Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 12. $1 / 2$ yard of aqua linen, 36 inches wide.
Centerpiece measures $141 / 2$ inches in diameter; Runner measures $141 / 2 \times$ 42 inches.

## MATERIALS:

CLARK'S O.N.T. BEST SIX CORD MERCERIZED CROCHET, Art. B.4, Size 50: 5 balls of Ecru for Centerpiece; 3 balls for Medium Doily: 2 balls for Small Doily; 5 balls for Runner; 2 balls each for Rectangular and Oval Mats; or
Clark's Bia Ball-Mercerized Crochet, Art. B.34, Size 40: 2 balls of Eorn for Centerpiece; 1 ball each for Medium and Small Duilies, 2 balls for Runner; I ball each for Rectangular and Oval Mats.
Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 12. $2 / 3$ yard of ecru linen, 36 inches wide.

Centerpiece measures 18 inches in diameter; Medium Doily measures 13 inches in diameter; Small Doily measures 8 inches in diameter; Runner
measures $151 / 2 \times 40$ inches: Rectangular Mat measures 121/i x $171 / 2$ inches; Oval Mat measures $13 \times 181 / 2$ inches.

Make a Centerpiece, Place Mat or Runner as shown, or adapt the design to a vanity set, a round tablecloth or to any size of rounded doily.

## MATERIALS:

CLARK'S O.N.T. BEST SIX CORD MERCERIZED CROCHET, Art. B.4, Size 30: 8 balls of White for Centerpiece; 5 balls for Place Mat and 3 balls for Small Doily; or
Clark's Big Ball Mercerized Crochet, Art. B.34, Size 20 or 30: 4 balls of White for Centerpiece; 2 balls for Place Mat and 1 ball for Small Doily.
Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 10.
Centerpiece measures 27 inches in diameter; Place Mat measures 18 inches in diameter; Small Doily measures 11 inches in diameter.

CENTERPIECE . . . Starting at center, ch 10. Join with sl st to form ring. lst and: 20 sc in ring. Sl 'st in first sc. 2nd rnd: Ch 1 , sc in same place as sl st, * ch 2, sc in next sc. Repeat from * around, ending with sl st in first sc. 3rd and 4th rnds: Sl st in next ch, sc in same sp, * ch 2, sc in next sp . Repeat from * around, ending with ch 2, s1-st in first sc. 5th rnd: Sl st in next ch, sc in same sp, * ch S, sc in next sp. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 5 , sl st in first sc. 6th rnd: Sl st in cach of next 3 ch , ch 10 , * d tr in 3rd ch of next loop, ch 5 . Repeat from * around, ending with sl st in Sth ch of ch-10. 7th rad: Ch 5, * skip 1 st, de in next st, ch 2 . Repeat from * around, ending with sl st in 3rd ch of ch-5 ( 60 sps ). 8th rnd: Sl st in next ch, sc in same sp, * ch 5 , sc in next sp. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 5 , sl st in first sc. 9th rnd: Sl st in each of next $2 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sc}$ in next ch, \$ch 5 , sc in 3 rdch of next loop. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 5, sl st in first sc. 10th and 11th rnds: SL st in each of next $3 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{ch} 8$, \% dc in 3 rd cl of next loop, sh 5. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 5 , sl st in 3 rd ch of ch-8. 12th rnd: SI st in each of next 3 ch , ch 10, * d tr in 3 rd ch of next sp , ch s . Repeat from $\%$ around, ending with ch 5 , sl st in 5th ch of ch-10. 13th rnd: Sl st in each of next $2 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sc}$ in next ch, * ch 7, sc in 3rd ch of next sp. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 7, sl st in first sc. 14th rnd: S1 st in each of next $2 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{ch} 4,2 \mathrm{tr}$ in sam sp , * ch $5,3 \mathrm{tr}$ in next sp. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 5, sl st in top of ch-4.

