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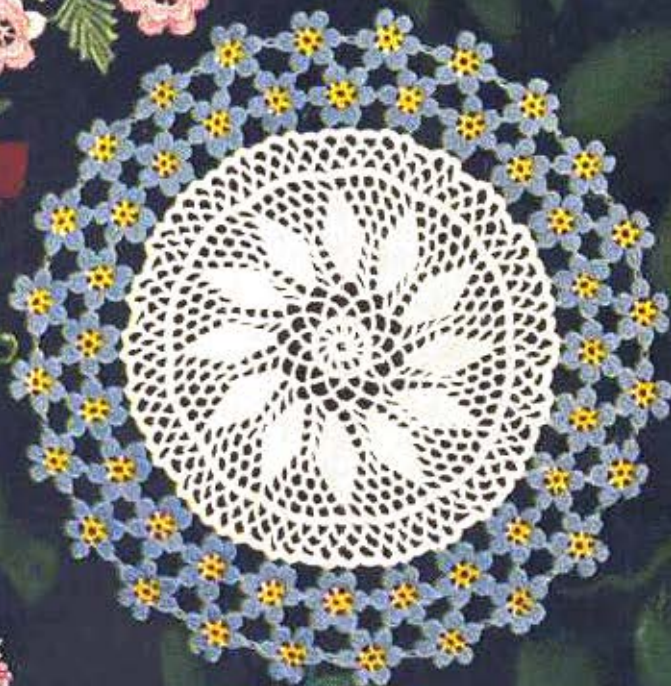
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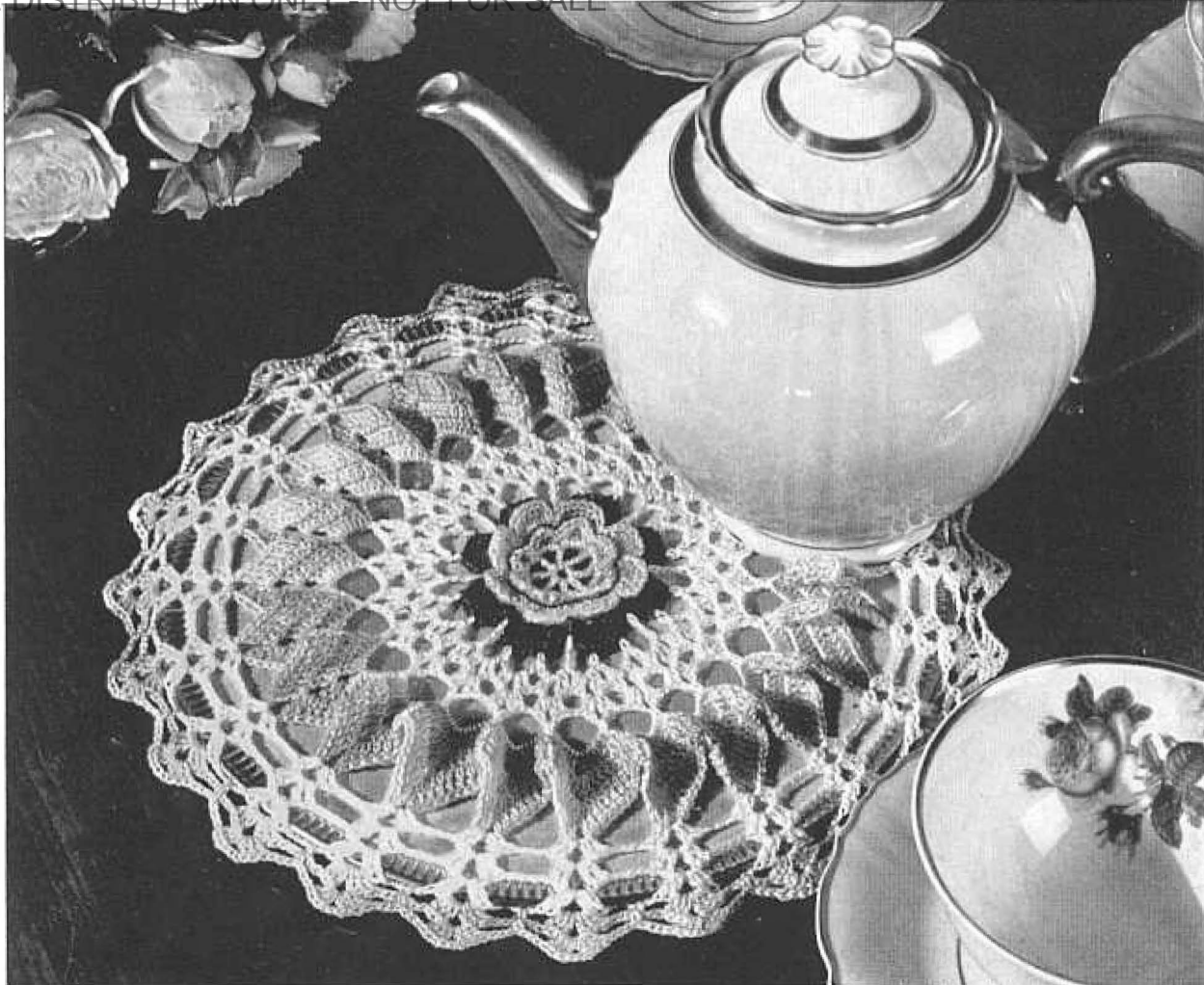

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Rose Hot Plate Mat Cover No. 6401

MATERIALS REQUIRED: American Thread Company "DE LUXE" Mercerized Crochet and Knitting Cotton, Article 346 or "PURITAN" Bedspread Cotton, Article 40.

1 Ball of White
 1 Ball of Green
 1 Ball of Shaded Pinks or any Color desired.
 Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.
 1 8½ inch Round Hot Plate Mat.

With Shaded Pinks ch 7, join to form a ring, ch 7, d c into ring, * ch 3, d c into ring, repeat from * 5 times, ch 3, join in 3 rd st of ch 7.

2nd Row—Ch 1 and over each loop work 1 s c, 1 d c, 3 tr c, 1 d c, 1 s c, join.

3rd Row—Sl st in back of petal, * ch 5, s c between next 2 petals in back of work, repeat from * 7 times.

4th Row—Ch 1 and over each loop work 1 s c, 1 d c, 5 tr c, 1 d c, 1 s c, join.

5th Row—Slip st in back of petal, * ch 7, s c between next 2 petals in back of work, repeat from * 7 times, break thread.

