




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# Keep Fingers Flying

# Needlepoint Crochet



Use this new stitch not only for footstools—but for chair backs and handbags—piano seats or samplers. It's new and different, yet so much like exquisite needlepoint.

No. 1901

**Materials Required — AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY**  
“STAR” PEARL COTTON Size 5 for the Crocheted Background and “STAR” SIX STRAND ART THREAD—for the Tapestry Design.

“STAR” PEARL COTTON 6 Medium Balls, Cream or Colors.


“STAR” SIX STRAND ART THREAD 6 Skeins Blue.

1 Skein Each of Light Pink, Dark Pink and Green.


Steel Crochet Hook Number 7.

Make a ch a little longer than required, work a row of s c the correct length (cut off remaining ch) ch 1, turn and continue rows of s c until work is correct size.

**TAPESTRY DESIGN.** Beginning in the center of the width and following chart, work the cross lines in Blue using all six strands. After the Blue is completed work the design following the diagram and color chart.

Materials Required—AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" or "GEM" MERCERIZED CROCHET COTTON Size 20.

3—300 Yard Balls Cream.

2—300 Yard Balls Dark Linen.

Steel Crochet Hook Number 11 or 12.

Materials Required—AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY  
“STAR” MERCERIZED CROCHET COTTON Size 50.  
6—175 Yard Balls, White or Ecu.  
Steel Crochet Hook Number 12 or 13.

MOTIF. Ch 6, join, ch 1, 11 s c into ring (ch 1 counts as 1 s c).

2nd Row. Ch 5, tr c into same space, ch 5, sl st in 5th st from hook for picot, \* 2 tr c in next st, ch 5, sl st in 5th st from hook for picot, repeat from \* 10 times, join in 1st ch 5.


Join Motifs together at picots in the 2nd row as follows: Ch 5, tr c in same space, ch 5, sl st in 5th st from hook for picot, 2 tr c in next s c, ch 2, sl st in picot of 1st Motif, ch 2, complete picot, 2 tr c in next s c, ch 2, sl st in next picot of 1st motif, ch 2, com-

# *Knitted chairbacks are different*

**Materials Required** — AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY  
“DE LUXE” MERCERIZED CROCHET AND KNITTING  
COTTON.

**3 Balls Beige.**

**1 Pair Steel Knitting Needles Number 1.**

**CHAIR BACK.** Cast on 125 sts and k 6 rows.

**Next Row.** K 3, \* over, k 2 together, k 1, repeat from \*

ending row with k 3. K 2 rows. Repeat the last 3 rows until work measures about 11 inches. K 6 rows, bind off.

**ARM REST.** Cast on 50 sts and k 6 rows and continue pattern same as chair back until arm rest measures 10 inches, k 6 rows, bind off.

**SCALLOP.** Ch 3, d c in same space, ch 2, 2 d c in same space, ch 2, skip 2 sts, s c in next st, ch 2, skip 2 sts, 2 d c, ch 2, 2 d c in next st, repeat all around.

**Materials Required**—AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY  
"STAR" or "GEM" MERCERIZED CROCHET COTTON  
Size 50 or 70 White and "STAR" TATTING COTTON  
in Colors for the Centers.

2—400 Yard Balls White.

2 Balls of Star Tatting Cotton in Shaded Yellows or any  
Color Desired.

Steel Crochet Hook Number 12 or 13.


Each Motif Measures About 1¾ Inches. 81 Motifs Are  
Required for Scarf Illustrated.

**MOTIF.** With color, ch 6, join to form a ring, ch 1, 20  
s c in ring, join.

**2nd Row.** Ch 4, d c in 1st s c, \* ch 1, d c in next s c,  
repeat from \* all around, ch 1, join in 3rd st of ch,  
break thread.

**3rd Row.** Attach White in same space at top of d c,  
ch 20, drop loop off hook and pull thread through first  
st of ch 20 and over the double ch work 2 s c, 1 s d c,  
12 d c, \* ch 10, turn work and sl st in next d c of 2nd  
row, turn and work 2 s c, 1 s d c, 12 d c over ch, repeat

**CROCHETED DOILY — No. 1906**

**Materials Required—AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY  
“SILLATEEN SANSIL.”**

**2 Balls White or Colors.**

**Steel Crochet Hook Number 10 or 11.**

**1st Row.** Ch 6, join to form a ring, ch 5, d c into ring \* ch 3, d c in ring, repeat from \* 3 times, ch 3, join to 3rd st of ch 5.

