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
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

Mats are worked with a double strand of thread throughout

LARGE MAT—With White ch 73, s c in 2nd st from hook, \* d c in next st of ch, s c in next st of ch, repeat from \* to end of row, ending row with d c in last st of ch, ch 1, turn.

**2nd Row**—\* S c in d c, d c in next s c,repeat from \* across row, ch 1, turn.

Repeat 2nd row until mat measures  $5\frac{1}{2}$  inches, always ending row with a d c and ch 1 to turn.

Work a row of s c around entire mat, working 3 s c in each corner, having 70 s c on each long side and 47 s c on each short side, join, break thread.

Attach Red in center st of corner, s c in same space, ch 3, s c in same place, 1 s c in each s c, working all corners same as 1st corner, join.

**2nd Row**—SI st into loop, ch 1, s c in same space, ch 3, s c in same space, \* 1 s c in each s c to corner loop, 1 s c, ch 3, 1 s c in loop, repeat from \* all around ending row to correspond, join.

Repeat 2nd row 14 times.

With White "STAR" Six Strand Embroidery Cotton embroider designs in cross stitch according to chart. Each block of chart equals 2 rows in width and 2 s c in length.

SMALL MAT—With White ch 63 and work in same manner as large mat for 5½ inches. Work a row of s c around entire mat, working 3 s c in each corner and 59 s c on each long side and 48 s c on each short side. Attach Red and work same as large mat. Embroider in same manner omitting one design in each long side.

**MEDIUM MAT-TOP SECTION**—With Red and No. 7 hook, ch 7, join to form a ring, ch 3, 2 d c in ring leaving last loop of each d c on hook, thread over and pull through all loops at one time, \*\* ch 3, cluster st in ring (cluster st: \* thread over hook, insert in ring, pull through and work off 2 loops, repeat from \* twice, thread over and work off all loops at one time), repeat from \*\* 6 times, ch 3, join. **2nd Row**—Ch 1 and over each loop work 5 s c, join,

**3rd Row**—Attach White in same space, ch 4, 1 tr c in each of the next 4 s c, \* ch 3, 1 tr c in each of the next 5 s c, ch 7, 1 tr c in each of the next 5 s c, repeat from \* twice, ch 3, 1 tr c in each of the next 5 s c, ch 7, join, break thread.

**4th Row**—Attach Red in same space, s c in same space, 1 s c in each of the next 4 tr c, \* 2 s c, ch 3, 2 s c in next ch 3 loop, 1 s c in each of the next 5 tr c, 1 s c, 1 s d c,


3 d c in next loop, (s d c: thread over hook, insert in st, pull through, thread over and pull through all loops at one time) ch 5, sl st in top of last d c for picot, 3 d c, 1 s d c, 1 s c in same loop (corner), 1 s c in each of the next 5 tr c, repeat from \* twice, 2 s c, ch 3, 2 s c in next loop, 1 s c in each of the next 5 tr c, 1 s c , 1 s d c, 3 d c, picot, 3 d c, 1 s d c, 1 s c in next loop, join, break thread. Work a 2nd motif in same manner joining it to 1st motif in last row as follows: attach Red and work 1 s c in each of the next 5 tr c, 2 s c, ch 3, 2 s c in next ch 3 loop, 1 s c in each of the next 5 tr c, 1 s c, 1 s d c, 3 d c in next loop, ch 2, join to corresponding picot of 1st motif, ch 2, complete picot, 3 d c, 1 s d c, 1 s c in same loop of 2nd motif, 1 s c in each of the next 5 tr c, 2 s c in next loop, ch 1, sl st in corresponding picot loop of 1st motif, ch 1, 2 s c in same space of 2nd motif, 1 s c in each of the next 5 tr c, 1 s c, 1 s d c, 3 d c in next loop, ch 2, sl st in corresponding picot of 1st motif, ch 2, complete picot, 3 d c, 1 s d c, 1 s c in same space, finish motif same as 1st motif. Join 3rd motif to 2nd motif and 4th motif to 3rd and 1st motifs in same manner. Join remaining motifs in same manner having 12 motifs 3 x 4 for medium size mat.

**BACK SECTION**—With White "STAR" Rug Yarn and No. 00 Hook ch 35, d c in 4th st from hook, 1 d c in each remaining st of ch, ch 3, turn.

**2nd Row**—1 d c in each d c, ch 3, turn. Repeat the last row 9 times, break yarn. With Red and No. 7 hook, work a row of s c all around working 5 s c in each corner, join, break thread leaving an end. Thread into needle and sew to wrong side of top section leaving the Red row of top section extended over the back section. For small mat work 9 motifs for top section having 3 motifs lengthwise and 3 motifs crosswise. For back section with "STAR" Rug Yarn and No. 00 hook, ch 28 and work in same manner as medium size mat working 15 motifs 3 x 5 for top section.

