



MATERIALS:

J. & P. Coats or Clark's O.N.T. Best Six Cord Mercerized Crochet, Size 30: SMALL BALL:

13. Amblypodia Asia

J. & P. COATS—3 balls of White or Ecru, or 4 balls of any color,

CLARK'S O.N.T.—4 balls of White or Ecru, or 6 balls of any color, or

BIG BALL:

J. & P. COATS—2 balls of White or Ecru, or 3 balls of any color.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 10.

A black velvet cloche.

GLOVES

Sizes Small Medium Large

LEFT GLOVE—Little Finger . . Starting at tip, ch 4. 1st rnd: Make 11 dc 12 dc 13 dc in 4th ch from hook. Join with sl st to top of starting chain.

2nd rnd: Ch 4, * dc in next dc, ch 1. Repeat from * around. Join last ch-1 to 3rd ch of ch-4. 3rd rnd: Sl st in next sp, ch 4, * dc in next sp, ch 1. Repeat from * around. Join.

Repeat 3rd rnd until
12 rnds 13 rnds 14 rnds
are completed. Join and break off.

RING FINGER . . . Starting at tip, ch 4. 1st rnd: Make

12 dc 13 dc 14 dc in 4th ch from hook. Join. Work as for Little Finger until

14 rnds 15 rnds 16 rnds are completed. Break off.

MIDDLE FINGER . . . Starting at tip, ch 4. 1st rnd: Make
13 dc 14 dc 15 dc

in 4th ch from hook. Join. Work as for Little Finger until

16 rnds 17 rnds 18 rnds are completed. Break off.

INDEX FINGER . . . Work exactly as for Ring Finger.

THUMB . . . Starting at tip, ch 4. 1st rnd: Make

16 dc 17 dc 18 dc in 4th ch from hook. Join. Work as for Little Finger until

12 rnds 13 rnds 14 rnds are completed. Break off.

Joining of Fingers: Sew the Ring Finger, the Middle Finger and the Index Finger together at base, joining a dc to a sp on following finger and leaving the same amount of sps free on both sides of joining.

PALM AND BACK . . . 1st rnd:
Attach thread to first free sp on inside
edge of Index Finger and work in sp
pattern across each finger; now continue working in pattern across Back
and join to first sp. There should be
40 sps 43 sps 46 sps

2nd rnd: Work in pattern around. Join. Now sew Little Finger in place. Next rnd: Work in pattern around, making sps over Little Finger as for other fingers. There should be

Sew Thumb in place and continue to work in sp pattern over Thumb sps. Next rnd: Mark the 2 sps directly above joining of Thumb on both sides of glove. Work in pattern to within the 2 marked sps, ch 1, holding back on hook the last loop of each dc, make dc in each of next 2 sps, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (1 sp decreased). Complete rnd, decreasing 1 sp over next 2 marked sps (this starts thumb gore). Now work in pattern for 2 more rnds, decreasing 1 sp directly over each previous decrease made. Next rnd: Mark the 2 sps directly between Thumb decreases and the 2 sps on outer edge of Little Finger side of glove. Continue to work in pattern, decreasing 1 sp over each dec and over the marked sps as before. Continue to work in pattern, making decreases over the 4 established points until 9 rnds are completed from first dec rnd. Break off.

Now shape lower edge as follows: 1st row: Mark the center sp of last rnd at

back of glove. Attach thread to 7th sp to the left of marked sp, ch 4 and work in pattern to within 6 sps preceding marked sp. Turn. 2nd row: SI st in next sp, ch 4, * dc in next sp, ch 1. Repeat from * across, ending with dc in last sp. Turn. Repeat 2nd row

EDGING ... * 2 sc in next sp, ch 3, sc in 3rd ch from hook (picot made). Repeat from * around entire lower edge. Join and break off.

