MATERIALS:

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN," Art. A.64: 3 balls of No. 76 Robinette: or

Clark's O.N.T. Mercerized Bedspread Cotton, Art. B.504: 3 halls of a color of your own choice; or

J. & P. Coats or Clark's O.N.T. Pearl Cotton, Art. A. or B.19, Size 5: 12 balls of a color of your own choice.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

3 yards of white satin ribbon, 3/2 inch wide . . . 3 tiny snap fasteners . . . A hook and eye . . . A baby doll, 22 inches tall; chest 13 inches.

GAUGE: 1 shell pattern measures 1 inch; 2 shell rows measure 1 inch.

SKIRT . . . Starting at top make a chain to reach loosely around doll's waist. 1st row: In 6th ch from hook make (dc, ch 1) 3 times and dc (shell made); * ch 2, skip 2 ch, sc in next ch, ch 2, skip 2 ch, in next ch make (dc, ch 1) 4 times and dc (another shell made). Repeat from * across. Ch 3, turn. 2nd row: Skip first sp, (sc in next sp. ch 3) 3 times; * skip next 2 sps, (sc in next sp, ch 3) 4 times. Repeat from across, ending with sc in last sp. Ch 4, turn. 3rd row: Skip first loop, shell in next loop, . ch 3, skip next loop, sc in next sp, ch 3, skip next loop, shell in next loop. Repeat from across. Ch 3, turn. 4th to 7th rows incl: Repeat 2nd and 3rd

rows alternately 2 more times. 8th row: Repeat 2nd row. At end of 8th row do not chain and turn, ch 3, sl st in first ch at beginning of row. Now work in rnds as follows: 1st rnd: SI st to 2nd loop, ch 4, shell in same loop, * ch 3, skip next loop, sc in next sp, ch 3, skip next loop, shell in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join to 3rd ch of ch-4. 2nd rnd: SI st in next sp, sc in same sp, * (ch 3, sc in next sp) 3 times; ch 3, skip 2 sps, sc in next sp. Repeat from a around Join to first sc. Repeat first and second

rnds until skirt measures 91/2 inches,

ending with first rnd. Break off.

WAISTBAND . . . 1st row: Attach thread to first st on opposite side of starting chain, sc closely across. Ch 1, turn. 2nd row: Sc in each sc across. Ch 4, turn. 3rd row: Skip first 2 sc, dc in next sc, * ch 1, skip 1 sc, dc in next sc. Repeat from * across.

BERTHA COLLAR . . . Starting at top make a chain to measure 2 inches longer than doll's neck. Work in pattern rows as for skirt until piece measures 3 inches. Break off.

To Shape Top: Attach thread to opposite side of starting chain and work as for waistband until 3 rows have been completed. Ch 1, turn. 4th row: Sc in each dc and in each ch-1 sp across. 5th to 9th rows incl: Sc in each sc across, decreasing 3 sc evenly on each row-to dec .1 sc, work off

2 se as 1 se. Ch 1, turn. Break off at end of 9th row.

Starch skirt and collar lightly and press. Sew a hook and eye to skirt opening. Cut a piece of ribbon 30 inches long. Lace through sps at waist and tie into a bow at back. Sew 3 snap fasteners to back of collar. Cut 2 pieces of ribbon, each 15 inches long. Attach one end of each piece to back of collar and lace through sps to center of front. Tie into a bow at front.

HAT . . . Starting at front make a chain long enough to reach around doll's face. 1st row: De in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 3, turn. 2nd row: Skip first dc, dc in each dc across, de in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. Repeat 2nd row until piece measures 3 inches. Break off. Mark last row off into 3 equal sections, attach thread to first st on center section. ch 3, dc in each dc across section. Ch 3, turn. Work in pattern until section measures 1/4 inch shorter than remaining sts on sides. Next row: Work off next 2 dc as 1 dc (1 dc decreased). Repeat from across. Break off. Sew up back seams. Attach thread to bottom of front, sc closely around neck edge. Ch 3, turn. Next row: Skip first sc, dc in each sc across.