**2nd Row.** Slip st in loop, ch 3, d c in same place \*

**5 Balls White or Colors.**


**Center Medallion 1 Shuttle and Ball.**

R, 3 d, p, 3 d, p, 3 d, p, 3 d, close r. R, 3 d, join to last p of r, 3 d, p, 3 d, p, 3 d, p, 3 d, p, 3 d, close r. R, 3 d, join to last p of last r, 3 d, p, 3 d, p, 3 d, close r. Ch, 3 d, p, 6 d. R, 6 d, p, 3 d, p, 6 d, close r. Ch, 6 d, p, 3 d. \* R, 3 d, p, 3 d, join to center p of last cluster r, 3 d, p, 3 d, close r. R, 3 d, join to last p of last r made, 3 d, 4 p's separated by 3 d, 3 d close r. R, 3 d, join to last p of last r made, 3 d, p, 3 d, p, 3 d, close r. Ch, 3 d, join to p of last ch, 6 d. R, 6 d, join to last p of single r, 3 d, p, 6 d, close r. Ch, 6 d, p, 3 d. Repeat from \* until you have 12 clusters joining the last one to correspond. Break thread and fasten.

**2nd Row.** \* R, 3 d, p, 3 d, join to 1st free p of center r of cluster, 3 d, p, 3 d, close r. Ch, 6 d, p, 3 d, p, 3 d, p, 6 d. R, 3 d, p, 3 d, join to 3rd p of center r in cluster, 3 d, p, 3 d, close r. Ch, 6 d, p, 3 d, p, 3 d, p, 6 d. Repeat from \* 11 times. Break thread and fasten. Complete each of the next 5 rows in the same manner and start each row in same place.

**3rd Row.** R, 3 d, p, 3 d, join in 1st p of ch, 3 d, p, 3 d, close r. Ch, 6 d, p, 3 d, p, 3 d, p, 6 d. R, 3 d, p, join

### DOILY — No. 1908

**Materials Required — AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY  
“SILLATEEN SANSIL.”**

**3 Balls of Cream or Main Color and 1 Ball Ecu or a  
Contrasting Color.**

**Doily Measures About 14 Inches.**

**Steel Crochet Hook Number 10.**

With Ecu, ch 9, join, ch 3 and work 23 d c in ring, join.

**2nd Row.** Attach Cream, ch 4, 1 tr c in same st, \* ch 3, skip 1 d c, 2 tr c in next st, repeat from \* all around, ch 3, join.

**3rd Row.** With Ecu, ch 1, \* 1 s c in each of the next 2 sts, 3 s c in loop, repeat from \* all around.

**4th Row.** 1 s c in each s c picking up back loop of st only and increasing 1 st in every 5th st.

**5th Row.** With Cream, ch 6, skip 2 sts, d c in next st, \* ch 3, skip 2 sts, d c in next st, repeat from \* all around, ch 3, join in 3rd st of ch 6.

**6th Row.** Ch 1, 1 s c in each d c and 3 s c in each loop.

**7th Row.** 1 s c in each s c picking up back loop of st only and increasing 1 st in every 6th st.

**8th Row.** Same as 5th row (37 meshes).

**9th Row.** Ch 9, 1 tr c in next d c \* ch 4, 1 tr c in next d c, repeat from \* all around ch 4, join in 5th st of ch 9.

**10th Row.** Ch 10, 1 tr c in next tr c, \* ch 5, 1 tr c in next tr c, repeat from \* all around ch 5, join in 6th st of ch 10.

**11th and 12th Rows.** Same as 10th Row having 6 chs between each tr c.

**13th Row.** 1 s c in each tr c and 6 s c in each loop.

**14th Row.** 1 s c in each s c increasing 1 st in every 14th st, and picking up back loop only, work 1 row even.

**16th and 17th Rows.** With Ecu, 1 s c in each s c.

**18th Row.** Increase in every 15th st.

**19th, 20th and 21st Rows.** With Cream work 1 s c in each s c.


**22nd Row.** Ch 1, \* 1 s c in each of the next 13 s c, ch 3, skip 2 sts, d c in next st, ch 4, d c in same st, ch 3, skip 2 sts, 1 s c in each of the next 4 s c, ch 3, skip 2 s c, d c in next s c, ch 4, d c in same st, ch 3, skip 2 sts and repeat from \* all around.

**23rd Row.** Sl st to 6th s c of group, ch 1, 1 s c in each of the next 3 s c, ch 4, \*\* cluster st of 4 tr c in next loop (cluster st \* thread over needle twice, insert in loop and pull through, thread over and work off 2 loops twice, repeat from \* 3 times, thread over needle and pull through all loops on needle) ch 8, d tr c cluster st








**PORCH SET — No. 1911**

**Materials Required — AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY  
“GEM” COTTON YARN.**

**6 Skeins Number 28 Rust.**

**1 Skein Number 22 Yellow.**

**1 Skein No. 37 Light Green.**

**Crochet Hook Size G and Large Rug Needle.**

**Each Place Mat Measures About 12 x 18 Inches.**

With Rust ch 44, work 1 d c in 6th st from hook, \* ch 1, skip 1 st, d c in next st, repeat from \* across row (20 meshes) ch 4, turn.