6th Row—Attach Green, ch 1 and over each loop work 1 s c, 1 d c, 7 tr c, 1 d c, 1 s c, join, break thread.

7th Row—Attach White in 2nd tr c of Green petal, ch 7, skip 3 tr c, s c in next tr c, * ch 5, tr c between petals, ch 5, s c in 2nd tr c of next petal, ch 7, skip 3 tr c, s c in next tr c, repeat from * 6 times, ch 5, tr c between petals, ch 5, join.

8th Row—Sl st to loop, ch 3, d c in same space, ch 3, 2 d c in same space, 2 d c in next loop, ch 3, 2 d c in same loop (shell), work o shell in each loop, join in 3rd st of ch 3.

9th Row—Sl st to center of shell, ch 3, d c in same space,

ch 3, 2 d c in some space, ch 1 ond work o shell in center of each shell with ch 1 between shells, join.

10th Row—Sl st to center of shell, * ch 8, s c in center of next shell, repeat from * all around, break thread.

11th Row—Attach Shaded Pinks in loop, ch 3, 5 d c, ch 3, 6 d c in some loop, * 6 d c, ch 3, 6 d c in next loop, repeat from * all around, join.

12th Row—Ch 3 and work 1 d c in each d c and 2 d c, ch 3, 2 d c in each ch 3 loop, join.

13th Row—Ch 4 and work 1 tr c in each d c and 2 tr c, ch 3, 2 tr c in each ch 3 loop, join, break thread.

14th Row—Attach White in ch 3 loop at point, ch 3 and work o shell in some space, * ch 3, work o shell in next ch 3 loop, repeat from * all around, ch 3, join.

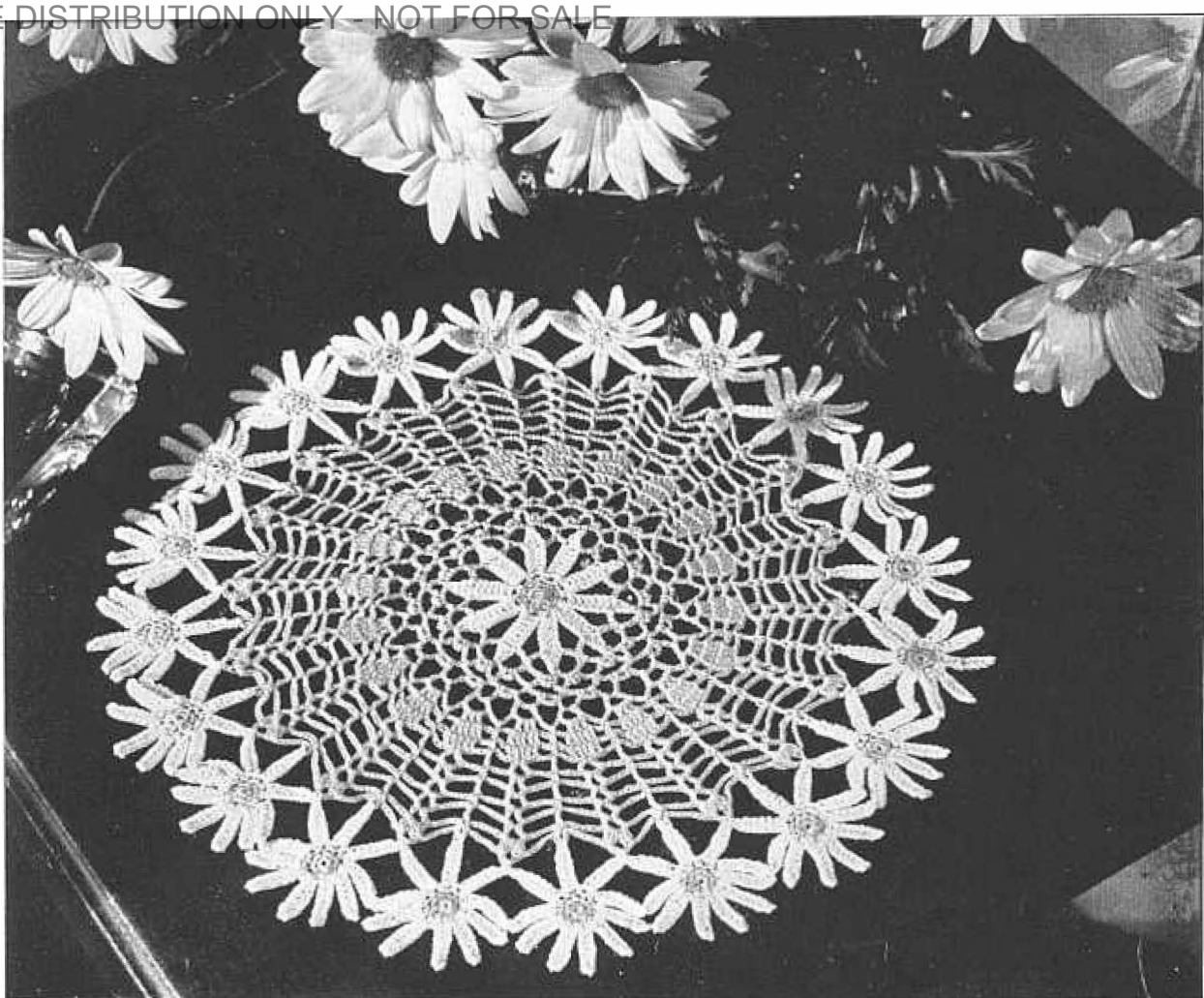
15th Row—Sl st to center of shell, ch 3 and work a shell in some space, * ch 4, shell in next shell, repeat from * all around, ch 4, join. Work 1 more row of shells with ch 5 between shells, break thread.

17th Row—Attach Shaded Pinks in shell, ch 3, 2 d c in same space, ch 3, 3 d c in some space, * ch 3, s c in next loop, ch 3, 3 d c, ch 3, 3 d c in next shell, repeat from * all around ending row with ch 3, s c in next loop, ch 3, join.

18th Row—Sl st to center of shell, ch 3, 2 d c, ch 3, 3 d c in some space, * ch 3, s c in next s c, ch 3, 3 d c, ch 3, 3 d c in center of next shell, repeat from * all around ending row with ch 3, s c in next s c, ch 3, join, break thread.