BRIM . . . Ist row: Attach thread to front, ch 3, dc in each st across. Ch 4. turn. 2nd row: Shell in first dc. * ch 3. skip 3 dc, sc in next dc, ch 3, skip 3 dc, shell in next dc. Repeat from Continued on page 11

Dress, Coronet and Panties for an 8-inch doll

Illustrated on centerspread

MATERIALS:

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN," Art. A.64: 1 ball of No. 1 White; or

Clark's O.N.T. Mercerized Bedspread Cotton, Art. B.504: 1 ball of No. 1 White: or

J. & P. Coats or Clark's O.N.T. Pearl Cotton, Art. A. or B.19, Size 5: 5 balls of No. 1 White.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

A hairpin staple 1½ inches wide . . . A spool of gold metallic thread . . . 1 yard of white taffeta ribbon, 5 inches wide . . . 2 tiny snap fasteners . . A hook and eye . . . A small piece of white binding . . . A doll, 8 inches tall; chest 4½ inches.

SKIRT—First Strip . . . Starting at top with White, make a strip of hairpin lace having 31 loops on each side of staple. Break off. Next row: Keeping the twist in all loops, insert hook through first 3 loops, draw gold metallic thread through, so in same place, ch 3, so through next 3 loops. Repeat from a across. Break off (waist-band). Following row: Still keeping the twist in all loops, attach gold metallic thread through first loop, ch 3, so in next loop. Repeat from across. Break off.

SECOND STRIP... Make another strip of hairpin lace having double the amount of loops as previous strip.

To Join Strips: Still keeping the twist in all loops, insert hook in first 2 loops, draw metallic thread through, sc in same place, ch 1, sl st in first ch-3 loop between single loops on previous strip, et 1, sc through next 2 loops on Second Strip, ch 1, sl st in next loop on First Strip. Repeat from * across. Break off.

Following row: Attach gold metallic thread to opposite side and complete as for First Strip. Make 2 more strips, joining as before and having double the amount of loops on each strip as on previous strip. Complete last side of last row as before.

BODICE . . . Starting at back with White, ch 12. Ist row: Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 3, turn. 2nd to 18th rows incl: Skip first dc, dc in each dc across and in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. Break off at end of 18th row.

SLEEVE . . . Attach thread to end de on 17th row of bodice, ch 10, turn, skip 4 rows, sl st in end de on next row. Ch 3, turn. 1st rnd: De in each ch across, 4 de in end de of each of the next 4 rows. Join to top of ch-3. 2nd rnd: Ch 3, de in same place as sl st, 2 de in each of next 9 de, de in each remaining de around. Join (36 de). 3rd and 4th rnds: Ch 3, * skip next de, de in next de. Repeat from * around. Join. 5th to 8th rnds inel: Ch 3, de in each de around. Join. Break off at end of 8th rnd. Complete other sleeve to correspond.

Attach thread to back and sc closely around entire bodice, making 2 sc in end dc of each row, Join and break off.

Attach gold metallic thread to bottom of bodice, sc in same place, ch 1, sl st in first loop on waistband of skirt, *ch 1, ski pl sc on bodice, sc in next sc, ch 1, sl st in next loop on skirt. Repeat from * across. Break off. Sew up back seam, leaving a 2-inch opening. Sew 2 snap fasteners to back.

CORONET ... Make a strip of hairpin lace, having 60 loops on each side of staple. Sew together at center to form ring.

INNER EDGE . . . Keeping the twist in all loops, attach gold metallic thread through 2 loops, sc in same place, * sc through next 2 loops. Repeat from * around. Join and break off.

OUTER EDGE . . . Still keeping the twist in all loops, attach gold metallic thread through any 5 loops, sc in salier place, ch 5, sc in 5th ch from hook (picot made), * ch 5, sc in center of hairpin lace (between loops), ch 5, sc through next 5 loops, picot. Repeat from * around, Join and break off.

