1 Cable Needle

Steel Crochet Hook Size 0

l yard Black grosgrain ribbon

7 inch CONMAR "NO-SNAG" Zipper

2 Hooks

GAUGE: 5 sts = 1 inch

NOTE: Twist yarns tightly on wrong side

when changing colors.

PATTERN A: Worked on 24 sts for 30 rows: ROW 1: (wrong side): P 1 \* K 2,

ROW 2: K 1, \* P 2, K 3; repeat from across, end P 2, K 1. ROW 3: As row 1. ROW 4: K 1, \* P 2, slip 2 sts to dp needle, hold in back of work, K 1, K 2 from dp needle; repeat from \* across, end P 2, K 1. ROW 5 and 7: As row 1. ROW 6: As row 2. ROW 8: K 1, \* P 2, slip 1 to dp needle, hold in front of work, K 2, K 1 from dp needle; repeat from \* across, end P 2, K 1. Repeat these 8 rows for pattern A. PATTERN B: Worked on 24 sts for 30 rows. ROW 1 (wrong side); K 2, \* P 4, K 4; repeat from \* across, end P 4, K 2. ROW 2: P 3, \* K 4, P 4; repeat from \* across, end K 4, P 1. ROW 3: \* P 4, K 4; repeat from \* across. ROW 4: K 1, \* P 4; K 4; repeat from \* across, end K 3. ROW 5: P 2, \* K 4; P 4; repeat from across, end P 2. ROW 6: K 3, \* P 4, K 4; repeat from \* across, end K 1. ROW 7: \* K 4, P 4; repeat from \* across. ROW 85 P 1, \* K 4, P 4; repeat from \* across, end P 3. Repeat these 8 rows for pattern B. PATTERN C: Worked on 24 sts for 30 rows. ROW 1 (wrong side); K 2 \* P 4, K 4; repeat from \* across, end P 4, K 2. ROW 2: P 2 \* K 4, P 4; repeat from \* across, end K 4, P 2, ROW 3: As row 1. ROW 4: \* Slip 3 sts to dp needle, hold in back of work, K 1, K 3 from dp needle, slip 1 st to dp needle, hold in front of work, K 3, K 1 from dp needle; repeat from \* across, Repeat these 4 rows for pattern C. PATTERN D: Worked on 24 sts. for 30 rows. ROW 1 (wrong side): K 1. P 1 for 5 sts, P 2, K 1, P 2 (cable) K 1, P 1 for 4 sts, P 2, K 1, P 2 (cable), K 1, P. 1 for 5 sts. ROW 2: K 1, P 1 for 5 sts, K 2, P 1, K 2 (cable), P 1, K 1, P 1, K 1, K 2, P 1, K 2 (cable), K 1, P 1 for 5 sts. ROW 3: As row 1. ROW 4: K 1, P 1 for 5 sts, slip 3 sts to dp needle, hold in back of work, K next 2 sts, P 1, K 2 from dp needle, P 1, K 1, P 1, K 1, slip 3 sts to dp needle, hold in back of work, K next



2 sts, P 1, K 2 from dp needle, K 1, P 1 for 5 sts. ROWS 5, 7, 9, AND 11: As row 1, ROWS 6, 8, 10, AND 12: As row 2. Repeat rows 1 through 12 for pattern D. PATTERN E: Worked on 24 sts for 30 rows. ROW 1 (wrong side): K 2, P 1, K I, P1, K4, P1, K4, P1, K1, P1, K4, P 1, K 2. ROW 2: P 2, slip 1 (slip as if to P with yorn in back of work), P 4, slip 1, P 1, slip 1, P 4, slip 1, P 4, slip 1, P 1, slip 1, P 2 Repeat these 2 rows for pattern E. RATTERN F: Worked on 24 sts for 30 rows. ROW 1 (wrong side): Purl. ROW 2: K 3, 4 popcorn in next st (K from back to front alternately 5 times in one st loosely, K 6th st in same st tightly, pull the 5 loose sts over the 6th st), K 5; repeat from \* across, end popcorn st, K 2. ROW 3: P. ROW 4: K 2, \* popcorn, K 1, popcorn, K 3; repeat from \* across, end popcorn, K 1. ROW 5: Purl across. ROW 6: As row 2. ROWS 7. 9, 11, 13, 15: Purl. ROWS 8, 10, 12, 14: Knit. ROW 16: K 6, \* popcorn, K 5; repeat from \* across, end K 5. ROWS 17, 19, 21, 23, 25: Purl. ROWS 18, 20, 22, 24: Knit. ROW 26: As row 2, ROW 27: As row 3. ROW 28: As row 4. ROW 29: As row 5. ROW 30: As row 6.

