Doily measures 14 inches in diameter
Starting at center with Green, ch 12. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: Ch 4, 32 tr in ring. Join with sl st to top of ch-4. 2nd rnd: Ch 4, tr in same place as sl st, 2 tr in each tr around. Join. 3rd rnd: Ch 4 , tr in each tr around. Join. 4th rnd: Ch 5, * tr in next tr, ch 1. Repeat from * around. Join to 4th ch of ch-5. 5th rnd: Ch 6, * tr in next tr, ch 2. Repeat from *

around. Join. 6th rnd: Sl st in next sp , sc in same sp, * ch 5 , sc in 3rd ch from hook (picot made), ch 8, sc in 3rd ch from hook (another picot made), ch 2, skip 2 sps , sc in next sp. Repeat from ${ }^{*}$ around. Join. 7th rnd: Sl st to center of next loop (between picots), ch 4, in same sp make 2 tr , ch 3 and 3 tr (shell made); * ch 3, in next loop between picots make 3 tr , ch 3 and 3 tr . Repeat from * around. Join. 8th rnd: Sl st in next 2 tr and next sp , ch 4 , in same sp make 2 tr , ch 3 and $3 \operatorname{tr}$ (shell made over shell); * ch 3, shell in sp of next shell. Repeat from * around. Join. 9th rnd: * Shell over shell, ch 4. Repeat from * around. Join. 10th, 11th and 12th rnds: Shell over each shell, having 1 ch more between shells on each rnd. Join. Break off at end of 12th rnd.

DAFFODIL (Make 11) . . . Starting at base of Daffodil, with Yellow, ch 5 . Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: $\mathrm{Ch} 4,11 \mathrm{tr}$ in ring. Sl st in top of ch-4. 2nd rnd: $\mathrm{Ch} 4, \mathrm{tr}$ in same place as sl st, * tr in next $2 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{tr}$ in next tr (1 tr increased). Repeat from * around. Join. 3rd rnd: Sc in same place as sl st, sc in each tr around. 4th rnd: Sc in each sc around. 5th to 15th rnds incl: Sc in each sc around, increasing 2 sc evenly in each rnd, being careful that increases do not fall over each other. 16th rnd: $\mathrm{Ch} 4, \mathrm{tr}$ in each sc around. Join. 17th and 18th rnds: Ch 4, tr in each st around, increasing 3 tr evenly around. Join. 19th rnd: Sc in same place as sl st, * ch S, sc in next tr. Repeat from * around. Sl st in first sc. Break off.

PETAL (Make 6) . . . Starting at base of petals, ch 18 . Join with sl st to form ring.
FIRST PETAL . . . 1st row: Ch 4, 4 tr in ring. Ch 4, turn. 2nd row: Tr in first tr , tr in next $3 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{tr}$ in top of turning chain. Ch 4, turn. 3rd and 4th rows: $\operatorname{Tr}$ in first $t r, t r$ in each $t r$ across, 2 tr in top of turning chain. Ch 4, turn. 5th row: Skip first tr, tr in each tr and in top of turning chain. Ch 4, turn. 6th row: Skip first tr, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr make tr in next 2 tr , thread over and draw through all loops on hook (a joint tr made), tr in next 4 tr ; holding back on hook the last loop of each tr make tr in next tr and tr in top of turning chain and complete joint tr as before. Ch 4, turn. 7th row: Skip first tr, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr make tr in next tr and in each following $\mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{tr}$ in top of turning chain, thread over and draw through all loops on hook. Break off.

SECOND PETAL . . . Attach thread to ring, ch 4, 4 tr in ring, ch 4, turn and complete as for First Petal. Make 4 more petals in this manner.

Attach thread at base of petal, 2 sc in $\mathrm{sp}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sp , in next sp make 2 sc and 3 half dc; 5 dc in next sp, 7 dc in next sp , in next sp make 3 half dc and $2 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{dc}$ in top sp . Work along side to correspond. Continue in this manner all around outer edges of all petals.
Insert flower through ring of petals and sew in place. Sew stamens in place. Apply sizing to stiffen flowers in order to preserve shape. Sew flowers around doily as follows: Tack tips of 2 petals of each flower to 2 shells on last shell rnd of doily and tack together the points of the side petals of adjacent flowers.

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MATERIALS: J. \& P. Coats or Clark's O.N.T. Best Six Cord Mercerized Crochet, Size 30, 1 ball (Small Ball) of Yellow, Size 100, 1 ball of White . . . J. \& P. Coats or Clark's O.N.T. Pearl Cotton, Size 5, 1 ball each of White and Dark Orange . . . Clark's O.N.T. "Bril. liant," 1 ball of Hunter's Green. 1/2 yard of yellow organdy . . . Steel Crochet Hooks No. 10 and No. 14.

CROCHETED BORDER . . . Starting at one corner with Yellow and No. 10 hook, ch 27. 1st row: Tr in

11th ch from hook, (ch 3, skip 3 ch , tr in next ch) 4 times. Ch 7, turn. 2nd to 5th rows incl: Skip first tr, tr in next tr, (ch 3, tr in next tr) 3 times; ch 3, skip 3 ch , tr in next ch. (One scallop completed). Ch 7, turn. 6th row: Skip first $\mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{tr}$ in next tr , (ch 3, tr in next tr ) twice. Ch 7, turn. 7th, 8th and 9th rows: Skip first tr , tr in next tr, ch 3, tr in next tr, ch 3, skip 3 ch , tr in next ch. Ch 7, turn. 10th row: Repeat 9th row making ch 14 (instead of ch-7) to turn. 11th row: (This starts second scallop.) Tr in 11th ch from hook, (ch 3, tr in next
tr) 3 times; ch 3, skip 3 ch , tr in next ch. Ch 7, turn. Repeat 2nd to 11th rows incl, until 7 scallops (sections of 5 sps ) have been completed. Break off. This completes one long side.

