## MORNING GLORY

FEMININE AND GLAMOROUS, CROCHETED FLOWER MOTIFS
BLOSSOM INTO AN ENCHANTINGLY DELICATE PATTERN.

AFGHAN No. 6000-A

Approximately 53 x 65 Inches

WOOL, 24 skeins (1 oz. skeins) of Light Rose, 22 skeins of Renaissance Rose, and 12 skeins of Violet.

MILWARD'S STEEL CROCHET HOOK No. 2/0 (double zero).

GAUGE: Hexagon measures  $5\frac{1}{2}$  inches from point to opposite point;  $5\frac{1}{4}$  inches from side to side. Each side measures 3 inches.

HEXAGON . . . Starting at center, with Violet ch 3, join with sl st. 1st rnd: Ch 3 (to count as d c), d c in ring, \* ch 1, 2 d c in ring. Repeat from \* 4 more times, ch 1, join to 3rd st of ch-3. 2nd rnd: \* Ch 6, tr tr at base of ch-6 (in 1st d c of 2-d c group), tr tr in next d c, ch 6, sl st in same d c, s c in ch-1 sp, sl st in next d c. Repeat from \* around, ending with s c in ch-1 sp, sl st at base of starting ch-6. Fasten off. 3rd rnd: Attach Light Rose at a tr tr, s c in same st, \* s c in next tr tr and in top ch of ch-6 following; half d c in next ch of same ch-6, d c in next ch, s c in next ch, s c in tr tr. Repeat from \* around, ending with s c in top of ch-6; join. 4th rnd: Ch 3, yarn over, insert hook in 2nd ch from hook and




CHART FOR JOINING OF MOTIFS

draw loop through; yarn over, insert hook in next ch and draw loop through; yarn over, insert hook in next st of previous rnd and draw loop through; yarn over and draw through all 7 loops on hook, ch 1 tightly (a group); yarn over, insert hook in ch-1 of group just made and draw loop through; yarn over, insert hook under 1 strand of previous group and draw loop through; yarn over, insert hook in next st of previous rnd and draw loop through; yarn over and draw through all loops, ch 1 tightly (another group); ch 2 more, make another group like previous one in same st of previous rnd (an increase—this is corner of hexagon). Continue to work a group in each st around, making ch-2 and an extra group at each corner. Join and break off. (The following 3 rnds flatten the edges of the hexagon.) 5th rnd: Attach Renaissance Rose at a ch-1 sp between groups, ch 1 (to count as s c), s c in each ch-1 around and in ch-2 sps at corners. Join. 6th rnd: Ch 1, s c in each s c around. Join. 7th rnd: Ch 1, s c in each s c around, making 3 s c in st directly above corner increases. Join and break off. Make 142 hexagons and sew together as in chart with neat over-and-over stitches on wrong side.

Work 2 Violet tassel-fringes along each short row of hexagons as follows: Draw ten 11-inch strands through stitch. Form a loop and draw all ends through loop to form a knot. Trim all fringe evenly to length of long rows.

PILLOW No. 6000-B

MATERIALS: CHADWICK'S RED HEART AFGHAN WOOL, 4 skeins (1 oz. skeins) of Renaissance Rose, 4 skeins of Light Rose and 2 skeins of Violet.

MILWARD'S STEEL CROCHET HOOK No. 2/0 (double zero).

A round pillow, 15 inches in diameter.

Make 14 hexagons as for Afghan. Join 7, as in illustration, for each side of pillow. Block pieces. Sew sides together, inserting pillow, and tack securely along circumference. Make 6 tassel-fringes as for Afghan.





## MODERNE

## **FLEETWOOD**

INTRODUCE A NOTE OF RICHNESS WITH SUBTLE SHADED COLORS, DRAMATIC TEXTURE AND SIMPLICITY OF DESIGN.

AFGHAN No. 698 Illustrated on opposite page
Approximately 50 x 73 Inches

WOOL, 34 skeins (1 oz. skeins) of Renaissance Blue for Afghan stitch strips. For narrow strips, 6 skeins of Wine Rose; 5 skeins each of Tapestry Rose, Renaissance Rose and Antique Rose; and 3 skeins of Light Rose.

A casein Afghan hook No. 6 (4½ mm. size). MILWARD'S CASEIN CROCHET HOOK No. 6.

GAUGE: (Afghan stitch) 5 sts make 1 inch; 5 rows make 1 inch.