BACK: With color #5 and No. 8 knitting needles cast on 124 sts. Attach colors and K across next row as follows: K 25 #2, K 25 #4, K 25 #1, K 25 #3 and K 24 #4. Each pattern box has 24 sts and between each pattern box there is 1 st worked in stockinette st so that it will be the guide st when working in the vertical #5 line upon completion of section. Start patterns following the chart on page 4 on next row, keeping the 1 st between boxes in stockinette st until the 30 pattern rows for each box are completed. All patterns end with the completion row on right side. With #5 purl 1 row across all sts. Establish the next boxes as designated on the chart by knitting across 1 row in the new colors. Start patterns for new boxes in the colors just established on the row below

on the wrong side of work. Make sure to keep the one st in stockinette st between boxes all the way up. Follow chart ending off boxes with a row of purl in #5 and establishing new boxes as explained above until the 5 boxes are completed. P 1 row in #5. Section should measure approximately 22" from beg. Bind off.

FRONT: With #5 and No. 8 knitting needles cast on 124 sts. Follow chart for front establishing colors and patterns in same manner as for back. Make sure to keep the one st stockinette st between boxes all the way up. After completion of 5th row of boxes, P 1 row in #5. Bind off. WAISTBAND: With #5 cast on 10 sts. Work even in stockinette st for 24½" (size 10), 26½" (size 12), 27½" (size 14), 29½" (size 16), 30½" (size 18) and 32½ (size 20). Bind off.

FINISHING: Block each pattern to same size. Along each st that was worked in stockinette st to separate the boxes, with #5 embroider a duplicate st. Embroider these vertical lines between boxes on back and front. Reblock pieces. With #5 work I row of s c along each side edge. Sew side seams flat leaving a 7" opening for zipper on left side. With #5 sew a running st around waistline and gather in to measure approx. 24" (size 10), 25" (size 12), 26" (size 14), 28" (size 16), 30" (size 18), 32" (size 20). Block waistband. With #5 work 1 row of s c around all sides of waistband. Place one edge of waistband over waistline edge of skirt and sew allowing approx. 1/2" for an overlap above zipper opening. Line waistband with ribbon and turn over top edge of waistband and sew. Sew in zipper. Block. With #5 work 1 row of s c around lower edge of skirt.

GAUGE For Sixe J Hook: 3 s c = 1 inch Directions are given for small size (10-12). Changes for medium (14-16) and large (18-20) sizes are given in paren-

With Amber and J hook ch 221 (238, 255), join in 1st st of ch taking care not to twist ch, ch 1, 1 s c in same space, I s c in each of the next 6 sts of ch, \* 3 s c in next st, 1 s c in each of the next 7 sts of ch, skip 2 sts of ch, 1 s c in each of the next 7 sts of ch, repeat from \* across ch ending to correspond, join in 1st s c. 2nd ROUND: Ch 1, turn, working in back loop of sts throughout skip 1 s c, \* 1 s c in each of the next 7 s c, 3 s c in next

SIZE: One size will fit 10-16

Materials Required:

AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "DAWN" KNITTING WORSTED

30 ounces Tangerine

1 Pr. KNITTING NEEDLES No. 8 OR ANY SIZE NEEDLE WHICH WILL RESULT IN STITCH GAUGE BELOW.

3/4 yd. 3/4 inch elastic GAUGE: 6 sts = 1 inch

MOTIF Cast on one st and K 2 sts into it. 2nd ROW: K1, K2 in next st. 3rd ROW: K 2, K 2 in next st. NEXT 19 ROWS: Continue knitting increasing I st in last st until there are 23 sts on needle. 23rd ROW: Purl across row and increase in last st (continue increasing at the end of each row until the 61st row has been completed. The increases will not be referred to again and must be added to each row except in rows 24 and 36. In these 2 rows the complete directions are given). 24th ROW: K 1, \* K 2 tog, K 1, y o, repeat from \* 6 times, K 2 and increase. NEXT 11 ROWS: P 1 row, K 9 rows, P 1 row, 36th ROW: K1, \* K2 together, K1, y o, repeat from \* 10 times, K 2 and increase. NEXT 5 ROWS: P 1 row, K 4 rows. 42nd ROW: K3, y o, K1, y o, \* K6, y o, K1, y o, repeat from \* 4 times, K 3. 43rd ROW: K 4, P 3, \* K 6, P 3, repeat from \* 4 times, K 3. 44th ROW: K 4, y o, K 3, y o, \* K 6, y o, K 3, y o, repeat from \* 4 times, K 4. 45th ROW: K 5, P 5, \* K 6, P 5, re-

peat from \* 4 times, K 4. 46th ROW: K 5. y o, K 5, y o, \* K 6, y o, K 5, y o, repeat from \* 4 times, K 5. 47th ROW: \* K 6, P 7, repeat from \* 5 times, K 5. 48th ROW: K 6, \* sl 1, K 1, pass sl st over K st, (p.s.s.o.) K 3, K 2 together, K 6, repeat from across row ending with K 6. 49th ROW: K 7, \* P 5, K 6, repeat from \* across row ending with K 6. 50th ROW: K 7, \* sl ), K 1, p.s.s.o., K 1, K 2 tog, K 6, repeat from \* across row ending with K7. 51st ROW: K8, \* P3, K6, repeat from \* across row ending with K 7. 52nd ROW: K 8, \* K 3 together, K 6, repeat from \* across row ending with K 8. NEXT 9 ROWS: K 4 rows, P 1 row, K 1 row, P 1 row, K 2 rows. 62nd ROW: Start decreasing, K to within the last 3 sts, K 2 tog, K 1, 63rd ROW: Purl to within the last 3 sts, P 2 tog, P 1. (Decrease 1 st at end of each row in same manner. Decreases will not be referred to again and must be worked in each row except in rows, 76, 80 and 121. In these rows the complete directions are given). NEXT 12 ROWS: K 1 row, P 1 row, K 9 rows, P 1 row. 76th ROW: K 1, \* K 2 tog, K 1, y o, repeat from # 14 times, K 2 tog (47 sts on needle). NEXT 3 ROWS: P 1 row, K 1 row, P 1 row. 80th ROW: K 1, \* K 2 tog, K 1, y o, repeat from \* 12 times, K 1, K 2 together, K 1, (43 sts on needle). NEXT 17 ROWS: P 1 row, K 9 rows, P 1 row, K I row, P I row, K I row, P I row, K 2



rows. 98th ROW: K 12, yo, K 1, yo, K to end of row. 99th ROW: K 12, P 3, K to end of row. 100th ROW: K 11, y o, K3, y o, K to end of row. 101st ROW: K 11 P.5, K to end of row. 102nd ROW: K 10, y o, K 5, y o, K to end of row. 103rd ROW: K 10, P 7, K to end of row. 104th ROW: K 9, y o, K 7, y o, K to end of row. 105th ROW: K 9, P 9, K to end of row. 106th ROW: K 8, y o, K 9, y o, K to end of row. 107th ROW: K 8, P 11, K to end of row. 108th ROW: K 7, sl 1, K 1, p.s.s.o., K 7, K 2 tog, K to end of row. 109th ROW: K 7, P 9, K to end of row. 110th ROW: K 6, sl 1, K 1, p.s.s.o., K 5, K 2 tog, K to end of row. 111th ROW: K 6, P 7, K to end of row. 112th ROW: K 5, sl 1, K 1, p.s.s.o., K 3, K 2 tog, K to end of row. 113th ROW: K 5, P 5, K to end of row. 114th ROW: K 4, sl 1, K 1, p.s.s.o., K 1, K 2 tog, K to end of row. 115th ROW: K 4, P 3, K to end of row. 116th ROW: K 3, K 3 tog, K to end of row. 117th, 118th, 119th and 120th ROWS: K across each row, 121st ROW: K 2 tog, K 1, turn, K 2 tog and fasten off. Work 17 more motifs. Weave motifs together as illustrated through loop in back of edge sts matching rows.

WAISTBAND AND CASING: See skirt on page 27. Work a row of sl sts around top edge, HEM: Turn up 2 inches or required amount for length desired all around and sl st in place.



