Crochet Abbreviations and Definitions

Mercrochet, the lustrous new Lily crochet cotton, is available in large and small balls. See the back cover for the color range which includes:

Large Mercrochet Balls (Art. 161) are available in full color range in sizes 20 and 30; small Mercrochet balls (Art. 61) in full color range in size 30. Mercrochet flows through your fingers, crocheting smoothly because it is mercerized, combed from imported long staple Egyptian cotton.

CHAIN STITCH (ch)—Start with a slip knot on hook. * Thread over and draw thru loop on hook. Repeat from * until ch is desired length.

SLIP STITCH (sl st)—Insert hook in work, catch thread and draw thru work and loop on hook at same time.

SINGLE CROCHET (sc)—With a loop on hook, insert hook in work, catch thread and pull thru work, thread over again and draw thru the 2 loops on hook.

HALF DOUBLE CROCHET (hdc)—Make like dc as far as *, then thread over and draw thru all 3 loops on hook at once.

DOUBLE CROCHET (dc)—Thread over, insert hook in work, catch thread and pull thru work, making 3 loops on hook. * Thread over and draw thru 2 loops, thread over and draw thru remaining 2 loops.

TREBLE (tr)—Thread over twice, insert hook in work, catch thread and pull through work, making 4 loops on hook. Work off in groups of two as in dc.

For a **Double Treble (dtr)**, thread over 3 times; for a **Triple Treble (tr tr)**, thread over 4 times; and for a long **Treble (long tr)**, thread over 5 times; taking off 2 loops at a time as in tr.

PICOT (p)—A Picot is made on a chain by working a sc in the specified st from hook, taking up 2 loops of ch st, — the left-hand

loop and the 1 back loop. A Picot is made following a sc, dc, tr, etc., by making the specified number of ch sts, then a sl st in side-top of st preceding chain.

PICOT-LOOP (p-loop)—This consists of a chain loop with 1 or more picots on it.

CLUSTER — This consists of 2 or more dc, tr, dtr, or tr tr, gathered at top into a tight group. Hold the last loop of each st on hook, then thread over and draw thru all loops on hook at once, pulling tight.

Stitches can be made thru either both loops of stitches of previous row or thru the back loops only. If not specified, take up both loops.

The term "fasten off" is used whenever the thread is to be cut 6 or 7 inches from the work, slipped thru the loop on hook, pulled tight, threaded to a sewing needle and fastened securely on wrong side of work.

Skip (sk)

GAUGE — Compare your work with gauge specified. If you crochet more tightly or too loosely, use a coarser or finer needle, to secure correct measurements.

TO INCREASE IN CROCHET — Make 2 stitches in one. Always increase in 2nd stitch from edges.

TO DECREASE IN CROCHET—Before working off last loops, insert hook in next stitch and work off loops of both stitches together.

Refreshment Set No. 1

MATERIALS—Lily MERCROCHET Cotton size 20:—1-ball each Baby Pink, Baby Blue, Lt. Yellow, Bright Nile Green, Beauty Pink, Beauty Rose, Lavender, Hunter Green and Shd. Pinks. (Sufficient for a large Set of Coasters).—1-ball makes 2 Small Coasters or 1 Large Coaster. Crochet hook size 13.

SMALL COASTER—(Size—5¼")—Base — In Baby Pink, ch 8, sl st in 1st st. Ch 3, 17 dc in ring, sl st in top of ch-3. Work all rows in back lps only. **ROW 2**—Ch 3, 2 dc in same st, (2 dc in next dc, 3 dc in next) repeated around. Join. **ROW 3**—Ch 3, dc in same st, (dc in next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc) repeated around. (This is a widening in every 3d st). Join. **ROW 4**—Ch 3, dc in same st, (dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in next dc) repeated around. (This is a widening in every 4th st). Join. **ROW 5**—Widen in every 3d st. **ROW 6**—Widen in every 5th st. **ROW 7**—Widen in every 10th st. **ROW 8**—Widen in every 11th st. **ROW 9**—Widen in every 6th st. **ROW 10**—Widen in every 7th st. **ROW 11**—Widen in every 12th st (208 dc in row). Edge—(Ch 6, sk 3 dc, sc in next dc) repeated around. Make ch 3 and dc for final lp. **ROW 2**—(Ch 7, sc in next lp) repeated around. Make ch 4 and dc for final lp. **ROW 3**—(Ch 8, sc in next lp) repeated around. Fasten off.

Ruffle Doily No. 2

MATERIALS—Lily MERCROCHET Cotton size 30:—3-large balls Baby Pink; Size 20:—1-ball each Beauty Rose and Hunter Green. Crochet hook size 13. Size—18"

CENTER—In Baby Pink, ch 9, sl st in 1st ch. Ch 1, 12 sc in ring, sl st in 1st sc. **ROW 2**—Ch 21, sk 1 sc, tr in next sc, (ch 15, sk 1 sc, tr in next sc) 4 times, ch 15, sl st in 6th st of ch-21. **ROW 3**—Ch 1, ** 7 sc in next lp, 1 sc in one lp of center st, * ch 6, holding back the last lp of each tr on hook, make 2 tr in 6th ch from hook, thread over and pull thru all lps on hook (Cluster made), ch 4, sl st in Cluster for a p, ch 6, sl st at base of Cluster, sc in same center st of ch-15 lp. Repeat from * twice. 7 sc on bal. of ch-15 lp. Repeat from ** 5 times. Join and fasten off. **ROW 4**—Join 1st Cluster in one group, * ch 9, (sc, ch 12, sc) in next (center) Cluster, ch 9, sc in next Cluster, ch 7, sc in 1st Cluster in next group. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 3 and dc in 1st sc. **ROW 5**—Ch 13, * dtr in ch-12 lp on next point, ch 10, (tr tr, ch 17, tr tr) in same lp, ch 10, dtr in same lp, ch 10, sk next ch-9 lp, dc in next ch-7 lp, ch 10 and repeat from * around. End with sl st in 3d st of ch-13. **ROW 6**—Sl st in next lp, ch 3, 7 dc in same lp. * dc in dtr, 9 dc in next lp, dc in tr tr, 7 dc in next lp, 5 dc in 9th (center) st of same lp, 7 dc in bal. of lp, dc in tr tr, 9 dc in next lp, dc in dtr, 6 dc in next lp, (2 dc in same lp and 2 dc in next lp)

Doily No. 3
(Center of Picture)

MATERIALS—Lily MERCROCHET COTTON size 30:—Large Balls—2-balls Beauty Pink; Small Balls—2-balls Baby Pink and 4-balls Bright Nile Green. Crochet hook size 13. Size—15".

CENTER—In Green, ch 10, sl st in 1st ch. Ch 1, 12 sc in ring, sl st in 1st sc. **ROW 2**—* Ch 6, dtr in same sc, 2 dtr in next sc, (ch 36, sl st in 36th ch from hook) 5 times, sk 4 lps, sl st at base of next lp, 2 dtr in same sc on ring, 1 dtr in next sc, ch 6, sl st in same sc, sl st in next sc. Repeat from * 3 times. Fasten off. **ROW 3**—Sc in 3d lp in one group, ch 3, 2 dc in same lp, * ch 15, 3 dc in next lp, ch 21, 3 dc in next lp, ch 27, 3 dc in next lp, ch 21, 3 dc in next lp, ch 15, 3 dc in next lp. Repeat from * around, making ch 7 and tr tr in top of ch-3 for final lp. **ROW 4**—Ch 3, 2 dc in this last lp, (ch 15, 3 dc in next lp) repeated around. Join to top of ch-3. **ROW 5**—Sl st in next dc, * (1 sc, 1 hdc, 2 dc, 11 tr, 2 dc, 1 hdc and sc) in next lp, sl st in 2d dc between lps. Repeat from * around. **ROW 6**—Sl st to center st on next lp, ch 5, 2 tr in same st, (ch 7, sk 3 tr, tr in next tr, tr in 6th st on next lp, ch 7, sk 3 tr, 3 tr in next tr) repeated around. Join to top of ch-5. **ROW 7**—Ch 5, 2 tr in same st, (ch 3, sk 1 tr, 3 tr in next tr, ch 4, dc in next ch-7 lp, dc in next lp, ch 4, 3 tr in next tr) repeated around. Join to top of ch-5. **ROW 8**—Ch 5, tr in next 2 tr, (ch 3, 2 tr in next sp, ch 3, tr in next 3 tr, ch 6, tr in next 3 tr) repeated around and join. **ROW 9**—Ch 5, tr in 2 tr, (ch 5, tr in next 2 tr, ch 5, tr in 3 tr, ch 4, tr in 3 tr) repeated around and join. **ROW 10**—Ch 5, 2 tr, (ch 7, 2 tr, ch 7, 3 tr, ch 2, 3 tr) repeated around and join. **ROW 11**—Ch 5, 2 tr, (ch 5, 2 tr in next tr, ch 3, 2 tr in next tr, ch 5, 3 tr, ch 2, 3 tr) repeated around and join. **ROW 12**—Ch 5, 2 tr, * ch 3, tr in next tr, 2 tr in next, ch 3, tr in next sp, ch 3, 2 tr in next tr, 1 tr in next, ch 3, 3 tr, ch 2, 3 tr. Repeat from * around and join. **ROW 13**—Ch 5, 2 tr, ch 2, 3 tr, * ch 2, 5 tr in next tr, (ch 2, 3 tr) 4 times. Repeat from * around and join. **ROW 14**—Ch 5, holding back the last lp of each tr on hook, make tr in next 2 tr, thread over and pull thru all lps on hook (a Cluster made), * ch 3, 3 tr, ch 2, tr in next 2 tr, 3 tr in next tr, tr in next 2 tr, ch 2, 3 tr, ch 3, (tr in next 3 tr) made into a Cluster, ch 1, (tr in next 3 tr) made into a Cluster. Repeat from * around and join to 1st Cluster. **ROW 15**—Ch 8, * tr in next 3 tr, ch 4, 7 tr, ch 4, 3 tr, ch 3, (tr in next Cluster, tr in ch-1, tr in Cluster) made into a Cluster, ch 3 and repeat from * around. End

Doily No. 4
(Lower Left)

MATERIALS—Lily Mercrochet Cotton size 20:—1-ball Ecu; size 30—1-small ball each Dk. Yellow, Beauty Rose, Lavender and Pastels. Crochet hook size 13. Size—14".