19th Row—Start casing for Mot Cover. With wrong side of work toward you, join Shaded Pinks in loop of 16th row, * ch 10, s c over next loop of some row, repeat from * all around.

20th and 21st Rows—Sl st to center of loop and work a row of ch 9 loops, break thread.

Shaded Colors may be used if desired.

With Yellow ch 2, 5 s c in 2nd st from hook.

2nd Row—Working around, work 2 s c in each s c (10 s c), join.

3rd Row—Ch 1, 1 s c in each s c, break Yellow. Attach White, * ch 10, s c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s d c in next st of ch (s d c: thread over needle, insert in stitch, pull through, thread over and work off all loops at one time), 1 d c in each of the next 7 sts of ch, s c in next s c, repeat from * 9 times (10 petals), break White.

1st Row—Attach Yellow at top of petal, * ch 5, thread over needle, insert in 3rd st from top on side of same petal, pull through, thread over and work off 2 loops, thread over needle, insert in 3rd st from top of next petal, pull through, thread over and work off 2 loops, thread over and work off all loops at one time, ch 5, s c in top of same petal, repeat from * all around ending row with ch 2, d c in same space as beginning (this brings thread in position for next row).

2nd Row—Ch 3, s c in some space, * ch 5, s c in next loop, ch 3, s c in some space (picot), repeat from * all around ending row with ch 2, d c in same space as beginning.

3rd Row—* Ch 6, s c in next loop, repeat from * all around ending row with ch 3, tr c in d c.

4th Row—Ch 3, s c in some space, * ch 6, s c in next loop, ch 3, s c in some space, repeat from * all around ending row with ch 3, tr c in tr c.

5th Row—Ch 7, d c in some space, * ch 5, 1 d c, ch 4, 1 d c in next loop, repeat from * all around ending row with ch 5, sl st in 3rd st of ch 7.

6th Row—Sl st into loop, ch 3, 2 d c in some space, * ch 3, s c in next loop, ch 3, 3 d c in next loop, repeat from * all around ending row with ch 3, s c in next loop, ch 3, join.

7th Row—Ch 3, d c in some space, d c in next d c, 2 d c in next d c, * ch 4, s c in next s c, ch 4, 2 d c in next d c, d c in next d c, 2 d c in next d c, repeat from * all

around ending row with ch 4, s c in next s c, ch 4, join.
8th Row—Same as last row but working 1 d c in each of the 5 d c in each d c group.

9th Row—Sl st to center d c of group, ch 6, d c in same space, * ch 4, d c in next s c, ch 4, 1 d c, ch 3, 1 d c (shell) in center d c of next d c group, repeat from * all around ending row with ch 4, d c in next s c, ch 4, join in 3rd st of ch.

10th Row—Sl st into loop, ch 6, d c in some space, * ch 5, s c in single d c, ch 5, 1 d c, ch 3, 1 d c in center of next shell, repeat from * all around ending row with ch 5, s c in next d c, ch 5, join in 3rd st of ch.

11th Row—Sl st into loop, ch 6, d c in some space, * ch 5, d c in next s c, ch 5, 1 d c, ch 3, 1 d c in next shell, repeat from * all around in some manner ending row to correspond, join.

12th Row—Sl st into loop, ch 6, d c in some space, * ch 6, s c in next single d c, ch 6, 1 d c, ch 3, 1 d c in next shell, repeat from * all around in some manner ending row to correspond, join in 3rd st of ch.

13th Row—Sl st into loop, ch 6, d c in some space, * ch 7, d c in next s c, ch 7, shell in next shell, repeat from * all around in some manner ending row to correspond, join in 3rd st of ch.

14th Row—Sl st into loop, ch 3, 2 d c in some space keeping lost loop of each d c on hook, thread over and pull through all loops at one time, ch 4, cluster st in some space (cluster st: thread over needle, insert in space, pull

through and work off 2 loops, * thread over needle, insert in some space, pull through and work off 2 loops, repeat from * once, thread over and work off all loops at one time), * ch 7, s c in next d c, ch 4, s c in some space for picot, ch 7, 2 cluster sts with ch 4 between in next shell, repeat from * all around ending row with ch 7, s c in next d c, ch 4, s c in some space, ch 7, join, break thread.

DAISY—Work 1st 2 rows some as center flower, break Yellow. Attach White, ch 8 and with wrong side of doily toward you, s c in ch 4 loop of doily between the 2 cluster sts, turn, s c in 2nd ch from hook, 1 s d c in each of the next 6 sts of ch, s c in next s c of Yellow center, ch 8, turn, s c in next picot of doily, turn, s c in 2nd ch from hook, 1 s d c in each of the next 6 sts of ch, s c in next s c of Yellow center, ch 8, turn, s c in next ch 4 loop between next 2 cluster sts, turn, s c in 2nd ch from hook, 1 s d c in each of the next 6 sts of ch, s c in next s c of Yellow center, then work 7 more petals to complete flower in some manner but do not join.

2nd Flower—Work Yellow center some as previous flower. Attach White, ch 8, s c in 4th petal of previous flower, s c in 2nd ch from hook, 1 s d c in each of the next 6 sts of ch, s c in next s c of Yellow center, work another petal joining it in some space of doily as 3rd petal of previous flower, join 3rd petal in next picot of doily and join 4th petal to next ch 4 loop between next 2 cluster sts, complete flower some as 1st flower having 10 petals.

Work 18 more flowers joining some as 2nd flower and join last flower to corresponding petal of 1st flower.

With White ch 8, join to form o ring, ch 1 and work 12 s c in ring, join.

2nd Row—Ch 5, d c in next s c, * ch 2, d c in next s c, repeat from * all around, ch 2, join in 3rd st of ch.

3rd Row—Ch 1 and work 3 s c over each loop, join.

4th Row—* Ch 6, s c in space over the d c of previous row, repeat from * all around ending row with ch 3, tr c

in same space as beginning (this brings thread in position for next row).

5th Row—* Ch 6, s c in next loop, repeat from * all around.

6th Row—Sl st into loop, ch 1 and work 3 s c in some space, * ch 6, 3 s c in next loop, repeat from * all around, ending row with ch 2, d tr c in the sl st.

7th Row—Ch 3, 2 d c in some loop, * ch 3, skip 1 s c, d c in next s c, ch 3, 3 d c in next loop, repeat from * all around ending row with ch 3, skip 1 s c, d c in next s c, ch 3, join.