# The Afghan Coat

Sizes: Small, Medium-Large Materials Required:

#### AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "DAWN" KNITTING WORSTED

25 (32) ounces Black
23 (30) ounces assorted colors
Plastic Crochet Hook Size H OR ANY
SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN
MOTIF GAUGE BELOW

GAUGE: Each motif is a 4½ inch square. Directions are given for Small size (10-12-14). Changes for Medium-Large size (16-18-20) are given in parentheses. MOTIF: With any color ch 4, join to form a ring, ch 3 (counts as I d c), 2 d c in ring, \* ch 1, 3 d c in ring, repeat from \*

twice, ch 1, join in 3rd st of ch, cut yarn. 2nd ROUND: Attach next color in ch 1 loop, ch 3, 2 d c, ch 1, 3 d c in same loop, \* 3 d c , ch 1, 3 d c in next loop, repeat from \* twice, join in 3rd st of ch, cut yarn. 3rd ROUND: Attach next color in corner loop, ch 3, 2 d c, ch 1, 3 d c in same loop, \* 3 d c in next space between corners, 3 d c, ch 1, 3 d c in next loop, repeat from \* twice, 3 d c in next space, join in 3rd st of ch. 4th ROUND: Attach Black in corner loop, ch 3, 2 d c, ch 1, 3 d c in same loop, \* 3 d c in each of the next 2 spaces, 3 d c, ch 1, 3 d c in corner loop, repeat from \* twice, 3 d c in each of the next 2 spaces, join in 3rd st of ch. 5th



#### Make It Long Make It Short Make It Medium

ROUND: Ch 1, work 3 s c in each corner st and work 1 s c in each st in round, join in 1st s c, cut yarn. Work 99 (151) more motifs in same manner working colors as desired.

FINISHING: Sew motifs tog through loop in back of sts of last row according to chart #3 for full length small size or #2 for full length large size on page 33.

TRIM: With Black, ch 3, work 5 s c in 1st st of ch. Do not join or turn rows. Working into back loop of each st work 1 s c in each st until trim is long enough to fit all around edge of coat. Finish each sleeve edge in same manner.

NOTE: If a shorter coat or jacket is desired, work in same manner following charts on pages 32 and 33 for length desired. If desired line coat.

9 ounces Black

11 ounces assorted colors
Plastic Crochet Hook Size H

Plastic Crochet Hook Size H OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN MOTIF GAUGE BELOW

yd. Taffeta for lining

Cafe Drapery Rod (20 inches long)

2 sets Drapery Rod Clips

GAUGE: Each motif is a 4½ inch square. Work 40 motifs same as motif on page 8. Sew 8 x 5 motifs tog same as Afghan Coat on page 8. Fold section in half having 5 motifs on each side of top. Sew side seams With Black work a row of s c across top dec every 3rd st, join in 1st

s c. NEXT ROW: Ch 3, 2 d c in same space, \* skip 2 sts, s c in next st, ch 3, 2 d c in same space, repeat from \* all around ending to correspond. Cut lining to fit bag allowing 1/2 inch for seams. Sew in position. Separate drapery rod and lace one half through each side of bag as illustrated. (Leave 3 shells free at each end of bag). Sew drapery clips in position at each end. HANDLES: With Black ch 2, 5 s c in 2nd st from hook, join. NEXT ROW: Ch 1, working in back loop of sts only 1 s c in each s c. Without joining rows continue in s c until handle measures 18 inches from beg. Work another handle in same manner. Cut 6 strands of Black 18 inches long. Lace through handle. Sew handles in position to free end of drapery clips.



# Slippers

# Materials Required: AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "DAWN" KNITTING WORSTED

2 ounces Watermelon

1 ounce Bright Pink No. 1 or colors of your choice

Plastic Crochet Hook Size H OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN MOTIF GAUGE BELOW.

**GAUGE:** Small motif is a 3 Inch square; Large motif is a 7 inch square.

SMALL MOTIF: (make 4) With Bright Pink No. 1 work 1st 5 rounds same as motif on page 12 finishing last round to end of next corner, join, cut yarn.

#### 3 Crocheted Squares Make A Slipper

LARGE MOTIF: (make 2) With Water-melon work 1st 7 rounds some as motif on page 12. Do not cut yarn at end of last round. NEXT 5 ROUNDS: Repeat 7th round finishing last round to end of next corner, join, cut yarn.

