

#### Abbreviations of Crochet Stitches.

Abbreviations of

1st. stands for first.
2nd. stands for second.
3rd. stands for row or round.
★ Called Asterisk; this mark means that the work is to be repeated from the preceding ★.

St. stands for stitch.
Ch. stands for chain or chain stitch and is made thus: Catch thread with hook, making a loop. Draw thread through the loop. This makes the first stitch. Repeat, drawing thread through as many loops as required. Each loop is termed a chain. (ch)

Sl. st. stands for slip stitch and is made thus: Insert hook into work, draw thread through work and the loop on the hook at the same time.

Sc. stands for single crochet and is made thus: Insert hook into work, draw thread through, making 2 loops on the hook; place thread over the hook and draw through both loops.

loops

De. stands for double crochet and is made thus: Thread over hook once; draw through work; thread over hook; draw through 2 loops twice.

Sde. stands for short double crochet and is made thus: Thread over hook once; draw through work; thread over hook; draw through all three loops at once.

Tr or te. stands for treble crochet and is made thus: Thread over hook twice; draw through work; thread over hook; draw through 2 loops 3 times.

Tt. stands for triple treble crochet and is made thus: Thread over hook, 3 times; draw through work; thread over hook; cast off 2 loops 4 times.

Ltr. stands for long treble crochet and is made thus: Thread over hook 5 times; cast off 2 loops twice; ch 6, keeping remaining loops on hook, sl st into 5th ch from hook for pi; bring hook under 2nd loop on hook; then cast off 2 loops 3 times.

tr. stands for short treble crochet and is made thus: Thread over hook twice; cast off 2 loops; then all remaining loops at once.

Quad tr. stands for quadruple treble crochet and is made thus: Thread over hook 4 times; cast off 2 loops at a time until all are cast off.

Ftr. stands for forked treble crochet and is made thus:
Place thread over hook 5 times; draw thread through
work; place thread over hook again, cast off 2 loops,
and again 2 loops; place thread over hook 2 times, draw
thread through work to left; thread over hook; cast
off 2 loops, then 2 loops, etc., until all are cast off.

Pi. stands for picot and is made thus: Chain 4; insert hook
in first chain made; thread over hook; draw through
chain stitch and loop on hook at once.

Ci. stands for cluster and is made thus: \*\* Place thread
over hook twice; draw thread through work; thread
over hook again; cast off 2 loops; then 2 more loops;
repeat from \*\* twice; then cast off remaining loops at
once.

Ba. or b stands for bar and is made thus: Ch 5; 1 dc.
La. stands for lacet and is made thus: Ch 3; 1 sc into ch of 5; ch 3; 1 dc.
Om. sometimes M. stands for open mesh and is made thus: Ch 2; skip 2 ch; 1 dc in next ch.

#### Cluny Band Yoke—Cover Page.

Material: 3 Balls No. 50 Cotton. No. 13 Hook.

Motifs are made according to directions for motifs of insertion in Cluny Centerpiece. Join thread in 1st ch of arch; ch 51 and join to corresponding place of 2nd motif with sl st.

sl st.

1st Row: (€h 3: skip 2 ch; 1 sc) 17 times. Sl st over 1st arch used and into next dc; turn.

2nd Row: Ch 2; 1 sc in 1st small loop; ch 3; 1 sc in next small loop; repeat from ★ across; ch 2; 1 sl st into corresponding place of 2nd motif; turn.

3rd Row: Ch 3; skip the 2 ch loop; 1 sc in next loop; ★ ch 3; 1 sc in next loop; repeat from ★ across; fasten the last 3 ch in last sl st made at this side; turn.

last 3 ch in last sl st made at this side; turn.