CENTER—In Ecu, ch 10, sl st in 1st ch. Ch 3, 23 dc in ring, sl st in top of ch-3. **ROW 2**—Ch 5, tr in same st, (2 tr in next dc) 23 times, sl st in ch-5. **ROW 3**—Ch 14, sc in 2d ch from hook, over ch (not into sts) make 1 hdc, 12 dc, 3 hdc and 3 sc. Sc in next 4 tr. * Ch 13, turn, sl st in 9th st up last scroll, ch 1, turn, (1 sc, 1 hdc, 12 dc, 3 hdc and 3 sc) (Cont. on Page 6—Col. 3)

Vanity Set No. 5

(Lower Right)

MATERIALS—Lily MERCROCHET Cotton:—3-large balls White size 30; 1-large ball each Lavender and Beauty Pink size 20. Lily Six Strand Floss:—2-sks. Med. Green. Crochet hook size 13.

BLOCK—(Size—3¼" when blocked) —In White ch 10, sl st in 1st st. (Ch 5, sc in ring) 11 times, ch 2, dc in ring. **ROW 2**—* (Ch 3, sc in next lp) 3 times, ch 5, sc in same lp with last sc. Repeat from * 3 times, ending with ch 2 and dc for final corner lp. **ROW 3**—* (Ch 3, sc in next lp)

"Anemone"

Place Mat Set No. 6

MATERIALS—Lily MERCROCHET COTTON:—Large Balls — 2-balls each Lavender and Shd. Pinks size 30, 2-balls White size 20; Small Balls — 2-balls Gray size 30. Lily Six Strand Floss:—4-sks Black. Sufficient for 4 place settings. Crochet hook size 13.

ANEMONE—In Lavender, ch 9, sl st in 1st st. Ch 1, 12 sc in ring. In back lps, sl st in 1st sc, * ch 3, 4 dc in same st. Ch 3, turn, dc in last dc, (2 dc in next dc) 3 times. Ch 3, turn, dc in last dc, tr in next 3 dc, ch 3, sl st in last tr for a p, tr in same dc, tr in next 2 dc, (dc, ch 3, sc) all in next dc, ch 5, sl st in same sc on center ring, sl st in back lps of next 2 sc. Repeat from * 5 times. Cut 6" long, thread to a needle and fasten off on back. Make a 2d row and tack on top of 1st row with petals between those of 1st row. **Center**—In Gray, * ch 6, (sl st, ch 5, sl st) all in 1st st of ch-6. Repeat from * 4 times. Sl st at base of 1st group. Cut 8" long and use to sew in center of flower. With Black Floss make a large French Knot in center, winding 6 times around needle. **PLACE MAT**—(Size—13")—Make 10

flowers each in Lavender and Shd. Pinks. Tack tog. by one petal on each side into a circle, alternating colors. **Center**—In size 20 White, ch 8, sl st in 1st ch. Ch 1, 10 sc in ring, sl st in 1st sc. Ch 15, tr in next sc, (ch 9, tr in next sc) 8 times, ch 9, sl st in 6th st of ch-15. **ROW 2**—(4 sc, ch 3, 4 sc) in each lp around. **ROW 3**—Sl st up to next point, (ch 13, sc in next point) repeated around. **ROW 4**—Sl st in next lp, ch 3, (5 dc, ch 5, 6 dc) in same lp, (6 dc, ch 5, 6 dc) in each lp around. Sl st in top of ch-3. **ROW 5**—Sl st in next 2 dc, ch 3, dc in each dc up point, * (3 dc, ch 5, 3 dc) all in next ch-5, dc in each dc down to 3d from angle, sk 4 dc in angle (2 on each side), dc in each remaining dc up point. Repeat from * around. Sl st in top of ch-3. **ROW 6**—Sl st in next dc, ch 3, dc in each dc up point, * (3 dc, ch 5, 3 dc) all in next ch-5, dc in each dc down to 2d from angle, sk 2 dc in angle (1 on each side), dc in each remaining dc up point. Repeat from * around. Sl st in top of ch-3. Repeat Rows 5, 6 and 5. **ROW 10**—Sl st in next 3 dc, ch 3, dc in next 9 dc, * (3 dc, ch 5, 3 dc) in ch-5, dc in 10 dc, ch 4, sk 6 dc in angle (3 on each side), dc in next 10 dc. Repeat from * around. End with ch 4, sl st in top of ch-3. **ROW 11**—Sl st in next 4 dc, ch 3, dc in next 8 dc, * (3 dc, ch 5, 3 dc) in ch-5, dc in 9 dc, ch 13, sk 4 dc on next point, dc in next 9 dc. Repeat from * around. End with ch 13, sl st in top of ch-3. **ROW**

12—Sl st in next 5 dc, ch 3, dc in next 6 dc, * (3 dc, ch 5, 3 dc) in ch-5, dc in next 7 dc, ch 13, sc in next lp, ch 13, sk 5 dc, dc in next 7 dc. Repeat from * around. Join to top of ch-3. **ROW 13**—Sl st in next 6 dc, ch 3, dc in next 3 dc, * (3 dc, ch 5, 3 dc) in ch-5, dc in next 4 dc, (ch 14, sc in next lp) twice, ch 14, sk 6 dc, dc in next 4 dc. Repeat from * around. Join to top of ch-3. **ROW 14**—Sl st to tip of point, * (ch 15, sc in next lp) 3 times, ch 15, sc in next point. Repeat from * around, making ch-7 and dtr for final lp. **ROW 15**—(Ch 15, sc in next lp) repeated around, making ch-7 and dtr for final lp. **Joining Row**—Ch 8, sl st in 1st free (Cont. on Page 7—Col. 2)

made into a Cluster in angle, 6 dc in same lp. Repeat from * around. End with a 2-dc Cluster, sk 1st ch-3, sl st in next dc. **ROW 7**—* (Ch 4, sk 2 dc, sc in next dc) 9 times up to center of point, ch 10, sc in same dc, (ch 4, sk 2 dc, sc in next dc) 9 times down to Cluster in angle. Repeat from * around. **ROW 8**—Ch 1, sc in 1st lp, * (ch 4, sc in next lp) repeat up to ch-10 lp at point, ch 4, (sc, ch 7, sc, ch 4, sc) all in same lp, (ch 4, sc in next lp) repeated down to angle, ch 2, sc across angle in 1st lp on next side. Repeat from * around. End with ch 2, sl st in 1st sc. **ROW 9**—Ch 1, sc in 1st lp, * (ch 4, sc in next lp) repeated up to ch-7 lp at point, ch 10, sc in same lp, (ch 4, sc in next lp) repeated down to angle, ch 2, sc in 1st lp on next side. Repeat from * around. End as last row. Repeat Rows 8 and 9 three times and Row 8 again. **Next Row**—Ch 1, sc in 1st lp, ch 2 for a hdc, * (ch 2, hdc in next lp) 14 times up to point, ch 7, hdc in same point, (ch 2, hdc in next lp) 14 times, ch 2, hdc across angle in next ch-4 lp. Repeat from * around and join to 2d st of 1st ch-4. Fasten off. **Edge**—Join to 7-ch tip of one point, ch 3, 2 dc in same lp, * 5 dc in center st of same lp, 3 dc in bal. of lp, (3 dc in next sp) 13 times, 2 dc in next sp, (1 dc in same sp, 2 dc in next sp and 1 dc in next sp) made into a 4-dc Cluster. 2 dc in same sp, (3 dc in next sp) 3 times, turn, (ch 2, tr tr) 7 times down in Cluster in angle, ch 2, sk 10 dc, sl st in next dc. Ch 1, turn, 3 sc in each ch-2 sp, sc in each tr across, sl st in last dc. (3 dc in next sp) 4 times, turn, (ch 6, sk 3 sc on shell, tr tr in next sc) 7 times, ch 6, sk 11 dc, sl st in next dc. Ch 1, turn, (4 sc, ch 5, sl st in last sc for a p, 3 sc) in each sp across, sc in each tr tr. Sl st in last dc. (3 dc in next sp) 4 times, turn, (ch 9, tr tr between next 2 ps) 7 times, ch 9, sk 11 dc, sl st in next dc. Ch 1, turn, (5 sc, p, 5 sc) in each sp across, sc in each tr tr, sl st in last dc, (3 dc in next sp) 3 times. Repeat from * around. Join to top of ch-3, sl st in next 5 dc. **Border**—Turn, * ch 13, a long tr (thread over 5 times and work off in twos) between next 2 ps. Repeat from * 6 times Ch 13, sc in tip of next point. Repeat around. **ROW 2**—Ch 3, turn, (13 dc in next sp, dc in next st) repeated around. Join to top of ch-3. **ROW 3**—Ch 4, sk 1 dc, dc in next dc, (ch 1, sk 1 dc, dc in next dc) repeated around. Join to 3d st of ch-4.

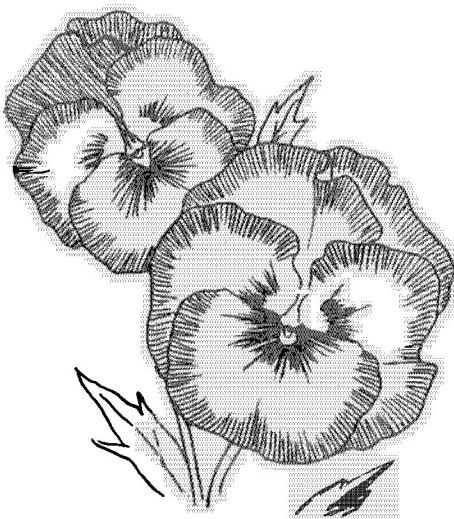
FRILL—Sc in next ch-1 sp, * sk 2 sps, (ch 2, dtr) 10 times in next sp, ch 2, sk 2 sps, sc in next 2 sps. Repeat from * around. **ROW 2**—Sc in

1st ch-2 sp, ch 3 for a dc (ch 5, dc in next sp) repeated around. Join to 3d st of 1st lp, sl st in next 3 ch. **ROW 3**—Ch 8, dc in next lp, (ch 5, dc in next lp) 8 times, * (ch 5, dc) 4 times in next lp (between shells), (ch 5, dc in next lp) 10 times. Repeat from * around. Join to 3d st of 1st ch-8. **ROW 4**—Sl st to center of next lp, ch 3 for a dc, * (ch 6, dc in next lp) repeated around. Join to 3d st of 1st lp. Repeat Row 4 four times increasing lps 1 ch in each row (10-ch lps in Row 8). **ROW 9**—Repeat Row 4 to *. (Ch 10, sl st in 5th ch from hook for a p, ch 6, dc in next lp, ch 11, dc in next lp) repeated around. Join and fasten off.