FINISHING: Fold large motif so that opposite points meet at center. Place I small motif in one opening. Sewing through loops in back of sts of last row, sew motifs in place centering points of all corners of small motif. Place and sew remaining small motif in position sewing 2 sides and 3 sts beyond center st of large motif for heel section.

# Crocheted Suits

SIZES: Small, Medium and Large Materials Required:

#### AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "DAWN" KNITTING WORSTED

18 (21, 24) ounces Tangerine or color of your choice

Plastic Crochet Hook Size H OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN MOTIF GAUGE BELOW

3/4yd. 3/4 inch elastic

GAUGE: Each motif is a 4 inch square.
Directions are given for small size (1012). Changes for medium (14-16) and large (18-20) sizes are given in parentheses.

MOTIF: Ch 2, work 8 s c in 1st st of ch (Do not join rounds, place a marker at beginning of each round). 2nd ROUND: Working in back loop of sts only throughout, \*3 s c in next s c, 1 s c in next s c, repeat from \* all around. 3rd to 7th ROUNDS: Work 1 s c in each s c working 3 s c in each corner s c, ending 7th round with s1 st in the 1st 2 s c to even round, cut yarn.

#### SKIRT

Work 60, (72, 84) motifs. Block each motif. Sew  $5 \times 12$   $(6 \times 12, 7 \times 12)$  motifs together sewing through loop in back of sts of last row.

BORDER: Attach yarn and working in back loop of sts only work 7 rounds of s.c., join in last round, sl st in next s.c., cut yarn. WAISTBAND: Working into back loop of sts work a round of s.c. de every other st, do not join. Work in rounds of s.c. until waistband measures 1 ½ inches, sl st in next 2 s.c., cut yarn.

CASING FOR ELASTIC: Attach yarn on inside of waistband in last round, \* ch 5, skip 3 s c, sl st in 1st round, ch 5, skip 3 s c, sl st in next s c of last round, re-

peat from \* all around, join, cut yarn. Lace elastic through casing.

NOTE: Directions for Coats below are given for small (10-12) size. Changes for medium-large size (14-16) are given in parentheses.

#### 34 LENGTH COAT (center) 34 (37) ounces

Work 98 (108) motifs, Block each motif and sew tog through loop in back of sts of last row. Arrange motifs according to chart on page 33 easing fullness at shoulders.

EDGING: Join yarn in center st at back of neck, then working in back loop of sts only, work 6 rows of s c for small size and 9 rows of s c for medium size all around working 3 s c in corner st at each lower front edge, st st in next 2 s c to even row, cut yarn.

#### JACKET (on left)

20 (23) ounces

Work 62 (67) motifs. Block and sew tog same as <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> length coat arranging motifs according to chart on page 32 and easingfullness at shoulder.

EDGING: Work same as 34 length.

#### % LENGTH COAT (on right) 36 (40) ounces

Work 108 (140) motifs. Block and sew motifs tog. Arrange motifs according to chart on page 33 but having 9 motifs in length for front and back. Leave 2 motifs free at each side seam for slits. Work tubing to fit all around edge and around each sleeve as follows: ch 2, 5 s c in 2nd st from hook, do not join this or following rounds. Working in back loop of sts, 1 s c in each s c until tubing is length required, cut yarn. Sew tubing in place easing in position at sides.

# Hairpin Lace Stole

illustrated in color on back cover

18 inches x 60 inches without fringe

Materials Required:

AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY
"DAWN" BABY YARN or
"DAWN" NYLON OR 'DAWN" NYLON
POMPADOUR or

"DAWN" ORLON HIGH BULK FINGER-ING YARN or "DAWN" ORLON POMPA-DOUR

9 ounces Baby Blue or color of your choice Plastic Crochet Hook Size E

1 — 1 inch Hairpin Lace Staple Each motif is a 3 inch square.

HAIRPIN LACE: Make a loop at end of yarn, place left prong of staple in loop just made having beg of loop at center of staple, insert hook in loop, wind yarn around right prong of hairpin staple, yarn over and draw through loop keeping work at center of staple, yarn over and pull through loop, \* drop loop from hook, turn staple ½ turn to the left, pick up dropped loop at center, insert hook through top part of loop on left prong, yarn over and pull through loop on the staple and on the hook at the same time, repeat from \* for lenath desired.