4th Row: Sl st over arch and into next dc; repeat 2nd and 3rd rows until there are 9 rows of loops; turn. (Ch 7; 1 sl st in 4th ch from hook for pi; ch 3). This is termed a half pi-loop. Ch 11; skip 3 loops of band; 1 dc in next loop; skip 1st ch of ch 11; 1 sc in next ch; 1 dc in each of next 7 ch; 1 sc in next; 1 sl st in next; 1 half pi-loop; 1 ltr into top of dc just made; 1 half pi-loop; ch 11; join with sl st into same dc; turn; petal on ch 11 same as previous one; ch 11; skip 3 small loops; 1 tr in next loop; 1 petal; 1 half pi-loop; ch 11; fasten in top of tr; 1 half pi-loop; ch 11; fasten in top of tr; 1 petal; ch 11; skip 3 small loops; 1 dc in next loop; 1 petal; 1 half pi-loop; 1 ltr into top of dc; 1 half pi-loop; ch 11; fasten in top of dc; 1 petal; 1 half pi-loop; fasten in last small loop of band. Break thread.

Join thread in 1st small loop on opposite side of band; ch 7; 1 sl st in 4th ch from hook for pi; ch 11; 1 sl st into 4th

ch from hook for pi; ch 3; skip 3 small loops; 1 sc in next small loop. (This is called a whole pi-loop.) Repeat whole pi-loops across (4 in all).

Sl st to top of 1st free arch of motif. Turn. 1 whole pi-loop; 1 sc in center of pi-loop of previous row; repeat across (5 in all). Break thread.

1 more row of pi-loops.

Upper Edge; 1st Row: Join thread in center of pi-loop; ch 11; 1 dc in next pi-loop; repeat across.

2nd Row: Join thread in day of for a tt. to ab 5: 1 tt.

2nd Row: Join thread in dc; ch 6 for a tt; ★ ch 5; 1 tt in same place; ch 6; 1 sl st in 4th ch from hook for pi. Then (ch 5; 1 sl st in 4th ch from hook for pi) 4 times. Ch 2; 1 tt in top of last tt; 1 tt in next dc. Repeat from ★.

Ch 2; 1 tt in top of last tt; 1 tt in next dc. Repeat from ★.

Lower Edge: Join thread in top of 1st petal of band.

Ch 5 for a tr; ch 4; 1 tr in same place; ★ ch 6; 1 sl st in 4th ch from hook for pi. Then (ch 5; 1 sl st in 4th ch from hook) 2 times. Ch 2; 1 tr in top of last tr; 1 tr in top of next ltr; ch 4; 1 tr in same place. Repeat from ★ 5 times. 1 tr in 2nd free arch of motif; ch 4; 1 tr in same place. 1 arch with pi as before; skip next small arch of motif. (1 tr; ch 4; 1 tr) in next arch. 1 arch with pi. (1 tr; ch 4; 1 tr) in next arch. (1 tr; ch 4; 1 tr) in next arch. (1 tr; ch 4; 1 tr) in top of 1st leaf of next band. Repeat.

Leaflets: Ch 11; skip 1 ch; 1 sc; 7 dc; 1 sc; 1 sl st in remaining chs; ch 23; 1 leaflet in last 11 chs; (ch 11; leaflet) 3 times. Sl st together at base and bring thread under leaflets to correct position. Ch 23; 1 leaflet in last 11 ch; break thread and sew to band.

#### Cluny Band Cap—Cover Page.

Material: 2 Balls No. 50 Cotton. No. 13 Crochet Hook. 6 motifs and 6 bands required for 1 cap.
Border for motif is made according to instructions of border for the motif in insertion for centerpiece. The daisy is made according to instructions for daisy in motif in Cluny centerpiece.

1st Row: Join thread to dc to left of small arch of motif; ch 30; join to corresponding place of 2nd motif; ch 3; skip 2 ch; 1 sc in next ch; repeat across (10 small arches in all).

2nd Row: 2 sl st along side of next dc and 2 sl st in 2 ch of next small arch; ch 2; turn; 1 sc in 1st small loop; ★ ch 3; 1 sc in next small loop; repeat across from ★; ch 2; 1 sl st into 2nd ch of small arch of 2nd motif; turn.