8th Row—Ch 3, d c in some space, 1 d c in next d c, 2 d c in next d c, * ch 3, d c in next single d c, ch 3, 2 d c in next d c, d c in next d c, 2 d c in next d c, repeat from * all around ending row with ch 3, d c in next single d c, ch 3, join.

9th and 10th Rows—Some as last row but having 2 more d c in each solid section of each row.

11th Row—Sl st to next d c, ch 3, 1 d c in each of the next 6 d c, * ch 3, d c in next loop, ch 3, d c in next loop, ch 3, 1 d c in each of the center 7 d c of next d c group, repeat from * all around ending row with ch 3, d c in next loop, ch 3, d c in next loop, ch 3, join.

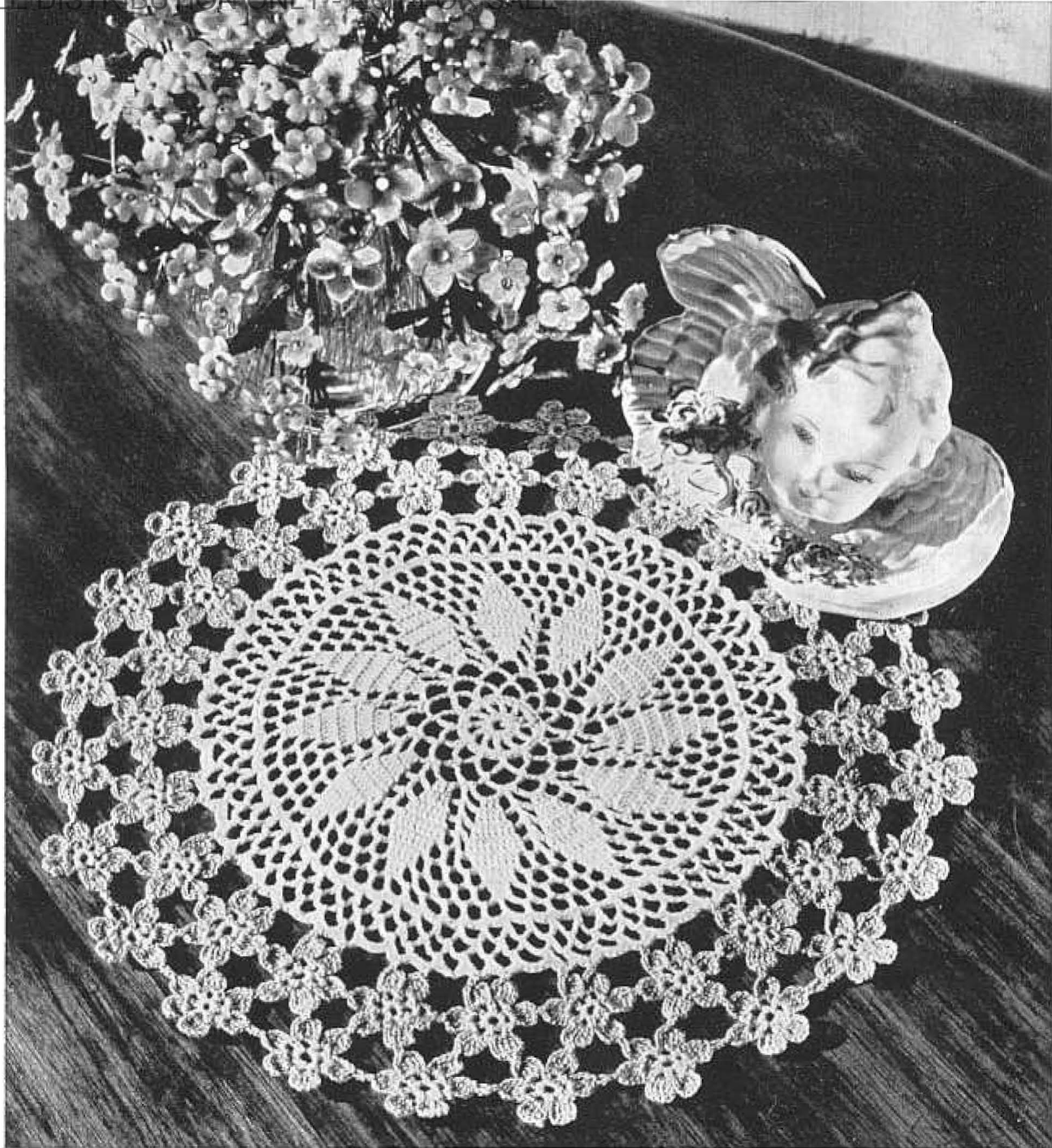
12th Row—Sl st to next d c, ch 3, 1 d c in each of the next 4 d c, * ch 3, d c in next loop, ch 3, d c in next loop, ch 3, d c in next loop, ch 3, 1 d c in each of the center 5 d c of next d c group, repeat from * all around ending row to correspond, ch 3, join.

13th Row—Sl st to next d c, ch 3, 1 d c in each of the next 2 d c, * ch 3, d c in next loop, ch 3, d c in next loop, ch 3, d c in next loop, ch 3, d c in next loop, ch 3, 1 d c in each of the 3 center d c of next d c group, repeat from * all around ending row to correspond, ch 3, join.

14th Row—Sl st to next d c, ch 6, d c in next loop, * ch 3, d c in next loop, repeat from * 3 times, ** ch 3, d c in center d c of next d c group, * ch 3, d c in next loop, repeat from * 4 times, repeat from ** all around ending row to correspond, ch 3, join in 3rd st of ch.

15th Row—Ch 1 and work 4 s c over each loop, join.

16th Row—* Ch 6, s c in space over the next d c of previous row, repeat from * all around ending row with ch 3, d c in some space as beginning.



17th Row—* Ch 6, s c in next loop, repeat from * all around ending row with ch 3, d c in d c.

18th Row—Same as last row but ending row with ch 6, s c in d c.

19th Row—Ch 1 and work 5 s c over each loop, join, break thread.