MOTIF: Work a length of hairpin lace having 52 loops on each side of staple, cut yarn leaving a length for joining. Remove from staple and join both ends at center to form a circle. Take care not to twist length. Make a loop on hook,

keeping I twist in each loop working along inner edge of circle, insert hook through 13 loops, yarn over and pull through all loops, \* ch 5, insert hook through next 13 loops, yarn over and pull through all loops, repeat from \* all around, ch 5, join in 1st 13 loop group, cut yarn. INNER CIRCLE: Ch 2, 3's c in 2nd st from hook, ch I drop loop from hook, insert in center st of any ch 5 loop of hairpin lace, pull dropped loop through, ch 1, 3 s c in same st where 3 s c were worked, \* ch 1, join in same manner to next ch 5 loop, ch 1, 3 s c in same st where 3 s c were worked, repeat from # all around ending to correspond, join, cut yorn. Working around outer edge of hairpin lace, keeping 1 twist in loops, attach yarn in center loop of any corner, ch 3, 2 d c in same loop, \* s d c in next loop (s d c: yarn over hook, insert in loop, pull yarn through, yarn over and work off all loops at one time), Ls c in each of the next 10 loops, s d c in next loop, 5 d c in next loop, repeat from \* all around ending to correspond working 2 d c in 1st st already worked in, join in 3rd st of ch, cut yarn.

FINISHING: Work 119 more motifs in some manner. Block all motifs. Sewing through back loop of sts only sew 6 x 20 motifs tog. Working into both loops work a row of s c around outer edge working 1 s c into each st of each motif and 3 s c

in each corner st.

FRINGE: Wind yarm over a 7 inch cardboard. Cut one end. Using 3 strands, double in half, insert hook in st, pull loop through, draw ends tightly through loop. Work a fringe in every other st across each short edge. Trim fringe evenly.

NEXT ROW: SI 1 as if to K, working in front of next st K 1, P 1 (an inc), K remaining sts. Repeat last 2 rows until there are 28 (30) sts on needle, bind off. Work 40 triangles of each color. Block each triangle. Alternating colors sew triangles tog through loop in back of sI sts on each side and through loop in back of each bound off st. Work a sl st in matching color along each motif on lower edge. WAISTBAND: With Bittersweet cast on 7 sts. K across row inc 1 st in each st. 2nd ROW: K 1 in back loop of st, \* sl 1 as if to P, K 1, repeat from \* across row ending with st 1. Repeat 2nd row until waistband measures 26 (28) inches or desired waistline length, bind off. Lace elastic through band. Work a row of sl sts across top of skirt drawing skirt in to measure 26 (28) inches. SI st waistband in place concealing sts. Seam waistband.

entheses. Each Motif measures about 7 inches.

3/4 yd elastic

MOTIF: With Turquoise ch 13, sl st in 6th st from hook to form a ring, over remainder of ch work 1's c, 1 s d c (s d c: yarn over hook, insert in st, pull loop through, yarn over and work off all loops at one time), 5 d c, \* ch 6, drop loop from hook, insert hook in ring, pick up loop and pull through ring, ch 1, over the ch 6 just made work 1 s c, 1 s d c, 5 d c, repeat from \* 10 times, join in 1st st of starting ch (12 petals completed). 2nd ROW:

ch 2, s c in next loop between petals repeat from \* all around, join, cut yarn. 3rd ROW: Attach Kelly Green in any s.c. ch 3, keeping last loop of each d c on hook, 2 d c in same space, yarn over and work off all loops at one time, \* ch 2, s c in next picot, ch 2, cluster st in next s c (cluster st: keeping last loop of each d c on hook, 3 d c in same space, yarn over and work off all loops at one time) repeat from \* all around ending with ch (2, s)c in next picot, ch 2, join in top of 1st cluster st, cut yarn. 4th ROW: Attach White in any s c, ch 3, 2 d c in same space, ch 3, 3 d c in same space (corner), \* ch 2, 3 d c in next sc, ch 2, 3 dc in next sc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 3, 3 d c in next s c (corner), repegt from \* all around ending with ch 2, 3 d c in next s c, ch 2, 3 d c in next s c, ch 2, join in 3rd st of ch, cut yarn. 5th ROW: Attach Black in corner loop, ch 3, 2 d c in same space, ch 3, 3 d c in same space, \* 1 d c in each of the next 3 d c, 2 d c in next loop, repeat from \* twice, 1 d c in each of the next 3 d c, 3 d c in next corner loop, ch 3, 3 d c in same space, repeat from 1st \* all around ending to correspond, join. 6th ROW: Ch 1 and work 1 s c in each a c and 3 s c in each corner loop, join, cut yarn. Thread White into embroidery needle, bring needle up through center of ring and work a straight stitch over center of each petal leaving 3 d c at top of each petal free. With Amber work a back st around lower edge of each straight st. Work 11 (14) more motifs in same manner but using White for 1st 2 rows. With Turquoise embroider straight st over center of each petal. Block each motif.