ROCK ROSE—In Beauty Rose, ch 8, sl st in 1st ch. Ch 1, 10 sc in ring, sl st in 1st sc. * Ch 3, making 1st st slightly longer than usual, (1 hdc, 2 dc, 2 tr, 7 dtr, 2 tr, 2 dc and 1 hdc) all in long st, sk 1 sc on ring, sl st in next sc. Repeat from * 4 times. **ROW 2**—(Ch 1, sl st in next st) repeated around petals. Fasten off. With 2 strands Green, make 5 French Knots in center, widening 6 times around needle. Make 12 Roses. Tack one on tip of each point of lattice band, and the others midway between points.

LEAVES—In Green, ** ch 18, sk last 2 ch, (2 sc, 1 hdc, 1 dc, 4 tr, 1 dc, 1 hdc and 2 sl sts) on ch. * Repeat from ** for 2d leaf. Sl st in next 4 ch, ch 14 and repeat from * to *. Sk opposite leaf, sl st in 4 ch of stem. Fasten off. Make 18 Leaves. Tack one down from each Rose on points of band, and one on each side of other Roses.

Dip doily in hot, thick starch. Roll in a cloth to absorb excess. Stretch and pin right-side-up in true shape. Press center thru a cloth. As starch sets, arrange ruffle in even ripples.

Tack 1st and last scroll tog. **ROW 4**—Sc in 1st 3 sts on one scroll, ch 14, sc in 2d ch from hook, then over ch make hdc, 12 dc, 3 hdc and 3 sc. * Sc in next 5 dc, ch 13, turn, sl st in 11th st up last scroll, ch 1, turn, (1 sc, 1 hdc, 12 dc, 3 hdc and 3 sc) in lp, sc in next 2 dc, sl st in next dc, ch 1, sc in 1st 3 sts on next scroll, ch 13, turn, sl st in 11th st up last scroll, ch 1, turn, (1 sc, 1 hdc, 12 dc, 3 hdc and 3 sc) in lp. Repeat from * around. Fasten off. Tack 1st and last scrolls tog. **ROW 5**—8 sc and 1 sl st around top of one scroll, (ch 1, 8 sc and 1 sl st around next scroll) repeated around. **ROW 6**—Sl st to center of next scroll, ch 6 for a tr, (ch 12, tr in center of next scroll) repeated around. Join to 6th st of 1st lp. **ROW 7**—Ch 6, (tr in next lp, ch 13, tr in next tr) repeated around. Join to top of ch-6, sl st in next tr. **ROW 8**—Ch 6, (2 tr in next lp, ch 14, sk 1 tr, tr in next tr) repeated around. Sl st in top of ch-6, sl st in 2 tr. **ROW 9**—Ch 6, (3 tr in next lp, ch 15, sk 2 tr, tr in next tr) repeated around. Sl st in ch-6, sl st in 3 tr. **ROW 10**—Ch 6, (4 tr in next lp, ch 16, sk 3 tr, tr in next tr) repeated around. Sl st in ch-6, sl st in 4 tr. **ROW 11**—Ch 6, (5 tr in next lp, ch 17, sk 4 tr, tr in next tr) repeated around. Sl st in ch-6, sl st in 5 tr. **ROW 12**—Ch 6, (7 tr in next lp, ch 17, sk 5 tr, tr in next tr) repeated around. Sl st in ch-6, sl st in 7 tr. **ROW 13**—Ch 6, (9 tr in next lp, ch 14, sk 7 tr, tr in next tr) repeated around and join. Fasten off.

PANSY—In Lavender, ch 8, sl st in 1st ch. Ch 2, (3 hdc in ring, ch 6, sl st in last hdc for a p) 5 times, sl st in 1st 2 hdc. **ROW 2**—* Ch 3, tr in next p, (ch 1, tr) 8 times in same p, ch 3, sc between ps on ring. Repeat from * 3 times. Ch 3, tr in next p, (ch 1, dtr) 11 times in same p, ch 1, tr in same p, ch 3, sc in ring. Fasten off. **Edge**—Join Pastels between 1st 2 petals, * ch 3, 2 dc in next ch-3, (ch 3, 2 dc in next sp) 9 times, ch 3, sc in ring between petals. Repeat from * once. ** Ch 3, sc in next ch-3 sp, (ch 5, sc in next sp) repeated around petal, ch 3, sc in ring. ** Ch 3, sc in next ch-3, (ch 5, sc in next sp) 6 times, ch 2, sl st in one lp on edge of Center, ch 2, sc back in next sp, (ch 5, sc in next sp) 6 times, ch 3, sc in ring. Repeat from ** to ** around final petal. Fasten off. Lap large bottom petal over side petals. Lap top petals over side petals. Lap right-hand top petal over left-hand top petal. Tack lightly. **2d Pansy**—Make Rows 1 and 2 in Pastels, Edge in Yellow. Join it to next loop on Center and join it to previous Pansy by center lp on side petal of each. **3d Pansy**—Make Row 1 and 2 in Rose, Edge in Pastels. **4th Pansy**—Make Rows 1 & 2 in Pastels, Edge in Lavender. **5th Pansy**—Make

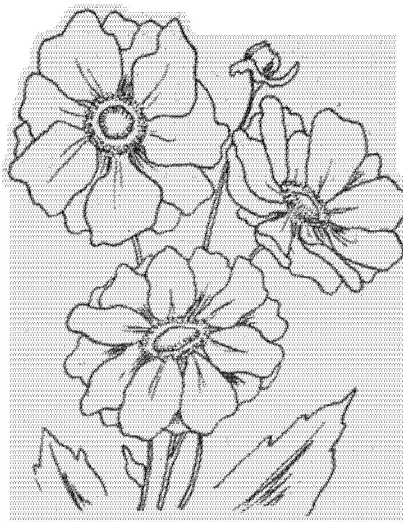
RIM—Working into remaining front lps on outer edge of Row 7, join, ch 3, dc in each st around. Join to top of ch 3. **ROW 2**—Ch 3, dc in each dc around and join. Repeat Rows 8 and 9, then make one row even without widenings. Fasten off. Cut a thick strip of cotton about 1/2" wide. Slip under rim all around. Skip one row of lps (Row 8) on Base, and sew edge of Rim down over cotton pad to lps on outer edge of Row 9 of Base. **TRIM**—Make one Ranunculus each in Lavender and Beauty Pink as for No. 5—Vanity Set, page 7. Sew on Rim 2 1/2" apart. Make a Hollyhock flower (as for No. 12 "Hollyhock Garden" Place Mat, page 14) in Shd. Pinks, and a 2d with Base in Beauty Pink and Petals in Beauty Rose. Tack tog. on Rim midway between Ranunculus. **Leaf**—In Hunter Green, * ch 15, sl st in 13th ch from hook, (ch 13, sl st) twice in same st. Repeat from * 4 times. Fasten off. Make 2 and tack on Rim between flowers. Wet back of Base with hot, thick starch. Stretch and pin down each lp around edge until dry. Repeat Coaster with Bases in Lt. Yellow, Baby Blue, etc. **LARGE COASTER**—(Size—8") — In Nile Green, repeat Base thru Row 11. **ROW 12**—Widen in every 8th st. **ROW 13**—Widen in every 13th st. **ROW 14**—Work even. **ROW 15**—Widen in every 9th st. **ROW 16**—Widen in every 10th st. Repeat Row 14. **ROW 18**—Widen in every 11th st. Repeat Edge. **RIM**—Working into remaining front lps on outer edge of Row 14, repeat Rows 1 and 2 of Rim, then repeat Rows 15 and 16, then make one row even. Sew down over cotton padding onto outer edge of Row 16 of Base. Make 2 Sets of Flowers and sew tog. around Rim. Starch back of Base.

Repeat from * around. End as in Row 15. **ROW 20**—Sl st in next ch-2 sp, ch 5, tr in same sp, * (ch 1, 2 dtr in next

Join as for Place Mat. **Center**—Repeat Rows 1 thru 4. **ROW 5**—Sl st in next 3 dc, ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, * (3 dc, ch 5, 3 dc) in ch-5, dc in next 3 dc, ch 9, sk 6 dc in angle dc in next 3 dc. Repeat from * around. GLASS DOILY—Make 3 flowers in each color. Ch 12, dc in next sc, (ch 9, dc in next sc) 4 times, ch 9, sl st in 3d st of ch-12. **ROW 2**—(5 sc, ch 3, 5 sc) in each lp. **Joining Row**—Sl st up to tip of 1st point, ch 6, sl st in free back petal

Dc in next dtr, 2 dc in next sp, ch 4, turn, sk last 6 dc, sl st in next dc, ch 1, turn, 5 sc in ch-4 lp, 2 dc in bal. of same sp on shell, dc in dtr, 4 dc in next sp, dc in dtr, ch 1, turn, sl st in last 4 dc, (ch 3, dtr) 5 times in center sc on added lp, ch 3, sk next 4 dc, sl st in the next 4 dc, ch 1, turn, ** (4 dc in next ch-3 sp, dc in dtr, a p) 5 times, 4 dc in next sp, sl st in end dc on shell, 4 dc in next sp, dc in dtr, a p, (3 dc in next sp, dc in next st, a p) 4 times. Repeat from * around, sl st in 1st ch-3, a p. Cut 6" long, thread to a needle and fasten off on back. **Ranunculus**—In Pink ch 6, sl st in 1st ch. * Ch 2, in 2d ch from hook make sc, hdc, 2 dc, hdc and sc, sc in ring. Repeat from * 5 more times (6 petals). **ROW 2**—* Ch 2, in 2d ch from hook make sc, hdc, 4 dc, hdc and sc, then, inserting hook from behind petals, make sc in back lp of sc between next 2 petals. Make another petal, sc in same sc. Repeat from * 5 times (12 petals). **ROW 3**—(Make a petal as in last row, sc in back lp of sc between next 2 petals) 12 times. Fasten off. Tack center to center of Block. In Green Floss embroider 3 leaves in Lazy Daisy Stitch from flower towards each corner of center square. Make a large Green French Knot in flower center.