BUTTERFLY—Large Wing (Make 2) . . . Starting at center, ch 13. 1st row: Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each of next 7 ch, half dc in next ch, in next ch make sc, ch 3 and sc. Now, working across opposite side of starting chain, make half dc in next ch, dc in each remaining chain across. Ch 3, Continued on page 6

Butterfly Handkerchiefs S-44

MATERIALS:

J. & P. Coats Tatting-Crochet, Size 70, 1 ball each of No. 8 Blue, No. 76 China Blue and No. 12 Black; or 1 ball each of No. 32 Purple, No. 43 Dk, Yellow and No. 48 Hunter's Green . . Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 13 . . . A rolled edge handkerchief.

(For a finer variety, butterfly and edg-

ing may be crocheted with J. & P. Coats or Clark's O.N.T. Mercerized Sewing Thread, Size 50, any color desired, and a Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 15.)

BUTTERFLY—Large Wing . . . Starting at inner edge with Blue, ch 33. 1st row: Half dc in 6th ch from hook, ch 2, skip 2 ch, dc in next ch, (ch 2, skip 2 ch, tr in next ch) 5 times; ch 2,

skip 2 ch, dc in next ch, ch 2, skip 2 ch, half dc in next ch, ch 2, skip 2 ch, sl st in next ch.

Now work around as follows: Working along opposite side of starting chain, make 5 sc in first sp, (sc in next ch, 2 sc in next sp) 8 times; sc in next ch, 9 sc in end sp, (sc in next st, 2 sc in next sp) 8 times; sc in next st, 2 sc in next sp) 8 times; sc in next st, 4 sc in next sp. Join and break off. Next row: Attach Black to same sc as sl st, sc in same place, sc in next 4 sc, * sc at base of next sc (long sc made), sc in next 2 sc. Repeat from * 7 more times; sc at base of next sc, sc in next 5 sc. Break off. Next rnd: Attach China Blue to first Black sc, sc in each st across, sc closely around remaining side. Join and break off.

Now work in rows as follows: 1st row: Attach Blue to same place as sl st, ch 3, dc in same place, (ch 2, skip 2 sc, 2 dc in next sc) 8 times; (ch 2, skip 2 sc, 2 dc in next sc) 8 times; (ch 2, skip 2 sc, 2 tr in next sc) 4 times. Ch 4, turn. 2nd row: Skip first tr, tr in next tr, (ch 3, tr in next 2 tr) 3 times; (ch 3, dc in next 2 dc) 7 times; ch 3, skip 1 dc, sl st in next dc. Turn. 3rd row: Sl st in next 2 dc, (ch 4, dc in next 2 dc) 5 times; (ch 4, tr in next 2 tr) 3 times; ch 4, tr in next tr and in top of turning chain. Ch 4, turn. 4th row: Skip first tr, tr in next tr, (ch 5, tr in next 2 tr) 3 times; (ch 5, dc in next 2 dc) 5 times; (ch 5, skip 1 dc, sl st in next 6. Turn. 5th row: Sl st in next 2 dc, (ch 6, dc in next 2 dc) 3 times; (ch 6, tr in next tr and in top of turning chain. Ch 4, turn. 6th row: Skip first tr, tr in next tr and in top of turning chain. Ch 4, turn. 6th row: Skip first tr, tr in next tr, (ch 7, tr in next 2 tr) 3 times; (ch 7, dc in next 2 dc) 3 times; ch 7, skip 1 dc, sl st in next dc. Break off.

EDGING . . . Attach China Blue to end st of first Blue row, sc closely around to opposite side of same row. Break off.

Make another Wing the same way, being careful to have sc's of Edging on right side of both Wings.