PANTIES . . . See page 11.

Gather taffeta across long side to reach around doll's waist. Sew binding to top. Sew up back seam. Sew hook and eye in place. Starch dress and coronet lightly and press.

How to Make Hairpin Lace

Step 1—Make a loop at end of ball thread (Fig. 1).

Step 2—Insert hook in loop and wind ball thread around right prong of staple (Fig. 1).

Step 3—Thread over hook and draw through loop, keeping loop at center (Fig. 1).

Step 4—Raise hook to a vertical position and turn staple to the left (Fig. 2).

Step 5-Thread over hook and draw

Clark's O.N.T. Mercerized Bedspread Cotton, Art. B.504: 1 ball of a color of your own choice and a few yards of a contrasting color; or

J. & P. Coats or Clark's O.N.T. Pearl Cotton, Art. A. or B.19, Size 5: 3 balls of a color of your own choice and 1 ball of No. 12 Black.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

yard of yellow taffeta ribbon, 4 inches wide . . . 2 tiny snap fasteners . . .
 A hook and eye . . . A doll, 8 inches tall; chest 4½ inches.

DRESS—Skirt . . . Starting at waist with Shaded Lt. Yellows, ch 37. 1st row: In 4th ch from hook make dc, ch 2 and 2 dc (shell made); * skip 2 ch, in next ch make 2 dc, ch 2 and 2 dc. Repeat from * across. Turn. 2nd row: Sl st to sp of first shell, ch 3, in same sp make dc, ch 2 and 2 dc (shell made over shell); * ch 1, shell in sp of next shell. Repeat from * across. Turn. 3rd row: Sl st to sp of first shell, shell in same sp, * ch 2, shell over next shell. Repeat from * across, ending with shell over last shell, ch 2, sl st in top of starting chain at beginning of row.



Step 6—Insert hook in loop of left prong (Fig. 4).

Step 7—Thread over hook and draw loop through (2 loops on hook), thread over and draw through 2 loops.

Step 8—Repeat Steps 4 to 7 incl until staple is filled.

Step 9—Remove all but the last 4 loops from staple and continue as before for length desired.

Repeat from . around loin 6th rnd: Ch 5. * (tr in next tr. ch 1) 9 times; tr in next 2 tr. ch 1. Repeat from o around. Join. 7th rnd: Sc in sp formed by last ch-1, * ch 2, skip next tr. (tr in next tr. ch 2) 8 times; tr in next tr, ch 2, skip next sp, sc in next sp. Repeat from * around. Join. 8th rnd: Sc in same place as sl st. o ch 5, skip next sp, (sc in next sp. ch 5) 8 times; sc in next sc. Repeat from around. Join and break off. 9th rnd: Attach Black to same place as sl st, sc in same place, (ch 3, sc in next loop) 9 times; ch 3, sc in next sc. Repeat from * around. Join and break off.

BODICE . . . 1st row: Attach Yellow to opposite side of starting chain at waist, sc in same place, \$ 2 sc in next sp, sc at base of next shell. Repeat from across. Ch 3, turn. 2nd row: Skip first sc, dc in each sc across. Ch 3, turn. 3rd and 4th rows: Skip first de, de in each de across, increasing 3 dc evenly across each row, dc in top of turning chain-to inc 1 dc. make 2 de in 1 de. Ch 3, turn. At end of 4th row, ch 1 to turn. 5th row: Sc in first de and in each de across, se in top of turning chain. Ch 1, turn. 6th row: Sc in first sc and in next 6 sc, ch 10, skip 8 sc, sc in next 10 sc, ch 10, skip next 8 sc, sc in next 7 sc. Ch 7, turn. 7th row: Skip first sc, * tr in next st, ch 3. Repeat from * across, ending with tr in last sc. Break off. 8th row: Attach Black to first sp. sc in same sp, * ch 3, sc in next sp.
Repeat from * across. Break off. Attach Black to first st at waistband and make a chain long enough to reach around dress, sl st in opposite side of same row. Break off.