Attach thread to corner of first sp on last row and, working along side of this section, make ch 7 , skip first sp, tr in next st, (ch 3, skip next sp, tr in next st) twice. Ch 7, turn. Continue making scallops as before until there are 5 sections of 5 sps , including the corner section, which was the last section of the long side. Work other sides

MATERIALS: J. \& P. Coats or Clark's O.N.T. Best Six Cord Mercerized Crochet, Size 30, 3 balls (Small Balls) of White . . J. \& P. Coats Tatting-Crochet, Size 70, 1 ball of Blue
J. \& P. Coats or Clark's O.N.T. Pearl Cotton, Size S, 1 ball of Orange . . . Steel Crochet Hooks No. 10 and No. 14.

## Doily measures $11 \times 16$ inches

Starting at one side, with White and No. 10 hook make a chain 17 inches long ( 15 ch sts to 1 inch). 1st row: Holding back on hook the last loop of each $\operatorname{tr}$ make 2 tr in 5th ch from hook, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (cluster made), skip 8 ch , sc in next ch, * (ch 5 and complete a cluster as before in

Sth ch from hook) twice; skip 5 ch, sc in next ch. Repeat from * across until row measures $151 / 2$ inches, ending with an sc. Cut off remaining chain. Ch 11, turn. 2nd row: Make a 2 -tr cluster in 5th ch from hook, sc between first 2 clusters, * (ch 5 and complete a cluster in 5 th ch from hook) twice; skip 2 clusters, sc between the 2nd cluster skipped and the following cluster. Repeat from * across, ending with 2 clusters, skip last 2 clusters, sc in next st. Ch 11, turn. Repeat 2nd row until piece measures $101 / 2$ inches. Ch 8 to turn at end of last row. Next row: Sc between first 2 clusters, * ch 5, skip 2 clusters, sc between the 2nd cluster skipped and the following cluster. Repeat from * across,
ending with ch 5, skip last 2 clusters, sc in next ch. Now work 2 rnds of sc closely around outer edges, making sc's as necessary at corners to keep work flai and joining each rnd. 3rd rnd: * Sc in next 5 sc , ch 5 , sc in 5 th ch from hook (picot made). Repeat from * around. Join and break off.

FORGET-ME-NOT (Make 100) . . .
Starting at center with Blue and No. 14 hook, ch 5, 2 tr in 5th ch from hook, ch 4, sc in same place, (ch 4, 2 tr in same place, ch 4, sc in same place) 3 times. Break off.

Tack Forget-me-nots in place on doily at joinings of clusters as in illustration, making a French knot with Orange Pearl Cotton through center of each flower. Starch lightly and press.

## Doily measures 14 inches in diameter

Starting at center ch 6. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: 8 sc in ring. 2nd rnd: 2 sc in each sc around. 3rd rnd: Sc in each sc around. 4th rnd: * Ch 20, skip 1 sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from * around. Join and break off. 5th rnd: Attach thread to any loop, ch 4, 3 tr in same loop, ch 4, sc in top of last tr made (picot), 3 tr in same loop, * ch 8 , make 4 tr , picot and 3 tr in' next loop. Repeat from * around, ending with ch $3, \mathrm{~d}$ tr in top of starting chain. 6th rnd: $\mathrm{Ch} 4,3$ tr in
same sp , picot, 3 tr in same $\mathrm{sp}, *$ ch 11 , in next sp make 4 tr , picot and 3 tr . Repeat from * around. Join. 7th rnd: Sl st in next 3 tr and in next picot, ch 4, 7 tr in same picot, * ch 9, sc in next sp , ch 9, 8 tr in next picot loop. Repeat from * around. Join. 8th rnd: Ch 4, tr in next $2 \mathrm{tr},{ }^{*}$ ch 4, sl st in next $2 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 4, \mathrm{tr}$ in next 3 tr , ch 4 , sc in next loop, ch 8, sc in next loop, ch 4, tr in next 3 tr . Repeat from * around. Join. 9th rnd: $\mathrm{Ch} 4, \mathrm{tr}$ in next $2 \mathrm{tr}, * \operatorname{tr}$ in top of next ch, ch 15, tr in top of next ch, tr in next 3 tr , ch 5 , skip next sp , sc in next loop, ch 5 , tr in next 3 tr . Repeat from * around. Join. 10th rnd: Ch 4, tr in next $3 \mathrm{tr}, * 18 \mathrm{tr}$ in next sp , tr in next 4 tr , ch 5 , tr in next 4 tr. Repeat from * around. Join. 11th rnd: Ch 4, tr in next 3 tr, * (ch 10, skip 7 tr, tr in next 4 tr ) twice; tr in next 4 tr. Repeat from * around. Join. 12th rnd: Ch 4 , tr in next 3 tr, * ch 2 , skip 1 ch , tr in next ch, (ch 1 , skip $1 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{tr}$ in next ch) 4 times; ch 1, skip 1 tr, ( tr in next tr, ch 1) twice; $t r$ in next ch, (ch 1, skip $1 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{tr}$ in next ch) 4 times; ch $2, \mathrm{tr}$ in
next 8 tr . Repeat from * around. Join. 13th rnd: Ch 6, tr tr in next 3 tr, * ch 9, skip 4 tr , sl st in next tr, across next 3 sps and following tr, ch 9, skip $4 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{tr} \mathrm{tr}$ in next $4 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 6, \mathrm{tr} \operatorname{tr}$ in next 4 tr . Repeat from * around. Join. 14th rnd: $\mathrm{Ch} 4, \mathrm{tr}$ in next 3 tr tr , * (ch 1 , skip 1 st, tr in next st) 12 times; ch 1 , trin next $4 \mathrm{tr} \mathrm{tr}, 12 \mathrm{tr}$ in next sp , tr in next 4 tr tr . Repeat from * around. Join. 15th rnd: Ch 4, tr in next 3 tr , * ch 7, skip 5 sps , tr in next sp , tr in next 2 tr , tr in next sp , ch 7 , skip 5 sps , tr in next 4 tr , ch 6 , skip 4 tr , tr in next tr, ch 6, skip 2 tr , tr in next tr , ch 6 , skip 4 tr , tr in next 4 tr . Repeat from * around. Join. 16th rnd: Ch 4, tr in next 3 tr, * ( tr in next 7 ch , tr in next $4 \mathrm{tr}) \mathrm{twice}$; (ch 6, tr in next sp) 3 times; ch 6, tr in next 4 tr. Repeat from * around. Join. 17th rnd: Ch 4, tr in next 2 tr, * ch 4, sl st in next $20 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 4, \operatorname{tr}$ in next 3 tr , (ch 7, tr in next sp) 4 times; ch 7, tr in next 3 tr. Repeat from * around. Join. 18th rnd: Ch 4, $\operatorname{tr}$ in next $2 \mathrm{tr},{ }^{*} \mathrm{tr}$ in top of next 2 chains, tr in next 3 tr, (ch 7, tr in next $s p$ ) 5 times; ch $7, \operatorname{tr}$ in next 3 tr.