For large mat work 15 motifs 3 x 5 for top section. For back section with "STAR" Rug Yarn and No. 00 hook, ch 45 and work in same manner as medium size mat, working same amount of rows.

**TOP SECTION**—With Shaded Yellows ch 7, join to form a ring, ch 5, d c in ring, \* ch 3, d c in ring, repeat from \* 5 times ch 3 join

\* 5 times, ch 3, join.

2nd Row—Ch 1, over each loop work 1 s c, 5 d c, 1 s c,

3rd Row—\* Ch 5, s c between next 2 petals in back of work, repeat from \* 7 times.

4th Row—Ch 1, over each loop work 1 s c, 7 d c, 1 s c,

5th Row—\* Ch 6, s c between next 2 petals in back of work, repeat from \* 7 times, break thread.

6th Row—Attach Green in loop, ch 1, over each loop work 1 s c, 1 d c, 7 tr c, 1 d c, 1 s c, join, break Green.
7th Row—Attach White in 2nd tr c of Green petal, ch 5, skip 3 tr c, s c in next tr c, \* ch 3, tr c between petals, ch 3, s c in 2nd tr c of next petal, ch 5, skip 3 tr c, s c in next tr c, repeat from \* all around ending row with ch 3, tr c between petals, ch 3, join. Continued—Page 15

3rd Row—Working in back loop of st only, 1 s c in each

**3rd Row**—Working in back loop of st only, 1 s c in each of the next 23 s c, 3 s c in next s c, 1 s c in each of the next 21 s c, ch 3, turn.

4th Row—Working in front loop of st only, 1 s c in each of the next 21 s c, 2 s c in next s c, 3 s c in next s c, 2 s c in next s c, 1 s c in each of the next 21 s c, ch 3, turn

5th Row—Working in back loop of st only, 1 s c in each of the next 24 s c, 3 s c in next s c, 1 s c in each of the next 21 s c, ch 3, turn. All the even numbered rows are worked in front loop of st and all the odd numbered rows are worked in back loop only Ch 3 to turn all rows.

6th Row—1 s c in each of the next 21 s c, 2 s c in next s c, 3 s c in next s c, 2 s c in next s c, 1 s c in each of the next 22 s c.

7th Row—1 s c in each of the next 25 s c, 3 s c in next s c, 1 s c in each of the next 22 s c. Continued—Page 15

2nd Round—Ch 1, 3 s c in same space, 1 s c in each of the next 8 s c, 3 s c in next s c, 1 s c in each of the next 8 s c, join in 1st s c.


3rd Round—1 s c in each s c on sides and 2 s c in each of the 3 center s c at each end, join.

4th Round—1 s c in each s c on sides and 3 s c in center st at each end, join, drop Yellow. (When changing Color always complete last half of st with next Color).

5th Round—Attach White and work 2 s c in each of the 5 sts at each end and 1 s c in each s c on sides, drop

6th Round—With Yellow ch 3 (counts as 1 d c) and work 1 d c in each s c on sides and 3 d c in each of the 3 center sts at each end, join, break Yellow.

7th Round—With White 1 s c in each d c having 55 s c in this round, break White.



9th Row—1 d c in each d c, ch 3, turn.
10th Row—\* 2 d c in next d c, 1 d c in next d c, repeat from \* 6 times, ch 3, turn.

11th Row—Same as 9th row.

12th Row—\* 2 d c in next d c, 1 d c in each of the next 2 d c, repeat from \* across row, ch 3, turn.


13th Row—Same as 9th row.

14th Row—\* 2 d c in next st, 1 d c in each of the next 2 sts, repeat from \* once, 2 d c in next st, 1 s d c in each of the next 5 sts (s d c: thread over hook, insert in st, pull through, thread over and work off all loops at one time), 1 s c in each of the next 3 sts, 1 s d c in each of the next 5 sts, \* 2 d c in next st, 1 d c in each of the next 2 sts, repeat from \* once, 2 d c in next d c, 1 d c in next d c, ch 3, turn.

15th Row—Decrease in next 2 sts (to decrease: \* thread over hook, insert in next st, pull through and work off 2 loops, repeat from \*, thread over and work off 3 loops at one time), 1 d c in each of the next 9 sts, 1 s d c in

2nd Row—Working in s c, decrease 1 s c at the beginning and end of row (to decrease: insert hook in st, pull loop through, insert hook in next st, pull through, yarn over and work off all loops at one time).

3rd Row-Work even, drop Brown, attach Blue (when changing Color always complete the last half of st with next Color).

4th Row-Keeping Brown in back of work and working over Brown decrease in 1st 2 sts, 1 s c in each of the next 17 sts, drop Blue, pick up Brown, 1 s c in each of the next 6 s c, decrease in next 2 sts.