AFGHAN STITCH STRIPS (Make 5) . . . Starting at narrow end, with Renaissance Blue and Afghan hook ch 35. 1st row: Insert hook in back loop of 2nd ch from hook and pull loop through; draw up a loop in each of next 33 ch, retaining all loops on hook (35 loops). This is half of row. Work other half as follows: Yarn over and pull through 1 loop; \* yarn over and pull through next 2 loops on hook. Repeat from \* across until 1 loop remains on hook. 2nd row: \* Insert hook in vertical bar of next loop and pull loop through. Repeat from \* across. Now work other half of row as before. Continue in this manner until piece measures 70 inches. Fasten off. Work a row of s c along both long edges.

CLUSTER STRIPS (Make 4) ... Attach Wine Rose to right-hand corner at bottom of one Afghan stitch strip, and work along one long side as follows: 1st row: Ch 2, \* insert hook in same st where s c was made and pull loop through; draw this loop out to measure 3/4 inch; yarn over. Repeat from \* 3 more times; draw through all loops on hook (a loopcluster). \*\* Skip 2 sts, s c in next st, ch 2 and complete another loop-cluster. Repeat from \*\* across, ending with s c in last st. Fasten off. 2nd row: Attach Tapestry Rose, ch 2 and complete a loop-cluster at tip of 1st cluster, \* s c at tip of next cluster, ch 2 and complete a cluster as before. Repeat from \* across, ending with s c in 2nd st of turning ch. 3rd, 4th and 5th rows: Same as 2nd row, using Renaissance Rose for 3rd row, Antique Rose for 4th row, and Light Rose for 5th row. 6th to 9th rows incl: Repeat 4th, 3rd, 2nd and 1st rows. Fasten off.

Sew strips together, having Afghan stitch strips at outer edges. With Wine Rose work a row of s c all around, making 3 s c at each corner; join. Now work a rnd of s c in each of these colors: Tapestry Rose, Renaissance Rose, Antique Rose and Light Rose, making 3 s c at corners and joining at end of each rnd. Now work another rnd of Wine Rose. Join and break off.

AFGHAN No. 697

Illustrated on cover

Approximately 62 x 75 Inches

WOOL, 17 skeins (1 oz. skeins) each of Antique Rose, Renaissance Rose and Tapestry Rose; 11 skeins each of Gobelin Blue, Flemish Blue and Renaissance Blue; 9 skeins of Light Rose; and 6 skeins of Dusty Blue.

MILWARD'S CASEIN CROCHET HOOK No. 6. GAUGE: 5 sts make 1 inch; 5 rows make 1 inch.

FIRST LARGE STRIP . . . Starting at short end, with Light Rose ch 9. 1st row: Insert hook in 2nd ch and draw up a loop; draw up a loop in each ch across, retaining all loops on hook (9 loops on hook); yarn over and draw through 1 loop, \* yarn over and draw through 2 loops. Repeat from \* across. The loop which remains on hook always counts as the 1st st of next row. 2nd and 3rd rows: Insert hook under 2nd vertical bar and draw loop through, \* insert hook under next vertical bar and draw a loop through. Repeat from \* across, retaining all loops on hook and working to within last bar; insert hook through double vertical bar and draw a loop through (thus giving a firm edge to this side—9 loops on hook); yarn over and draw through 1 loop. \*\* Yarn over and draw through 2 loops. Repeat from \*\* across. 4th row: Make a loop in each vertical bar until there are 4 loops on hook; yarn over 3 times, insert hook in 2nd vertical bar on the 3rd row down (1st row) and draw a loop through; (yarn over and draw through 2 loops) 3 times; yarn over 3 times, skip 5 bars of same row and draw a loop through the next vertical bar; (yarn over and draw through 2 loops) 4 times—thus making a herringbone st; skip the st directly behind herringbone st just made and make a loop in each of next 4 vertical bars (9 loops on hook); yarn over and draw through 1 loop; \* yarn over and draw through 2 loops. Repeat from \* across. 5th row: Same as 2nd row. Repeat 4th and 5th rows alternately until piece measures 72 inches. SI st in each vertical bar across. Fasten off.

Make 2 more strips like this with Antique Rose, and sew one on each side of previous strip with neat over-and-over stitches on wrong side. Now make 2 strips of Renaissance Rose and sew one to side of each previous strip as before. Make 2 strips of Tapestry Rose and sew to previous strips as before. This completes one large strip. Make 2 more large strips like this.

SECOND LARGE STRIP... With Dusty Blue make 1 strip. With Gobelin Blue make 2 strips and sew

## PRIMROSE PATH

THE CHARM AND ELEGANCE OF DRESDEN CHINA IS CAPTURED IN PASTEL FLOWERS ON A PORCELAIN WHITE BACKGROUND.