of next ch-4, tr in next 2 tr , tr in next ch, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (another cluster made). Repeat from * around ( 12 petals). Join and break off. 4th rnd: Attach White at tip of any cluster, in each sp around make 7 sc , ch 3 and 7 sc ; sl st in first sc ( 12 points made). Sth rnd: Sl st in next 7 sc and in next ch-3 loop, ch 4, in same loop make tr, ch 4 and 2 tr ; * ch 7, in next ch-3 loop make 2 tr , ch 4 and 2 tr . Repeat from * around. Join with sl st to top of ch-4. 6th rnd: Sl st in next tr and in next sp, ch 4 , in same sp make tr, ch 4 and 2 tr ; * ch 4, sc in next sp, ch 3, sc in same sp , ch 4, in next sp make 2 tr , ch 4 and 2 tr . Repeat from * around. Join. 7th rnd: Sl st in next tr and in next sp , ch 4 , in same sp make tr , ch 5 and 2 tr ; * ch 6 , skip next sp , sc in next loop, ch 6, skip next sp, in next sp between tr's make 2 tr , ch 5 and 2 tr . Repeat from * around. Join. 8th rnd: Sl st in
next tr and in next sp , ch 4, make 10 tr in same sp, * ch 3 , tr in each of next 2 sps , ch 3, 11 tr in next sp. Repeat from ${ }^{*}$ around. Join. 9th rnd: Ch 5, ( tr in next tr , ch 1) 9 times; * tr in next tr, ch 5 , sc in each of next 2 ch-3 sps; ch 5, (tr in next tr, ch 1) 10 times. Repeat from * around. Join to 4th ch of ch-5. 10th rnd: Ch 6, * (tr in next tr, ch 2) 9 times; tr in next 2 tr, ch 2 . Repeat from * around, ending with tr in last tr. Join to 4th ch of ch-6. 11th rnd: Sl st in next sp, (ch 5 , sc in next sp ) 3 times; * ch 4, skip next tr, in next tr make t , ch 5 and tr ; ch 4, skip next sp, sc in next sp, (ch 5, sc in next ch-2 sp) 7 times. Repeat from * around. Join and break off.

## FLOWER MOTIF (Make 12)—First

 Motif . . . With Yellow work as for Center until 3rd rnd is completed. 4th rnd: Attach White at tip of any cluster, Continued on page 10

Coats or Clark's O.N.T. Six Strand Embroidery Floss, 1 skein of Colonial Brown $\ldots$ A piece of pink organdy, $12 \times 18$ inches.

APPLE BLOSSOM (Make 12) . . . Starting at center with Pink and No. 14 hook, ch 10. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: Ch 1, 25 sc in ring. Join.

Now work petals individually as follows.

FIRST PETAL . . . 1st row: 2 sc in next 5 sc . Ch 1 , turn. 2nd to 7 th rows incl: Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. Do not turn at end of 7th row.
SECOND PETAL . . . Sl st in end sc of each row. Next row: 2 sc in next s sc on center. Ch 1, turn. Work as for First Petal. Complete other petals to correspond.

Make a narrow hem around outer edge of organdy. Using 3 strands of Embroidery Floss, embroider blanket stitch around outer edge of Mat. Em-
broider a French knot between each ba of blanket stitch.

STEM . . . Using Brown Pearl Cotto double and No. 10 hook make a chai1 6 inches long, make 6 lengths of chain each 3 inches long, and 5 lengths, eacl 4 inches long.
Sew these chains to Mat, to form : branch as shown in illustration. Sev an Apple Blossom to end of each stem With Yellow make a chain 2 inche long, sew to center of Apple Blossom making 5 loops (for stamens). Com plete all flowers in this manner. Starcl lightly and press.

Starting at center with Green and No. 13 hook, ch 10 , join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: 16 sc in ring, sl st in first sc made. 2nd rnd: $S c$ in same place as sl st, * ch 5, skip 1 sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 5 . 3rd rnd: * Sc in next sc, 2 sc in ch-5 sp, ch 5. Repeat from * around. 4th to 17th rnds incl: * Skip first sc, sc in each remaining sc of sc group, 2 sc in ch-5 sp, ch 5 . Repeat from * around; on 17th rnd end with the 17 sc of last group. 18th rnd: Ch 5 , * skip 1 sc , sc in next 1 scc ch 5 , sc in ch- 5 sp , ch 5 . Repeat from * around. 19th rnd: * Skip 1 sc, sc in next 13 sc ; (ch 5, sc in next loop) twice; ch 5. Repeat from * around. Continue in this manner, having 2 sc less in each sc group and 1 loop more between sc groups on each rnd until 1 sc remains in each sc group, and ending with ch 5, sc in loop preceding first sc.