2d BLOCK—Repeat to ** in Row 12, (4 dc in next sp, dc in dtr, a p) 3 times, 4 dc in next sp, dc in dtr, ch 2, sl st in matching p on 1st Block, ch 2, sl st back in last dc to complete joining p. Join each of the next 8 ps on each Block in same way then complete as for 1st Block. Make a Lavender flower for this Block. Continue to make and join blocks by 9 ps on each side, leaving the center p at each corner free. Alternate colors of flowers.

LARGE DOILY—Make 15 Blocks and join 3 x 5.

SMALL DOILY—Make 6 Blocks and join 2 x 3. Make 2d Doily. Stretch and pin doilies right-side-down in true shape on a well-padded board. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.



No. 7 Tablecloth "Sweet Springtime"

MATERIALS—Lily MERCROCHET Cotton size 30:—Large Balls—18-balls White and 8-balls Bright Nile Green; Small Balls—7-balls each Dk. Yellow, Blue, Beauty Pink and Dk. Lavender. Crochet hook size 13. Size—70 x 92 inches.

BLOCK—(Size—4 $\frac{3}{8}$ " when blocked)
—In White, ch 8, sl st in 1st ch. Ch 5, tr in ring, ch 3, holding back the last lp of each tr on hook, make 2 tr in ring, thread over and pull thru all lps on hook (a Cluster made), (ch 15, a 2-tr Cluster in ring, ch 3, a 2-tr Cluster in ring) 3 times, ch 15, sl st in 1st tr. Cut 3" long. **Leaves**—Turn, sk 1st 5 ch of one ch-15 lp, * 4 sc in Green across to center of lp, ch 9, a 3-dtr Cluster in 8th ch

from hook, ch 4, sl st in Cluster for a p, ch 8, sl st at base of Cluster, (ch 8, a 3-dtr Cluster in starting st of ch-8 a ch-4 p, ch 8, sl st at base of Cluster) twice, sk these 3 leaves, sc in 1-ch sp before 1st leaf, 3 sc in same corner ch-15, ch 2, 7 dtr between next 2 Clusters, ch 2, sk 1st 5 ch of next ch-15 lp and repeat from * around, working over end left from last row. End with ch 2, sl st in 1st sc. Cut 6" long, thread to a needle and fasten off on back. **ROW 3**—Turn, sc in White in center leaf at one corner, ch 12, sc in next leaf, * ch 9, dc in center dtr in next shell, ch 9, sc in next leaf, ch 9, (dc, ch 11, dc) in next (corner) leaf, ch 9, sc in next leaf. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 9, dc in 1st corner leaf, ch 5, tr in 3d st of 1st ch-12. **ROW 4**—Ch 12, turn, dc in next ch-9 lp, * (ch 9, dc in

next lp) repeated across to corner, ch 11, dc in same corner lp. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 9, dc in corner lp, ch 5, tr in 3d st of 1st ch-12. **ROW 5**—Ch 5, turn, 4 tr in last ch-5, (ch 9, dc in next lp) repeated around, with ch 9, (a 5 tr, ch 11, 5 tr shell) in corners. End with ch 9, 5 tr in 1st corner, ch 5, tr in top of 1st ch-5. Repeat Row 5 once. Fasten off. **Flower**—In Pink, ch 8, sl st in 1st ch. Ch 1, 12 sc in ring. In back lps only, sl st in 1st sc, (ch 2, 2 dc in same sc, 2 dc in next sc, ch 2, sl st in same sc, sl st in next sc) 6 times, ending with only 1 sc. Cut 8" long and use to sew flower on Block. Make one more flower each in Blue, Yellow and Lavender. Tack on Block in same color order, centering each on a dtr-shell between leaves in Green row. **No. 2—BLOCK**—Repeat to 2d corner in Row 6. Instead of corner ch-11, make * ch 5, sl st in one lp of center st of a corner lp on 1st Block, ch 5, 5 tr back in corner lp on 2d Block, * (ch 4, sl st in next lp on 1st Block, ch 4, dc back in next lp on 2d Block) repeated across to corner, ending with 5 tr in corner lp. Repeat from * to *, then complete as for 1st Block. Continue to make and join 16 rows of 21 Blocks, being careful to have the color placement of flowers the same in all Blocks.

EDGE—Join White to one corner, ch 5, a 2-tr Cluster in same lp, (ch 7, sl st in 5th ch from hook for a p, ch 3, a 3-tr Cluster in same corner lp) 3 times, * ch 1, (a 3-tr Cluster, ch 7, p, ch 3, a Cluster) all in next lp. Repeat from * around, making 4 Clusters in each corner (like 1st corner). Join and fasten off.

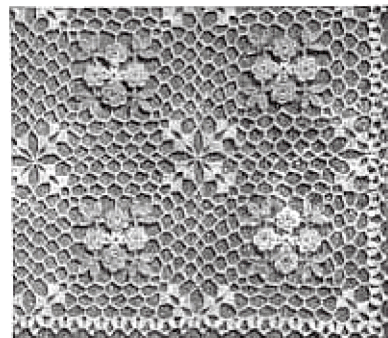
BLOCKING—Stretch and pin cloth right-side-down on curtain or quilting frames. Lay frames over an ironing board or padded table a section at a time. Steam and press dry each section thru a cloth until entire cloth is blocked.

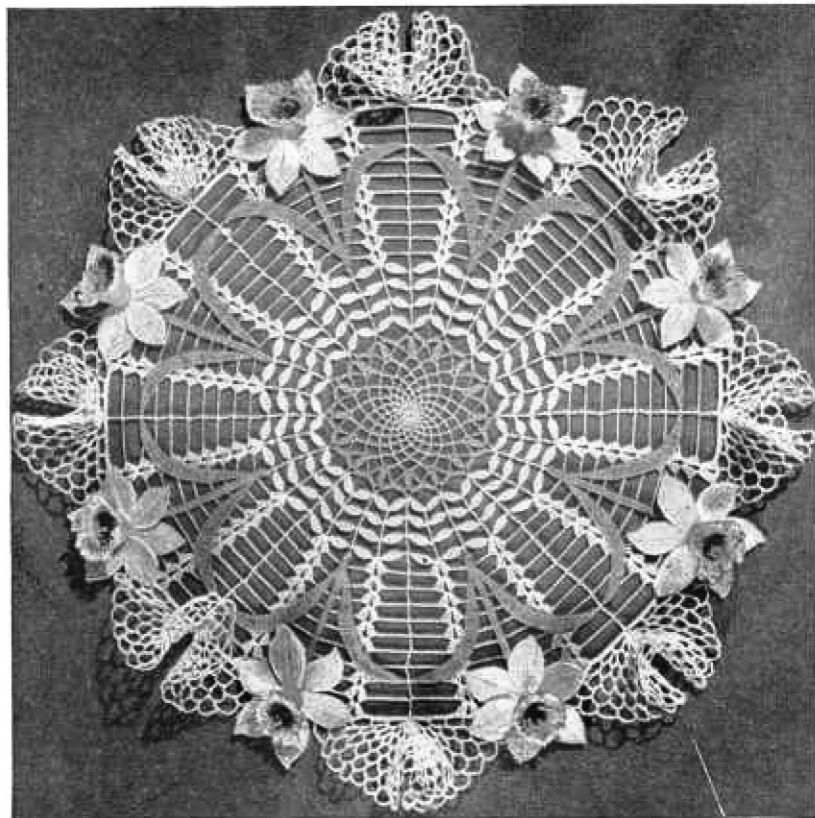

Ch 3, 15 dc in ring, sl st in top of ch-3. **ROW 2**—(Ch 5, sc in next dc) 15 times, ch 2, dc in next st. **ROW 3**—(Ch 5, sc in next lp) repeated around with ch 2 and dc for final lp. **ROW 4**—Repeat with ch-6 lps. **ROW 5**—Ch 7 lps with ch 3 and dc for final lp. **ROW 6**—Ch-8 lps. **ROW 7**—Ch-9 lps with ch 4 and tr final lp. **ROW 8**—(Ch 9, dc in 6th ch from hook, ch 4, sc in next lp) repeated around. Fasten off. **ROW 9**—In Dk. Yellow, sc in one lp, ch 10, * holding back the last lp of each tr on hook, make 3 tr in same lp, thread over and pull thru all lps on hook (a Cluster made), ch 5, tr in same lp, tr in next lp, ch 5. Repeat from * around. Join to 5th st of ch-10. **ROW 10**—(5 sc in next sp, ch 5, sk Cluster, 5 sc in next sp) repeated around. Join and fasten off. **ROW 11**—In White, sc in a ch-5 lp, * ch 8, a 3-dtr Cluster in 8th ch from hook, ch 1, sc in next point. Repeat from * around. **ROW 12**—Ch 6 for a tr, (ch 8, a Cluster in 8th ch from hook, ch 1, tr between next 2 Clusters) repeated around. Join to top of 1st ch-6. **ROW 13**—Ch 6, for