AFGHAN No. 699-A

Approximately 48 x 66 Inches

MATERIALS: CHADWICK'S RED HEART AFGHAN WOOL, 27 skeins (1 oz. skeins) of White, 5 skeins Dusty Pink, 5 skeins Lilac, 4 skeins Mauve and 3 skeins Tapestry Green.

MILWARD'S PHANTOM KNITTING PINS, 1 pair No. 6  $(4\frac{1}{4} mm. size)$ .

MILWARD'S STEEL CROCHET HOOK No. 1/0. Quilted satin for lining.

Strips are knitted entirely in stockinette st (k 1 row, p 1 row), changing colors as indicated on chart and always twisting colors on wrong side of work. Each square on chart equals 1 stitch.

GAUGE: 6 sts make 1 inch; 6 rows make 1 inch.


FIRST STRIP ... With White cast on 49 sts and p across. 1st row: K 23 with White; attach Tapestry Green and k 3; k 23 with White. 2nd row: P 20 White, p 1 Green, p 1 White, p 5 Green, p 1 White, p 1 Green, p 20 White. 3rd row: K 21 White, k 2 Green, k 1 White, k 1 Green, k 1 White, k 2 Green, k 21 White. 4th row: P 21 White, p 1 Green, p 2 White, p 1 Green, p 2 White, p 1 Green, p 21 White. Break off Green. 5th row: K 20 White, attach Dusty Pink and k 1, k 2 White, k 3 Pink, k 2 White, k 1 Pink, k 20 White. 6th row: P 19 White, p 2 Pink, p 1 White, p 5 Pink, p 1 White, p 2 Pink, p 19 White. 7th row: K 18 White, k 4 Pink, k 1 White, k 3 Pink, k 1 White, k 4 Pink, k 18 White. 8th row: P 14 White, attach Lilac and p 1, p 3 White, p 13 Pink, p 3 White, p 1 Lilac, p 14 White. 9th row: K 13 White, k 2 Lilac, k 4 White, k 4 Pink; attach Green and k 3, k 4 Pink, k 4 White, k 2 Lilac, k 13 White. Starting at 10th row from bottom, follow chart to top. Then repeat entire chart 6 more times. Bind off. Block strip to measure 8 x 61 inches. With Mauve work a row of s c along right side of one long edge, keeping work flat. Fasten off. With Lilac, work s c in back loop of each Mauve s c. Fasten off. Finish other long edge in same way. Make 2 more strips same as this.

SECOND STRIP... With White cast on 49 sts and p across. Work as for first strip, starting at 27th row from bottom and follow chart to top. Then repeat entire chart 6 more times. Now work from 1st to 26th rows incl. Bind off. Block and finish long edges exactly as for first strip. Make another strip same as this.

With Lilac join first and second strips alternately, using overhand sewing and catching 1 loop of Lilac s c on each strip. Work Mauve and Lilac s c along remaining edges.

**FRINGE...** Cut a cardboard strip 4 inches wide and 5 inches long. With right side of work toward you, attach White, insert crochet hook, yarn over and draw out a loop, place loop over width of cardboard; insert hook in next st, yarn over and draw out a loop, place over cardboard as before. Continue in this manner until cardboard is covered with loops. Do not break off but, with a second ball of White, make a chain along top edge of cardboard, making a st in top of each loop. Drop 2nd strand of yarn when all loops have been fastened, slip out cardboard, pick up 1st strand of yarn and continue to make loops as before. Continue thus until loops are made all around edges of Afghan. Break off both strands. Fold the row of loops in half and whip down the chain-edge to wrong side with sewing thread. Line Afghan with quilted satin.

WOOL, 44 skeins (3/4 oz. skeins) of Mexicana and 24 skeins (1 oz. skeins) of Black.

MILWARD'S CASEIN CROCHET HOOK No. 5.

GAUGE: When joined, motif measures 53/4 inches between opposite corners.

MOTIF... Starting at center, with Mexicana ch 3, join with sl st. 1st rnd: Ch 3 (to count as d c); in ring make 2 d c, ch 3; (3 d c, ch 3) 3 times; join to ch-3 first made. 2nd rnd: Ch 3, \* in next ch-3 sp (corner) make 3 d c, ch 3, 3 d c; repeat from \* 2 more times. In next ch-3 make 3 d c, ch 3, 2 d c; join. 3rd rnd: Ch 3, 2 more d c in sp between groups; \* in next ch-3 (corner) make 3 d c, ch 3, 3 d c; 3 d c in next sp. Repeat from \* to last corner; join. 4th rnd: Ch 3, 3 d c in next sp, \* in corner sp make 3 d c, ch 3, 3 d c; 3 d c in next 2 sps. Repeat from \* around, ending with 2 d c in sp preceding ch-3; join. Fasten off. Attach Black at sp following joining, ch 3 to count as d c; work around, making 3 d c in each sp, and (3 d c, ch 1, 3 d c) in each corner; join. Fasten off.

