Row 2: Ch 25, turn, dc in 8 th ch from hook, (ch 2, sk 2 ch, dc in next st) 6 times ( 1 half-sp and 6 sps added), (ch 2 , dc in next dc) 13 times, ch 2, dc in 3d st of end half-sp, ch 5 , dc in same st, (ch 5 , turn, dc in 3 d st of previous ch-5) 5 times, ch 2, turn, tr in 3d st of last ch-5 (6 sps and 1 half-sp added). Row 3: Ch 16, turn, dc in 8th ch from hook, (ch 2, sk 2 ch , dc in next st) 3 times, ( 1 halfsp and 3 sps added), make 27 sps , ch 5 , sl st in 3 d st of end half-sp, (ch 5, turn, dc in 3d st of previous ch-5) 3 times, ch 2, turn, $\operatorname{tr}$ in 3d st of last ch-5 ( 3 sps and 1 half-sp added). Row 4: Ch 13, dc in 8th ch from hook,
(ch 2, sk 2 ch , dc in next st) twice ( 1 half-sp and 2 sps added), make 35 sps , ch 2 , dc in 3 d st of end half-sp, ch 5 , dc in same st, ch 5 , turn, dc in 3d st of previous ch-5, ch 2, turn, tr in 3 d st of last ch-5 ( 2 sps and 1 half-sp added). Row 5: Ch 10, turn, dc in 8 th ch from hook, ch 2, dc in next tr ( 1 half-sp and 1 sp added), make 41 sps , ch 5 , sl st in 3 d st of end half-sp, ch 5 , turn, dc in 3d st of previous ch-5, ch 2, turn, tr in 3d st of last ch-5 ( 1 sp and 1 half-sp added). Rows 6, $7 \& 8$ : Start and end each row as in Row 5. Row 9: Ch 7, turn, dc in tr (half-sp added), make 57 sps , ch 2 , dc in 3d st of end half-sp, ch 2, tr in same st (half-sp added). Row 10: Start and end as in Row 5. Row 11: Ch 7, turn, dc in tr, $23 \mathrm{sps}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next sp , dc in next dc (1 blk made), 39 sps , ch 2, dc in 3d st of end half-sp, ch 2 , tr in same st. Row 12: Ch 7, turn, dc in tr, make $25 \mathrm{sps}, 3$ blks, $12 \mathrm{sps}, 3 \mathrm{blks}, 10 \mathrm{sps}, 1 \mathrm{blk}$ and 11 sps , ch 2, dc in 3d st of end half-sp, ch 2, tr in same st. Row 13: Start and end as in Row 12. Row 14: Start and end as in Row 5. Rows 15 thru 19: Start and end as in Row 12. Row 20: Ch 5, turn, sk half-sp, dc in next dc, follow Chart across; end with ch 2, dc in 3d st of end half-sp. Continue thru Row 38. Row 39: Ch 5, turn, sk half-sp, dc in next dc, make $28 \mathrm{sps}, 1 \mathrm{blk}, 9 \mathrm{sps}, 1 \mathrm{blk}, 5 \mathrm{sps}, 3 \mathrm{blks}$, (ch 3, sk 2 dc, sc in next dc, ch 3, sk 2 dc , dc in next dc) 5 times ( 5 Lacet Sts made), 3 blks , ( $6 \mathrm{sps}, 1 \mathrm{blk}$ ) twice, 9 sps , 2 blks and 20 sps. Row 40: Ch 5, turn, sk 1st sp, dc in next dc, $15 \mathrm{sps}, 6$ blks, $8 \mathrm{sps}, 1 \mathrm{blk}, 7 \mathrm{sps}, 1 \mathrm{blk}, 4 \mathrm{sps}, 2$ blks, 1 sp , ch 5 , sk 5 dc , dc in next dc (long sp made), (ch 5 , dc in next dc) 5 times, 1 long $\mathrm{sp}, 1 \mathrm{sp}, 2 \mathrm{blks}, 4$ sps, 1 blk, $8 \mathrm{sps}, 1 \mathrm{blk}$ and 29 sps . Row 41: Ch 5, turn, sk 1 st sp , dc in next dc, $27 \mathrm{sps}, 1 \mathrm{blk}, 7 \mathrm{sps}, 2 \mathrm{blks}, 4 \mathrm{sps}, 1$ blk, 1 sp , ch 3, sk 2 dc , sc in next dc, ch 3, dc in next dc, (ch 3, sc in next long sp, ch 3, dc in next dc) 7 times, ch 3 , sc in next dc, ch 3 , sk 2 dc , dc in next dc, $1 \mathrm{sp}, 1$ blk, 4 sps, $1 \mathrm{blk}, 6 \mathrm{sps}, 1 \mathrm{blk}, 7 \mathrm{sps}, 1 \mathrm{blk}, 2 \mathrm{sps}, 2 \mathrm{blks}$, $1 \mathrm{sp}, 3$ blks, 14 sps . Continue thru Row 61. Row 62: Ch 4, turn, sk 1st dc, dc in next dc (half-sp decrease), follow Chart across, ending with $11 \mathrm{sps}, \mathrm{tr}$ in 3d st of end ch-5 (half-sp dec). Follow Chart thru Row 97. Row 98: Ch 1, turn, sk tr, sl st across to 2 d dc , ch 4 , dc in next dc, 12 sps, 3 blks and follow Chart across. Follow Chart thru Row 110. In Rows 108, 109 and 110, ch 1, turn, sl st across to proper place to start each row.