Now work as follows: 26th to 30th rnds incl: * Ch 6, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around ( 72 loops). 31st rnd: Ch 7, sc in next loop, ch 7, sc in same loop ( 1 loop increased), inc 8 more loops evenly around ( 81 loops). 32nd to 40th rads incl: * Ch 7, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join and break off at end of 40th rnd.

FIRST PANSY . . . Starting at center with Shaded Lavender and No. 10 hook, ch 6. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: Ch 3, 2 dc in ring, (ch 7, 3 dc in ring) 4 times; ch 7. Join with sl st to top of ch-3. 2nd rnd: Ch 3, (skip 1 dc , dc in next dc, 15 tr in next sp , dc in next dc) 3 times; * skip 1 dc , dc in next dc, ch 1 , in next sp make (tr, ch 1) twice; (d tr, ch 1) 3 times; ( tr tr , ch 1) 5 times; ( d tr, ch 1) 3 times and ( $\mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{ch} 1$ ) twice; dc in next dc, ch 1. Repeat from * until another large petal is
completed. Join and break off. Make 8 more Lavender Pansies, 9 Yellow and 9 Fuchsia.

To Join Pansies: Attach White to center tr of center small petal on Lavender Pansy, sc in same place, sl st in any loop on doily, ch 3, sl st in next loop, ch 1, skip 1 tr on next small petal, tr in next tr , ch 3 , sl st in next loop on doily, ch 1 , tr in next-to-last tr on first small petal of next Yellow pansy, ch 3, sl st in next loop on doily, sl st in center tr of next petal on pansy. Complete joining as before. Join a Fuchsia pansy the same way. Join remaining pansies, alternating colors as before. Join and break off White.

EDGING . . . Attach White to first ch-1 sp on first large petal of any pansy, ch 4 , * dc in next sp, ch 1 . Repeat from * across 2 large petals. Ch 3, dc in next ch-1 sp on next large petal, ch 1 and work in this manner all around. Join and break off.

MEDIUM DOILY . . . Work as for Large Doily until 30 rnds are completed. Join and break off (72 loops).

PANSIES . . . Make 6 pansies of each color.

To Join Pansies: Attach White to center tr of 2nd small petal on Lavender Pansy, sc in same tr, sl st in any loop on doily, ch 3, sl st in next loop, ch 1, skip 1 tr on next petal, $\operatorname{tr}$ in next tr, (ch 3, sl st in next loop on doily) twice; ch 3, tr in next-to-last tr on first small petal on next Yellow Pansy. Join as before, having 1 extra loop between each pansy around. Complete as for Large Doily.

SMALL DOILY . . . Work as for Large Doily until 10 rnds are completed. 11th rnd: Ch 5, * skip 1 sc, sc in next 8 sc , ch 5 , sc in next ch- 5 sp , ch 5 . Repeat from * around. 12th, 13th and 14th rnds: Work as before, having 2 sc less and 1 loop more between sc groups. 15th rnd: * Skip 1 sc, sc in next sc, (ch 5, sc in next loop) 5 times; ch 5 . Repeat from * around. 16th rnd: * Ch 5, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join and break off (48 loops). Make 4 pansies of each color. Join as for Medium Doily.

Join. 16th rnd: Sl st to center of next loop, sc in same loop, * (ch 4, sc in next loop) 6 times; ch 6, skip 7 sc , sc in next sc, ch 6 , sc in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join. 17th rnd: Sl st to center of next loop, sc in same loop, * (ch 4, sc in next loop) 4 times; ch 4, 2 sc in next loop, 6 sc in next sp, ch 1, 6 sc in next sp , 2 sc in next loop. Repeat from * around, ending with 2 sc in first loop (over sl sts). Join. 18th rnd: Sl st to center of next loop, sc in same loop, * (ch 4, sc in next loop) 4 times; ch 6, tr in next ch-1 sp, ch 6, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join. 19th rnd: Sl st to center of next loop, sc in same loop, * (ch 4, sc in next loop) twice; ch 4, 2 sc in next loop, 6 sc in next sp, ch 1,6 sc in next sp, 2 sc in next loop. Repeat from $*$ around, ending with 2 sc in first loop (over sl st). Join. 20th rnd: Sl st to center of next loop, sc in same loop, * (ch 4, sc in next loop) twice; ch 11 , sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 11 , sc in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join. 21st rnd: Sl st to center of next loop, ch 4, tr in next loop, * (ch 12, sc in next loop) twice; ch 12, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr, make tr in next 2 loops, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (joint tr made). Repeat from * around, ending with $\mathrm{ch} 6, \mathrm{tr} \mathrm{tr}$ in top of starting chain. 22nd rnd: $\mathrm{Ch} 3,3 \mathrm{dc}$ in top of tr tr , ch 3 , sl st in same place, * ch 12 , sc in next loop, ch $3,3 \mathrm{dc}$ in last sc made, ch 3 , sl st in same place. Repeat from * around. Join and break off. Starch lightly and press.

ASTER (Make 7) . . . Starting at center with Blue Tatting-Crochet, and No. 14 hook, ch 10. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: 24 sc in ring. Sl st in first sc. 2nd rnd: * Ch 14, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, sc in next 2 sc on ring (one petal completed). Repeat from * around ( 12 petals). 3rd rnd: * Working over 2 strands of Light Blue Pearl Cotton, sc in each ch of next petal, 5 sc in last ch; working over the 2 strands as before and over the sc's of
petal make sc at base of each sc of petal, skip 1 sc on ring, sc in next sc. Repeat from * around. Sl st in first sc. Break off.