SMALL WING (Make 2) . . . Starting at long side with Blue, ch 33. 1st row: D tr in 11th ch from hook, ch 1, skip 1 ch, d tr in next ch, (ch 1, skip 1 ch, tr in next ch) twice; (ch 1, skip 1 ch, dc in next ch) twice; ch 1, skip 1 ch, half dc in next ch, ch 1, skip 1 ch, sc in next 9 ch. Ch 1, turn. 2nd row: Dec 1 sc—to dec 1 sc, work off 2 sc as 1 sc—sc in each sc across scgroup, sc in each ch-1 sp and in each st across, ending with sc in last d tr. Ch 10, turn. 3rd row: D tr in first sc, ch 1, skip 1 sc, dt rin next sc) twice; (ch 1, skip 1 sc, dc in next sc) twice; (ch 1, skip 1 sc, half dc in next sc, ch 1, skip 1 sc, sc in each sc across group to within last 2 sc, dec 1 sc. Ch 1, turn. Continued on page 12





Butterfly Blouse S-34

MATERIALS:

J. & P. Coats Tatting-Crochet, Size 70, 1 ball each of assorted colors as desired (1 ball will make approximately 6 butterflies) . . Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 13 . . A cotton sport blouse.

BUTTERFLY—Wing . . . Starting at lower edge with main color, ch 13. 1st row: Dc in 7th ch from hook, ch 2, skip next ch, dc in next ch, ch 2, skip next ch, half dc in next ch, ch 2,

sc in last ch. Ch 1, turn. 2nd row: Sc in first st, (2 sc in next sp, sc in next st) 3 times; sc in last sp. Ch 7, turn. 3rd row: Skip first sc, in next sc make tr, ch 2 and tr; ch 2, skip 2 sc, dc in next sc, ch 2, skip 2 sc, half dc in next sc, ch 2, sc in last sc. Ch 1, turn. 4th row: Sc in first st, (2 sc in next sp, sc in next st) 4 times; sc in last sp. Ch 7, turn. 5th row: Skip first sc, in next sc make tr, ch 2 and tr; (ch 2, skip 2 sc, dc in next sc) twice; ch 2, skip 2 sc, half dc in next sc, ch 2, sc in last sc. Ch 1, turn. 6th row: Sc in

first st, (2 sc in next sp, sc in next st) 5 times; sc in last sp. Ch 7, turn. 7th row: Skip first sc, in next sc make tr, ch 2 and tr; (ch 2, skip 2 sc, dc in next sc) 3 times; ch 2, skip 2 sc, half dc in next sc, ch 2, sc in the last sc. Break off.

EDGING... Attach a contrasting color to last sc made and, working around outer edge of Wing, make 3 sc in each of the next 6 sps, (10 sc in next loop, sl st in end st of next row) 3 times; 10 sc in next loop, 3 sc in Continued on page 12

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Butterfly Runner S-37

14 x 36 inches

MATERIALS:

J. & P. Coats Tatting-Crochet, Size 70, 6 balls of No. 9 Yellow, 5 balls of No. 76 China Blue, 2 balls of No. 12 Black . . . Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 13 . . . ½ yard of pale blue organdy, 36 inches wide.

BUTTERFLY (Make 16)—Large Wing (Make 2)... Starting at inner edge with Yellow, ch 36. 1st row: Half dc in 6th ch from hook, ch 2, skip 2 ch, dc in next ch, (ch 2, skip 2 ch, tr in next ch) 6 times; ch 2, skip 2 ch, dc in next ch, ch 2, skip 2 ch, half dc in next ch, ch 2, skip 2 ch, sl st in next ch. Now work around as follows: Working along opposite side of starting chain, make 5 sc in first sp, (sc in next ch, 9 sc in next sp) 9 times; sc in next st, 4 sc in next sp. 9 times; sc in next sp. Join with sl st to first sc. Break off.