SCROLL: With Beauty Pink, ch 60, sk 1 ch , (sc in next 3 ch , draw up a lp in next $2 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{Y} \mathrm{O}$ and draw thru 3 lps on hook for a dec) 4 times, hdc in 5 ch , (dc in 3 ch , dc in 2 ch made into a dec) 5 times, hdc in 4 ch , sc in 4 $\mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$ in end ch ; on other side of chain, sc in next 4 ch, hdc in $3 \mathrm{ch}, 2 \mathrm{hdc}$ in next ch, (dc in $4 \mathrm{ch}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next ch) 5 times, hdc in $4 \mathrm{ch}, 2$ hdc in next ch, (sc in 3 ch, 2 sc in next ch) 4 times, sc in 4 ch . In back lp of 1st

Row 3: Ch 5, turn, dc in 1st dc, * ch 2, dc in next $4 \mathrm{dc}(1 \mathrm{blk})$, ${ }^{* *}$ ch 2 , (dc, ch 1 , dc) in 3d st of next ch-6. Row 4: Ch 6, turn, sk 1st dc, dc in next dc, * ch 2, blk in next blk, ch 2, dc in next dc (1 sp ), ** ch 2, dc in 2d st of next ch-5. Row 5: Start as in Row 3 to ${ }^{*} ; 2 \mathrm{sps}, 1 \mathrm{blk}, 1 \mathrm{sp}$, end as in Row 3 from ${ }^{* *}$ to end. Row 6: Start as in Row 4 to ${ }^{*} ; 2$ sps, 1 blk, 2 sps, end as in Row 4 from ** to end. Row 7: Ch 6, turn, dc in 1 st dc, * 3 sps, $1 \mathrm{blk}, 2$ sps, ${ }^{* *} \mathrm{ch} 2$, (dc, ch 2 , dc) in 3d st of end ch-6. Row 8: Start as in Row 3 to *; follow Chart across and end as in Row 3 from ** to end.

Row 9: Start as in Row 4 to *; follow Chart across and end as in Row 4 from ** to end. Rows 10 thru 13: Repeat Rows 8 \& 9 twice. Row 14: Start as in Row 7 to *; follow Chart across and end as in Row 7 from ** to end. Repeat Rows 8 thru 14 twice (thru Row 28); then repeat Rows 8 \& 9 twice (thru Row 32 at Corner B on Chart). Row 33: Ch 4, turn, sk 1st dc, dc in next dc (half-sp), follow Chart across to end dc, dc in 3d st of end sp (half-sp). Row 34: Ch 4, turn, sk 1st sp , dc in next dc (half-sp), follow Chart across, ending with a half-sp. Continue, following Chart, thru Row 37. Row 38: Ch 1, turn, sl st across 1st sp to next dc, ch 4, dc in next dc and follow Chart. Repeat for 2 more rows. Row 41: Ch 1, turn, sl st across 2 sps to next dc, ch 4, dc in next dc and follow Chart. Fasten off. Make 6 Sections.

