st.

Ch. 10, 1 tr.c. between the 2 first loops, ch. 5, 1 tr.c. between the following 2 loops, repeat around and join the 5 last chs. to the 4th ch. at beginning.

7 s.c. into each hole, 1 s.c. into each sp., join with sl.st. Ch. 1, 1 s.c., ch. 10, sk. 1, 1 s.c., 1 h.d.c., 1 d.c., 6 tr.c., sk. 4 s.c. of previous row, 3 s.c., ch. 10, and repeat for 7 more petals, 1 s.c. into first petal. 4 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c., 1 p. on point of petal, 3 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c., 1 p., 4 s.c. between leaves, 3 s.c., take up back rib, repeat the same all around, join with sl.st. This finishes 1 medallion.

Make 3 more medallions the same way, which join with picot on points of petals as shown in cut.

Make 2 leaves for front, ch. 10, sk. 1, 1 s.c., 1 h.d.c., 1 d.c., 6 tr.c., ch. 10, repeat for other leaf, ch. 3, 1 s.c. between leaves. ch. 3, 1 s.c. into beginning of 1st leaf, 4 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c., 1 p. on point, 3 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c., 1 p., 4 s.c., repeat the same on 2nd leaf, but join point to medallion. Finish off.

SPIDERS.

Ch. 10, join to ring, 4 s.c. into ring, ch. 6, 1 s.c. into p. nearest to the point of the 1st of 2 leaves, 8 s.c. around ch. 6, 16 s.c. into ring, join with sl.st.

Make another spider the same way, after ch. 6, join to same leaf on other side to p. nearest to point, 8 s.c. around ch. 6, 4 s.c. into ring, ch. 6, join to 2nd leaf, into p. nearest to point, 8 s.c. around ch. 6, 1 s.c. into ring, ch. 6, join to 1st p. of joined petal of medallion, the same way as described, 4 s.c. into ring, join to p. nearest to point of other petal of medallion, 3 s.c. into ring, join with sl.st. Finish off.

Make another spider for corner of collar:

4 s.c. into ring, join to p. nearest to point at other side of 3rd petal, 4 s.c. into ring, join to p. of 4th petal, 12 s.c. into ring. Finish off. Make another spider, 4 s.c. into ring, join to other side of 5th petal, 4 s.c. into ring, join to 6th petal, 1 s.c. into ring, and join with p. of petal of 2nd medallion, 4 s.c. into ring, join to p. of 2nd petal, 8 s.c. into ring. Finish off.

Center Spider:

Join to p. at other side of 4th petal of 2nd medallion, 4 s.c. into ring, join to 5th petal, 1 s.c. into ring, and join to petal of 3rd medallion, 4 s.c. into ring, join to 2nd petal of 3rd medallion, 8 s.c. into ring. Finish off. Make outside spiders for other half of collar the same way.

Inside Spiders:

4 s.c. into ring, join to the 8th petal of 1st medallion, 4 s.c. into ring, join into 7th petal of same medallion, 1 s.c. into ring, join to 8th petal of 2nd medallion, 4 s.c. into ring, join to 2nd petal of 2nd medallion, 8 s.c. into ring. Finish off.

Make 2 more spiders the same way for inside of collar.

Begin with s.c. at center st. of center spider of inside of collar, ch. 9, 1 s.c. into point of petal, ch. 9, 1 s.c. into center of spider ring, ch. 12, join to point of petal at other medallion, 4 s.c. around ch., ch. 12, join to p. next to point into next petal, 8 s.c. around ch., ch. 5, join to p. next to bottom of leaf, 6 s.c. around ch., ch. 10, join to bottom of same leaf, 5 s.c. around ch., ch. 10, join into center between the 2 leaves, 5 s.c. around ch., ch. 10, join to bottom of other leaf, 5 s.c. around ch., ch. 12, join to p., 8 s.c. around ch., ch. 6, join to st. next to radius of spider at end of collar, 8 s.c. around ch., (*), ch. 12, join to 5th st. of ring, 8 s.c. around ch., ch. 12, join to next st. and repeat from (*) twice more, ch. 12, and join to st. next to 1st radius. Always make 8 s.c. around each radius. Ch. 12, join to point of 1st leaf, ch. 6, join to st. next to radius, ch. 12, join to 5th st. of ring, ch. 6, join to point of petal, ch. 12, join to next p. of same petal, ch. 6, join to p. next to point of next petal, ch. 12, join to point of same petal, ch. 6, join to st. to next radius, ch. 12, join to 5th st., ch. 14, join to 4th st., ch. 12, join into 5th st., ch. 16, join into point of petal, ch. 12, join to next p. of same petal, ch. 6, join into p. next to point of 2nd petal, ch. 12, join into point of same petal, ch. 6, join to st. next to radius, ch. 12, join to 5th st., ch. 12, join to 5th st., ch. 6, join to point of petal, ch. 12, join to next p. of same petal, ch. 6, join to p. next to point of other petal, ch. 10, join into point of same petal, but only 5 s.c. around ch. instead of 8, ch. 12, join to p. next to point, ch. 6, join to p. next to point of other petal, ch. 12, join to point of same petal, ch. 6, join to st. next to radius. Ch. 12, join to 5th st., ch. 12, join to next 5th st. This finishes half of collar. Continue for other side the same way.

Continue making 10 s.c. into each of the first 4 holes, into the 5 following holes 7 s.c. Into 3 next holes 8 s.c., into next hole, which is the corner hole, 16 s.c. Into each hole of 3 sides 8 s.c., but in point of corner 16 s.c. Finish other half of inside of collar the same way. Join with sl.st., 1 s.c. into each, taking up back rib, till hole of 8 s.c. is reached. Ch. 6, 1 s.c. into 6th st., ch. 6, sk. 1, 1 s.c., 1 h.d.c., 3 d.c., 1 s.c. into 3rd following s.c., ch. 6, 1 s.c. into 6th st., repeat from (*) all around. At end of row join with sl.st., make sl.sts. until 1st loop, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into loop, ch. 3, 1 s.c. into point of petal, 1 p., 1 s.c., 1 p., 1 s.c., 1 p., 1 s.c. all into the same stitch, ch. 3, 1 s.c. into loop, ch. 3, continue all around.

Materials required: 8 balls ROYAL SOCIETY White Crochet Cotton, size 3; Crochet Hook No. 5

Ch. 10, sk. 1, 1 s.c., 1 h.d.c., 5 d.c., 1 d.c., 1 s.c., repeat this 3 times more and close with sl.st. Around each petal, 1 s.c. into each st. in corner sts., 3 s.c.

1st row—ch. 14, 1 s.c. into the point of next petal, ch. 7, 1 d.t.r.c. between the petals, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into point of following petal and repeat around, join the last ch. 7 to 7th ch. at beginning.

2nd row—8 s.c. into each hole, 3 s.c. into each corner.

3rd row—at each side of square 10 holes of ch. 1, 1 d.c. Into the corner sts. 1 d.c., ch. 3, 1 d.c. Finish row with corner hole.

4th row—2 s.c. into each of 8 following holes, turn, ch. 6, 1 s.c. into the 6th following st., ch. 6, 1 s.c. into the next 6th st., turn, 9 s.c. into the 1st hole, 5 s.c. into the 2nd hole, turn, ch. 6, 1 s.c. into the center of scallop, turn, 10 s.c. into the hole, 5 s.c. into the half finished scallop, 2 s.c. into each of the following holes, 5 s.c. into the corner hole. Repeat this 3 times.

5th row—turn, 3 sl.sts. till the center st. of corner, turn, ch. 8, 1 d.c. into the center of 1st scallop, ch. 8, 1 d.c. into the 5th st. of center scallop, ch. 3, 1 d.c. into the 2nd following st., ch. 8, 1 d.c. into the center of 3rd scallop, ch. 8, 1 s.c. into the corner of square. Repeat this 3 times.

6th row—8 s.c. into each hole of ch. 8, 5 s.c. into each hole of ch. 3.

7th and 8th rows—1 s.c. into each st., 3 s.c. into each corner st.

9th row—5 s.c. into the following sts. (**). Turn, ch. 1, 1 tr.c. into the 5th st., ch. 1, 1 tr.c. into the same, repeat this until 7 tr.c. are made. Ch. 1, 2 s.c., into the 4th and 5th st., turn, 2 s.c. into each hole, 5 s.c. into the following sts., turn, ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into the 1st st. on top of holes, (*), 1 tr.c. into the 4th st., ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into the same. Repeat three times from (*). Ch. 5, 2 s.c. into the 5th and 6th sts. of square. Turn, 7 s.c. into the hole, turn, 6 s.c., sk. 1st, turn, 5 s.c., turn, 4 s.c., decreasing until 1 s.c. is left, 7 sl.st. down side of triangle. Make 4 more triangles the same way, then continue with s.c. until corner of square, turn, ch. 9, 1 s.c. into point of 1st triangle, ch. 9, and repeat till next corner, 1 s.c. into corner, turn, 12 s.c. into each hole, 26 s.c. into the following sts., and repeat from (**).

10th row—6 s.c. into the following sts., (*), ch. 13, 1 s.c. into center of 1st hole, ch. 13, 1 s.c. into center of following hole, ch. 7, 1 tr.c. on top of triangle, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into center of next hole. Ch. 13, 1 s.c., ch. 13, 13 s.c. into the following sts. and repeat from (*) all around.

11th row—turn, sk. 2, 11 s.c., turn, sk. 2, 9 s.c., diminish until 2 s.c. are left 7 sl.sts. down side of triangle, and 17 s.c. into each hole of ch. 13. Into corner hole of ch. 7, 8 s.c., 1 s.c. into sp.

12th row—7 sl.sts. up the side of triangle, 2 s.c. into the point, (*), ch. 7, 3 s.c. into the scallop from the 9th st., ch. 9, 3 s.c. into the following scallops from the 8th st., ch. 9, 1 tr.c. into the center st. of corner, ch. 5, 1 d.t.r.tr.c., ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into the same, ch. 9, 3 s.c. into the following scallop from the 8th st., ch. 9, 3 s.c. into the next scallop from the 7th st., ch. 7, 2 s.c. into the triangle and repeat from (*) all around.

13th row—2 s.c. into sts., 9 s.c. into hole, 3 s.c. into sts., 9 s.c. into hole, 3 s.c. into sts., 9 s.c. into hole, 1 s.c. into sp., 6 s.c. into hole, 3 s.c. into corner sp. and repeat all around. Join with sl.st.

14th row—ch. 5, sk. 1, 1 d.c., ch. 1, sk. 1, 1 d.c., continue till corner for 21 holes, ch. 3, 1 d.c. into same in corner, 42 holes till next corner. Continue around, join with sl.st.

15th row—2 s.c. into each hole. Into each corner hole, 5 s.c. Join with sl.st.

16th row—(**), 5 s.c. into next sts., turn, ch. 1, 1 tr.c. into the 5th st., ch. 1, 1 tr.c. into same. Repeat this until 7 tr.c. are made. Ch. 1, 2 s.c. into 4th and 5th sts. Turn, 2 s.c. into each hole, 5 s.c. into next sts. Turn, ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into 5th st., (*), 1 tr.c. into 4th st., ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into same. Repeat from (*) 3 times, ch. 5, 2 s.c. into the 5th and 6th st. of square, turn, 7 s.c. into each of 5 holes, 7 s.c. into square, turn, ch. 7, 1 d.t.r.c. into 7th st., 1 d.t.r.c. into the 5th st. of circle, ch. 7, 1 d.t.r.c. into same, 1 d.t.r.c. into next 5th st., ch. 7, 1 d.t.r.c. into same, 1 d.t.r.c. into 5th st., ch. 7, 1 d.t.r.c. into same, 1 d.t.r.c. into 3rd st. Ch. 7, 1 d.t.r.c. into same. This is the center hole of circle. Finish side. At end, 2 s.c. into 6th and 7th st. of square, turn, 9 s.c. into each hole, 4 s.c. into 4 sts. of square, turn, ch. 2, sk. 3 sts. of circle, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., continue across for 27 holes, 3 s.c. into 3rd, 4th and 5th sts. of square. Turn, ch. 2, 1 d.c. into 2nd hole, ch. 2 and repeat across. 2 s.c. into 3rd and 4th sts. of square. Turn, 3 s.c. into each hole, for 81 s.c., 2 s.c. into next sts. of square. Turn, (*), 9 s.c. into circle. Turn, sk. 1, 8 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 7 s.c., turn and continue diminishing until 1 s.c. is left. 9 sl.sts. down side of triangle, 9 s.c. into next sts. Turn, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into 5th st., ch. 7, 1 s.c. into last st., turn, 13 s.c. into hole, 6 s.c. into next hole, turn, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into 6th st. of 1st scallop, turn, 13 s.c. into hole, 7 s.c. into unfinished hole. Repeat from (*) for 4 more triangles. 14 s.c. into square, turn, ch. 13, 1 s.c. into point of triangle, ch. 13, 1 s.c. into center of scallop and repeat around circle. After last ch. 13, 1 s.c. into 14th st. of square. Turn, 15 s.c. into each hole. 4 s.c. until corner, 3 s.c. into corner st., continue across with 44 s.c. or till center st. of square. Repeat from (**), at beginning of 16th row for 3 times more, up till last corner.

17th row—ch. 8, (*), 1 s.c. into center st. of loop, ch. 15, 1 s.c. into center of next loop, ch. 15, and continue until 4 loops of ch. 15 are made. Ch. 8, 1 d.t.r.c. into st. above point of center triangle, ch. 8, 1 s.c. into center st. of next loop, 4 more loops of ch. 15, ch. 8, 1 s.c. into corner of square, ch. 8 and repeat from (*) all around.

18th row—9 s.c. into 1st hole, turn, sk. 2, 7 s.c., 9 s.c. into next hole, turn, sk. 2, (*), 14 s.c., turn, sk. 2, 12 s.c., continue diminishing 2 sts. at each row until 2 s.c. are left. 9 sl.sts. down side of triangle, 17 s.c. into each of next 4 loops, 9 s.c. into next loop, 1 s.c. into sp. Continue reversing till end of circle. 9 s.c. into last hole of 1st circle, 9 s.c. into last hole of 1st circle, turn, sk. 2, 16 s.c., turn, sk. 2 and repeat from (*).

19th row—(*), 2 s.c. into point of triangle, ch. 10, 3 s.c. from the 9th st. of loop, ch. 10, 3 s.c. from 9th st. of next loop, and repeat for 2 more loops. Ch. 10, 1 d.t.r.c. into st. above sp., ch. 5, 1 d.t.r.tr.c. into same st., ch. 5, 1 d.t.r.c. into same, ch. 10, 3 s.c. from the 8th st. of next loop, ch. 10, and repeat for 4 more loops, then repeat from (*).