Now work in rows as follows: 1st row: Attach Black to same place as sl st, sc in same place, sc in next 4 sc, sc at base of next sc—long sc made— (sc in next 2 sc, sc at base of next sc) 9 times; sc in next 5 sc. Break off. 2nd row: Skip first sc, attach Yellow to next sc, ch 3, dc in same place, (ch 2, skip 2 sc, 2 dc in next sc) 4 times; (ch 2, skip 2 sc, 2 tr in next sc) 4 times; (ch 2, skip 2 sc, 2 d tr in next sc) 4 times. Ch 5, turn. 3rd row: Skip first d tr, d tr in next d tr, (ch 3, d tr in next 2 d tr) 3 times; (ch 3, tr in next 2 tr) 4 times; (ch 3, dc in next 2 dc) 4 times; ch 3, skip next dc, sl st in top of starting chain. Turn. 4th row: SI st in next 3 ch, sI st in next dc, ch 4, skip next dc, (dc in next 2 dc, ch 4) 3 times; (tr in next 2 tr, ch 4) 4 times; (d tr in next 2 d tr, ch 4) 3 times; d tr in next d tr, d tr in top of turning chain. Ch 5, turn. 5th row: Skip first d tr, d tr in next d tr, ch 5, d tr in next d tr, ch 8, turn; skip last d tr made, d tr in next d tr and in top of turning chain, ch 5, turn; skip first d tr, holding back on hook the last loop of each d tr, make d tr in next d tr, skip 3 ch, d tr in next ch, thread over and draw through all loops on hook-joint d tr madech 5; working along side, sl st at base of next d tr, ch 5, sl st in top of next d tr, d tr in next d tr on 4th row, (ch 5, d tr in next 2 d tr) twice; (ch 5, tr in next 2 tr) 4 times; (ch 5, dc in next 2 dc) twice; ch 5, skip next dc, sl st in next dc. Break off.

OUTLINE... Attach China Blue to first free sc on inner side of Wing and sc in each sc across, ch 5, skip next Black sc, sc in next free sc, (ch 5, skip next free Black sc, sc in next free sc) 12 times. Join and break off. Attach

China Blue to first Yellow row and sc closely across side to joint d tr, sc in joint d tr, ch 5, sc in 5th ch from hook (picot made), sc in same place as last sc, sc closely across remaining side of Wing. Break off. When working Outline on 2nd Large Wing, start at opposite side so Wings will correspond.

SMALL WING (Make 2) ... Starting at inner edge with Yellow, ch 10. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st row: Ch 3, 8 dc in ring. Ch 3, turn. 2nd row: Dc in first dc, (ch 2, skip next dc, 2 dc in next dc) 3 times; ch 2, 2 dc in top of starting chain. Ch 3, turn. 3rd row: Skip first dc, dc in next dc, ch 3, tr in next 2 dc, ch 3, dt rin next 2 dc, ch 3, dc in next dc, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. 4th row: Skip first dc, dc in next dc, dc in next dc, ch 4, tr in next 2 tr, (ch 4, 2 d tr in next d tr) twice; ch 4, tr in next 2 tr, ch 4, dc in next dc, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. 5th row: Skip first dc, dc in next dc, ch 5, tr in next 2 tr, ch 5, d tr in next 2 tr, ch 5, dc in next dc, dc in next dc, dc in next 2 dr, ch 5, tr in next 2 tr, ch 5, dc in next dc, dc in next dc, dc in next 2 tr, ch 5, dc in next dc, dc in next dc, dc in next 2 tr, ch 5, dc in next dc, dc in top of turning chain. Break off.

Attach China Blue to ring and sc closely around Wing. Join and break off

BODY . . . Starting at long side with Black, ch 24. 1st row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, half dc in next ch, dc in next ch, half dc in next ch, sc in next ch (Head), half dc in next ch, dc in next 3 ch, half dc in next ch, sc in next ch, half dc in next ch, dc in next ch, tr in next 7 ch, dc in next ch, half dc in next ch, sc in next ch. Break off. Now work around as follows: 1st rnd: Attach Yellow to first sc, sc in same sc, sc in next 3 sts, sl st at base of next sc (long st made), sc in next 5 sts, sl st at base of next sc, sc in each remaining st across; working along opposite side of starting chain make sc in each ch across, making long sts over sc's to correspond with opposite side. Join and break off. 2nd rnd: With Black make a chain 1½ inches long (Antenna), sl st in first sc on Head, sc in each sc around Head and Body, making long sts over long sts as before. Join to first sc. Make another chain 1½ inches long for other Antenna. Break off.