BOW (Make 12) ... With Black, ch 13, sl st in 8th ch from hook, ch 8, sl st in same ch, ch 5. Break off. Sew a how to each scallop around skirt. Sew 2 snap fasteners to back.

HAT... Starting at front with Yellow, ch 38. 1st row: Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 3, turn. 2nd, 3rd and 4th rows: Skip first dc, dc in each dc across, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. Break off at end of 4th row.

To Shape Back: 1st row: Skip first 12 dc, attach thread to next dc, ch 3, dc in next 11 dc. Ch 3, turn. 2nd, 3rd and 4th rows: Skip first dc, work off next 2 dc as 1 dc (1 dc decreased), dc

in each dc across, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. Break off at end of 4th row.

BRIM... Ist row: Attach Yellow to opposite side of starting chain, sc in same place, sc in next st, half de in next 3 sts, de in next 5 sts, 2 tr in each of next 16 sts, de in next 5 sts, 2 tr in each of next 16 sts, sc in next 2 sts, half de in next 3 sts, sc in next 2 sts, half de in next 3 sts, de in next 2 sts, half de in next 3 sts, tr in each st across to within last 9 sts, de in next 3 sts, half de in next 3 sts, sc in next 2 sts, half de in next 3 sts, sc in next 2 sts, half de in next 3 sts, sc in next 3 sts, sc in next 2 sts, als t in next st. Break off. Sew up back seams. Attach thread to neck edge and, working across back, sc closely across, drawing it in to fit. Break off.

With Black make a chain 4 inches long, sl st in first st on brim of hat, st in each st across. Make a chain 4 inches long. Break off.

Gather ribbon to reach around doll's waist. Sew up back seam, leaving a 2-inch opening. Sew hook and eye in place. Starch dress and hat lightly and press.

MATERIALS:

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN," Art. A.64: 1 ball of No. 12 Black; or

Clerk's O.N.T. Mercerized Bedspread Cotton, Art. B.504: 1 ball of a color of your own choice: or

J. & P. Coats or Clerk's O.N.T. Pearl Cotton, Art. A. or B.19, Size 5: 5 balls of No. 12 Black.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

A black lace handkerchief . . . 1 yard of rose taffeta ribbon 4 inches wide . . . 2 small flowers . . . 26 gold sequins . . . A snap fastener . . . A doll. 8 inches tall; chest 4½ inches.

GAUGE: 10 dc make 1 inch; 4 rows make 1 inch.

BODICE . . . Starting at back, ch 13. 1st row: Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 3, turn. 2nd row: Skip first dc, dc in each dc across, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. Repeat 2nd row until 13 rows have been completed. Break off. Sew narrow ends together.

SKIRT . . . Starting at top. ch 32. Join, being careful not to twist. 1st rnd: Ch 3. dc in same place as sl st. * dc in next ch. 2 dc in next ch. Repeat from * around. Join (48 dc). 2nd rnd: Ch 3, dc in same place as sl st.

• dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc. Repeat from * around. Join (72 dc). 3rd rnd: Ch 3, dc in next 11 dc, ch 4. dc in next 12 dc. Repeat from o around, ending with ch 4. Join. 4th rnd: Ch 3, dc in next 11 dc, * ch 4. sc in next loop, ch 4, dc in next 12 dc. Repeat from * around. Join. 5th rnd: SI st in next dc, ch 3, dc in next 9 dc.