a tr, (ch 10, a 3-tr tr Cluster in 10th ch from hook, ch 1, tr between next 2 Clusters) repeated around. Join to top of 1st ch-6. **ROW 14**—Ch 6 for a tr, (ch 11, a 3-tr tr Cluster in 10th ch from hook, ch 2, tr between next 2 Clusters) repeated around and join. **ROW 15**—Ch 7 for a dtr, * ch 10, (a 3 tr, ch 3, 3 tr shell) in next tr, ch 10, dtr in next tr. Repeat from * around. Sl st in 7th st of 1st lp. **ROW 16**—Ch 6 for a tr, (ch 11, a shell in sp of next shell, ch 11, tr in next dtr) repeated around. Join in 6th st of 1st lp. **ROW 17**—Like last row but with ch-12 lps. Make 7 more rows with lps 1-ch longer in each row (ch-19 in final Row 24). **ROW 25**—Ch 1, sc in same st with sl st, * 20 sc in next lp, 9 sc across shell, 20 sc in next lp, sc in tr, ch 6, sl st in last sc for a p. Repeat from * around. End with sl st in 1st sc, a p. Fasten off. **Frill**—Turn, * join in 8th sc to right of one p, (ch 5, tr) 11 times in p, ch 5, sk 7 sc, sl st in next 8 sc. **ROW 2**—Turn, (ch 7, dc) twice in each ch-5 lp, ch 7, sk 6 sc, sl st in next 8 sc. **ROW 3**—Turn, (ch 8, dc in next lp) repeated around, ch 8, sk 6 sc, sl st in next 8 sc. Repeat Row 3 three times with lps of 9-ch, 10-ch and 11-ch. Fasten off. Repeat in every 2d p (8 Frills). **Daffodil—Petals**—In Lt. Yellow, ch 18, sl st in 1st st. * Ch 22, making sts looser than usual. Sk last ch and working tightly again, make sc in next ch, hdc in next. Holding back the last lp of each dc on hook, make dc in next 2 ch, thread over and pull

thru all 3 lps on hook (a Cluster made), tr in next 2 ch, (dtr in next 2 ch made into a Cluster, dtr in next 2 ch) twice, tr in next 2 ch made into a Cluster, tr in next 2 ch, dc in next 2 ch made into a Cluster, hdc in next (end) ch, sc in ring. Ch 1, turn, sk sc, sc in next 15 sts, 2 sc in end sc. Ch 3, turn, sl st in last sc, sc in next sc, hdc in next, 2 dc in next, tr in next 2 sc, (2 dtr in next sc, dtr in next 2 sc) twice, 2 tr in next sc, tr in next 2 sc, 2 dc in next sc, hdc in next, sc in ring. Repeat from * 5 times. Cut 8" long to use in sewing petals and cup tog. **Cup**—In Dk. Yellow, ch 7, sl st in 1st st. Ch 3, 12 dc in ring, sl st in top of ch-3. Ch 3, dc in same st, (2 dc in next dc) 12 times, sl st in top of ch-3. (Ch 2, hdc in next 25 dc, sl st in top of ch-2) for 6 rows. **ROW 9**—Ch 8, sl st in starting st of ch-8, ch 7, sl st in same st, ch 7, sc in next hdc, ch 5, sc in next hdc) 13 times. Fasten off. Insert Row 1 of Cup thru ring of petals and sew in place. Make 8. **Stem**—In Green, ch 55, sk last 2 ch, hdc in each ch to end. Fasten off. Make 8. **Leaf**—In Green, ch 50 loosely, sk last ch and working tightly again, make (2 sc, 2 hdc, 2 dc, 4 tr, 23 dtr, 4 tr, 4 dc, 4 hdc, 3 sc in 1 sl st) on ch. Fasten off. Make 16, Tack a Stem up each line of tr between Frills, starting at Row 14 (final Clus-

ter row). Tack a Leaf on each side of each Stem 1/2" from bottom end, turning left-hand leaves wrong-side-up. Dip doily in hot, thick starch. Roll in a cloth to absorb excess. Stretch until pattern is opened up and pin right-side-up in a true circle. Press center thru a cloth. As starch sets, arrange Frills in even ripples. Rub back of Daffodil petals and inside of cups with starch. Pin petals flat with cups tipped over at an angle. When dry, sew stamens in place and tack flowers at top of stems between Frills. **SMALL DOILY**—(Size — 12") — In Lt. Yellow, ch 8, sl st in 1st ch. Ch 1, 12 sc in ring, sl st in 1st sc. (Ch 5, sc in next sc) 11 times, ch 2, dc in next sc. Repeat Rows 3, 5, 7, 8, 9 and 10. **ROW 9**—Sc in White in one point, (ch 8, a 3-dtr Cluster in 8th ch from hook, ch 10, a Cluster in 8th ch from hook, ch 1, sc in next point) repeated around. **ROW 10**—Ch 6, for a tr, (ch 9, a 3-dtr Cluster in 8th ch from hook, ch 1, tr between next 2 Clusters) repeated around and join to top of 1st ch-6. **ROW 11**—Ch 7 for a dtr, * ch 7, (a 3 tr, ch 3, 3 tr shell) in next tr, ch 7, dtr in next tr. Repeat from * around. Join to top of 1st ch-7. **ROW 12**—Ch 6 for a tr, (ch 9, a shell in sp of next shell, ch 9, tr in next dtr) repeated around and join. Continue for 5 more rows with lps of 11-ch, 12-ch, 13-ch, 15-ch and 16-ch. **ROW 18**—Ch 1, sc in same st with sl st,

(17 sc in next lp, 9 sc across shell, 17 sc in next lp, sc in tr, a 6-ch p) repeated around. Sl st in 1st sc, a p. Fasten off. **Frill**—With work right-side-up, repeat Frill beginning at *, but omit final row of 11-ch lps. Make 6 Frills. Make 6 Stems, starting with ch-40. **Leaf**—Ch 37, sk last ch, (2 sc, 2 hdc, 2 dc, 4 tr, 14 dtr, 3 tr, 3 dc, 3 hdc, 2 sc and 1 sl st) on ch. Fasten off. Make 12. Sew to bottom of Stems. Make 6 Daffodils. Assemble and starch as for Large Doily. Make a 2d Small Doily.

Fasten off. **Edge**—Join White to 1st free back petal on outside of one flower, * (ch 19, sc in next back petal of same flower) twice, ch 19, sc in 1st free back petal of next flower. Repeat from * around. Fasten off. Repeat Row 2 of Edge on Place Mat. Stretch and pin dollies right-side-down in true circle on a padded board. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

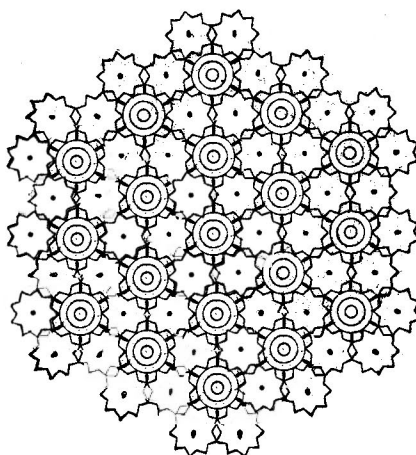
"Daisy Garlands"

MATERIALS—Lily MERCROCHET Cotton:—7-small balls White size 30; 2-large balls Dk. Yellow size 20. 1-ball Lily Pearl Cotton size 5 in Black. Crochet hooks sizes 13 and 5. Size—28 x 30 inches.

DAISY BLOCK—(Size—3")—In Yellow and size 13 hook, ch 8, sl st in 1st ch. Ch 3, 17 dc in ring, sl st in top of ch-3. **Petals**—* Ch 14, sk last 3 ch, sc in next 2 ch, hdc in 2 ch, (holding back the last lp of each dc on hook, make dc in next 2 ch, thread over and pull thru all 3 lps on hook) twice, 1 dc and 2 hdc on bal. of ch, sk 1 dc on center, sl st in next dc. Repeat from * 8 times. Cut 6" long, thread to a needle and fasten off on back. Make a 2d row and tack on top of 1st row with petals between those of 1st row. **Center**—With Black Pearl Cotton and size 5 hook, ch 2, 6 sc in 2d ch from hook. **ROW 2**—2 sc in back lp of each sc. **ROW 3**—1 sc in back lp of each sc around. Sl st in next sc. Cut 8" long. Stuff lightly with cotton and sew in place. **Edge**—Join White with size 13 hook to one back petal, * ch 3, (dc, ch 6, dc) all in tip of next (front) petal, ch 6, sc in next (back) petal. Repeat from * around. **ROW 2**—* Ch 5, dc between next 2 dc, (ch 2, dc) twice in same sp, ** ch 5, dc in same sp, (ch 2, dc) twice in same sp, ch 5, sc in next sc between points. Repeat from * around. Cut 6" long, thread to a needle and fasten off on back.

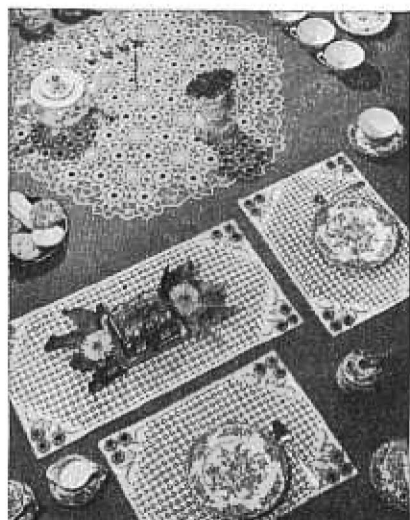
2d BLOCK—Repeat to ** in Row 2 of Edge. Ch 2, sl st in one point in 1st Block, ch 2, dc back in same sp on 2d Block, (ch 2, dc) twice in same sp, ch 5, sc in next sc between points. Join the next point in same way to next points on 1st Block, then complete 2d Block as for 1st one. Make 4 more Blocks, joining these 6 into a circle by 2 points on each side of each, leaving one point free on each Block on inside of circle, 4 free points on outside of each.