Make 158 motifs. See chart. Crochet motifs together with s c's on wrong side, picking up a single loop at back of each motif for each s c, thus forming ridges on right side.

motif at right. Keeping work flat, work s c to sp following next corner of same motif; ch 2, in next sp make 4 d c; ch 3, sl st in top of last d c made (p); 4 more d c in same sp (a shell), ch 2, s c in next sp, ch 2, 4 d c in next sp; 4 d c in 1st free sp on next motif, ch 2, s c in next sp, ch 2, shell in next sp, s c around to sp following corner of same motif. Continue thus around Afghan. Fasten off.



WOOL, 28 skeins (1 oz. skeins) of Antique Blue and 18 skeins of Pearl Grey.

MILWARD'S STEEL CROCHET HOOK No. 2/0 (double zero).

GAUGE: 9 sts make 2 inches; 3 rows make  $1\frac{1}{4}$  inches.

With Antique Blue make a chain 70 inches long (about 5 ch sts to 1 inch). 1st row: D c in 4th ch from hook, d c in each ch until there are 246 d c, counting turning ch as 1 d c. Cut off remaining chain. Ch 3, turn. 2nd row: D c in each d c across. Ch 3, turn. 3rd row: Repeat 2nd row. 4th row: D c in 8 d c; d c in next d c, leaving last 2 loops on hook; drop Blue, attach Grey and \* draw through 2 loops. Holding Blue along top of previous row and working over it, make d c in next 11 d c (thus concealing Blue); d c in next d c, leaving last 2 loops on hook; drop Grey, pick up Blue and draw through 2 loops. D c in next 15 d c, concealing Grey as before and leaving the last 2 loops of last d c on hook; drop Blue, pick up Grey. Repeat from \* across, ending with 12 Grey d c and 9 Blue d c. Ch 3, turn. Now work as follows, changing colors and concealing unused color as before. 5th row: 9 Blue, \* 3 Grey, 6 Blue, 3 Grey, 15 Blue. Repeat from \*, ending row with 3 Grey, 6 Blue, 3 Grey, 9 Blue. 6th row: Repeat 5th row. 7th row: 9 B, \* 21 G, 6 B. Repeat from \* across, ending with 12 G, 9 B. 8th row: 27 B, 3 G, 6 B, 3 G, \* 15 B, 3 G, 6 B, 3 G. Repeat from \* across, ending with 18 B. 9th row: 18 B, 3 G, 6 B, 3 G, \* 15 B, 3 G, 6 B, 3 G. Repeat from \* across, ending with 27 B. 10th row: 18 B, 21 G, \* 6 B, 21 G. Repeat from \* across, ending with 18 B. 11th row: Same as 8th row. 12th row: Same as 9th row. 13th row: 9 B, 12 G, \* 6 B, 21 G. Repeat from \* across, ending with 9 B. 14th and 15th rows: Same as 5th row. 16th row: Same as 13th row. 17th row: Same as 9th row. 18th row: Same as 8th row. 19th row: Same as 10th row. 20th row: Same as 9th row. 21st row: Same as 8th row. 22nd row: Same as 7th row. 23rd and 24th rows: Same as 5th row. 25th row: Same as 7th row. 26th row: Same as 8th row. 27th row: Same as 9th row. 28th row: Same as 10th row. 29th row: Same as 8th row. 30th row: Same as 9th row. Repeat 13th to 30th rows incl. 5 more times; then 13th to 24th rows incl. once more. Next row: Like 4th row. Work 3 rows Blue to correspond with other end. Fasten off. Block to measure 55 x 68 inches.

## **TROPHY**

WHETHER YOU KNIT OR CROCHET, MAKE A POPULAR CHEVRON AFGHAN. IN CRISP BRIGHT COLORS OR DARKER TONES.

AFGHAN No. 693

Approximately 52 x 78 Inches

WOOL, 27 skeins (1 oz. skeins) of Antique Green, and 9 skeins each of Lichen Green, Old Gold, Golden Fleece and White.

MILWARD'S PHANTOM KNITTING PINS, 1 pair No. 6 (41/4 mm. size).

GAUGE: 6 sts make 1 inch; 10 rows make 1 inch.