20th row—2 s.c. into the triangle, 10 s.c. into hole, 3 s.c. into next 3 sts., 10 s.c. into hole. Repeat till corner. Into corner, 1 s.c. into sp., 5 s.c. into hole, 3 s.c. into corner sp., 5 s.c. into next hole. Continue across.

BABY IRISH CROCHET CAP No. 1038

Materials required: 1 ball ROYAL SOCIETY White Crochet Cotton, size 8; Crochet Hook No. 11

Ch. 6, join to ring, (*), 1 s.c., ch. 4, 5 tr.c., ch. 4, 1 s.c., ch. 4, 5 tr.c., ch 4, 1 s.c. into ring. Ch. 7, form p., skipping the first 2 chs., ch. 6, form p., sk. 1 ch., ch. 6, form p., sk. 1, ch. 8, sk. 2, join 6 to ring. Repeat from (*) 10 times.

(*) Into the 11th ring make two more petals, 1 s.c. into ch. next to ring, ch. 6, sk. 1, form p., make 2 more p., ch. 1, 1 s.c. into last ch. before next ring. Repeat from (*) across row.

Ch. 5, 1 s.c. into the 3rd tr.c. of next petal, * ch. 12, 1 s.c. into center of next petal. Turn, 20 s.c. into hole, join with sl.st. to s.c. Turn, 4 s.c., ch. 5, 1 p., 4 s.c., 1 p., 4 s.c., 1 p., 4 s.c., 1 p., 4 s.c., 1 sl.st. Ch. 6, sk. 1 ch., 1 p., ch. 1, 1 s.c. into center of p. of previous row, ch. 6, 1 p., ch. 1, 1 s.c. into center of next petal. Repeat from (*) across row. Ch. 5, 1 s.c. into center of next petal.

(*) Ch. 5, 1 s.c. into same, ch. 9, 1 s.c. into center of next petal, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into same, 2 tr.c. in center p. which finish together. Ch. 5, 2 tr.c. the same way into same st., 1 s.c. into center of next petal. Repeat from (*) across row. Turn, ch. 9, 1 s.c. into center of ch. 9 of previous row, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into same, ch. 9, 1 s.c. into center of ch. 5, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into same. Repeat from (*). Finish row by making ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into st. behind p. of previous row. Turn, ch. 9.

(*) 1 s.c. into center of next ch. 9, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into same, ch. 9 and repeat from (*).

Make 3 more rows the same as the last one. Turn, ch. 8, 1 s.c. into center of ch. 9, continue across. Finish off.

Back Piece.—1 s.c. into center of ch. 8 of 11th hole, ch. 10, join 6 to a ring, and repeat for 4 flowers the same as the first two rows. Ch. 5, 1 s.c. into center of next ch. 8 of long strip. Turn, ch. 2, 1 s.c. into center of 1st petal, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into same, ch. 9, 1 s.c. into center of next petal, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into same, 2 tr.c. into center p., ch. 5, 2 tr.c. into same p. made as described before. Repeat this 3 times more. Into last petal, 1 s.c., ch. 9, 1 s.c. into next petal. Continue as before.

Ch. 2, 1 s.c. into center of next ch. 8 of long piece. Turn, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into center of ch. 9, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into same ch. 9, 1 s.c. into center of ch. 5, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into same. Repeat this around the strip, but omit p. at bottom. In connecting with long strip, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into center of following ch. 8. Turn, ch. 9, 1 s.c. into center of ch. 9, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into same and repeat all around strip, but at bottom make into each of the two holes, 5 s.c. To connect with long strip, 1 s.c. into center of next ch. 8. Turn, ch. 4, 1 s.c. into center of next ch. 9, ch. 8, 1 s.c. into center of next ch. 9, and repeat all around, at bottom 10 s.c. In connecting with long strip, ch. 4, 1 s.c. into same st. of previous row. Finish off.

Connect thread with last scallop, and continue for narrow row, 5 s.c. into 1st hole, ch. 5, 1 p., 5 s.c. into same, 1 p., 5 s.c. into next hole, 1 p., 5 s.c. into same. Repeat this all around. Into the holes which connect long and short strip, 5 s.c. only and without p. at end join with sl.st. to scallop. Turn, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into 1st p., ch. 4, 1 d.c. into next p., ch. 4 and repeat around into each p. At end ch. 5, 1 sl.st. into st. next to scallop. Turn, 5 s.c. into hole, 1 p., 5 s.c. into next hole. Repeat all around. Finish off.

The addition of a little lace and pink or blue silk lining beautifies the finished article.

21st row.—1 s.c. into each st. until 1st corner, 3 s.c. into corner st., 1 s.c. into each across other side, till next corner. (**). Turn, make 3 more rows of s.c. across one side only, turn. (*) This is for medallion. 7 s.c., ch. 9, sk. 1, 6 s.c., 2 rows of s.c. all around foundation ch. and 3 s.c. into corner st., 3 s.c. 1 p. of ch. 3, 3 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c. until center. Repeat on other side. At end of 1 sl.st., 1 s.c. into the same with last s.c. of foundation, 12 s.c. and repeat from (*) for 10 more medallions. Turn, ch. 17, 1 s.c. into point of medallion. Wind thread 7 times around needle, insert hook into the 6th s.c., work loops off 2 at a time. Ch. 6, 1 s.c. into point of next medallion and repeat across. After last medallion, ch. 17, 1 s.c. into last st. of side. Turn, 17 s.c. into first hole, 1 s.c. in sp., 6 s.c. into next hole, 1 s.c. into sp., continue across. Into last hole, 17 s.c., 5 s.c. till next loop, 1 s.c. into each until 4th corner is reached. Repeat from (**).

When this row is finished make 2 more rows with 1 s.c. into each st. and 3 s.c. into each corner around Afghan. Join with sl.st.

24th row—ch. 5, sk. 2 sts., 1 d.c. ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d. c. Continue all around. Into corner ch. 3, 1 d.c. into same. Make 2 more rows the same, join with sl.st.

27th row—3 s.c. into each hole, 5 s.c. into corner hole.

28th row—1 s.c. into each st. Into corner 3 s.c. Join with sl.st.

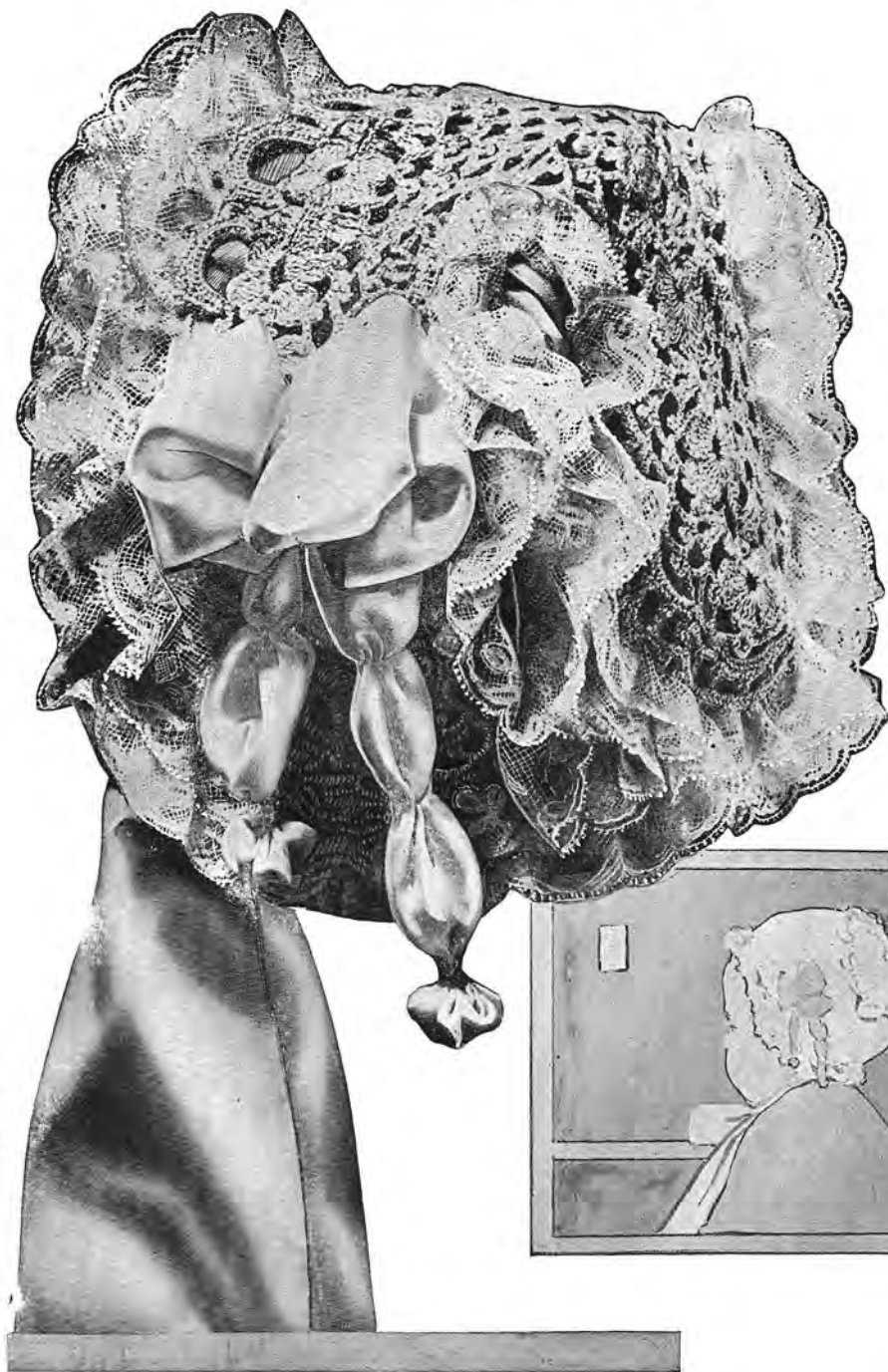
29th row—ch. 20, sk. 7, 2 s.c., ch. 20, continue until corner, ch. 20, 2 s.c. into next 2 sts., ch. 20, and repeat all around.

30th row—27 s.c. into each hole.

31st row—9 sl.sts. into s.c. of 1st loop, (*), 2 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c., sk. 9 s.c. of 2nd loop, and repeat from (*) all around.

Materials required: 4 balls ROYAL SOCIETY White Crochet Cotton, size 8; Crochet Hook No. 11

Ch. 7, sk. 1, 6 s.c. 2 rows of s.c. all around, 3 s.c. into each corner, 1 sl.st., ch. 14. Turn, 1 s.c. into next st. Turn, 4 s.c., 1 p., 4 s.c. into hole, ch. 9. Turn, 1 s.c. into next st. Turn, 4 s.c., 1 p., 4 s.c. into hole, ch. 9. Turn, sk. 1, 1 s.c. Turn, 4 s.c., 1 p., 4 s.c. into hole, ch. 9 and repeat until 11 bars are made. Ch. 9, 1 s.c. into st. with ch. 14, 4 s.c., 1 p., 4 s.c. around both chs.

(*) 7 s.c. into each of 4 following holes, 8 s.c. into next 2 holes, repeat from (*). Join with sl.st. to 1st s.c. of row.

(*) Ch. 5, sk. 2 sts., 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2 and repeat until 9 holes are made. Ch. 2, sk. 1, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 1 and repeat for 9 holes. Then repeat from (*), join with sl.st. into 3rd ch. of ch. 5. 3 s.c. into each hole, join with sl.st. Turn, 12 sl.sts. till corner. Turn, then make 3 leaves. Turn, ch. 10, sk. 1, 1 s.c., 1 h.d.c., 5 d.c., 1 h.d.c., 1 s.c. into ch. 10. Turn, repeat this up to point. Turn, 9 sl.st., 1 s.c. around the leaf.

Make 2 more leaves the same way. 1 s.c. around all three leaves. 18 s.c. Turn, sk. 1, 10 s.c. Turn, sk. 1, 9 s.c., continue the same way until 1 s.c. is left. 10 sl.sts. down the side of triangle, 7 s.c. into the following sts., repeat 3 times from (*), join with sl.st., ch. 2, 1 s.c. into 3rd st. on left side of center leaf, ch. 10, 1 s.c. into point of same leaf, ch. 9, 1 s.c. into point of next leaf, ch. 11, 1 s.c. into point of triangle, ch. 11, 1 s.c. into point of next leaf, ch. 8, 1 s.c. into next leaf, ch. 8, 1 s.c. into next leaf, ch. 11 and repeat all around. This forms the center medallion.

1st row.—Into holes of ch. 8 and 9, 13 s.c. into holes of ch. 11, 17 s.c., join with sl.st.
2nd row.—Ch. 4, 8 tr.c. into 1st st., ch. 3, sk. 3, 1 s.c., ch. 3, sk. 3, 8 tr.c., ch. 3, sk. 3, 1 s.c., ch. 3 and continue all around until 28 shells are made.

3rd row.—8 s.c. into first shell, ch. 3, 8 s.c. into next shell and repeat all around. Join with sl.st.

4th row.—1 sl.st., 4 s.c., ch. 3, 1 d.c. into center st. of ch. 3, ch. 2, 1 d.c. into same, ch. 3, sk. 2 sts. of shell, 4 s.c., ch. 3 and continue all around. Then sl.st. up to 1st space of 2 d.c.

5th row.—Ch. 4, 8 tr.c. into the space, ch. 3, 2 s.c. into the 4 s.c., sk. first and last st., ch. 3, 8 tr.c. into the space, ch. 3, and continue all around.

For 6th, 7th and 8th rows, repeat 3rd, 4th and 5th rows.

For 9th row, repeat 3rd row. Finish off.

10th row.—From the center of 4th shell, where thread was finished off, 65 s.c. one into each, turn, (*), 25 s.c., turn, 25 s.c., turn, 20 s.c., turn, 20 s.c., turn, 15 s.c., turn, 15 s.c., turn, 10 s.c., turn, 10 s.c., turn, 5 s.c., turn, 5 s.c., turn, 65 s.c., and repeat from (*).

Into point 3 s.c., 12 s.c. down side of triangle (**), 4 s.c. into remaining sts. of shell, 3 s.c. into hole, 3 s.c. into shell. Repeat this for 7½ shells in all. Turn, 4 s.c., ch. 4, sk. 3, 1 s.c. Turn, 2 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c. into hole, ch. 4, sk. 3, 1 s.c. Turn, 2 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c. into hole. Turn, ch. 6, sk. 3, 1 s.c. Turn, 3 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c. into hole. Repeat from ch. 6, 3 times more, turn, ch. 8, sk. 3, 1 s.c. Turn, 4 s.c., 1 p., 4 s.c. into hole. Repeat from ch. 8, 3 times more. Turn, ch. 9, sk. 2, 1 s.c. Turn, 5 s.c., 1 p., 5 s.c. into hole. Finish side the same way. But going backwards, 3 s.c., turn, 3 s.c. into sts., 4 s.c. into each hole, 4 s.c. into last sts. of side **. Repeat for top 4th, 5th, 6th rows for 6 shells in 1 row and these same rows for 5 shells in 1 row. Ch. 3, 1 s.c. into next shell, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into center of next shell. Turn, 5 s.c. into 1st hole, ch. 3, 8 s.c. into each shell after 5th shell, ch. 3, 1 s.c. into point of shell of previous row, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into 1st st. at beginning. Turn, 6 s.c. into hole, 1 s.c. into sp., 3 s.c. into each hole, 8 s.c. into each shell. Repeat between **. For other side turn.