3rd Row: Ch 3; skip 2 ch loop; 1 sc in next loop; repeat 3 ch loops across; skip the 2 ch loop; 1 sl st into the last sl st made in small arch.

4th Row: Sl st into the 3 remaining ch of the same small arch; 1 sl st along side of next dc; turn; ch 2; 1 sc in 1st srom ★; ch 2; 1 sl st into corresponding place of 2nd motif; turn.

5th Row: Skip the 2 ch loop; ch 3: 1 sc in next loop.

5th Row: Skip the 2 ch loop; ch 3; 1 sc in next loop; repeat loops across; 1 sl st in last sl st made in previous row; turn.

6th Row: SI st into dc and into 4 chs of next small arch; ch 2; 1 sc in 3 ch loop; ch 3; 1 sc in next loop; repeat loops across; ch 2; 1 sl st in corresponding place of 2nd motif;

7th Row: Same as 5th row.

Sth Row: Sl st into last ch of arch and 2 sl st into the next dc; turn; ch 2; repeat loops as in 6th row; turn.

9th Row: Same as 5th.

Sl st to center of last 3 ch loop made; ch 6; sl st into 4th ch from hook; ch 9; 1 sl st into 4th ch from hook; ch 9; 1 sl st into 4th ch from hook; ch 2; skip 2 small loops; 1 sc in next loop. Repeat pi-loops across band (3 in all). Sl st in each ch of next arch of motif into next dc and to center of next arch; turn; repeat pi-loops across (4 in all). Break thread. Make same pi-loops on opposite side of band.

Edge; 1st Row: Join thread in 1st pi-loop of band; ch 3 (for a dc); ch 9; 1 dc in next pi-loop; ch 9; 1 dc in next pi-loop; ch 9; 1 dc in next pi-loop; ch 9; 1 dc in next arch; of 10; skip 1st free arch of motif; 1 dc in next arch; ch 4; 1 sc in next arch ch 4; 1 sc in next arch ch 10; skip 1 arch; 1 de in 1st pi-loop of next band. Repeat around. Join to 3 ch with sl st.

2nd Row: Without breaking thread ch 7; 1 dc in same last st of previous row; \*\* (ch 5; 1 sl st in 4th ch from hook for pi) 3 times; ch 1; 1 tr into top of last dc; skip 8 ch; 1 dc in 9th ch; ch 4; 1 dc in same place; repeat from \*\* around.

Unner Edge: 1st Row: Same as lower edge.

Upper Edge: 1st Row: Same as lower edge.

2nd Row: 1 row of meshes, thus: ch 5; skip 2 ch; 1 dc
in next ch; ★ ch 2; skip 2 ch; 1 dc in next ch; repeat from ★.

Leaflets: Ch 10; skip 1st ch; 1 sc in next ch; 1 dc in
each of next 5 ch; 1 dc in next; 1 sc in next; 1 sl st in last;
ch 10; repeat leaflet as before, join to base of 1st with sl
st; ch 10; 3rd leaflet; ch 10; 4th leaflet; join to 3rd with
sl st. Break thread. Sew to band.

(Directions for Cap given in Book No. 3, Page 15, Picot-Talpa Pattern.)

Material: 3 balls No. 60 cotton-No. 13 hook.

1st Row: Ch 8; join; 16 sc in ring.

2nd Row: Ch 6; skip 1 sc; 1 dc in next sc; ★ ch 3; skip 1 sc; 1 dc in next sc. Repeat from ★ around. Join.

3rd Row: 4 sc into each space of 3 ch of previous row.

4th Row: 4 sc into each space of 3 ch of previous row.

4th Row: Ch 12; skip 1 ch; ★ 1 sc; 2 dc; 3 tr; 3 tr into following ch; skip 3 sc of previous row; 1 dc in next sc. Ch 9; skip 1 ch; repeat from ★ around. When 8th petal is made join to 3rd ch from beginning.