EDGE: Attach Blue at Corner B of 1 Section, 2 sc in same $\mathrm{st}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$ in next 18 sps , sc in next $4 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$ in next 18 sps , 3 sc in next (corner) st, 3 sc in next 32 sps , * 3 sc in starting st at point, 3 sc in next $32 \mathrm{sps}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in same st with 1st 2 sc , join to 1 st sc and fasten off. Repeat EDGE to * on a 2 d Section; 2 sc in starting st, ch 2, sl st in 2d of 3 sc on point of 1st Section, ch 2, sl st back in last sc on 2 d Section, 1 sc in same st with last 2 sc, ( 2 sc in next sp , ch 2 , sl st in 2d sc in next sp on 1st Section, ch 2 , sl st back in last sc on 2d Section, 1 sc in same sp) 32 times, 1 sc in same st with 1 st 2 sc , join to 1 st sc, ch 2 , sl st in $2 d$ of 3 sc in corner on 1st Section, ch 2, sl st back in same sc on 2d Section. Rnd 4: Ch 3, (3 dc in next sp , dc in next Cluster, dc in next ch-1 sp , dc in next Cluster) repeated around; join to ch-3 ( 72 dc ). PLACE MAT measures $12 \times 17 \frac{1}{2}$ inches.
Work tightly for best results.
PLACE MAT (Make 4): 1st MOTIF ( $21 / 4$ "): CENTER: With Baby Pink, ch 30. Row 1: Dc in 9th ch from hook, (ch 2, sk 2 ch , dc in next ch) 7 times. Row 2: Ch 5, turn, sk 1st sp, dc in next dc, (ch 2, dc in next dc) 6 times, ch 2, dc in 3d st of end sp. Repeat Row 2 six times ( 8 rows square). EDGE: Ch 6, sc in same st with last dc, * (ch 3, dc in next dc, ch 3, sc in next dc) 3 times, ch 3 , (dc, ch 3 , dc) in corner st, ch 3 , sc in next dc; repeat from * around; end with ch 3, dc in corner dc, ch 3, sl st in 3d st of ch-6. Rnd 2: Ch 8, dc in next dc, (ch 5, dc in next dc) 3 times, * ch 11, dc in next corner dc, (ch 5, dc in next dc) 4 times; repeat from * around; join final $11-\mathrm{ch}$ to 3 d st of ch-8. Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in same st, * (3 sc in next sp , ch 4, sl st in last sc for a $\mathrm{p}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in same sp , sc in next dc) 4 times, in corner sp make 3 sc , a ch-4 p , 4 sc , ${ }^{* *}$ a ch-7 p, 4 sc , a ch-4 p and 3 sc ; sc in next dc; repeat from * around; join and fasten off.

2d MOTIF: Repeat to ** in Rnd 3; ch 3, sl st in 1 lp of center st of a corner $p$ on 1st Motif, being careful that the 8th row of CENTER of all Motifs will be on the same side after joining. Ch 3, sl st back in last sc on 2d Motif, 4 sc in corner sp, ch 2, sl st in next p on 1st Motif, ch 2 , sl st back in last sc, 2 sc in same sp , sc in next dc. Join the next 5 ps on both Motifs, as for last p, then join corner ps as for 1st corner ps, and complete rnd as for 1st Motif. Make 3 rows of 5 Motifs, joining adjacent sides as for 1st 2 Motifs (where 4 corners meet, join 3d and 4th corners to joining of previous 2 corners).

BORDER: Attach to center st of a corner p, ch 3, dc in same st, ch 4, holding back the last lp of each dc on hook, make 2 dc in same st, Y O and draw thru all 3 lps on hook (Cluster made), ** ch 3, hdc in next p, * (ch 5, hdc in next p) 5 times, (ch 4, a 2-dc Cluster) twice in joining of corner ps , ch 4 , hdc in next p ; repeat from * to corner, ch 3, 2-dc Cluster in center st of corner p, (ch 4, 2-dc Cluster) twice in same st; repeat from ** around; end with ch 3, Cluster in corner p, ch 4, join to 1st dc. Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in same st, 4 sc in next sp, sc in

Cluster, ** 3 sc in next sp, sc in hdc, * ( 5 sc in next sp, sc in hdc) 5 times, ( 4 sc in next sp , sc in next st) 3 times; repeat from * across; 3 sc in 1st ch- 3 sp at corner, sc in Cluster, ( 4 sc in next sp, sc in Cluster) twice; repeat from ** around; join to 1st sc. Rnd 3: Ch 5, turn, sk 2 sc in next sp, dc in next sc, * (ch 2, sk 2 sc , dc in next sc) repeated to center sc at corner, ch 5 , dc in same st; repeat from * around; end with ch 2, dc in 3d st of 1st ch-5 (ending at exact corner). Rnd 4: Ch 5, turn, sk 1st sp, dc in next dc, * (ch 2, dc in next dc) repeated to center st of corner sp , ch 5 , dc in same st; repeat from * around, ending as in last rnd. Repeat Rnd 4 eight times. Rnd 13: Ch 6, sc in same st with last dc, * (ch 3, dc in next dc, ch 3, sc in next dc) repeated to corner, ch 3, (dc, ch 3, dc) in 3d st of corner sp, ch 3, sc in next dc; repeat from * around; end with ch 3 , dc in corner dc, ch 3, sl st in 3d st of ch-6. Rnd 14: Ch 8, dc in next dc, * (ch 5, dc in next dc) repeated to 1 st dc at corner, ch 11, dc in next corner dc; repeat from * around; join to 3 d st of $1 \mathrm{st} \mathrm{ch}-8$. Rnd 15: ( $3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch}-4 \mathrm{p}$, 2 sc ) in each ch-5 sp around, with ( $3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{p}, 4 \mathrm{sc}$, ch-7 p, $4 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch}-4 \mathrm{p}$ and 2 sc ) in corner lps. Join and fasten off.

