**T**HE object of this book primarily is to meet the ever-growing interest in crochet and lace making and to assist the needle-worker in selecting the working material that will give the most perfect results.

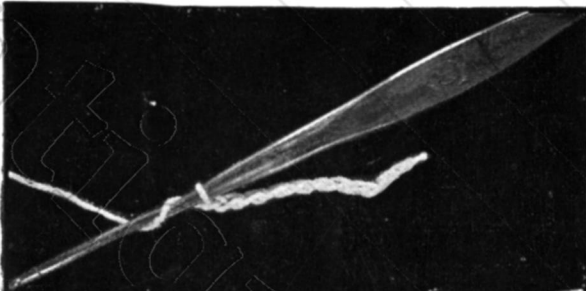
To more successfully accomplish this aim, designs of a practical and attractive nature are presented with carefully compiled, explicit directions and actual photographs of the finished pieces.

With all instructions the correct sizes of cotton and crochet hooks are suggested, and in the filet patterns block drawings are supplied to facilitate counting the mesh.

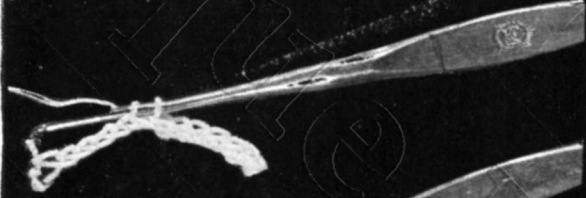

# CROCHET STITCHES

## CHAIN STITCH

1—Catch thread with needle, forming a loop. Pull the thread with the needle through this loop to form the first stitch. Continue chain to desired length.

## SLIP STITCH

2—Make row of chain stitches. Insert needle in last chain and pull thread through. Pull loop thus made through first loop.

## SINGLE CROCHET

3—Make row of chain stitches. Insert needle in last chain and pull thread through, thus having two loops on needle. Wind thread once over needle and pull through the two loops.

## HALF DOUBLE CROCHET

4—Wind thread once around needle, insert into chain and pull loop through. Wind thread around needle again and pull through three loops at once

## DOUBLE CROCHET

5—Wind thread once around needle. Insert needle into chain and pull thread through; this leaves three loops on needle. Wind thread once around needle and pull through two. Wind thread again over needle and pull through two.

## TREBLE CROCHET

6—Make same way as Double Crochet, only at first wind thread twice over needle and pull thread through three times—two and two and two.

## DOUBLE TREBLE CROCHET

7—Make same way as Double Crochet, only at first wind thread three times over needle and pull thread through four times—two and two and two and two.

## QUADRUPLE CROCHET

8—Make same way as Double Crochet, only at first wind thread four times over needle and pull thread through five times—two and two and two and two and two.

## QUINTUPLE

9—Make same way as Double Crochet, only at first wind thread five times around needle and pull through six times—two at a time.

## SEXTUPLE

10—Make same way as Double Crochet, only at first wind thread six times around needle and pull through seven times—two at a time.

## SEPTUPLE

11—Make same way as Double Crochet, only at first wind thread seven times around needle and pull through eight times—two at a time.

## OCTUPLE

12—Make same way as Double Crochet, only at first wind thread eight times around needle and pull through nine times—two at a time.

## PICOT

13—Make a chain. Skip three chains and make a Single Crochet. Chain four, catch back into the first chain. Wind thread once around needle and pull through both loops. Make three or four Single Crochet stitches or enough to make desired distance between picots and repeat.

## MESH

14—Used in filet crochet work. Chain two stitches, skip two stitches, one double crochet into next stitch.

## SHELL

15—Five Double Crochet in one stitch form a shell.

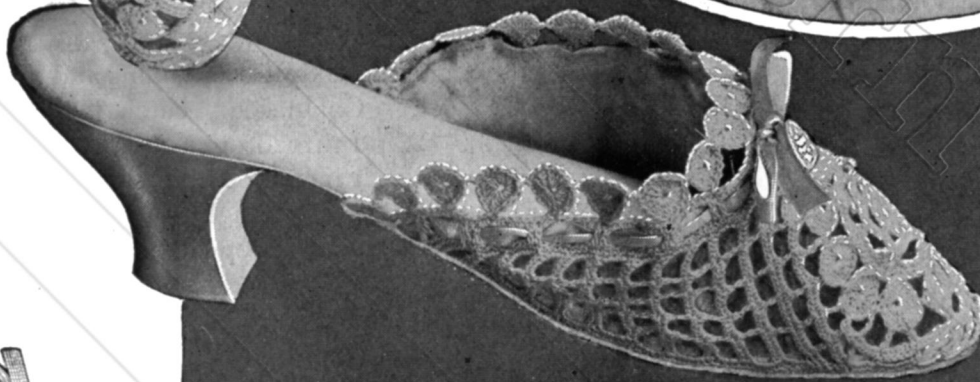
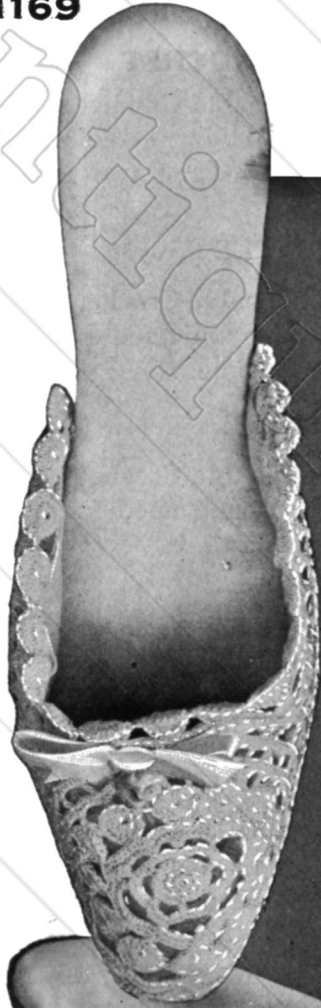

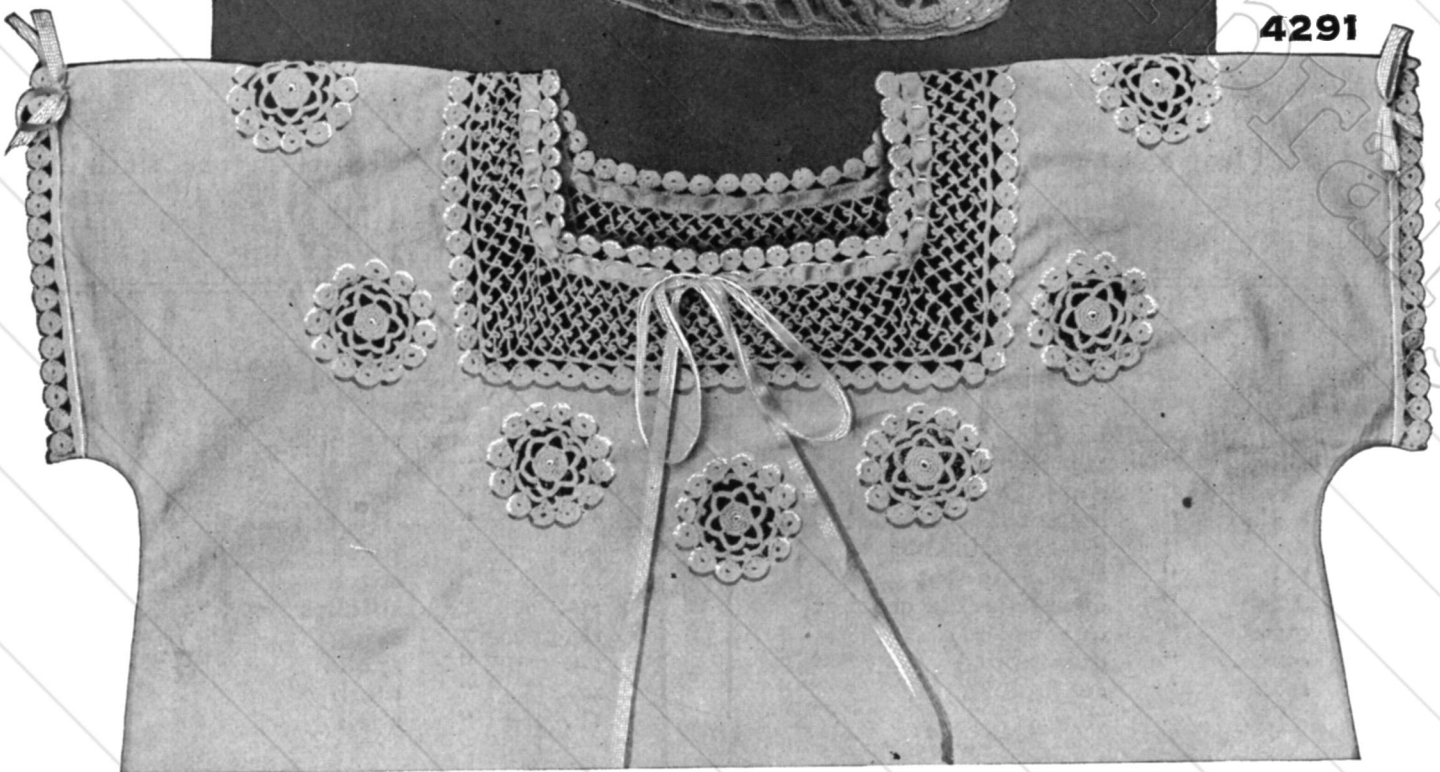

## BOUDOIR SET

## Nightgown Yoke No. 4291

WITH TRIMMING

Materials required:

ROYAL SOCIETY Cordichet Blue 3010, size 30, 4 balls.  
Crochet hook No. 11.

## YOKE

**1st Row.**—Ch. 146, sk. 1, 1 s.c., ch. 9, sk. 5, 1 s.c. ch. 5, 1 s.c. into same, ch. 9, sk. 5, 1 s.c., ch. 5, 1 s.c. into same, continue across (24 loops of ch. 9 in all), turn.

**2nd Row.**—Ch. 9, 1 s.c. into center st. of first ch. 9, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into same. Ch. 9, 1 s.c. into center st. of next ch. 9, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into same, continue across. Finish row with ch. 5, 1 d.t.r.c. into s.c. of previous row.

Make three more rows like second row, turn. This is for front of yoke. Continue for shoulder strap. Ch. 9, 1 s.c. into center st. of first ch. 9, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into same, \* ch. 9, 1 s.c. into center st. of next ch. 9, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into same, ch. 9, 1 s.c. into center st. of next ch. 9, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into same, ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into center st. of next ch. 9, turn, ch. 9, 1 s.c. into center st. of next ch. 9, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into same, ch. 9, 1 s.c. into center st. of next ch. 9, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into same, ch. 9, 1 s.c. into center st. of last ch. 9, turn, ch. 9, 1 s.c. into center st. of next ch. 9, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into same, repeat from \* until 42 rows in all are made for shoulder strap, finish off.

At other end of front repeat the same for other shoulder strap. Join the two shoulder straps with 108 chs.

For back repeat the five rows the same way as for front.

At inside of yoke make 1 row of ch. 5, 1 s.c. into center st. of next ch. 9, ch. 5, and continue across.

Work all around inside of yoke 6 s.c. into each space.

**Beading.** Ch. 6, sk. 1, 1 tr.c., ch. 4, sk. 4, 1 tr.c., ch. 1, sk. 1, 1 tr.c., ch. 4, sk. 4, 1 tr.c., continue around. At angles after ch. 4, 1 tr.c., ch. 1, sk. 1, 1 tr.c., sk. 4, 1 tr.c. into angle, sk. 4, 1 tr.c., ch. 1, sk. 1, continue and join at end of row to fourth ch. from beginning.

Work all around 5 s.c. around each ch. 4, 2 s.c. around each ch. 1, join.

**Edging.** Ch. 4, 1 tr.c. into angle, ch. 9, 12 d.c. into fifth ch. from needle, join to tr.c. with sl.st. 4 d.c. into same ch. as the 12 d.c., sk. 7 sts. of yoke, join with sl.st. into next, working into yoke from left to right, 4 more d.c. into same ch. as previous d.c., join with sl.st. to first d.c. made, \* ch. 9, 8 d.c. into fifth ch. from needle. Join to joining at side of previous round, 4 d.c. into same ch., sk. 7 sts. of yoke. Join to next st., 4 more d.c. into same ch. Join to first d.c. of this round, repeat from \* to angle until 7 sts. are left, make 2 tr.c. into angle, repeat the same for other three sides.

At outside of yoke work all around 6 s.c. into each space. Make same edging all around, only try to have 1 round at each corner.

**Edging for Sleeves.** Ch. 9, 16 d.c. into fifth ch. from needle, \* join to first d.c., ch. 9, 8 d.c. into 5th ch. from needle. Join to joining of last round, 8 d.c. into same ch., repeat from \* for 35 rounds in all.

Work across one side of rounds, 1 s.c. into center of first round, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into center of next round, continue across, turn, 8 s.c. around each ch. 7, turn, 1 s.c. into each st.

## Medallion.

**1st Row.**—Ch. 5, join to ring, 8 s.c. into ring, join.

**2nd Row.**—2 s.c. into each st., join.

**3rd Row.**—2 s.c. into 1 st., 1 s.c. into next st., 2 s.c. into next st., continue until 24 s.c. are made, join.

**4th Row.**—Ch. 8, sk. 3, 1 s.c., ch. 8, continue around (6 loops in all).

**5th Row.**—13 s.c. around each ch. 8.

**6th Row.**—7 sl.sts. up first loop, 1 s.c. into next st., \* ch. 9, catch into fifth ch. from needle to

form p., ch. 4, 1 s.c. into center st. of next loop, repeat from \* around.

**7th Row.**—6 s.c. around each ch. 4.

**8th Row.**—1 s.c. into each st.

**9th Row.**—Ch. 9, 13 d.c. into fifth ch. from needle, join with sl.st. to last s.c. made, 3 d.c. into same ch. as the 13 d.c., join to first d.c. of ring, ch. 9, \* 9 d.c. into fifth ch. from needle, join to joining of first round, 3 d.c. into same ch., sk. 5 sts. of round, working from left to right, join with sl.st., 4 d.c. into same ch., join to first d.c. of round, ch. 9, repeat from \* (12 rounds all around medallion), 9 medallions are required to trim gown around yoke.

## Boudoir Cap No. 4293

Materials required:

ROYAL SOCIETY Cordichet Blue 3010, size 30, 2 balls.  
Crochet hook No. 11.

## BRIM OF CAP.

**1st Row.**—Ch. 360, join, ch. 9, sk. 5 of foundation ch., 1 s.c., ch. 5, 1 s.c. into same, ch. 9, sk. 5 of foundation ch., 1 s.c., ch. 5, 1 s.c. into same, continue all around (60 loops of ch. 9 in all). Finish with ch. 5 to form p. at beginning of row.

**2nd Row.**—4 sl.sts. into 4 chs. of first ch. 9, 1 s.c. into next st., ch. 5, 1 s.c. into same as last s.c., ch. 9, 1 s.c. into center st. of next ch. 9, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into same. Continue around. To make last loop, ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into first s.c. of row.

Repeat second row four times more, finish off. Edging is made separately and joined afterwards.

Ch. 9, 16 d.c. into fifth ch. from needle, join with sl.st. to first d.c. ch. 9, 8 d.c. into fifth ch. from needle, join to joining of previous round, 8 d.c. into same ch., join to first d.c. of round. Continue until 60 rounds are made.