CENTER . . . Starting at center with Orange, ch 2. 1st rnd: 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 2nd rnd: 2 sc in back loop of each sc. 3rd rnd: * Sc in back loop of next sc, 2 sc in back loop of next sc. Repeat from * around. 4th and 5th rnds: Sc in back loop of each sc around. Sl st in next sc. Break off. Stuff center with cotton batting or scraps of thread and sew neatly in place. Sew Asters in place as in illustration.

Repeat from * around. Join. 19th rnd: Ch 4, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr, make tr in next 7 tr, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (cluster made); * (ch 7, tr in next sp) 6 times; ch 7, cluster over next 8 tr. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 3, tr in tip of first cluster. 20th rnd: Ch 4, * tr in next sp, (ch 10 , sc in 5 th ch from hook-picot made-ch 5 , tr in next sp ) 6 times. Repeat from * around. Join and break off.

## FOUR LEAF CLOVER (Make 8)

 . . . Starting at center with Green, ch 10. Join with sl st to form ring.First Leaf: 1st row: Sl st in ring, ch 4, tr in ring. Ch 3, turn. 2nd row: 2 dc in first $\mathrm{tr}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next ch. Ch 1, turn. 3rd row: 2 sc in first dc, sc in each dc across, 2 sc in top of next ch. Ch 3, turn. 4th row: Holding back on hook the last loop of each dc, make dc in next 3 sc , thread over and draw through all loops on hook (cluster made), ch 3, sl st in next sc, ch 3, make another cluster, ch 3, sl st in last sc. Break off.

Second Leaf: Attach thread to ring, ch 4, and complete Leaf as before. Make 2 more leaves in this manner. Now work sc closely along outer edges of First Leaf to within first tr at base of leaf, work sc over this tr-bar, making sc's in corresponding sc on opposite side of leaf. Sl st in ring and work sc in this manner all around outer edges of all leaves. Do not break off.

STEM . . . Make a chain 6 inches long. Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, sl st in ring. Break off.

BUD (Make 8) . . . Ch 5, tr in 5th ch from hook, ch 3, turn and complete as for Four Leaf Clover until first leaf is
completed. Sc around this piece as before. Break off.

FLOWER . . . 1st row: Mark off 9 sc on top of Bud. Using 3 strands of Rose, attach thread to first sc, sc in same place, half dc in next sc, dc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{tr}$ in next $\mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dc}$ in next 2 sc , half dc in next sc, sc in next sc. Ch 1, turn. 2nd row: Sc in first sc, ${ }^{*} \mathrm{ch} 3$, sc in next st. Repeat from * across. Break off.

Sew Leaves and Flowers in place as in illustration. Starch lightly and press.

7 sc in next sp, ch 1 , sl st in center ch-s loop of any scallop on Center, ch $1,7 \mathrm{sc}$ in same sp on Motif, 7 sc in next sp on Motif, ch 1, skip 2 loops on center, sl st in next loop, ch 1, 7 sc in same sp on Motif, 7 sc in next sp on Motif, ch 1, skip 3 loops on Center, sl st in next loop, ch 1, 7 sc in same sp on Motif, 7 sc in next sp on Motif, ch 1 , sl st in center ch- 5 loop of same scallop on Center, ch 1,7 sc in same sp on Motif and complete rnd as for 4th rnd of Center (no more joinings). Join and break off.

SECOND MOTIF . . . With Yellow work as for First Motif until 3rd rnd is completed. 4th rnd: Attach White at tip of any cluster, 7 sc in next sp , ch 1 , sl st in ch-3 loop of first free point following joining on First Motif, ch 1, 7 sc in same sp on Second Motif, 7 sc in next sp on Second Motif, ch 1, sl st in same center loop of scallop on Center as last joining of First Motif was made, ch 1 and complete as for First Motif, joining next 3 points of Second Motif to Center as First Motif was joined.
Make 10 more motifs, joining each to previous motif and to Center as Second Motif was joined.

EDGING . . . 1st rnd: Attach White to first free point on any motif, sc in same place, * (ch 13, sc in next point) 5 times; ch 5 , sc in next free point. Repeat from * around. Join. 2nd rnd: * (In next sp make 8 sc , ch 3 and 8 sc ) 5 times; 4 sc in next sp. Repeat from * around. Join and break off.

FLOWER CENTER (Make 13) . . . Starting at center with Black, ch 2. 1st rnd: 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 2nd rnd: 2 sc in each sc around. 3rd rnd: * 2 sc in next sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from $*$ around ( 15 sc ). 4th rnd: * Work off 2 sc as 1 sc , sc in next sc. Repeat from * around. Break off. Sew one to center of each flower. Starch lightly and press.

Starting at center with White and No. 10 hook, ch 10 . Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: Ch 3, 27 dc in
ring. Join. 2nd rnd: Sc in same place as sl st, * ch 3, sc in next dc. Repeat from * around. Join. 3rd, 4th and 5th rnds: Sl st to center of next loop, sc in same loop, * ch 3, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join. 6th rnd: Same as last rnd, making ch-4 loops instead of ch-3. 7th and 8th rnds: Same as last rnd, making ch-s loops instead of ch-4. 9th rnd: Sl st to center of next loop, ch 6, tr tr in next loop, ch 6 , sc in top of tr tr (picot made), * ch 11, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr tr make tr tr in next 2 loops, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (joint tr tr made); ch 6, sc in top of joint tr tr (another

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picot made). Repeat from * around. Join. 10th rnd: Sl st to center of next picot, ch 5 , holding back on hook the last loop of each $\mathrm{d} \operatorname{tr}$ make 4 d tr in same loop, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (cluster made); * ch 6, sc in tip of cluster, ch 12 , make a 5 -d tr cluster in next picot loop. Repeat from * around. Join.