FLOWER: With Beauty Pink, ch $2,8 \mathrm{sc}$ in 2 d ch from hook, join to back lp of 1st sc. Rnd 2: * Ch 6, 3 dtr in same st, ch 4, sl st in last dtr for a p, 3 dtr in back lp of next sc, ch 6 , sl st in same sc, sl st in next sc; repeat from * 3 times. Cut with 10 " sewing end. Make 15 . Sew one on center of each Motif.
BORDER ROW: Make one Flower. Make a 2d Flower up to $p$ on 4th petal, ch 2, sl st in a p on 1st Flower, ch 2, sl st back in last dtr on 2d Flower (joining-p made); complete Flower. Make and join 14 Flowers into a straight row for each long side of Mat. Connect at ends with 7 Flowers ( 42 Flowers total on Border), and sew on center of Border. Make 3 more Place Mats.

Stretch and pin Mats right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

APRON: BAND: With Baby Pink, make a 64 " chain. Row 1: Dc in 9th st from hook, * (ch 2, sk 2 ch , dc in next ch) * repeated to measure 15 ", ch 5 , dc in same st (corner sp made); repeat from * to * to measure 27" and make corner sp ; repeat from * to ${ }^{*}$ for same number of sps as 1st side. Cut and rip excess chain. Row 2: Ch 5, turn, sk 1st sp, dc in next dc, * (ch 2, dc in next dc) repeated to center st of next corner sp , ch 5 , dc in same st; repeat from * around, making final dc in 3d st of end sp. Repeat Row 2 eight times. EDGE: Repeat Rnd 13 of Mat across end and down inner edge to 1st sp before 1 st corner angle, ch 3 , sk 2 sps ( 1 on each side of angle), sc in next dc; continue, working next corner angle in same way, then continue Rnd 13 to end of

LILY SIX STRAND FLOSS, Art. 21: 2 skeins Deep Yellow.

Nos. 13 and 7 Steel Crochet Hooks.
GAUGE: 9 sps-2"; 9 rows-2".
Work tightly for best results.
With Green and No. 13 hook, make 18" chain. Row 1: Tr in 12th ch from hook, (ch 3, sk 3 ch , tr in next ch ) 67 times. Cut and rip excess chain. Row 2: Ch 7, turn, sk 1st $\mathrm{sp}, \mathrm{tr}$ in next $\mathrm{tr},{ }^{*} \mathrm{ch} 1$, tr in 2d (center) st of next $\mathrm{sp}, \mathrm{ch} 1$, tr in next tr ( 2 half-sps made) ; repeat from * across to end $\operatorname{tr}$ ( 132 half-sps); ch 3 , $\operatorname{tr}$ in 4 th st of end sp. Row 3: Ch 7, turn, sk 1st sp , tr in next tr, (ch 1 , tr in next tr) 8 times ( 8 half-sps), * (ch 3, sk 1 tr , tr in next tr) twice ( 2 sps made), (ch 1, tr in next tr) 10 times; repeat from * 7 times; end row with $2 \mathrm{sps}, 8$ half-sps, ch 3, tr in 4th st of end sp. Row 4: Ch 7, turn, $\mathrm{sk} 1 \mathrm{st} \mathrm{sp}, \mathrm{tr}$ in next tr , (make 6 half-sps, 4 sps ) 9 times,


6 half-sps, ch 3, $\operatorname{tr}$ in 4 th st of end sp. Row 5: Ch 7, turn, tr in next tr, 4 half-sps, ( $6 \mathrm{sps}, 2$ half-sps) 8 times, $6 \mathrm{sps}, 4$ half-sps, 1 sp . Row 6: Ch 7, turn, tr in next tr, 2 half-sps, $64 \mathrm{sps}, 2$ half-sps, 1 sp . Continue, following Chart thru Row 10. Row 11: Ch 7, turn, tr in next tr, 6 half-sps, 25 sps , ( 3 tr in next sp , tr in next tr) 10 times ( 10 blks made), $25 \mathrm{sps}, 6$ half-sps, 1 sp . Row 12: Ch 7, turn, $\operatorname{tr}$ in next tr, 4 half-sps, 22 sps, 4 blks, $10 \mathrm{sps}, 4$ blks, $22 \mathrm{sps}, 4$ half-sps, 1 sp . Follow Chart to top (Row 34), then reverse Chart and work back thru Row 1 ( 68 rows); fasten off.