15th rnd: St st in each of next 2 tr , sl st in next sp, ch 3, 3 dc in same sp, * ch 2, 4 dc in next sp. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 2, sl st in top of ch-3. 16th rnd: Sl st in each-of next 3 dc , sl st in next sp, ch 6. holding back on hook the last loop of each tr tr, make 2 tr tr in same sp, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (cluster made), " ch 10, make a 3 -tr tr cluster in same sp, ch 1, skip next sp , make a 3 -tr tr cluster in next
sp. Repeat from * around, ch 1 , sl st in tip of first cluster. 17th rnd: Ch 6 , * skip 2 ch, dc in next ch, ch 3, skip 3 ch , dc in next ch, ch 3, (dc in tip of next cluster, ch 3) twice. Repeat from ** around, ending with sl st in 3rd ch of ch-6. 18th to 26th rads incl: Repeat Sth to 16 th rads incl. 27th rnd: Sl st to center of next sp , ch 6 , make a 2 -tr tr cluster in same sp, (ch 5, make a 3 -tr tr cluster in same sp ) 4 times; * in next ch-10 sp make tr, ch 3 and tr; in next sp make (3-tr tr cluster, ch 5) 4 times and a 3 -tr tr cluster. Repeat from * around. Join with sl st in tip of first cluster. 28th rnd: Ch 6 , * skip next 4 sts, de in next st, ch 3. Repeat from * around. Join with sl st to 3 rd ch of ch-6. 29th to 34th rnds incl: Repeat 8 th to 13 th rnds incl. 35 th and: Sl st in each of next $4 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{ch} 10$, ${ }^{\prime}$ d tr in 4th ch of next loop, ch 5 . Repeat from *around, ending with sl st in 5th ch of ch-10. 36th to 39th rnds incl: Repeat 13th to 16 th rnds incl. 40th rnd: Repeat 27 th rnd. 41st rnd: * (4 sc in next sp) twice; ch 5,
( 4 sc in next sp ) twice; ch 8, skip next sp . Repeat from * around. Join. 42nd rnd: SI st in each of next 7 sc and in next sp, ch 9, tr in same sp, * in next sp make ( $3-\mathrm{tr} \mathrm{tr}$ cluster, ch 6) 4 times and 3 - $\mathrm{tr} \operatorname{tr}$ cluster; in next sp make tr, ch 5 and tr. Repeat from ${ }^{*}$ around, ending with sl st in 4th ch of ch-9. 43rd rnd: Sl st to center of first sp, ch 12, * d tr in next sp , ch 7 . Repeat from * around. Join with sI st to Sth ch of ch-12. 44th rnd: Sl st in each of next 3 ch , sc in next ch, * ch 9, sc in 4th ch of next loop. Repear from * around, ending with ch 9, sl st in first sc, Break off,

PLACE MAT . . . Work as for Centerpiece until 27 rods have been completed. 28th and 29th rnds: Work as For 43 rd and 44 th rads of Centerpiece.
SMALL DOILY . . . Work as for Centerpiece until 16 rods have been completed. 17th rnd: Work as for 27th ind of Centerpiece. 18th and 19th rnds: Work as for 43rd and 44 th rnds of Centerpiece.
Starch each piece lightly and press.

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GAUGE: Each motif measures $21 / 2$ inches in diameter.

## CENTERPIECE-CENTER MOTIF

$\ldots$ Starting at center ch 18. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st row: Ch 21 for First Spoke, ic in 4th ch from hook make 28 dc over ch. Ch 1, turn. 2nd row: Sc in each dc across, sc in top of turning chain, Ch s, turn. 3rd row: (Si st in back loop of next 6 sc , ch 5) 4 times; sl st in back loop of next 6 sc ( 5 picots made), sl st in ring (First Spoke completed). Ch 18 for Second Spoke, drop loop from hook, insert hook in 2nd picot from ring and draw dropped loop through, ch 3, make 29 dc over ch. Ch 1, turn. 2nd and 3rd rows: Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows of First Spoke.
Make 3 more Spokes the same way, joining as before. Make another Spoke, joining to preceding Spoke as before and joining 4th picot to base of first dc on First Spoke. Join and break off, Now work in rnds as follows: 1st rnd: Attach thread to first picot on any spoke, sc in same place, "(ch 7, sc in next picot) twice; ch 8 , sc in first picot on next spoke. Repeat from * around. Join. 2nd rnd: Sc in each SC and in each ch around. Join (132 sc). 3rd to 6th rnds incl: Sc in each sc around, increasing 9 sc evenly on each rndto inc 1 sc. make 2 sc in 1 sc. Join ( 168 sc on 6 th rad). Break off at end of 6th rnd.