Join to brim. Start into center st. of one loop of ch. 9, ch. 3, 1 s.c. into center of first round, ch. 3, 1 s.c. into center st. of next ch. 9, ch. 3, 1 s.c. into center st. of next round, ch. 3, continue around.

To trim cap make seven medallions, following same directions as for medallions for nightgown.

To make up this cap cut a round piece of material 16 inches in diameter, trim with the seven medallions, placing one into center, and the other six around it in equal distances. Make a small casing around edge of this round, to pull elastic through, gather just enough around edge of casing to make it the same width as the brim. Sew the brim to cap.

Cover a piece of featherbone 30 inches long with blue silk ribbon and sew to right side of brim, so that the edging covers the covered featherbone.

Trim with ribbon.

## Slippers No. 1169

Materials required:

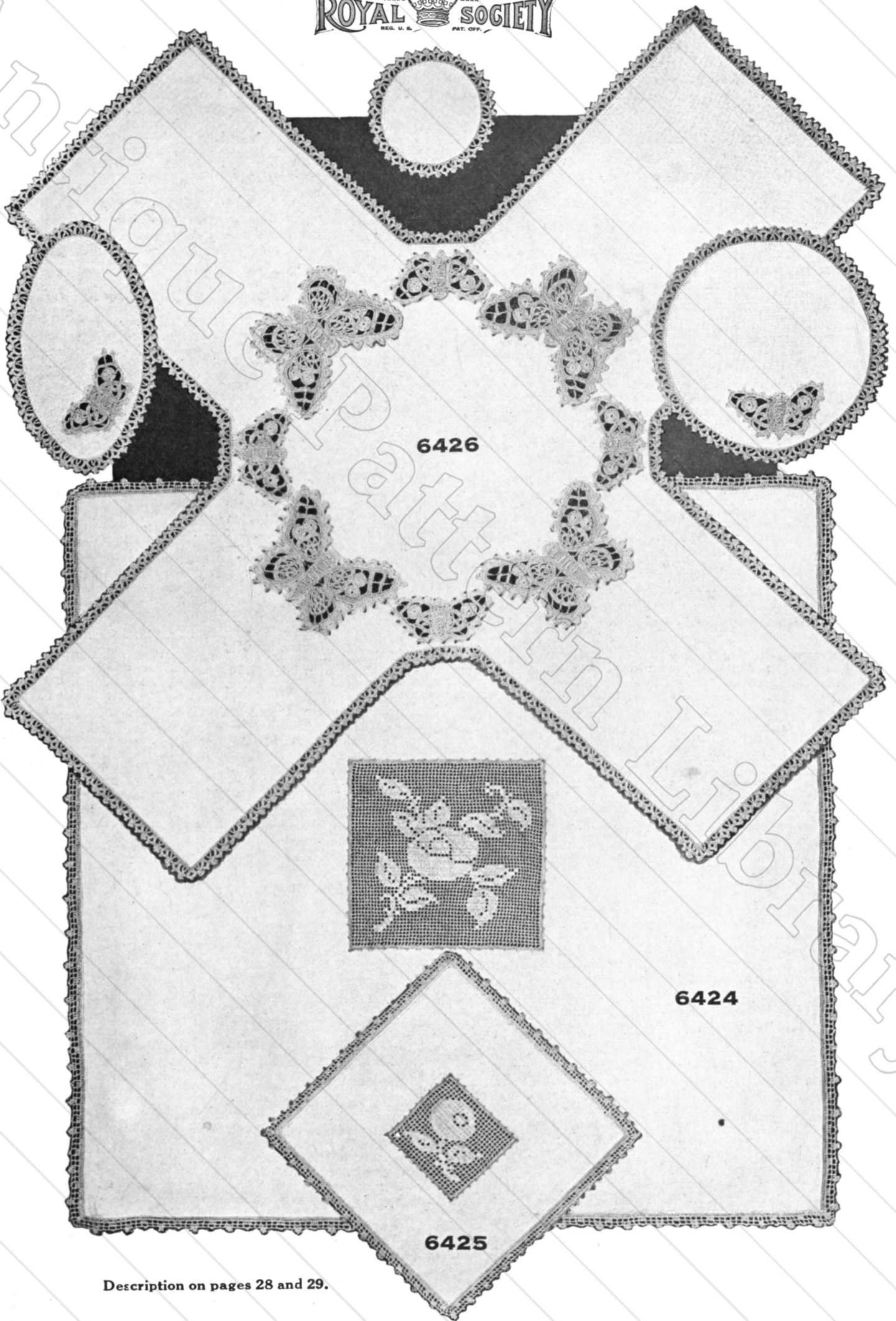
ROYAL SOCIETY Cordichet Blue 3010, size 30, 1 ball.  
Crochet hook No. 11.

This Slipper is started with medallion, for which follow directions of medallion for nightgown No. 4291. When medallion is completed turn, 4 sl.sts. to center of first round, \* ch. 9, 1 s.c. into center of next round. Repeat from \* three times more, turn, 11 s.c. around each of three next ch. 9, 6 s.c. around last ch. 9, turn, ch. 5, sk. 5, 1 d.c., ch. 5, sk. 5, 1 tr.c., ch. 5, sk. 5, 1 d.t.r.c., ch. 5, 1 d.t.r.c. into same, ch. 5, sk. 5, 1 tr.c., ch. 5, sk. 5, 1 d.c., ch. 5, sk. 5, 1 sl.st., turn.

6 s.c. around each ch. 5. 1 sl.st. into last st., 5 s.c. around remaining of next ch. 9, 9 sl.sts. to center of next round, turn, ch. 5, sk. 4, 1 tr.c., ch. 5, sk. 4, 1 d.c. ch. 5, sk. 4, 1 s.c., turn, 6 s.c. around each of three next ch. 5, 23 sl.sts. to center of second following round, turn, ch. 10, sk. 4, 1 tr.c., ch. 5, sk. 4, 1 s.c., ch. 5, sk. 4, 1 tr.c., ch. 5, sk. 4, 1 s.c., ch. 5, sk. 4, 1 tr.c., ch. 5, sk. 4, 1 d.c., ch. 5, sk. 4, 1 d.c., ch. 5, sk. 4, 1 sl.st., turn.

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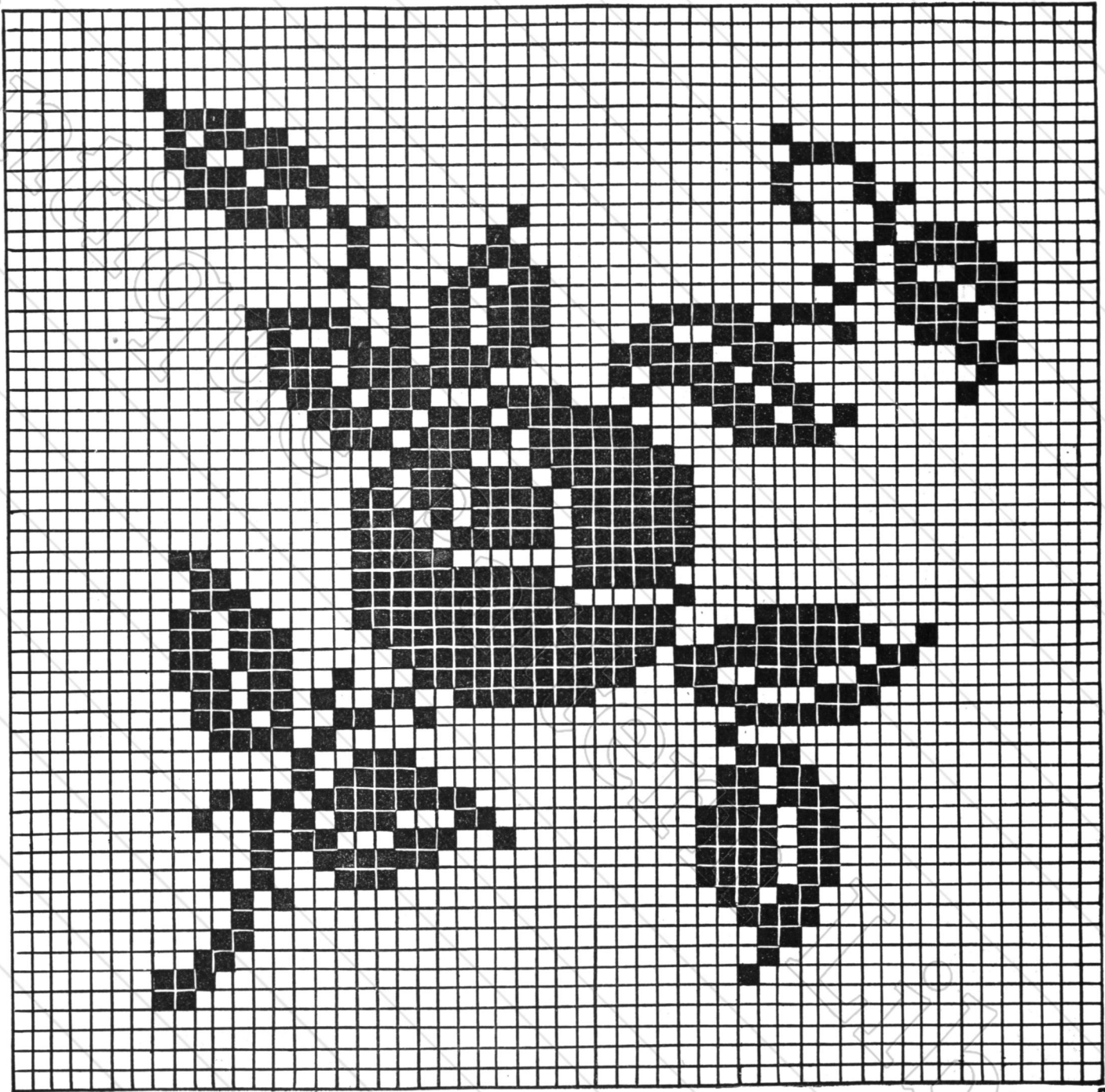

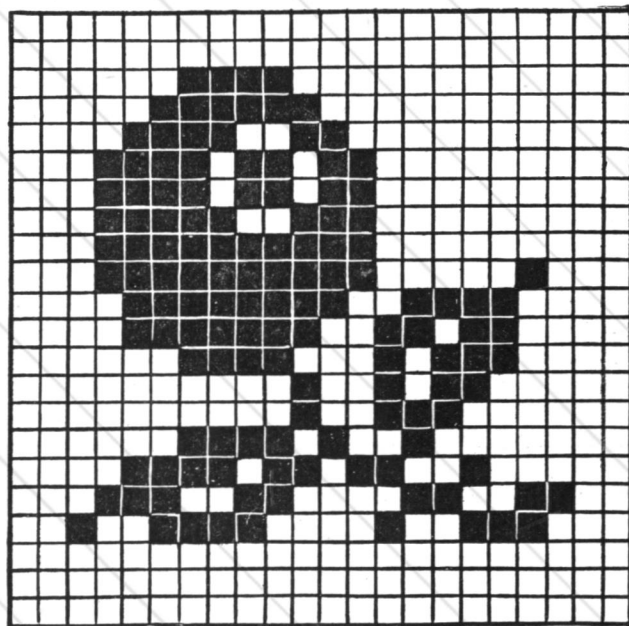


No. 6424—TABLE COVER

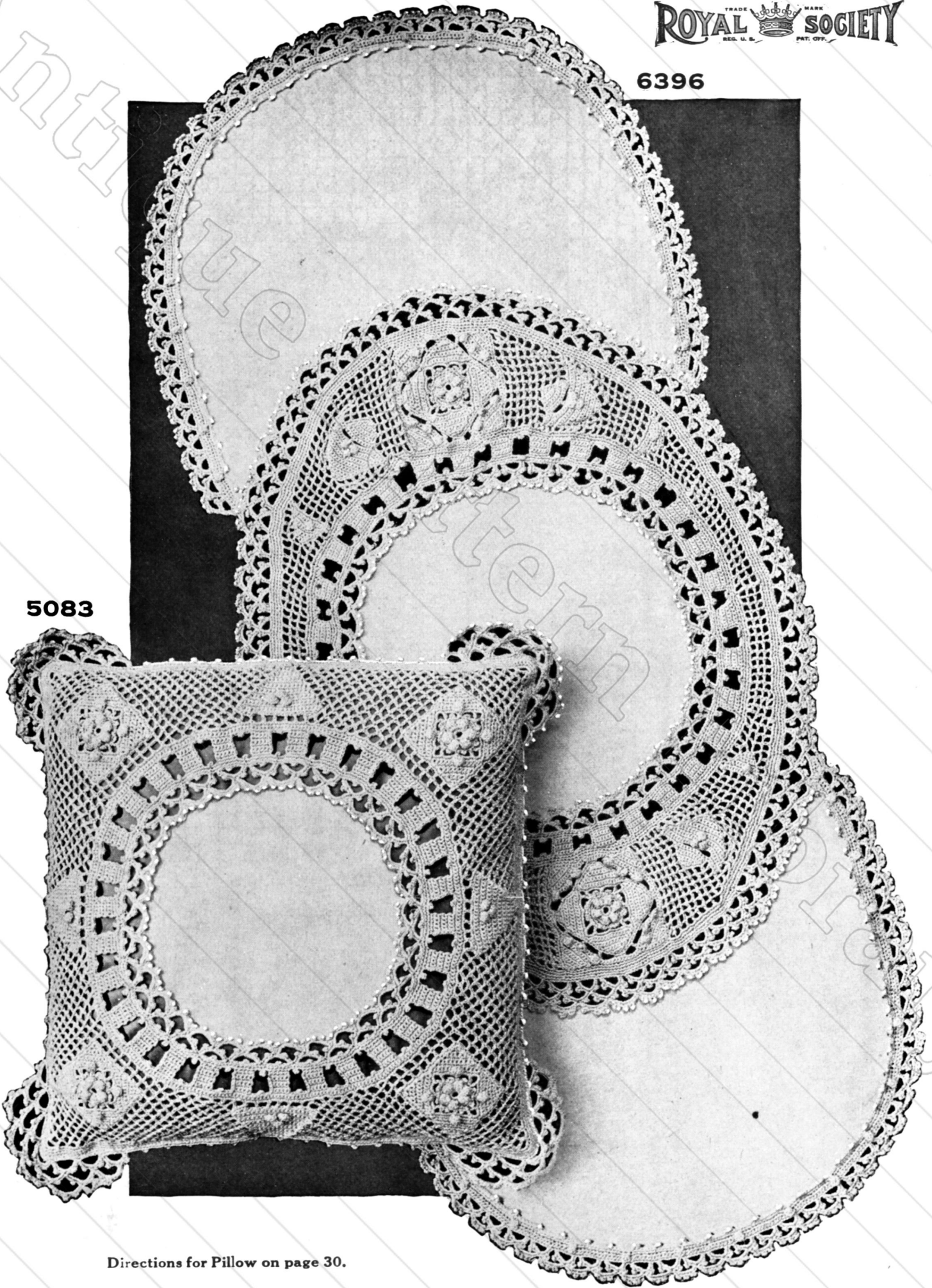

# Scarf No. 6396

## Materials required:

ROYAL SOCIETY Crochet Ecu 1010, size 3, 7 balls.  
Crochet hook No. 5.

Start with center medallion at side.

**1st Row.**—Ch. 5, join to ring, 6 s.c. into ring, join.

**2nd Row.**—Ch. 1, \* 5 d.c. into first st., turn, 1 sl.st. around ch. 1 (this forms bean st.), turn, 1 s.c. into same as 5 d.c., ch. 1, repeat from \* five times more.