EDGE: Attach White to 4 th st of a corner sp , ch 3,2 dc in same st, * ( 3 dc in next sp , dc in next tr) repeated across; in corner sp make $3 \mathrm{dc}, 5$ dc in center st, 3 dc in bal. of sp , dc in next tr ; repeat from * around; make 2 dc in same st with 1st 2 dc , join to ch-3. Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in same st, sc in next $12 \mathrm{dc},^{* *} \mathrm{ch} 5$, sl st in last sc for a $p$, sc in next 3 dc , ch 9 , turn, sk sc at base of $p$, sl st in 3d sc to left, ch 1, turn, in lp make 11 sc and 1 sl st; * ch 1, sc in next 11 dc , a p, sc in next 14 dc , a p, sc in next 3 dc , ch 9 , turn, sl st in 3 d sc to left of p , ch 1 , turn, 11 sc and 1 sl st in lp ; repeat from * 8 times; sc in next 8 dc , ( $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{p}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in next (corner) dc, sc in next 2 dc , ch 11, turn, sl st in 3d sc to left of p, ch 1, turn, 13 sc and 1 sl st in lp, ch 1 , sc in next 10 dc ; repeat from ** around; end with 1 sc in same st with 1 st 2 sc , join to 1 st sc, ch 5 , sl st in same st, sl st in next 2 sc and make corner lp ; fasten off.

DAISY: With White, ch 9 , join with sl st to form ring. Rnd 1: Ch 3, 23 dc in ring, join to ch-3. Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in same st, sc in next dc, ${ }^{*}$ ch 36 , turn, sl st in 1st sc, ch 1 , turn, in half of lp make $1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{hdc}, 12 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{hdc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$, ch 4 and 1 sc ; turn this half of petal over to left (wrong-side-up) so top of sts is next other half of ch-lp. Going thru back lps only of sts and working over other half of ch-lp, make sc in 1st 2 sc to left of $p$, hdc in next 2 hdc, dc in next 12 dc , hdc in next 3 hdc , sc in end sc, sc in next 2 dc on ring; repeat from * thru 12 petals, join to 1st sc, fasten off. CENTER: With Six Strand Floss and No. 7 hook, ch 2, 6 sc in 2d ch from hook. Without joining, 2 sc in back lp of each sc ( 12 sc ). ( Sc in next sc , 2 sc in next sc) 6 times ( 18 sc ). Cup circle with right-side-inside, sc in 18 sc , sl st in next 4 sc , cut with 8 " sewing end. Sew around edge on center of Daisy leaving $1 / 4$ " open, stuff with cotton and finish sewing.
Make 12 Daisies and sew on doily as marked on Chart, hemming down edge of petals.

Stretch and pin doily right-side-down in a true square. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

Rnd 3: ( Sc in next sp , ch 2, in same sp make $1 \mathrm{dc}, 5$ tr , a ch-4 p, $5 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, ch 2 and sc) 6 times. Fasten off.
2d FLOWER: Join to 1 st Flower by $p$ on 6 th petal, making ch 2, sl st in a p on 1st Flower, ch 2, sl st back in last tr on 2d Flower and complete petal. Make and join 5 Flowers into a curve for each Section, leaving 1 petal free between joinings on inside of curve, 3 petals free on outside, joining groups by ps on adjoining outer petals. Sew inner edge of Flowers over edge of doily.

EDGE: Attach Lt. Blue to joining of 2 Flower groups, * (ch 14, sc in next petal) twice, ch 5, sc in 1st petal on next Flower; repeat from * 3 times; ch 14, sc in next petal, ch 14, sc in joining of Flower groups; repeat from * around; join. Rnd 2: ( $8 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch}-4 \mathrm{p}, 8 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in each ch-14 lp and ( $3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{p}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in each ch-5 lp, joining ps on $2 \mathrm{ch}-$ 14 lps between Flower groups.


SM. DOILY: SECTION: Work as for Lg. Doily, following Chart. Make 6. Work EDGE, joining Sections.

CENTER: Repeat Rnds 1 and 2 of Lg. Doily "CENTER". Blue to joining of 2 Flower groups, * (ch 14, sc in next petal) twice, ch 11, sc in 1st petal on next flower; repeat from * once; ch 14, sc in next petal, ch 14, sc in joining of Flower groups; repeat from * around; join. Rnd 2: ( $8 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch}-4 \mathrm{p}, 8 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in each ch-14 lp and ( $6 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{p}$, 6 sc ) in each ch-11 lp , joining ps on $2 \mathrm{ch}-14 \mathrm{lps}$ between Flower groups.