Sew Wings together. Sew Body in place. Pin 14 Butterflies in place around organdy as illustrated.

Cut out material in back of Butterflies, leaving 1/4 inch for hem. Sew hem and Butterflies in place, joining adjacent picots on Wings. Sew a Butterfly to each end of runner. Starch lightly and press.

turn. 2nd row: Skip first dc, dc in each st to ch-3 loop at tip, in ch-3 loop make 3 dc, ch 3 and 3 dc; dc in each remaining st across and in top of turning chain. Ch 1, turn. 3rd row: Sc in each dc across, making 2 sc, ch 3 and 2 sc in sp at tip. Ch 4, turn. 4th row:

* Skip 1 sc, dc in next sc, ch 1. Repeat from * across, making dc, ch 1, dc, ch 3, dc, ch 1 and dc in loop at tip. Ch 1, turn. 5th row: 2 sc in each sp across, making 2 sc, ch 3 and 2 sc in sp at tip. Ch 5, turn. 6th row: * Skip 1 sc, dc in next sc, ch 2. Repeat from across, making dc, ch 2, dc, ch 3, dc, ch 2 and dc in loop at tip. Ch 1, turn. 7th row: 3 sc in each sp across, making 3 sc, ch 3 and 3 sc in sp at tip. Ch 5, turn. 8th row: Repeat 6th row. 9th row: * Make 3 sc in next sp, ch 3, sc in 3rd ch from hook (picot made).
Repeat from * across, ending with 3 sc in last sp. Break off,

SMALL WING (Make 2) ... Work as for Large Wing until 6 rows are completed. 7th row: Repeat 9th row of Large Wing.

BODY ... Starting at one end, ch 11.

1st row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and
in each ch across. Ch 1, turn. Here
after pick up back loop only of each
sc. 2nd row: 2 sc in first sc, sc in next
7 sc, work off last 2 sc as 1 sc. Ch 1,

turn. 3rd row: Work off first 2 sc as 1 sc, sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in last sc. Ch 1, turn. Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows alternately until piece measures 3 inches. Break off.

ANTENNAE . . . Ch 50, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Break off.

Shirr the straight ends of Wings tightly. Place the shirred end of one large wing over the shirred end of small wing as in illustration and sew in place. Sew two remaining wings together the same way. Sew the shirred edges of the 2 pairs of wings together at center. Sew the two long ends of body together, stuffing with several strands of thread and making sure to keep one end of body pointed. Sew body in place over joined wings, having pointed end of body even with bottom edge of small wings. Roll and sew ends of Antennae to form small knobs. Double this piece and sew in place under upper part of body.

Starch lightly and press. Sew Butterfly in place on back of glove.


RIGHT GLOVE . . . Make another Glove the same way, reversing it to fit Right Hand.

HAT... Make 4 Butterflies as before and sew 2 to each side of hat.

MATERIALS:

J. & P. Coats or Clark's O.N.T. Best Six Cord Mercerized Crochet, Size 30:

SMALL BALL:

J. & P. COATS—4 balls of No. 76 China Blue, 3 balls of No. 26-B Bright Nile Green, and 2 balls of No. 43 Dk. Yellow, or

CLARK'S O.N.T.—5 balls of No. 76 China Blue, 4 balls of No. 26-B Bright Nile Green and 3 balls of No. 43 Dk. Yellow, BIG BALL:

J. & P. COATS—2 balls each of No. 76 China Blue, No. 26-B Bright Nile Green, and 1 ball of No. 43 Dk. Yellow.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 10. A pink luncheon cloth, 54 inches square.