**3rd Row.**—\* 2 s.c. into sl.st. behind bean st., 1 s.c. into s.c., repeat from \* around, join.

**4th Row.**—2 s.c. into first st., 1 s.c. into each of 2 next sts., 2 s.c. into following st., continue around (this row has 24 s.c.), join.

**5th Row.**—1 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c., 1 p., continue around, join.

**6th Row.**—Ch. 8, 1 d.c. into same as sl.st., \* ch. 4, 1 s.c. between two next ps., ch. 4, 1 d.c. between two following ps., ch. 5, 1 d.c. into same, repeat from \* around, join last ch. 4 to third ch. from beginning.

**7th Row.**—3 sl.sts. into 3 chs. of first space, 3 s.c. into same space, 5 s.c. into each of two next spaces, 2 s.c. into next space, turn, sk. 1, 13 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 10 s.c. sk. 1, 1 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 8 s.c., sk. 1, 1 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 6 s.c., sk. 1, 1 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 4 s.c., sk. 1, 1 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 2 s.c., sk. 1, 1 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 2 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 1 s.c., 9 sl.sts. down the side of triangle, 3 s.c. into same space, repeat from \* three times more until point of last triangle is made.

**8th Row.**—19 s.c. across two triangles, into corner 3 s.c., continue around. After 3 s.c. into last corner are made, join.

**9th Row.**—Ch. 4, sk. 3, 1 d.c., ch. 5, sk. 5, 1 d.c., ch. 5, sk. 5, 1 d.c., ch. 4, sk. 3, 3 s.c. into three corner sts., repeat from \* around, join.

**10th Row.**—\* 3 s.c. into 3 s.c., 4 s.c. around ch. 4, 6 s.c. around each of 2 ch. 5, turn, sk. 1, 11 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 1 s.c., ch. 1, 5 d.c. into next st., turn, 1 sl.st. around ch. 1, turn, 2 s.c., ch. 1, 5 d.c. into next st., turn, 1 sl.st. around ch. 1, turn, 2 s.c., ch. 1, 5 d.c. into next st., turn, 1 sl.st. around ch. 1, turn, 2 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 9 s.c. across into s.c. and into sl.sts. behind bean sts., turn, sk. 1, 8 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 7 s.c., turn, sk. 2, 5 s.c., turn, sk. 2, 3 s.c., turn, sk. 2, 1 s.c., 9 sl.sts. down the side of triangle, 4 s.c. into next space, repeat from \* three times more, join.

**11th Row.**—Turn, 12 sl.sts. to corner, 3 s.c. into corner st., 28 s.c. to next corner, 3 s.c. into corner, 4 s.c. into following sts., ch. 4, sk. 3, 2 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 2 tr.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 2 tr.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 2 d.c., ch. 4, sk. 3, 4 s.c., 3 s.c. into corner st., 28 s.c. to next corner, 1 s.c. into next corner, turn, 1 s.c. into each st. across, 3 s.c. into corner st., 5 s.c., 4 s.c. into next space, 2 s.c., 2 s.c. into next space, 2 s.c., 3 s.c. into next space, 2 s.c., 2 s.c. into next space, 2 s.c., 4 s.c. into next space, 5 s.c., 3 s.c. into corner st., 1 s.c. into each st. to next corner, 1 s.c. into corner st., turn, continue across one side of square only.

**12th Row.**—\* Ch. 5, sk. 1 s.c., 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., continue across (11 spaces to last st. of side, turn).

**13th Row.**—Ch. 5, 1 d.c. into second d.c., ch. 2, continue across with ms. (11 ms. in all).

**14th Row.**—Ch. 6, 1 d.c. into first d.c., ch. 2, continue across (12 ms. in all), turn.

**15th Row.**—Ch. 5, 1 d.c. into second d.c., ch. 2, continue across (12 ms.), turn.

**16th Row.**—Ch. 5, 1 d.c. into second d.c., 10 more ms., 1 tr.c. into third following ch., turn.

**17th Row.**—1 sl.st. into next d.c., ch. 5, 1 d.c. into next d.c., 9 more ms., turn.

**18th Row.**—3 s.c. into each of five next ms., 1 sl.st. into next d.c., ch. 5, 1 d.c. into next d.c., 4 more ms., turn.

**19th Row.**—Ch. 3, 1 d.c. into second d.c., 4 ms., turn, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into second d.c., 2 more ms., 1

tr.c. into next d.c., turn, sk. 1, 7 sl.sts. into next sts., 5 s.c. into next space, 3 s.c. into each of two next spaces, 2 s.c. into two following s.c., turn, sk. 1, 3 s.c. into following sts., turn, sk. 1, 4 s.c. into following sts., turn, sk. 1, 5 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 6 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 7 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 8 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 9 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 10 s.c., 1 sl.st. into next st., turn, ch. 6, sk. 5, 1 d.c., ch. 6, sk. 4, 4 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 3 s.c., 7 s.c. into each of two spaces, 3 s.c., 1 sl.st., turn, sk. 1 sl.st. and 1 s.c., 19 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 18 s.c., turn, sk. 1 st., 7 s.c., ch. 1, 5 d.c. into next st., turn, 1 sl.st. around ch. 1, turn, 1 s.c., ch. 1, 5 d.c. into next st., turn, 1 sl.st. around ch. 1, 7 s.c., turn, sk. 2, 15 s.c., turn, sk. 2, 6 s.c., ch. 1, 5 d.c. into next st., turn, 1 sl.st. around ch. 1, turn, 6 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 12 s.c., turn, sk. 2, 10 s.c., turn, sk. 2, 8 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 7 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 6 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 5 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 4 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 3 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 2 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 1 s.c., turn, 15 sl.sts. down side of triangle to top of d.c., ch. 2, 1 d.c. into third ch., turn, ch. 2, sk. 2 sl.sts. of triangle, 1 d.c., ch. 5, 1 d.c. into same as last d.c., sk. 2 sl.sts. of triangle, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2 sl.sts., 1 d.c., turn, ch. 2, 1 d.c. into third ch. of ch. 5, turn, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into next d.c., sk. 2 sl.sts. of triangle, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2 sl.sts. of triangle, 1 d.c., turn, ch. 2, 1 d.c. into third ch., turn, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into next d.c., ch. 5, 1 sl.st. into same as last d.c. in triangle, 16 sl.sts. down the side of triangle, ch. 2, 1 d.c. into next d.c. over sl.st., ch. 2, 1 d.c. into next d.c., turn, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into second d.c., ch. 2, 1 d.c. into same st. of triangle, sk. 2 sl.sts. of triangle, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 1 sl. st. of triangle, 1 d.c., turn, ch. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2, 1 d.c. into third next ch., turn, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into second d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2, 1 d.c. into same st. of triangle, sk. 1 sl.st. of triangle, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 1 sl.st., 1 d.c., turn, 3 ms., turn, 4 ms., sk. 2 sl.sts., 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2 sl.sts., 1 d.c., turn, 4 ms., turn, 4 ms., ch. 2, sk. 2 chs. of next ch. 5, 7 sl.sts. into following sts., turn, ch. 5, 7 ms., turn, ch. 3, 1 d.c. into second d.c., 6 ms., turn, ch. 6, 1 d.c. into first d.c., 6 ms., turn, 7 ms., turn, 6 ms., 1 tr.c. into 3rd ch., sk. 1, 3 sl.sts., 3 s.c. into each of four next ms., turn, sk. 1, 11 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 10 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 4 s.c., ch. 1, 5 d.c. into next st., turn, 1 sl.st. around ch. 1, turn, 4 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 9 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 8 s.c., continue until 1 s.c. is left, 12 sl.sts. down the side of triangle, 3 sl.sts. into 3 next sts., turn, ch. 2, sk. 2 sl.sts. of triangle, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2 sts. of triangle, 1 d.c., ch. 5, 1 d.c. into same, sk. 2 sl.sts., 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2 sl.sts., 1 d.c., turn, ch. 2, sk. 2 chs., 1 d.c., turn, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into next d.c., ch. 5, 1 sl.st. into same at point of triangle, 12 sl.sts. down the side of triangle, 3 sl.sts. into three next sts., turn, ch. 2, sk. 2 sl. sts. of triangle, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 1 sl.st., 1 d.c., ch. 5, 1 d.c. into same, sk. 2 sl.sts., 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 1 sl.st., 1 d.c., turn, ch. 2, 1 d.c. into third ch., turn, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into next d.c., ch. 2, 1 sl.st. into point of triangle, 3 sl. sts. into chs., turn, ch. 2, 1 d.c. into next d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., turn, 4 ms., turn, 3 ms., 1 tr. c. into third ch., turn, sk. 1, 1 sl.st., 3 ms., ch. 2, 1 d.c. into same, turn, 4 ms., turn, 4 ms., turn, 3 ms., 1 tr.c. into third ch., turn, sk. 1, 1 sl.st., 3 ms., 7 more rows of 3 ms., finish off.

**3rd Row.**—1 s.c. into tr.c., ch. 7, 1 s.c. into next loop, ch. 7, continue across, when 1 s.c. into last loop is made ch. 49, turn.

**4th Row.**—Sk. 1, 1 s.c., ch. 7, sk. 4, 1 s.c., ch. 7, sk. 4, 1 s.c., make 7 more loops into chs., ch. 7, 1 s.c. into first loop, continue across with loops, into the last s.c. of previous row attach 48 chs., continue with 9 loops across the chs., turn.

**5th Row.**—Ch. 7, 1 s.c. into first loop, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into next loop, continue across, when 1 s.c. into last loop is made ch. 4, 1 d.t.r.c. into last s.c. of previous row, turn.

**6th Row.**—1 s.c. into the d.t.r.c., ch. 7, 1 s.c. into next loop until 35 loops are made, 7 tr.c. into next s.c., 1 s.c., into next loop (this forms a shell), ch. 7, continue with loops to end of row, turn.

**7th Row.**—Ch. 7, 1 s.c. into first loop, ch. 7, continue across, at end of row ch. 4, 1 d.t.r.c. into s.c., turn.

**9th Row.**—Ch. 7, 1 s.c. into first loop, continue until 34 loops are made, 7 tr.c. into next s.c., 1 s.c. into next loop, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into center of shell, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into next loop, 1 shell, continue with loops to end of row, turn.

**10th Row.**—29 loops, 1 shell, 5 loops, 1 shell, 5 loops, 1 shell, continue with loops to end of row, turn.

**12th Row.**—28 loops, 3 shells, 2 loops, 2 shells, 1 loop, 2 shells, 2 loops, 3 shells, 28 loops, turn.

**13th Row.**—35 loops, 2 shells, 35 loops, turn.

**14th Row.**—29 loops, 1 shell, 5 loops, 1 shell, 5 loops, 1 shell, 29 loops, turn.

**15th Row.**—34 loops, 1 shell, 2 loops, 1 shell, 34 loops, turn.

**16th Row.**—35 loops, 1 shell, 35 loops, turn.

**17th Row.**—1 row of loops only, turn.

**18th Row.**—35 loops, 1 shell, 35 loops, turn.

**19th Row.**—1 row of loops only, turn.

**20th Row.**—24 loops, 1 shell, 21 loops, 1 shell, 24 loops, turn.

**21st Row.**—\* 29 loops, turn. (This row starts the side of the yoke.)

**22nd Row.**—3 loops, 3 shells, 23 loops, turn.

**23rd Row.**—29 loops, turn.

**24th Row.**—4 loops, 1 shell, 24 loops, turn.

5 rows of 29 loops, turn.

**30th Row.**—2 loops, 1 shell, 26 loops, turn.

**31st Row.**—29 loops, turn.

**32nd Row.**—1 loop, 3 shells, 25 loops, turn.

**33rd Row.**—29 loops, turn.

**34th Row.**—2 loops, 1 shell, 26 loops, turn.

5 rows of 29 loops, turn.

**40th Row.**—4 loops, 1 shell, 24 loops, turn.

**41st Row.**—29 loops, turn.

**42nd Row.**—3 loops, 3 shells, 23 loops, turn.

**43rd Row.**—29 loops, ch. 39, turn, sk. 1, 1 s.c., ch. 7, sk. 4, 1 s.c., 6 more loops into chs., ch. 7, 1 s.c. into next loop, 3 more loops, 1 shell, 24 loops, turn. (This row starts the back.)

**44th Row.**—36 loops, turn.

Make 15 more rows of 36 loops, turn. Ch. 7, 1 s.c. into first loop, ch. 4, 1 s.c. into next loop, ch. 4, repeat for eight more ch. 4, then ch. 7, 1 s.c.

into next loop, continue across for 26 loops of ch. 7 in all, turn, make two more rows of 26 loops, turn.

Ch. 7, 1 s.c. into first loop, ch. 4, 1 s.c. into next loop, ch. 4, continue across.

Now start where side of yoke started and work across front, ch. 4, 1 s.c. into next loop, ch. 4, 1 s.c. into following loop, continue until 13 ch. 4 are made, then repeat from \* for other half of yoke.

Start at under arm across back of yoke, 3 s.c. into first space, 5 s.c. into each of following spaces: To form corner, make 3 s.c. into center st., continue up the back with 5 s.c. into each space, form corner and continue around the neck. When underarm is again reached, turn, 1 s.c. into each st. into corner st., 3 s.c., at four angles of neck, sk. 2 sts. When underarm is again reached, turn, make wide beading.

### WIDE BEADING.

Ch. 6, 2 quat.c. into next st., ch. 6, sk. 6, 1 quat.c., ch. 6, sk. 6, 3 quat.c. finished together into next st., ch. 6, sk. 6, 1 quat.c., continue across, turn, 7 s.c. into each space, turn, 4 s.c., 1 p., sk. 1, 4 s.c., 1 p., sk. 1, continue across.

Around neck make narrow beading, ch. 4, 2 tr.c. into next st., ch. 4, sk. 4, 1 tr.c., ch. 4, sk. 4, 3 tr.c. finished together, ch. 4, sk. 4, 1 tr.c., continue. At angle, after 3 tr.c. are made, sk. 3, 1 tr.c. into angle, sk. 3, 3 tr.c. When end of neck is reached turn, 5 s.c. into each space, turn.

### EDGING.

Ch. 3, sk. 3, 1 d.c., 1 p., 1 tr.c., 1 p., 1 tr.c., 1 p., 1 d.c. all into next st., ch. 3, sk. 3, 3 s.c., ch. 3, repeat from \* across. Across sleeves make two rows of s.c. and same beading and edging as for neck.

Across front of yoke make two rows of s.c., repeat same wide beading as for back. After 7 s.c. into each space of beading are made turn, 1 s.c. into each st. until 84 s.c. are made, turn, start strap. \* Ch. 7, sk. 4, 1 s.c., ch. 7, sk. 4, 1 s.c., continue until seven loops are made, turn, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into first loop, six more loops, ch. 3, 1 d.t.r.c. into next s.c., turn, make two more rows of loops, turn, 3 loops, 1 shell, 3 loops, turn, 7 loops, turn, 2 loops, 3 shells, 2 loops, turn, 7 loops, turn, 3 loops, 1 shell, 3 loops, turn, three more rows of 7 loops, turn, ch. 4, 1 s.c. into next loop, ch. 4, 1 s.c. into next loop, continue across, make 30 sl.sts. down the side of strap until row of s.c. is reached, 1 sl.st. into next s.c., turn, 5 s.c. into each space over sl.sts. up the side of strap, 5 s.c. into each space across and down the side of strap, continue until 63 s.c. are made and repeat from \* twice more, when s.c. to end of row are made finish off.