5th Row—1 s c in each of the next 6 s c, drop Brown, pick up Blue, 1 s c in each remaining s c.

6th Row—Decrease in 1st 2 sts, 1 s c in each of the next 17 s c, drop Blue, pick up Brown, 1 s c in each of the next 3 s c, decrease in next 2 sts.

7th Row—1 s c in each of the next 3 s c, drop Brown, pick up Blue, 1 s c in each remaining s c.

8th Row-Decrease in 1st 2 sts, 1 s c in each of the next 18 s c, break Blue, pick up Brown, decrease in next 2 sts, break yarn, do not turn.

9th Row—Attach Cream in 2nd st from beginning of row,

s c in same space, 1 s c in each of the next 17 s c, turn. 10th Row—3 s c in 1st s c, 1 s c in each remaining s c. 11th Row—Working in s c decrease 2 s c at end of row. 12th Row—Decrease in 1st 2 sts, 1 s c in each remaining 13th Row—Increase 1 s c at end of row.

14th Row—Increase 1 s c at beginning of row. Work 1 row even.

16th Row-Same as 14th row.

17th Row—Work same as 13th row, ch 7, turn.
18th Row—S c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s c in each of the next 5 sts of ch, 1 s c in each s c.

19th Row—Decrease 1 s c at end of row. Work 1 row

Repeat the last 2 rows 4 times.

29th Row—Decrease 2 s c at end of row.

30th Row—Decrease in 1st 2 sts at beginning of row.

31st Row—1 s c in each of the 1st 19 s c, sl st in last s c. 32nd Row—Skip the sl st, 1 s c in each remaining s c.

33rd Row—1 s c in each s c and 1 s c in ch 1 at end of row, break yarn, do not turn.

34th Row—Attach Beige in 1st s c, 1 s c in each s c working 2 s c in last s c.

35th Row—Increase 1 s c at the beginning and end of row. 36th Row-Increase 2 s c at end of row. Work 1 row even.

38th Row-Increase 1 s c at end of row.

39th Row—Increase 1 s c at beginning of row, break yarn, turn.

40th Row—Attach Blue and work same as 38th row, break

Blue, do not turn. 41st Row—Attach Brown in 1st s c and work same as last

row, break yarn.

HANDLE: With Brown ch 5, s d c in 2nd st from hook (s d c: yarn over hook, insert in st, pull loop through, yarn over and pull through all loops at one time), s d c in next st of ch, 1 s c in next st, sl st in last st, ch 1, turn.

2nd Row—SI st in 1st st, 1 s c in next s c, 1 s d c in each of the next 2 sts, ch 1, turn.

3rd Row-1 s d c in each of the next 2 s d c, s c in next s c, sl st in next sl st. Repeat the last 2 rows 3 times.

10th Row-1 s c in each st, ch 1, turn. Repeat the last row 11 times.

22nd Row—Same as 2nd row.
23rd Row—Same as 3rd row. Repeat the last 2 rows 3 times, break yarn. Sew handle in position.

With Cream work a row of s c all around all Colored sections.

With Black embroider eye and ear in an outline st. With Black embroider mustache and eye brows with satin st. With Red "Star" Six Strand Embroidery Cotton embroider mouth in satin st. With Blue embroider eyes in satin st.

BUTTONS: With Yellow ch 2 and work 8 s c in 2nd st from hook, join, break thread.

2nd Row—Attach Golden Brown and work 2 s c in each st, join, break thread. Work 2 more buttons in same manner Sew in position.

**LARGE MAT**—With White ch 15, 2 d c in 4th st from hook, 3 d c in next st of ch, 1 d c in each of the next 8 sts of ch, 3 d c in each of the next 2 sts of ch, working on opposite side of ch, 3 d c in next st, 1 d c in each of the next 8 sts, 3 d c in next st, join in 3rd st of ch.

**2nd Row**—\* Ch 3, 2 d c in same space, sl st in next d c (slanted shell), repeat from \* twice, \* ch 3, 2 d c in same space, skip 1 d c, sl st in next d c, repeat from \* once, \* ch 3, 2 d c in same space, skip 2 d c, sl st in next st, repeat from \* once, \* ch 3, 2 d c in same space, skip 1 d c, sl in next st, repeat from \* once, repeat from beginning all around ending row with sl st in 1st st of ch. **3rd Row**—\* 3 d c in next sl st (shell), sl st in top of next slanted shell, repeat from \* all around.

4th Row—SI st to center d c of next shell, \* shell in next sl st, sl st in center d c of next shell, repeat from \* all around.

