




NIGHT GOWN YOKE. 2 Balls No. 80 Thread


Chain 77. Make four pieces of filet crochet by following pattern. Work 3 s in each mesh for the first row on each side. FOR EDGE—FIRST ROW—Is made in cross trebles. 2ND ROW—3 s over each 2 ch. 3RD ROW—1 s in 2nd of 3 s, ch 5, 1 s in next 2nd of 3 s. 4TH ROW—2 d, ch 3, 2 d in 3rd of 5 ch. 5TH ROW—1 s, ch 3, 1 s in 3 ch, ch 3, 1 s in next 3 ch. MEDALLION Chain 6, sl st together. 1ST ROUND— ch 6, 1 d in ring. * ch 3, 1 d in ring; * ch 3, 1 d in ring



ROUND YOKE. 2 Balls No. 60 Thread.

MEDALLION—CHAIN 11—sl st together. 1ST ROUND—ch 7, 1 d in ring.* ch 4, 1 d in ring; repeat from * 4 times, ch 4, sl st together. 2ND ROUND—1 s, 1 d, 5 t, 1 d, 1 s over each 4 ch. 3RD ROUND—ch 9, 1 d in 3rd t, ch 5, 1 t between scallops; repeat all around. 4TH ROUND—8 s. over each 5 ch. Work two rows of knot-stitch for 5th and 6th round. 7TH ROUND—ch 3, 2 t, 1 p, 2 t, 1 p, 2 t, on


knot-stitch, ch 3, 1 s in next knot-stitch; repeat. Medallions are sl st together, according to illustration. UPPER EDGE—Work 3 rows of knot-stitch. 4TH BOW—1 s in knot-stitch, ch 9, 1 s in next knot-stitch. 5TH ROW—Cross trebles. 6TH ROW—1 s in 2 ch. ch 3, 2 t, 1 p, 2 t, 1 p, 2 t over 2 ch between c t, ch 3, 1 s over 2 ch.



SQUARE YOKE. 2 Balls No. 50 Thread.

MEDALLION—Chain 8, sl st together 1ST ROUND—ch 4. 1 cl of 2 t over 8 ch, ch 9, 1 cl of 3 t over 8 ch; repeat from 4 times, ch 9, sl st together. 2ND ROUND—13 s over each 9 ch. FOUNDATION—Chain 220, and start work ing cross trebles in 10th chain stitch, continue all along, at end work 1 t. Work 6 more rows of cross trebles. For shoulder, work 24 rows of cross trebles. Break

thread. Start on other side and work 25 rows of cross trebies, ch 135 and work 7 more cross trebles on the 24 rows. This would make the yoke without a seam, ch 7 and continue like before, until you have worked 7 rows of cross trebies, which completes the foundation. See book No. 1 or No. 2 for description and illustration of cross treble stitch.



NIGHT GOWN YOKE. 2 Ball No 70 Thread.

CHAIN 12—1ST ROW—3 d, ch 3, 3 d in 8th ch, ch 3, sk 3 ch, 3 d, ch 3, 3 d in last ch. 2NID ROW—ch 3, 3 d, ch 3, 3 d in 3 ch, ch 3, 3 d, ch 3, 3 d in next 3 ch, ch 2, sk 2 d, 1 d in d, ch 2, 1 d in 3 ch. 3RD ROW—ch 5, 1 d in d, ch 2, 1 d in 3 ch work row up like before. Each succeeding row is worked likewise, only increasing

one mesh, and the pattern can easily be copied from illustration.

GE—1ST ROW—I cl in mesh, ch 6, sk 1 mesh, 1 cl in next mesh.

At corners put in 3 cl. Omit the 6 ch between the scallops.

2ND ROW—10 s over each 6 ch.

UPPER EDGE—1ST ROW—1 s in 3 ch, ch 5, 1 s in next 3 ch.

1 cl over 5 ch, ch 6, 1 cl over next 5 ch; repeat.

3RD ROW—10 s over each 6 ch.