1 s.c. into each st. till top of bag. (*) 30 s.c., turn, 30 s.c., turn, 25 s.c., turn, 25 s.c., turn, 20 s.c., turn, 20 s.c., turn, 15 s.c., turn, 15 s.c., turn, 10 s.c., turn, 5 s.c., turn, 5 s.c., turn, 72 s.c., turn, and repeat from (*), 3 s.c. into point, 14 s.c. down side of triangle, join with sl.st. Turn, 15 s.c. up to point of triangle, 3 s.c. into point, 1 s.c. into each, 3 s.c. into next point, 15 s.c. down side of triangle, 1 s.c. into each st. until other triangle is reached. Join with sl.st. into 3rd st. Turn, continuing 1 s.c. into each st. and 3 s.c. into each point, all around. Finish off. Make another piece for other side of bag the same way. Join both sides together with one s.c. into each stitch all around 3 sides.

EDGE FOR TOP OF BAG.

Ch. 20, join 10 to ring, 20 s.c. into ring, join with sl.st. Ch. 22, sk. 1, 1 s.c., 1 h.d.c., 2 d.c., ch. 1, sk. 1, 1 d.c., ch. 1, sk. 1, 2 d.c., 1 h.d.c., 1 s.c., ch. 20, join 10 to ring and repeat until 6 rings are made. Ch. 10 and finish off.

Begin at the 7th s.c. of 1st ring. Ch. 7, 1 p. of ch. 3, 1 tr.c. into next st., 1 p., 1 tr.c. into next 1 p., 1 tr.c. into next 1 p., 1 tr.c. into next 1 p., 1 tr.c. into same, 1 p., 1 tr.c. into next and continue until 9 ps. are made. 1 s.c. into leaf, 1 tr.c. into the 7th st. of following ring and repeat across. Finish off.

Hook needle into 1st ch. of last ch. 10 of edge, fasten it to one end of top of bag, 12 s.c. around ch. 10 to ring, 12 s.c. around ch. 10 to leaf, 1 s.c. into the 14th st. of bag and continue across. Make another edge for other side for top of bag.

EDGE FOR REMAINDER OF BAG.

Ch. 12, join 6 to ring, 12 s.c. into ring, join with sl.st., ch. 13, sk. 1, 1 s.c., 1 h.d.c., 2 d.c., 1 h.d.c., 1 s.c., ch. 12, join six to ring and repeat until 31 rings are made. Ch. 6, finish off.

Begin at 5th st. of last ring, ch. 7 (*) form picot of 3 chs., 1 tr.c. into next st., 1 p., 1 tr.c. into next st., 1 p., 1 tr.c. into same, 1 p., 1 tr.c., 1 p., 1 tr.c., 1 s.c. into leaf, 1 tr.c. into 5th st. of next ring and repeat from (*) across.

Begin at first ch. 6 of edge and fasten to side at top of bag, 7 s.c. around ch. till ring, 7 s.c. around ch. till leaf, 1 s.c. into the 8th s.c. of bag, 7 s.c. around ch. to ring, 1 s.c. into corner of bag, 7 s.c. around ch. till leaf, 1 s.c. into 5th st. of bag, 7 s.c. around ch. till ring, 7 s.c. around ch. to leaf, 1 s.c. into the 10th st. Continue fastening 7 more scallops to the side of bag, 7 s.c. around ch. to ring, 1 s.c. into corner of bag, 7 s.c. around ch. to leaf, 1 s.c. into the 5th st., 7 s.c. till ring, 7 s.c. till leaf, 1 s.c. into point of bag, 7 s.c. till ring, 7 s.c. till leaf, 1 s.c. into 7th st. Continue fastening 5 more scallops till next point, and repeat for other side.

2nd row—7 s.c., taking up back rib, ch. 8, sk. 7, 7 s.c. and repeat around.

3rd row—* 5 s.c., sk. 1st and last of 7 s.c. of previous row, ch. 2, 1 d.c. into the hole, ch. 2, 1 d.c. into the same, repeat till 5 d.c. are made, ch. 2, and repeat from *.

4th row—*3 s.c., sk. 1st and last of 5 s.c. of previous row, 2 s.c. into the 1st hole, 1 p., 2 s.c. into the next hole, 1 p., repeat till 4 p. are made, 2 s.c. into the last 2 holes and repeat from *.

BALLS FOR BAG.

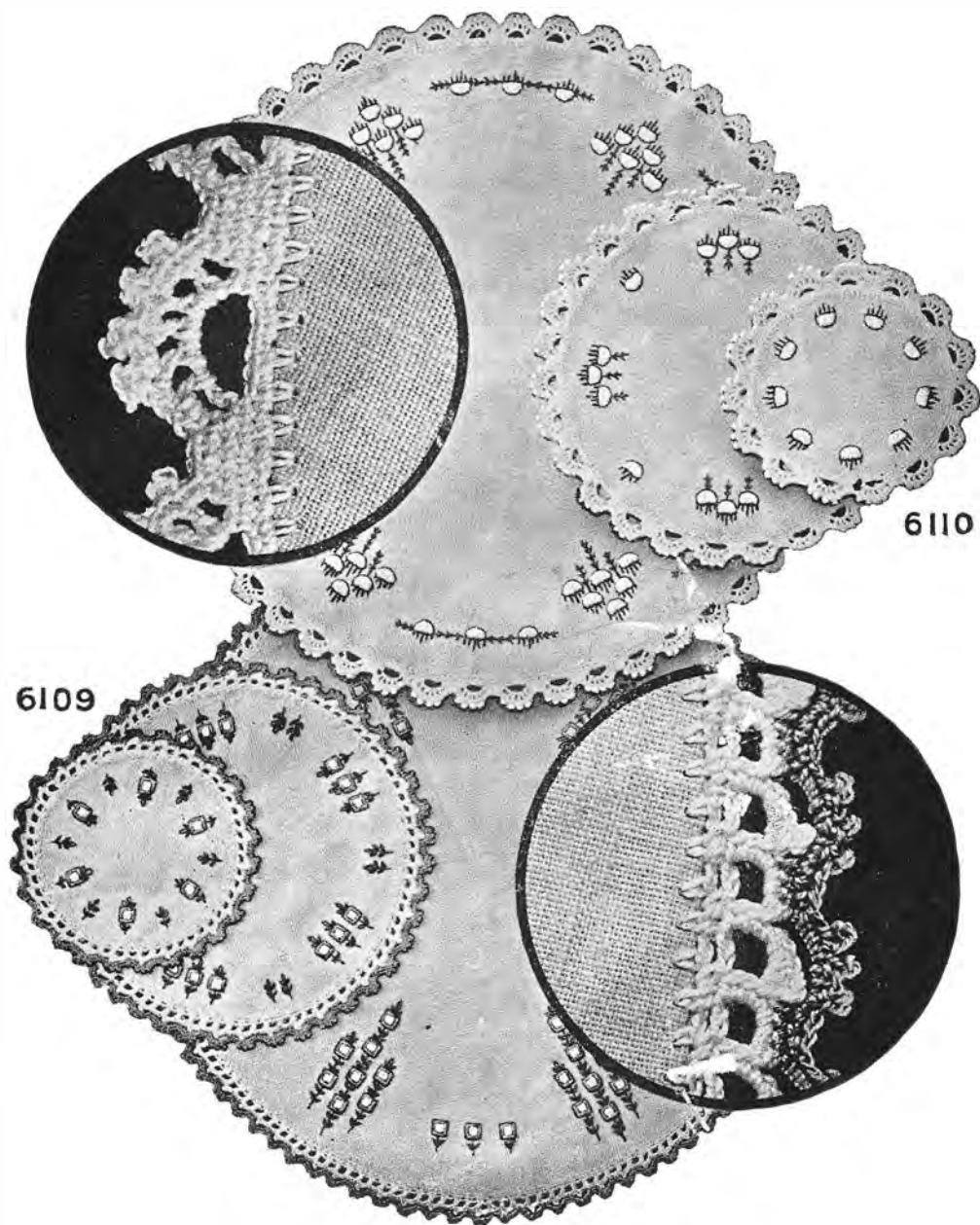
Ch. 4, join to ring, 8 s.c. into ring, 2 s.c. into each st. till 16 s.c., 4 more rows of 16 s.c. Stuff these solid with wadding and begin diminishing, 1 s.c., sk. 1, 1 s.c. until the ball is closed up, ch. 2, 1 s.c. into 1st ch., ch. 1, 1 s.c. into 1st s.c. Repeat this until 7 s.c. are made, ch. 4, 2 s.c. into each ch., join the 8 s.c. to a ring, 2 s.c. into each st. until 16 s.c., make 4 more rows of 16 s.c. Stuff ball, diminish until closed up. Ch. 2, 1 s.c. into 1st ch., ch. 1, 1 s.c. into 1st s.c., repeat until 7 s.c. are made, fasten to point of bag. Make another double ball for other side for same point. Each of 4 points gets 2 double balls, and each leaf at top and bottom of bag a single ball.

FOR HANDLE.

Ch. 182, 1 d.c. into 7th ch., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., continue across until 59 holes are made. Turn, 3 s.c. into each hole on both sides of band. Ch. 5 sk., 4 sts., 1 s.c., ch. 5, sk. 4, 1 s.c., continue all around, 6 s.c. into each hole all around. Finish off. Make another handle the same way and attach each to the inside of bag, before the lining is put in.

A colored silk lining will accentuate the beauty of the design.

MEDALLION.

Wind the cotton 16 times around cardboard 2 inches long, take it off cardboard and make 60 s.c. over the 16 threads, this forming a solid ring.

1st row—60 s.c., taking up back rib of sts.

2nd row—16 ch., 10 s.c. into the 11th and following s.c. of row, taking up each rib. Repeat twice.

3rd row—24 s.c. into the hole of 16 ch., 10 s.c. into 10 s.c. of previous row, taking up back rib.

4th row—1 s.c. into each s.c., taking up back rib.

5th row—1 s.c. into each s.c., in the 5 center s.c. of each scallop 2 s.c.

6th row—1 d.c. into each s.c., in the 6 center s.c. of each scallop 2 d.c.

7th row—ch. 5, 1 d.c. (through the whole st.) into 2nd following st., ch. 2, 1 d.c. into 3rd following st., ch. 2, 1 d.c., taking alternately the 2nd and 3rd st., finish row with 2 ch., 1 sl.st. into 3rd of 1st 5 ch.

8th row—3 s.c. into each hole.

9th row—ch. 6, 1 d.c. into the 5th following st., ch. 6, 6 s.c., taking up back rib, into the 5th and following sts., repeat 10 times.

10th row—8 s.c. into each hole, 4 s.c. into the 6 s.c. between scallops, skip first and last.

11th row—4 s.c., 1 p., 4 s.c., 1 p., 4 s.c., 1 p., 4 s.c. on each scallop, 2 s.c. into the 4 s.c. between scallops, skip first and last.

EDGING.

Ch. as many as required for length, turn.

1st row—1 s.c. into each ch., finish off.

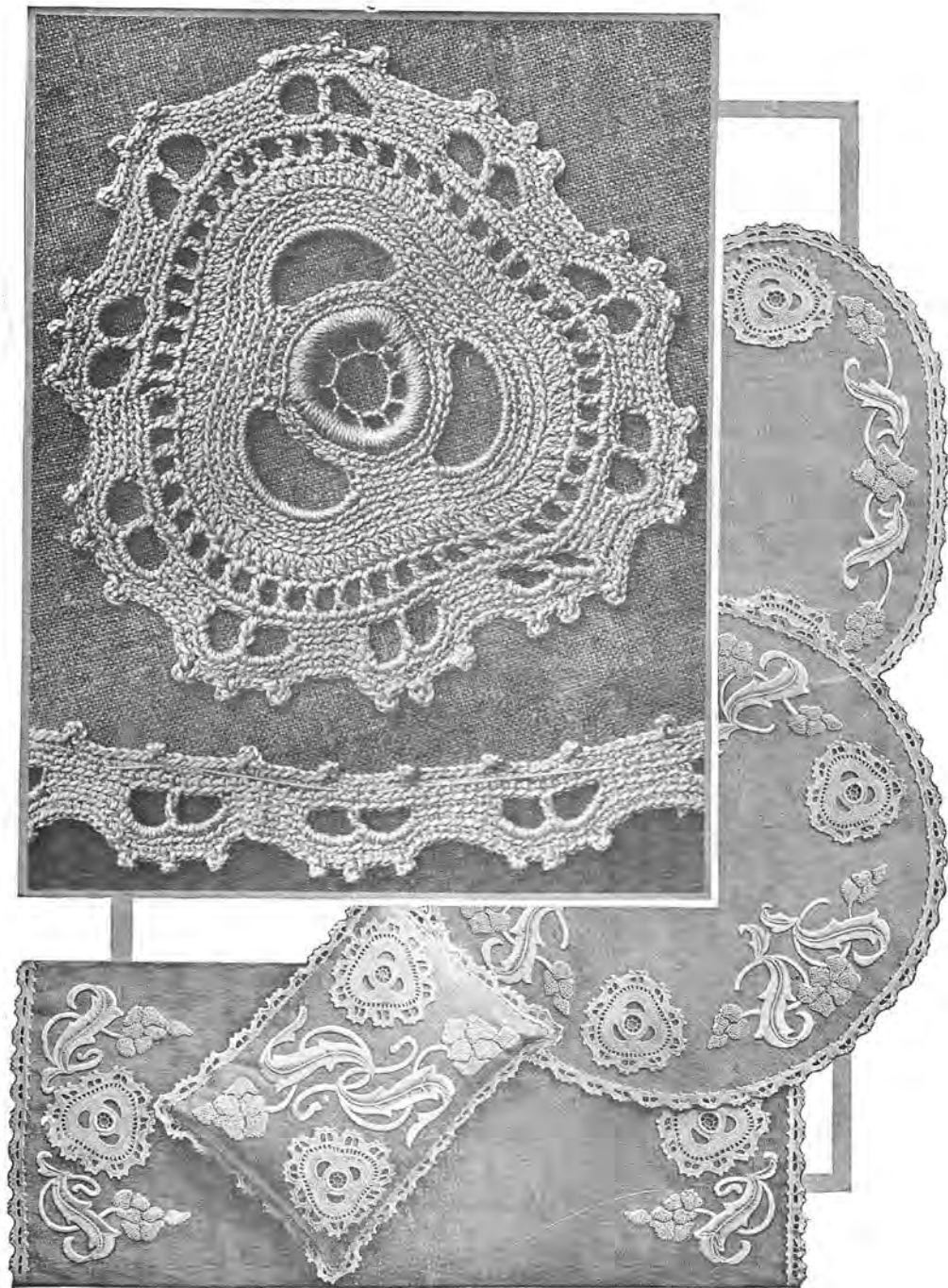
2nd row—6 s.c., taking up back rib, ch. 6, 1 d.c. into the 5th following st., ch. 6, 6 s.c. into the 5th and following sts. and continue, finish off.