Start at other end of front, 4 s.c., 1 p., sk. 1, 4 s.c., 1 p., sk. 1, 4 s.c., continue, at angles sk. 2 s.c., up the strap 4 s.c., 1 p., sk. 1, 4 s.c. and continue across.

### EDGE FOR BOTTOM OF DRESS.

**1st Row.**—Ch. 851, sk. 1, 1 s.c., ch. 7, sk. 4, 1 s.c., ch. 7, sk. 4, 1 s.c., continue across, join into first s.c. of row. This row has 170 loops.

**2nd Row.**—4 sl.sts. into chs. of first loop, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into next loop, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into next loop, continue around, to make last loop, ch. 4, 1 tr.c. into first st. of row. Make four more rows same as second row.

**7th Row.**—Ch. 4, 1 s.c. into next loop, ch. 4, 1 s.c. into next loop, continue until 18 ch. 4 are made. \* ch. 7, 1 s.c. into next loop, continue for six more loops of ch. 7, turn, 7 loops, ch. 4, 1 d.t.r.c. into next s.c., turn, 3 loops, 1 shell, 3 loops, turn, 7 loops, turn, 2 loops, 3 shells, 2 loops, turn, 7 loops, turn, 3 loops, 1 shell, 3 loops, turn, three rows of 7 loops, turn, ch. 4, 1 s.c. into next loop, ch. 4, 1 s.c. into next loop, continue until 7 ch. 4 are made, 25 sl.sts. down the side of strap, ch. 4, 1 s.c. into next loop, continue until eight ch. 4 are made, repeat from \* for four more straps. This is half the edge, then repeat again from beginning of 7th row.

**8th Row.**—5 s.c. into each space, join.

**9th Row.**—4 s.c., 1 p., sk. 1, 4 s.c., 1 p., sk. 1, continue, at angles near straps, sk. 2 st., continue all around.

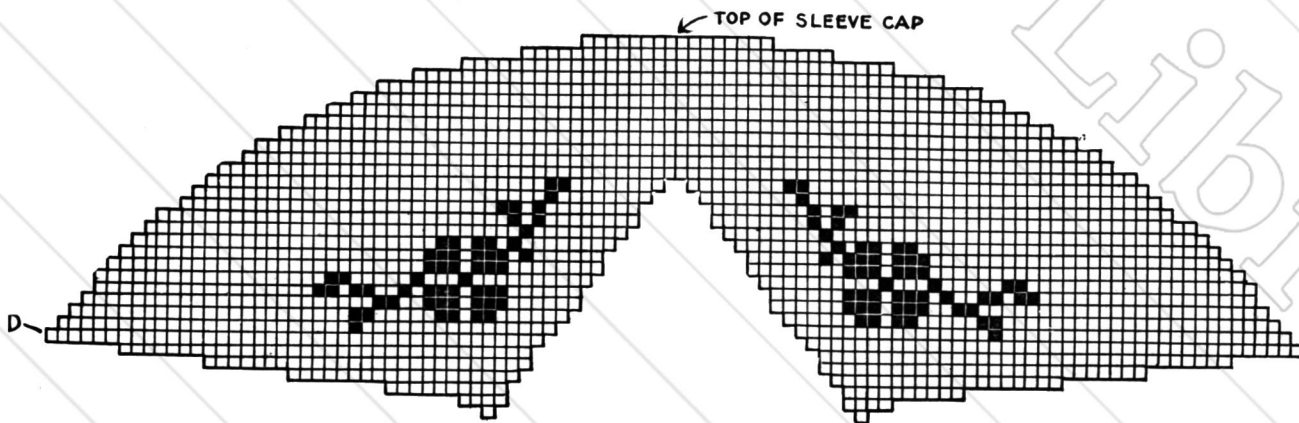
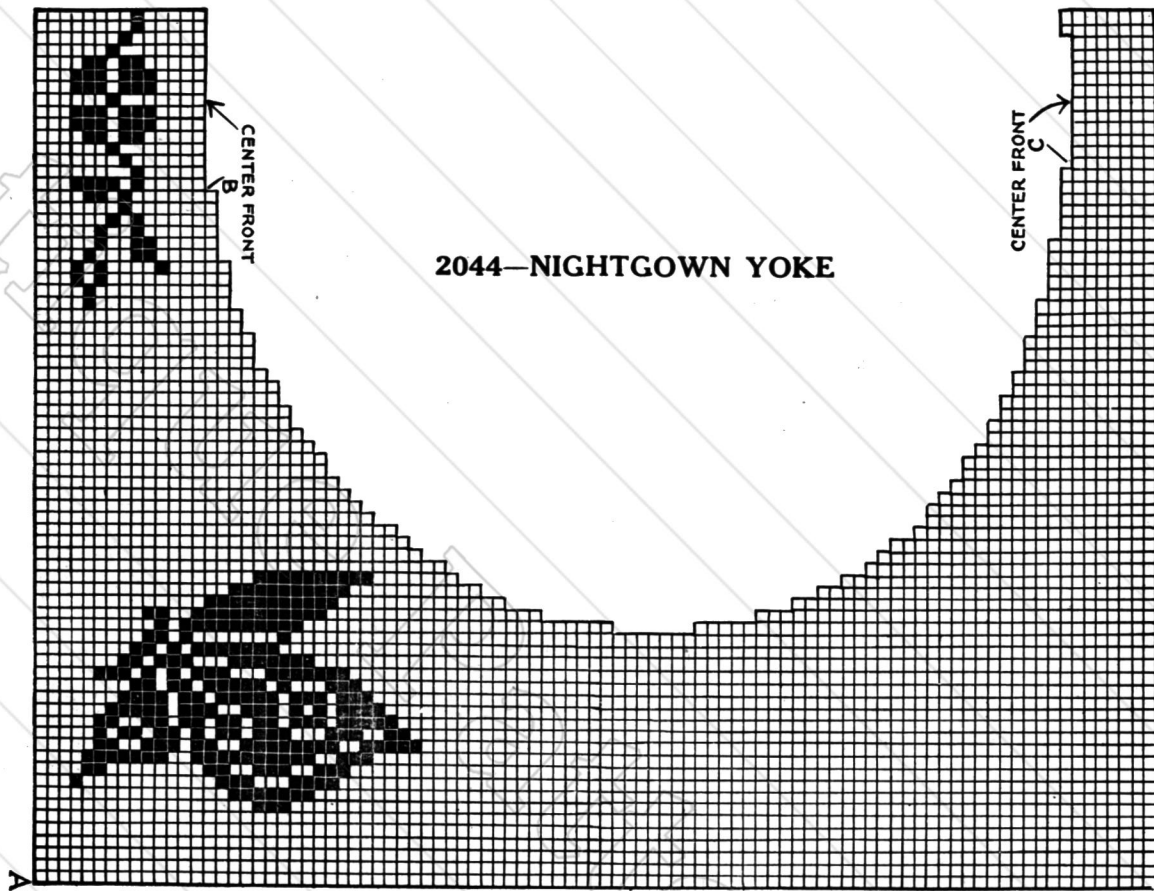

Crochet hook No. 13.

### YOKE.

To make filet start at letter A with 131 open ms., turn, continue following diagram until letter B is reached, then continue to letter C for one side of yoke. Now start at other side of front for other half, join both sides with 32 chs. for 11 ms. and work across for back.

### SLEEVE CAPS.

For filet of sleeve caps start at letter D with 1 open m. and continue working back and forth, increasing and decreasing as shown in diagram.

### FILET BEADING.

Start at letter E with 9 open ms., make 4 more rows of 9 open ms., \* turn, ch. 38, 1 sept.c. into last st. of previous row, turn, make 2 rows of 9 open ms., turn, 3 open ms., 1 closed m., 1 open m., 1 closed m., 3 open ms., turn, 2 open ms., 2 closed ms., 1 open m., 2 closed ms., 2 open ms., 1 open m., 2 closed ms., 2 open ms., turn, 4 open ms., turn, 2 open ms., 2 closed ms., 1 open m., 2 closed ms., 2 open ms., turn, 3 open ms., 1 closed m., 1 open m., 1 closed m., 3 open ms., turn, 2 rows of 9 open ms., turn, ch. 38, 1 sept.c. into last st. of previous row, turn, 3 rows of 9 open ms., repeat from \* for length indicated on diagram. Now work across both sides of beading 1 row of open ms.

Work all around outside of yoke 3 s.c. into 1 m., 2 s.c. into next m., 5 s.c. into corner m. Across both sides of beading make 3 s.c. into 1 m., 2 s.c. into next m., join beading to side of yoke, starting at corner of front, 1 s.c., ch. 1, 1 s.c. into s.c. on top of 27th m. from one end of beading, ch. 1, sk. 1 s.c. of yoke, 1 s.c., ch. 1, sk. 1 s.c. of beading, 1 s.c., continue across side of yoke.

Around sleeve cap make 3 s.c. into one m., 2 s.c. into next m. all around. Join curved side of same to beading, starting with 1 s.c. into s.c. on top of 27th m. at same end of beading at other side, ch. 1, 1 s.c. into first s.c. of curved side of sleeve cap, ch. 1, sk. 1 of beading, 1 s.c., ch. 1, sk. 1 of sleeve cap, 1 s.c., continue to last s.c. of same side of sleeve cap. Continue with 1 row of 1 s.c. into each st. across other side of sleeve cap.

Across inside of beading and across front of yoke make 1 row of 5 s.c., 1 p., sk. 1, 5 s.c., 1 p.

Proceed the same way at the back. Start at outside of beading and across sleeve caps for edging.

### EDGING.

Ch. 9, sk. 4, 1 s.c., 2 d.c. into chs., \* 1 tr.c. into next st., pull through 2 loops, sk. 2, 1 d.c., pull through all loops on needle, two at a time, ch. 4, form p., 1 d.c. into sp., 1 d.c. into center of sp., repeat from \* across.

At inside of yoke 1 row of 3 s.c. into one m., 2 s.c. into next m. all around. 1 other row of 1 s.c. into each st.

### BEADING.

Ch. 5, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., turn, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into second d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., turn, 6 sl.sts. across 2 ms., \* ch. 4, sk. 4, 1 tr.c., ch. 7, sk. 4, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., turn, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into second d.c., 1 d.c. into third of 7 chs., turn, 3 sl.sts. across m., repeat from \* around.

3 s.c. into each m., 4 s.c. around each ch. 4, 1 other row of 1 s.c. into each st., then make same edging as across sleeves.

## Nightgown Yoke No. 2045

### Materials required:

ROYAL SOCIETY Cordichet Pink 3015, size 70, 7 balls.  
Crochet hook No. 13.

Start the filet at letter A with 178 open ms., turn and continue following diagram until letter B is reached, then continue working across one side only for shoulder until letter C is reached.

Start again at front for other side for shoulder and join the two shoulder bands with 29 chs. for 10 open ms. Continue working across for back of yoke.

When filet is completed work around neck 3 s.c. into one m., 2 s.c. into next m., continue around, alternating. Make one other row of 1 s.c. into each st.

### BEADING.

Ch. 4, 1 tr.c. into next st., \* ch. 4, sk. 4, 1 tr.c., ch. 4, sk. 4, 2 tr.c. into next st. finished together, repeat from \* around, join.

### EDGING.

1 s.c., ch. 5, 1 s.c. into first space, 1 s.c., ch. 5, 1 s.c. into next space, continue around. Ch. 3, 1 d.c., 1 p., 2 d.c. around first ch. 5, 2 d.c., 1 p., 2 d.c. around next ch. 5, continue around.

### ACROSS FRONT OF YOKE.

One row of 3 s.c. into 1 m., 2 s.c. into next m. 1 other row of 1 s.c. into each st.

Make same beading as around neck. 1 row of 5 s.c. into each space. 1 row of 4 s.c., 1 p., sk. 1, 4 s.c., 1 p., sk. 1.

### ACROSS BACK OF YOKE.

One row of 3 s.c. into one m., 2 s.c. into next m., one other row of 4 s.c., 1 p., sk. 1, 4 s.c., 1 p., sk. 1.

To give the armhole the right width attach 27 chs. at point of back of yoke and 11 chs. at point of front of yoke, then work across, 1 s.c. into each ch. 3 s.c. into one m., 2 s.c. into next m., continue across, turn, one other row of 1 s.c. into each st. turn and make same edging as around neck.

Ch. 7, sk. 7, 1 d.c., ch. 7, sk. 7, 1 sl.st., turn, 9 s.c. around first ch. 7, 6 s.c. around next ch. 7, turn, ch. 7, sk. 5, 1 d.c., ch. 7, sk. 5, 1 sl.st., turn, 9 s.c. around each of two ch. 7, continue working toward center of slipper, 5 s.c. into each of 11 spaces, 1 s.c. into last loop on top of center round of medallion, ch. 10, 1 sl.st. into center of same round. Continue with sl.sts. over this half round and over three following rounds, 5 sl.sts. over next half round and 5 sl.sts. into 5 next sts., turn.

Ch. 5, sk. 4, 1 d.c., ch. 5, sk. 4, 1 tr.c., ch. 5, sk. 5, 1 sl.st., turn, 6 s.c. into two next spaces, turn, ch. 5, sk. 5, 1 d.c., ch. 5, sk. 5, 1 d.c., ch. 5, sk. 5, 1 tr.c., ch. 5, sk. 5, 1 s.c., ch. 5, sk. 5, 1 tr.c., ch. 5, sk. 5, 1 s.c., ch. 5, sk. 5, 1 tr.c., ch. 5, 1 sl.st. into fifth ch. of ch. 10, turn, 6 s.c. into each of next six spaces, turn and finish this side of slipper same as other side. Continue around bottom 5 s.c. into each space to center of slipper, join and work all around slipper 1 s.c. into each st.