CORSET COVER YOKE. 2 Balls No. 50 Thread.

MEDALLION—1ST ROUND—ch 6, sl st together. 2ND BOUND—ch 3, 2 d over 6 ch. * ch 3, 3 d over 6 ch; repeat from * twice, ch 3, sl st together 2RD ROUND—ch 3, 1 d in d, 1 d in next d, 2 d in last d, ch 6. Each succeeding round is made likewise, only increase each round with 2 ch and 2 d, so that there are 7 ch and 7 d in 4th round and 9 ch and 9 d in 5th round. Sew the wheels together and work 3 d over each 9 ch. to form little design, connecting the wheels.

OUTSIDE EDGE—1ST ROW—1 d in 5th d, ch 11, 1 t over 9 ch, (keep last loop of t on needle) 1 t over next 9 ch, (draw thread through 1st t also, when finishing this t, ch 11, 1 d in 5th d. 2ND ROW—1 d over d, ch 2, 1 d in 3rd ch, con tinue all along.

3RD ROW—1 s in d, sk 1 d, ch 3, 2 d, ch 3, 2 d in next d, ch 3, sk 1 d, 1 s in next d. 4TH ROW—1 s over 3 ch ch 4, 1 s over same 3 ch, ch 5, 1 s over same 3 ch, ch 4, 1 s over next 3 ch.




NIGHT GOWN YOKE. 2 Balls No. 60 Thread.

MEDALLION—CHAIN 23—1 d in 8th ch, ch 2, sk 2 ch, 1 d in ch; repeat till you have 6 o. m. Other five rows worked same way, then sl st to 4th o. m. 3 s in o. m, 3 s in next o. m, 3 s, ch 5, 3 s in next o. m; repeat all around, sl st together.

2ND ROUND—ch 4, * 1 cl (made of 3 d t) in 5 ch, ch 4; repeat from * 4 times ch 4, sl st in center of block 3RD ROUND—6 s over 4 ch, 3 s, ch 3, 3 s over next 4 ch; repeat. Medallions are sl st together according to illustration. FOR RING—Chain 14, sl st together, 4 s in ring. * ch 5, sl st to medallion, ch 5,

4 s in ring, repeat from \$ 3 times, ch 10, 4 s in ring, ch 10, 81 st together UPPER EDGE—1ST ROW—1 d in p, ch 5, 1 d in next p, ch 9, 1 s in 10 ch, ch 5, 1 s in next 10 ch, ch 9, 1 d in p. 2ND ROW—Doubles, 3RD ROW—Is made in cross trebles 4TH ROW—1 d in c t, ch 3, 1 d in same c t, 1 d, ch 3, 1 d in next c t. 5TH ROW—1 d, ch 3, 1 d in 3 ch, 1 d, ch 3, 1 d in next 3 ch.



ROSE YOKE. 3 Balls No. 80 Thread.

Start your work by chaining 308 stitches and follow design in back EDGE—

1ST ROW—3 s in each mesh.

2ND ROW—1s made in cross trebles.

3RD ROW—3 s over 2 ch. ch 2, 3 d, ch 2, 3 d over next 2 ch. ch 2, 3 s over next 2 ch.

CAMISOLE TOP 2 Balls No. 70 Thread.

MEDALLION—Chain 6, sl st together. 1ST ROUND—ch 6, 1 d in ring. ch 3. l d in ring; repeat from 6 times, ch 3, sl st together. 2ND ROUND—ch 1, l s, 1 h d, 3 d, 1 h d. 1 s over 3 ch; repeat from 6 all around. 3RD ROUND—sl st up to 2nd d. ch 6, 1 d in 2nd d. ch 3. 1 d, ch 3. 1 d in next 2nd d: repeat all around. 4TH ROUND—1 s, 1 h d, 3 d, 1 h d, 1 s over each 3 ch 5TH ROUND—sl st up to 2nd d, ch 7, 1 s in next 2nd d, ch 7; repeat all around.