## FIRST ROUND OF MOTIFSFirst Motif . . . Work as for Center Motif.

SECOND MOTIF . . . Work as for First Motif until 2 rows of First Spoke have been completed. Ch 2, turn. 3rd row: Sl st in 2nd picot on any spoke
on First Motif, ch 2, sl st in next 6 sc on Second Motif, ch 2, si st in next picot on same spoke on First Motif, ch 2, sl st in next 6 sc on Second Motif. Complete rnd (no more joinings).

Make 5 more motifs, joining adjacent sides as Second Motif was joined to First Motif, leaving ? spokes free on each side of joining. Join last motif to First Motif the same way.

To join motifs to center: Attach thread to first sc on center, sc in same place, sc in next 5 sc , sl st in first free picot on first free spoke on inner edge of any motif, * sc in next 6 sc on center, sl st in first picot on next spoke of next motif, sc in next 6 sc on center, $s l$ st in next picot, sc in next 6 sc on center, turn; holding back on hook the last loop of each st, make do in next picot, tr in next 2 picots, de in next picot, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (a joint cluster made), turn, sc in next 6 sc , sl st in next picot. Repeat from * around. Join and break off.

Now work around outer edge of motifs as follows: 1st rnd: Attach thread to first free picot on first free spoke of any motif, sc in same place, * (ch 7, sc in next picot) twice; ch 8, sc in next picot, ch 7, sc in next picot, ch 15, thread over 6 times; insert hook in next picot, draw loop through, thread over and take off 2 loops at a time 4 times; thread over 4 times, insert hook in next picot, draw loop through, thread over and draw through 2 loops at a time 8 times (long joint-tr made), ch 15 , sc in next picot. Repeat from * around. Join. 2nd rnd: $S c$ in each st and in each ch around. Join ( 455 sc ). 3rd, 4th and 5th rnds: Sc

## MATERIALS:

CLARK'S O.N.T. BEST SIX CORD MERCERIZED CROCHET, Art. B. 4 , Size 30: 5 balls of No. 9 Yellow for Centerpiece; $s$ balls for Large Oval Mat; 4 balls for Small Oval Mat and 3 balls for Small Round Mat; 12 balls for Vanity Set; or

Clark's Big Ball Mercerized Crochet, Art. B.34, Size 20 or 30: 2 balls of No. 9 Yellow for Centerpiece; 2 balls eath for Large and Small Oval Mats and 1 ball for Small Round Mat; 4 balls for Vanity Set.
Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 10. 1 yard of yellow linen, 36 inches wide. Centerpiece measures 18 inches in diameter; Large Oval Mat measures $131 / 2 \times 19$ inches; Small Oval Mat measures it $\times 151 / 2$ inches; Small Round Mat measures 12 inches in diancter.