Flower: With Yellow, ch 6, join to form a ring, * ch 4, s c in ring, repeat from * 5 times (6 loops), break Yellow. Attach Shaded Blues in loop, ch 4, 2 tr c in same loop, ch 1 and with wrong side of doily toward you, sl st in center st of any scallop of doily, ch 1, turn, sl st in same tr c of flower, 1 tr c in same loop of flower, ch 4, sl st in same loop of flower, sl st in next loop of center of flower, ch 4, 2 tr c in same space, ch 1, sl st in center st of next scallop of doily, ch 1, turn, sl st in top of same tr c of flower, 1 tr c in same loop of flower, ch 4, sl st in same loop of flower, * sl st in next loop of center of flower, ch 4, 3 tr c in same space, ch 4, sl st in some space, repeat from * 3 times, join (6 petals), break Blue. Work a 2nd flower joining side petal to side petal of 1st flower, skip 1 scallop on doily and join next 2 petals to next 2 scallops of doily. Work 22 more flowers in some manner joining same as previous flowers and having 2 petals free on top

of each flower joining last flower to 1st flower at side petal.

2nd Row of Flowers—Work center some as 1st row of flowers. Attach Shaded Blues in loop, ch 4, 3 tr c in some space, ch 4, sl st in same space, sl st in next loop of center, ch 4, 2 tr c in same space, ch 1 and with wrong side of doily toward you, sl st in 2nd free petal of any flower, ch 1, turn, sl st in top of tr c just made, tr c in some loop of center, ch 4, sl st in same space, sl st in next loop, ch 4, 2 tr c in same loop, ch 1, sl st in 1st free petal of next flower, ch 1, turn, sl st in top of tr c just made, tr c in some loop of center, ch 4, sl st in some space, then complete remaining 3 petals some as other flowers.

2nd Flower—Work center some as 1st flower. Attach Shaded Blues in loop, ch 4, 2 tr c in some space, ch 3, sl st in center st of side petal of previous flower, ch 3, turn, sl st in top of tr c just made, tr c in same space, ch 4, sl st in some space, sl st in next loop of center and join next 2 petals to previous row of flowers some as 1st flower, then complete remaining petals of flower same as 1st flower. Work 22 more flowers and join same as 2nd flower joining the side petal of last flower made to side petal of 1st flower.

Ch 6, join to form o ring, ch 5, d c in ring, * ch 2, d c in ring, repeat from * 5 times, ch 2, join in 3rd st of ch.
2nd Row—Sl st into loop, ch 3 (always counts as 1/3 part of 1st cluster st) and work a cluster st in each loop with ch 5 between cluster sts, (cluster st: thread over needle,

insert in space, pull through, thread over and work off 2 loops, * thread over needle, insert in some space, pull through, thread over and work off 2 loops, repeat from * once, thread over and pull through all loops at one time) ch 5, join in top of 1st cluster st.

3rd Row—Sl st into loop, ch 3, cluster st in some space, ch 4, cluster st in some space, * ch 4, 2 cluster sts with ch 4 between in next loop, repeat from * all around, ch 4, join.

4th Row—Sl st into loop, * ch 6, s c in next loop, repeat from * all around ending row with ch 2, tr c in sl st, this brings thread in position for next row.

5th Row—Ch 3, cluster st in some space, ch 5, cluster st in some space, * ch 5, s c in next loop, ch 5, sl st in next loop, ch 3, sl st in some loop, ch 5, s c in next loop, ch 5, 1 cluster st, ch 5, 1 cluster st in next loop (corner), repeat from * twice, ch 5, s c in next loop, ch 5, sl st in next loop, ch 3, sl st in some space, ch 5, s c in next loop, ch 5, join.

6th Row—Sl st into loop, ch 3 and work 2 cluster sts with ch 5 between in some space, * ch 5, s c in next ch 5 loop, repeat from * 3 times, ch 5, 2 cluster sts with ch 5 between in next loop, repeat from 1st * twice, * ch 5, s c in next ch 5 loop, repeat from * 3 times, ch 5, join.

7th Row—Sl st into loop, ch 3, 2 cluster sts with ch 5 between in some space, * ch 7, 2 cluster sts with ch 5 between in some space, ch 5, skip 1 loop, s c in next loop, ch 5, cluster st in next loop, ch 5, s c in next loop, ch 5, skip 1 loop, 2 cluster sts with ch 5 between in next loop, repeat from * all around ending row to correspond, join, break thread. Work a 2nd motif joining it to 1st motif in last row as follows, sl st into loop, ch 3, cluster st in

Will make 4 mats. Shaded Color may be used if desired.

With White ch 217, tr c in 12th st from hook, 1 tr c in next st of ch, * ch 3, skip 3 sts of ch, 1 tr c in each of the next 2 sts of ch, repeat from * 39 times, ch 3, skip 3 sts of ch, tr c in next st of ch, ch 1, turn.

2nd Row—S c in same space, * ch 3, 1 s c in each of the next 2 tr c, repeat from * across row ending row with ch 3, s c in 4th st of ch, ch 7, turn.

3rd Row—* 1 tr c in each of the next 2 s c, ch 3, repeat from * across row ending row with tr c in s c, ch 1, turn. Repeat the last 2 rows 22 times (piece should measure about 7¾ inches). Do not ch 1 to turn last row.

Next Row—Start border; working along side of work, ch 4, 3 tr c over side of tr c just made, * 1 tr c in side of each of the next 2 previous rows, 3 tr c in next mesh, repeat from * to corner mesh, work 7 more tr c in same mesh, 1 tr c in base of each of the next 2 tr c, continue working around remaining 3 sides in same manner ending row with 6 tr c in 1st mesh, join.

Next Row—Ch 7, skip 3 tr c, ** 1 tr c in each of the next 2 tr c, * ch 3, skip 3 tr c, 1 tr c in each of the next 2 tr c, repeat from * to next corner tr c group, ch 3, skip 3 tr c, 1 tr c in each of the next 2 tr c, ch 10, 1 tr c in each of the next 2 tr c, ch 3, skip 3 tr c, 1 tr c in each of the next 2 tr c, ch 3, repeat from ** all around in same manner ending row with ch 10, tr c in next st, join in 4th st of ch.

Next Row—Ch 1, s c in same space, * ch 3, 1 s c in each of the next 2 tr c, repeat from * to next corner loop, ch 3, skip 3 sts of ch, 1 s c in each of the next 4 sts of ch, repeat from 1st * all around in same manner, join in 1st s c.

Next Row—Ch 7, 1 tr c in each of the next 2 s c, * ch 3, 1 tr c in each of the next 2 s c, repeat from * to corner mesh, ch 3, 1 tr c in each of the next 2 s c, ch 10, 1 tr c in each of the next 2 s c, repeat from 1st * all around in same manner, join in 4th st of ch.

Repeat the last 2 rows 3 times.