BUTTERFLY (Make 24) — Large Wing (Make 2) ... Starting at lower edge with China Blue, ch 25. 1st row: Tr in 7th ch from hook, (ch 1, skip 1 ch, tr in next ch) twice; (ch 1, skip 1 ch, dc in next ch) 3 times; (ch 1,

skip 1 ch, half dc in next ch) twice; ch 1, skip 1 ch, sc in next 3 ch. Draw ball through loop to fasten. Turn. 2nd row: Attach Green to first sc, sc in same place, sc in next 2 sc, sc in next sp, sc in next half dc, dc in each sp and in each dc across, ending with 3 dc in last sp, draw ball of Green through loop to fasten. 3rd row: Pick up Blue from opposite end of row, sc in first 5 sc, ch 1, skip 1 st, half dc in next dc, ch 1, skip 1 dc, dc in next dc, (ch 1, skip 1 dc, tr in next dc) 5 times; ch 1, skip 1 dc, in next dc make tr, ch 1 and tr; ch 1, d tr in next dc. Draw ball of Blue Continued on page 14

MATERIALS:

Clark's Big Ball Mercerized Crochet, Size 30, 1 ball each of White, No. 64-B Nugrey and No. 123-A Flamingo, and J. & P. Coats Tatting-Crochet, Size 70, 3 balls of No. 12 Black . . Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 10.


Doily measures 14 inches square.

DOILY . . . Starting at center with White, ch 8. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: Ch 3, 4 dc in ring, (ch 5, 5 dc in ring) 3 times; ch 5. Join with sl st to top of ch-3. 2nd rnd: Sl st in next dc, ch 6, sc in 3rd ch from hook (picot made), ch 4, sc in 3rd ch from hook (another picot made), skip next dc, dc in next dc, * picot, ch 1, picot (a picot loop made), in

next sp make tr, picot loop and tr; (make a picot loop, skip next dc, dc in next dc) twice. Repeat from *around, ending with a picot loop. Join to 3rd ch of ch-6. 3rd rnd: Sl st in base of next picot and in next ch, ch 3, make a picot loop, dc between picots of next picot loop, ac between picots of next picot loop at corner make tr, picot loop and tr; *picot loop, dc in next picot loop. Repeat from *around, making tr, picot loop and tr in each corner sp. Join. Repeat 3rd rnd until piece measures 7½ inches square. Join Next rnd: Sl st at base of picot and in next ch, ch 7, dc in next picot loop, ch 4, in picot loop at corner make tr, ch 5 and tr; *ch 5, dc in next picot loop. Repeat from *around, making tr, ch 5 and tr in each corner sp. Join to 3rd ch of ch-7. Break off. Following rnd: Attach Grey to ch-5 loop at any

corner, ch 3, in same loop make 2 dc, ch 3 and 3 dc; make 6 dc in each ch-4 sp around, making 3 dc, ch 3 and 3 dc in each corner. Join. Break off. 11th row: Pick up Blue, 21 sc in ch-10 loop, (sc in next 2 sts, 7 sc in next sp) 5 times; sc in next 5 sc. Break off.

BODY . . . With Lemon and Pink, ch 14. 1st row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, half dc in next 2 ch, dc in next 4 ch, half dc in next 2 ch, sc in next 2 ch, sl st in last ch. Break off.

HEAD . . . With Blue, ch 8. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: 20 sc in ring, sl st in side of first sc on Body, sc in each st across Body, 3 sc in sl st at other end of Body; working across opposite side, sc in each ch across, sl st in first sc on Head. Break

ANTENNAE . . . With Lemon and Pink, ch 25. Break off. Attach Blue to first ch, ch 3, dc in same ch, ch 3, sl st in same ch, sl st in each ch across to center, sl st in center of Head, sl st in each remaining chain across, ch 3, dc in last ch, ch 3, sl st in same ch. Break off.

Sew Wings and Body together. Sew

Butterflies together, joining center of loops on last row of each wing. Place Butterflies on organdy and around inside edges. Cut out material in back of Butterflies, leaving 1/8 inch for hem. Sew hem and Butterflies neatly in place.