FILL-IN MOTIF—In White, ch 8, sl st in 1st st. Ch 9, tr in ring, (ch 3, tr) 10 times in ring, ch 3, sl st in 6th st of ch-9. **ROW 2**—Ch 1, sc in same st, * 2 sc in next sp, ch 5, sl st in last sc for a p, 1 sc in same sp, sc in next tr. Repeat from * around. Sl st in 1st sc. **ROW 3**—Ch 14, tr between next 2 ps, (ch 8, tr between next 2 ps) repeated around, ch 8, sl st in 6th st of ch-14. **ROW 4**—Ch 1, sc in same st, * (4 sc, a p, 4 sc) all in next sp, sc in tr. Repeat from * around. Sl st in 1st sc. **ROW 5**—Ch 19, tr between next 2 ps, (ch 13, tr between next 2 ps) repeated around. Join to 6th st of ch-19. **Joining Row**—8 sc in next sp, sl st in free point on one Block, * 8 sc back in bal. of same sp, 8 sc in next sp, ch 12, sl st in joining of Blocks, ch 12, sl st back in last sc, 8 sc in bal. of same sp, 8 sc in next



sp, sl st in free point on next Block. Repeat from * around. Fasten off. Following Chart, make and join 54 Blocks, filling in the 19 openings between Blocks with Fill-In Motifs.

BORDER—Join White to 1st free point on Block marked "A" on Chart. * (Ch 8, sc in 5th st from hook for a p, ch 8, p, ch 10, p, ch 8, p, ch 4, sc in next point) 3 times, (ch 8, p) twice, ch 4, a long tr (thread over 6 times and work off in twos) down in joining of Blocks, (ch 8, p) twice, ch 4, sc in next point. Repeat from * once. ** (Ch 8, p) twice, ch 4, a long tr in next joining of Blocks, ch 30, turn, sk last 2 p-lps, sl st in next long tr, ch 1, turn, 33 sc in lp, sl st in long tr, (ch 8, p) twice, ch 4, sc in next point, ** (ch 8, p, ch 8, p, ch 10, p, ch 8, p, ch 4, sc in next point) 3 times, (ch 8, p) twice, ch 4, a long tr in next joining of Blocks, (ch 8, p) twice, ch 4, sc in next point. Repeat from ** to **. Repeat from * around. Fasten off. **ROW 2**—Sc in center of next (1st) p-lp, ** (ch 30, sc in next p-lp) twice, ch 10, a long tr in next long tr, (ch 5, a long tr) 5 times in same long tr, ch 10, sc in next large p-lp, * (ch 30, sc in next p-lp) twice, ch 10, a long tr in 8th sc on next (Cont. on Page 12)



"Cornflower"

MATERIALS—Lily MERCROCHET Cotton size 20:—11-balls White, 1-ball each Dk. Blue and Bright Nile Green, and 3-balls Blue. Sufficient for Centerpiece and 4 Place Mats. Crochet hook size 13.

PLACE MAT—In White, ch 190, sk last 4 ch, dc in 186 ch. **ROW 2**—Ch 5, turn, sk last dc, tr in next 73 dc, * ch 6, sk 4 dc, sc in next dc, ch 3, turn, 6 dc on ch-6, ch 3, turn, dc in 6 dc, sk next 4 dc on last row, tr in next dc. Repeat from * 3 times. Tr in 73 sts to end of row. **ROW 3**—Ch 5, turn, sk last tr, tr in next 73 tr, (ch 5, sk 5 dc on next square, sc in next dc, ch 5, tr down in next tr) 4 times, 73 tr across to end ch-5. Work the solid-tr corners very tightly for best effect. **ROW 4**—Ch 5, turn, sk last tr, tr in each tr across solid corner to within 11th tr from end (10 less tr than last row), * ch 6; sk 4 tr, sc in next tr, ch 3, turn, 6 dc on ch-6, ch 3, turn, dc in 6 dc, sk 4 tr, tr in next (end) tr on corner, (ch 6, sc in next sc, ch 3, turn, 6 dc on ch-6, ch 3, turn, dc in 6 dc, tr in next tr) repeated across to first tr on solid corner. Ch 6, sk 4 tr, sc in next tr, ch 3, turn, 6 dc on ch-6, ch 3, turn, dc in 6 dc, sk 4 tr, tr in next tr, tr in each remaining tr across corner to end ch-5. **ROW 5**—Ch 5, turn, sk last tr, tr in each remaining tr across solid corner, * (ch 5, sk 5 dc on next square, sc in next dc, ch 5, tr in next tr) repeated across squares, tr in each tr across corner to end ch-5. Repeat Rows 4 and 5 five times. **ROW 16**—Ch 5, turn, sk last tr, tr in next 3 tr, * ch 6, sk 4 tr, sc in next tr, ch 3, turn, 6 dc on ch-6, ch 3, turn, dc in 6 dc, sk 4 tr, tr in next tr, * (ch 6, sc in next sc, ch 3, turn, 6 dc on ch-6, ch 3, turn, dc in 6 dc, tr in next tr) 16 times. Repeat from * to *. Tr in remaining 3 sts. **ROW 17**—Ch 5, turn, sk last tr, tr in next 3 tr, * (ch 5, sk 5 dc on next square, sc in next dc, ch 5, tr down in next tr) * repeated across, ending with 4 tr. **ROW 18**—Ch 5, turn, sk last tr, tr in next 3 tr, * (ch 6, sc in next sc, ch 3, turn, 6 dc on ch-6, ch 3, turn, dc in 6 dc, tr down in next tr) * repeated across, ending with 4 tr. Repeat Rows 17 and 18 thru 21 pattern rows of squares, ending with Row 17. **End**—**ROW 44**—Ch 5, turn, sk last tr, tr in next 3 tr, (4 tr in next sp, tr in next st) twice. Repeat from * to * in Row 18 sixteen times. Tr in remaining 13 sts. **ROW 45**—Ch 5, turn, sk last tr, tr in next 13 tr. Repeat from * to * in Row 17 across, ending with 14 tr. **ROW 46**—Ch 5, turn, sk last tr, tr in each remaining tr across solid corner, (4 tr in next sp, tr in next st) twice. Repeat Row 18 from * to * across making one less pattern square at end (as at start) than in last pat (Cont. on Page 14—Col. 1)

MATERIALS—Lily MERCROCHET COTTON size 20:—1-ball each Shd. Peaches and Shd. Greens. Lily Six Strand Floss:—2-sks. each Green and Brown. Crochet hooks sizes 12 and 3.

Brown linen or Indian Head.

FLOWER—In Shd. Peaches and size 12 hook, ch 8, sl st in 1st st. Ch 3, 19 dc in ring, sl st in top of ch-3. **Petal**—* Ch 33 loosely, sk last ch and working very tightly again, sc in next ch, 2 sc in next, hdc in 2 ch, dc in 3 ch, holding back on hook the last lp of each dc, make dc in next 2 ch, thread over and pull thru all 3 lps on hook (Cluster made), tr in 2 ch, (tr in 2 ch) made into a Cluster, tr in 2 ch, (dtr in 2 ch made into a Cluster, dtr in next ch) twice, (tr in 2 ch) made into a Cluster, tr in 3 ch, (dc in 2 ch) made into a Cluster, hdc in 2 ch, 2 sc in next ch, 1 sc in next, sl st in next dc on center ring. **ROW 2**—Ch 1, turn, sk sl st, sc in next 2 sts, hdc in 2 sts, dc in 2 sts, tr in next st, (tr in 2 sts) made into a Cluster, dtr in 2 sts, (dtr in 2 sts) made into a Cluster, dtr in 3 sts, (tr in 2 sts) made into a Cluster, tr in next st, (dc in 2 sts) made into a Cluster, dc in next st, hdc in 2 sts, sl st in next st. **ROW 3**—Ch 1, turn, sk last st, sc in 20 sts, sl st in next dc on ring. **ROW 4**—Ch 1, turn, sk sl st, sc in 2 sts, hdc in 2 sts, dc in 2 sts, tr in next st, 2 tr in next, dtr in 2 sts, 2 dtr in next

st, dtr in 3 sts, 2 tr in next st, tr in next, 2 dc in next st, 1 dc in next, hdc in 2 sts, sc in next, sl st in next (3d from end). **ROW 5**—Ch 1, turn, sk sl st, sc in next st, hdc in 2 sts, dc in 3 sts, 2 dc in next st, tr in 2 sts, 2 tr in next st, tr in 2 sts, dtr in 2 sts, 2 dtr in next st, dtr in 2 sts, 2 tr in next st, tr in 2 sts, 2 tr in next st, dc in next, hdc in next, sc in 2 sts, sl st in next 3 dc on ring. Repeat from * thru 3 more petals. Fasten off. Using Green Floss, cover center ring closely with French Knots, widening 4 times around needle. Make 4 Flowers.

SMALL LEAF—In Shd. Greens, ch 32, sk last ch, * (3 sc, 2 hdc, 2 dc, 3 tr, 12 dtr, 4 tr, 1 dc, 2 hdc and 1 sc) * on ch, (sc, ch 3, sc) in end ch. Repeat from * to * on other side of ch. **Stem**—Ch 5, sk last ch, sl st in 4 ch, sl st in leaf. Fasten off. Make 5.

LARGE LEAF—Ch 38, sk last ch. * (2 sc, 2 hdc, 2 dc, 3 tr, 4 dtr, 12 tr tr, 4 dtr, 4 tr, 1 dc, 1 hdc and 1 sc) * on ch, (sc, ch 3, sc) in end ch. Repeat from * to * on other side of ch. Repeat Small Leaf Stem. Make 3.

TINY LEAVES—* Ch 20, sk last 2 ch, (1 sc, 1 hdc, 2 dc, 2 tr, 7 dtr, 2 tr, 1 dc, 1 hdc and 1 sl st) on ch. Repeat from * once. Fasten off. Make 3.

BUD—In Shd. Peaches, repeat Tiny Leaves except make 3 petals. Make 3 Buds.

MAIN STEM—(lengthwise of doily)—Use size 3 hook and Six Strand Floss in Brown and Green held tog. Ch 12, sk last ch, sl st in next 3 ch, ch 23, sk last ch, sl st in next 19 ch, ch 53, sk last ch, sl st in 8 ch, ch 25, sk last ch, sl st in 24 ch, sl st in next 20 ch, ch 5, sk last ch, sl st in 4 ch, sl st in each ch to end. Fasten off.

TOP LEFT CORNER—Short Stem—Ch 16, sl st in 4th ch from hook, ch 3, sl st in same ch, sl st in each ch to end. Fasten off. **Long Stem**—Ch 22, 21 sl sts on ch. Repeat this Stem for Lower Left Corner Stem.