* (ch 4, sc in next loop) twice: ch 4. skip next dc, dc in next 10 dc. Repeat from * around. Join. 6th rnd: Ch 3, dc in next 9 dc, * (ch 4, sc in next loop) 3 times; ch 4, skip next dc, dc in next 10 dc. Repeat from around. Join. 7th rnd: SI st in next dc. ch 3. dc in next 7 dc. . (ch 4, sc in next loop) 4 times; ch 4, skip next dc, dc in next 8 dc. Repeat from around. Join. 8th to 11th rnds incl: Work as for last 2 rnds alternately; having 2 dc less on each de group on every other rnd and I loop more between groups on every rnd (4 dc and 9 loops on 11th rnd). 12th rnd: Ch 3, dc in next 3 dc. ch 5, skip next loop, (sc in next loop, ch 4) 6 times; sc in next loop, ch 5, dc in next 4 dc. Repeat from • around. Join. 13th rnd: SI st in next de, se in same place, se in next de, (ch 4, sc in next loop) 8 times: ch 4, skip next dc, sc in next 2 dc. Repeat from around, ending with ch 2, dc in first sc. 14th and 15th rnds: * Ch 4, sc in next loop. Repeat from around, ending with ch 2, dc in dc. 16th rnd: * Ch 5, sc in next 2 loops, (ch 5, sc in next loop) 7 times. Repeat from around. Join and

FIRST FLOWER . . . Starting at center, ch 5. Join with s. st to form ring. 1st radi Ch 4, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr. make 2 tr in ring, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (cluster made), (ch 5, make a 3-tr cluster in ring) 5 times; ch 5, sl st in tip of first cluster. Break off.

SECOND FLOWER... Work as for First Flower until 6 clusters have been completed, ch 2, sl st in any sp on First Flower, ch 2, sl st in tip of first cluster on Second Flower. Break off.

Make 14 more flowers, joining as Second Flower was joined to First Flower, leaving 2 sps free between joinings on each flower. Join last flower to First Flower.

To Join Flowers to Skirt: 1st rnd: Attach thread to first free sp on any flower, sc in same sp. * ch 5, in next sp make sc, ch 5 and dc; in first free sp on next flower make dc, ch 5 and sc. Repeat from * around, ending with dc in same sp as first sc, ch 2, dc in first sc. 2nd rnd: Ch 2, sc in next loop on last rnd of skirt. * ch 2, sc in next loop on skirt. Repeat from * around. Join and break off.

Sew bodice to skirt. Now work around top as follows: Ist end: Attach thread to end de of any row on top of bodice, sc in same place, * ch 5, sc in end de of next row. Repeat from *

MATERIALS:

J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN," Art. A.64: 2 balls of No. 21 Shaded Greens; or

Clark's O.N.T. Mercerized Bedspreed Cotton, Art. B.504; 2 balls of a color of your own choice; or

J. & P. Coats or Clerk's O.N.T. Pearl Cotton, Art. A. or B.19, Size 5: 7 balls of No. 21 Shaded Greens.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.

3 small snap fasteners . . . 2½ yards of white satin ribbon, ¼ inch wide . . . A doll, 15 inches tall; chest 10½ inches.

GAUGE: 8 dc make 1 inch; 4 rows make 1 inch; 2 loop-rows make 1½ inches.

DRESS—Front Yoke . . . Starting at waist make a chain long enough to reach across front half of doll's waist. 1st row: De in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 3, turn. 2nd and 3rd rows: Skip first dc, dc in each dc across and in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. At end of 3rd row do not ch 3 to turn.

To Shape Armhole: 4th row: SI st across first 7 dc, ch 3, dc in each dc across to within last 6 dc. Ch 3, turn. 5th and 6th rows: Skip first dc, dc in each dc across and in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. 7th row: Skip first dc, dc in each dc across, and in top of turning thain. Ch 3, turn. Break off at end of 12th row incl. Skip first dc, dc in each dc across, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. Break off at end of 12th row. Attach thread to opposite side of 6th row and complete other side to correspond.

BACK YOKE . . . Starting at waist make a chain half as long as foundation chain of Front Yoke. Work as for Front Yoke until 3 rows have been completed. 4th row: Skip first dc, dc in each dc across to within last 6 dc, Ch 3, turn. 5th to 12th rows incl: Repeat 5th to 12th rows of Front Yoke. Make another piece the same way. Sew up shoulder and side seams.