EDGING . . . Attach Shaded Lt. Yellows to right side of Antennae on any Butterfly, sc in same place, * ch 15, sc in end of left side of same Antenna, ch 10, skip 2 sps on wing, in center sc of next sp make tr, ch 10 and tr; ch 10, skip next sp, sc in center sc of next sp, ch 10, skip 5 sc on next sp, tr in next sc, tr in corresponding sc of next wing, ch 10, sc in center sc of next sp, ch 10, skip next sp, in center sc of next sp make tr, ch 10 and tr; ch 10, sc in end of next Antenna. Repeat from * around. Join and break off.

BREAD AND BUTTER PLATE DOILY . . . Make 6 Butterflies. Sew together as before and complete as for Place Doily.

GLASS DOILY . . . Make 4 Butterflies and complete as for Place Doily. Starch lightly and press.

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Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows alternately until 9 rows in all are completed (1 sc in last sc-group). Break off. Attach China Blue and sc closely around, making 16 sc in each ch-10 loop. Join and break off.

BODY . . . Starting at long side with Black, ch 24. 1st row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, half dc in next ch, dc in next ch, half dc in next ch, sc in next ch (Head), half dc in next ch, dc in next 3 ch, half dc in next ch, sc in next ch, half dc in next ch, dc in next ch, tr in next 7 ch, dc in next ch, half dc in next ch, sc in next ch. Break off. Attach China Blue to first sc, sc in same place, sc in next 3 sts, sl st at base of next sc (long st made), sc in next 5 sts, sl st at base of next sc, sc in each remaining st across; working along opposite side of starting chain make sc in each ch across, making long sts over sc's to correspond with opposite side. Join and break off.

ANTENNAE . . . With China Blue make a chain 2 inches long, sl st in center st of Head and make another chain 2 inches long. Break off.

Sew Wings and Body together. Sew Butterfly to corner of handkerchief.

EDGING . . . 1st rnd: Attach China Blue to corner of handkerchief, 3 sc in same place, sc closely around, making 3 sc in each corner and having number of sc's on each side divisible by 6 plus 3. Join to first sc. 2nd rnd: SI st in next sc, sc in same place as sl st, * ch 10, skip 5 sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from * around. Join. 3rd rnd: 16 sc in each loop around. Join and break off.

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BUTTERFLY (Make 13) - Large Wing . . . Starting at center with Mid Rose, ch 6. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st row: Ch 4, 6 tr in ring. Ch 4, turn. 2nd row: Tr in first tr, 2 tr in each tr across, 2 tr in top of turning chain. Ch 4, turn. 3rd row: Skip first tr, 2 tr in each tr across, tr in top of turning chain. EDGING ... 1st rnd: Attach Yellow to ring and sc closely around both wings. Join and break off. 2nd rnd: Attach Black Tatting-Crochet to first sc, sl st in back loop of each sc around. Join and break off.

SMALL WING (Make 2) ... Starting at center with Mid Rose, ch 14. 1st row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, half dc in next ch, dc in next ch, tr in next 7 ch, dc in next ch, half dc in next ch, sc in next ch. Now work around as follows: 1st rnd: Working across opposite side of starting chain, make sc in each ch across, sc in each st across. Join and break off. 2nd rnd: Attach Yellow to first sc, sc in back loop of each sc around. Join and break off. 3rd rnd: Attach Black to first sc, sl st in back loop of each sc around. Join and break off.

BODY . . . Starting at Head with Black Tatting Crochet, ch 10. Join with sl st to form ring, ch 21. 1st row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 3 ch, half dc in next ch, dc in next 13 ch, half dc in next ch, sc in next ch, sc closely around ring. Join and break

ANTENNAE . . . With Yellow, make a chain 2 inches long. 1st row: SI st in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Break off. 2nd row: Attach Black to first sl st, sl st in each st to center, sl st in center of Head, sl st in each remaining st on chain. Break off. Sew Wings and Body together. Sew

Butterflies around Doily.