Make 22 rows of black, then 2 rows of yellow, join cotton as follows: Pull the yellow cotton through last two loops of last st. and ch. 1 with same, turn and work 12 to 14 s.c. working over end of yellow cotton and over black cotton, then cut both off very short and finish row. Continue making rows of following colors:

The last row of Blue will have 1 s.c. turn, ch. 3, 1 s.c. into the first point formed by decreasing, ch. 2, 1 s.c. into the next point ch. 3, 1 s.c. into the next point, ch. 2, and continue to the lower edge of belt.

FRINGE.

Cut 1 thread of each color of cotton 2 yards long, double, pull through first hole of ch 3, put ends through loops and pull up tight, repeat this in each hole of ch. 3. Tie 11 Solomon Knots in a straight line. A little lower tie 10 s.k. leaving first and last fringe loose. Make 6 s.k. about 2 inches lower, using all the fringe; 3 s.k. 2 inches lower and then one. Finish with large tassel for which more crochet cotton must be added. Cover joining of tassel with crocheted band as follows: Ch. 15, join to ring, 20 s.c. into the ring, make 9 rows of s.c.; in the 10th row 1 s.c., skip 1, 1 s.c., skip 1, until 10 stitches are left. Finish off. Slip end of fringe through ring and sew in place.

SOLOMON KNOT.

Instructions for Knot. Take 3 first fringes, hold the center one down straight between 2nd and 3rd fingers of left hand, bring left hand fringe around over the middle fringe, take right hand fringe, bring it down over the left hand fringe, across back of the middle one, up through the loop on left hand side. Repeat, starting with the right hand fringe, bring the left hand fringe up through the loop on the right hand side. Holding the center one firmly, pull the 2 side fringes to form a firm Knot. Take the right hand fringe and the two following fringes and tie another knot. Continue across.

ROMAN STRIPE BAG No. 1051

Begin with Black, ch. 71, sk. 1, 70 s.c., ch. 1, turn, 1 row of 70 s.c., join yellow cotton as follows: Pull the yellow cotton through last two loops of last st. Ch. 1 with same, turn and work 12 to 14 s.c. working over end of yellow cotton and over black cotton, then cut both off very short and finish row. Each row has 70 s.c. and when turning always ch. 1. Continue with following colors.

Repeat the same for other side of bag. Join both sides together with black, 1 s.c. into each. Around bottom work 1 row of s.c. then join both sides with black. Around top, 1 row of s.c. in black, finish off.

POINTED FLAP.

With Black, ch. 9, sk. 1, 8 s.c. turn. Ch. 1, 9 s.c. (2 sts. into the last st.), turn. With Yellow, ch. 2, 10 s.c. (2 sts. into the 1st). Continue increasing always on the same edge (using the same stripes as on the bag), until the 5th row of the green is reached, which must have 35 sts., 1 more row the same length, then decrease 1 st. on each. After last row of 8 s.c. is made, continue in black all around flap with s.c., 1 into each row. Make 1 other row of s.c. around point of flap, 8 sl.st. up to the top of flap. Then join the back of bag and flap together with s.c.

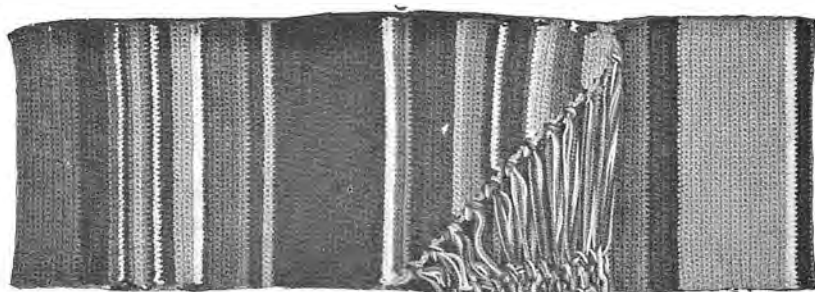
HANDLE.

Ch. 7, sk. 1, 6 s.c. turn, ch. 1, 6 s.c. and continue until 23 inches are made. Sew to upper corners of bag under flap.

Fringes for Flap.

Take a double thread about 5 inches, double again, pull through stitches. Make ch., pull out, tie tight. Use some colors as in the stripes, 1 fringe for each row of s.c. Fringes for bottom of bag. At the bottom of bag make fringes in the same way but cut thread 14 inches long. Tie the Solomon Knots to form a point. Begin 1st Knot 1/2 inch below corner of bag.

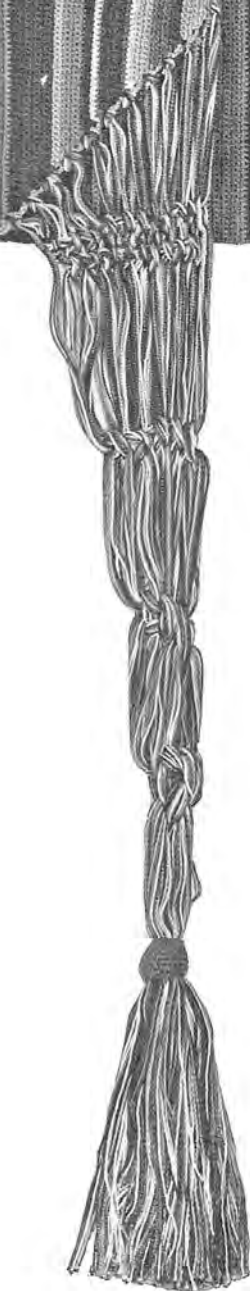

This forms a rose, 1 s.c. into the loop left from the 1st loose ch., pull through from the back, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into the same, ch. 2, 1 d.c. into the next loop, ch. 2, 1 d.c. into the same, ch. 2 and continue till end of row. Last 2 ch. join to 3rd of ch. 5.

Ch. 3, 5 d.c. into 1st hole, 3 d.c. into the next, repeat 3 times, join with sl.st.
Ch. 5, 1 d.c. into the 3rd d.c. of previous row, ch. 3, 1 d.c. into the same, ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 1, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 3, 1 d.c. into the same. Repeat all around, join to 3rd of ch. 5, ch. 3 into each hole, 2' d.c. into each sp., 1 d.c. into corner hole, 6 d.c., join with sl.st., finish off.

LONG CENTER.

Ch. 3, join to ring, ch. 3, 10 d.c. into the ring, turn * ch. 4 (1 loose, 3 tight), 10 d.c. into the loose ch. Turn and repeat from * till 15 scallops are made. Ch. 9, 1 d.c. into the 3rd ch. from beginning of the next to last scallop, ch. 7, 1 d.c. into the beginning of next scallop on this side. Repeat 5 times. Ch. 9, 1 d.c. into 2nd d.c. of first scallop made, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into the 4th following d.c., ch. 9, 1 d.c. into the next 3rd d.c., ch. 7, 1 d.c. into 3 sk. of next scallop. Finish row, join with sl.st. into 3rd ch. of ch. 9.

7 s.c. into each hole of 7th ch. 9 s.c. into the corner holes, 5 s.c. into hole of ch. 5 1 s.c. into each sp., join with sl.st., 1 d.c. into each s.c., into corner 3 d.c. at the center of one end join the square medallion with sl.st. At the end of the row join with sl.st., ch. 5, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., repeat to next corner, ch. 4, 1 d.t.r.c. into 4th following d.c. Pull thread through 3 times through 2 loops, 1 d.t.r.c. into 3rd st. from joined corner of square medallion. Pull thread through 4 times through 2 loops 1 t.r.c., into following 5th d.c. pull thread through 3 times, ch. 4, 1 d.c., into the 4th following d.c. ch. 4, 1 s.c. into the corner, ch. 4 sk. 3, 1 d.c. Repeat 3 times to corner, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into the same, continue the row to the end of the opposite side, and continue across the end with ch. 5, 1 d.c. into the same, 2 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 3 d.c., continue across, ch. 2, 1 d.c. into the 3rd of ch. 5, turn, ch. 5, and repeat this last row twice.

Ch. 3, 1 row of d.c. all around, into holes of ch. 2, 2 d.c., into holes of ch. 4, 4 d.c., into top point 7 d.c., into each corner of bottom 5 d.c., into each sp. 1 d.c., 1 row of 4 s.c. 1 p., 4 s.c. all around.

EDGING.

Into the scarf 1 s.c., ch. 1, 1 s.c. all around.

1st row—1 d.c. into ch. of previous row, ch. 1, 1 d.c., ch. 1, repeat.

2nd row—2 d.c. into one hole, 1 d.c., 1 p., 1 d.c. into next hole, repeat. Into the corner holes 5 d.c.

On each corner place 1 tassel of 40 strands, fasten with 1 loop, finish with buttonhole stitch. On each side 9 tassels.

PILLOW No. 5851

Materials required: 3 balls ROYAL SOCIETY Tan Crochet Cotton 1010, size 3;
Crochet Hook No. 4.

Strip consisting of one long and two square medallions and two pointed ends.

Square Medallion—Ch. (1 tight, 4 loose) join to ring into tight chain. Into the first loose ch. 1 s.c., 1 h.d.c., 5 d.c., 1 h.d.c., 1 s.c., repeat into the 3 following chs. join with sl.st.; this forms a rose. 1 s.c. into the loop left from the loose ch., pull through from back, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into the same, ch. 2, 1 d.c. into the next loop, ch. 2, 1 d.c. into the same, ch. 2 and continue to end of row, last 2 ch. join to 3rd of ch. 5.

Ch. 5, 1 d.c. into the 3rd d.c. of previous row, ch. 3, 1 d.c. into the same, ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 1, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 3, 1 d.c. into the same. Repeat all around. Join to 3rd of ch. 5, ch. 3, into each hole 2 d.c. into each sp. 1 d.c., into corner hole 6 d.c., join with sl.st. and finish off.

Make another one of these medallions.

Long Center Medallion—Ch. 3, join to ring, ch. 3, 10 d.c. into the ring, turn, (*) ch. 4 (1 loose, 3 tight) 10 d.c. into the loose ch., turn and repeat from (*) till 7 scallops are made. Ch. 9, 1 d.c. into the 3rd ch. from beginning of next to the last scallop. Ch. 7, 1 d.c. into the beginning of next scallop on this side. Repeat twice. Ch. 9, 1 d.c. into 2nd d.c. of 1st scallop made, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into the 4th following d.c., ch. 9, 1 d.c. into the next 3rd d.c., ch. 7, 1 d.c. into the 3 chs. of next scallop. Finish row, join with sl.st. in the 3rd ch. of ch. 9. 7 s.c. into each hole of ch. 7, 9 s.c. in the corner holes. 5 s.c. into the hole of ch. 5, 1 s.c. into each sp., join with sl.st., 1 d.c. into each s.c., in the corner 3 d.c., at the center of each end join the sq. medallions with sl.st., at the end of the row join with sl.st., turn. sl.sts. to the corner, turn, ch. 5, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c. repeat to end of long center, ch. 4, 1 d.t.r.c. in the 4th following st. pull thread through 2 loops 3 times, 1 d.t.r.c., into the 3rd d.c. of sq. medallion, pull thread through 2 loops 4 times, 1 t.r.c. into the following 5th d.c., pull thread through 3 times, twice through 2 loops and once through 3 loops, ch. 4, 1 d.c. into the 4th following d.c., ch. 4, 1 s.c. into the next corner, ch. 4, sk. 3, 1 d.c. ch. 4, sk. 3, 1 d.t.r.c., ch. 4, sk. 3, 1 d.t.r.c., ch. 5, 1 d.c. into the same, ch. 4, 1 s.c. into the corner, continue the row the same way all around and finish off.

Pointed Ends—(*) 1 row of 22 d.c. Turn, ch. 5, skip 2, 3 d.c., ch. 2, skip 2, 3 d.c. Repeat this twice, ch. 2, 1 d.c., turn, ch. 5 and repeat this row 6 times, turn, 1 row of 22 d.c., turn, ch. 4, skip 2, 1 d.c., ch. 5, skip 2, 9 s.c., ch. 5, skip 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2, skip 2, 1 d.c., turn, 3 sl.st., ch. 8, 7 s.c., skip 1st and last of 9 s.c., ch. 5, 1 d.c. into d.c., turn,

Materials required : 3 balls ROYAL SOCIETY White Crochet Cotton, size 8; Crochet Hook No.11

1st row—Ch. 50, sk. 1 (*), 3 s.c., ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into the 6th st., ch. 5, sk. 5, 5 s.c., ch. 5, sk. 5, 1 tr.c., ch. 5, sk. 5, 5 s.c., ch. 5, sk. 5, 1 tr.c., ch. 5, sk. 5, 3 s.c. Turn.

2nd row—Ch. 1, 3 s.c., 9 s.c. into hole, 1 s.c. into sp., 9 s.c. into next hole, 5 s.c. into sts. Finish row. Turn.

3rd row—Ch. 10, 5 s.c. into center sts. of scallop. Ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into center st. of 5 s.c., ch. 5, 5 s.c. into center of next scallop and continue row. At end ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into last st. Turn.

4th row—Ch. 10, 5 s.c. into 5 s.c., ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into sp., ch. 5 and repeat to end of row. At end 1 tr.c. Turn.

5th row—10 s.c. into 1st hole, 5 s.c. into 5 s.c., 9 s.c. into next hole, 1 s.c. into sp. Continue row. Turn.

6th row—Ch. 1, 3 s.c. into 1st 3 s.c., ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into center of 5 s.c., ch. 5, 5 s.c. into center of scallop and continue row. Turn, ch. 1 and repeat from (*) 14 times.

This forms the back for slipper.

To make front of slipper, continue crocheting over both ends in the same way, repeating from (*) to (*) 6 times.