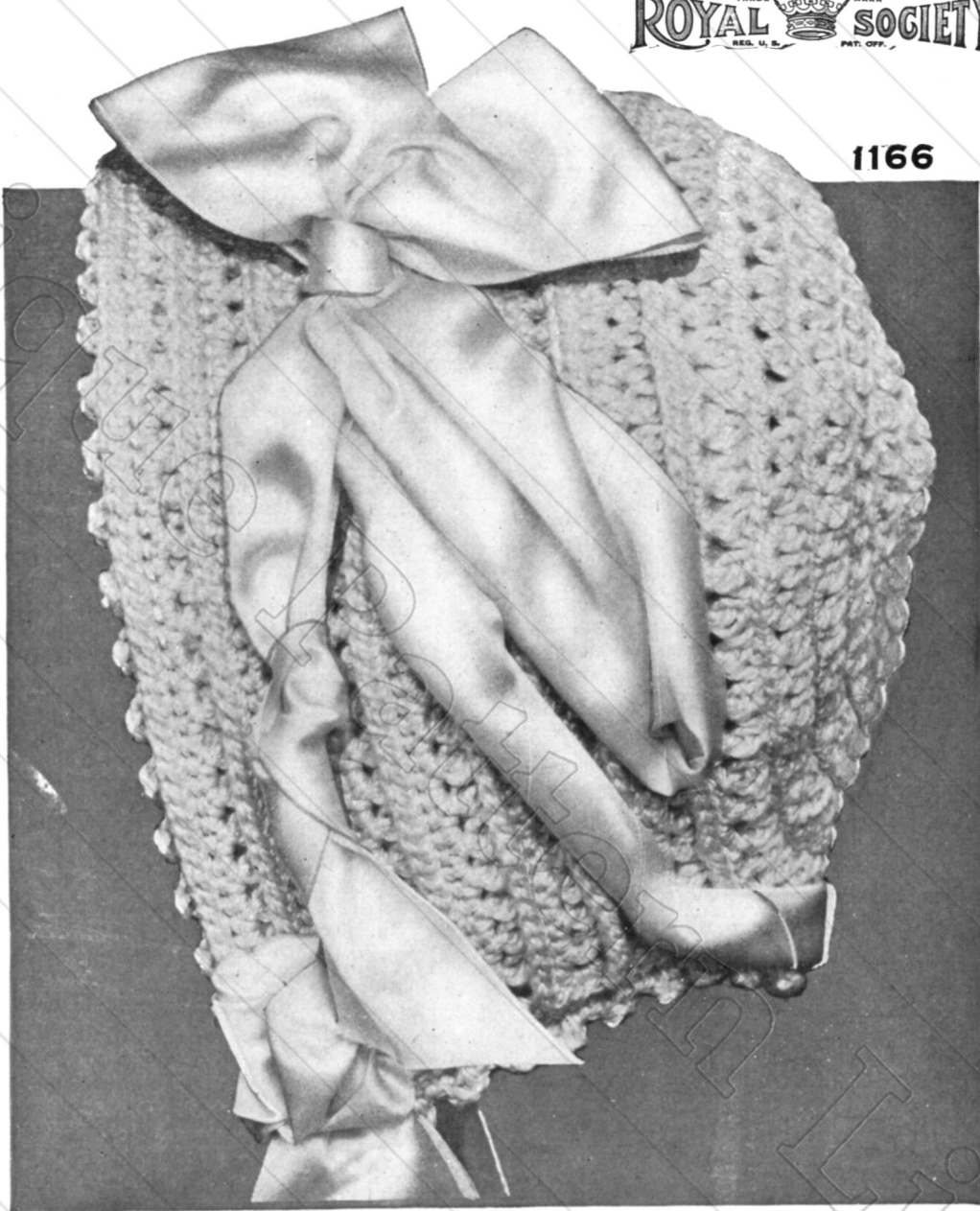

ROYAL SOCIETY Crochet

With cream crochet.

**1st Row.**—Ch. 6, join to ring, 10 s.c. into ring, join.

**2nd Row.**—Pull out a st. about  $\frac{1}{4}$  of an inch long, cotton around needle, insert into first st., taking up back rib and pull out again as long as the first st., cotton around needle, insert into next st., always take up back rib, pull out again and pull through all loops on needle, ch. 1. This forms a tuft st., \* cotton around needle, insert into same st. as before, pull out a loop the same length as previous st., cotton around needle insert next st. pull out, pull through all loops on needle, ch. 1, repeat from \* around (10 tuft sts. in all). Join to first st. of row.

**3rd Row.**—3 s.c. around ch. 1 between 2 first tuft sts., 2 s.c. around next ch. 1, continue around, alternating, join.

**4th Row.**—Pull out the st. about  $\frac{1}{4}$  of an inch, cotton around needle, insert into same as joining, cotton around needle, insert into next st., pull through all loops on needle, \* make one other tuft st., inserting into same and into the following st. Now make one tuft st., inserting into two following sts., repeat from \* around (17 tuft sts. in all), join.

**5th Row.**—3 s.c. around ch. 1 between 2 first tuft sts., 2 s.c. around next ch. 1, 3 s.c. around following ch. 1, continue around, join.

**6th Row.**—Pull out st., cotton around needle, insert into same st. as joining, cotton around needle, insert into next st., pull through all sts. on needle, \* make one other tuft st., inserting into same and into following st. of previous row, make one more tuft st. inserting into two new sts. of previous row, repeat from \* around (this row has 28 tuft sts. in all). Join.

(This row has 45 tuft sts.)

**11th Row.**—2 s.c. around each ch. 1, join.

**12th Row.**—Same as 10th row, only instead of 3 tuft sts. between creasing have 4 tuft sts. between.

**13th Row.**—2 s.c. around each ch. 1.

**14th Row.**—Pull out st., cotton around needle insert into same st. as joining, cotton around needle, insert into next st., pull through all loops at once, ch. 1, continue inserting for each tuft st., always into two new sts. until 43 tuft sts. are made, turn.

**15th Row.**—3 s.c. around first ch. 1, 2 s.c. around each of following ch. 1, 1 s.c. into st. of last tuft st., turn.

**16th Row.**—43 tuft sts.

Repeat 15th and 16th row 6 times more, ch. 1, continue across back of cap, 2 s.c. into row of tuft sts., 1 s.c. into row of s.c., 1 s.c. into each s.c. at center of back, continue across, join to first s.c. of front, turn ch. 1, 1 s.c. into each st. across back, finish off.

With No. 1000 blue crochet into 8 last rows of s.c. across front of cap, working into front rib. When s.c. are made into the last row into front ribs, continue across back of cap, working into back rib, 2 s.c., 1 p., sk. 1, 2 s.c., 1 p., sk. 1, continue across and around front of cap the same way.

This cap is lined with blue silk and trimmed with ribbon, as shown in cut.

**1st Row.**—Ch. 5, join to ring, 8 s.c. into ring, join.

**2nd Row.**—Ch. 7, 1 s.c., ch. 7, 1 s.c., continue for five more loops, ch. 3, 1 tr.c.

**3rd Row.**—Ch. 7, \* 1 s.c. into next loop, 7 tr.c. into next s.c. (this forms a shell), 1 s.c. into next loop, ch. 7, repeat from \* around.

**4th Row.**—4 sl.sts. to center of next loop, ch. 7, \* 1 s.c. into s.c. before shell, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into center st. of shell, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into s.c. after shell, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into next loop, ch. 7, repeat from \* three times more. To make last loop, ch. 3, 1 tr.c. into fourth sl.st. at beginning of row.

**5th Row.**—7 tr.c. into same as last tr.c., \* 1 s.c. into next loop, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into next loop, 7 tr.c. into next s.c., 1 s.c. into next loop, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into next loop, 7 tr.c. into next s.c., repeat from \* around.

**6th Row.**—4 sl.sts. to center of first shell, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into same as last sl.st., ch. 7, \* 1 s.c. into next loop, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into center of next shell, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into same, ch. 7, repeat from \* seven times more. To make last loop ch. 3, 1 tr.c. into fourth sl.st. at beginning of row.

**7th Row.**—Ch. 7, 1 s.c. into next loop, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into next loop, \* 7 tr.c. into next s.c., 1 s.c. into next loop, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into next loop, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into next loop, repeat from \* around.

**8th Row.**—4 sl. sts. to center of first loop, make two loops to center of shell, \* ch. 7, 1 s.c. into same, three loops, repeat from \* around. To make last loop always ch. 3, 1 tr.c. into first st. of row.

Make five more rows, always increasing eight times in each row as described before.

The 13th row has eight loops between each increasing.

**14th Row.**—Increase again the same way, then 4 loops, 1 shell, 4 loops and increase again.

**15th Row.**—Increase again in the same place, 10 loops and increase.

**16th Row.**—This row has no more increasing, 3 loops, 3 shells (the center shell must be on top of previous shell), 8 loops, 3 shells, continue around.

**17th Row.**—Loops all around.

**18th Row.**—5 loops, 1 shell (this shell must be in the center of the three shells), 10 loops, continue around.

Make 11 more rows of loops, ch. 3, 1 s.c. into next loop, ch. 3, 1 s.c. into following loop, continue around, join.

2 sl.sts. into 2 first chs., ch. 7, 1 tr.c. around next ch. 3, ch. 3, 1 tr.c. around following ch. 3, ch. 3, continue around, join.

### BRIM.

**1st Row.**—2 sl.sts. into 2 first sts., ch. 7, \* 1 s.c. around next ch. 3, ch. 7, 1 s.c. around next ch. 3, ch. 7, 1 s.c. around next ch. 3, ch. 7, 1 s.c. around same ch. 3, ch. 7, repeat from \* around. For last loop ch. 3, 1 tr.c. into first st. of row.

**2nd Row.**—Ch. 7, 1 s.c. around next loop, ch. 7, continue around. Make four more rows like second row.

**7th Row.**—Ch. 7, 1 s.c. into next loop, 7 tr.c. into next s.c., 1 s.c. into next loop, continue with 1 loop, 1 shell, all around.

**8th Row.**—Loops all around.

**9th Row.**—Again alternating, 1 loop, 1 shell.

**10th Row.**—Loops all around.

**11th Row.**—Edging. \* Ch. 6, 1 s.c. into fifth ch. from needle to form p., ch. 1, 1 s.c. into next loop, 1 tr.c., 1 p., 2 tr.c., ch. 4, form p., ch. 4, form p., ch. 4, form p., 1 s.c. into s.c. of first p., 2 tr.c., 1 p., 2 tr.c., all into next s.c., 1 s.c. into next loop, repeat from \* around.

To make up hat cut a piece of buckram 20 inches long and 2½ inches wide. Sew ends together. Cover a smooth wire with pink silk and sew around one side of buckram. Cut a piece of pink silk 21 inches long and 6½ inches wide. Sew ends together, gather on one side and sew other side to buckram near to covered wire. Edge a silk ribbon with dainty lace, so that ribbon and lace is about 2 inches wide, gather to crown, leaving just the covered wire showing at the inside. Put crochet over crown and sew to hat on row of tr.c. before brim is started.

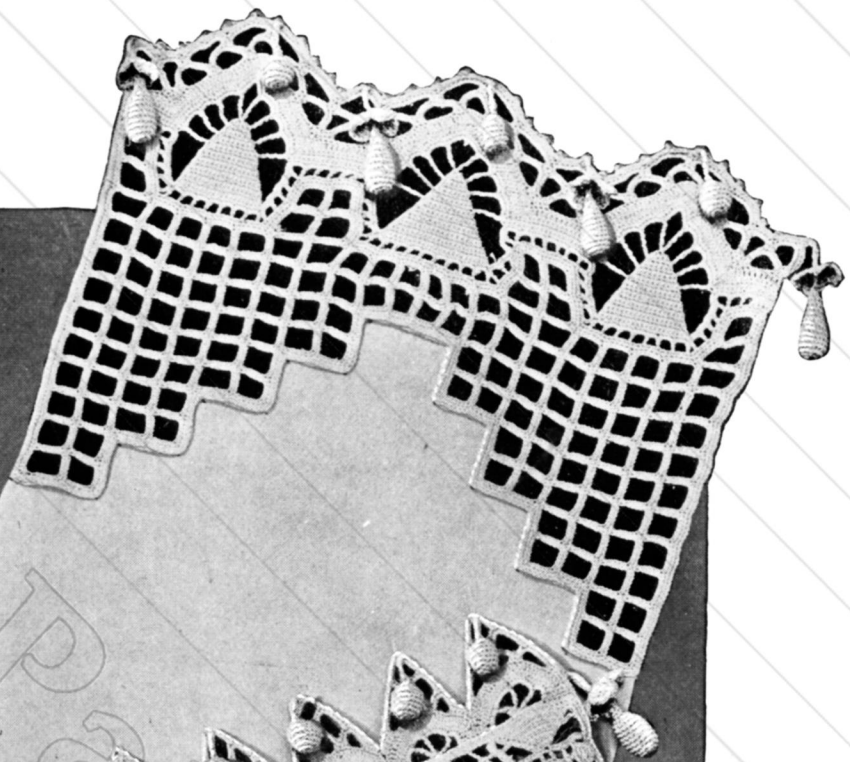

## Pillow No. 1180

Materials required:

ROYAL SOCIETY Cordichet Ecrú, size 3, 9 balls.

Crochet hook No. 7.

The style of stitch in this pillow is similar to the filet crochet, and the diagram is followed in the same way, only the meshes are larger. For open meshes ch. 3 instead of 2, and tr.c. instead of d.c. For closed meshes 5 tr.c. instead of 4 d.c. as in filet crochet. There is one other m. added to this pillow called cross mesh. To make this m., after tr.c. is made, 1 tr.c. into next ch., pull only twice through two loops, sk. 1, 1 d.c., pull through all loops on needle, two at a time, ch. 1, 1 d.c. into center of sps., 1 tr.c. into next tr.c.

To make spider in center of pillow, make d.tr.c. as indicated.

To make foundation ch., ch. 4 for each m. To turn, ch. 7 instead of ch. 5. Start at letter A and work across.

When square as shown in diagram is completed work all around, 1 tr.c. into each st., 7 tr.c. into corner st., one other row of 1 tr.c. into each st., 7 tr.c. into corner st., continue all around.

Ch. 7, sk. 3, 1 tr.c., ch. 3, sk. 3, 1 tr.c., continue. At corner ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into same. Join to fourth ch. from beginning.

One other row of 1 tr.c. into each st., 7 tr.c. into corner st., continue all around.

### EDGING.

15 s.c., \*, turn, ch. 9, sk. 6, 1 s.c., ch. 9, sk. 6, 1 s.c., turn, 13 s.c. around first ch. 9, 6 s.c. around next ch. 9, turn, ch. 9, 1 s.c. into center st. of first loop, turn, 13 s.c. around ch. 9, 6 s.c. around remaining of next ch. 9, 15 s.c. into next st. Repeat from \* around. One scallop shall be at each corner.

Trim center of square with petals.

Start around one of the eight spokes at center, ch. 15, attach with sl.st. to opposite corner of solid square, work into chs., 1 s.c., 1 h.d.c., 1

d.c., 9 tr.c., 1 d.c., 1 h.d.c., 1 s.c., ch. 1, work up foundation ch., 1 sl.st. into each st., 15 sl.sts. down the other side of petal, 1 s.c. around spoke at center, finish off.

Make one petal from each sp. as shown in cut.

Now make three petals the same way, only ch. 13 instead of 15 at each point of solid band, and two petals into each center of solid band also with 13 chs.

5 sl. sts. into five first sts., ch. 5, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., turn, ch. 5, sk. 3, 4 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., turn, ch. 5, sk. 3, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., \* ch. 5, sk. 5, 1 d.tr.c., ch. 11, sk. 5, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2, 2 more ms., turn, ch. 5, sk. 3, 4 d.c., sk. 2 chs., of ch. 11, 1 d.c. into next, ch. 2, sk. 2 chs. of ch. 11, 1 d.c., turn, sk. 2 d.c., 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., repeat from \* around, 3 s.c. into each m., 6 s.c. around each ch. 5, 1 row of 5 s.c., 1 p., sk. 1, 5 s.c., 1 p., sk. 1, continue around.

Across front of yoke and around sleeves proceed the same way as around neck.

Across back of yoke 3 s.c. into one m., 2 s.c. into next m., 1 row of 5 s.c., 1 p., sk. 1, 5 s.c., 1 p. across.

Ch. 3, sk. 1, 1 s.c. into next, 2 s.c. into last st., turn, 2 s.c., 2 s.c. into last st., turn, 5 s.c., turn, 6 s.c., turn, three times more 6 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 5 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 4 s.c., turn, cotton ten times around needle, insert into loop before first st. at beginning of last row, pull through all loops on needle (this forms bullion st.), 4 s.c. into sts. of previous row, working over single thread formed by bullion st., turn, 5 s.c., turn, 6 s.c., turn, 7 s.c., turn, two rows of 8 s.c., 1 bullion st. made the same way as before only cotton 18 times around needle, 2 rows of 8 s.c., turn, again 1 bullion st. with 18 times around needle, two rows of 8 s.c., turn, 4 s.c., 1 bullion st. 18 times around needle, 8 s.c., turn, 7 s.c., turn, 6 s.c., turn, 1 bullion st. 10 times around needle, 4 s.c., turn, 6 s.c., turn, 6 s.c., turn, 8 s.c., turn, 2 s.c., to form eyes, ch. 1, \* cotton over needle, catch around ch. 1, repeat from \* four times more, pull through all loops at once, 1 s.c. into last s.c. made, sk. 1, 2 s.c., repeat same for other eye, 2 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 6 s.c. across, turn, 6 s.c., turn, 4 s.c., turn, 2 s.c., make s.c. all around body.