**2nd Row.** D c in d c, \* ch 1, d c in next d c, repeat from \* across row, ch 4, turn and repeat 2nd row for entire mat working 2 more rows Rust, 2 rows Yellow, 3 rows Rust, 2 rows Green, 4 rows Rust, 2 rows Green, 3 rows Rust, 2 rows Yellow, 4 rows Rust, break yarn.


The pattern is darned in by working 3 rows through each mesh lengthwise working over 1 d c and under the next, reversing the over and under in the 2nd row of each mesh. Darn 4 meshes in Rust, 2 meshes Yellow, 3 meshes Rust, 2 meshes Green, 3 meshes Rust, 2 meshes Yellow, 4 meshes Rust.

Crochet a row of s c across each long side and finish 2 short sides with a narrow fringe.

**FRINGE.** Cut a 4½ inch length, double and knot through mat placing as close together as desired and using the Yellow fringe at end of Yellow rows, Green at end of Green rows and Rust at the end of Rust rows. Work other 3 mats to correspond.

### LACY TABLE CLOTH — No. 1912

Size 48 x 56

**Materials Required** — AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY  
“STAR” or “GEM” MERCERIZED CROCHET COTTON  
Size 20, White, Ecu, Dark Cream or Dark Linen.

22–300 Yard Balls.

Steel Crochet Hook Number 11.

Each Motif Measures About  $4\frac{1}{2}$  Inches, 120 Motifs (10 x 12)  
Are Required for Cloth Illustrated.

**MOTIF.** Ch 6, join to form a ring, ch 7, tr c into ring,  
\* ch 2, 1 tr c into ring, repeat from \* 9 times, ch 2,  
join in 5th st of ch 7.

**2nd Row.** Ch 3, \* 2 d c in next space, d c in next tr c,  
repeat from \* twice, \*\* ch 3, d c in same tr c, \* 2 d c  
in next space, d c in next tr c, repeat from \* twice  
and repeat from \*\* twice, ch 3, join.

**3rd Row.** Ch 5, \* skip 1 d c, d c in next d c, ch 2,  
repeat from \* 3 times, d c in next mesh, ch 2, d c in  
next d c, ch 2 and repeat from first \* all around, join  
in 3rd st of ch 5.

**4th Row.** Ch 10, skip 2 d c, sl st in next d c, repeat  
7 times.


**5th Row.** Over each loop work 2 s c, 2 s d c, 2 d c,  
ch 3, 2 d c, 2 s d c, 2 s c.

**6th Row.** Ch 10, \* sl st in center of next petal, ch 6,

Will Make a Cloth About 42 x 50 Inches (163 Motifs).

Steel Crochet Hook Number 11.

Each Motif Measures About 3½ Inches.







# Bridge story in three parts

## BRIDGE SET — No. 1915

**Materials Required — AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY  
“GEM” or “STAR” MERCERIZED CROCHET COTTON  
Size 30.**

2—400 Yard Balls Medium Ecu.

3—300 Yard Balls Yellow.

3—300 Yard Balls Nile Green.

Steel Crochet Hook Number 11 or 12.

## CLOTH 40 x 40

Begin center square with Medium Ecu, ch 116 work 1st d c in 8th st from hook, \* ch 2, skip 2 sts, d c in next st, repeat from \* to end of ch (37 open meshes), ch 5, turn.

2nd Row. D c in next d c, \* ch 2, d c in next d c, repeat from \* twice, 2 d c in mesh, d c in d c, \* 3 open meshes, 1 solid mesh, repeat from \* 6 times, 4 open meshes, ch 5, turn and continue working back and forth, following diagram until square is completed, break thread.


Attach Green in same place, ch 5, turn and work 7 rows of 2 ch meshes, ch 5 and without turning, work open meshes into side of work (across 44 meshes), ch 5, turn and work 6 more rows on this side, break thread.

Attach Yellow in same place, ch 5 and without turning, work meshes into side of 7 rows of Green and across

the Ecu ch 5, turn and work 6 more rows, ch 5 and work 7 rows of meshes across entire 4th side (across 51 meshes), break thread.

Attach Green in same space and work 9 rows of meshes on the same side, ch 5 and work 9 rows on 2nd side, break thread.