CENTERPIECE . . Cut a piece of linen 12 inches in diameter. Make a narrow hem all around linen. 1st rnd: Attach thread to edge of linen, sc in same place where thread was attached, * ch 2, sc in linen. Repeat from * around, having 208 sc around (about 11 sc to 2 inches) and ending with $\mathrm{ch}_{2} 2$, si st in first sc made. 2nd rnd: Sl st in next ch-2 sp, ch 5, * dc in next sp, ch 2. Repeat from * around. Join with st st to 3 rd ch of ch-5. 3rd rnd: Sl st in next sp , sc in same sp , * ch 3, skip next sp, in next sp make dc, ch 3 and dc (shell made); ch 3, skip next sp , sc in next sp, Repeat from *around (52 shells on rad). Join with sl st to first sc made. 4th rnd: SI st to sp of next shell. ch 3, thrcad over in times, insert hook in same sp. draw loop through, thread over and draw through all loops on hook to with last 2 loops, then thread over and draw through remaining loops (a roll st made), make ? more roll sts in same sp, * ch 3, make 8 roll sts in sp of next shell (thread over 15 times), ch 3, make 3 roll sts in Sp of next shell (thread over 10 times). Repeat from * around. Join to top of first roll st. Sth rnd: Sl st in top of next roll st. ch 3, make 3 roll sts in same place (thread over 10 times)-(a 3 roll st group made at beginning of rnd) ; *h 3 , sc between first and 2 nd roll sts on next 8 roll st group, (ch 3, sc between next 2 foll sts) 6 times (pineapple started) ; ch 3 . make 3 roll sts (thread over 10 times) in center roil'st of next 3 roil st group. Repeat from around join to first roll st.

6th rnd: Make a-3 roll st group at beginning of rnd as before, * ch 3, skip next sp, (sc in next loop, ch 3) 6 times; make 3 roll sts in center roll st of next roll st group (thread over

10 times). Repeat from * around. Join. 7th rnd: Make a 3 roll st group as before, "th 3, skip next sp, (sc in next loop, ch 3) 5 times; 3 roll sts over 3 roll sts. Repeat from *around. Join. 8th rnd: Sl st between first and 2nd roll sts, ch 3, make 3 roll sts in same place where ch 3 was started. * ch 3, make 3 roll sts between 2nd and 3 rd roll sts, ch 3, skip next sp, (sc in next loop, ch 3) 4 times; make 3 roll sts between first and 2nd roll sts of next roll st group. Repeat from * around. Join to first roll st. 9th rad: Sl st in next roll st, ch 3, make 3 roll sts in same place, "ch 3 , in next ch-3 sp make dc, ch 3 and de; ch 3, make 3 roll sts in center roll st of next group, ch 3, skip next sp, (sc in next loop, ch 3) 3 times; make a 3 roll st group in center roll st of next roll st group Repeat from saround. Join. loth tnd: Sl st in next roll st, ch 3, make 3 roll sts in same place, ${ }^{*}$ ch 3 , 8 dc in sp of next shell. ch 3,3 roll sts in center st of next roll st group, ch 3 , skip next sp, (sc in next loop. ch 3) twice; 3 roll sts in center st of next roll st group. Repeat from * around. Join. 1ith rnd: $\% 3$ roll sts over roll

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in each sc around, increasing 7 sccvenly on each rnd. Join ( 476 sc on 5 th rnd). Break off at end of 5 th rad.
SECOND ROUND OF MOTIFS
. . Make 14 motifs, joining each motif to preceding motif as beforc.

To join motifs to center: Attach thread to first sc, sc in same place, sl st in 3rd picot on first free spoke on inner edge of any motif, sc in next 6 sc on center, * sl st in next picot on motif, sc in next 10 sc on center, turn; make a joint cluster by making de in next picot, tr tr in next ? picots and dc in next picot, turn; sc in next 10 sc on center, sl st in next picot, sc in next 7 sc on center, sl st in next picot, sc in next 7 sc. Repeat from $\%$ around. Join and break off.

Now work in rnds as follows: Attach thread to first free picot on- first free spoke of any motif, sc in same place and work as for 1 st and 2 nd rods of last group of sc rnds ( 910 sc ). 3rd and 4th znds: Inc 7 sc evenly on each rnd ( 924 sc ). 5th rnd: Sc in each sc around. Join and break off.

## THIRD ROUND OF MOTIFS . .

Make 21 motifs, joining each motif to preceding motif as beforc.

To join motifs to center: Attach thread to first sc on center. sc in same place as sl st, sl st in 3rd picot on first free spoke on inner edge of any motif, sc in next 9 sc on center, * sl st in next picot on motif. sc in next 12 sc on center, turn; make a joint-cluster by making a de in next picot, tr tr in next 2 picots and dc in next picot, turn, sc in next 12 sc on center, sl st in next picot, sc in next 10 sc on
st group as before, (dc in next dc, (h) 4, sc in 4th ch from hook-picot made) 8 times; 3 roll sts over next roll st group, skip next sp, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join and break off.