PATTERN STITCH . . . Cast on 66 sts. 1st row: Inc. in 1st st, k 30, k 2 tog. twice, k 30, inc. in last st. 2nd row: K across.

Repeat pattern, working colors as follows: \* 8 ridges (16 rows) of Lichen Green, 8 ridges Golden Fleece, 8 ridges Old Gold, 8 ridges White and 29 ridges of Antique Green. Repeat from \* 3 more times; now work 8 ridges each of Lichen Green, Golden Fleece, Old Gold, White, and Antique Green. Bind off. Make 5 more strips like this. Sew together with neat over-and-over stitches, matching stripes.

USE CHADWICK'S MOTH PROOFED AFGHAN WOOL
IN LOVELY TAPESTRY COLORS

AFGHAN No. 6006

Approximately 50 x 72 Inches

WOOL, 39 skeins (3/4 oz. skeins) of Shaded Browns, and 27 skeins (1 oz. skeins) of Antique Brown.

MILWARD'S STEEL CROCHET HOOK No. 2/0 (double zero).

GAUGE: Each chevron measures about 10 inches between points.

Starting at bottom with Brown, ch 310 (about 4 ch sts to 1 inch). 1st row: S c in 2nd ch from hook, s c in next 29 ch, \* 3 s c in next ch (inc.), s c in next 30 ch (a chevron completed); skip 1 ch (dec.), s c in next 30 ch. Repeat from \* until 5 chevrons are made. Cut off remaining chain. Ch 1, turn. Hereafter pick up only back loop of each s c, except 1st and last s c's of each row (to keep edges firm). 2nd row: Skip 1st s c, \* s c in next 30 s c, 3 s c in center st of 3-s c group, s c in next 30 s c, skip 2 s c at dec. Repeat from \* across, omitting next to last s c. Ch 1, turn. Repeat 2nd row until Brown measures 4 inches (take all measurements along straight edges at sides). Break off. Work 2½ inches Shaded Browns. Break off. Work 4 inches Brown (always be sure to have same number of rows in stripes of same measurement). Work 10 inches Shaded Browns. This completes color pattern. Repeat color pattern from beginning 2 more times. Work 4 inches Brown, 2½ inches Shaded Browns, 4 inches Brown. Fasten off.

## GREEN PASTURES

CROCHET THIS VERSATILE AFGHAN IN A JIFFY! USE A SMART SOLID COLOR.

AFGHAN No. 6001 Illustrated on page 13
Approximately 47 x 67 Inches

WOOL, 58 skeins (1 oz. skeins) of Lichen Green; and 2 skeins each of Antique Green and Golden Fleece.

MILWARD'S STEEL CROCHET HOOK No. 2/0 (double zero).

Starting at narrow end, with Lichen Green make a chain 55 inches long (5 ch sts to 1 inch). 1st row: S c in 2nd ch from hook, s c in each ch across until row measures 44 inches. Cut off remaining chain.

Ch 3, turn. 2nd row: \* Insert hook in 1st s c and pull loop through, drawing loop out to measure 1 inch; yarn over. Repeat from \* 5 more times, pull through all loops on hook, ch 1 to fasten (a loop-cluster). \*\* Skip 2 sts, s c in next s c, ch 3 and complete another loop-cluster in s c where last s c was made. Repeat from \*\* across. Ch 1, turn. 3rd row: S c in 1st s c, \* ch 2, s c in next s c. Repeat from \* across. Ch 3, turn. This stitch has a tendency to slant while the Afghan is being worked. This will, however, be taken care of in blocking. Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows alternately until piece measures 64 inches. Do not break off but work border as follows:

Approximately 47 x 67 Inches

WOOL, 23 skeins (1 oz. skeins) of Old Gold, 10 skeins Antique Green, 6 skeins Brique, and 5 skeins Beauvais Brown.

MILWARD'S STEEL CROCHET HOOK No. 1/0.
GAUGE: 5 sps make 2 inches; 2 rows make 1 inch.
Starting at short end with Old Gold, ch 237 (5 ch sts to 1 inch). 1st row: D c in 7th ch from hook, \* ch 1, skip 1 ch, d c in next ch. Repeat from \* across (116 sps). Ch 4, turn. 2nd row: Skip 1st d c, \* d c in next d c, ch 1. Repeat from \* across, ending with ch 1, skip 1 ch, d c in next ch. Ch 4, turn. Repeat 2nd row, changing colors as follows: \*\* 4 rows Old Gold, 2 rows Antique Green, 2 Brique, 4 Old Gold, 2 Antique Green, 2 Beauvais Brown. Repeat from \*\* 7 more times. Then repeat the 1st 12 rows once more. Fasten off. Block to measure 47 x 67 inches.