TOP RIGHT STEM—Ch 24, sk last ch, sl st in next 3 ch, ch 33, sk last ch, sl st in 20-ch, ch 5, sk last ch, sl st in 4 ch, sl st in next 17 ch, ch 35, sl st in 4th ch from hook, ch 3, sl st in same st, sl st in next 23 ch, ch 5, sk last ch, sl st in 4 ch, sl st in each ch to end. Fasten off.

LOWER RIGHT CORNER STEM—Ch 30, 29 sl sts on ch. Fasten off. Cut cloth 12 x 18 inches. Make ¼" hem all around. In Shd. Peaches and size 12 hook, make sc over hem in one corner, (ch 2, sc) 3 times in same place, (ch 2, sc) repeated around, spacing sc so 2-chs are taut. Make all corners like 1st one. Join. **ROW 2**—(Sc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, sc) in each ch-2 sp around. Join and fasten off.

Following illustration, pin motifs on cloth. Turn all stems wrong-side-up. Hem edge of Motifs down closely. Stretch and pin doily right-side-down on a padded board. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

½-yd. Green organdy.

BORDER—In Green, ch 13, tr in starting st. **ROW 2**—Ch 10, turn, tr in tr, ch 3, sk 3 ch, tr in next tr. **ROW 3**—Ch 8, turn, tr in next tr, ch 3, sk 3 ch, (tr, ch 3, dtr) in next ch. **ROW 4**—Ch 10, turn, tr in dtr, (ch 3, tr in next tr) repeated across to 4th st on end ch. **ROW 5**—Ch 8, turn, tr in next tr, (ch 3, tr in next tr) repeated across to 4th st of end ch, ch 3, dtr in same st. **ROW 6**—Ch 11, turn, tr in dtr, (ch 3, tr in next tr) 5 times across to 4th st of end ch. **ROW 7**—Ch 8, turn, tr in next tr, (ch 3, tr in next tr) twice, ch 3, holding back the last lp on each st on hook make tr in next tr, dtr in next tr, thread over and pull thru all 3 lps on hook (Cluster made). **ROW 8**—Ch 6, turn, sk Cluster, tr in next tr, (ch 3, tr in next tr) 3 times to 4th st on end ch. **ROW 9**—Ch 8, turn, tr in next tr, ch 3, (tr in next tr, dtr in next) made into a Cluster. **ROW 10**—Ch 6, turn, tr in next tr, ch 3, tr in 4th st of end ch. **ROW 11**—Ch 8, turn, tr in next tr. Repeat Rows 2 thru 11 five times for long side. **Corner**—Repeat Rows 2, 3, 4, 5, and 4. Ch 8, turn, tr in next tr, (ch 3, tr in next tr) 4 times, ch 3, sk 3 ch, * (tr, ch 8, tr) all in next ch,—completing corner. Repeat Rows 2 thru 11 four times for end. Repeat Corner. Repeat Rows 2 thru 11 six times for long side. Repeat Corner. Repeat Rows 2 thru 11 four times for end. Repeat Corner to *, tr in next ch. Fasten off and with work untwisted, sew ends tog.

OUTSIDE EDGE—In Green, 2 sc in 1st sp to right of a corner sp, ch 4, sl st in last sc for a p, 2 sc in same sp, (4 sc, a p, 4 sc) in corner sp, * (2 sc, p, 2 sc) in next sp, (4 sc in next sp) twice, a p, (4 sc in next sp) twice. Repeat from * around with corners like 1st one. Join and fasten off.

INSIDE EDGE—Join Green to the 11-ch lp at tip of one point, ch 3, 4 dc in same lp, * 5 dc in center st of same lp, 4 dc in bal. of lp, (dc in next st, 5 dc in next sp) 4 times, (dc in next st, 3 dc in next sp in angle, dc in next st) worked off tog. into a Cluster, (5 dc in next sp, dc in next st) 4 times, 5 dc in next lp. Repeat from * around. Across corners, make 5 dc in each sp, dc in each st between sps. Join and fasten off. Lay Border over organdy in true shape. Hem down the inner edge closely. Cut cloth ¼" outside stitching, turn edge back twice and hem down on back of dc-row.

LARGE LEAVES—In Green, ch 9, sl st in 1st st. Ch 1, (sc, hdc, 2 dc, 2

(Lower Doily in Illustration)

MATERIALS—Lily MERCROCHET Cotton size 20:—4-balls White, 6-balls Baby Blue and 1-ball each Beauty Pink, Blue and Hunter Green. Lily Six Strand Floss:—4-sk. Dk. Yellow. (Sufficient for 4 Place Mats). Crochet hook size 13. Size—12 x 18 inches.

In Baby Blue, ch 15" long, 7 tr in 12th ch from hook, ch 3, sk 5 ch, dc in next ch, (ch 3, sk 5 ch, a 7-tr shell in next ch, ch 3, sk 5 ch, dc in next ch) 13 times. Cut and rip excess ch. The right side of shell-rows is right side of doily. **ROW 2**—Ch 5, turn, * dc in 1st tr of next shell, ch 4, (dc, ch 4, dc) in center tr of same shell, ch 4, dc in end tr of same shell, ch 1 and repeat from * across. ** After final dc, tr in next 4th ch. **ROW 3**—Ch 6, turn,

3 tr in tr, * (ch 3, sk next ch-4 sp, sc between next 2 dc, ch 3, sk next ch-4 sp, a 7-tr shell in one lp of ch-1 between next 2 dc) repeated across.

* End with ch 3, 4 tr in top of end ch-5 (a half-shell). **ROW 4**—Ch 6, turn, dc in last tr, ch 4, sk 2 tr, dc in next tr, ch 1 and repeat Row 2 from * to **. End with ch 4, (dc, ch 2, dc) all in end ch-6. **ROW 5**—Ch 1, turn, sc in last dc, ch 3, sk next 2 dc, a 7-tr shell in one lp of next ch-1 sp. Repeat Row 3 from * to *. After final shell, ch 3, sc in end ch-6 lp. Repeat Rows 2, 3, 4 and 5 eleven times and Rows 2 and 3 again (26 rows of shells),—to measure about 11" long when stretched and blocked.

END BAND—Ch 1, turn, sc in last

Ch 5, p, ch 2, sc in corner, (ch 5, p, ch 2, sc between next 2 rows) repeated across long side. Continue around in same way with an extra loop at each corner. Fasten off.

CORNFLOWER—In Blue, ch 10, sl st in 1st ch, ch 3, 17 dc in ring, sl st in top of ch-3. * Ch 11, sl st in 11th ch from hook, (ch 10, sl st in same st) 3 times, sc in next dc. Repeat from * 17 times. Cut 6" long, thread to a needle and fasten off on back. **Center**—In Dk. Blue, * ch 11, sl st in 11th ch from hook, (ch 10, sl st in same st) 3 times. Repeat from * 3 times. Sl st at base of 1st group. Cut 8" long and use to tack Center in flower.

LEAVES FOR LEFT TOP CORNER

1st Leaf—Starting at left side, in Green ch 36, sk last ch and working tightly, make 4 sc, 4 hdc, 20 dc, 3 hdc, 3 sc and 1 sl st on ch. Fasten off. Use wrong-side-up. **2d Leaf and Stem**—Ch 21, sk last ch, 15 sc and 1 sl st on ch, * ch 25, sk last ch, 3 sc, 3 hdc, 12 dc, 2 hdc and 4 sc on ch. * 3 sc and 1 sl st in stem ch. Fasten off. Use right-side-up.

2d Spray—Ch 18, sk last ch, 3 sc, 3 hdc, 4 dc, 2 hdc, 2 sc and 1 sl st on ch. Ch 33, sk last ch and make sc to end of ch. Ch 20, sk last ch, 3 sc, 3 hdc, 8 dc, 2 hdc, 2 sc and 1 sl st on ch. Fasten off. Use right-side-up.

3d Spray—**1st Leaf**—Repeat 2d Leaf from * to *. Use wrong-side-up.

Next Leaf and Stem—Ch 40, sk last ch, 4 sc, 4 hdc, 18 dc, 2 hdc, 1 sc and 1 sl st on ch. Ch 16, sk last ch and make sc to end of ch. Fasten off. Use right-side-up.

Tack 3 flowers on corner, arrange leaves and stems in order and hem down closely. Repeat on lower right corner. For other 2 corners reverse all leaves and stems.

CENTERPIECE—Make center section 12 pattern squares longer before starting final END. Repeat END for a total of 40 pattern squares. Repeat Final Row of dc, make Edge around. Make flowers and leaves for each corner.

Stretch and pin dollies right-side-down in true shape on a padded board. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

Repeat from * across. **ROW 3**—Ch 3, turn, sk last dc, dc in each dc across. Repeat thru 29 White rows, working very tightly.

EDGE—Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in last dc, sc in each dc across, 3 sc in end st, 3 sc in end of each row across end of Band, 5 sc in each sp to corner, 10 sc in corner sp, (5 sc in next sp, sc in dc, 5 sc in next sp) repeated across, 10 sc in corner sp. Continue around in same way. End with 1 sc in 1st corner, sl st in 1st sc. **ROW 2**—Ch 20, sc in same corner, (ch 17, sk 9 sc, sc in next) repeated around with a ch-20 lp in each corner.

ROW 3—25 sc in each corner lp and 19 sc in each ch-17 lp. **ROW 4**—Sl st in 1st 6 sc, ch 3, dc in next 2 sc, * (ch 4, sc in 4th ch from hook for a p) 3 times, ch 1, sk 1 sc, dc in next 3 sc. Repeat from * twice. (Sk 6 sc on next lp, dc in next 3 sc, a 3-p lp, sk 1 sc, dc in next 3 sc) repeated to corner. Sk 5 sc on corner lp, dc in next 3 sc. Repeat from * around, join and fasten off.