Turn, and work 1 s.c. into each hole, to gather point of slipper. Work 1 row of s.c. all around bottom of slipper (5 s.c. into each hole and 1 s.c. into each st.). Finish off. Begin in front at top of slipper and make a row of s.c. all around (5 s.c. into hole, 1 s.c. into st.). Then, ch. 10, 1 tr.c. into the 6th st., pull thread through two loops only, sk. 2 sts., 1 d.c., pull thread through all loops in needle, 2 at a time. Ch. 2, 1 d.c. into center of 3 spokes to form a cross, ch. 4, 1 tr.c. into 5th st., ch. 4, repeat the cross and continue all around. At end when 6 sts. are left, ch. 10, 2 s.c. into center of front, 10 s.c. into 1st hole, 4 s.c. into each of the following holes. Repeat all around. At end 10 s.c. into hole.

10 s.c. into sts., ch. 16, sk. 6 sts., 2 s.c., ch. 16, and repeat until the last 10 s.c. from front of slipper are left. 10 s.c. into the 10 s.c., 4 s.c., ch. 5, form picot, 3 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c. into the 10 s.c. of previous row, 5 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c., 1 p., 10 s.c. into big hole, 6 s.c. into next hole, join with sl.st. to the 7th s.c. of previous scallop, 3 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c., 1 p., 10 s.c. into the 2nd hole. Repeat all around. Finish row with 3 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c., join with sl.st. at the beginning.

A colored satin or silk lining gives a touch of style, while a thinly padded interlining will add body to the slipper, making it soft and comfortable.

ch. 9, 5 s.c., ch. 6, 1 d.c. into 3rd ch. of previous row, turn, ch. 10, 3 s.c., ch. 7, 1 d.c. into 3rd ch. of previous row, turn, ch. 11, 1 s.c., ch. 8, 1 d.c. into 3rd ch. of previous row, turn, ch. 5, 1 sl.st. into 8th ch. of ch. 11. Finish off and repeat from (*) at the other end. 1 row of d.c. all around, into holes of 2 ch., 2 d.c. into holes of 3 ch., 3 d.c. into holes of 4 ch., 4 d.c. into the 2 holes of points, 7 d.c., 1 d.c. into each sp. 1 row of 4 s.c. 1 p. all around. Be sure to have 1 p. at each corner.

In each 3 points of each side have tassel.

Finish around strip—1 row of d.c. all around, in the holes of ch. 2, 2 d.c. in the holes of ch. 3, 3 d.c. in the holes of ch. 4, 4 d.c. in the two holes of point 7 d.c., 1 d.c. into each sp., 1 row of 4 s.c., 1 p. 4 s.c., 1 p. all around. Be sure to have 1 p. at each corner. Finish off. Fasten three tassels to each end of strip, one on each corner.

To make tassel, wind cotton 20 times around cardboard 9 inches long. Cut loops in two and make 3 knots in center of strands. Then wind cotton around below knot and fasten to band with a button holed loop.

Make two more strips and mount on cushion, leaving the pointed ends free and the panel formed by the medallions sewed firmly to linen, which is afterwards cut away underneath.

Ch. 22, sk. 6, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., repeat till 6 holes are made, turn, ch. 6*, 1 d.c. into the 1st d.c. ch. 2, 1 d.c. into the next d.c., ch. 2, 1 d.c. into the next d.c., repeat till 7 holes are made, ch. 5 form p., 1 d.c. into the same, ch. 5 form p., repeat till 5 p. are made, turn 5 s.c. into each p., ch. 2, 1 d.c. into next d.c., ch. 2, 1 d.c. into following d.c., continue till 7 holes are made, ch. 2, 1 d.c. into the same, turn, ch. 6, 1 d.c. into the 1st d.c., ch. 2, continue till 9 holes are made, turn, 1 row of 10 holes, increasing the same way as before, turn, 11 holes, continue scallop the same as after 2nd row. Continue 12 holes, turn, increase and continue till 7 holes are made. Begin Daisy.

Ch. 4, 1 s.c. into the following d.c.: For leaf, ch. 10, join with sl.st. to 3rd d.c. from scallop at row of 10 holes, sk. 1 ch. 1 s.c., 1 h.d.c., 5 d.c., 1 h.d.c., 1 s.c., 1 s.c. into the hole of ch. 2 of previous row. Ch. 10, join to 5th d.c., from scallop at row of 9 holes, finish leaf, 1 s.c. into the same hole as after 1st leaf.

Ch. 10, join to 7th d.c. from scallop, at row of 10 holes, finish leaf, 1 s.c. into the 7th holes from 1st row, ch. 10, join to the 9th d.c. from scallop at row of 12 holes, finish the leaf, 1 s.c. into the same hole, as after 3rd leaf, 1 s.c. into hole of ch. 4. Ch. 10, finish leaf, 1 s.c. into the same, make 3 more leaves and 1 s.c. into the hole, then join with sl.st. to 1st s.c. before 1st leaf. Ch. 3, 1 d.c. into next d.c., ch. 2, 1 d.c., join the last leaf made, finish row with 2 more holes, turn, 1 other row of 13 holes, turn, decrease 1 hole, after 4 holes are made join 1 leaf, continue 5 more holes, join the leaf made before last, finish the row, which has 12 holes, with scallop, turn, 1 row of 11 holes at the 6th d.c. join the loose leaf, 1 row of 10 holes, 1 row of 9 holes, after which make scallop, 1 row of 8 holes, 1 row of 7 holes, repeat from * until 7 Daisies are made. Finish off.

NARROW EDGING FOR BACK.

1 row of 1 s.c., ch. 1, 1 s.c. into the towel.

1st row—1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., repeat to end of row.

2nd row—1 s.c. into 1st d.c. *5 d.c. into next d.c., 1 s.c. into following d.c., turn, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into 1st of 5 d.c., ch. 5, repeat till 5 loops are made, turn, 5 s.c. into each loop, 1 s.c. into following d.c. of 1st row, ch. 2, 1 s.c. into the next 4 d.c., and repeat from *.

Materials required: 1 ball ROYAL SOCIETY White Crochet Cotton, size 8; 1 ball Pink No. 1015, size 8; Crochet Hook No. 11

EDGING.

1st row—1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c. to end of row.

2nd row—1 s.c. into the 1st d.c., ch. 3, *sk. 1 hole, 1 d.c. into the next hole, ch. 3, 1 d.c. into the same hole, ch. 3, sk. 1 hole, 1 s.c. into the next hole, ch. 3, repeat from * to end of row.

3rd row—* 1 s.c. into the 1st s.c. of previous row, 3 d.c. into the 1st hole, 3 d.c. into the center hole, 3 d.c. into the 3rd hole, 1 s.c. into s.c. Repeat from * to end of row.

4th row—with Pink cotton, *1 s.c. into 1st s.c. ch. 3, sk. 3, 1 d.c., ch. 3, sk. 3, 1 s.c., ch. 3, 1 s.c. into s.c. between scallops. Repeat from *.

5th row—* 4 s.c. into 1st hole, 2 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c. into center hole, 4 s.c. into 3rd hole, 1 s.c. into s.c. between scallop. Repeat from *.

Materials required for Embroidery: 4-Strand Pink 311, 313, 315; Green 332; Blue 131

TOWEL No. 3052

Materials required: 1 ball ROYAL SOCIETY White Crochet Cotton, size 8; Crochet Hook No.11

Ch. 144, join to ring.

Ch. 4, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 1, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 1, and repeat until 48 holes are made, join the last ch. to 3rd ch. from beginning.

*Into the 1st hole, 1 s.c., 1 p., 1 s.c. into 2nd hole, 1 s.c. into 3rd hole, 1 p., 1 s.c. into 4th hole 1 s.c., into 5th hole 1 p., 1 s.c., into 6th hole 1 s.c., into 7th hole 1 p., 1 s.c.

Into each of the 10 following holes, 1 s.c., 1 p., 1 s.c., into the 18th hole 1 s.c., into the 19th hole 1 p., 1 s.c., into 20th hole 1 s.c., into 21st hole 1 p., 1 s.c., into 22nd hole 1 s.c., into 23rd hole, 1 p., 1 s.c., into 24th hole, 1 s.c., 1 p., 1 s.c. and repeat from *. Finish off.

On the outside 3 s.c. into each of 48 holes, join with sl.st. Begin the 3 leaves *. Ch. 10 turn, sk. 1, 1 s.c., 1 h.d.c., 5 d.c., 1 h.d.c., 1 s.c., turn, repeat the same to the top, turn 9 sl.st. down side of leaf. Repeat the same for each of the next two leaves. 1 s.c. around 3 leaves. This holds them together. 10 s.c. into the following s.c. (next leaf) ch. 9, turn, sk. 1, 1 s.c., 1 h.d.c., 4 d.c., 1 h.d.c., 1 s.c., turn, repeat the same to top, turn, 8 sl.st. down side of leaf, 1 s.c. around leaf, 52 s.c. into the following s.c., repeat the leaf just made, 10 s.c., repeat from *.

Ch. 3, 1 sl.st. on left side into 2nd d.c. of center leaf, ch. 8, 1 s.c. into the top of the same leaf, ch. 9, 1 s.c. into the top of other leaf, ch. 5, 1 d.tr.c. into 5th sl.st. of same leaf, pull thread once through 2 loops, 1 tr.c. into 5th s.c., 1 d.c. into center of other leaf, pull thread through all loops on needle, two loops at a time.

Ch. 5, 1 s.c., into top of same leaf, ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into the 3rd sl.st. of same leaf, pull thread once through 2 loops, 1 tr.c. into 5th following s.c. from leaf, pull thread through all loops on needle, two loops at a time, ch. 4, 1 d.tr.c. into the 3rd following s.c., pull thread twice through two loops, 1 d.tr.c. into 3rd following s.c., pull thread through all loops on needle, two loops at a time, ch. 3, 1 d.tr.c. into the center of 3 sps., ch. 3, 1 d.tr.c. into 3rd s.c., pull thread through once, 1 d.c. into 3rd following s.c., pull thread through all loops on needle, ch. 2, 1 d.c. into center of three sps., ch. 5, and repeat this last bar. This finishes half of one side.

1st row—Ch. 9, sk. 2, 1 d.c. into 3rd s.c., ch. 5, sk. 2, 1 d.c. into next 3rd, repeat all around. The last 5 chs. join to the 4th ch. of ch. 9.

2nd Row—3 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c. into 1st hole. Continue around. Join with 1 sl.st.

3rd Row—Ch. 9, 1 d.c. between next 2 p., ch. 5, 1 d.c. between following 2 p. (*). Turn, 5 s.c. into 1st hole, 1 s.c. into sp., 5 s.c. into next hole, 1 s.c. into 4th ch. at beginning of row. Turn, sk. 1, 11 s.c. Turn, sk. 2, 9 s.c. Turn, sk. 2, 7 s.c. Turn, sk. 1, 6 s.c. Turn, sk. 1, 5 s.c. Turn, sk. 2, 3 s.c. Turn, sk. 2, 1 s.c., 8 sl.st. down side of triangle, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into next p. Ch. 5, 1 d.c. between the 2 p. Ch. 5, 1 d.c. between next 2 p. Ch. 5, 1 d.c. between following 2 p. Turn and repeat from (*) until 4 triangles are made. Join to 1st triangle.

4th Row—(*) 16 s.c. over triangle, 5 s.c. into next hole, 1 s.c. into sp., 5 s.c. into next hole. Repeat from (*).

5th Row—(*) 16 s.c. over triangle. Continue with 8 s.c., ch. 8. Turn, sk. 3, 2 s.c. Turn, 12 s.c. into the hole, sk. 1 s.c. of previous row, 2 s.c. Turn, 2 d.c. into 1st s.c. of hole, 1 d.c. into next s.c., 2 d.c. into the following, and continue until 13 d.c., sk. 2 s.c., 1 sl.st. Turn, 1 s.c. into each of 18 d.c., 16 s.c. over triangle and repeat from (*) all around.

6th Row—8 sl.st. to the point of triangle, ch. 4. (*) 1 d.c. into the 4th st. on other side of triangle. Ch. 4, 1 d.c. into 4th st. of scallop. Ch. 4, 1 tr.c. into the center of scallop. Ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into the same. Ch. 4, 1 d.c. into 5th st. at other side of scallop. Ch. 4, 1 d.c. into the 4th st. of triangle. Ch. 4, 1 s.c. into point of triangle. Ch. 4, repeat from (*) all around.

7th Row—4 s.c. into each hole, 1 s.c. into each sp., 9 s.c. into corner hole. When 2nd corner is reached 4 s.c. into the hole. Turn (*). Make 2 more rows each of 40 s.c. from corner to corner. Turn, ch. 6, 1 tr.c. into 5th s.c. Ch. 6, 1 s.c. into 5th. Repeat three times to next corner. Turn, 2 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c. into 1st hole, 1 s.c. into tr.c., 2 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c. into next hole. Repeat this scallop 3 times. Ch. 11, 1 s.c. into center s.c. of 1st scallop.

Ch. 9, 1 s.c. into center of next scallop. Ch. 9. Repeat across row. For corner ch. 11. Join with sl.st. at beginning of previous row. Turn, 13 s.c. into 1st hole, 1 s.c. into center of scallop, 9 s.c. into each of the following 2 holes, 1 s.c. into scallop, 13 s.c. into corner hole, 3 s.c. into the 3 rows of s.c., continue for other 2 sides with 4 s.c. into each hole, 1 s.c. into each sp., 9 s.c. into corner hole, when 4th corner is reached 4 s.c. into hole. Repeat from (*). Join with sl.st.

8th Row—1 s.c. into each st. round to starting point. Finish with sl.st. to point of corner.

9th Row—1 s.c. into each st., 3 s.c. into each corner st.

10th Row (Border)—3 s.c. (*). Ch. 8, sk. 5, 1 s.c. into 6th ch. 8. Continue until 7 loops are made. Over corner 6 s.c. Ch. 8, sk. 5, 1 s.c. into 6th ch. 8. Repeat until 9 loops are made, 6 s.c. over corner. Repeat from (*). Finish with 3 s.c. and join with sl.st.