5th Row: 7 sl st to point of 1st petal; 1 sc into point; ch 6; 1 tt into st between 2 petals; ch 6; 1 sc into point of next petal; ch 6; repeat around.

6th Row: (4 sc; 1 p; 4 sc) over each ch 6; join. Break thread. Make one more medallion and join the 2 last pi to 2 pi of 1st medallion.

Join medallions according to design. After all medallions are joined put in daisies between the medallions, thus: Ch 9; fasten into 5th free pi of medallion; (skip 1 ch; 1 sc; 6 dc; 1 sc) into following chs; ch 9; fasten into next pi. 1 petal same as 1st. Ch 9; fasten into 1st pi of next medallion; 1 petal; ch 9; fasten into next pi; 1 petal; ch 1; fasten into base of 1st petal. Break thread.

Upper Edge; 1st Row: Fasten into side of daisy with sc; ch 12; ★ fasten to 1st pi of medallion; ch 6; fasten into next pi; ch 12: fasten into side of petal of daisy; sl st to other side of other petal; ch 12: repeat around from ★.

2nd Row: Ch 6; skip 2 ch; 1 dc in next ch; ★ skip 2 ch; ch 2; 1 dc into next ch; repeat around from ★.

3rd Row: Sl st to center of mesh; ch 4; 1 tr in next mesh; skip 1 mesh; ★ ch 5; 2 tr to form a cluster in next mesh; ch 2; 2 tr to form a cluster in same mesh; skip 1 mesh; ch 5; 1 tr in next mesh; 1 tr in next mesh; skip 1 mesh; ch 5; 1 tr in next mesh; 1 tr in next mesh; skip 1 mesh; ch 5; 1 tr in same mesh; skip 1 mesh; ch 5; 1 tr in same mesh; skip 1 mesh; repeat around from ★.



Ch 22; 1 dc in 8th ch from hook; 1 dc in each of next 2 ch. (Ch 1; skip 1 ch; 1 dc in each of next 3 ch) 3 times. ★ Turn 2 om; ch 4; 1 dc above last dc of group; 1 dc over ch; 1 dc in 1st dc of next group. (Ch 1; skip 1 dc; 1 dc in dc; 1 dc in



Material: 3 Balls No. 50 Cotton. No. 13 Crochet Hook. Make motifs according to directions for insertion in centerniece.

1st Row: Ch 3; skip 2 ch; 1 sc in next ch; repeat across

3rd Row: Ch 3; skip the 2 ch loop; 1 sc in next loop; ch 3; 1 sc in next loop; repeat across from Skip 2 ch loop at end; 1 sl st into same sl st as the 2 ch loop was fastened; turn.

4th Row: Sl st into base of pi and next 2 sts or 3 sts in all; ch 2; 1 sc in 1st small loop; ch 3; 1 sc in next small loop and repeat across from ch 2; 1 sl st into 3rd st of 2nd motif; turn.

5th Row: Same as 3rd.

6th Row: Same as 3rd.

6th Row: Sl st in last ch of pi-loop; skip ltr; sl st into 1st 2 ch of next loop; ch 2; repeat same across 4th row. Continue in this manner, repeating 3rd and 4th row until there are 15 rows of small loops in all.

1st Row: Do not break thread but sl st to center of last small loop (ch 7; 1 sl st into 4th ch from hook for pi; ch 1; sl st into 4th ch from hook for pi; ch 3; skip 4 small loops; 1 sc in next loop) twice. 

#### ROSE FILET YOKE. COVER PAGE, BOOK NO. 10


Material: 5 Balls No. 70 Crochet Cotton. 1 No. 12 Crochet Hook.

Hook.