Make a 2d Sm. Doily. Stretch and pin doilies right-sidedown in true circles. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

Continue thru Row 145 at top of Chart, then reverse Chart and beg. at Row 46, work back thru Row 1. Where one or more blks are decreased at beg. of a row, ch 1, turn, sk 1st st, sl st to correct st to start next row.
FLOWER: Ch 8, join with sl st to form ring. Row 1: Ch $1,12 \mathrm{sc}$ in ring; join. Row 2: Ch 1 and working over last row, still inserting hook in center ring, make 15 sc , join. Row 3: Repeat Row 2 but make 18 sc , join; ch 1, turn, sl st in next sc. Make 28 Flowers.

PLACE MAT ( 12 " x 20 ") ; BOTTOM BORDER: Starting at bottom edge with Red, make a 19" chain. Row 1: Sk 4 ch , dc in next 3 ch , (ch 2, sk 2 ch , dc in next 4 ch ) repeated for 17". Cut and rip excess chain. Row 2: Ch 5, turn, sk 3 dc , dc in next dc, ( 2 dc in next sp , dc in next dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc , dc in next dc) repeated across; end by drawing White thru last 2 lps of final dc. Join each color in this way. Cut Red 6" long. Row 3: With White, ch 5 , turn, (sk sp, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc , de in next dc, ch 2) repeated across; make final dc in 3d st of end ch-5, drawing Green thru final 2 lps of dc. Drop White but do not cut. Row 4: With Green, ch 3, turn, 2 dc in 1st sp , dc in next dc, (ch 2, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next sp , dc in next dc) repeated across; make final dc in 3d st of end ch-5. Row 5: Repeat Row 2; end by drawing White up from previous row to join. Cut Green 6" long. Row 6: Repeat Row 3, joining Yellow thru final dc. Rows 7 \& 8: With Yellow, repeat Rows 4 \& 5; join White and cut Yellow 6" long. Row 9: Repeat Row 3, joining Red thru final dc. Working as previously, make 2 Red rows, 1 White row and 2 Green rows.

CENTER SECTION: Make 1 White row. * Next Row: With White, ch 5, turn, dc in next dc, (ch 2, dc in next dc) repeated across to 3 d st of end ch -5 . TULIP: Right Petal: With Red, ch 23, sk 1 ch, sc in next 2 ch , hdc in $2 \mathrm{ch},{ }^{*}$ holding back the last lp of each dc, make dc in next $2 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{Y} \mathrm{O}$ and draw thru all 3 lps on hook (Cluster-dec), dc in next ch; repeat from * twice; ** dc in $4 \mathrm{ch},{ }^{* *} 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next ch, 1 dc in next ch, 2 hdc in next ch, 1 hdc in next ch, sc in end ch. Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sk sc, sc in next 3 sts, 2 hdc in next st, 1 hdc in next st, 2 de in next st, ${ }^{* *}$ tr in next 10 sts, ${ }^{* *}$ dc in next 2 sts made into a dec, hdc in next st, sc in next st. Fasten off. Left Petal: Ch 23, sc in 2d ch, hde in $1 \mathrm{ch}, 2$ hdc in next ch, dc in $1 \mathrm{ch}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in 1 ch , ${ }^{* *}$ dc in next $5 \mathrm{ch},^{* *}$ (dc in next 2 ch made into a dec, 1 dc in next ch) twice, dc in 2 ch made into a dec, hdc in 2 ch , sc in 2 ch . Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sk sc, hdc in next st, dc in next 2 sts made into a dec, ${ }^{* *}$ tr in next 10 sts, ** 2 dc in next st, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next st, sc in 3 sts, sl st in end st. Fasten off. Center Petal: Ch 20 , sc in $2 \mathrm{~d} \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{hdc}$ in 2 sts, dc in 2 sts, ** tr in $11 \mathrm{ch},{ }^{* *}$ 2 dc in next ch, hdc in 1 ch , (sc, ch 2, sc) in end ch; on
other side of chain, hdc in next st, 2 dc in next st, ${ }^{* *}$ tr in 11 sts, ** dc in 2 sts, hdc in 2 sts, sc in end st. Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to tip, (sc, ch 2, sc) in tip ch-2, sc in each st to end. Fasten off. Sew side petals over sides of Center Petal. Make 2 Red and 2 Yellow Tulips.