Next Row—Ch 4, * 3 tr c in next mesh, 1 tr c in each of the next 2 tr c, repeat from * to next corner loop, 13 tr c in corner loop, repeat from 1st * all around in same manner, join in 4th st of ch.

Next Row—Ch 1, s c in same space, 1 s c in each of the next 9 tr c, ch 3, sl st in last s c for picot, * 1 s c in each of the next 10 tr c, ch 3, sl st in last s c for picot, repeat from * 12 times, * 1 s c in each of the next 5 tr c, ch 3 picot, repeat from * twice, * 1 tr c in each of the next 10 tr c, ch 3 picot, repeat from * 24 times, continue all around in same manner, join, break thread.

FLOWER—With Green ch 2 and work 10 s c in 2nd st from hook, join, break thread.

2nd Row—Attach Yellow, * ch 3, sl st in same space, ch 2, skip 1 s c, sl st in next s c, repeat from * 4 times, break thread.

Next Row—Petal; with wrong side of work toward you, attach Pink in any ch 2 loop and work 3 s c in loop, ch 1, turn.

Next 5 Rows—Working in s c, increase 1 s c at beginning and end of each row, ch 1 to turn each row. Work 1 row even, ch 3, turn.

Next Row—1 d c in same space, 1 d c in next s c, 1 s d c in next s c (s d c: thread over needle, insert in st, pull through, thread over and work off all loops at one time), 1 s c in each of the next 7 s c, 1 s d c in next s c, 1 d c in next s c, 2 d c in next s c, ch 3, turn.

Next Row—1 d c in each of the next 3 sts, 1 s d c in next

st, 1 s c in each of the next 5 s c, 1 s d c in next st, 1 d c in each of the next 4 sts, ch 2, turn.

Next Row—1 d c in each of the next 4 sts, 1 s d c in next st, 1 s c in each of the next 3 sts, 1 s d c in next st, 1 d c in each of the next 4 sts, 1 s d c in next st, break thread. Work 4 more petals in same manner. Work 3 more flowers in same manner and 4 more flowers in Rose Pink.

LEAF—With Green ch 16, sl st in 2nd st from hook, 1 s c in each of the next 2 sts of ch, 1 s d c in each of the next 2 sts of ch, 1 d c in each of the next 5 sts of ch, 1 s d c in each of the next 2 sts of ch, 1 s c in each of the next 2 sts of ch, sl st in next st, working on opposite side of ch, 1 s c in each of the next 2 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 2 sts, 1 d c in each of the next 5 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 2 sts, 1 s c in each of the next 2 sts, sl st in next st, join in 1st sl st.

2nd Row—Sl st in each of the next 2 sts, 1 s c in each of the next 2 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 5 sts, 1 s c in each of the next 2 sts, sl st in each of the next 5 sts, 1 s c in each of the next 2 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 5 sts, 1 s c in each of the next 2 sts, sl st in remaining sts, join, ch 8, break thread leaving an end long enough for sewing. Work 7 more leaves in same manner. Work 18 more leaves in same manner omitting the ch 8 at end of each leaf.

FINISHING—Applique one Rose Pink flower in each corner. In two opposite corners applique one Pink flower on each side of Rose Pink flower as illustrated. Arrange and applique leaves as illustrated.