PINK LARKSPUR—In Pink, * ch 13, sc in 3d st from hook, hdc in next ch, dc in 2 ch, ch 1, sk 1 ch, sl st in next ch, (ch 7, sc in 3d st from hook, hdc in next ch, dc in 2 ch, ch 1, sk 1 ch, sl st in same st with sl st at end of previous petal) 4 times (completing one flower). Repeat from * thru 15 flowers. **End**—(Ch 9, sk last 2 ch, sc, hdc and 2 dc on ch, ch 1, sk 1 ch, sl st in next ch) twice, (ch 8, sl st in 7th ch from hook) 3 times. Fasten off.

CENTER BLUE LARKSPUR—Repeat thru 20 flowers. Repeat End.

3d LARKSPUR—In Baby Blue, repeat thru 12 flowers. Repeat End. **1st STEM**—In Green, make a ch 2 1/2" long, sk last st, sc in each remaining ch. Fasten off.

2d STEM—Make ch 3" long. **3d STEM**—Make ch 2 1/2" long.

RIBBON—In Pink, ch 210 loosely. Working tightly again, sk last 3 ch, 3 dc in next ch, dc in each remaining ch. **ROW 2**—Ch 1, turn, sl st in last dc, (ch 2, sl st in next 2 dc) repeated to end. Fasten off. Make a short piece for center of bow.

Tack Larkspurs on End Band, overlapping flowers in a zigzag spike. In Yellow Floss, make a French Knot in center of each flower. Tack Stems in place, from ribbon into a bow and tack over Stems.

Stretch and pin dolly right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

tr, 11 dtr, 2 tr, 2 dc, 1 hdc and 1 sc) all in ring. Ch 1, turn, sc in last sc, hdc in next st, 2 hdc in next, 2 dc in each st around to 5th from end, 2 hdc in next st, 1 hdc in next, sc in next, ch 15, sk last ch, 14 sc on ch. Sl st in leaf. Fasten off. Make 11.

RIGHT END TALL PLANT

— In Green, ch 35. **1st LEAF**—In 2d ch from hook make 1 sc, 1 hdc, 2 dc, 2 tr, 11 dtr, 2 tr, 2 dc, 1 hdc and 1 sc. 4 sc on ch, ch 25. **2d Leaf**—In 2d ch from hook make 1 sc, 1 hdc, 2 dc, 11 tr, 2 dc, 1 hdc and 1 sc. 3 sc on ch, ** ch 20 and repeat 2d Leaf, 3 sc on ch. * Ch 30. **3d Leaf**—In 2d ch from hook make 1 sc, 1 hdc, 2 dc, 5 tr, 2 dc, 1 hdc and 1 sc. 3 sc on ch, ch 25.

4th Leaf—In 2d ch from hook make 1 sc, 1 hdc, 3 dc, 1 hdc and 1 sc. Ch 10, sk last 8 ch, sl st in next 2 ch, sk leaf, 3 sc on next ch, ch 3 and repeat 4th Leaf, 1 sc on leaf stem, 10 sc on main stem, ch 4 and repeat 3d Leaf, 2 sc on leaf stem, 10 sc on main stem, sk leaf, 10 sc on next stem, ch 5, repeat 2d Leaf, 3 sc on stem, 16 sc on main stem, hdc in opposite leaf stem, * 7 sc on next stem, ch 5, repeat 2d Leaf, 3 sc on stem, 7 sc on main stem, hdc in opposite leaf stem, ** 20 sc on next stem, hdc in opposite leaf stem, 4 sc on next stem, ch 5, repeat 1st Leaf, 3 sc on stem, 24 hdc on main stem, sc in end st. Fasten off. Sew on organdy starting 1 1/4" from bottom border and 1 1/4" from right end border. **Flower**

—**Base**—In Shd. Pinks, ch 8, sl st in 1st st. Ch 3, 17 dc in ring, sl st in top of ch-3. (4 hdc in next dc, sc in next) 9 times. Fasten off. **Petals**—* Ch 8, sl st in 8th ch from hook. (ch 7, sl st in same st) 5 times. Repeat from * 3 times. Sl st at base of 1st group. Tack on Base. Make 11 flowers and tack along both sides of stem.

2d PLANT—Ch 35, repeat 1st Leaf, 4 sc on stem. Repeat from * to *. 4 sc on next stem, ch 5, repeat 1st Leaf, 3 sc in stem, 24 hdc on main stem, sc in end st. Fasten off. Tack close to 1st Plant. Make 6 flowers, the Base of each in Beauty Rose, Petals in Beauty Pink, and tack along stem. Tack 7 Large Leaves across base of plants.

3d PLANT (at left end)—Ch 35, repeat 1st Leaf, 4 sc on stem. Repeat from ** to **. 4 sc on next stem, ch 5, repeat 1st Leaf, 3 sc on stem, 24 hdc on main stem, sc in end st. Fasten off. Make 8 Flowers, the Base of each in Beauty Pink, Petals in Beauty Rose, and tack along stem. Tack 4 Large Leaves at base of plant.

Stretch and pin dolly right-side-down in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

Table Doily Set No. 14

MATERIALS—Lily MERCROCHET Cotton size 30:—Large Balls—3-balls Shd. Pinks and 2-balls each Shd. Greens and Bright Nile Green. Small Balls—1-ball each Gray and Dk. Yellow. Sufficient for Centerpiece, 4 Place Mats and 4 Glass Doilies. Crochet hook size 13. Linen or Indian Head in Green.

DESERT ROSE—In Shd. Pinks, ch 8, sl st in 1st st, ch 3, 19 dc in ring, sl st in top of ch-3. **Petal**—* Ch 3, 3 dc in same st, (3 dc in one lp of next dc) twice. Ch 3, turn, 2 dc in last dc, dc in next 7 dc, 2 dc in end dc. Ch 3, turn, 2 dc in last dc, dc in next 9 dc, 2 dc in end dc. Ch 1, turn, hdc in last dc, 2 dc in next, (tr in next, 2 tr in next) 4 times, tr in next st, 2 dc in next, hdc in end dc. Ch 1, turn, sc in hdc, hdc in next st, 2 dc in next, dc in 5 dc, 2 dc in next dc, (dc, ch 2, sc, ch 2, dc) all in next dc, 2 dc in next, dc in 5 dc, 2 dc in next st, hdc in next, sl st in end st, (ch 2, sc between next 2 rows) 3 times, ch 2, sl st in one lp of next 2 dc on ring. Repeat from * 4 times. Cut 6" long, thread to a needle and fasten off on back. **Stamens**—In Gray, (ch 9, sl st in starting st of this ch-9) 15 times, join, cut 8" long and sew around center ring. In Yellow, * ch 9, sl st in 1st st, (ch 8, sl st in same st) 4 times. Repeat from * 5 times. Sl st at base of 1st 5 groups, drawn tight, forming a coll. Sew in center of flower.

LEAF SPRAY—In Shd. Green, ch 25, sk last st, sc in 24 ch. Ch 1, turn and working in back lps only, make sc in last sc, * hdc in next, dc in 2 sc, tr in 3 sc, dtr in 10 sc, tr in 3 sc, dc in 2 sc, hdc in next sc, * (2 sc, ch 3, 1 sc) all in end sc. Working back on other side of 1st row, sc in 1st st and repeat from * to *. Sc in next st, sl st in 1st sc on other side, ch 25, sk last ch, sc in remaining ch, sl st in end of leaf. Cut 6" long and fasten off. Make 2 more leaves without stems. Tack on either side of main stem.

SCROLL—In Nile Green, ch 136 tightly to measure 8". Sk last st, sc in next, hdc in next, 2 hdc in next, (dc in 5 ch, 2 dc in next ch) 7 times, dc in each remaining ch. Cut and fasten off.

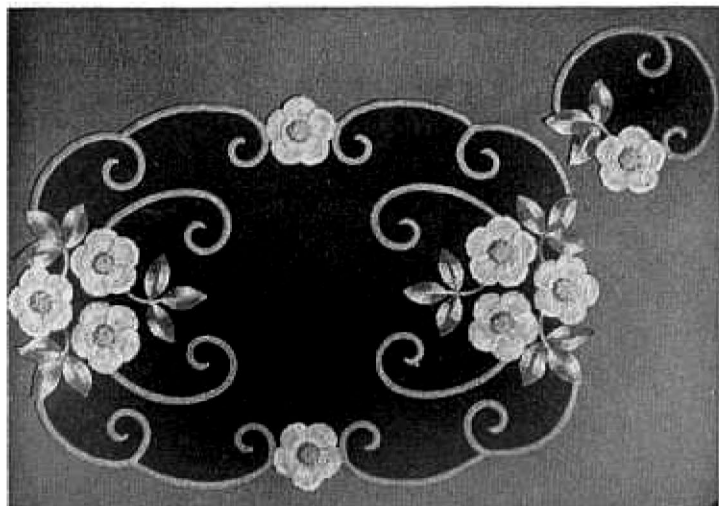


PLACE MAT—Cut cloth 12 x 18 inches. Make 8 Roses, 6 Leaf Sprays and 12 Scrolls. Following illustration, baste 3 Roses, 3 Leaf Sprays and 2 Scrolls on one end. Add 2 Scrolls around one corner and up side to a Rose on center of long side. Lay a piece of glass over this and mark around motifs on tracing or tissue paper. By tracing from this 1st corner, make a pattern for entire doily. Lay tissue paper over this pattern and trace one for each doily. Pin on cloth, baste motifs lightly thru both paper and cloth, first cutting out centers of roses and leaves in the paper to make removal easier. Sew half of Scrolls right-side-up, other half wrong-side-up. Tear away paper and hem down motifs closely. Around edge hem down inner edge of Scrolls only, leaving outer edge of all motifs around edge of doily free so cloth can be turned back under motifs. Cut cloth just outside motifs, turn edge back twice and hem down on back of motifs.

CENTERPIECE—Cut cloth 12 x 22 inches. Make 12 Roses, 6 Leaf Sprays and 12 Scrolls. Arrange motifs as for Place Mat except put 3 Roses along center of each long side.

GLASS DOILY—Cut a 5½ inch circle of cloth. Arrange one Rose, one Leaf Spray and 2 Scrolls around edge and finish as for Place Mat.

Stretch and pin doilies right-side-down. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.