# Luncheon flattery



## LUNCHEON SET - No. 1916

**Materials Required - AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY  
"STAR" PEARL COTTON Size 5.**

**21 Medium Balls, White or Cream.**

**4 Medium Balls, Green or Any Color Desired.**

**Steel Crochet Hook Number 8 or 9.**

**DAISY MOTIF.** With White, ch 10, join to form a ring, ch 3, thread over, insert into ring, work off 2 loops, thread over, insert into ring, work off 2 loops then work off remaining loops 2 at a time, \*\* ch 5, \* thread over hook, insert in loop, work off 2 loops, repeat from \* twice and work off all loops 2 at a time, repeat from \*\* 6 times, ch 5 and join in 1st cluster st, break thread.

Work a second motif joining it to 1st motif as follows: work 2 cluster sts, ch 3, slip loop off hook, insert in center st of ch 5 in 1st motif, ch 3, work a second cluster st, ch 3, join to 2nd ch of 1st motif, ch 3, and complete 2nd motif. Join all motifs in same manner.

Work 96 motifs 8 x 12 for each of the 4 plate doilies and 162 motifs 9 x 18 for the center doily.

**BORDER.** Join White in center petal of 1st flower from corner of long side, ch 8, \* thread over twice, insert in next 5 ch loop and work off 2 loops, thread over, insert in next 5 ch loop and work off all loops 2 at a time, ch 5, d c in next petal of flower, ch 5, re-

peat from \* to corner flower, tr c in corner petal, ch 2, tr c in same space, ch 2, tr c in same space, ch 5, d c in next petal, ch 5 and repeat from first \* all around, ending row with a slip st in 3rd st of ch 8.

**2nd Row.** Ch 1 and work 5 s c in each 5 ch loop, 1 s c in each d c and tr c to corner, in corner work 1 s c in tr c, 2 s c in ch 2, 1 s c, ch 2, 1 s c in corner tr c, 2 s c in ch 2, 1 s c in next tr c and continue all around, join, ch 1 and work 1 s c in each s c and ch 3 at corners picking up the back loop of st only, break thread.

**4th Row.** Attach Green in 1st s c from corner, ch 4, skip 1 s c, d c in next s c, \* ch 1, skip 1 s c, d c in next s c, repeat from \* across side, in corner, ch 1 and work 4 d c with ch 1 between in same space, ch 1, d c in 1st s c on 2nd side and continue all around, join.

**5th Row.** Work a row of open meshes, working 2 d c with ch 1 between in each of the 2 center corner d c, break thread.

**6th Row.** Attach White and repeat last row, break thread.

**7th Row.** Attach Green and repeat last row, break thread.



**Steel Crochet Hook Number 11 or 12.**

# How grand to step on my new crocheted rug in the morning



## CROSS STITCH RUG—No. 1917

Size 19 x 28

**Materials Required—AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY  
“GEM” COTTON YARN.**

8 Skeins Beige and 4 Skeins Natural for the Rug.

6 Yards Rose, 4 Yards Old Rose, 9 Yards Light Green and  
6 Yards Dark Green for the Embroidery.

Crochet Hook Size F and a Large Rug Needle for the  
Embroidery.

With Beige, Ch 65 and work 64 s c on ch, ch 1, turn

and work 1 s c in each s c, continue back and forth in  
same manner until work measures 3½ inches.

**Next Row.** \* Work 12 sts in Beige, 40 sts in Natural,  
12 sts in Beige carrying the yarn under sts, ch 1, turn  
and repeat from \* 69 times or until rug measures 24  
inches from beginning, drop White yarn and work 3½  
inches in Beige.

**TUFTING** around outer edge of Rug. With Beige, cut  
strands 2 inches long, take 25 strands for each tuft and  
tie about 1 inch apart. Tie a second row around center  
section of rug.



## CROCHETED RUG WITH TUFTED EDGE—No. 1918

Size 27 x 40

**Materials Required**—AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY “GEM” COTTON YARN.

18 Skeins Natural or Colors.

Steel Crochet Hook Size G.


Ch 91, work 1 s c in 2nd st from hook, 1 s c in each remaining ch, \* ch 1, turn and work 1 s c in each s c, repeat from \* until rug measures 40 inches.

**TUFTING.** Cut 2 inch strands, take 25 strands for each tuft and using “Gem” Cotton Yarn sew to outside edge of rug, placing the tufts about 1 inch apart.

Sew a second row about 1 inch above lower row placing the tufts between tufts of 1st row.

## HUCK TOWEL EDGE — No. 1919-A

Materials Required—AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY  
“SILLATEEN SANSIL.”

1 Ball White and 1 Ball of Color.

Steel Crochet Hook Number 9.

**WIDE EDGING.** With color, ch 11, making 1st st twice the usual length, tr c in long st (ch 4, tr c in long st), 6 times, ch 4, sl st in next 6th st (the 5th st from 1st tr c). \* Ch 19, making the 9th st extra long, tr c in long st (ch 4, tr c in long st), twice, ch 4, sl st in 3rd ch st from previous wheel, insert hook under ch, catch thread and pull through loop (1 ch st). Now swing work around to left, keeping right-side-up, so that hook is on right side of work, ch 3, tr c in long st (ch 4, tr c in long st), twice, ch 4, sl st in next 6th st (the 5th st from 1st tr c). Repeat from \* for required length.