STEM: With Green, ch 50 , in 4 th ch make dc, hdc, 2 sc , hdc, dc, ch 3 and sl st; sc in each remaining st of chain. Fasten off. Make 4. Sew top ends on base of tulips.
RIGHT LEAF: With Green, ch 40 , sk 1 ch , on bal. of chain make $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{hdc}, 25 \mathrm{dc}, 5$ hdc and 5 sc . Row 2: Ch 1 , turn, sk 1 sc, sl st in next st, sc in 4 sts, hde in 6 sts, dc in 21 sts, (dc in 2 sts made into a dec) twice, hdc in next st, sc in end st. Fasten off. Left Leaf: Ch 40, sk 1 ch , on bal. of chain make $5 \mathrm{sc}, 5 \mathrm{hdc}, 25 \mathrm{dc}, 2$ hdc and 2 sc . Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sk 1 sc , sc in next st, hde in next st, (dc in 2 sts made into a dec) twice, dc in 20 sts, hdc in 6 sts, sc in 5 sts, sl st in end st. Fasten off. Lap base of Right Leaf over Left Leaf and sew tog. Sew Stem on back of Leaves. Repeat for each Tulip. Sew Tulips on Mat, evenly spaced, alternating colors, across top of Bottom Border. Fringe: Wind White and 3 colors in turn around a $13 / 4$ " card, cut at one edge and tie 4 strands in each ch-3 lp across each end, matching colors to each row. Trim fringe evenly 1 " long.

CAFE CURTAIN ( 27 "' x 60 ") : Start with a 70 " Red chain and working as for Place Mat, make 1st Row 60 " long, then repeat Mat Border to *. Then make 2 rows Yellow, 1 row White, 2 rows Red, 1 row White and 2 rows Green, to complete Bottom Border. Make White mesh for $111 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. (Make 1 row Yellow as in Row 4, 4 rows White mesh, 1 row Green as in Row 4, 4 rows White mesh, 1 row Red as in Row 4, 4 rows White mesh) twice; then repeat top border and Edge as on Place Mat.

TULIP: RIGHT PETAL: With Red, ch 28 and work as for Place Mat except from ** to ${ }^{* *}$ in Row 1, change to dc in 9 ch ; and in Row 2, from ** to **, change to tr in 15 sts. Left Petal: Ch 28 and repeat Place Mat except from $* *$ to ${ }^{* *}$ in Row 1, change to dc in 10 ch ; and in Row 2, from ** to ${ }^{* *}$, change to $\operatorname{tr}$ in 15 sts. Center Petal: Ch 25 and repeat Place Mat except from ** to ** in 2 places in Row 1, change to tr in 16 ch . Make 6 Red and 5 Yellow Tulips.

STEM: With Green, ch 80 and repeat Stem on Place Mat.
RIGHT LEAF: With Green, ch 70, sk 1 ch , on bal. of chain make $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{hdc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}, 43 \mathrm{tr}, 10 \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{hdc}$ and 5 sc . Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sl st in 2 d sc , then make $5 \mathrm{sc}, 6$ hdc, $10 \mathrm{dc}, 38 \mathrm{tr}$, ( tr in 2 sts made into a dec) twice, dc in 2 sts made into a dec, 1 hdc and 1 sc . Fasten off.

LEFT LEAF: Ch 70, sk 1 ch , on bal. of chain make 5 sc , 5 hdc, $10 \mathrm{dc}, 43 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{dc}, 2$ hdc and 2 sc. Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in 2 d st, then make 1 hdc , dc in 2 sts made into a dec, ( tr in 2 sts made into a dec) twice, $38 \mathrm{tr}, 10 \mathrm{dc}, 6$ hdc, 5 sc , sl st. Fasten off.
Assemble Tulips as for Place Mat and sew on Curtain.
RING: Attach Red to a ring and cover closely with sc; join and cut, leaving a sewing end. Make 13. Stretch and pin Mat and Curtain right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth. Sew rings to top of Curtain, one to each corner and one above each Tulip.

Continue, following Chart, thru Row 64. Row 65: Ch 4, turn, de in next dc (half-sp), $5 \mathrm{sps}, 5$ blks, follow Chart across ending with 1 blk and 5 sps , tr in 3 d st of end sp (half-sp). Row 66: Ch 5, turn, sk 1st sp, dc in next dc, $20 \mathrm{sps}, 1$ blk and follow Chart across. Continue thru Row 73. Row 74: Ch 1, turn, sk tr and dc, sl st to next dc, ch 4, dc in next dc, $14 \mathrm{sps}, 2$ blks and follow Chart. Row 75: Ch 1 , turn, sk tr and dc, (sl st in next 2 ch , sl st in dc) twice, ch 4 , dc in next dc, $17 \mathrm{sps}, 2$ blks and complete row. Make Row 76 and fasten off. Row 77: Turn, sk halfsp and 12 sps , attach to next dc, ch 5, dc in next dc, 14 sps, 3 blks, $28 \mathrm{sps}, 1 \mathrm{blk}$ and 4 sps . Complete work thru Row 90. EDGE: Row 1: Ch 3, turn, 2 dc in next sp , dc in next dc, work around with 2 dc in each ch-2 sp, 3 dc in each ch-4 half-sp and 1 dc between sps. At angles $C$ and D, make 5 dc worked off tog into a Cluster. At corners B and A, make 5 dc in corner st. Join to ch-3. Row 2: Ch 1, sc in same st, sc in next 3 dc , ch 4, sl st in last sc for a p, (sc in next 9 dc , a p) repeated. At B corner, make $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{p}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in center dc, sc in next 2 dc , a $p$, (sc in next 9 dc, a p) repeated around, with A corner like B. Join and fasten off.

