**CHADWICK'S RED HEART SOCK & SWEATER YARN, 3 Ply, Shrink-and-Stretch Resist Finish, Art. E.255:** 1 skein (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skein) of No. 789 Bittersweet, or

**CHADWICK'S RED HEART ORLON "FASHION YARN," 3 Ply, Art E.265,** 1 skein (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skein) of No. 789 Bittersweet, and

**CHADWICK'S RED HEART ORLON "FASHION-GLO," 3 Ply, Art. E.265M,** 1 skein (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skein) of No. M.12 Black.

**Clark's O.N.T. Plastic Crochet Hook No. 2.**  
A hook and eye.

Starting at neck edge with Bittersweet, make a chain 16 inches long. **1st row:** 3 dc in 4th ch from hook, \* skip next 3 ch, 3 dc in next ch. Repeat from \* until row measures 14 inches, ending with 3 dc, dc in next ch. Cut off remaining chain. Ch 3, turn. **2nd row:** Make 3 dc in center dc of each 3-dc group, dc in top of ch-3. Ch 3, turn. **3rd and 4th rows:** Make 5 dc in center dc of each dc group, dc in top of turning chain. Ch 3, turn. **5th row:** Make 7 dc in center dc of each dc group, dc in top of turning chain. Break off. (This is right side of work.)

With right side facing, attach Black to neck edge, holding yarn in back of work, sl st in sp between the ch-3 and first dc group on first row, (ch 1, sl st in next sp on next row) 3 times, ch 1, sl st in back loop of each of next 7 dc, (ch 1, working toward neck edge sl st in next sp between shells) 5 times. Working toward outer edge, continue in same manner, working back over the sps that have just been worked to within next 7 dc, ch 1, sl st in back loop of each of next 7 dc. Complete all scallops the same way. Work side edge to correspond with opposite side. Break off. Sew hook and eye in place.

# C-272

**CHADWICK'S RED HEART ORLON "FASHION-GLO," Art. E.265M:** 1 skein (1 oz. "Tangle-Proof" Pull-Out Skein) each of No. M.1 White and No. M.12 Black.

**Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 2/0** (double zero).

A hook and eye.

Starting at neck edge with White, ch 73. **1st row:** 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, \* sc in next 6 ch, 2 sc in next ch. Repeat from \* across (82 sc). Break off and turn. Work over ends of previous row in order to conceal them. **2nd row:** Attach Black to first sc of 1st row, sc in same st, (thread over, insert hook through sc just made, draw loop through) twice, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (puff st made); skip next sc. Repeat from \* across, ending with sc in last sc. Break off and turn. **3rd row:** Attach White to first sc of previous row, dc in same place, \* sc in single loop of puff st, dc at base of next sc. Repeat from \* across, ending with sc in last

sc. Break off and turn. Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows 2 more times. **8th row:** Attach Black and sc in same place, \* make 7 dc at base of next sc, skip next dc, sc at base of next sc, skip next dc. Repeat from \* across, ending with sc in last sc. Break off. **9th row:** Attach White and sc in same place, \* sl st in back loop of next 7 dc, sc at base of next sc. Repeat from \* across. Break off. With right side facing, attach Black to starting chain and sl st in each ch across. Break off. Sew hook and eye in place.

# S-597

**J. & P. COATS "KNIT-CRO-SHEEN," Art. A.64:** 1 ball of No. 51 Spice.

**Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 7.**

Assorted beads and sequins.

A hook and eye.

**GAUGE:** 8½ sc make 1 inch; 10 rows make 1 inch.

Starting at neck edge, ch 116 to measure 14 inches. **1st row:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 1, turn. **2nd row:** Sc in each sc across, increasing 4 sc evenly across—to inc 1 sc, make 2 sc in 1 sc. Ch 1, turn. **3rd row:** Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows alternately until piece measures 2¼ inches. Break off.

Sew a hook and eye to neck edge. Sew on sequins and beads as desired.

# S-598

**J. & P. COATS BEST SIX CORD MERCERIZED CROCHET, Art. A.104, Size 30:** 1 ball of White.

Scraps of White "Knit-Cro-Sheen."

**Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 10.**

Pearls and rhinestones.

**GAUGE:** 6 loops make 1 inch; 10 rows make 1 inch.

Starting at neck edge make a chain 7¼ inches long. **1st row:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 1, turn. **2nd row:** Sc in first sc, \* ch 3, skip next sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from \* across. Ch 3, turn. **3rd to 13th rows incl:** Sc in first loop, \* ch 3, sc in next loop. Repeat from \* across. Ch 3, turn. Ch 1 to turn at end of 13th row. **14th to 18th rows incl:** Sl st to center of first loop, sc in same loop (1 loop decreased), \* ch 3, sc in next loop. Repeat from \* across. Ch 1, turn. **19th row:** Sl st to center of first loop, sc in same loop, \* ch 3, sc in next loop. Repeat from \* across, ending with sc in 2nd loop from end of row. Break off. Attach thread to neck edge and sc closely around outer edge to opposite side of collar. Break off.

**FLOWER (Make 4) . . .** Starting at center, ch 6. Join with sl st to form ring. **1st rnd:** Working over 4 strands of "Knit-Cro-Sheen" make 12 sc in ring. Join. Cut off "Knit-Cro-Sheen." **2nd rnd:** Sc in same place as sl st, \* ch 5, skip 2 sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from \* around. Join.

**3rd rnd:** Sl st in next loop, \* ch 3, in same loop make dc, 7 tr and dc; ch 3, sl st in same loop, ch 2, sl st in next loop. Repeat from \* around. Join and break off. **4th rnd:** Attach thread to any ch-2 sp between petals and working over 8 strands of "Knit-Cro-Sheen," sc in same sp, \* make 3 sc over ch-3, sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next tr, 3 sc in next tr, 2 sc in next tr, sc in next 3 sts, 3 sc over next ch-3, sc in next ch-2 sp. Repeat from \* around. Join. Cut off "Knit-Cro-Sheen." **5th rnd:** Sc in same place as sl st, \* ch 3, skip next 3 sc, dc in next sc, (ch 2, skip next sc, dc in next sc) 6 times; ch 3, sc in sc at base of petal. Repeat from \* around. Join and break off. Sew Flowers to collar.

Make another piece the same way. Sew together at one end.

**TIE (Make 2) . . .** Make a chain to measure 13 inches. **1st row:** Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across, 7 dc in last ch; working along opposite side of starting chain, make dc in each ch across. Break off. Make a Flower and sew to one end of tie and sew other end to neck edge.

Sew pearls and rhinestones on Flowers as desired.

**COATS & CLARK'S O.N.T. "SPEED-CRO-SHEEN" MERCERIZED COTTON, Art. C.44:** 1 ball of No. 49-A Killarney.

**Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 2/0** (double zero).

Yellow and aqua velvet ribbon, ½ inch wide.

Assorted sequins.

A hook and eye.

Starting at neck edge, ch 56 to measure 14 inches. **1st row:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 1, turn. **2nd row:** Sc in each sc across. Ch 5, turn. **3rd row:** Skip first sc, \* tr in next sc, ch 1. Repeat from \* across, ending with tr in last sc. Ch 6, turn. **4th row:** Skip first tr, \* tr in next tr, ch 2. Repeat from \* across, ending with tr in 4th ch of turning ch-5. Ch 6, turn. **5th row:** Repeat 4th row. Ch 1, turn. **6th row:** Sc in first tr, 2 sc in each sp across, sc in 4th ch of turning chain. Break off.

Lace ribbon through sps as illustrated. Sew sequins in place as desired. Sew a hook and eye to neck edge.