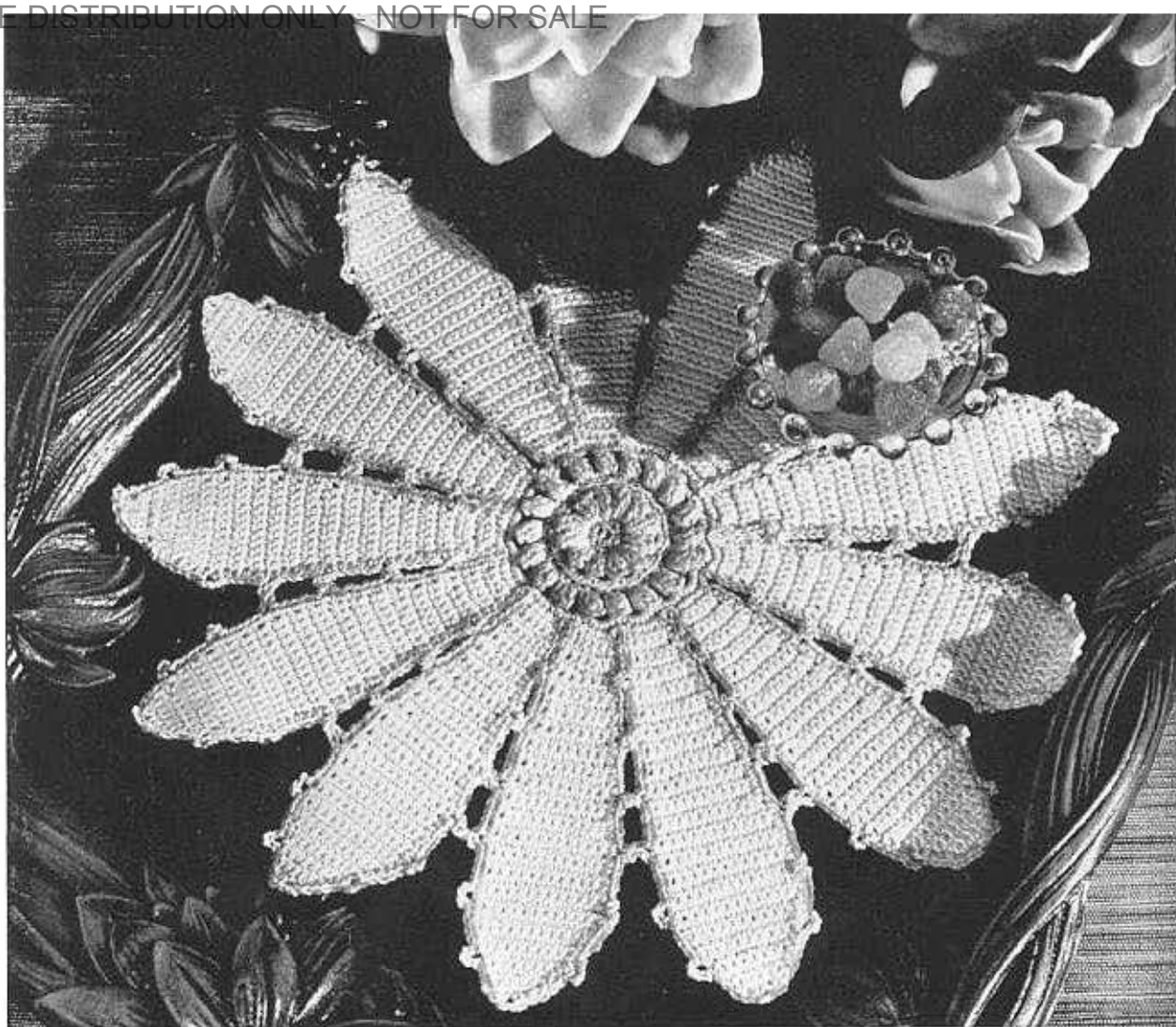

This makes a thick pasty mixture. As soon as starch is cool enough to handle, dip doily and squeeze starch through it thoroughly. Wring out extra starch. The doily should be wet with starch but there should be none in the spaces. Pin center of doily in position according to size and leave until thoroughly dry. If steam iron is used, iron ruffle after it is dry. If regular iron is used, dampen ruffle slightly before pressing. Pin folds of ruffle in position and leave until thoroughly dry.
 After doily is dry tie flowers over loops of doily as illustrated alternating the Colors.

9, sl st in corresponding petal of next flower to left of joining, ch 1, turn and work back on ch same as before, sl st in top of last s c made on motif, 1 s c in each of the next 4 s c of next motif, ch 7, sl st on right hand side of next petal of same flower, ch 1, turn and work back on ch same as before, sl st in top of last s c made on motif, 1 s c in each of the next 5 s c, picot, 1 s c in each of the next 5 s c, repeat from * 3 times, ch 1, sl st in tip of some petal, ch 1, sl st in top of last s c made on motif, 1 s c in each of the next 5 s c, ch 3, sl st on left hand side of same petal, ch 3, sl st in top of last s c made on motif, ch 3, sl st on right hand side of next petal of some flower, ch 3, turn, sl st in top of last s c made on motif, 1 s c in each of the next 5 s c, ch 1, sl st in tip of same petal of flower, ch 1, turn, sl st in top of last s c made on motif, 1 s c in each of the next 5 s c, picot, 1 s c in each of the next 5 s c, ch 7, sl st on left hand side of some petal, ch 1, turn and work back on ch same as before, sl st in top of last s c made on motif, 1 s c in each of the next 4 s c, picot, 1 s c in each of the next 4 s c of single motif, ch 7, sl st on right hand side of next petal, ch 1, turn and work down on ch same as before, sl st in top of last s c made on motif, 1 s c in each of the next 5 s c, picot, 1 s c in each of the next 5 s c, ch 1, sl st in tip of some petal, ch 1, turn, sl st in top of last s c made on motif, 1 s c in each of the next 5 s c, ch 3, sl st on side of some petal, ch 3, sl st in top of last s c made on motif, ch 3, sl st on side of next petal, ch 3, sl st in top of last s c made on motif, 1 s c in each of the next 5 s c, ch 1, sl st in tip of some petal, ch 1, turn, sl st in top of last s c made on motif, 1 s c in each of the next 5 s c, picot, 1 s c in each of the next 5 s c, ch 7, sl st on left hand side of some petal, ch 1, turn and work down on ch same as before, sl st in top of last s c made on motif, ch 7, sl st on right hand side of next petal, ch 1, turn and work down on ch same as before, sl st in top of last s c made on motif, then work 1 s c in each s c on the next 2 sides of single motif, working a picot on top of every 5th st having the picots over the cluster sts of previous row and 1 picot in center st at corners. Join next 3 flowers across short side in some manner and finish other long and short side to correspond.

