MATERIALS:

CLARK'S O.N.T. or J. & P. COATS BEST SIX CORD MERCERIZED CROCHET, size 20.

SMALL BALL:

CLARK'S O.N.T.—10 balls of White or Ecru,

OR

J. & P. COATS —6 balls of White or Ecru.

BIG BALL:

J. & P. COATS —3 balls of White or Ecru.

1 yard of linen, 18 inches wide.

This material is sufficient for a luncheon set consisting of a center mat about 16 inches square, 4 place mats about 11 inches square and 8 mats about 5½ inches square (4 for bread and butter plates and 4 for glasses).

CENTER MAT—First Corner . . . Use shuttle and ball of thread. First Motif: R of 6 ds, 3 p's sep. by 2 ds, 4 ds, cl. R of 4 ds, join to adjacent p of previous r, 2 ds, 4 p's sep. by 2 ds, 4 ds, cl. R of 4 ds, join to adjacent p of previous r, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, p, 6 ds, cl (clover leaf made). Rw, ch of 4 ds, p, 4 ds. * Rw, r of 6 ds, join to adjacent p of previous r, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. Complete clover leaf as before. Rw, ch of 4 ds, join to p of previous ch, 4 ds. Repeat from * 2 more times, joining last r to adjacent p of 1st r made, and joining last ch to base of 1st r.

Second Motif . . . R of 6 ds, 3 p's sep. by 2 ds, 4 ds, cl. R of 4 ds, join to adjacent p of previous r, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, join to center p of corner of 1st motif, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. R of 4 ds, join to adjacent p of previous r, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, p, 6 ds, cl. Rw and complete 2nd motif same as 1st motif.

Make 19 more motifs joining them as 2nd motif was joined to 1st (see illustration).

Work remaining 3 corners in same way, joining the corner p's of end motifs of outer edge to form a square. Cut an 11-inch square of linen. Place lace on linen; with a ruler and pencil draw a line lightly along inner edge of lace, having the lines touch the p's. Cut linen to within ½ inch of line and make a narrow hem all around, having pencil mark at fold of hem. Sew lace to linen.

PLACE MATS (Make 4) . . . Make 10 motifs for each corner and cut linen 8 inches square. Finish same as for Center Mat.

BREAD AND BUTTER PLATE MATS (Make 4) ... Make 3 motifs for each corner and cut linen 4 inches square. Finish same as for Center Mat.

GLASS MATS (Make 4) . . . Same as Bread and Butter Plate Mats.

MATERIALS:

CLARK'S O.N.T. or J. & P. COATS BEST SIX CORD MERCERIZED CROCHET, size 30.

SMALL BALL:

CLARK'S O.N.T.—13 balls of White or Ecru, or 17 balls of any color,

OR

J. & P. COATS —8 balls of White or Ecru, or 11 balls of any color.

BIG BALL:

J. & P. COATS —4 balls of White or Ecru, or 6 balls of any color.

This material is sufficient for a luncheon set consisting of a centerpiece about 15 inches in diameter, 4 place doilies about 12 inches in diameter, 4 bread and butter plate doilies about $7\frac{1}{2}$ inches in diameter and 4 glass doilies about $4\frac{1}{2}$ inches in diameter.

Use shuttle and ball of thread.

Tie and cut (20 ch's). 3rd rnd: R of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to p of any ch of 2nd rnd, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. * Rw, ch of 8 ds, p, 8 ds. Rw, r of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to p of next ch of 2nd rnd, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to p of next ch of 2nd rnd, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, in to p of next ch of 2nd rnd, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to p of next ch of 2nd rnd, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to p of next ch of 2nd rnd, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. Repeat from * around joining as before. Tie and cut. 4th rnd: Same as 3rd rnd, but making ch's of 9 ds, p, 9 ds instead of 8 ds, p, 8 ds. 5th rnd: R of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to p of any ch

of 4th rnd, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. * Rw, ch of 9 ds, p, 9 ds. Rw, r of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to same p where previous r was joined, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl (increase made). Rw, ch of 9 ds, p, 9 ds. Rw, r of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to p of next ch of 4th rnd, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 9 ds, p, 9 ds. Rw, r of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to p of next ch of 4th rnd, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. Repeat from * around, joining as before. Tie and cut (30 ch's). 6th rnd: Same as 4th rnd. 7th rnd: Same as previous rnd, but making ch's of 10 ds, p, 10 ds.