WEAVING ... Cut 4 strands of Antique Green, each 20 inches longer than length of Afghan and, starting at lower edge, weave these 4 strands in and out each space lengthwise, leaving center ridge of each color-stripe on top and taking care not to draw strands too tight in order to keep blocked measurements (leave extra length of strands free at each end for fringe). Fill in all other spaces in same manner, using colors as follows: another row of Green, 2 rows Brown, 4 Old Gold, 2 Brique, 2

FRINGE... Pick up 4 strands left free at one end of 1st row and make a knot close to Afghan. \* Knot together 4 strands of each of next 2 rows. Repeat from \* across. Trim ends evenly.

### PILLOW TOP No. 691-B

WOOL, 2 skeins (1 oz. skeins) of Old Gold, and 1 skein each of Antique Green, Beauvais Brown and Brique.

MILWARD'S STEEL CROCHET HOOK No. 1/0.

Pillow 14 x 18 inches.

Lining material.

Starting at long side, with Old Gold ch 95 (5 ch sts to 1 inch), and work in pattern as for Afghan until 4 Old Gold stripes are made (10 stripes in all). Fasten off. Darn and finish with fringe as for Afghan. Cover pillow with lining material and tack crocheted piece to pillow.

## **CALICO**

AS GAY AS OLD-FASHIONED CALICO. SQUARE CROCHETED MOTIFS JOIN TO MAKE A CHARMING COLONIAL DESIGN.

AFGHAN No. 6005 Illustrated on page 12
Approximately 52 x 72 Inches

WOOL, 40 skeins (1 oz. skeins) of Cardinal Red and 31 skeins of White.

MILWARD'S STEEL CROCHET HOOK No. 2/0 (double zero).

GAUGE: Each block measures about 5 inches between opposite corners.

BLOCK...With Red ch 5, join with sl st. 1st rnd: Ch 4 (to count as tr), 19 tr in ring. Insert hook in 4th st of ch-4 first made, drop Red and draw White through, thus joining rnd. 2nd rnd: With White, make s c over each tr-bar, inserting hook between 2 sts from wrong side of work and bringing it out between following 2 sts; join. 3rd rnd: Ch 6 (to count as d c and ch-3); working with White over White sts, make d c in sl st (corner); \* yarn over,


WOOL, 21 skeins (1 oz. skeins) of Light Rose, 21 skeins of Gobelin Blue and 10 skeins of Deep Purple.


MILWARD'S STEEL CROCHET HOOK No. 2/0 (double zero).

GAUGE: When joined, block measures 6 inches between opposite corners.

Starting at center, with Deep Purple ch 4, join. 1st rnd: Ch 3 (to count as d c); in ring make 2 d c, ch 2, 3 d c, ch 2, 3 d c, ch 2, 3 d c, ch 2, join to 3rd st of starting ch-3. 2nd rnd: Ch 2, yarn over, insert hook in top of ch-3 below and draw loop through; yarn over, insert hook in next d c and draw loop through; yarn over and draw through all loops on hook, ch 1 tightly (a group made). Yarn over, insert hook in same d c and draw loop through, yarn over, insert hook in next d c and draw loop through; complete group. \* Make a group in 1st ch of corner ch-2, ch 2 more, another group in next ch; make 2 groups as before over next 3-d c group. Repeat from \* around, ending with ch 2, group in 2nd ch of corner. Join and break off. 3rd rnd: Attach Gobelin Blue to 2nd ch of one corner, ch 3, make a group in same ch, insert hook in next group (not in ch-1) and draw loop through; yarn over, insert hook in ch-1 of same group and draw loop through; yarn over and draw through all loops, ch 1. Make a group above each of next 3 groups in same manner, 1 group in 1st ch of corner, ch 1 more, 1 group in next ch of corner; continue along second side, ending with 1 group in 1st ch of corner. Draw a Light Rose loop through Blue loop, drop Blue, ch 1 with Light Rose and work around remaining 2 sides of square.

Dashes in heavy squares in chart at right indicate 4 joined blocks. Detail below.





End with ch 1 more, join with s c (6 groups on each side). 4th rnd: Turn, sl st back to 1st ch-1 of corner, ch 2, make a group in last ch-1 made, 6 groups over next 6 groups, group in next ch, ch 1, group in next ch, 6 groups over next 6 groups, group in next ch, ch 2, draw Blue through Rose loop on hook, drop Rose, work around other 2 sides with Blue, drawing up last loop of last group in sp under s c to conceal color (8 groups on each side). End with ch-1, join with s c, turn. 5th rnd: Ch 2, group in last ch-1 made, work around 2 sides as before, ending 2nd side with ch 2 (including ch-1 of group). Pick up Rose as before, ch 1, and continue around remaining 2 sides (10 groups on each side); join. Fasten off securely. This completes 1 block.