11th rnd: Same as 10th rnd, making ch 15 (instead of ch-12) between clusters. 12th rnd: Sl st in next picot, ch 6 . (d tr in same loop, ch 1) 9 times; d tr in same loop, * ch 7, sc in next sp , ch 7, in next picot loop make ( d tr, ch 1) 10 times and dtr. Repeat from * around. Join to top of ch-3. 2nd rnd: Sc in same place as sl st, * ch 5, skip 1 dc , sc in next dc. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 2 , dc in first sc. 3rd rnd: * Ch 6, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 3, dc in dc. 4th rnd: * Ch 7, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 3 , tr in dc. 5th rnd: * Ch 9 , sc in 5th ch from hook (picot made); ch 4, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 4, tr in tr. Ch 5, turn. 6th rnd: Sl st in last tr made, turn, sl st in ch- 5 loop, ch 4, in same loop make 2 tr , ch 3 and 3 tr ; * ch 5 , in next picot make 3 tr , ch 3
and 3 tr (shell made). Repeat from * around, ending with ch 5 , sl st in 4th ch of ch-4. 7th rnd: Sl st to sp of next shell, ch 4 , in same sp make 2 tr , ch 3 and $3 \operatorname{tr}$ (shell made over shell); * ch 7, shell in sp of next shell. Repeat from * around. Join. 8th, 9th and 10th rnds: Same as last rnd, having 1 ch more between shells on each rnd. 11th rnd: Same as last rnd, having 12 ch between shells. 12th rnd: * Shell over shell, ch 7 , sc in next sp, ch 7 . Repeat from * around. Join. 13th rnd: * Shell over shell, ch 7, $\operatorname{tr}$ in next sc, ch 7 . Repeat from * around. Join. 14th rnd: Sl st to sp of next shell, ch 4, in same sp make 2 tr , ch 5 and 3 tr ; * ch 9, sc in next tr, ch 9, in sp of next shell make 3 tr , ch 5 and 3 tr . Repeat from * around. Join. 15th rnd: Sl st to sp of next shell, ch $5,12 \mathrm{dtr}$ in same sp, * ch $15,13 \mathrm{~d} \mathrm{tr}$ in sp of next shell. Repeat from * around. Join. 16th rnd: Ch 6, ( d tr in next d tr, ch 1) 11 times; ${ }^{*} d$ tr in next $d$ tr, ch 6, sc in next sp, ch 6, ( dtr in next d tr, ch 1) 12 times. Repeat from * around. Join. 17th rnd: Ch 7 , ( d tr in next d tr, ch 2) 11 times; * d tr in next $d$ tr, ch 5 , ( $d$ tr in next $d$ tr, ch 2) 12 times. Repeat from * around. Join.

Now complete scallops individually as follows:

FIRST SCALLOP . . . 1st row: (In next sp make sc, ch 1, dc, ch 1 and sc) 12 times. Ch 8, turn. 2nd row: (D tr between next 2 sc, ch 3) 11 times; d tr in next sc . Turn. 3rd row: In each sp across make sc , ch $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$, ch 1 , and sc (shell made); ch 5, sl st in top of first d tr on next scallop.

SECOND SCALLOP . . . 1st row: Repeat first row of First Scallop. 2nd row: ( D tr between next 2 sc , ch 3 ) 11 times; sl st in top of next ch. Turn. 3rd row: Repeat 3rd row of First Scallop. Complete other Scallops to correspond. Join last shell of last scallop to first shell made.

Next rnd: Sl st to center dc of 2 nd shell on First Scallop, sc in same place, * ch 20 , skip 2 shells, sc in center dc of next shell. Repeat from * around. Join. Following rnd: Sl st to center of next loop, ch 3, holding back on hook the last loop of each dc, make 3 dc in same loop, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (cluster made); * ch 18, make a 4 -dc cluster in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join and break off.

BLUE BELL (Make 13) . . . Starting at center with Blue and No. 14 hook, ch 5. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: $\mathrm{Ch} 4,14 \mathrm{tr}$ in ring. Join. 2nd rnd: Ch 4, tr in same place as sl st, 2 tr in next tr, $*$ tr in next tr, 2 tr in next 2 tr . Repeat from * around, ending with tr in last tr . Join. 3rd rnd: Sc in same place as sl st, sc in each tr around ( 25 sc ). Join. 4th rnd: Ch 4, tr in same sc as sl st, 2 tr in each sc around. Join.

FIRST PETAL . . . 1st row: Ch 4, holding back on hook the last loop of each $\operatorname{tr}$ make $t r$ in next 2 tr, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (cluster made); tr in next 3 tr , cluster over next 3 tr . Ch 4 , turn. 2nd row: Holding back on hook the last loop of each tr make 2 tr in tip of next cluster, tr in next $3 \mathrm{tr}, 2 \mathrm{tr}$ in tip of next cluster, thread over and complete a cluster; ch 4 , turn, sl st at base of cluster, ch 4 , sl st in next 2 tr on Blue Bell, ch 4, and work next petal as for First Petal until 5 petals are completed. Join and break off.

LEAF AND STEM (Make 13) . . . Using Green and No. 10 hook, ch 17, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 6 ch, (ch 7, sr in 2nd ch from hook and in next 6 ch , sl st in same ch as last sc on starting chain) twice; ch 9. Break off.

Sew stems around doily. Sew stamens to flowers. Apply sizing to flowers to preserve shape. Sew flowers in place.

MATERIALS: J. \& P. Coats or Clark's O.N.T. Best Six Cord Mercerized Crochet, Size 50 (Small Ball), 4 balls of White . . . Steel Crochet Hook No. 12 . . 1 yard of yellow linen.