**2nd Row.** Ch 1, \* (4 s c in next space, s c in tr) 3 times, 4 s c in next space, sl st in one of the ch sts between wheels. Repeat from \* in the same way around both sides of band. Sl st in 1st l-ch and fasten off.

**HEADING.** Join White to next 2nd s c, ch 6, tr c in next 3rd s c, \* ch 4, d c in next 3rd s c (ch 1, d c in

## CROCHET-TRIMMED TURKISH TOWEL — No. 1920-A

Materials Required—AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY  
“STAR” PEARL COTTON Size 5.

1 Medium Ball White.

1 Medium Ball Each of a Light Deep Shade of Any Color Desired.

Steel Crochet Hook Number 7.

With White, ch 13, d c in 7th st from hook (ch 1, d c in next 2nd ch st) 3 times, \* ch 16, d c in 7th st from hook (ch 1, d c in next 2nd ch st), 3 times. Repeat from \* for required length, having an uneven number of points.


**2nd Row.** 3 s c over last d c (3 s c in next space), repeat across top of points. Fasten off.

**3rd Row.** Join light color to 1st point, \* tr c in next point (ch 2, tr c in same point), 5 times, s c in next point. Repeat from \* across. Fasten off.

**4th Row.** Join dark color to start of last row, s c in 1st tr c, \* 3 s c in next space (2 s c, ch 4, sl st in last s c for a p and 1 s c), in each of next 3 spaces, 3 s c in next, sl st in s c between shells. Repeat from \* across. Fasten off.

Stretch and press to exact width of towel and whip to edge. Repeat for other end of towel.

# A tisket . . . a tasket . . . a lacy crocheted basket

## CROCHETED FLOWER BASKET—No. 1921

Materials Required—AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY  
“STAR” or “GEM” MERCERIZED CROCHET COT-  
TON Size 30.

1—300 Yard Ball, White or Colors.

Steel Crochet Hook Number 11 or 12.

Basket Is Made to Fit a Glass 2" in diameter at bottom,  
2½" at top and 3½" high.

**BASE.** Ch 7, sl st in starting st, ch 3, 17 d c in ring,  
sl st in 3-ch. Work following rows in back loops.

**2nd Row.** Ch 3, d c in same st, 2 d c in each remain-  
ing d c. Sl st in ch 3 (36 d c counting the ch 3).

**3rd Row.** Ch 3, d c in same st (d c in next st, 2 d c  
in next), repeated around (54 d c). Sl st in ch 3.

**4th Row.** Ch 3, d c in same st (d c in next 2 d c,  
2 d c in next d c), repeated around (72 d c). Sl st  
in ch 3.

**5th Row.** Ch 3, d c in same st (d c in next 3 d c,  
2 d c in next d c), repeated around (90 d c). Sl st





**Materials Required — AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY  
“STAR” PEARL COTTON Size 5.**

**6 Medium Balls, White.**

**4 Medium Balls, Green or Any Color Desired.**

**Steel Crochet Hook Number 8.**

**Large Mat 8 x 11. Medium Size Mat 6½ x 9½. Small Mat  
5½ x 7½.**

**LARGE MAT.** With color ch 64, 2 d c in 4th st from hook, ch 1, 2 d c in same space, \* skip 3 chs, 2 d c, ch 1, 2 d c in next ch, repeat from \* across row, ch 4, turn.

**2nd Row.** S c between shells, \* ch 4, s c between next 2 shells, repeat from \* across row ending last loop in end ch, drop color.

**3rd Row.** Attach White in base of 1st shell made and turning work upside down, ch 4, s c between shells working into the 1st row of chs, \* ch 4, s c between next 2 shells, repeat from \* across row ending last loop in 1st stitch of last shell, ch 4, turn.

**4th Row.** Holding work in position of 1st shell made, thread over hook, insert hook through the White ch 4

loop at bottom of work and center st of shell in previous row (leaving the color ch 4 loop free), work a shell of 2 d c, ch 1, 2 d c in same space, work a shell in next White loop and shell, repeat in each loop and shell across row, ch 4, turn.

**5th Row.** \* S c between next 2 shells, repeat from \* across row, drop the White thread, pick up the color thread at other end of work, without turning, repeat the 4th and 5th rows with color leaving the White ch 4 loop free, drop the color and pick up the White thread at other end of work, without turning, ch 4 and repeat the last 2 rows reversing the colors every 3rd row until mat measures about 9½ inches.