1st Row: Ch 9; 1 dc in the 9th ch from hook. This forms the 1st om. Turn. 2nd Row: Ch 8; 1 dc in top of dc. This adds 1 om. 2 dc into the 1st om. 1 dc into 3rd ch of ch of 9; ch 2; 1 tt into the same place as last dc was made. This adds 1 om to opposite side. No further directions will be given for this. 3rd Row: Add 1 om; then 1 solid (sm) mesh. 1 om; 1 sm; add 1 om. NOTE: When 2 om are added ch 11; 1 dc in the 9th ch from hook; ch 2; 1 dc above next dc. A opposite side when 2 meshes are added, add 1 om as usual, then 1 tt into the 2 sts in center of tt just made. Follow design to 15th row. 15th Row: Ch 171. This adds 55 om at

the beginning of 15th row. Take separate thread and join to 14th row; ch 165. Break thread. Then work 55 om on this ch. Turn. 16th Row: Ch 17 to add 4 om. Follow design to the 108th row. Take separate thread and work 2nd shoulder and sleeve to correspond with the 1st. At the end of the 108th row of 2nd shoulder-piece ch 38 and join to the 108th row of 1st shoulder-piece. Follow design. Work shaping line around neck with 1 sc in each corner space and ch as space requires. In the long spaces between corners work a sdc.

Edge: 1st Row: 1 row of sc around neck. 2nd Row: Ch 4 for a tr. ★ Ch 4; skip 2 sc. 1 tr in next sc. Repeat from ★. Join. 3rd Row: 1 sc into tr. ★ Ch 3; 1 dc into next tr. Ch 4; 1 sl st into top of tr. Ch 3; 1 sc in next tr. Ch 3; 1 sc in next tr.



12-Inch Cluny Doily.

Material: 2 Balls No. 30 Cotton. No. 13 Crochet Hook. Ch 245; 1 dc in 8th ch from hook.

1st Row:  $\bigstar$  ch 2; skip 1 ch; 1 dc in next ch; repeat from  $\bigstar$  (120 meshes in all) join.

**2nd Row:** Sl st to center of mesh;  $\bigstar$  ch 12; skip 2 mesh; 1 sc in next mesh; repeat from  $\bigstar$  around. (40 loops in all.) Join.

3rd Row: Sl st in 1st 4 ch of 1st loop; ch 3; 1 dc in each of next 3 ch; ch 9; 1 sc in center of next loop (thru the ch); ch 14; turn; skip 1st ch of ch 14; 1 sc in next ch; 1 sdc in next; 1 dc in each of next 2 ch; 1 sdc in next; 1 sl st in last ch; turn; 1 sc in each st up side of petal; 1 sl st in center of next loop; ch 8; 1 petal like preceding; ch 6; 1 sc in center of next loop; ★ ch 9; skip 4 ch of next loop; 1 dc in each of next 4 ch; ch 9; 1 sc in center of next loop; ch 1s; 1 petal; ch 6; 1 sc in next loop; repeat from ★ around; ch 9; join.

4th Row: SI st back in each of 3 ch of last ch of 9: turn; ch 3; 1 dc in each of 2 ch; 1 dc above each of next 4 dc; 1 dc in each of next 3 ch (10 dc in all); ch 14; turn; 1 petal; join with sI st to point of 1st petal; ch 11; join with sI st to point of 2nd petal; ch 8; 1 petal; th 6; 1 dc in each of 3 ch of ch of 9 of previous row; 1 dc above each of next 4 dc; 1 dc in each of 3 ch of next 9 ch; ch 14; turn. 1 petal as before; join to 1st petal; ch 11; join to 2nd petal; ch 8; 1 petal; repeat from \* around; ch 6; join. Turn.