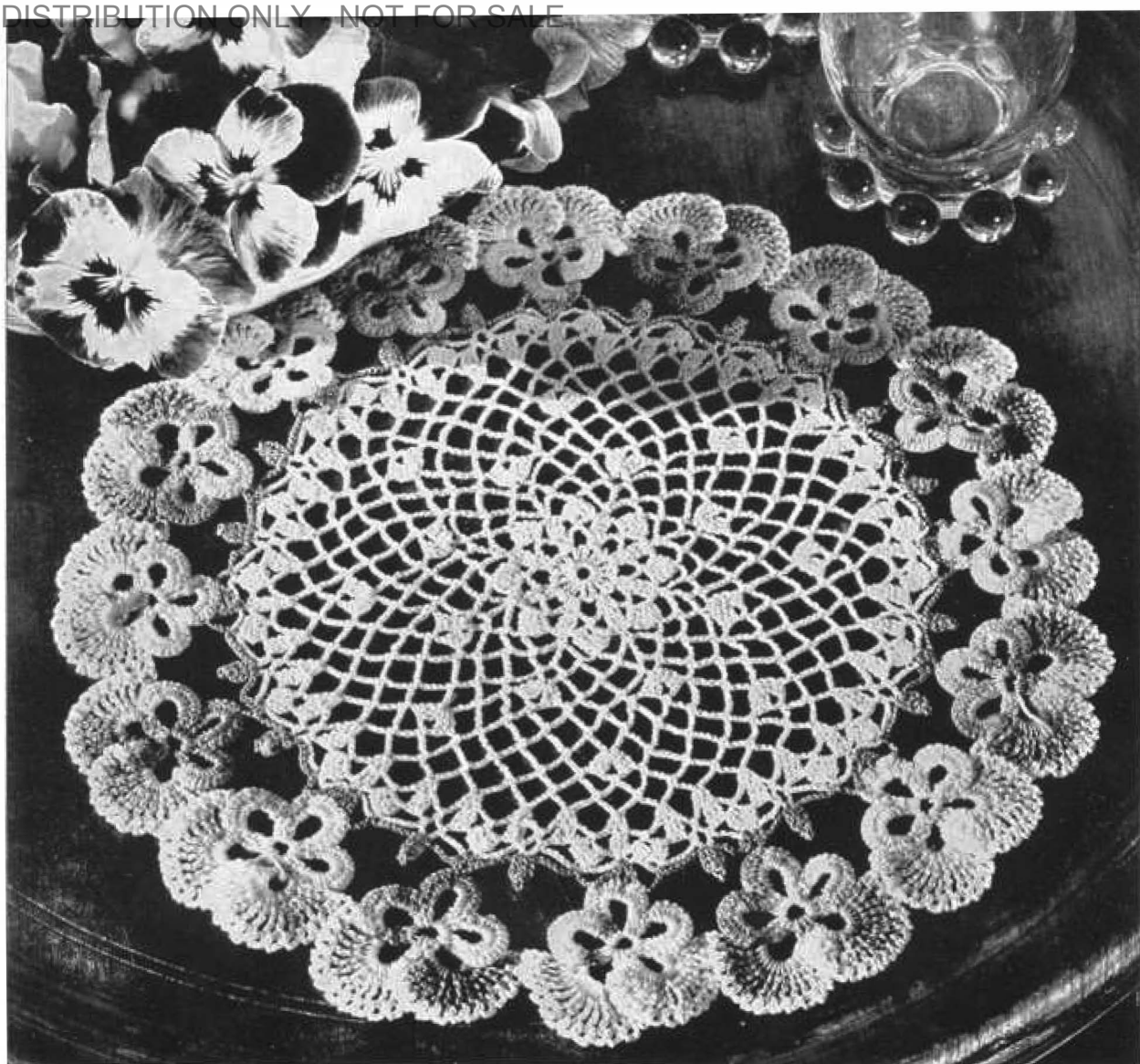

This means, that whatever appears in the parenthesis must be repeated the number of times specified after the closed parenthesis.

An even row means work row without increasing or decreasing.

2nd Row—Sl st into loop, ch 4, 2 tr c in some space, * ch 5, skip 1 loop, 3 tr c in next loop, repeat from * 6 times, ch 5, join in 4th st of ch.

3rd Row—Sl st to next tr c, ch 4, 2 tr c in same space, * ch 3, s c in next loop, ch 3, 3 tr c in center tr c of next tr c group, repeat from * 6 times, ch 3, s c in next loop, ch 3, join in 4th st of ch.

4th Row—Sl st to next tr c, ch 7, ** thread over needle twice, insert in next loop, pull through, thread over and work off 2 loops twice, * thread over needle twice, insert in same space, pull through, thread over and work off 2 loops twice, repeat from * once, repeat from ** once, thread over and work off all loops at one time (6 tr c cluster st), ch 7, s c in center tr c of next tr c group, ch 7, repeat from 1st ** all around in some manner ending row with s c in sl st.

5th Row—Ch 9, s c in next loop, * ch 7, s c in next loop, ch 5, 1 tr c in next s c, ch 5, s c in next loop, repeat from * 6 times, ch 7, s c in next loop, ch 2, d c in 4th st of ch.

6th Row—Ch 5, s c in next loop, ch 9, s c in next loop, ch 9, s c in next loop, repeat from beginning all around in same manner ending row with ch 4, d tr c (3 times over needle), in d c.

7th Row—Ch 3, 3 tr c, ch 3, 3 tr c (shell) in center st of next loop, ch 3, s c in next loop, ch 7, s c in next loop, repeat from beginning all around in some manner ending row with ch 3, d c in d tr c.

8th Row—Ch 8, s c in next loop, repeat from beginning all around ending row with ch 4, tr c in d c.

9th Row—Ch 9, s c in next loop, repeat from beginning all around ending row with ch 4, d tr c in tr c.

10th Row—Ch 4, shell in center st of next loop, ch 4, s c in next loop, ch 9, s c in next loop, ch 9, s c in next loop, repeat from beginning all around in same manner ending row with ch 4, d tr c in d tr c.

11th Row—Same as 8th row but ending row with tr c in d tr c.

12th Row—Same as 9th row.

13th Row—Ch 3, 2 d c in same space, * ch 6, 3 d c in center st of next loop, repeat from * all around, ch 6, join in 3rd st of ch.

14th Row—Sl st to next d c, ch 4, 2 tr c in same space, * ch 3, s c in next loop, ch 3, 3 tr c in center d c of next d c group, repeat from * all around in some manner, join in 3rd st of ch.

15th Row—Ch 7, 6 tr c cluster st over the next 2 loops, ch 7, s c in next loop, ch 5, s c in next loop, ch 7, 6 tr c cluster st over next 2 loops, ch 7, s c in center tr c of next tr c group, ch 7, 6 tr c cluster st over the next 2 loops, ch 7, s c in next loop, ch 5, s c in next loop, repeat from beginning all around in some manner, break thread.

PANSY—With Shaded Yellows ch 7, join to form a ring, ch 3 (counts as 1 d c), 2 d c in ring, * ch 7, 3 d c in ring, repeat from * 3 times, ch 7, join.

2nd Row—Sl st to loop, ch 3 (counts as 1 d c), work 15 more d c in loop, s c in center d c of next 3 d c group, * 16 d c in next loop, s c in center d c of next 3 d c group, repeat from * once (3 petals), ch 4, 12 d tr c (3 times around needle) with ch 1 between each d tr c in next loop, ch 1, 2 tr c with ch 1 between in same loop, ch 1, 2 d c with ch 1 between in some loop, s c in center d c of next 3 d c group, 2 d c with ch 1 between in next loop, ch 1, 2 tr c with ch 1 between in some loop, ch 1, 12 d tr c with ch 1 between each d tr c in same loop, ch 4, s c in center of next d c group, join, break thread. Work 7 more Shaded Yellow pansies and 8 Shaded Lavender pansies in some manner.

Attach Green in center st of 2nd loop to right of single cluster st, ** ch 4, * thread over needle twice, insert in same space, pull through, thread over and work off 2 loops twice, repeat from *, thread over and work off all loops at one time, ch 3, sl st in top of st just made for picot, ch 4, sl st in some space of loop, (leaf) ch 5, 2 d c in top of next cluster st, ch 1, sl st in center st of 2nd small petal of Lavender pansy, ch 1, 2 d c in some cluster st, ch 5, skip 1 loop, sl st in center st of next loop, leaf in some space, ch 7, s c in next cluster st, ch 4, sl st in 4th st of center small petal of Yellow pansy, ch 3, 2 d c in next s c, ch 1, sl st in center st of same petal of pansy, ch 1, 2 d c in same s c of doily, ch 3, skip 3 d c of same petal of pansy, sl st in next st, ch 4, s c in next cluster st, ch 7, skip 1 loop, sl st in center st of next loop, repeat from ** all around in same manner until all pansies are joined alternating Colors, break thread. Join White in s c between large petals at top of Yellow pansy, * ch 3, s c in next 1 ch loop, repeat from * 14 times, ch 3, s c in ch 4 loop of same pansy, ch 3, s c in 4 ch loop of large petal of Lavender pansy, work ch 3 loops across 2 large petals of pansy, ch 3, join the next Yellow pansy and continue until all pansies are joined.

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