8th rnd: R of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to p of any ch of previous rnd which is directly above an increase on 5th rnd, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. ** Rw, ch of 10 ds, p, 10 ds, Rw, r of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to same p where previous r was joined, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. * Rw, ch of 10 ds, p, 10 ds. Rw, r of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to p of next ch of previous rnd, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. Repeat from * 5 more times, then repeat from ** around (35 ch's). 9th rnd: R of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to p of any increase ch of previous rnd, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 10 ds, p, 10 ds. Mark this ch with colored thread. * Rw, r of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to p of next ch of previous rnd, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 10 ds, p, 10 ds. Repeat from * around. 10th rnd: R of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to p of marked ch of previous rnd, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. * Rw, ch of 10 ds, p, 10 ds. Rw, r of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to p of next ch of previous rnd, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. Repeat from * 2 more times. *** Rw, ch of 10 ds, p, 10 ds. Rw, r of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to same p where previous r was joined, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl (increase made directly above increase on 5th rnd). ** Rw, ch of 10 ds, p, 10 ds. Repeat from ** 6 more times, then repeat from *** around (40 ch's). 11th rnd: R of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to p of any ch of previous rnd which is directly above an increase on 8th rnd, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. ** Rw, ch of 10 ds, p, 10 ds. Rw, r of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to same p where previous r was joined, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. * Rw, ch of 10 ds, p, 10 ds. Rw, r of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to p of

next ch of previous rnd, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. Repeat from * 7 more times, then repeat from ** around (45 ch's). 12th rnd: R of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to p of any ch of previous rnd, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. * Rw, ch of 5 ds, 3 p's sep. by 5 ds, 5 ds, cl. Rw, r of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to p of next ch of previous rnd, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. Repeat from * around.

EDGING . . . R of 6 ds, p, 6 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 6 ds, join to 1st p of any ch of previous rnd, 6 ds, p, 8 ds. Rw, r of 6 ds, join to p of previous r, 6 ds, cl. R of 5 ds, p, 5 ds, p, 5 ds, cl. * Rw, ch of 8 ds. Rw, r of 5 ds, join to adjacent p of last r, 2 ds, 4 p's sep. by 2 ds, 5 ds, cl. R of 5 ds, join to last p of previous r, 2 ds, 6 p's sep. by 2 ds, 5 ds, cl. R of 5 ds, join to last p of previous r, 2 ds, 4 p's sep. by 2 ds, 5 ds, cl. R of 5 ds, join to last p of previous r, 5 ds, p, 5 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 8 ds. Rw, r of 5 ds, join to last p of previous r, 5 ds, p, 5 ds, cl. R of 6 ds, p, 6 ds, cl. R of 5 ds, join to free p of next adjacent r, 5 ds, p, 5 ds, cl. Repeat from * around, joining last 2 r's to corresponding r's of 1st point, and joining last ch to base of 1st r made. Tie and cut (45 points).

PLACE DOILIES (Make 4) . . . 1st to 8th rnds incl: Same as 1st to 8th rnds incl of centerpiece. 9th rnd: Same as 12th rnd of centerpiece. Work edging as on centerpiece (35 points).

BREAD AND BUTTER PLATE DOILIES (Make 4) ... 1st, 2nd and 3rd rnds: Same as 1st, 2nd and 3rd rnds of centerpiece. 4th rnd: Same as 12th rnd of centerpiece. Work edging as on centerpiece (20 points).

GLASS DOILIES (Make 4) . . . 1st rnd: Same as 1st rnd of centerpiece. Work edging as on centerpiece (10 points).

Primrose No. 7541

MATERIALS:

CLARK'S O.N.T. or J. & P. COATS BEST SIX CORD MERCERIZED CROCHET, size 30.

SMALL BALL:

CLARK'S O.N.T.—9 balls of White or Ecru, or 12 balls of any color,

OR

J. & P. COATS —6 balls of White or Ecru, or 8 balls of any

3/4 yard of linen, 18 inches wide.

This material is sufficient for a luncheon set consisting of a centerpiece about 14½ inches in diameter, 4 place doilies about 10½ inches in diameter, 4 bread and butter plate doilies about 7½ inches in diameter, and 4 glass doilies about 5½ inches in diameter.

CENTERPIECE . . . 1st rnd: * Sr of 6 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 3 ds, 8 p's sep. by 3 ds, 3 ds. Rw. Repeat from * around until there are 28 sr's and 28 ch's. Join last ch to base of 1st sr, tie and cut. Note—These sr's do not show in photograph as they are covered by the linen.