SKIRT...1st row: With wrong side facing, attach thread to back of yoke and sc closely across yoke. Turn. 2nd row: Insert hook in first sc, thread over and draw loop through sc and loop on hook, draw loop on hook out to measure 1/4 inch (loop st made), holding last loop on book, insert book in same sc. thread over and draw loop through, ch I tightly, draw loop on hook out to same height as previous loop (another loop st made), " make I loop st in next sc, 2 loop sts in next sc. Repeat from a across, insert hook in last loop st and draw loop through to same height as loop st. insert hook in single loop and complete a sl st. Turn. 3rd row: Sc in each loop st across. Turn. 4th row: Make 2 loop sts in first sc, * 1 loop st in each of next 2 sc. 2 loop sts in next sc. Repeat from * across, ending as before. Turn. 5th row: Sc in each loop st across. SI st in first sc. Turn. Now work in rnds as follows: 1st rnd: 2 loop sts in first sc. * 1 loop st in each of next 3 sc, 2 loop sts in next sc Repeat from around. Join and turn. 2nd rnd: Sc in each loop around. loin and turn. 3rd rnd: Make a loop st in each sc around 4th to 11th rnds incl: Repeat 2nd and 3rd rnds 4 more times. 12th rnd: Repeat 2nd rnd. Join and turn. 13th rnd: Sc in each sc around, loin and break off.

SLEEVE . . . 1st rnd: With wrong side facing, attach thread to first free de at underarm and se closely around. loin and turn. 2nd rnd: Mark off 20 sc at center top of armhole. Make a loop st in each sc to first marked sc (? loop sts in next sc. loop st in next sc) 10 times; loop st in each remaining sc around. Join and turn. 3rd rnd: Sc in each loop st around. Join and turn. 4th end: Make a loop st in each sc around, increasing 10 loop sts evenly across top. Join and turn. 5th rnd: Sc in each loop st around. Join and turn. 6th rnd: Make a loop st in each sc around, loin and turn. 7th rnd: Sc in next 2 loop sts, make an sc through next 2 loop sts (1 loop st decreased). Repeat from a around. loin and turn. 8th rnd: Make a loop st in each sc around. Join. 9th rnd: * Sc in next 3 loops, make an sc through next 2 loops. Repeat from 6 around. Join and break off. Join (20 de). 2nd rnd: Sc in same place as sl st, sc in next 3 dc, half de in next de, de in next 1dd, half de in next de, Join. 3rd rnd: Sc in each st around, decreasing 10 sc evenly around. HAT . . . Starting at front with White, make a chain 5 inches long. 1st row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 1, turn. 2nd row: Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. Repeat 2nd row until piece measures 13/4 inches. Break off. Divide last row into 3 coual sections. Next row: Attach yarn to first st on center section, sc in each sc across section. Ch 1, turn. Cut a piece of cardboard the same shape as sole and insert inside thor.

Repeat from * around. Join and break off. Attach yarn to next dc where sts were divided and complete other leg to correspond.

BLOUSE ... Starting at bottom with White, ch 31. Ist row: De in 4th ch from book and in each ch across. Ch 3, turn. 2nd row: Skip first dc, dc in each dc across, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. 3rd row: Skip first dc, dc in next 1 dd, ch 5 (for armhole), skip 4 dc, dc in next 10 dc, ch 5 (for other armhole), skip 4 dc, dc in next 10 dc, ch 5 (for other armhole), skip 4 dc, dc in next 4 dc and in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. 4th row: Skip first dc, dc in each dc and in each ch across, dccreasing 2 dc at 4 equal intervals—to dec 2 dc, work off 3 dc as 1 dc.

SLEEVE . . . 1st rnd: Attach White at armhole, ch 3, dc closely around armhole, Join. 2nd to 6th rnds incl: Ch 3, dc in each dc around. Join. Break off at end of 6th rnd. Complete other sleeve the same way.