LARGE OVAL MAT . . . Cut an oval piece of linen $73 / 4 \times 131 / 4$ inches. Roll a narrow hem all around. 1st and: Attach thread to linen and work as for 1st and of Centerpiece, having 168 sc around. Complete as for Centerpiece

SMALL OVAL/MAT ... Cut an oval piece of linen $5 \frac{1}{4} \times 101 / 4$ inches. Roll a narrow hem all around 1st end: Work as for Centcrpiece, having 136 sc around. Complete as for Centerpiece.

SMALL ROUND MAT . . . Cut a piece of linen $61 / 2$ inches in diamster. Roll a narrow hem all around. 1st rnd: Work as for Centerpiece, having 104 sc around. Complete as for Centerpiece.

VANITY SET . . . Make 1 Large Oval Mat and 2 Small Round Mats. Starch each piece lightly and press.
hot plate mats . . . Make one each of the Large and Small Oval Mats and one Small Round Mat.
center, sl st in next picot, sc in next 10 scen center, Repcat from * around. Join and break off.

MEDIUM DOILY . . . Work as for Centerpiece until 2 rads of motifs have been completed.

SMALL DOILY . . . Work as for Centerpicce until first rnd of motifs has been completed.

RUNNER . . . Make a strip of 15 motifs as for Conterpicce, joining as before.

To form corner: loin next motif to preceding motif, leaving I spoke free on inner edge. Join 4 more motifs as before, Join next motif to form coner and complete other 2 sides to correspond Join last motif to First Motif to form last corner. Cut a piece of linen $103 / 4 \times 341 / 4$ inches. Roll a narrow hem all around. Sew motifs in place, joining picots as shown in illustration.

RECTANGULAR MAT . . . Make a strip of ? motifs joining as before. Join next motif to form corner, join 3 more motifs as before, join next motif to form corner. Complete other 2 sides to correspond. Join last motif to First Motif to form last corner.

Cut a piece of linen $8 \times 131 / 2$ inches. Roll a narrow hem all around. Sew motifs in place.

OVAL MAT . . . Make 18 motifs, joining as before. Join last motif to First Motif. Cut an oval piece of linen $81 / 2 \times 141 / 2$ inches. Roll a narrow hem all around. Sew motifs in place.

Starch each piece lightly and press.

Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 9.
Centerpiece measures $11 \times 181 / 2$ inches. Each Place Mat measures 11 inches square.
LUNCHEON SET-Centerpiece . . . Starting at narrow edge, ch 80. 1st row: Tr in 12th ch from hook (sp made) * ch 3, skip 3 ch, tr in next ch. Repeat from * across ( 18 sps ) Ch 7, turn. 2nd and 3rd rows: Skip first tr, $\Rightarrow$ tr in next tt, ch 3. Repeat from * across, ending, with ch 3, skip 3 ch of turning chain, tr in next ch. Ch $?$, turn. 4th row:-Skip first $t t$, ( tr in next $t r$, ch 3) twice: tr in next tr, ch 1,6 tr in next tr, (ch 2, skip next $\mathrm{tr}, 6 \mathrm{tr}$ in next tr) 5 times; ch 1 , tr in next tr, (ch 3, tr in next tr) twice; ch 3, skip 3 ch , tr in next ch. Ch 7, turn. Sth row: Skip first tr, (tr in next tr, ch 3) 3 times; holding back on hook the last loop of each tr make tr in next 6 tr, thread over and draw through all loops on hook (cluster made), (ch 7, cluster in next 6 tr) 5 times; (ch 3, tr in next tr) 3 times; ch 3 , skip 3 ch , $\operatorname{tr}$ in next $\mathrm{ch} . \mathrm{Ch} 7$, turn. 6th row: Skip first th, (ir in next tr, ch 3) twice; trvin next tr, ch 1,6 tr in tip of next cluster, ch 5 , (tr in tip of next cluster, ch 3, tr in center (h) of next Sp. ch 3) 3 times; tr in tip of next cluster, ch 5, 6 tr in tip of next cluster, ch 1, (tr in next tr, ch 3) 3 times; skip 3 ch , $t \mathrm{tr}$ in next ch. $\mathrm{Cl} ~ 7$, turn. 7 th row: Skip first tr, (tr in next tr, ch 3) 3 times; cluster over next 6 tr , ch 3 , skip 1 ch , tr in next ch, (ch 3, tr in next tr ) 7 times; ch 3, skip 3 ch , to in next ch. ch 3 , cluster over next 6 tr , (ch 3, tr in next tr) 3 times; ch 3 , skip 3 ch , tr in next ch. Ch 7 turn. 9th to 20th rows incl: Remeat 7 th and 8 th rows alternately 6 more times. 21st row: Skip first tr, (tr in next tr, of 3) 3 times: cluster over next 6 tr , ch 3, 6 tr in next tr , (ch 2, skip next tr , 6 tr in next tr$) 3$ times; ch 3, cluster over next 6 tr, (ch 3, tr in next tr) 3 times; ch 3 . skip $3 \mathrm{ch} . \mathrm{tr}$ in next ch. Ch 7, turn. 22nd row: Skip first tr. (tr in next tr, ch 3) twice; tr in
next tr, ch $1,6 \mathrm{tr}$ in tip of next cluster, ch 5, (cluster over next 6 tr , ch 7) 3 times; cluster over next 6 tr, ch $5,6 \mathrm{tr}$ in tip of next cluster, ch 1 , ( tr in next tr, ch 3) 3 times; skip 3 ch , tr in next ch. Ch 7, turn. 23rd row: Skip first tr, (tr in next tr, ch 3) 3 times; cluster over next 6 tr , ch 3, skip 1 ch, tr in next ch, (ch 3, tr in tip of next cluster, ch 3, tr in center ch of next sp ) 3 times; ch 3, tr in tip of next cluster, ch 3, skip 3 ch, tr in next ch, ch 3 , cluster over next 6 tr, (ch 3, tr in next tr) 3 times; ch 3, skip $3 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{tr}$ in next ch. Repeat from ${ }^{3}$ around Join to first sc made. 6th rnd: SI st to center of loop, sc in same loon. * ch 6, sl st in 4 th ch from hook (picot), ch 5 , picot, ch 2 (a double oicot loop), sc in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join. 7th to 10th rnds incl: Sl st to center of next loop, sc in same place, * make a double picot loop, sc between
picots of next loop. Repeat from * around. Join. At end of 10th rnd, break off.

FIRST OUTER MOTIF . . . Work as for Center Motif until 4 inds of Border have been completed. 5th rnd: SI st to center of next loop, sc in same loop, ch 2, sl st between picots on any picot loop on Center Motif, ch 2, sc in next loop on First Outer Motif, (ch 2, sl st between picots on next picot loop on Center Motif, ch 2, sc in next loop on First Outer Motif) twice; * ch S, sc in next loop. Repeat from * around (no more joinings). Join and break off.

## SECOND OUTER MOTIF

Work as for First Outer Motif until 4 rads have been completed. 5th rnd: Sl st to center of loop ch 2, sl st between picots on 6th picot loop preceding first joining of previous motif, ch 2. sc in next loop on Second Outer Motif, ioin the next 2 loops to next 2 loops on Center Motif, (ch S, sc in next loop) 6 times; ch 2 , skip 6 loops on First Outer Motif, sl st in next loop, ch 2, sc in next loop on Second Outer Motif, (ch 2, sl st in next loop on First Outer Motif, ch 2, sc in next loop on Second Outer Motif) 3 times and complete rnd as before (no more joinings). Make Fill-In Motifs in this manner all around.