### LARGE WING.

**1st Row.**—Ch. 4, join to ring, 8 s.c. into ring, join.

**2nd Row.**—Ch. 4, 1 tr.c. into next st., \* ch. 4, 1 tr.c. into same, 1 tr.c. into next st., finish both together. Repeat twice from \*, turn.

**3rd Row.**—4 s.c. into each of three spaces, turn.

**4th Row.**—1 s.c. into each st., turn.

**5th Row.**—Ch. 4, 1 tr.c. into next st., \* ch. 4, 1 tr.c. into same, sk. 2, 1 tr.c. into next st., finish the two last tr.c. together. Repeat from \* three times more, turn.

**6th Row.**—4 s.c. into each of four spaces, turn.

**7th Row.**—4 s.c., ch. 9, 16 tr.c. into fifth ch. from needle, join. 1 sl.st. through first ch. made, 8 s.c. into following sts., ch. 9, 4 tr.c. into fifth ch. from needle. Catch into fourth st. of previous round, 12 more tr.c. into same st. as before, join. 1 sl.st. through first ch., 4 s.c. into following sts., turn.

**8th Row.**—Ch. 5, 1 d.c. into fourth st. of last round. Ch. 9, sk. 4 sts. of round, 1 s.c., ch. 8, 1 s.c. into fifth st. from joining of next round, ch. 5, cotton three times around needle, insert into fourth following st. of round, pull through two loops, cotton twice around needle, pull through all loops on needle, two at a time, turn.

**9th Row.**—6 s.c. into first space, 11 s.c. into next space, 6 s.c. into last space, turn.

**10th Row.**—13 s.c., turn, ch. 9, sk. 5, 1 tr.c., ch. 9, sk. 5, 1 s.c., turn.

**11th Row.**—9 s.c. into first space, 6 s.c. into next space, turn.

**12th Row.**—Ch. 5, sk. 5, 1 tr.c., ch. 5, sk. 5, 1 s.c., turn.

**13th Row.**—7 s.c. into first space, 1 s.c. into sp., 7 s.c. into next space, continue working around wing, 1 s.c. into each row of s.c., 5 s.c. into each space until beginning of wing is reached, 4 sl.sts. into remaining sts. of first row, continue up the other side of wing with s.c. until first st. of row is reached.

**14th Row.**—1 s.c. into each st., 1 sl.st. into each sl.st., finish off.

### SMALL WING.

The six first rows are same as six first rows for large wing.

**7th Row.**—1 s.c. into each st.

**8th Row.**—Ch. 9, sk. 3, 1 tr.c., ch. 5, sk. 3, 1 tr.c., ch. 5, sk. 3, 1 tr.c., ch. 5, sk. 4, 1 tr.c., turn.

**9th Row.**—6 s.c. into three first spaces, 11 s.c. into next space, continue working around with s.c. the same way as around large wing until first st. of row is reached.

**10th Row.**—5 s.c. into sts., 5 d.c. into next st., 1 s.c. into each st. around, into 4 sl.sts. again 4 sl.sts., finish off.

To join wings hold the two right sides of two different wings together. Start at twelfth s.c., counting from sl.st., and join with sl.sts. into six next sts., working toward beginning of wings and taking up back rib only, then ch. 6, sk. 5 sts. of small wing, 1 tr.c., turn, sk. 5 sts. of large wing, 1 tr.c., turn, 1 s.c. around first tr.c. made, finish off.

Join wings to body, starting at second s.c. of large wing and at curve of body, which indicates head. Take up back rib only and join with s.c. At each tr.c., take up four loops for four sts. of body. Continue until curve to indicate tail is reached.

When both sides are joined, continue with s.c. taking up back rib to point of tail, 1 p., 1 s.c. into each st. to wing, 11 s.c. into sts. of wing, turn, ch. 5, sk. 3, 1 s.c., turn, 4 s.c., 1 p., 4 s.c. around ch. 5, 6 s.c., make two more scallops like this, 3 s.c., turn, ch. 5, sk. 2, 1 s.c., turn, finish scallops, 5 s.c., make three scallops like the three first ones, 5 s.c., 11 s.c. into sts. of large wing, turn, ch. 5, sk. 3, 1 s.c., finish scallop, make four more scallops, 3 s.c., turn, ch. 5, sk. 2, 1 s.c., turn, finish scallop, 5 s.c., make five more scallops as before, 1 s.c. into each st. until joining to body is reached, 1 s.c. into each st. around head, continue same way for other side.

### SMALL BUTTERFLY—BODY.

Ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 s.c., turn, 2 s.c., turn, 3 s.c., turn, 4 s.c., turn, 3 s.c., turn, 2 s.c., 1 bullion st., cotton five times around needle, made the same way as for larger butterfly, 2 s.c., turn, 3 s.c., turn, 4 s.c., turn, 5 s.c., turn, twice more 5 s.c., turn, 1 bullion st., cotton twelve times around needle, 5 s.c., turn, 4 s.c., turn, 3 s.c., turn, 2 s.c., 1 bullion st., cotton five times around needle, 2 s.c., turn, 3 s.c., turn, 4 s.c., turn, 5 s.c., turn, 1 s.c. To make eyes, ch. 1, \* cotton over needle, catch around ch. 1, repeat from \* twice, 1 s.c. into last s.c. made, sk. 1, 1 s.c., repeat for other eye, 1 s.c. into last st., turn, sk. 1, 2 s.c., sk. 1, 1 s.c., make s.c. all around the body, finish off.

### WINGS.

**1st Row.**—Ch. 4, join to ring, 8 s.c. into ring, join.

**2nd Row.**—Ch. 4, 1 tr.c., \* ch. 4, 1 tr.c. into same, 1 tr.c. into next st., finish both tr.c. together, repeat from \* twice more, turn.

**3rd Row.**—5 s.c. into each space, turn.

**4th Row.**—7 s.c., turn, ch. 7, sk. 3, 1 tr.c., ch. 7, sk. 3, 1 s.c., turn, 9 s.c. into each space, 4 s.c. into following st., ch. 9, 16 tr.c. into fifth ch. from needle, join, 1 sl.st. into first ch., 4 s.c. into remaining sts., turn.

**5th Row.**—Ch. 5, 1 d.c. into fourth st. of round. Ch. 9, sk. 4 sts. of round, 1 s.c., ch. 9, sk. 4, 1 d.c., ch. 5, 1 s.c. into last s.c. near space, turn.

**6th Row.**—6 s.c. into first space, 9 s.c. into next space, 6 s.c. into third space, turn.

**7th Row.**—Ch. 6, sk. 5, 1 tr.c., ch. 6, sk. 5, 1 s.c., turn.

**8th Row.**—7 s.c. into first space, 1 s.c. into sp., 7 s.c. into next space, 6 s.c. into each of two next spaces, 2 sl.sts. across two rows of s.c., 4 sl.sts. into chs., 3 sl.sts. into sts. of first row, 4 sl.sts. into tr.c., 2 sl.sts. into two rows of s.c.

Join wings to body the same way as for larger butterflies.

Continue with s.c. into sts. of tail to point, 1 p., s.c. into sts. to wing, continue around wings 5 s.c., 1 p., 5 s.c., 1 p. Around head 1 s.c. into each st.

### EDGING FOR SET.

**1st Row.**—Into material, 1 s.c., ch. 1, 1 s.c., continue around.

**2nd Row.**—\* Ch. 5, sk. 1, 1 tr.c., sk. 3, 1 tr.c., finish both tr.c. together, ch. 5, sk. 1, 1 s.c., ch. 2, sk. 3, 1 s.c., repeat from \* around.

**3rd Row.**—6 s.c. around first ch. 5, 1 s.c. into next st., \* ch. 4, form p., ch. 4, form p., ch. 4, form p., 1 s.c. into s.c. of first p., 6 s.c. around next ch. 5, 1 s.c. around ch. 2, 4 s.c. around next ch. 5, turn, ch. 4, 1 s.c. into second st. after ps., turn, 3 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c. around ch. 4, 2 s.c. around remaining of ch. 5, 1 s.c. into next st., repeat from \* around.

**4th Row.**—Ch. 3, \* 2 d.c., ch. 5, form p., ch. 5, form p., ch. 5, form p., 1 sl.st. into s.c. of first p., 2 d.c. into following sts., 2 ms., 2 d.c., ch. 5, form p. with sl.st., 2 d.c., 2 ms., repeat from \* around.

The style of stitch in this baby outfit is similar to the filet crochet, and the diagram is followed in the same way, only the meshes are larger. For open meshes ch. 3 instead of 2, and 1 tr.c. instead of d.c., as in filet crochet. For closed meshes 5 tr.c. instead of 4 d.c., as in filet crochet.

To make foundation ch. of each piece ch. 4 for each m., to turn ch. 7 instead of 5, as in filet crochet.

To make back of coat start at letter A with 40 open ms., as described above, turn, add 12 ms., at each side and continue following diagram.

Start the fronts at letter B with 19 open ms., and continue increasing as shown in diagram.

The sleeves are started at letter C with 14 open ms., turn, continue increasing and decreasing.

The cuffs are started at letter D with 35 open ms.

The collar is started at letter E with 34 open ms., continue to letter F and finish one side, then make other side the same way.

When two fronts and back are completed, join at shoulders and under arm, always 4 s.c. into each hole.

After sleeves are finished, join them, starting at lower edge with 4 s.c. into each hole, then join into armhole, starting at eighth hole of front from underarm seam, with 4 s.c. into each hole.

Into meshes around lower edge of sleeve, starting at seam, working toward top, 4 s.c. into four first ms., 2 s.c. into 30 following ms., 4 s.c. into 10 remaining ms.

When cuffs are finished work all around 4 s.c. into each hole, 9 s.c. into corner holes, one other row of 1 s.c. into each st., join the four first sts.

of shortest side with s.c., then join the remaining sts. to sleeve, starting at 11th hole of sleeve from seam at underarm. Around ends of cuffs and longer side continue with edging, 6 s.c., \* turn, ch. 4, sk. 3, 1 sl.st., turn, 4 s.c., 1 p., 4 s.c. around ch. 4, 6 s.c., repeat from \* around.

When collar is completed join to coat, starting at front into eighth hole from shoulder seam with 4 s.c. into each hole. Now work all around the coat and the collar 4 s.c. into each hole, 9 s.c. into corner hole.

**Edging.**—1 row of 1 s.c. into each st., 6 s.c., \* turn, ch. 4, sk. 3, 1 sl.st., turn, 4 s.c., 1 p., 4 s.c. around ch. 4, 6 s.c., repeat from \* around.

This coat is lined with white silk. Cut lining a trifle larger than each crochet piece, join them and sew to two rows of s.c. all around coat.

The collar and cuffs are lined with white chiffon.

## Baby Cap No. 1164

ROYAL SOCIETY Cordichet White, size 50, 1 ball.  
Crochet hook No. 12.

This bonnet is worked in two parts, front and back, and joined. To make back of cap, start at letter G with 24 open ms. as described for coat, and continue following diagram. Start front of cap at letter H with 55 open ms., and continue as shown in diagram.

Work around curved part of back of cap 4 s.c. into each mesh, turn, 1 row of 1 s.c. into each s.c., turn.

**BEADING.**

Ch. 7, sk. 2, \* 1 tr.c., pull through two loops, sk. 2 s.c., 1 d.c., pull through remaining loops on needle, two at a time, ch. 2, 1 d.c. into center of sps., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 tr.c., ch. 3. Repeat from \* around curved part, turn, 3 s.c. around each ch. 2, turn. With next row join curved side of front part, 1 s.c. into each of four next s.c. and at the same time around sts. of first mesh of front side, continue all around.

Work all around cap 4 s.c. into each mesh, 9 s.c. into corner meshes, one other row of 1 s.c. into each mesh.

**EDGING.**

5 s.c., \* turn, ch. 4, sk. 3, 1 sl.st., turn, 4 s.c., 1 p., 4 s.c. around ch. 4, 6 s.c. into following sts., repeat from \* around.

To line this bonnet cut white silk lining the same shape as the two crochet pieces before joining them. Seam them together and sew lining to bonnet all around. Trim with ribbon.

When filet is completed join the two ends with 4 s.c. into each hole.

Across bottom of booties make 5 s.c. into each hole, 1 s.c. into each st.

Across top 5 s.c. into each hole, turn, 1 s.c. into each st., turn, ch. 7, sk. 3, 1 tr.c., ch. 3, sk. 3, 1 tr.c., continue across, turn, ch. 7, making one other row of same meshes.

Now work around the instep 4 s.c. into each hole, turn, 1 s.c. into each st., turn and make loops for lacing ribbon around instep, 7 s.c., turn, ch. 5, sk. 4, 1 s.c., turn, 11 s.c. around ch. 5, 7 s.c., continue (5 loops on each side of instep). Continue across top with edging, 6 s.c., \* turn, ch. 4, sk. 3, 1 sl.st., turn, 4 s.c., 1 p., 4 s.c. around ch. 4, 6 s.c., repeat from \*.

These booties are lined with white silk. Before joining cut lining a trifle larger, then crochet and sew to booties all around 2 rows of s.c.

Sew to sole Size 2.

**4th Row.**—2 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c., continue around, join (8 ps. in all).

**5th Row.**—Ch. 8, 1 d.c. into same, \* ch. 4, 1 s.c. between two next ps., ch. 4, 1 d.c. between two following ps., ch. 5, 1 d.c. into same, repeat from \* around, join to third ch. from beginning.

**14th Row.**—Ch. 7, 1 d.c. into d.t.r.c., 10 ms., 1 d.t.r.c. into next d.c., turn.

**15th Row.**—Sk. 1, 1 sl.st., ch. 5, 10 ms., ch. 2, 1 d.t.r.c. into same, turn.

**16th Row.**—Ch. 1, sk. 1, 7 sl.sts., ch. 5, 7 ms., 1 d.t.r.c. into next d.c.

**17th Row.**—Sk. 1, 1 sl.st., ch. 5, 6 ms., turn.

**18th Row.**—5 ms., 1 d.t.r.c. into next d.c., turn.

**19th Row.**—Sk. 1, 1 sl.st., ch. 5, 5 ms., turn.

**20th Row.**—3 ms., 1 d.t.r.c. into next d.c., turn.

**21st Row.**—Sk. 1, 1 sl.st., ch. 5, 3 ms., turn.

**22nd Row.**—1 m., 1 d.t.r.c. into next d.c., turn.

**23rd Row.**—Sk. 1, 1 sl.st., ch. 5, sk. 2, 1 d.c., finish off.

Start at other side and repeat the same from and including 10th row.

Make three more corners the same way.