Make 172 blocks and sew together neatly, on wrong side, as in chart (see illustration).



insert hook in same st where last st was made, yarn over and draw through 2 loops; insert hook in next st, yarn over and draw loop through; yarn over and draw through 2 loops; yarn over and draw through remaining 2 loops. Repeat from \* 4 more times. In same st where last st was made, make d c, ch 3 and d c (corner). Work in this manner around. Join, dropping White and attaching Red. 4th rnd: \*\* In corner ch-3 make 2 s c, ch 2 and 2 s c; \* insert hook under next bar and complete as for an s c; insert hook over next bar and complete as for an s c. Repeat from \* 2 more times, insert hook under next bar. Repeat from \*\* around; join. 5th rnd: With Red ch 3 (to count as d c), d c in next st, \* in corner sp make 3 d c, ch 3, 3 d c; d c in next st, yarn over, insert hook in next st and pull loop through; yarn

over and draw through 2 loops; (hereafter conceal unused color) drop Red, pick up White and draw through remaining 2 loops; d c in next 7 sts, drop White, pick up Red, d c in next 2 sts. Repeat from \* around. Join and break off.

Make 276 blocks and sew together with over-andover stitches on wrong side, arranging blocks as in chart.





## VICTORIANA

EMBROIDERY ADDS THE FINISHING TOUCH TO THIS LIGHT-WEIGHT AFGHAN WITH ITS QUAINTLY VICTORIAN FLAVOR.

AFGHAN No. 6008

Approximately 47 x 67 Inches

WOOL, 32 skeins (1 oz. skeins) of Ashes of Roses, and 14 skeins (3/4 oz. skeins) of Shaded Blues.

MILWARD'S CASEIN CROCHET HOOK No. 4. GAUGE: 9 d c make 2 inches; 3 rows (2 s c-rows and 1 d c-row) make 1 inch.

Starting at one long side (inside border), with Ashes of Roses make a chain 56 inches long (9 ch sts to 2 inches). 1st row: D c in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 1, turn. 2nd row: Picking up only back loop of each st, make s c in each d c across. Ch 1, turn. 3rd row: Picking up only front loop of each st, make s c in each s c across. Ch 3, turn. 4th row: Picking up back loop, make d c in each s c. Ch 1, turn. 5th row: Picking up front loop, make s c in each d c. Ch 1, turn. 6th row: Picking up back loop make s c in each s c. Ch 3, turn. 7th row: Picking up front loop, make d c in each s c. Ch 1, turn. The last 6 rows (2nd to 7th rows incl.) constitute the pattern. Work in pattern until piece measures 35 inches, ending with a d c-row. Do not break off.

BORDER . . . 1st rnd: Ch 3 and work a rnd of d c closely together all around Afghan, picking up both loops throughout border and making 3 d c in each corner st; sl st in 3rd st of ch-3 first made. Drop Ashes of Roses, attach Shaded Blues to top st of ch-3 first made and work as follows. 2nd rnd: Scin same st, \* tr in double strand of bar at base of next d c, leaving the last loop of tr on hook; yarn over, insert hook in same place as tr and pull loop through; (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times thus making a knob st; skip the d c where knob st was made, s c in next 3 d c. Repeat from \* to within 3 d c of corner, s c in next d c, 3 s c in center d c, s c in next d c (5 s c in all). Continue in pattern around Afghan, join. Drop Shaded Blues. 3rd rnd: Pick up Ashes of Roses, ch 3, d c in each st around, making 3 d c in corner st. Join. Drop Ashes of Roses. 4th rnd: Pick up Shaded Blues, ch 3, s c in top st of ch-3 of previous rnd, s c in next d c, \* knob

st in double strand at base of bar of next d c, skip d c where knob st was made and make s c in next 3 d c (knob sts fall between those of previous rnd). Repeat from \* around, increasing at corners as before. Drop Shaded Blues. 5th rnd: Same as 3rd rnd. Repeat the last 4 rnds (2nd to 5th rnds incl.) until border measures 6 inches, increasing knob sts at corners whenever necessary. Fasten off.

Embroider 2 diagonal corners thus: With double strand of Shaded Blues, embroider 2 large leaves, scatter fashion, using outline stitch (see illustration). Embroider a group of 2 small leaves at right above and one of 3 leaves at left below, using straight stitches.

one on each side of previous strip. With Flemish Blue make 2 strips and sew to sides of previous strips. With Renaissance Blue make 2 strips and sew to sides of previous strips. This completes second large strip. Make another strip like this.