FINISHING: Sew motifs tog through back loops of sts only. Sew 3 x 8 (3 x 10) motifs alternating colored centers. Sew

remaining seams.

WAISTBAND: Join Black in 1st st of any motif, ch 3, \* yarn over, insert in next st, pull through and work off 2 loops, yarn over, insert in next st, pull through and work off 2 loops, yarn over and work off all loops at one time (a dec), I d c in next st, repeat from \* all ground, join in 3rd st of ch. 2nd ROUND: Ch 1, 1 s c in each st, join. 3rd ROUND: Work in same manner as 1st round. NEXT 6 ROUNDS: Repeat 2nd round, join, cut yarn (For 5'2" or under work only 6 rounds of s c working dec rounds in 1st and 3rd rounds of sc). CASING FOR ELASTIC. Join Black on inside of waistband in any st of 6th round from top, \* ch 5, skip 3 s c, sl st in next st of 2nd round from top, ch 5, skip 3 s c, sl st in next st of 6th round from top, repeat from \* all around, join, cut yarn. Lace elastic through casing.

LOWER EDGE: Join Black in any s c, ch 1, 1 s c in each s c, join 2nd ROUND: Ch 3, 1 d c in each s c, join in 3rd st of ch. Repeat last 2 rounds twice, cut yarn (For 5' 7" or over repeat last 2 rounds

for desired length.)

#### SLIPOVER

Sizes: 4-6; 8-10; 12-14; 16-18; 20-22 Materials Required:

#### AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "DAWN" KNITTING WORSTED

8 (10, 14, 18, 22) ounces for Sweater or Cardigan

Plastic Crochet Hook Size H OR ANY SIZE HOOK WHICH WILL RESULT IN MOTIF GAUGE BELOW.

GAUGE: Each motif is a 2½ inch square. Materials above given for size 4-6. Changes for sizes 8-10; 12-14; 16-18; 20-22 are given in parentheses.

#### SIZE 4-6

Work 64 motifs working 1st 4 rounds of motif on page 12.

BACK: Sew 5 (width) x 4 (length) motifs tog sewing through back loops of sts only. FRONT: Work same as back.

SLEEVES: Sew 3 (length) x 4 (width) motifs tog.

TO ASSEMBLE: Place front and back sections tog. Sew 2 lower motifs tog for side seam. Sew 1 motif on front and back for each shoulder. Sew 3 motifs for sleeve seams, then sew sleeves in position to 2 free motifs of front and 2 free of back. Work 52 s c all around neck opening. CUFFS: Work 26 s c around each edge. 2nd ROUND: Working in front loops of sts only work 1 s.c in each s.c. 3rd ROUND: Working in back loops of sts only work 1 s c in each s c, sl st in 1st 2 s c to end round. WAISTBAND: Working in back loop of sts only, work 68 s c all around lower edge. Repeat 2nd and 3rd rounds of cuffs 3 times, cut yarn.

#### **SIZE 8-10**

Work 84 motifs (same as 4-6)

BACK: Sew 6 (width) x 5 (length) motifs tog, sewing through back loops of sts.

FRONT: Work same as back.

SLEEVES: Same as size 4-6.

TO ASSEMBLE: Sew 3 lower motifs tog for each side seam. Sew 1 ½ motifs tog for each shoulder. Complete same as size 4-6, working 54 s c around neck edge, 28 s c around each cuff and 84 s c around waistband.