CLARK'S O.N.T. BEST SIX CORD MERCERIZED CROCHET, Art. B.4, Size 50: 4 balls of Ecru for Centerpiece; 3 balls for each Luncheon Mat and 2 balls for Small Doily; or
Clark's Big Ball Mercerized Crochet, Art. B.34, Sizc 40: 2 balls of Ecru for Centerpiece or Luncheon Mat; 1 ball for Small Doily.
Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 10.
$1 / 2$ yard of ecru linen, 36 inches wide.
Centerpiece measures $211 / 2$ inches in diameter; Luncheon Mat measures $191 / 2$ inches in diameter; Small Doily measures $151 / 2$ inches in diameter.

CENTERPIECE . . . Cut a piece of linen 13 inches in diamcter. Make a narrow hem all around.
EDGING . . . Ist rnd Attach thread to edge of linen, sc in same place where thread was attached, *ch 1 , sc in linen. Repeat from "around, having 228 sc on rod (about 11 se to 2 inches). Join. 2nd rad: Ch 5, * tr in next sc, ch 1. Repeat from * around. Join to th ch of ch-5. 3rd rnd: Ch 3, de in each tr and in each ch-1 sp around, increasing 38 dc evenly on rnd -to inc I dc. make $2 d c$ in same place. Join. 4th rnd: Ch 5, * skip next dc, tr in next dc, ch 1. Repcat from * around. Join to fth ch of ch-5. 5th to 8th rnds incl: Repeat 3rd and 4th rads alternately (there are 270 sps on sth rid). Join. 9th rnd: * (Ch 5, sl st in next tr)

7 times; ch 10, skip 2 tr, sl st in next tr. Repeat from * around. Join. 10th rnd: SI st to center of next loop, * (ch 5, sl st in next loop) 6 times; 13 dc in next loop, sl st in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join. 11th rnd: Sl st to center of next loop, * (ch 5, sl st in next loop) S times; skip next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 4 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, skip 3 dc , in next dc make 3 dc, ch 3 and 3 dc (shell made); skip $3 \mathrm{dc}, 4 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc, sl st in next ch-5 loop. Repeat from * around. Join. 12th rnd: Sl st to center of next loop, * (ch 5, sl st in next loop) 4 times; make 4 dc in sp between 2nd and 3rd dc's of next 4 -dc group, in ch-3 sp of next shell make 3 tr , (ch 3, tr) twice, oh 3 and 3 tr; make 4 dc between 2nd and 3rd dcs of next 4-de group, sl st in next ch-5 loop. Repeat from * around. Join. 13th rnd: Si st to center of next loop, * (ch 5, sl st in next loop) 3 times: make 4 dc in center of next 4 -de group as before, in next ch-3 sp make 3 tr , ch 3 and 3 tr: in next ch -3 sp make 2 tr , ch 3 and 2 tr , in next ch- 3 sp make 3 tr , ch 3 and $3 \mathrm{tr}: 4 \mathrm{dc}$ in center of next 4-dc group, sl st in next ch-s loop. Repeat from ${ }^{2}$ around. Join. 14th rnd: Sl st to center of next loop, * (ch 5, sl st in next loop) twice; 4 dc in center of next 4 -dc group, (in next ch-3 sp make 3 tr, ch 4 and 3 tr) 3 times; 4 dc in center of next 4 -dc group, sl st in next loop. Repeat from * around. Join.