6TH ROUND—sl st up to 4th ch, ch 9, 1 s over 7 ch; repeat all around. Medal lions are sl st together, according to illustration.

1ST ROW—1 s over 9 ch, ch 9, 1 cl (made of 3 t) over next 9 ch, ch 9, 1 cl over next 9 ch, ch 9, 1 cl over next 9 ch, ch 9, 1 cl over next 9 ch.


2ND ROW—1 d, ch 2. 1 d over 9 ch, * ch 5.1 t, ch 2. 1 t over next 9 ch; repeat from * once, ch 5. 1 d, ch 2. 1 d over next 9 ch. 3RD ROW—1 d, ch 3. 1 d over 2 ch, 1 d, ch 3. 1 d in 3rd ch. 4TH ROW—1 s, 1 h d, 3 d, 1 h d, 1 s over each 3 ch. For straps work first 2 rows of medallion, now sl st up to 3rd d, ch 7. 1 s in next 3rd d; repeat. EDGE—1ST ROW—1 d t between medallions, ch 3. 1 d, ch 3.1 d over 7 ch, ch 3. 1 d, ch 3. 1 d over next 7 ch, ch 3. 1 d t between medallion. 2ND ROW—1 d. ch 3. 1 d over 3 ch. 1 d, ch 3. 1 d in 2nd ch. 1 d, ch 3. 1 d over next 3 ch. 3RD ROW—1 s, 1 h d, 3 d. 1 h d, 1 s over each 3 ch.














Start work at corner of yoke by chaining 95 stitches and crochet 30 open meshes for first 4 rows, now follow design from illustration. Finish on both sides with

3 s in each mesh. 2ND ROUND—1 s in s, ch 6, sk 5 s, 1 s in 6th s. 3RD ROUND


4 s, ch 3, 4 s over each 6 ch. At corners chain 6 and crochet 4 s, ch 3, 4 s over 6 ch.



YOKE. 2 Balls No. 60 Thread.

MEDALLION—CHAIN 12—sl st together. 1ST ROUND—ch 1, * 3 s, ch 4, 3 s; repeat from * 5 times, sl st together. 2ND ROUND—ch 10, 1 s in 2nd s; repeat all around, sl st together. Wheels are sl st to each other after crocheting 5 chain stitches of next wheel. Yoke is made with 3 rows of wheels and requires 12 wheels for outside row across shoulder, 13 across back, counting each corner wheel and 17 across the front. OUTSIDE EDGE—1 s in 10 ch, ch 7, 1 s in next

10 ch; repeat all around. 2ND ROW—1 d in s, ch 1, 1 d in ch, all along till you get to corner, where you put in 1, d in s, ch 1, 3 times. UPPER EDGE—First 2 rows like outside rows, only omit the 1 ch, 4 times in the corners. 3RD ROW—1 s in d, ch 9, sk 3 d, 1 s in d. At corners ch 4, sk 3 d, 1 t in d. 4TH ROUND—3 d in 3 of the 9 ch, ch 5, 3 d in 3 of the 9 ch; repeat all around. 5TH ROUND—2 s, 1 p, 2 s over 5 ch, ch 4, 2 s, 1 p, 2 s in next 5 ch.



CHILD'S YOKE.

1 Ball No. 80 Thread. Follow filet design from illustration.

EDGE—1ST ROW—3 s in each mesh.
2ND ROW—Is made in cross trebles.


3RD Row-1 s in c t, ch 2, * 1 d, ch 2; repeat from * 4 times in next c t, ch 2, 1 s in next c t.

CHILD'S YOKE.

