


## Simple Crochet Stitches...

- 1... Chain (ch): Make a loop on hook, thread over and draw main length of thread through. Continue to draw thread through each new loop for length desired.
- 2... Single Crochet (sc): Insert hook under 2 loops of st, draw thread through (2 loops on hook), thread over, draw through both loops on hook.
- 3... Double Crochet (d c): Thread over, insert hook in st and draw thread through (3 loops on hook); thread over, draw through 2 loops, thread over, draw through 2 remaining loops. Work Half Double Crochet (half d c)
- like d c, but draw thread through all 3 loops at once.
- 4... Treble (tr): Thread over twice, insert hook in st and draw thread through (4 loops on hook); thread over and work off 2 loops at a time as for a d c. For a Double Treble (d tr), thread over 3 times; and for a Triple Treble (tr tr), thread over 4 times, working off 2 loops at a time as in the tr.
- 5... Slip Stitch (sl st): Insert hook in st, catch thread and, with one motion, draw thread through both the st and the 1 loop on hook.

# #8301-BUD INSTRUCTIONS FOR CROCHETING BUD POT HOLDER (Use #5 Steel Crochet Hook)

- (Start at waist from letter-H as shown on chart)

  1st Row- Ch 35 fasten in 4th ch from hook with a dc, ch l
  skip l ch, dc in next ch \* ch l, skip l ch, dc in
  next ch, repeat from \* ch 4 turn (making 16 open
  meshes).
- 2nd Row- Dc in dc \* ch 1, dc in next dc, repeat from \* ch 4 turn.
- 3rd-4th-5th-6th Rows- Crochet same as 2nd Row.
  INSTRUCTIONS FOR CROCHETING SHOULDER
- 7th Row- Ch 4, dc in dc, repeat 4 times making 5 open meshes or 6 dc.
- 8th-9th-10th-11th Rows- Crochet same as 7th Row, this completes shoulder, fasten, cut thread.

  FOR OTHER SHOULDER-Join thread as shown on chart.
- 1st Row- Ch 4, dc in next dc, repeat 4 times making 5 open meshes or 6 dc, repeat for 5 rows, this completes shoulder. Ch 12 for neck, sl st in each dc, sl st under each ch to end, ch 4 turn.
- 12th Row- Dc in dc, \* Ch 1, dc in next dc, repeat from \* to ch 12 for neck, skip 1 ch, dc in next dc, repeat having 6 open meshes for neck, repeat crocheting across other shoulder, ch 4 turn, (making 16 open meshes or 17 dc in 12th Row.)

  Follow instructions for 3rd, 4th, 5th, & 6th rows.

  This completes waist.

  INSTRUCTIONS FOR CROCHETING PANTS
- 1st Row- Ch 4, dc in dc, ch 1, dc in next dc, repeat to 9th dc, ch 1, dc in 9th dc, ch 1, dc in same dc making an increase, ch 1, dc in next 8 dc, ch 4 turn.
- 2nd Row- Dc in dc, ch 1, dc in dc repeat to increase, ch 1, dc under same ch, \* ch 1, dc in dc, repeat from \* ch 4 turn.
- INSTRUCTIONS FOR CROCHETING LEGS FOR PANTS

  Ch 4, dc in dc, ch 1, dc in dc, repeat to increase, ch 1, dc under ch, ch 4 turn. Next 2 rows crochet same as above making 3 rows for each leg, fasten cut thread, join thread at increase ch 4, dc in dc, ch 1, dc in dc, repeat from \* ch 1 turn. Next 2 rows crochet same as above. (Start at H shown on chart) Crochet other half of pants same as instructions given above.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SEWING POT HOLDER TOGETHER.

Fold over and sew pants together from G to F and from A to B. Sew crotch together from C to D and from D to E turn pot holder to right side.

Join colored thread at <u>E</u> with a sc, \* 2 sc under ch, 2 sc under next ch, repeat from \* to <u>E</u> join, cut thread. Join thread at <u>C</u> with a sc \* 2 sc under ch, 2 sc under next ch, repeat from \* join at <u>C</u> and cut thread. Fasten colored thread in dc at neck with a sc,\*2 sc under ch, 2 sc under next ch, repeat from \* join, sl st to top of shoulder, ch 10 for hanger, 14 sc under ch, join cut thread, finish arm holes same as instructions given for leg and neck. Finish front with 3 french knots, take two strands of thread, wrap thread once over needle for french knot.

### INSTRUCTIONS FOR CROCHETING BELT.

Crochet ch long enough to go around suit, ch l sc in each ch, fasten cut thread, sew to suit as shown. #8301-SIS

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CROCHETING SIS POT HOLDER
For crocheting waist follow instructions given for Bud pot holder.

### INSTRUCTIONS FOR FRONT OF SKIRT.

- lst Row- Join thread in dc at waist, ch 5, dc under ch of open mesh \* skip open mesh, dc under next ch in open mesh, ch 2, dc in same place, skip open mesh repeat from \* dc under ch of open mesh in back of waist, ch 2 dc in same place, \* skip open mesh, dc under next ch in open mesh, ch 2 dc in same place, repeat from \* join.
- 2nd Row- Ch 5, dc under ch 2 between dc, ch 2, dc in same place, ch 2, dc in same place making a shell of 4 dc with 2 between dc \* shell under next ch of 2 between dc, repeat from \* join.
- 3rd Row- Sl st to center of shell ch 5 for first dc a shell of 4 dc \* Shell in next shell, repeat from \* join.
  4th through to 3th Rows inclusive- Crochet same as 3rd Row.
  TO FINISH ARM HOLES

Join natural colored thread, (ch 4 for first dc) ch 1, dc in same place, repeat having 4 dc with ch 1 between for shell \* skip next open mesh, shell in next open mesh repeat from \* join (finish other arm hole same way). Join colored thread (follow instructions given for bottom of skirt.) Finish neck and hanger same as for Bud pot holder. Crochet ch long enough to draw through waist of dress and tie in bow as shown.