11th Row—2 s.c., sk. 1, (*) 9 s.c. into 6 loops. Into the 7th loop 5 s.c. Turn, ch. 8, 1 s.c. into center of 1st scallop. Ch. 8. Repeat for 6 loops. Turn 9 s.c. into 5 loops, 5 s.c. into 6th. Turn ch. 8, 5 loops. Turn 9 s.c. into 4 loops, 5 s.c. into 5th. Turn, ch. 8, 4 loops. Turn, 9 s.c. into 3 loops, 5 s.c. into 4th. Turn, ch. 8, 3 loops. Turn, 9 s.c. into 2 loops. Turn, 9 s.c. into 2 loops, 5 s.c. into 3rd. Turn, ch. 8, 2 loops. Turn, 9 s.c. into 1 loop, 5 s.c. into 2nd. Turn, ch. 8, 1 loop. Turn, 9 s.c., continue 5 s.c. into each of the 6 half loops, 4 s.c. into the 6 s.c. of previous row, skipping 1st and last s.c., 9 s.c. into 1st loop, 5 s.c. into 2nd. Turn, ch. 8, 1 s.c. into 5th st. of 1st scallop. Turn, 9 s.c. into loop, 5 s.c. into the remaining half loop, 9 s.c. into the 4 following loops, 5 s.c. into the 5th. Turn, ch. 8, 4 loops. Turn, 9 s.c. into 3 loops, 5 s.c. into the 4th. Turn, ch. 8, 3 loops. Turn, 9 s.c. into 2 loops, 5 s.c. into 3rd. Turn, ch. 8, 2 loops. Turn, 9 s.c. into 1st loop and 5 s.c. into 2nd. Turn, ch. 8, 1 loop. Turn, 9 s.c. into loop, 5 s.c. into each of 4 remaining half loops. Continue finishing this side like the beginning and repeat from (*). At the end of row 2 s.c. join with sl.st. to the 2 first s.c.

12th row—1 row of s.c. all around the medallion.

13th row—5 s.c., 1 p., 5 s.c., 1 p. Continue. Be sure to have 1 p. at each point. Between the small and center point at the wide side, sk. 3 s.c. to give a good shape.

INSERTION.

For solid circle—Ch. 3, join to ring, 8 s.c. into ring, 2 s.c. into each until 16 s.c., 2 s.c. into 1st. 1 s.c. into next until 24 s.c. 2 s.c. into 1st, 1 s.c. into each of following 2 s.c. until 32 s.c., 1 s.c. into each all around 1 sl.st. Ch. 11 and begin triangles.

The triangles—Turn, sk. 1, 5 sl.st. Ch. 6. Turn, 11 s.c. into chs. and sl.st. Turn, sk. 1, 10 s.c. Turn, sk. 1, 9 s.c. Turn, sk. 1, 8 s.c. Turn, sk. 1, 7 s.c. and so on until 1 s.c. is left. Turn, 1 s.c. into the same. Turn, 2 s.c. Turn, 2 s.c. into the 1st and 1 s.c. into next. Turn, 2 s.c. into 1st, 2 s.c. into the next 2. Turn and continue until 11 s.c. Turn, 6 sl.sts.

The open circle—Ch. 17, 1 s.c. into the 6th ch. from needle to form a ring. 20 s.c. into ring. Join ch. 5, sk. 1, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 1, 1 d.c. Repeat all around until 10 holes are made. Join to the 3rd ch. from beginning 4 s.c. into 1st hole, 1 p. 4 s.c. into next hole, 1 p. repeat all around. Join to the 5th s.c. at the beginning of the open circle. Ch. 6 times 3 and join with 1 sl.st. after each ch. 3 on the left side on the last row of s.c. until center of other side of circle is reached. Ch. 11 and repeat the triangles. After this, ch. 14, join

- w.m., weaving mesh.
- cl.m., closed mesh.
- f.m., fancy mesh.

1st row—Ch. 2 78, 14 m. (1 tr.c. into 13th ch., ch. 4, 1 tr.c. into 5th. This is for 2 m.).
2nd row—2 m. (always ch. 8 at beginning of row), 1 cl.m. (5 tr.c.), 3 m., 1 d.tr.c. into next and center sp., 7 tr.c., 1 d.tr.c. into same, 1 tr.c. into next sp., 3 m., 1 cl.m., 2 m. Turn.

3rd row—1 m., 1 cl.m., 1 cr.m. (1 d.tr.c. into next st., ch. 2, 1 d.c. into center of last d.tr.c., pull loop through, make another d.c. into 3rd st., and pull thread through all the loops, 2 at a time). 1 cl.m., 1 m., 1 d.tr.c., 3 tr.c., all into the next sp., 2 fancy m. (*) (1 tr.c., ch. 5, 1 s.c. into center of the last tr.c., ch. 2, 1 s.c. into the 2nd st., ch. 5, turn and join into center of ch. 5, turn ch. 2, cotton over needle, hook into center st. of ch. 5, cotton over needle, hook into 2nd st., and work off 2 loops at a time. This makes 1 fancy m.). 3 tr.c., 1 d.tr.c. into sp., 1 tr.c. into next sp., 1 m., 1 cl.m., 1 cr.m., 1 cl.m., 1 m., turn.

4th row—2 m., 1 cl.m., 1 m. (*) 1 d.tr.c. and 3 tr.c. into next sp., 1 f.m., 3 tr.c., 1 d.tr.c. into next 4 sts., finish all 4 together. Ch. 3, 1 tr.c. (*), continue reversing row, turn.

5th row—3 m., repeat between (*) of 4th row, 2 m., and finish row reversing.

6th row—2 m., repeat between (*) of 4th row, but instead of ch. 3, ch. 8, 1 s.c. into sp. 4 weaving m. (into the 4 center m., ch. 1, sk. 1, 1 s.c., repeat until 12 s.c. are made, turn and repeat 4 times more. At end of 2nd and 4th row, take up with sl.st., the 2nd ch. of ch. 8. This makes 4 weaving m.). Finish row reversing.

7th row—1 m., repeat between (*) of 4th row, ch. 8, 1 s.c. into next sp., 1 w.m. (made as before only with 4 s.c.), ch. 4, 1 d.tr.c. into corner of w.m., 1 tr.c. into 4th st., 1 d.tr.c. into next 4th st., finish those 3 together, ch. 8 and repeat w.m. Finish row reversing. This makes one-half of square, finish other half the same way, reversing it.

When square is finished, make 1 row of 1 m., 1 cl.m., 1 m., 1 cl.m., 1 m., 1 cl.m., 2 m. and finish row reversing.

Repeat from beginning for length required

When completed, 1 row of d.c. into each st. all around the band, 5 d.c. into corner st.

EDGE FOR BEDSPREAD. CORNER.

1st row—Ch. 23, 1 tr.c. into 13th ch, 2 more m., turn.

4th row—1 m., 1 d.tr.c., 3 tr.c. into following sp., 1 f.m., 3 tr.c., 1 d.tr.c. into sts., finish together, ch. 3, 1 m., ch. 8, 1 tr.c. into same, turn, 4 sl.sts.

5th row—Ch. 12, 1 tr.c. into last sl.st., 1 m., ch. 3, 1 d.tr.c., 3 tr.c. into sts., finish together, 1 f.m., 3 tr.c., 1 d.tr.c. into same sp., 2 m., turn.

6th row—3 m., 1 d.tr.c., 3 tr.c. into sp., 1 f.m., 3 tr.c., 1 d.tr.c. into sts., finish together, ch. 3, 1 m., ch. 8, 1 tr.c. into same, turn.

7th row—4 sl.sts., 2 m., 1 f.m., 3 tr.c., 1 d.tr.c. into same sp., 2 m., 1 cl.m., 1 m., turn.

8th row—2 m., 1 d.tr.c., 3 tr.c. into next sp., 1 f.m., 3 tr.c., 1 d.tr.c. into sts., finish together, ch. 3, 2 m., turn.

9th row—4 sl.sts., 2 m., ch. 3, 3 tr.c., 1 d.tr.c. into sts., finish together 1 f.m., 1 m., ch. 3, 1 d.tr.c., 3 tr.c. into sts., finish together, 1 tr.c. to finish row, turn.

10th row—Ch. 9, 1 f.m., 3 tr.c., 1 d.tr.c. into sts., finish together, ch. 3, 1 tr.c. into sp., 1 d.tr.c., 3 tr.c. into next sp., 2 m., turn.

11th row—4 sl.sts., 2 m., 1 f.m., ch. 3, 1 d.tr.c., 3 tr.c. into sts., finish together, turn.

12th row—3 m., turn.

13th row—4 sl.sts., 2 m., 4 sl.sts., over last tr.c.

14th row—This row is worked across. Ch. 3, 2 m., 1 d.tr.c., 3 tr.c. into next sp., 1 f.m., 3 tr.c., 1 d.tr.c. into sts., finish together, ch. 3, 2 m., turn.

15th row—1 m., ch. 3, 1 d.tr.c., 3 tr.c. into sts., finish together. 1 f.m., 3 tr.c., 1 d.tr.c. into same sp., 1 tr.c. into next sp., 2 m., turn.

16th row—4 sl.st., 2 m., 1 d.tr.c., 3 tr.c. into next sp., 1 f.m., 1 m., turn.

17th row—1 m., 3 tr.c., 1 d.tr.c. into same sp., 1 tr.c. into next sp., 2 m., turn.

18th row—4 sl.sts., 3 m., turn. This finishes corner. Proceed for side.

19th row—2 m., 1 cl.m., ch. 8, 1 tr.c. into same, turn, 4 sl.sts.

20th row—ch. 12, 1 tr.c. into last sl.st., 1 cl.m., 1 cr.m., 1 cl.m., 1 m., turn.

21st row—2 m., 1 cl.m., 1 m., turn, 4 sl.sts.

22nd row—ch. 8, 3 m., turn.

23rd row—1 m., ch. 3, 1 d.tr.c., 3 tr.c. into sts., finish together, ch. 8, 1 tr.c. into same, turn 4 sl.sts.

24th row—ch. 12, 1 tr.c. into last sl.st., 1 m., ch. 3, 1 d.tr.c., 3 tr.c. into sts., finish together, 1 f.m., 1 m., turn.

25th row—1 m., 1 d.tr.c., 3 tr.c. into next sp., 1 f.m., 3 tr.c., 1 d.tr.c. into sts., finish together, ch. 3, 1 m., ch. 8, 1 tr.c. into same, turn.

26th row—4 sl.sts., 1 tr.c. into last sl.st., 1 m., ch. 3, 1 d.tr.c., 3 tr.c. into sts., finish together, 1 f.m., 3 tr.c., 1 d.tr.c. into same sp., 2 m., turn.

27th row—3 m., 1 d.tr.c., 3 tr.c. into next sp., 1 f.m., 3 tr.c., 1 d.tr.c. into sts., finish together, ch. 3, 1 m., ch. 8, 1 tr.c. into same, turn, 4 sl.sts.

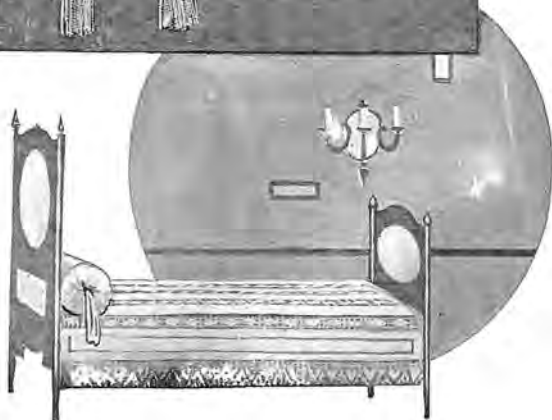
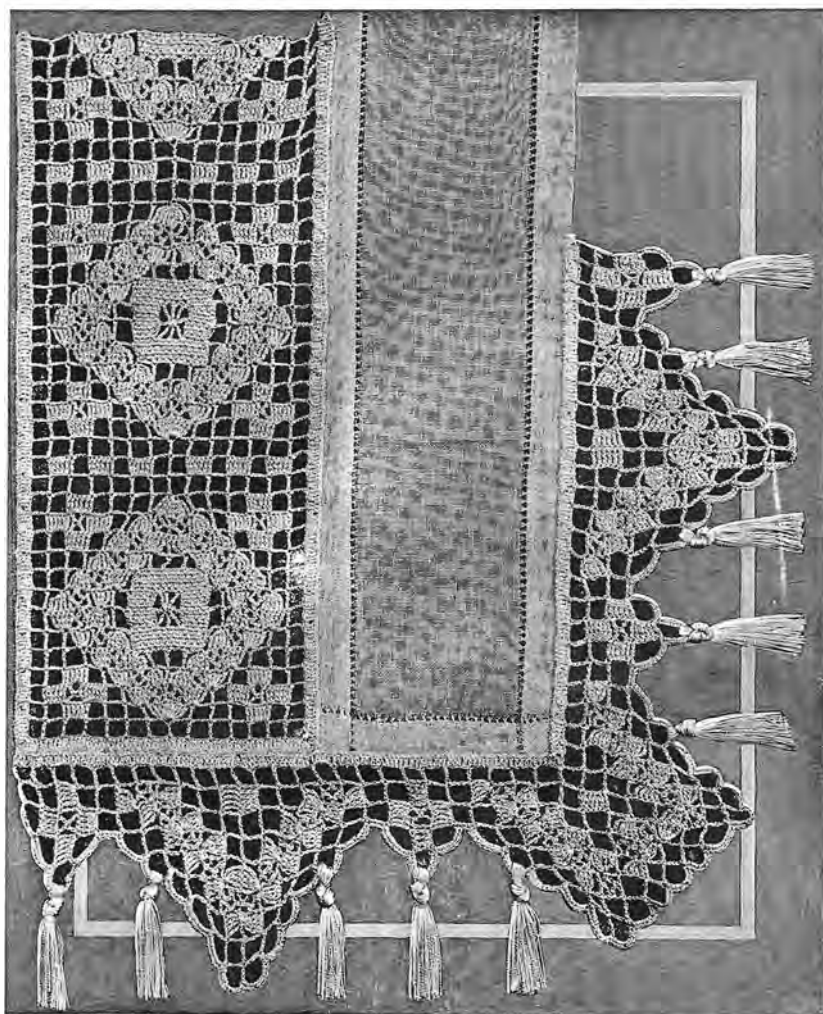

Make ch. for length required, 12 s.c., ch. 9, 1 s.c., 1 h.d.c., 1 d.c., 2 tr.c., 2 d.t.r.c., 1 d.t.r.t.r.c., 1 sl.st. into 6th s.c., turn, sl.sts. all around petal, 3 s.c. into foundation ch., turn, ch. 8, form p. of 5 chs., ch. 8, p. of 5, chs. 4, 1 s.c. into point of petal, ch. 9, 1 p. of 5, ch. 8, 1 p. of 5, ch. 3, 1 sl.st. into the 4th s.c. from petal, turn, 1 s.c. into each st. around, 1 s.c. into next st. of foundation ch., turn 8 s.c., * 2 s.c. into next st., 2 s.c. into next 2 sts., repeat from * 3 times more, 8 s.c., 1 sl.st. into s.c. of foundation ch., 9 sl.sts., 1 p., 6 sl.sts., ch. 6, turn, 1 s.c. into 4th sl.st., turn, 3 sl.sts., 1 p., 3 sl.sts., 6 sl.sts. into next 6 s.c., ch. 6, turn, 1 s.c. into 4th sl.st., turn, 3 sl.sts., ch. 8, turn work, 1 s.c. 1 h.d.c., 1 d.c., 1 tr.c., 2 d.t.r.c., 1 d.t.r.t.r.c., 1 s.c. next to p., turn, 8 sl.sts. up to point of petal, ch. 11, join to ring, 25 s.c. into ring, join with sl.st. 7 sl.sts., down side of petal, 1 p., 3 sl.sts. into following chs., 2 s.c. into 2 s.c., 1 p., 9 sl.sts.