**SCALLOP.** With White work a row of 1 ch meshes all around.

**2nd Row.** 7 tr c with ch 1 between in next mesh, skip 1 mesh, s c in next mesh, skip 1 mesh, repeat from beginning all around.

**MEDIUM SIZE MAT.** Ch 52 and work same as large mat working until mat measures about 8½ inches.

**SMALL MAT.** Ch 44 and work same as large mat until work measures about 6½ inches.

Finish with a scallop same as large mat.

OVAL MAT. Ch 36, 2 s c in 2nd st from hook, 2 s c in next st, 1 s c in each of the next 30 chs, 2 s c in next ch,

3 s c in end ch. Working on other side of ch, 2 s c in next st, 1 s c in each of the next 30 sts, 2 s c in next st, 1 s c in same space with first 2 sts, join.

Work 3 more rows increasing at ends as necessary to keep work flat.

5th Row. Ch 3, 3 d c in same space, drop loop off hook, insert in 3rd st of ch and pull loop through from back forming a popcorn st, \* 1 d c in each of the next 3 s c, 4 d c in next st, drop loop off hook insert in 1st d c and pull loop through, repeat from \* all around increasing as necessary on ends to keep work flat, 1 d c in each of the next 3 sts, join.

6th Row. Same as 5th row having the popcorn sts between popcorn sts of previous row.

7th Row. Same as 5th row.

8th, 9th, 10th and 11th Rows. Work in s c increasing as necessary at ends to keep work flat. Repeat 5th, 6th and 7th rows, then repeat 8th, 9th, 10th and 11th rows.


Next Row. Popcorn st in next st, 1 d c in each of the next 2 s c, repeat from beginning all around.

SMALL MATS. Ch 6, join and work 9 s c into ring.

Work 4 more rows in s c increasing as necessary to keep work flat, then work same as large mat increasing a sufficient number of times to keep work flat.

With a single strand of thread finish edges with a shell.

Ch 3, 3 d c in same space, \* skip 1 st, s c in next st, ch 3, 3 d c in same space, repeat from \* all around.



With Cream, ch 56, d c in 8th st from hook, \* ch 2, skip 2 sts, d c in next st, repeat from \* 15 times, ch 5, turn.

**2nd Row.** \* D c in d c, 2 d c in mesh, d c in d c, ch 2, d c in next d c, 2 d c in mesh, d c in d c, ch 9, skip 3 meshes, repeat from \* d c in d c, 2 d c in mesh, d c in d c, 2 d c in mesh, d c in d c, ch 2, d c in center st of corner, ch 5, turn.

**3rd Row.** 2 o m (open meshes) 1 s m (solid mesh) 1 o m, ch 9, 1 o m, 1 s m, 1 o m, ch 9, 1 o m, 1 s m, 2 o m, ch 5, turn.

**4th Row.** 1 o m, \* 1 s m, 1 o m, 1 s m, ch 5, s c in center st of ch in 2nd row (over ch 9 of 3rd row) ch 5, repeat from \* 1 o m, ch 5, turn.

**5th and 6th Rows.** 4 o m, ch 9, 3 o m, ch 9, 4 o m, ch 5, turn.

**7th Row.** 4 o m, \* ch 5, s c in center st of ch 9 of 5th row, ch 5, 3 o m, repeat from \* 1 o m, ch 5, turn and repeat from 2nd row for about 10 or 11 inches ending with the 5th row of pattern and work 1 row of open meshes across row.

Join Dark Linen in 1st mesh from corner in upper edge of work, work 3 s c in each mesh on each side and 8 s c in each corner mesh.

**2nd Row.** Ch 4, tr c in next s c, \* ch 2, skip 2 s c, 1 tr c in each of the next 2 s c, repeat from \* to corner, in corner work 4 groups of 2 tr c with ch 2 between without skipping the 2 s c. Continue all around. There must be the same number of groups of tr c on each side.

**3rd Row.** 2 s c in ch 2, \* ch 6, 2 s c in next ch 2, repeat from \* all around.

Work 3 more sections joining them to each other in the last row of border as follows: Beginning in the center of corner, work the 2 s c in corner ch, \* ch 3, join to correspond loop of completed section, ch 3, 2 s c in next ch 2, repeat from \* across long side to corner, and complete 2nd section.

**TASSELS.** Cap. Ch 2, 5 s c in 1st ch, without joining rows, work 2 s c in each s c then 1 row of 1 s c in each s c. Last row, 1 s c in every other s c.

For the 2 center sections, cut 18—6 inch strands for each tassel and for the 2 end sections cut 18—4 inch strands for each tassel. Tie strands together at center leaving a length of thread for sewing, slip through the center of cap and attach to chair back.

For Arm Rests work 2 sections about 10 inches long or length desired.