**TO JOIN CORNERS.**

Start at end of one corner into eight last rows, working downwards, 2 s.c. into each space, now take one other corner and into last row, working upwards, make 2 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 1 s.c., 2 s.c. into next sts. of other side, turn, sk. 1, 2 s.c., 2 s.c. into following space, turn, sk. 1, 5 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 4 s.c., 2 s.c. into next space, turn, sk. 1, 7 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 6 s.c., 2 s.c. into next space, turn, sk. 1, 9 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 8 s.c., 2 s.c. into next space, turn, sk. 1, 11 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 10 s.c., 2 s.c. into next space, turn, sk. 1, 13 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 6 s.c., ch. 1, 5 d.c., turn, 1 sl.st. around ch. 1, 5 s.c., 2 s.c. into next space, turn, sk. 1, 15 s.c., turn, sk. 1, 6 s.c., ch. 1, 5 d.c., turn, 1 sl.st. around ch. 1, 1 s.c., ch. 1, 5 d.c., turn, 1 sl.st. around ch. 1, 5 s.c., 2 s.c. into next space, turn, sk. 1, 16 s.c., 2 s.c. into next space, 2 s.c. into each of two next spaces over sl.sts., turn, sk. the seven last s.c., 14 s.c., 2 s.c. into each of two next spaces, sk. seven last s.c., 1 sl.st., turn, 2 sl.sts. into 2 sps. of last space, turn, ch. 2, sk. 1, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 1, 1 sl.st. into center of next space, finish off.

**AROUND INSIDE OF PILLOW.**

3 s.c. into each space, join. Now finish the inside the same as inside for scarf from second row.

**AROUND OUTSIDE OF PILLOW.**

**1st Row.**—3 s.c. into each space, 9 s.c. into corner space, join.

**2nd Row.**—1 s.c. into each st., 3 s.c. into center st. at corner.

**3rd and 4th Rows.**—Same as 2nd row.

To make filet panel start at letter A with 46 open ms., turn and continue following diagram. Into eighth row when lacet st. is indicated on diagram after two closed ms. are made, ch. 3, sk. 2, 1 s.c., ch. 3, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 3, sk. 2, 1 s.c., ch. 3, sk. 2, two closed ms.

Into next row to continue lacet st., after two closed ms. are made, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into next d.c., ch. 5, two closed ms.

The lacet is always made this same way where indicated on diagram.

When filet is completed work all around it, 3 s.c. into one m., 2 s.c. into next m., 7 s.c. into corner m., join.

1 row of 1 d.c. into each st., 5 d.c. into center st. at corners.

**BAND FOR FRINGES.**

Ch. 438, sk. 3, 3 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., continue until 33 open ms. are made, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into same to form corner, ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2, continue again until 15 open ms. from corner are made, sk. 5, 1 d.c., this forms another corner. Make again 47 open ms. form last corner, sk. 5, 1 d.c., 15 open ms., ch. 5, 1 d.c. into same, 33 open ms., 3 d.c. into last chs.

Work across both sides of these ms., 1 d.c. into each d.c., 2 d.c. into each m. Into corner m. 7 d.c., at angles finish 5 d.c. together.

Across outside of band to attach fringes make 2 s.c., ch. 3, sk. 3, 2 s.c., ch. 3, sk. 3, continue to angle, then down the side of 15 ms. 1 s.c. into each st., across 37 ms. again 2 s.c., ch. 3, sk. 3, 2 s.c., continue across.

**FRINGES.**

Wind No. 2 Cordichet around cardboard eight inches long, cut. Take five of these strands, fold and pull with heavy crochet needle through first loop of ch. 3 from wrong side to right. Proceed same way as to make a ch., pull out, repeat into each ch. 3.

This gives 10 strands into each fringe. Take five strands of first fringe and make knot about  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch from top, take five strands from same fringe and five strands from next fringe and again make a knot, continue like this second knot across.

Ch. 5, make another row of ms., 21 ms. to center st. of corner, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into same, 40 ms., ch. 5, 1 d.c. into same, 21 ms., turn.

Around outside of band, 1 d.c. into each d.c., 2 d.c. into each m., 7 d.c. into corner m., around inside of band repeat the same, only at angles finish 5 d.c. together.

**3rd Row.**—6 s.c. into chs., ch. 7, sk. 1, 6 s.c. into chs., 1 s.c. into s.c., continue across 2 squares, 1 s.c. into each st.

**4th Row.**—Ch. 24, turn, 1 sl.st. into first ch. made, 1 sl.st. into next s.c., turn, 6 s.c. into chs., \* ch. 12, sk. 4, 2 sl.sts., turn, 6 s.c. into chs., repeat from \* twice more.

**5th Row.**—Ch. 1, 1 s.c. into each st. across four squares, turn.

**6th Row.**—Ch. 18, make again four squares.

**7th Row.**—Ch. 7, sk. 1, 1 s.c. into each st. until 6 s.c. into last square are made.

**8th Row.**—Ch. 24, and proceed the same way as in fourth row for six squares.

**3rd Row.**—Ch. 1, 1 s.c. into each st. until 6 s.c. into chs. of seventh square are made, turn.

**4th Row.**—Ch. 18, sk. 5 s.c., 2 sl.sts., turn, 6 s.c. into chs., turn, ch. 12, continue for three more squares (four squares in all).

**5th Row.**—Ch. 1, 1 s.c. into each st. over four squares, turn.

**6th Row.**—Ch. 18, three squares.

**7th Row.**—Ch. 1, s.c. over three squares, turn.

**8th Row.**—Ch. 18, two squares.

**9th Row.**—Ch. 1, 13 s.c., turn, ch. 18, sk. 5, 2 sl.sts., turn, 6 s.c. into chs., ch. 1, 6 s.c., turn.

Continue with 1 s.c. into each st. across side and repeat same for other end.

At each corner of pillow attach an ornament as described for scarf.

At each of five scallops at end of pillow attach a ball, as described for scarf.

**3rd Row.**—Ch. 4, \* 13 tr.c. into sts., 2 tr.c. into each of seven next sts., repeat from \*, join.

**4th Row.**—Ch. 4, \* 13 tr.c., 2 tr.c. into each of 14 next sts., repeat from \*, join.

**5th Row.**—Ch. 4, \* 13 tr.c., 2 tr.c., into next st., 1 tr.c. into following st., 2 tr.c. into next st., continue alternating until 14 times 2 tr.c. are made, repeat from \*, join.

**6th Row.**—Ch. 4, \* 13 tr.c., 2 tr.c. into next st., 1 tr.c. into each of two next sts., 2 tr.c. into next st., continue until 14 times 2 tr.c. are made, repeat from \*, join.

**7th Row.**—Same as sixth row, but 3 tr.c. between, increasing.

**8th Row.**—1 s.c. into each st. (This completes bottom for basket.)

**9th Row.**—1 s.c. into each st., taking up back rib, join.

sixth st. of previous loop, 5 s.c. around next ch. 9, 11 s.c. around 3 following ch. 9, 5 s.c. around next ch. 9, turn, ch. 9, sk. 4 sts. of previous loop, 2 s.c., turn, 11 s.c. around ch. 9, 6 s.c. around remaining of next ch. 9, continue across.

Repeat the same from \* at fourth row for other half of valance.

**3rd Row.**—\* Ch. 14, 1 s.c. into fifth ch. from needle to form p., ch. 7, 1 s.c. into fifth ch. from needle, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into fifth ch. from needle, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into fifth ch. from needle and into s.c. of third p., ch. 7, 1 s.c. into fifth ch. from needle and into s.c. of second p., ch. 7, 1 s.c. into fifth ch. from needle and into s.c. of first p., ch. 9, sk. 4, 1 s.c., repeat from \* eight times more, then repeat again from \*, but after ch. 9 make 1 s.c. into same. Now continue same as other side for 9 Edelweis. To make last Edelweis, ch. 9, 1 sex.c. into same as last s.c., ch. 5, form p., turn, ch. 5, form p., ch. 7, 1 s.c. into fifth ch. from needle, turn, 1 d.c. into s.c. of p. below, 1 p., turn, ch. 7, 1 s.c. into fifth ch. from needle, turn, 1 d.c. into s.c. of p. below, 1 p., turn, ch. 2, 1 p. into s.c. of p. below, turn, ch. 2, 1 d.c. into d.c.

Finish last Edelweis as described in third row of lower part of bag.

**9th Row.**—Ch. 15, 1 s.c. into p. at point of first Edelweis, ch. 15, continue around. Finish row with ch. 7, 1 quint.c. into first s.c. of row.

**10th Row.**—Same as eighth row, only work s.c. around each ch. 15.

**11th Row.**—Same as ninth row.

**12th Row.**—Ch. 11, 1 s.c. into p. at point of next Edelweis, ch. 11, continue around, join last ch. 11 to first st. of row.

**13th Row.**—Ch. 5, 1 d.t.r.c. into each st., join.

**14th Row.**—Ch. 11, sk. 5, 1 d.t.r.c., sk. 5, 1 d.t.r.c., continue around, join last ch. 5 to sixth ch. from beginning.

**15th and 16th Rows.**—Same as fourteenth row.

**17th Row.**—Ch. 4, 1 d.t.r.c. into each st., join.

**18th Row.**—5 s.c., 1 p., 5 s.c., \* ch. 4, form p., ch. 4, form p., ch. 4, form p., 1 s.c. into s.c. of first p., 5 s.c., 1 p., 5 s.c., repeat from \* around.

At other side of foundation ch. of upper part, ch. 5, 1 d.t.r.c. into each st., join, 5 s.c., 1 p., sk. 1, 5 s.c., \* ch. 4, form p., ch. 4, form p., ch. 4, form p., 1 s.c. into s.c. of first p., 5 s.c., 1 p., 5 s.c., repeat from \* around. Trim with four tassels across bottom and 2 tassels on each side.

**TASSEL.**

Wind cotton 150 times around cardboard 4½ inches long, cut, tie in center.

**Top for Tassel.**—Ch. 4, join to ring, 8 s.c. into ring, continue without joining, 2 s.c. into each st. until 16 s.c. are made, make 7 more rows of 16 s.c., pull cup over top of tassel and sew on.

This bag is lined with white taffeta, for which a piece 14 inches long and 24 inches wide is required. Gather at the bottom and sew between two first rows of lower part of bag. Sew last row or lower part to silk, putting crochet over it. Now make a fold into silk about 2½ inches wide, and at top of silk make a heading 2 inches wide, sew through heading once more 1½ inches from top to make beading. Now place upper part of bag over silk, the picots of last row at bottom looking over the edge of the fold and at the top looking over heading and sew on. In this bag white silk cord is used for draw strings.

Now join again, and continue to neck.

With No. 3017 Cordichet, 1 s.c. into first loop, ch. 1, 1 s.c. into next loop, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into next loop, ch. 1, continue across shoulder, around the sleeve and again across shoulder of front. Finish off.

**4th Row.**—Ch. 10, sk. 4, 1 fr. c., ch. 4, 1 s.c. into center st. of first loop, ch. 4, continue across, ch. 4, 1 tr. c. into last st.

Repeat these four rows once more. (This gives four rows of loops.)

**Curve for Neck.** 4 s.c. around first ch. 4, 1 s.c. into tr. c., 3 s.c. around next ch. 4, turn, ch. 8, sk. 5, 1 sl.st., turn, 11 s.c. around ch. 8, 1 s.c. around same ch. 4, 1 s.c. into s.c., 4 s.c. around next ch. 4, 1 s.c. into tr. c., 3 s.c., around next ch. 4, turn, ch. 8, sk. 5, 1 sl.st., turn, 5 s.c. around ch. 8, turn, ch. 3, 1 tr. c. between two last loops made, ch. 4, 1 s.c. into center st. of next loop, ch. 4, 1 tr. c. into last st., turn, 4 s.c., 1 s.c., 4 s.c., 1 s.c., 3 s.c., turn, ch. 8, sk. 5, 1 sl.st., turn, 5 s.c. around ch. 8, turn, ch. 4, 1 tr. c. into last st. of previous row, turn, 5 s.c. into each of 2 next holes, 2 s.c. into next small space of ch. 4, 5 s.c. into next hole, 1 s.c. around same ch. 4 of eighth row, 4 s.c. around each of five next ch. 4, 1 s.c. into sts., turn, ch. 8, sk. 5, 1 sl.st., turn, 11 s.c. around ch. 8, 1 s.c. around same ch. 4, 1 s.c. 4 s.c., 1 s.c., 3 s.c., turn, ch. 8, sk. 5, 1 sl.st., turn, 11 s.c. around ch. 8, 1 s.c., turn, ch. 10, 1 s.c. into center of loop, ch. 4, 1 tr. c. between two loops, ch. 4, 1 s.c. into center of loop, turn, 4 s.c., 1 s.c., 3 s.c., turn, ch. 8, sk. 5, 1 sl.st., turn, 11 s.c. around ch. 8, 1 s.c., 1 s.c., 4 s.c., turn, ch. 10, 1 s.c. into center st. of loop, turn, 11 s.c. around ch. 10. Continue down the side, 5 s.c. into each space, turn, make 1 s.c. into each st. up the side and across curve for neck, down the side 5 s.c. into each space, turn, 1 s.c. into each st. up this same side. Across bottom of yoke make 1 row of s.c.

With No. 3017 Cordichet work across sides and bottom, 5 s.c., \* turn, ch. 4, sk. 3, 1 sl.st., turn, 3 s.c., 1 p., 3 s.c. around ch. 4, 5 s.c. into following sts., repeat from \* across. Continue across neck with 5 s.c., 1 p., sk. 1, 5 s.c.

Place yoke to stamped lines.

**STRAP FOR BELT.**

With No. 3016 Cordichet, ch. 12, sk. 1, 9 s.c., turn, ch. 8, sk. 5, 1 s.c., turn, 11 s.c. around ch. 8, 3 s.c. into remaining sts., turn, ch. 10, 1 s.c. into center of loop, ch. 4, 1 tr. c. into last st., turn, 5 s.c. around ch. 4, 1 s.c. into s.c., 3 s.c. around ch.

10, turn, ch. 8, sk. 5, 1 s.c., turn, 11 s.c. around ch. 8, 2 s.c. around same ch. 10, turn, ch. 10, 1 s.c. into center of loop, ch. 4, 1 tr. c. into last st., turn, 5 s.c. around ch. 4, 1 s.c., 3 s.c., turn, ch. 8, sk. 5, 1 s.c., turn, 11 s.c. around ch. 8, 2 s.c., turn, ch. 10, 1 s.c. into center of loop, ch. 4, 1 tr. c. into last st.

Work down the side of strap 5 s.c. into each space, across bottom 1 s.c. into each st., up the side and across top 5 s.c. into each space.

With No. 3017 Cordichet work all around strap 5 s.c., 1 p., 5 s.c.

Six straps are required.

The belt is trimmed with crochet button.

**BUTTON.**

Ch. 4, join to ring, 8 s.c. into ring, 2 s.c. into each st. until 16 s.c. are made, 2 s.c. into first, 1 s.c. into next until 24 s.c. are made, 2 s.c. into one, 1 s.c. into each of two next sts., 2 s.c. into next, continue until 32 s.c. are made. Make three rows of 32 s.c., put mould inside, sk. 1, 2 s.c., sk. 1, continue for 1 row, then sk. 1, 1 s.c., sk. 1, 1 s. c. until closed.

**EDGE ACROSS TOP OF BAG.**

**1st Row.**—With No. 3016 Cordichet into material s.c. near together.

**2nd Row.**—Ch. 5, sk. 3, 1 s.c., ch. 5, sk. 3, 1 s.c., continue across.

**3rd Row.**—With No. 3017 Cordichet, 1 s.c. into first loop, \* ch. 1, 1 s.c. into next loop, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into next loop, repeat from \* across.

**4th Row.**—1 s.c. around ch. 1, 4 s.c., 1 p., 4 s.c. around ch. 5.

**BAND TO COVER SEAM OF BAG.**

Make a ch. long enough to ridge around seam, ch. 3, sk. 3, 1 d.c. into each st. Into other side of foundation ch., 1 d.c. into each st.