PLACE DOILY (Make 2)—Motifs (Make 106) . . . Starting at center, ch 7. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: 24 sc in ring. Sl st in first sc. 2nd rnd: Attach a new piece of thread and working over original thread make 9 sc over it. Ch 1, turn. * Make sc in next 9 sc, picking up the back loop
only of each sc and working over original thread in order to conceal it, skip 1 sc on ring, sc in next sc concealing original thread as before (one petal made ). Ch 1, turn. Sc in each of next 4 sc on last petal picking up front loop of each sc only and working over original thread; now make 5 sc over original thread (9 sc in all). Ch 1, turn. Repeat from * until 12 petals in all are made. Skip 1 sc on ring, sc in next sc. Ch 1, turn. Cut off original thread and join the first and last petals together by slip stitching together the last 4 sc at base of both petals. Break off.

Cut a piece of yellow linen, 12 inches
in diameter. Starch motifs lightly and press. Pin 30 motifs in place along outer edges of linen. Work in blanket st along inner edge of motifs, thus forming scallops. Cut off excess linen.

BREAD AND BUTTER DOILY (Make 2) . . . Cut a piece of yellow linen, 6 inches in diameter. Pin 14 motifs in place along outer edges and finish as for Place Doily.

GLASS DOILY (Make 2) . . . Cut a piece of yellow linen, 4 inches in diameter. Pin 9 motifs in place along outer edges and finish as for Place Doily.

Conts-3 balls of White and 2 balls each of Shaded Pinks and Shaded Greens, or Clark's O.N.T.-s balls of White and 3 balls each of Shaded Pinks and Shaded Greens . . . Steel Crochet Hook No. 10.

Doily measures 13 inches in diameter
LARGE FLOWER . . . With White, ch 20.1 st row: Sc in 2 nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across, 3 sc in end ch, sc in each ch along other side of starting chain. Ch 1, turn. Hereafter pick up back loop only of each sc. 2nd row: Sc in each sc to within 3 sc at tip, 2 sc in each of 3 tip sts, sc in each sc to end of row. Ch 4, turn. 3rd row: Skip the sc at base of ch and next 3 sc , sc in next sc, (ch 4, skip 3 sc, sc in next sc) 3 times; (ch 4, skip 2 sc , sc in next sc) 3 times; (ch 4, skip 3 sc , sc in next sc) 4 times. Break off. This completes one petal. Work first 2 rows of a 2 nd petal as for first petal, ending with ch 2, turn. 3rd row: Sl st in end loop of first petal, ch 2, skip 3 sc on 2nd petal, sc in next sc, ch 2, sl st in corresponding loop of first petal, ch 2 , skip 3 sc , sc in next sc, ch 4 and complete this petal same as first petal (no more joinings). Make 10 more petals, joining 2 loops of adjacent petals as before (join last 2 loops of last petal to first 2 loops of first petal). Break off.

Attach thread to base of any petal and, working toward center, make 2 sc-rnds, 1 dc-rnd and 1 sc-rnd, decreasing as necessary to keep work flat by working off 2 sts as one.

ROSETTE . . . With Pink, ch 10, join. 1st rnd: * In ring make sc, half $\mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{s} \mathrm{dc}$, half dc and sc . Repeat from * 4 more times ( 5 petals). 2nd rnd: * Ch 6, then, inserting hook from behind petals, work sc in ring between next 2 sc. Repeat from * around ( 5 loops). 3rd rnd: In each loop make sc , half $\mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{dc}, 8 \mathrm{tr}$, dc , half dc and sc . Sl st in first sc made. Break off. Sew this rosette to center of Flower.

LEAF . . . Starting at tip with Green, ch 15. 1st row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch to within last ch, 3 sc in last ch; sc in each ch along opposite side of starting chain, sc in same place as last sc. Mark last sc for base of leaf. Hereafter pick up only the back loop of each sc. Do not turn but work sc in each sc to within 3 sc from
center sc at tip of leaf. Ch 1, turn. 2nd row: Sc in each sc to marked sc, 3 sc in marked sc, sc in each sc on other side to within 3 sc from center sc at tip of leaf. Ch 1 , turn. 3rd and 4th rows: Sc in each sc to within center sc of 3 -sc group, 3 sc in next sc, sc in each sc on other side to within last 3 sts. Ch 1, turn. 5th row: Same as 3rd row but making sc, ch 7 and sc in center sc of sc-group at base of leaf. 6th row: $S c$ in each sc to within ch-7 loop; 2 sc in loop, then pick up Flower and join leaf between 2 petals as follows: Ch 2, sl st in first loop to left of loop at tip of a petal, ch 2,3 sc
in ch-7 loop, ch 5, 3 sc in same loop, ch 2 , sl st in corresponding loop of next petal, ch 2, 2 sc in ch-7 loop, sc in back loop of each sc across to within last 3 sts. Break off. Make 11 more leaves, joining.each leaf between 2 petals of Flower as first leaf was joined.

Attach White to loop at tip of a petal, * ch 7, sc in first corner st of adjacent leaf, (ch 7, sc in next corner st of same leaf) twice; ch 7 , at tip of leaf make sc, ch 7 and sc; (ch 7 , sc in next corner st of leaf) 3 times; ch 7 , sc in loop at tip of next petal. Repeat Continued on page 15

With Pink work a rosette as for center. Break off. Attach White to Sth st on any petal of a rosette, sc in same place, ch 7, skip 3 sts, sc in next st, then pick up doily and join rosette between 2 leaves as follows: Ch 3, tr in loop at tip of leaf, ch 3, sc in 5th st of next petal of rosette, ch 3, skip next loop on leaf, sl st in next loop, ch 3, skip 3 sts on rosette, sc in next st, ch 3 , then, holding back on hook the last loop of each $t r$ make $t r$ in next loop on leaf and in corresponding loop on next leaf, thread over and draw through all loops on hook; ch 3, sc in 5th st of next petal, ch 3, sl st in next loop on leaf, ch 3, skip 3 sts on petal, sc in next st, ch $3, \operatorname{tr}$ in loop at tip of leaf, ch 3 , sc in 5th st of next petal, * ch 7, skip 3 sts, sc in next st, ch 7, sc in Sth st of next petal. Repeat from * once more. Join and break off. Make and join 11 more rosettes in this manner.