15th rnd: Sl st to center of next loop, ch 5 , sl st in next loop, sc in same loop, * 4 dc between 2nd and 3 rd dc's of next 4-dc group, ch 3, sc in sp between the 4 -dic group and the following 3 -tr group, ch 5 , skip 2 tr, (sc in hext tr, ch S) twice; skip 2 tr,
sc in sp between this tr-group and the following tr-group, ch 5 , in next loop make sc, ch 5 and $s c$; ch 5 , sc in sp between next 2 tr-groups, ch 5 , skip 2 tr , (sc in next tr, ch 5) twice; sc in sp between the $3-\mathrm{tr}$ group and the 4 -dc group ( 9 ch-5 loops), ch 3, make 4 dc between 2nd and 3 rd de's of next 4 -dc group, sc in next ch-5 loop, ch 5 . sc in next loop. Repeat from * around Join and break off. 16th rnd: Attach thread to last ch-5 loop of last 9 ch-5 loops, * ch 2 , in next ch-5 loop make tr, ch 1 and tr; ch 2, se in next ch-5 loop, (ch 5, sc in next loop) 8 times. Repeat from waround. Join. 17th rnd: Turn, sl st back to middle of last loop made, turn, sc in same place, * ch 3 , dc io sp between tr's, ch 3,sc in next ch-s loop, (ch $Z$ sc in next loop) 7 times. Repeat from * around. Join. 18th rnd: * 3 sc in next ch-3 sp, sc in next dc, ch 3 , sc in last sc made (picot made), 3 sc in next sp, over each ch-7 loop make 4 sc , ch 3, sc in last Sc made, ch 5, sc in same place, ch 3 , sc in same place (triple picot made). Repeat from around. Join and break off.

LUNCHEON MAT . . . Cut a piece of linen, $111 / p$ inches in diameter. Make a narrow hem all around. Work as for Centerpiece, making 188 se on first and and having 230 sps on 8th rnd. Complete as for Centexpiece.

SMALL DOILY . . . Cut a piece of linen $7 \frac{1}{2}$ inches in diameter. Male a narrow hem all around, Work as for Centerpiece, making 128 sc on first rnd and having 170 sps on 8th mnd. Complete as for Centerpiece.
Starch each piece lightly and press.

MATERIALS:
CLARK'S O.N.T. BEST SIX CORD MER. CERIZED CROCHET, Art. B.4, Size 50: 2 balls of White for Centerpicce; 2 halls for each Place Mat; 3 balls for Runner; or
Clark's Biq Ball Mercerized Crochet, Art. B.34, Size 50: 1 ball of White for Centerpiece: 1 ball for each Place Mat; I ball for Runner.
Milwards Steel Crochet Hook No. 12. 1 yard yellow linen, 36 inches wide. Centerpiece or Place Mat measures 18 inches in diameter; Runncr $151 / 2$ $x 40$ inches.

CENTERPIECE-SCALLOP (Make 10) ... Stating at center, ch 15. Join with sl st to form ring. 1st rnd: 30 sc in ring. Join with sl st to first sc. Now work in rows as follows: 1st row: * Ch 15, sc in same sc, ch 15, sc in next sc. Repeat from t across until 20 loops have been made. Ch 8, turn. 2nd row: Sc in first loop, *h 4, sc in next loop. Repeat from ${ }^{\prime}$ across. Ch 5 ,
turn. 3rd to 7th rows incl: * Sc in next loop, ch 5. Repeat from * acress. Ch 5, tum. At end of 7th row, ch 1 to turn. 8th row: Draw loop out on hook to measure $3 / 8$ inch, thread over and draw loop through, insert hook between single and double loops and draw loop through, thread over and draw through 2 loops on hook (knot st made), make another knot st, " sc in next loop, make 2 knot sts. Repeat from * across, ending with sc in last loop. Turn. 9th to 12 th rows incl: * Make 2 knot sts, se under double loop of next knot st (to right of the knot), sc under double loop of next knot st (to the left of the same knot). Repeat from * across. Turn. Break off at end of 12 th row.
Pin scallops together, overlapping $1 / 2$ inciton each scallop. Place on linen and trace around inner edge, leaving $1 / 8$ inch for hem. Sew hem and scallops neatly in place.

PLACE MAT (Make 2) . . . Work exactly as for Centerpiece.

RUNNER . . . Make 20 scallops. Cut a piece of linen $101 / 2 \times 35$ inches, rounding ends evenly. Roll a narrow hem all around. Sew scallops in place, overlapping as before.

Starch each piece lightly and press.

* (asterisk) . . . Repeat the instructions following the asterisk as many more times as specified, in addition to the original.

Repeat instructions in parentheses as many times as specified. For example:
"(Ch 5, sc in next sc) 5 times" means to make all that is in parentheses 5 times in all.