5th Row—SI st to center of next shell, \* 5 d c shell in next sl st, sl st in center d c of next shell, repeat from \* twice, \* 3 d c shell in next sl st, sl st in center d c of next shell, repeat from \* 5 times, repeat from 1st \* all around.
6th Row—Ch 1, 3 s c in same space, \* skip 1 d c of next shell, 1 sl st in each of the next 3 d c, skip 1 d c, 3 s c in next sl st, repeat from \* twice, \* sl st in center d c of next shell, 3 s c in next sl st, repeat from \* 5 times, repeat from 1st \* all around ending row to correspond.
7th Row—Ch 5 skip 1 st d c in next st \* ch 2 skip 1

7th Row—Ch 5, skip 1 st, d c in next st, \* ch 2, skip 1 st, d c in next st, repeat from \* all around ending row with ch 2, join in 3rd st of ch (even number of meshes).

8th Row—SI st into mesh, ch 5, d c in next mesh, \* ch 2, d c in next mesh, repeat from \* all around ending row with ch 2, join in 3rd st of ch.

9th Row—5 d c shell in next d c, sl st in next d c, repeat from beginning all around, break yarn. The pattern is darned in working over 1 d c and under the next d c. Reverse the over and under of every other strand of yarn. 1st Mesh—1 strand Blue, 1 strand Yellow, 1 strand Green and 1 strand Black.

2nd Mesh—1 strand Black, 1 strand Green, 1 strand Blue, 1 strand Yellow, 1 strand Red and 1 strand Black. MEDIUM MAT—With White ch 11, 2 d c in 4th st from hook, 3 d c in next st of ch, 1 d c in each of the next 4 sts of ch, 3 d c in each of the next 2 sts of ch, working on opposite side of ch, 3 d c in next st, 1 d c in each of the next 4 sts. 3 d c in next st, ioin.





Continue from the 7th row of large mat.

**CENTER MOTIF:** With Yellow ch 7, join to form a ring, ch 1 and work 16 s c in ring, join, break thread.

**2nd Row**—Attach Shaded Pinks ch 4 (counts as part of 1st popcorn st) 4 tr c in same space, slip loop off hook, insert in 4th st of ch, pull loop through, ch 1 to tighten st, \* ch 3, skip 1 s c, popcorn st in next st (popcorn st: 5 tr c in same space, drop loop from hook, insert in 1st tr c, pull loop through, ch 1 to tighten st), repeat from \* 6 times, ch 3, join in 1st popcorn st, break thread.

**3rd Row**—Attach White and work 1-7 tr c popcorn st over each loop and having ch 4 between each popcorn st, join, break thread.





12th Row—Attach White in ch 3 loop, ch 3, 1 d c, ch 2, 2 d c in same space, \* ch 2, 2 d c, ch 2, 2 d c in next ch 3 loop, repeat from \* all around, ch 2, join, break thread.

UNDER SECTION—With White ch 2, 8 s c in 2nd st from hook, join.

2nd Row—Ch 3, d c in same space, \* 2 d c in next s c, repeat from \* all around, join in 3rd st of ch.

3rd Row—Ch 3, d c in same space, \* 2 d c in next d c, repeat from \* all around, join each row.

4th and 5th Rows—Working in d c increase in every other

6th Row-Increase in every 3rd d c, then work 1 row

8th Row-Increase in every 4th d c, then work 1 row even.

10th Row—Ch 1 and work 1's c in each d c (120 s c).

11th Row—Ch 3, 1 d c in same space, ch 2, 2 d c in next s c, \* ch 2, skip 3 s c, 2 d c in next s c, ch 2, 2 d c in next s c, repeat from \* all around, join, break thread. With White and holding top section toward you, crochet the 2 sections together as follows: attach White in center of any shell, ch 3, d c in same space, ch 4, sl st in 4th st from hook for picot, 2 d c in same space, \* ch 3, s c in next loop, ch 3, 2 d c in center of next shell, ch 4, sl st in 4th st from hook for picot, 2 d c in same space, repeat 14 times, then working on top section only, repeat from \* around remainder of holder Finish under section opening in same manner. Work another top section and under section in same manner Slip over each side of napkin holder and tack at lower edge.

Next Row—Attach White in 1st tr c, ch 4, tr c in same space, \* 2 tr c in next tr c, repeat from \* all around, join, break White.

Next Row—Attach Green in last tr c of scallop, s c in same space, 1 s c in each of the next 2 tr c, \* ch 3, 1 s c in each of the next 3 tr c, repeat from \* all around, join, break thread.

LARGE MAT-Top Section: Work 1st 11 rows of top section same as small mat.

12th and 13th Rows—SI st into loop, ch 3 and work 2 popcorn sts with ch 2 between in same space, \* 1 d c in each d c of next d c group, 2 popcorn sts with ch 2 between in next loop, repeat from \* all around, ending row to correspond, join.

14th Row—Work same as 9th row increasing in each d c section in same manner.