ARM REST DOILY: Ch 165. Row 1: Starting at A, dc in 9th ch, 14 sps , ( 1 Lacet St, 1 sp ) 7 times, 17 sps. Row 2: Ch 5, turn, dc in next dc, $6 \mathrm{sps}, 4$ blks, $6 \mathrm{sps}, 1 \mathrm{blk}$, ( 1 long $\mathrm{sp}, 1 \mathrm{sp}) 6$ times, 1 long $\mathrm{sp}, 8 \mathrm{blks}$ and 7 sps . Continue, following Chart, thru Row 84. EDGE: Repeat Row

BIRD: Body: Ch 24, sk 4 ch , dc in next $19 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in end ch. Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in 1st 2 dc , hdc in 3 dc , (dc in $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc) 4 times, hdc in 3 dc , sc in 2 dc. Fasten off. Tail: Ch 28, sk 4 ch , on bal. make $8 \mathrm{dc}, 8$ hdc and 8 sc . (Ch 1 , turn and working in back lps, make $24 \mathrm{sc} . \mathrm{Ch} 4$, turn and in back lps, make $8 \mathrm{dc}, 8 \mathrm{hdc}$ and 8 sc$) 4$ times. Fasten off. Wing: Ch 42, sk 1 ch , sc in next 30 ch , (draw up a lp in next $2 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{Y} \mathrm{O}$ and draw thru all 3 lps ) 5 times ( 5 decs), 2 sc in end ch. Row 2: Ch 1, turn and working all rows in back lps, 2 sc in 1st sc, sc in next 34 sc . Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sk $1 \mathrm{sc}, 23 \mathrm{sc} . \operatorname{Ch} 1$, turn, 21 sc. Ch 1, turn, sk 1 sc , 20 sc , hde down in next 2 sts on previous row, sc in next 3 sts, 3 sc-decs, 2 sc in end st. Row 4: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in 1st sc, 27 sc. Row 5: Ch 1, turn, sk $1 \mathrm{sc}, 17 \mathrm{sc}$. Ch 1, turn, 15 sc . Ch 1 , turn, sk 1 sc, $14 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{hdc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ and 3 decs. 2 sc in end st. Row 6: Ch 1, turn, 4 decs, 12 sc . Row 7: Ch 1 , turn, sk $1 \mathrm{sc}, 10 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{hdc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}-\mathrm{dec}$ and 2 hdc . Make 4 hdc across end, sl st in starting st. Fasten off.

CHAIR BACK: Sew Head to right end of Body, Tail to left. Sew Wing, long side down, on side of Body. Make a 2d BIRD with a double beak and sew tog, reversing
position. Repeat for one ARM REST DOILY. For 2d ARM REST, reverse Birds. Sew on doilies as given in Chart.

FLOWER: Ch 8, join with sl st to form ring. Rnd 1: Ch $1,12 \mathrm{sc}$ in ring, join to back lp of 1st sc. Rnd 2: * Ch 10, sl st in 5th ch from hook for a p, holding back the last lp of each dtr make 2 dtr in same sc, 2 dtr in back lp of next sc, Y O and draw thru all 5 lps on hook for a Cluster, ch 5, sl st in Cluster for a p, ch 5, sl st in 5th ch from hook for a p, ch 6, sl st in same sc on ring, sl st in next sc. Repeat from * 5 times. Fasten off. Make 20 for CHAIR BACK and 13 for each ARM REST DOILY. Sew in place as given by circles on Charts.
Stretch and pin doilies right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

Band, across end and around outside edge; join. Rnd 2: Repeat Rnd 14 of Mat, omitting ch- 5 between 2 dc at 2 lower inner corner angles. Rnd 3: Repeat Rnd 15 of Mat.

Make a row of 13 Flowers (as for Mat) for each side band. Connect with a row of 22 Flowers across lower band. Sew on band.
POCKET: Make a square of 4 Motifs as for Mat. Sew a Flower on each Motif.
Stretch and pin Band and Pocket right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth. Cut a piece of cloth to fit Band, allowing for narrow hems. Hem sides and lower edge and sew to Band. Gather top edge to measure 15 ". Make waistband and ties and sew in place. Sew Pocket in place.