In the following row there will be 3 motifs joined as follows: Work the center motif joining it in last row as follows: Join to next 4 free picots of left hand motif, then join at joining of 2 motifs and the next 3 free picots of right hand motif. Work the right hand motif. Join to the next 3 free picots of center motif, then join at joining of 2 motifs and the next 3 free picots of right hand motif in same manner. Work and join left hand motif. Continue rows of motifs having 1 more motif in a row until there are 9 motifs in a row, then work other half to correspond.

The Scarf may be made larger or smaller by increasing or decreasing the number of motifs in the center. A Scarf with straight sides may be made by joining the motifs together at 4 picots on each side leaving 1 free picot between joinings.

**2nd Row.** Join Green in corner s c, ch 6, d c in same space, ch 2, skip 2 s c, d c in next s c, repeat meshes to corner, in corner work 2 d c with ch 3 between in corner s c, continue all around joining in 3rd st of ch 6, break thread.

**3rd Row.** Attach Yellow in 1st d c of corner, ch 5, d c in same space, ch 5, 2 d c with ch 2 between in next d c, ch 2 and continue meshes all around working all corners in same manner, join in 3rd st of ch 5.

**4th Row.** Ch 4, sl st in same space for picot, 3 s c in mesh, picot, 3 s c, picot, 3 s c in corner mesh, picot, 3 s c in next mesh, picot, 3 s c in each mesh on side of napkin, continue all around working all corners in same manner.

### COASTERS

With Ecu, ch 6, join and work 11 s c into ring.

**2nd Row.** Ch 3, d c in same space, 2 d c in each of the next 10 s c, join (22 d c).

**3rd Row.** \* Ch 4, skip 1 d c, s c in next d c, repeat from \* all around.

**4th Row.** Sl st into loop, ch 3, 3 d c in same loop, \* ch 2, 4 d c in next loop, repeat from \* all around, ch 2, join.

**5th Row.** Ch 3 and work 1 d c in each d c and 2 d c in each 2 ch loop.

**6th Row.** \* Ch 5, skip 2 d c, s c in next d c, repeat from \* all around.

**7th Row.** Same as 4th row having 1 ch between groups of d c.

**8th Row.** 1 d c in each d c and 1 d c in each 1 ch loop.

**9th Row.** Attach Green and work 1 s c in each d c increasing 1 st in row.

**10th Row.** 1 s c in each s c.

**11th Row.** Attach Yellow, ch 5, skip 2 s c, d c in next s c \* ch 2, skip 2 s c, d c in next s c, repeat from \* all around, ch 2, join.

**12th and 13th Rows.** Same as 11th row.

**14th Row.** With Green work 1 s c in each d c and 2 s c in each mesh.

**15th, 16th and 17th Rows.** 1 s c in each s c.

With Yellow, repeat 11th, 12th and 13th rows.

With Green, repeat 14th row and work 10 more rows of s c without joining rows.

Work another coaster in same manner, then work 2 coasters reversing the Yellow and Green.

Cut a 12 inch square of linen, draw a thread  $\frac{3}{8}$  inch from each side and baste a narrow hem.

Join thread in corner and work 3 s c over hem in corner, \* ch 2, skip a space the length of the ch 2, s c over hem, repeat from \* to corner having an uneven number of s c, 3's c in corner and continue all around, join in 1st s c.

**2nd Row.** Ch 3 and work a 3 d c cluster st with ch 5 between in each corner s c (cluster st see luncheon set), ch 5, cluster st in next s c, ch 5, s c in next s c, 2 s c over 2 ch loop, s c in s c, ch 4, sl st in top of s c just made for picot, \* 2 s c over each of the next two 2 ch loops, s c in next s c, ch 4, sl st in top of s c just made for picot, repeat from \* to the 3rd s c from corner, 2 s c over next ch 2, ch 5, 1 cluster st in next s c, ch 5 and work 1 cluster st with ch 5 between in each corner s c, ch 5, cluster st in 1st s c on next side, ch 5, s c in next s c, 2 s c over next ch, picot, continue same as first side working all corners in same manner.

### COASTERS

**Materials Required—AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" MERCERIZED CROCHET COTTON Size 20 White.**

**1—300 Yard Ball Will Make 6 Coasters.**

**Steel Crochet Hook Number 12 or 13.**

Ch 6, join and work 11 s c into ring.

**2nd Row.** Ch 3, d c in same space, 2 d c in each of the next 10 s c, join.

**3rd Row.** \* Ch 4, skip 1 d c, s c in next d c, repeat from \* around row.

**4th Row.** Sl st into loop, ch 3, 3 d c in same loop, \* ch 2, 4 d c in next loop, repeat from \* all around, ch 2, join.