5th Row: SI st back in 2 ch of ch of 6; turn; ch 3; 1 de in next ch; 1 de above each of 10 dc; 1 de in each of 2 ch of next 6 ch;  $\bigstar$  ch 5; 1 sI st in point of petal; ch 8; 1 petal; 1 tt in center of ch 11 of previous row; ch 8; 1 petal; ch 8; 1 petal; 1 tt in same ch as previous tt; ch 8; 1 petal; join with sI st to point of petal of previous row; ch 5; 1 de in each of last 2 chs of ch 6 of previous row; 1 de above each of 10 dc; 1 dc in next 2 ch; repeat from  $\bigstar$ ; ch 5; join.

6th Row: Ch 4 for tt; ch 6; 1 tt between 2 petals; ch 6; 1 tt in point of scallop between next 2 petals; ch 7; 1 tt in same place; ch 6; 1 tt between next 2 petals; ch 6; 1 tt in end of next petal; ch 6; skip 2 dc; 1 dc above 10 dc; ch 6; 1 tt in end of next petal; ch 6; 1 tt between next 2 petals; repeat around. Join.

7th Row: Ch 3 for a dc; ★ ch 1; skip 1 ch; 1 dc in next st; repeat from ★ 7 times. (ch 1; 1 dc in next ch) 4 times. (Ch 1; skip 1 ch; 1 dc in next st) 8 times. (21 dc in all). Ch 8; skip 3 dc; 1 dc above next 4 dc; ch 8; 1 dc above tt. Repeat around.

Sth Row: Ch 3 for 1 dc. (Ch 1; 1 dc above dc) 8 times. (Ch 2; 1 dc above dc) 4 times. (Ch 1; 1 dc above dc) 8 times. Ch 6; 2 sc above 4 dc; ch 6; repeat around. Join.

9th Row: Ch 3 for a dc;  $\bigstar$  ch 2; 1 dc above next dc; ch 8; 1 dc in top of last dc made; 1 dc above next dc; repeat from  $\bigstar$  4 times. (Ch 8; 1 dc in top of last dc; 1 dc above next dc; ch 2; 1 dc above next dc) 5 times. Ch 5; 1 sc between 2 sc; ch 5; and repeat.



"Queen Anne" Doily Pattern.—12 inch (top) and 9 inch (lower). Directions for 9 inch Doily on Page 6. Directions for 12 inch Doily below.

Material: 2 Balls No. 30 Cotton. No. 13 Crochet Hook.

Ch 8; 1 dc in 5th ch from hook; ch 2; skip 2 ch; 1 sc in last ch; turn. ★ ch 3; 1 dc in sc; ch 2; 1 dc in dc; turn; ch 4; 1 dc in dc; ch 2; 1 sc in dc; repeat from ★ until there are 16 inner loops or arches and 16 outer arches. Join with sl st while making last row. Break thread; ch 9; 1 sl st in 3rd ch from hook for pi; ch 3; join with sl st to inner arch; ★ skip the 1st ch of ch of 3; 1 sl st in each of next 2 ch; 1 sl st in pi; 1 sl st in each of next 2 ch; ch 4; skip 1



Ch 10; join with s1 st to an outer arch; skip 1st ch of ch 10; 1 sc in next ch; 1 dc in each of next 6 ch; 1 sc in next; 1 sl st in last ch; turn work wrong side to you and work to the left, thus: ★ (Ch 7; 1 sl st in 4th ch from hook for pi; ch 3). This will be called a "half-loop" 1 ltr in same arch; thus: Thread over hook 4 times into arch, cast off 2 loops twice, ch 4, 1 sl st into 4th ch from hook for pi; bring hook with loop under next loop on hook, then cast off 2 loops twice; 1 half-loop as before; ch 10; 1 sc in same arch; make petal in 10 ch same as 1st; ch 10; skip 1 arch; 1 sc in next arch; make petal and repeat from ★.

Band; 1st Row: Join thread in 2nd ch of pi-loop of motif; ch 64; join to corresponding place of 2nd motif. (Ch 3; skip 2 ch; 1 sc in next ch) 8 times, then (ch 3; skip 1 ch; 1 sc in next ch; ch 3; skip 2 ch; 1 sc in next ch) 7 times. (23 small loops in all). Sl st into next ch of pi-loop into base of pi and also into next ch on other side of pi. Turn.