This finishes one point. Repeat from beginning.

On other side of foundation ch. 1 s.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 s.c., continue across. Finish off.

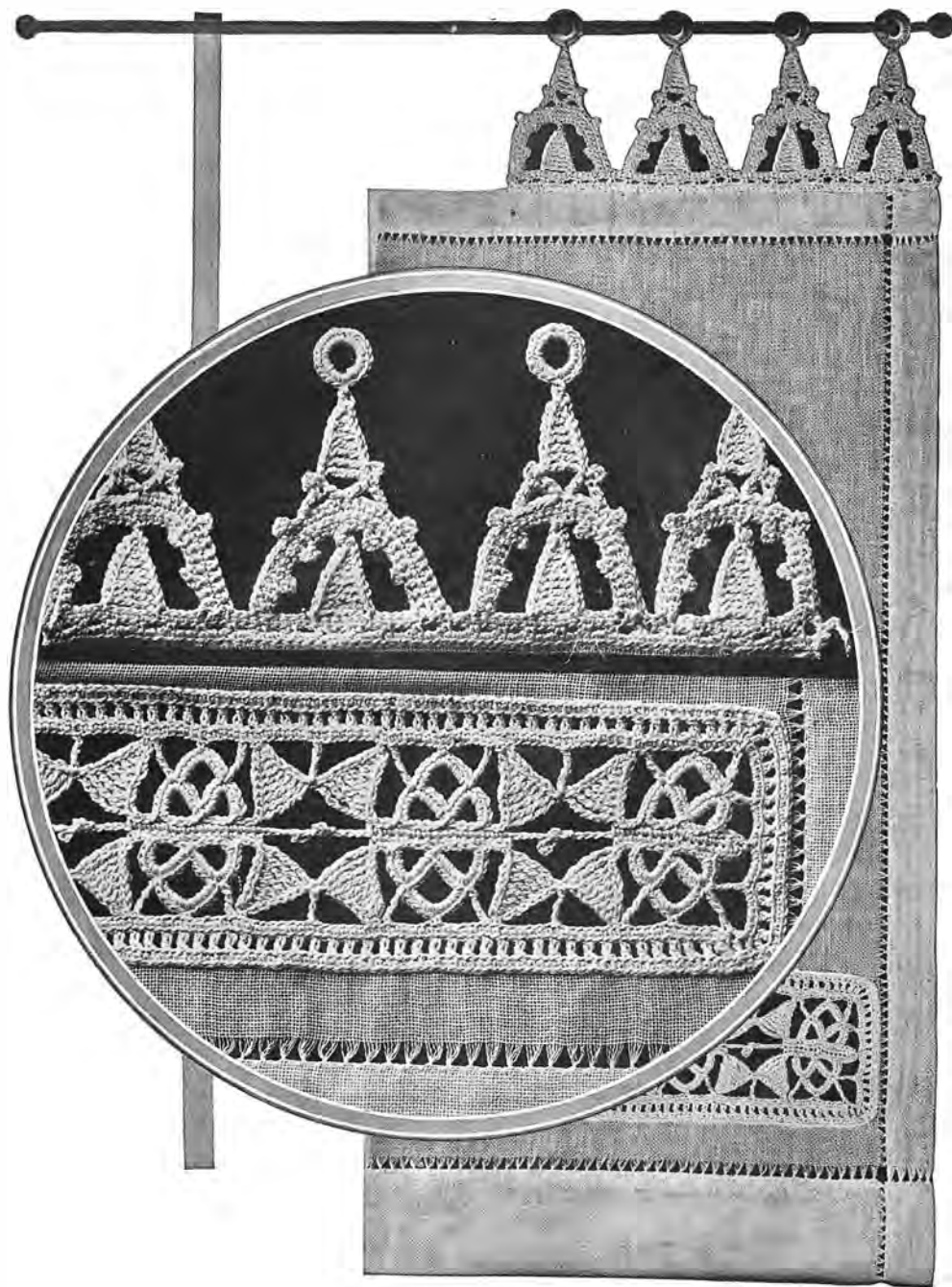

Ch. 4, 1 d.c. into center st. of 1st ch. 5, ch. 3, 1 d.c. into same, ch. 4, 1 s.c. into s.c. ch. 4, and repeat around.

Sl.sts. until 1st d.c., 1 s.c., 1 p., 1 s.c., 1 p., 1 s.c., 1 p., 1 s.c. all into space, ch. 3, 1 s.c. into next center space, 1 p., 1 s.c., 1 p., 1 s.c., 1 p., 1 s.c. into same space. Continue around.

Finish off. Repeat the same on other side.

Finish off and fasten at beginning. 5 s.c. into 1st hole, * 2 s.c., ch. 5, 1 p., 2 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c. into center hole, 5 s.c. into 3rd hole, 2 s.c. into hole of ch. 2, 3 s.c. into next hole, ch. 3, turn 1 s.c. into 3rd s.c. of 3rd hole, turn, 2 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c. into hole of ch. 3, 2 s.c. into unfinished hole, and repeat from *.

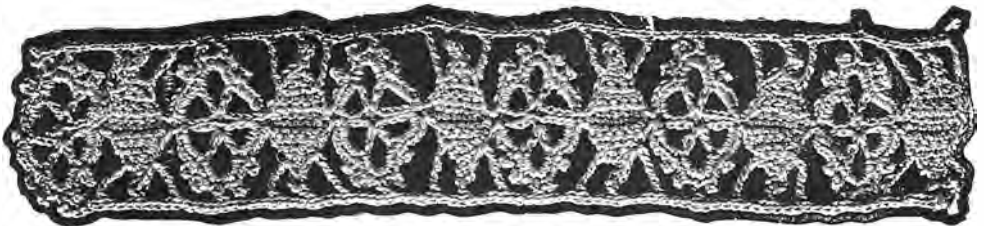

* ch. 12, turn, sk. 1, 1 s.c., ch. 1, sk. 1, 1 s.c., repeat this until 6 s.c. are made, turn, ch. 1, 1 s.c. into space of ch. 1, ch. 1, 1 s.c. into next space of ch. 1, repeat until 6 s.c. are made, make 4 more rows like the last, 6 rows in all.

Ch. 9, join 8 chs. to ring, 4 sl.sts. into the next 4 chs., 18 s.c. into the ring, join with sl.st., and repeat from * till the length required. Finish off.

1 s.c. into point of first square, ch. 9, form p. of 5 chs., ch. 4, 3 tr.c. into center st. of ring, ch. 9, form p. of 5 chs., ch. 4, 1 s.c. into corner of next square, repeat this for the length. Finish off. 1 s.c. into first st., 4 s.c. into hole till p., 4 s.c. into hole after p., 3 s.c. into 3 following sts., 4 s.c. into hole, before p., 4 s.c. into hole after p., 1 s.c. into next sp., and repeat for length. Turn, ch. 6, sk. 3, 1 d.c., ch. 3, sk. 3, 1 d.c., and repeat. Turn, 3 s.c. into 1st hole, 1 s.c. into sp., 1 p., 3 s.c. into next hole, 1 s.c. into sp., 1 p., and repeat for the length. Repeat the same on the other side. Finish off.

EDGING.

For edging, repeat the same as for insertion for center and one side. For scallop side. * 1 s.c. into point of square, ch. 4, 2 tr.c. into 2nd st. of ring, ch. 3, sk. 1, 2 tr.c., and repeat this twice more into ring. Ch. 4, 1 s.c. into next corner of square and repeat from * for length. Finish off.

Begin at other end. * 4 s.c. into 1st hole, 1 s.c. between 2 tr.c., 2 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c. into next hole, 1 s.c. between 2 tr.c., repeat this for two following holes, 4 s.c. into hole before square. 1 s.c. into sp., and repeat from *.

Balls, ch. 4, join to ring, 8 s.c. into ring, 2 s.c. into one, 1 s.c. into next until 12 s.c. 4 more rows each of 12 s.c., stuff solid with wadding, sk. 1, 1 s.c. until closed.

Leave $\frac{1}{2}$ -inch thread and fasten ball to center of each scallop.

ARABIAN MEDALLION

Materials required: ROYAL SOCIETY Tan Crochet Cotton 1010, size 3; Crochet Hook No. 4

Ch. 14, sk. 5, 1 d.c., ch. 1, sk. 1, 1 d.c., ch. 1, continue for 5 holes, turn, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into first sp., continue row and repeat for 3 more rows. 2 s.c. into each of 3 following holes, (*). Turn, ch. 9, sk. 1, 1 sl.st. turn, 3 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c., all into hole, 2 s.c. into next hole, 5 s.c. into corner hole, 2 s.c. into 2 following holes, and repeat from (*) 3 times. Join with sl.st.

Ch. 7, 1 s.c. into 2nd p., ch. 7, 1 s.c. into 4th p., ch. 7, 1 s.c. into corner st. Repeat around. Join with sl.st.

(*) 3 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c. into 1st hole, 2 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c. into 2nd hole, 3 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c. into 3rd hole. Repeat from (*) 3 times. Finish off.

LACE INSERTION AND EDGE

Materials required: ROYAL SOCIETY White Crochet Cotton, size 8; Crochet Hook No. 11

1st row—Make a chain for desired length, 7 s.c. into chs., 3 s.c. into next st. 7 s.c., sk. 2, and repeat from beginning. Finish off—always take up each rib.

2nd row—sk. 1st st., 7 s.c., 3 s.c. into center st., 7 s.c., sk. 2, and repeat. Finish off.

3rd row—1 d.c. into 4th st., ch. 1, sk. 1, 1 d.c., ch. 1, sk. 1, 1 d.c., ch. 7, 1 d.c. into point, ch. 7, 1 d.c. into next st., ch. 1, sk. 1, 1 d.c., ch. 1, sk. 1, 1 d.c., sk. 4, 1 d.c. Continue row. Finish off.

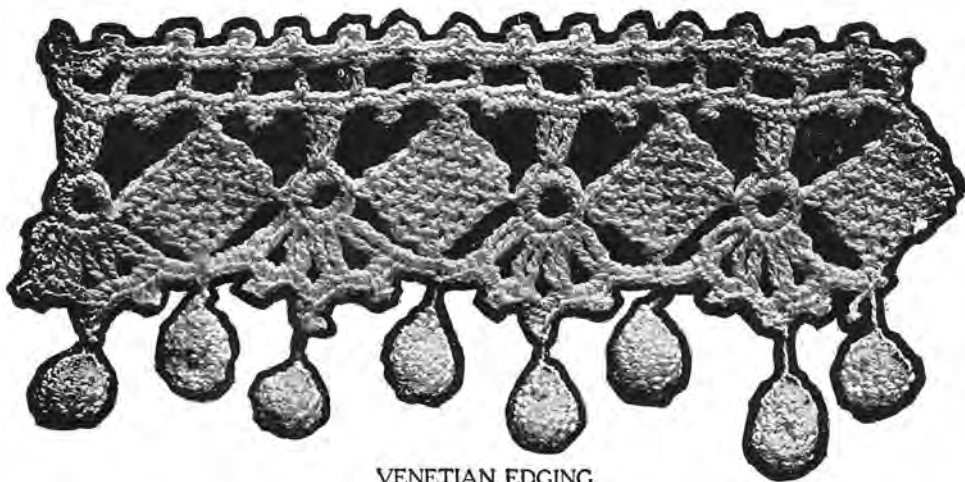

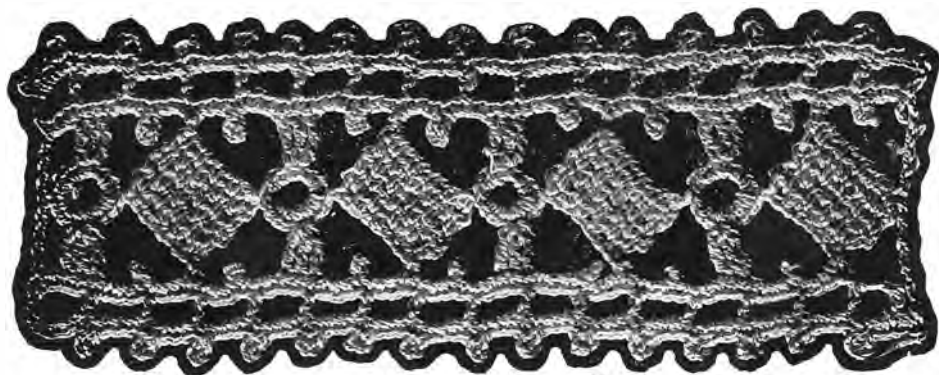

Turn, ch. 5, 7 d.c. from 3rd spoke, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into each hole, ch. 5, sk. 2, 7 d.c., ch. 5, 1 s.c. into hole. Turn, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into hole, ch. 5, skip 2, 3 d.c., ch. 5, 1 s.c. into hole, ch. 5, 3 d.c. into next hole, ch. 3, 3 d.c. into 3rd hole, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into 4th hole, ch. 5, skip 2, 3 d.c., ch. 5, 1 s.c. into hole, ch. 3, 1 d.c. into last st., turn. Ch. 5, 1 s.c. into 2nd hole, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into next hole, ch. 5, 3 d.c. into next hole, ch. 3, 1 d.c. into center hole, ch. 3, 3 d.c. into next hole, ch. 5, 1 s.c., ch. 5, 1 s.c., ch. 3, 1 d.c. into last hole. Turn, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into 1st hole, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into next hole, ch. 5, 3 d.c., ch. 3, 1 d.c. into next hole, 1 d.c. into spoke, 1 d.c. into other hole, ch. 3, 3 d.c., ch. 5, 1 s.c., ch. 5, 1 s.c., ch. 3, 1 d.c. Turn.

Ch. 5, 1 s.c. into 1st hole, ch. 5, 1 s.c., ch. 5, 3 d.c., ch. 3, 1 d.c. into center spoke, ch. 3, 3 d.c. into next hole, ch. 5, 1 s.c., ch. 5, 1 s.c., ch. 3, 1 d.c., turn, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into 2nd hole, ch. 5, 1 s.c., ch. 5, 3 d.c., ch. 3, 3 d.c., ch. 5, 1 s.c., ch. 5, 1 s.c., ch. 3, 1 d.c., turn. Ch. 5, 1 s.c. into 2nd hole, ch. 5, continue until 6 holes are made. Ch. 3, 1 d.c. into last spoke. Turn ch. 5, 1 s.c. into 2nd hole, continue row until 5 holes, ch. 3, 1 d.c. into last hole. Turn ch. 5, 1 s.c. into 2nd hole, continue until 4 holes, ch. 3, 1 d.c. Turn, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into 2nd hole, continue until 3 holes, ch. 3, 1 d.c., turn, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into 2nd hole, continue until 3 holes. Finish off. Make 3 more pieces the same way.