Place Blue strips between Rose strips and sew together neatly.

Work tassel-fringes along both ends, having colors correspond with stripes: Cut ten 11-inch strands of yarn. Pull strands through center of end of stripe; form loop and draw ends through to form a knot. When all fringe has been made, trim evenly.

1st rnd: S c closely all around, making 3 s c at corners. Join and break off. 2nd and 3rd rnds: With Golden Fleece make s c in each s c, joining each rnd and making 3 s c at corners. Fasten off. 4th rnd: Attach Antique Green and work as for 3rd rnd. 5th rnd: Ch 5, s c in same place as sl st, \* s c in next 5 s c, ch 5, skip 1 s c, s c in next s c. Repeat from \* around, making a ch-5 loop at each corner. Join and break off. 6th rnd: With Lichen Green, \* make 3 s c in ch-5 loop, ch 3 and complete a loop-cluster as before, skip 4 s c, s c in next s c. Repeat from \* around. Join and break off.





## REGIMENTAL

AN EASY-TO-DO KNITTED STITCH FINDS SMART EXPRES-SION IN THIS STURDY MILITARY-STRIPED AUTO ROBE.

AFGHAN No. 678

Approximately 52 x 72 Inches

WOOL, 36 skeins (1 oz. skeins) of Antique Blue and 16 skeins of Ruby.

MILWARD'S PHANTOM KNITTING PINS, 1 pair No. 4 (3½ mm. size).

MILWARD'S STEEL CROCHET HOOK No. 1/0.

GAUGE: 5 sts make 1 inch; 10 rows make 1 inch.

Strips are made individually and then sewed together. Pattern is a multiple of 4 sts, plus 3.

row: Attach Ruby and p across. Drop Ruby. 2nd row: Attach Blue, k 1, sl 1 as if to p, \* k 3, sl 1 as if to p. Repeat from \* across, ending with sl 1, k 1.

3rd row: K 1, \* place yarn in front of work and sl 1 as if to p, place yarn at back of work and k 3. Repeat from \* across, ending with k 1. Drop Blue.

4th row: Pick up Ruby, \* k 3, sl 1 as if to p. Repeat from \* across, ending with k 3. 5th row: K 3, \* place yarn in front of work and sl 1 as if to p, place yarn at back of work and sl 1 as if to p, place yarn at back of work and sl 1 as if to p, place yarn at back of work and k 3. Repeat from \* across. The 2nd to 5th rows incl. constitute the pattern. Work in pattern until piece measures 70 inches. Bind off with Blue. This completes 1 strip.

solid Strips (Make 2) ... Entire strip is worked in Antique Blue. Starting at one end, cast on 39 sts and work in pattern for 70 inches. Bind off.

Place solid strips between colored strips and sew together with over-and-over stitches on wrong side.

border . . . 1st rnd: Attach Blue and work a rnd of s c closely together, making 3 s c at corners. Join. 2nd rnd: Insert hook in next s c, yarn over and draw loop through, \* yarn over, insert hook in next s c, yarn over and draw loop through, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook. Insert hook in same place as last loop was drawn through. Repeat from \* around, making 3 sts at corners. 3rd and 4th rnds: S c in each st around, making 3 s c at corners. Fasten off. 5th rnd: Attach Ruby and repeat 4th rnd. Fasten off. 6th rnd: Attach Blue and repeat 2nd rnd. Fasten off.

**BOUDOIR PILLOW No. 699-B** 

MATERIALS: CHADWICK'S RED HEART AFGHAN WOOL, 2 skeins (1 oz. skeins) of White, and 1 skein each of Tapestry Green, Dusty Pink, Mauve and Lilac.

MILWARD'S PHANTOM KNITTING PINS, 1 pair No. 6 (41/4 mm. size).

MILWARD'S STEEL CROCHET HOOK No. 1/0.

A satin-covered pillow, 12 inches square.

With White cast on 61 sts (6 sts more to be worked in White on either side of chart). Work as for first strip of Afghan up to and including 39th row. Then work from the 26th row back to the 1st row incl. (thus reversing part of design). Bind off. Work Mauve and Lilac s c all around edges. Block to measure 12 x 12 inches. Work fringe all around as for Afghan, using a cardboard 2 x 5 inches. Sew to top of pillow, having fringe extend beyond edges.

IMPORTANT... Be sure to buy at one time sufficient material of the same dye lot to complete the article. It is otherwise impossible to avoid slight variations in color.