1 Ball No. 60 Thread.


MEDALLION—Chain 6, sl st together 1ST ROUND—ch 6, 1 d in ring, • ch 3, 1 d in ring, repeat from • 6 times, ch 3, sl st together. 2ND ROUND—ch 4, 1 cl of 4 t over 3 ch, ch 7 • 1 cl of 5 t over next 3 ch; repeat from • 6 times, ch 7, sl st together 3RD ROUND—ch 7, 1 d in 4th ch, ch 4, 1 d over cl, ch 4, 1 d in 4th ch, all around. 4TH ROUND—1 s, 1 h d, 5 d, 1 h d, 1 s over each 4 ch, Medallions are sl st together, according to illustration. UPPER EDGE—1ST BOW—1 s in 3rd d, ch 5, 1 d in next 3rd d, ch 5, 1 tr, ch 5, 1 s in next 3rd d, continue all around, sl st together. 2ND ROW—ch 4, 1d in s, 1 d in d, ch 4, sl st to d, ch 4, 1 d in d, 1 d in tr, ch 4, sl st to tr, ch 4, 1 d in tr. 3RD ROW—1 s over the 2 chains of 4 and 2 ds, ch 4, 1 s over same ds and chains of 4, ch 4, 1 s over next ds and chains of 4.



CAMISOLE TOP. 2 Balls No. 80 Thread.

Chain 59 stitches, then follow filet pattern from illustration UPPER EDGE—18T ROW—3 s in each mesh. 2ND ROW—1 cl (made of 3 t) in s, ch 5, 1 cl in next 6th s, 3RD ROW—1 s in cl, ch 7, 1 s in next cl. 4TH ROW—5 s, ch

3. 5 s over each 7 ch. Work 1st 2 rows of upper edge for lower edge. For straps across shoulders follow pattern and finish each side like upper edge.



GOWN YOKE. 3 Balls No. 80 Thread

Chain 68. Start work at point on side and crochet 25 rows after illustration, break thread. Chain 68 stitches again, and work other side but 26 rows, now chain 207 stitches and crochet right on to the 25 rows made before. This will give you a seamless yoke. Continue to follow design from illustration. UPPER EDGE—1ST ROW—3 s in each mesh. 2ND ROW—1 cl (made of 3 t) in 8, ch 4 sl st to 9th

s. ch 4. 1 cl (made of 2 t) in same s, ch 4, sl st in 9th s; repeat. 3RD ROW—1 s in cl, ch 8, 1 s in next cl. 4TH ROW—9 s over each 8 ch. 5TH ROW—1 d, ch 3, 1 d in s. sk 4 s, 1 d, ch 3, 1 d in 5th s. 6TH ROW—1 s over 3 ch, ch 1, 7 d over next 3 ch, ch 1, 1 s over next 3 ch.

AUGUSTA PFEUFFER'S NEW CROCHET BOOKS.

HOW TO USE IT Augusta Pfeuffer GOWN YOKE BLOCK PATTERN OF PAGE

RICK RACK BRAID (Frontis piece).

1 Ball No. 40 Thread and 1 piece No. 41 Rick Rack Braid.

Take 8 scallops of braid and sew together, now work 1 d in point of braid, ch 1, 1 d in next point of braid; repeat all around, sl st together. FOR OUTSIDE ROW—* 1 d, ch 7, 1 d in point of braid, ch 3, 1 p, ch 3; repeat from * all around, sl st together, sl st the medallions to each other after crocheting 3 ch of the 7 ch. INSIDE EDGE—IST ROW—1 s in braid, sl st to 7 ch, 1 s in same point of braid ch 8 1 s in next point of braid, ch 4, 1 s in same point of braid, ch 8,

1 s in next point of braid, ch 3, 1 p,ch 3,sl st to 7 ch, ch 3, 1 p, ch 3,sl st to 7 ch of next wheel, ch 3, 1 p, ch 3, 1 s in same point of braid, ch 8, 1 s in next point continue all around. 2ND ROW—1 s in point of braid, ch 8, 1 s in next point of braid At corners chain only 6. 2ND ROW—* 1 d in s, ch 3, 3 d over d, ch 5; repeat from *. At corners ch 2, 1 d in s, ch 2. OUTSIDE EDGE—1ST ROW—Same like in side rows. At corners work 1 d in 7 ch. 2ND ROW—1 s in point of braid, ch 8, 1 s in next point of braid. At corners ch 10.