2nd rnd: Fasten threads to 5th p of any ch of previous rnd. * Ch of 3 ds, 8 p's sep. by 3 ds, 3 ds, join to 4th p of next ch, 1 ds, lp, 1 ds, join to next p. Repeat from * around, joining end of last ch to beginning of 1st ch. Tie and cut. 3rd rnd: * R of 4 ds, p, 4 ds, join to lp of previous rnd, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. Rw, r of 4 ds, 4 p's sep. by 4 ds, 4 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 5 ds, join with shuttle thread to last p of last r, (5 ds, join with shuttle thread to next p) 3 times; 5 ds, join to base of r. Rw, ch of 7 ds, join with shuttle thread to space above last joining of previous ch, (7 ds, join

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A trio of Tray Doilies! Hard to Choose? Make all three!

MATERIALS:

CLARK'S O.N.T. or J. & P. COATS BEST SIX CORD MERCERIZED CROCHET, size 30, 1 ball of White, Ecru or any color.

A piece of linen about 4 x 6½ inches finished with narrow hem all around.


Completed doily measures about 5 x 11½ inches.

END... Use shuttle and ball of thread. R of 3 ds, 3 p's sep. by 3 ds, 3 ds, cl (center r). Rw, ch of 6 ds, p, 6 ds. Rw, r of 3 ds, 3 p's sep. by 3 ds, 3 ds, cl. * Rw, ch of 6 ds, p, 6 ds. Rw, r of 6 ds, lp (1/4 inch), 6 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 4 ds, 3 p's sep. by 4 ds, 4 ds. Rw, r of 6 ds, join to lp, 6 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 4 ds, 6 p's sep. by 2 ds, 4 ds. Rw, r of 6 ds, join to lp, 6 ds, cl. SIDE EDGE . . . Join thread to base of 3rd r on end clover. * Ch of 4 ds, 3 p's sep. by 4 ds, 4 ds. Rw, r of 6 ds, p, 6 ds. Repeat from * until there are 9 r's and 10 ch's. Tie securely to corresponding position on other end. Cut. Finish other side to correspond.

Repeat from * until there are 24 r's and 24 ch's. Rw, r of 4 ds, join to last p of adjacent r, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, join to a free p on 3rd rnd of end, 4 ds, cl. Tie and cut. Finish other side to correspond leaving 20 r's free on outer edge of each end and 14 r's to be joined to the linen. Place lace on linen; draw a line lightly along inner edge of lace, having the line touch the p's. Cut linen to within 1/4 inch of outline. Make a narrow hem all around, shaping corners as in illustration and having pencil mark at fold of hem. Sew lace to linen.





MATERIALS:

CLARK'S O.N.T. or J. & P. COATS BEST SIX CORD MERCERIZED CROCHET, size 50, 1 ball of White or Ecru.

1/4 yard of linen, 36 inches wide.

3 small buttons.

Make paper patterns following measurements in diagrams.

COLLAR... Cut 2 pieces of linen on dotted line of diagram (diagram shows one half of collar). Place the two pieces together and machine stitch around outer edges (1/8 inch allowed in diagram for all seams). Turn inside out, fold the

neck edge in ¼ inch and sew edges together neatly. Make a buttonloop on one end of collar and sew a button on opposite end to correspond.

TABS (Make 2) . . . Cut two pieces of linen as in diagram. Place the two pieces together and machine stitch around edges, leaving a large enough space to allow for turning piece inside out. Turn and press piece, then turn under raw edges and sew neatly. Join shuttle and ball threads to edge of tab and work as follows: 1st rnd: * Ch of 4 ds, p, 4 ds, join with shuttle thread to edge of tab 1/4 inch from previous joining. Repeat from * around joining last ch to beginning of 1st ch. Tie and cut. 2nd rnd:

Attach threads to any p of 1st rnd. * Ch of 5 ds, p, 5 ds, join to next p of 1st rnd. Repeat from * around joining last ch to beginning of 1st ch. Tie and cut. 3rd rnd: Attach threads to p of 2nd rnd. * Ch of 6 ds, p, 6 ds, join to next p. Repeat from * around, joining as before. Tie and cut. 4th rnd: Work ch's of 7 ds, p, 7 ds around. Tie and cut. 5th rnd: Work ch's of 8 ds, p, 8 ds around. Tie and cut. Fold tab across unbroken line indicated in diagram and sew fold to inner edge of collar at top (see illustration).

CUFFS... Work exactly as for collar, but follow diagram for cuffs and make only one tab for each cuff.