Now work a round of loops as follows: Attach White to tr-bar at right of loop which is at tip of leaf, ch 4 , tr under next tr (at left of leaf), ** ch 3, sc in 3rd st from hook (picot made), ch 2, sc in next free loop on rosette, * ch 2, picot, ch 2, picot, ch 2, sc in next loop. Repeat from * 3 more times; ch 2 , picot, then, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr make tr under next 2 tr, thread over and draw through all loops on hook. Repeat from ** around. Join last picot with sl st to 4th st of ch-4. Break off. With Green, work a leaf as before until the Sth row is completed. 6th row: Sc in each sc to within ch-7 loop; 2 sc in loop, then pick up doily and join as follows: Ch 2, sl st in 2nd picot preceding joined tr's between rosettes, ch 2,3 sc in ch-7 loop of leaf, ch 5, 3 sc in same loop, ch 2, sl st in 2nd picot after same joined tr's, ch 2, 2 sc in ch-7 loop and complete leaf as before. Make and join 11 more leaves in this manner. Make another leaf until the 5th row is completed. 6th row: Sc in each sc to within ch-7 loop, in loop make 2 sc, ch 5 and 3 sc ; ch 2 , sl st in sc above center petal of rosette, ch 2 , 3 sc in ch-7 loop, ch 5, 2 sc in same loop, and complete leaf as before. Make and join 11 more leaves in this manner.

Now work 3 rnds of loops as follows: 1st rnd: Attach White to tip of a leaf which is joined between rosettes, ch 7, sc in same place, * (ch 7, sc in next corner st) 3 times; tr in next free loop of rosette, tr in free loop of next leaf, (ch 7, sc in next corner st) 3 times; ch 7 , in tip of leaf make sc, ch 7 and sc; (ch 7, sc in next corner st) 3 times; ch 7, tr in free loop of leaf, $t r$ in next free loop of rosette, sc
in next corner st of next leaf, (ch 7, sc in next corner st) twice; ch 7, in tip of leaf make sc, ch 7 and sc. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 7, sl st where thread was attached. 2nd rnd: Sl st in next 3 ch , sc in loop, (ch 2, picot, ch 2, picot, ch 2, sc in next loop) twice; * ch 2, picot, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr make tr in each of next two ch-7 loops, thread over and draw through all loops on hook, picot, ch 2, sc in next ch-7 loop, (ch 2, picot, ch 2, picot, ch 2, sc in next loop) 6 times; ch 2, picot, then, holding back on hook the last loop of each tr, make tr in next two ch- 7 loops, thread over and draw through all loops on hook; picot, ch 2, sc in next loop, (ch 2, picot, ch 2, picot, ch 2, sc in next loop) 4 times. Repeat from * around. Join last loop with sl st to first sc made. 3rd rnd: Sl st to center of next loop, sc in loop, ch 2, picot, ch 2, picot and ch 2; sc in next loop, * ch 3, sc between picots of next free loop, (ch 2, picot, ch 2, picot and ch 2, sc in next loop) 5 times; ch 3, sc between picots of next free loop, (ch 2, picot, ch 2, picot, ch 2, sc in next loop) 3 times. Repeat from * around. Join and break off.

to correspond, ending with a section of 3 sps. Sew last row to first section made to complete border. The scalloped edges are inner edges of border. Work sc closely along outer edges of border. Press border, place over organdy and sew in place with close blanket stitch.

DAISY (Make 6) . . . Starting at center with Size 100 White and No. 14 hook, ch 10. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: 24 sc in ring. Sl st in first sc. 2nd rnd: * Ch 14, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, sc in next 2 sc on ring (one petal completed). Repeat from * around ( 12 petals). 3rd rnd: * Working over 2 strands of White Pearl Cotton, sc in each ch of next petal, 5 sc in last ch; working over the 2 strands as before and over the sc's of petal make sc at base of each sc of petal, skip 1 sc on
ring, sc in next sc. Repeat from * around. Sl st in first sc. Break off.

CENTER . . . Starting at center with Orange and No. 10 hook, ch 2. 1st rnd: 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 2nd rnd: 2 sc in back loop of each sc. 3rd rnd: * Sc in back loop of next sc, 2 sc in back loop of next sc. Repeat from * around. 4th and 5th rnds: Sc in back loop of each sc around. Sl st in next sc. Break off. Stuff center with cotton batting or scraps of thread and sew neatly in place.

LARGE LEAF (Make 2) . . . Starting at center with Green and No. 10 hook, ch 25 (the end of this chain is tip of leaf). 1st row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 3 ch , ch 5, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 3 ch , sc in next 7 ch , sl st in next ch, turn, sc in next 5 sc, (ch S, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 3 ch , sc in each sc and in next 5 ch , sl st in next ch, turn, sc in next 7 sc ) twice; ch 5, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 3 ch , sl st in next sc. Break off. Working along opposite side of starting chain, attach thread to 5th ch from tip of leaf, ch 5, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 3 ch and continue to correspond with side just completed.

SMALL LEAF (Make 2) . . . Starting at center with Green and No. 10 hook, ch 12. 1st row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 3 ch , ch 5 , sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 3 ch , sc in next 5 ch , sl st in next ch, sc in next 3 sc , ch 5, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 3 ch , sl st in next sc. Break off. Working along opposite side of starting chain, attach thread in 5th ch from tip, ch 5, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 3 ch and continue to correspond with side just completed.

Sew 3 daisies, a large leaf and a small leaf at each of 2 diagonally opposite corners as shown in illustration.

STEM . . . With Green make three chains of desired lengths for each flower group and sew in place as illustrated.