#### SIZE12-14

Work 114 motifs (same as 4-6)

BACK: Sew 7 (width) x 6 (length) motifs tog sewing through back loops of sts only. FRONT: Work same as back.

SLEEVES: Sew 3 (length) x 5 (width) motifs tog.

TO ASSEMBLE: Sew lower 3½ motifs tog for side seams. Sew 2 motifs tog for each shoulder. Complete same as size 4-6 working 58 s.c. around neck edge, 32 s.c. around each cuff and 98 s.c. around waistband.

#### SIZE 16-18

Work 136 motifs (same as 4-6)

BACK: Sew 8 (width) x 6 (length) motifs tog sewing through back loops of sts only. FRONT: Work same as back.

SLEEVES: Sew 4 (length) x 5 (width) motifs tog.

TO ASSEMBLE: Sew lower 31/2 motifs tog for side seams. Sew 2 motifs tog for each shoulder. Complete same as size 4-6 working 62 s c around neck edge, 34 s c around each cuff and 112 s c around waistband.

#### SIZE 20-22

Work 174 motifs (same as 4-6)

BACK: Sew 9 (width) x 7 (length) motifs tog sewing through back loops of sts only. FRONT: Work same as back.

SLEEVES: Sew 4 length x 6 width motifs tog.

TO ASSEMBLE: Sew lower 4 motifs tog for side seams. Sew 3 motifs tog for each shoulder. Complete same as size 4-6, working 66 s c around neck edge, 36 s c around each cuff and 126 s c around waistband.






#### SIZES 4 to 22

Work Back and Sleeves same as corresponding size sweater.

FRONTS: Work as follows:

SIZE 4-6: Work 16 motifs. Sew 2 x 4 motifs tog for each front. Complete side and sleeve seams same as sweater.

SIZE 8-10: Work 20 motifs. Sew 2 x 5 motifs tog for each front. Complete side and sleeve seams same as sweater.

SIZE 12-14: Work 24 motifs. Sew 2 × 6 motifs tog for each front. Complete side and sleeve seams same as sweater.

SIZE 16-18: Work 36 motifs. Sew 3 × 6 motifs tog for each front. Complete side and sleeve seams same as sweater.

SIZE 20-22: Work 42 motifs. Sew 3 x 7 motifs tog for each front. Complete side and sleeve seams same as sweater.

BORDERS FOR ALL SIZES EXCEPT 12-14: Attach yarn at lower right front edge, work s c all around edge working 1 s c in each st working 3 s c in each corner st. 2nd ROUND: Working into front loops of sts only work 1 s c in each st working 3 s c in each corner st. 3rd ROUND: Working in back loops of sts only work 1 s c in each st working 3 s c in each corner st. Repeat last 2 rounds twice, cut yarn. Work cuffs same as sweater.

st from shoulder seam on left front, sl st in same space, working in back loop of sts, work 1 s c in each s c to corner, ch 1, turn. Work 1 s c in front loop of each s c, sl st in last s c of row below, cut yarn. Work right front to correspond. Then complete border same as border of other sizes.

#### Child's Motif Skirt

SIZES: 4-10

Work 2 more motifs than sweater in width for front and 2 more motifs than sweater

in width for back for size desired. Work as many motifs as necessary for length. Assemble motifs and finish with Border and Waistband same as Larger Skirt on page 12. Work casing for elastic, and lace elastic through casing If a fuller skirt is desired work more motifs in width.

with H hook ch 3, \* holding all loops on hook, insert hook in each of 15 sts pulling loops up the length of a dic, yarn over and pull through all loops at one time, ch 3, s c in next ch 2 space, ch 3, repeat from \* all around ending to correspond, join, ch) turn. 2nd ROUND: Work 1 s c in each s c and in each st of ch, join, ch 1, turn. 3rd ROUND: 1 s c in each s c, join, ch 1, turn, Repeat 3rd round 3 times, cut yarn. CASING FOR ELASTIC: Join Amber in any s c of 1st s c round on inside of waistband, \* ch 5, skip 2 sts, sl st in next s c of last s c round of waistband, ch 5, skip 2 sts, sl st in next s c of 1st s c round, repeat from \* all around ending to correspond, join, cut yarn. Lace elastic through casing.

This means, that whatever appears in the parenthesis must be repeated the number of times specified including the closed parenthesis. An even row means work row without increasing or decreasing.