With No. 3017 Cordichet, 1 s.c. into each st. at each side of band.

**STRAPS.**

With No. 3016 Cordichet, ch. 14, sk. 3, 11 d.c.

With No. 3017 Cordichet, 1 s.c. into each st., 5 s.c. across top of strap, continue around.

At each side of bag place five straps to stamped lines.

**CORD.**

Take No. 3017 Cordichet double, ch. 2, 1 s.c. into first ch., turn always to your left, ch. 1, 1 s.c. into second ch., turn, 1 s.c. into first single loop at beginning of row, turn and continue.

Each string is 1½ yards long.

Materials required:

ROYAL SOCIETY Cordichet Pink  
3016, size 10, 2 balls  
3017, size 10, 1 ball

Crochet hook No. 8.

**HAT BAND.**

With Pink Cordichet No. 3016, ch. 21, sk. 3, 18 d.c. into chs. turn, ch. 1, 18 s.c., turn, ch. 3, 18 d.c., turn, ch. 1, 18 s.c., turn and continue until band is 23 inches long.

Finish band into a point, skipping 1 st. at beginning and at end of each row.

With Cordichet No. 3017 work all around band 3 s.c. into each row of d.c., 1 s.c. into each row of s.c.

Trim point of band with buttons, as shown in cut.

**BUTTONS.**

Ch. 4, join to ring, 6 s.c. into ring, 2 s.c. into each st. until 12 s.c. are made, 2 more rows of 12 s.c., stuff with cotton, sk. 1, 1 s.c., sk. 1, 1 s.c., continue until closed.

**TRIMMING FOR EDGE OF HAT.**

With No. 3016 Cordichet, make ch. long enough to ridge around hat, make 3 more chs., sk. 3, 1 d.c. into each st. With No. 3017 Cordichet 1 s.c. into each st. at both sides of row of d.c.



## GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR FILET CROCHET

For the beginner in Filet Crochet, it would be well to read the following directions carefully and practise with the working models shown before starting a piece of work.

The Filet Crochet is worked in "open" and "closed" meshes shown in the diagram in black and white squares, which are made entirely in chain and double crochet.

For the foundation ch. make 3 times as many chains as meshes shown in first row of diagram and add 1. Always ch. 5 to turn.

**Open Mesh:** 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2 chs., 1 d.c. into next ch. to close mesh. This forms a perfect square. In making rows of open meshes the d.c. is always made into d.c. of previous row.

**Closed Mesh:** 1 d.c. into d.c., 2 d.c. into 2 chs., 1 d.c. into next d.c.

### Fig. 1. Working Model Showing Open Mesh.

To make a number of open meshes like Working Model Fig. 1, which has 10 open meshes, ch. 30, add 1 ch., ch. 5 more to turn, sk. 8 chs., 1 d.c., into 9th ch. (this forms the first open mesh), \* ch. 2, sk. 2 chs., 1 d.c. into 3rd ch., this forms the 2nd open m. Repeat from \* until 10 open meshes are made. For 2nd row, turn, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into 2nd d.c. of preceding row, ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c. into next d.c. and repeat.

### Fig. 2. Working Model Showing Closed and Open Mesh.

Fig. 2 shows 1 row of open and 1 row of closed meshes and small design and is started with 7 closed meshes, ch. 21, ch. 3 more to turn, sk. 3 chs., 1 d.c. into each of the 21 chs. (The ch. 3 at beginning counts for first d.c.), turn, ch. 5, sk. 3 first d.c., 1 d.c. into fourth d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., continue across the last d.c. to be put into the last ch. of ch. 3, turn, ch. 3, sk. first d.c., \* 1 d.c. into each of next 2 chs., 1 d.c. into next d.c. (this forms a closed m. at beginning of a row), ch. 2, sk. 2 chs., 1 d.c. into next d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2 chs., 4 d.c. into next 4 sts. (this forms a closed m. in the center of design), ch. 2, sk. 2 chs., 1 d.c. into next d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2 chs., 4 d.c. into next 4 sts., turn, ch. 5, sk. 3 d.c., 1 d.c. into next d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2 chs., 4 d.c. into next 4 sts. and continue

### Fig. 3. Working Model Showing Increasing and Diminishing of Open Mesh.

**1st Row.**—To make first 3 meshes, ch. 9, add 1, ch. 5 more to turn, sk. 8 chs., 1 d.c. into next, ch. 2, sk. 2 chs., 1 d.c. into next ch. 2, sk. 2 chs., 1 d.c. into last ch., turn.

**2nd Row.**—To increase one mesh at beginning of row, ch. 8, 1 d.c. into first d.c., ch. 2, 1 d.c. into next d.c., ch. 2, 1 d.c. into 3rd d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2 chs., 1 d.c. into next ch. To increase one mesh at end of row, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into same ch. as last d.c., turn, 1 sl. st. into each of last 3 chs. made (these sl. st. bring you up to top of 2nd row).

**3rd Row.**—To increase 2 meshes at beginning of row, ch. 11, sk. 8, 1 d.c. into next ch., ch. 2, sk. 2, chs., 1 d.c. into same st. as last sl. st. Make 5 ch. as last d.c., turn, 1 sl. st. into each of last 3 chs. made (these sl. st. bring you up to top of row, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into same st. as last d.c., turn, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into 3rd ch. of last ch. 5 (this row has 9 meshes).

**4th Row.**—To increase 3 meshes at beginning of row, ch. 14, sk. 8 chs., 1 d.c. into next ch., ch. 2, sk. 2 chs., 1 d.c. into next ch., ch. 2, sk. 2 chs., 1 d.c. into next d.c. Make 9 inches. To increase 3 holes at end of row, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into same st. as last d.c., turn, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into center st. of last ch. 5, turn, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into center st. of last ch. 5, turn, 3 sl. sts. into 3 last chs. made. The sl. sts. bring you up to top of row. Any number of meshes can be increased in this way.

**5th and 6th Row** are each 15 open meshes, turn.

**7th Row.**—To decrease 3 meshes at beginning of row, 10 sl. sts., 1 into each st. over first 3 meshes, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into next d.c., 8 more open meshes, turn.

**8th Row.**—To decrease 2 meshes 7 sl. sts., 1 into each st. over first 2 meshes, ch. 5, 5 open meshes, turn.

**9th Row.**—To decrease 1 m., 4 sl. sts., 1 into each, over first mesh ch. 5, 3 m.

### Fig. 4. Working Model Showing Increasing and Diminishing of Closed Mesh.

Start with 4 closed meshes.

**1st Row.**—Ch. 16, sk. 3, 12 d.c. into chs., turn.

**2nd Row.**—To increase 1 closed mesh at beginning of row, ch. 5, sk. 3, 2 d.c. into 2 chs., 1 d.c. into each of 11 d.c. To increase 1 closed mesh at end of row, cotton around needle, insert into next ch., pull through 1 loop which forms 1 ch., then twice through 2 loops, thus forming d.c. \* Cotton around needle, insert into ch. made before last d.c., ch. 1, finish d.c. like preceding one. Repeat from \* twice more, turn.

**3rd Row.**—To increase again 1 closed m. at each end ch. 5, sk. 3, 2 d.c. into 2 chs., 7 d.c. into 7 following d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., 6 d.c. into 6 following d.c., cotton around needle, insert into next ch., ch. 1, finish d.c., \* cotton around needle, insert into ch. made before last d.c., ch. 1, finish d.c. Repeat twice from \*, turn.

**4th Row.**—To increase 2 closed meshes at beginning of row, ch. 8, sk. 3, 5 d.c. into 5 next chs., 7 d.c. into 7 following d.c., 4 open meshes, 6 d.c. into 6 following d.c. To increase 2 closed meshes at end of row proceed the same way as to increase 1 closed mesh only, instead of 4 d.c. made with 1 ch. as before making 7 d.c. this way. To increase 3 or more closed meshes proceed the same way only at beginning of row ch. 3 for each additional closed mesh. At end of row make 3 d.c. as explained for each additional closed m.

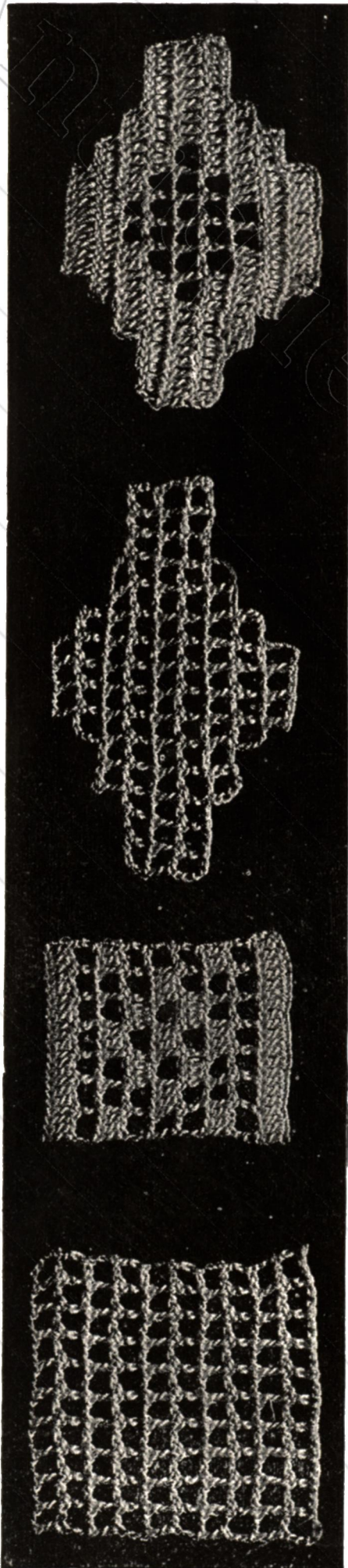

## Combing Cape No. 2054

ROYAL SOCIETY Crochet White, size 5, 1 ball  
Pink, size 5, 1 ball  
Crochet hook No. 8.

The combing cape is finished all around with crochet and is joined under the arms between arrows.

**1st Row.**—With White Crochet work into material 1 s.c., ch. 1, 1 s.c., ch. 1, continue all around following stamped lines.

**2nd Row.**—Ch. 3, sk. 3, 3 d.c., ch. 3, 3 d.c. into same, sk. 3, 1 d.c., sk. 3, 3 d.c., ch. 3, 3 d.c. into same, continue across until arrow at underarm seams is reached. Then ch. 5, sk. 3, 1 s.c., ch. 5, sk. 3, 1 s.c., continue to other arrow, about 15 ch. 5 in all, then continue with edging as before until arrow at back of underarm seam is again reached. Ch. 2, 1 s.c., around first ch. 5, ch. 2, sk. 3 sts., 1 s.c., continue into each ch. 5, then continue with edging.

**3rd Row.**—With pink crochet, \* 3 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c. around ch. 3, ch. 1, 1 d.c., into space before d.c., 1 d.c. into space after d.c., finish both together, ch. 1, repeat from \* around neck, down front and around the bottom. Repeat the same around the sleeves.

On blue combing cape use 1000 blue crochet cotton in place of the pink.

On white combing cape use 1045 purple, but the purple comes next to the material and the white on the edge.

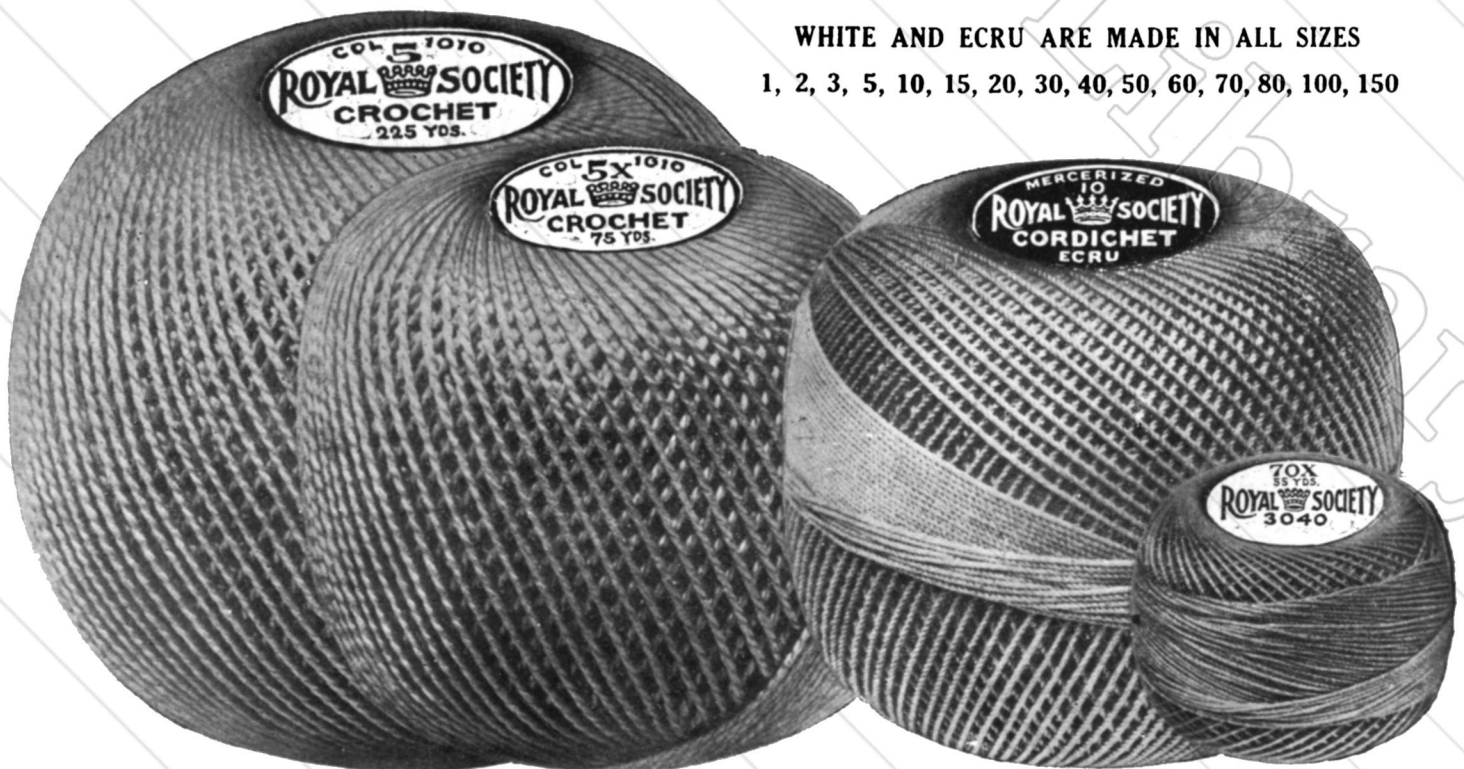

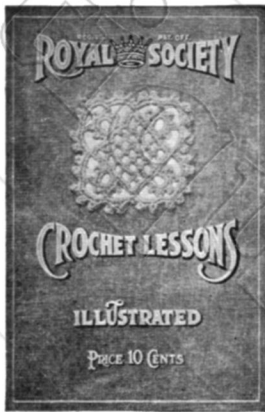

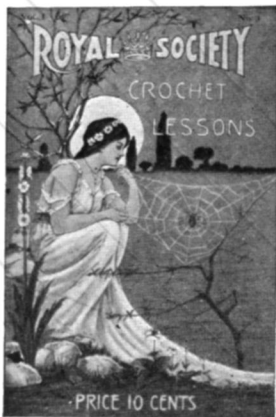