Join pieces by placing two together, 2 s.c. into first hole from top, 1 p. 2 s.c. into next hole, 1 p. Repeat the same into each hole, until 12 p. are made.

After the pieces are joined, make 1 s.c. into each st. around the bottom, join with sl.st. At the top, 7 d.c. into each hole, join with sl.st. Make another row, 3 s.c., ch. 3, p. sk. 1, 3 s.c. and repeat around.

FRINGES.

Take a double thread about 4 inches, double again, pull through stitch. Make ch. pull out, tie tight and cut loops.

To make raised rose, start with three loops of dark shade of pink and 2 stitches across loops to hold them in place. Then make 2 rows of big loose Back Stitch of the same color, and 3 rows of light shade in the same way. Then work green leaves around rose with 4 or 5 stitches in each leaf, as shown in cut.

 14th row—7 m., 10 d.c., 1 m., 10 d.c., 2 m., 7 d.c., 2 m. Turn.

 16th row—7 m., 10 d.c., 2 m., 16 d.c., 3 m. Turn.

 4th row—ch. 5, 4 m., 7 d.c. Turn.
 5th row—ch. 5, 2 m., 4 d.c., 2 m. Turn.
 6th row—3 sl.sts., ch. 5, 4 m. Turn.
 7th row—ch. 3, 4 d.c., 2 m. Turn.
 8th row—3 sl.sts., ch. 5, 2 m. Turn.
 9th row—ch. 5, 1 m. Turn, 5 sl.sts.
 10th row—4 m., 7 d.c., 1 sl.st. at bottom of ch. 7. This row is worked across the last 9 rows. Turn.
 11th row—4 d.c., 4 m. Turn. This finishes corner.

PROCEED FOR NARROW SIDE.

- 12th row—3 sl.sts., 4 m., ch. 7, 1 s.c. into sp. Turn.
 13th row—ch. 6, 1 s.c., ch. 3, 2 m., 4 d.c., 1 m. Turn.
 14th row—4 m., ch. 3, 1 s.c., ch. 3, 1 d.c. Turn.
 15th row—ch. 10, 4 d.c., 3 m., ch. 5, 1 d.c. into same. Turn, 3 sl.sts.
 16th row—ch. 7, 1 d.c. into last sl.st., 3 m., 7 d.c., ch. 7, 1 d.c. Turn.
 17th row—ch. 6, 1 s.c., ch. 3, 13 d.c., 2 m., ch. 5, 1 d.c. into same. Turn.
 18th row—5 sl.sts., ch. 5, 4 m., 7 d.c., ch. 3, 1 s.c., ch. 3, 1 d.c. Turn.
 19th row—ch. 10, 4 d.c., 4 m. Turn.
 20th row—3 sl.sts., 4 m., ch. 7, 1 d.c. Turn.
 21st row—ch. 6, 1 s.c., ch. 3, 2 m., 4 d.c., 1 m. Turn.
 22nd row—ch. 7, 1 d.c. into same, 2 m., 4 d.c., 1 m., ch. 3, 1 s.c., ch. 3, 1 d.c. Turn.
 23rd row—ch. 6, 1 s.c., ch. 3, 2 m., 4 d.c., 1 m. Turn. Make 1 more scallop for narrow side, repeat corner and half of edge is finished. Then repeat from the very beginning.
 Around scallop make 1 row of s.c. (into holes between 2 scallops 2 s.c. into each, into the 2 following 5 s.c. each, into point 8 s.c.). Into the inside edge make 1 row of d.c. into each st.

For insertion follow instructions for scarf, making each piece $6\frac{1}{2}$ inches long.

Place medallion into center of Pin Cushion and attach insertion into center at each side of medallion. Then place edge around cushion close to the medallion.

the last 3 chs. into a ring and repeat the solid circle. After half of last row of circle is made join to 5th ch. of the remaining 10 chs. and finish row of circle. Repeat the triangles, then the open circle and so on until the border is long enough. Finish off.

Connecting bars—Onto the solid circle, 1 s.c. into the 8th st. from the connecting line between triangles, ch. 2, 1 tr.c. into the 4th st., ch. 4, 1 tr.c. into the next st. from connecting line, pull thread through 2 loops only. Keep the rest on the needle. 1 tr.c. into center st. of connecting line, pull thread through 3 times through 2 loops, 1 d.c. into next st. from line. Pull thread through 5 times, through 2 loops at a time, ch. 4, 1 d.c. into corner of triangle, ch. 4, 1 tr.c. into 5th row of triangle. Ch. 4, 1 d.tr.c. into the 8th row of the same triangle. Pull thread twice through 2 loops, 1 tr.c. into the 3rd row of the opposite triangle. Pull thread through remaining loops 2 at a time. Ch. 4, 1 tr.c. into center of the 3 bars to form a cross, ch. 4, 1 tr.c. into 6th row of triangle. Ch. 4, 1 d.c. into corner of same triangle. Ch. 4, 1 d.tr.c. into the next stitch of connecting line of triangle. Pull thread through 2 loops only. 1 tr.c. into center of line, 1 d.c. into p. next to connecting line, work off all the loops on needle ch. 4. 1 d.c. into next p. Ch. 2, 1 s.c. into next p. Ch. 2, 1 d.c. into following p. Ch. 4, continue across row. Make other side of insertion the same way. Finish off. 1 row of s.c. all across, into the holes of ch. 4, 4 s.c. and into the holes of ch. 2, 2 s.c., 1 s.c. into sp. Turn, make another row of s.c. Turn, make a 3rd row of s.c. and picots (5 s.c. between each picot).

SCARF AND CENTER No. 6101

CENTERPIECE

For the medallion of the centerpiece follow the diagram of Pillow until the 7th row. Then make 4 s.c. into each hole, 1 s.c. into each sp., 9 s.c. into the corner hole continue all around to starting point, sl.sts. to the corner, make another row of s.c. all around. Into corner st. 3 s.c. Into last st. of row 1 sl.st., ch. 125 for edge. Turn, 125 s.c., skip 1 s.c. of medallion. Make another row of s.c. around medallion. 3 s.c. into corners. Continue 1 s.c. into each st. of edge. At the end 2 sl.st. Continue 5 s.c., 1 p. at top of edge, skip 1 st. of edge and 1st of medallion, 1 s.c., 1 p., 5 s.c., 1 p., continue around 3 sides. When p. in 3rd corner has been made, 3 s.c., ch. 8, sk. 5, 1 s.c., repeat this for 6 loops, 1 s.c. into each along edge. Turn (*), 2 s.c., ch. 4, sk. 3, 1 s.c., ch. 4, skip 3, 3 s.c., ch. 7, skip 4, 1 s.c., ch. 7, skip 4, 3 s.c. Repeat from (*) 4 times, ch. 4, skip 3, 1 s.c., ch. 4, skip 3, 7 s.c., 1 sl.st. Finish off and begin at the 4th side of medallion, 1 s.c. into st. before loops, 9 s.c. into 5 loops, 5 s.c. into last. Turn, ch. 8, 5 loops. Turn, 9 s.c. into 4 loops, 5 into 5th. Turn, ch. 8, 4 loops. Turn, 9 s.c. into 1st, 5 s.c. into 2nd loop. Turn, ch. 8, 1 loop. Turn, 9 s.c. into loop, 5 s.c. into the remaining half loop. Finish the other 2 loops the same. 5 s.c. into the remaining 2 half loops, 1 sl.st. Turn, make 2 rows of s.c. around border decreasing with 2 sts. between points at each row, 3 s.c. into corner st. Continue 5 s.c. (*). Into 1st loop of edge 4 s.c., 1 s.c. into spoke, 4 s.c. into next loop. Turn, skip 1, 8 s.c. Turn, continue decreasing 1 st. at each row until 9 rows are made. When 1st is left, 9

sl.st. down side of triangle, 1 s.c. into each of following, 3 s.c., 8 s.c. into next loop, 4 s.c. into following. Turn, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into center of 1st scallop. Turn, 8 s.c. into loop, 4 s.c. into the remaining half loops, 3 s.c. Repeat from (*). Finish off and begin from the last p. around medallion. Make 1 row of p. around border and edge. Repeat four times for 36-inch center. For 27-inch center repeat medallion only three times with enough of the edging to reach between the medallions.

SCARF.

For big medallion follow the diagram for Pillow until the 10th row, then begin the border. Turn, 3 s.c., ch. 9 times 8, sk. always 5, 1 s.c., make 9 loops, 9 s.c. into 1st loop, into the next loop 5 s.c. Turn, ch. 8, 1 loop, turn 9 s.c. into the loop, 5 s.c. into the remaining half loop. 9 s.c. into each of next 4 loops, 5 s.c. into the 5th, turn, ch. 8, make 4 loops, 9 s.c. into 3 loops, 5 s.c. into the 4th, turn and continue decreasing until 1 loop is left, then fill the 4 remaining half loops each with 5 s.c. The 2 remaining loops finish like the 2 at beginning, 1 sl.st. into next s.c., turn, 2 rows of s.c. around border, decreasing 2 s.c. between points at each row, 5 s.c., 1 p. all around the medallion. Be sure to have 1 p. at each corner. Turn, around border 1 row of 5 ch. always fasten between p. into the small point fasten once with s.c. twice with d.c. Between the points with s.c. at the big point once with s.c., 6 times with d.c. and continue and finish row with s.c., turn, dot into 1st loop, 3 s.c., 3 h.d.c., into sp. 1 d.c., into next loop 6 d.c., into sp. 1 d.c., into next loop 9 d.c., into sp. 1 d.c., into last loop of small point 3 h.d.c. and 3 s.c. Into 1st loop of big point 6 s.c., into sp. 1 h.d.c., into next loop 6 h.d.c., into sp. 1 d.c., into each of next 2 loops 6 d.c., into each sp. 1 d.c., into center loop 9 d.c., and continue row the same way. Turn, 1 row of loops for fringes. Ch. 5, sk. 4, 1 s.c., repeat this till 5 loops on small point, between points, sk. 3 of each, ch. 3, 1 s.c., ch. 5, sk. 4, repeat till 11 loops around big point, continue row. Finish off.

FRINGES.

Wind cotton 10 times around cardboard 6½ inches long, cut and pull through the second loop of small point, take all 20 threads together, make a knot. Make another fringe the same way into the 4th and 5th loop, 1 into the loop between points, sk. 1 loop, 1 into each loop around big point, finish the other side the same way.

SCARF—SIDE MEDALLION.

Center round, ch. 3, join to ring, 8 s.c. into the ring, continue without joining 2 into each, till 16, then 1 s.c. into one, 2 s.c. into the next, till 24, 1 row, 1 s.c. into each, join with sl.st.

1st row—Ch. 5, sk. 2, 1 s.c., repeat 7 times.

2nd row—4 s.c., 1 p., 4 s.c. into 1st hole and repeat all round, join with sl.st., 5 sl.st. to top of p.

3rd row—(*) ch. 7, 1 s.c. into next p., turn 8 s.c. into the hole, turn, sk. 1, 7 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 6 s.c., turn, sk. 2, 4 s.c., turn, sk. 2, 2 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 1 s.c., 6 sl.st. down side of triangle, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into next p., turn 6 s.c. into hole, turn, ch. 5, sk. 2, 2 s.c., turn 8 s.c. into hole of ch. 5, and 2 s.c. into hole of ch. 7, turn, 2 d.c. into one, 1 d.c. into the next of 8 s.c. till 12 d.c. to form scallop. Join with sl.st. into picot and repeat from (*).

4th row—12 s.c. over triangle and 12 s.c. over scallop continue to starting point, 6 sl.st. till top of 1st triangle.

5th row—(*) Ch. 3, 1 d.c. into 3rd s.c. at side of triangle, ch. 3, 1 d.c. into 4th s.c. of scallop, ch. 3, 1 tr.c. into center of scallop, ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into the same, ch. 3, 1 d.c. into 3rd, s.c. on other side of scallop, ch. 3, 1 d.c. into 3rd s.c. at side of triangle, ch. 3, 1 s.c. into point of triangle. Repeat from (*) and join with sl.st.

6th row—3 s.c. into each hole, 1 s.c. into sps., 7 s.c. into corner hole, 3 s.c. into 2nd corner, turn.

(*) Make 2 rows of 30 s.c. at same side from corner to corner, turn, ch. 5, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., repeat until 9 holes are made, ch. 5, 1 sl.st. into the last s.c., turn, 7 s.c. into corner holes, 3 s.c. into each of the other holes, 3 s.c. into the 3 rows of s.c. Continue next two sides with 3 s.c. into holes, 1 s.c. into sps. and 7 s.c. into corner hole, 3 s.c. into the 4th corner and repeat from (*). Finish till starting point. Continue with sl.sts. till end of side.

7th row—1 s.c. into each, 3 s.c. into corners, turn.

Border—2 sl.st., 7 loops of 8 ch. always sk. 5, turn, 9 s.c. into 1st hole, 5 s.c. into the next, turn, ch. 8, 1 loop, turn, 9 s.c. into the loop, 5 s.c. into the remaining half loop, 9 s.c. into the 2 following loops, 5 s.c. into the next, turn, ch. 8, 2 loops, 9 s.c. into 1 loop, 5 s.c. into next, turn, 1 loop, turn 9 s.c. into the loop and 5 s.c. into the 3 remaining half loops, finish the last 2 loops like the 2 1st ones. Turn, around border 1 row of 1 s.c. into each, between points sk. 2 s.c. Continue around medallion and border 5 s.c., 1 p. Be sure to have 1 p. at each corner, turn.

Around border 1 row of loops of 5 chs. fasten between the p. twice into the small point with d.c. between points with 1 s.c. into the big point 4 times with d.c. and continue, finish the row with s.c., turn, into the 1st loop, 3 s.c. and 3 h.d.c., into sp. 1 d.c., into the center loops 9 d.c., into sp. 1 d.c. into the next loop 3 h.d.c. and 3 s.c.

Into the 1st loop of big point 3 s.c. and 3 h.d.c., into sp. 1 d.c., into next loop 6 d.c., into sp. 1 d.c., into center loop 9 d.c., continue the row the same way. Turn, 1 row of loops for fringes, ch. 5, sk. 4, 1 s.c., repeat till 4 loops are made into the small point, between points, ch. 3, sk. 3 of each point 1 s.c., ch. 5, sk. 4, repeat till 5 loops are made into the big point, continue row, and finish off.

Make fringes as directed one into the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th loop of small points, 1 between points, 1 into the 1st, 2nd, and center loop of big point, finish the other side the same way.