Attach Scarlet to neck and sc closely around. Break off. Sc closely around both sleeves. Join and break off. Attach White to lower edge of back opening and sc closely across. Break off. Work across other side of back in same way. Sew 3 snap fasteners to back of blouse. Embroider flowers as before on front. Fold front of pants to fit waist, forming a pleat on each side of front. Sew pleats in place. Attach Blue to pleat, ch 5, skip 2 sts, sl st in next st for buttonloop. Make a buttonloop over other pleat and one at center back. Sew buttons to blouse to correspond with buttonloops

HAT... Starting at center with Blue, ch. 2. 1st rnd: 7 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 2nd rnd: 2 sc in each sc around. 3rd rnd: * 2 sc in next sc (1 sc increased), sc in next sc. Repeat from * around. Inc 7 sc evenly on each rnd until piece measures 2 inches in diameter. Work without increasing until hat measures 13½ inches deep. Turn.

BRIM . . . Sc in each sc around until brim measures ¾ inch. Join and break off. Fold brim back.

HAIR... Cut a strand of Yellow 2½ inches long, double this strand and draw through any sc on first rnd of brim, draw loose ends through loop, pull ends up tightly, forming a fringe. Make a fringe in each sc around. Trim ends evenly. Trim front short to represent bangs.

SHOES . . . Work exactly as for Girl's Shoes.

- 12 yards of yellow satin ribbon, 1/4 inch wide . . . 3 small snap fasteners . A baby doll, 15 inches tall: chest 101/5 inches.

GAUGE: Size 20 or 30-11 dc make 1 inch; 4 loop-rows make 1 inch.

DRESS . . . Starting at neck make a chain 10 inches long. 1st row: Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across until row is long enough to reach around the doll's neck, allowing 1/4 inch overlap at the back for snap fastener. Cut off remaining chain. Ch 3, turn. 2nd, 3rd and 4th rows: Skip first de, de in each de across, increasing 12 dc evenly on each rowto inc 1 dc. make 2 dc in 1 dc-dc in top of turning chain. - Clark's Big Ball Mercerized Crochet, Art. B.34, Size 30: 3 balls of a color of your own choice.
- Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 10. 21/2 yards pink satin ribbon, 3/8 inch wide . . . 3 tiny snap fasteners . . . A hook and eye . . . A baby doll, 15 inches tall, chest 10½ inches.

GAUGE: 1 shell pattern measures 3/4 inch; 3 shell rows measure 1 inch.

SKIRT . . . Work as for Large Doll until skirt measures 71/2 inches long. Complete as for Large Doll.

BERTHA COLLAR . . . Work as for Large Doll until collar measures 21/2 inches. Complete as for Large Doll.

HAT . . . Work as for Large Doll until front piece measures 23/4 inches. Complete as for Large Doll, having only 3 shell rows on brim.

SHOE (Make 2) . . . Starting at center of sole, ch 22. 1st rnd: 4 dc in 4th ch from book, dc in each ch across, 7 dc in last ch. Working along op-posite side of starting chain make dc in each ch across. Join. 2nd rnd: Ch 3, de in same place as sl st, 2 de in each of next 4 dc, dc in each dc around, making 2 dc in each of 7 dc across toe. Join. 3rd rnd: Sc in same place as sl st, sc in each dc around. 4th to 7th rnds incl: Repeat 3rd rnd of Large Doll's shoe. 8th, 9th and 10th rnds: Repeat 8th rnd of Large Doll's shoe. Complete as for Large Doll.

Directions for Making Panties Pages 4-5-8-9

Starting at top make a chain long enough to reach around doll's waist. Join, being careful not to twist (center back). 1st rnd: Ch 3, dc in each ch around. Join. 2nd, 3rd and 4th rnds: Ch 3, dc in each dc around, Join, Fold in half, having starting chain in center back, ch 5 for crotch, sl st in corresponding de on front. Break off.