2nd Row: Ch 2; 1 sc in 1st small loop of previous row; ★ ch 3; 1 sc in next loop; repeat across from ★. At end of row ch 2; 1 sl st into corresponding place of 2nd motif.

Turn.

3rd Row: Ch 3; skip the 2 ch loop: 1 sc in pext loop:

5th Row: Same as 3rd. Turn.

6th Row: Sl st into last 3 chs of half-loop; ch 2; 1 sc in 1st small loop; (Ch 3; 1 sc in next small loop) across row. At the end of row ch 2; 1 sl st into last 3 chs of half-loop of 2nd motif.

5th Row: Same as 3rd. Turn.

6th Row: Skip the sc; 1 sl st into last ch of half-loop of 2nd motif. Turn.

7th Row: Skip the sc; 1 sl st into last ch of half-loop of 2nd motif. Turn.

7th Row: Skip the sc; 1 sl st into last ch of half-loop of 2nd motif. Turn.

Continue in this manner until there are 11 rows of small loops. Break thread. This completes 1st band. Make the remaining 3 in same way taking care that daisies are all set the same way. Join thread in 1st small loop of band. (Ch 7; 1 sl st into 4th ch from hook for pi; ch 11; 1 sl st into 4th ch from hook for pi; ch 3. This is termed a whole pi-loop.) (Skip 4 small loops of band; 1 sc in next loop) twice. Then 1 whole loop; skip 3 small loops of band; 1 sc in next loop; then (1 whole loop; skip 4 small loops of band; 1 sc in next loop) twice. Sl st to center of 2nd free arch of motif; 1 whole loop; 1 sc in center of last whole loop of previous row; 5 more whole loops; break thread. Repeat same for remaining bands.

Make a ch long enough to reach around the inner part of doily; 1 dc in 7th ch from hook; \* ch 5; 1 dc in top of last dc; skip 1 ch on foundation; 1 dc

in next ch; ch 2; skip 1 ch; 1 dc in next ch; ch 2; take hook out of work and draw loop thru the center of 1st whole loop of band; ch 2; 1 dc in top of last dc made; skip 1 ch on foundation; 1 dc in next ch; ch 2; skip 1 ch; 1 dc in next ch; repeat from \*\*across band. Then make 1 mesh; 1 arch; 1 mesh as before. In making next arch fasten to 2nd free arch of motif, then make 1 mesh; 1 arch; 1 mesh. In making next arch fasten to 5th arch cf motif; 1 mesh; 1 arch; 1 mesh. Rejeat as over 1st band.

Edge: Join thread in last free arch of motif; ch 10; 1 tt in same arch; 1 tt in 1st small loop of band; ch 4; 1 tt in same place. \* Ch 6; 1 sl st in 4th ch from hook for pi; then (ch 5; 1 sl st into 4th ch from hook for pi; then (ch 5; 1 sl st into 4th ch from hook; 1 tt into top of last tt made. Skip 2 small loops; 1 tt in next small loop; ch 4; 1 tt in same place; repeat from \* 7 times. 1 tt in 1st free arch of motif; ch 4; 1 tt in same arch; make loop with 4 pi as over band; 1 tt in top of tt; skip 1 arch; 2 tt separated by 4 ch in next arch; 1 pi-loop as before; 2 tt separated by 4 ch in next arch; 2 tt separated by 4 ch in next arch; 1 pi-loop as before; skip 1 arch; 2 tt separated by 4 ch in next arch; 1 pi-loop as before; 3 tt separated by 4 ch in next arch; 1 pi-loop as before; 2 tt separated by 4 ch in next arch; 1 pi-loop as before; 2 tt separated by 4 ch in next arch; 1 pi-loop as before; 2 tt separated by 4 ch in next arch. Repeat around.