**5th Row.** 1 d c in each d c and 2 d c in each 2 ch loop.

**6th Row.** \* Ch 5, skip 2 d c, s c in next d c, repeat from \* all around.

**7th Row.** Same as 4th row having 1 ch between groups of d c.

**8th Row.** 1 d c in each d c, 1 d c in each 1 ch loop.

**9th Row.** Ch 4, \* skip 1 st, d c in next st, ch 1, repeat from \* all around, join.

**10th and 11th Rows.** Sl st into mesh, ch 4, d c in next mesh, \* ch 1, d c in next mesh, repeat from \* all around, ch 1, join.

**12th Row.** Sl st into mesh, ch 4, \* thread over needle twice, insert in same space and work off 2 loops twice, repeat from \* then work off remaining loops at 1 time, \* ch 3, work a 3 tr c cluster st in same space, repeat from \* ch 4, skip 2 meshes, s c in next mesh, ch 4, skip

2 meshes, 3—3 tr c cluster sts with ch 3 between in next mesh, repeat all around skipping 3 meshes at end of row, join.

**13th Row.** Sl st to loop between first 2 petals, \* ch 4, s c in next 3 ch loop, ch 4, d c in s c of previous row, ch 4, s c in 3 ch loop between next 2 petals, repeat from \* all around.

**14th Row.** Sl st into loop and work 3—3 tr c cluster sts with ch 3 between in same space, \* ch 4, s c in d c, ch 4, s c in same space, ch 4, skip next loop, 3—3 tr c cluster sts with ch 3 between in next loop, repeat from \* all around.

next 2nd s c), twice, ch 4, tr c in next 3rd s c, tr c in 5th s c on next wheel. Repeat from \* ending with 7-ch, sl st in next 3rd s c. Fasten off.

**EDGE.** Join White to next 4th s c, ch 7, s c in 4th st from hook for a p, ch 3, tr c in back loop of next 8th (center) s c, \* (ch 5, p, ch 2, tr c in same s c) 3 times, ch 1, tr c in next 5th s c, tr c in 5th s c on next wheel, ch 1, tr c in back loop of next 5th s c. Repeat from \*. After final shell, make 7-ch, a p, ch 3, sl st in next 8th s c. Fasten off.

**NARROW EDGE.** With White (ch 6, d c in 6th st from hook), repeated for length required, having an uneven number of loops. Fasten off.

**2nd Row.** Join color to 1st loop, \* ch 3 (d c, ch 3, d c), in next loop, ch 3, s c in next loop. Repeat from \*.

**3rd Row.** Ch 1, turn (3 s c in next 3-ch, 5 s c in next, 3 s c in next) repeated across. Fasten off.

**4th Row.** Join White to beginning of last row, ch 7, s c in 4th st from hook for a p, ch 3, \* d c in back loop of center s c at tip of next shell (ch 4, p, ch 1, d c in same s c), 3 times, d c between shells. Repeat from \*. After final shell, ch 7, p, ch 3, s c down in end of last row. Fasten off.

Stretch and press Edgings to exact width of towel and whip to towel.

### CROCHET-TRIMMED HUCK TOWEL

**No. 1919-B** *Illustrated on page 20*

**Materials Required—AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "SILLATEEN SANSIL."**

**1 Ball White and 1 Ball of Any Shaded or Iridescent Color.**

**Steel Crochet Hook Number 9.**

**EDGING.** Ch 28, making 11th st twice usual length, remove hook, insert it in long st, catch loop and pull through, ch 2, 3 d c in ring, ch 2, s c in ring, ch 2 (5 d c, ch 2, s c), in ring, ch 2 (7 d c, ch 2, s c), in ring, ch 2 (5 d c, ch 2, s c), in ring, ch 2 (3 d c, ch 2, s c), in ring, sl st in long st at top of ring, ch 3, sl st in next 4th ch st (7th st from starting end of ch). \* Ch 35, making 18th st longer, form a ring as before in long st, ch 2 (3 d c, ch 2, s c, ch 2 and 2 d c), in ring, ch 1 and fasten back with a sl st in center d c on 4th petal of previous motif (3 d c, ch 2 and s c), in ring, ch 2 (7 d c, ch 2, s c, ch 2, 5 d c, ch 2, s c, ch 2, 3 d c, ch 2 and s c), in ring, sl st in long st at top of ring, ch 3, sl st in next 4th ch st (14th ch st from top of previous stem). Repeat from \* until required length of motifs are made. Ch 6 and fasten off.

**Heading.** Join White to last st, ch 3, d c in next 5 ch sts (ch 2, skip stem, d c in next 13 ch sts), repeated across, ending with 6 d c.

**2nd Row.** Ch 3, turn, d c in next 3 d c (ch 2, d c in next 2 ch space, ch 2, skip 2 d c, d c in next 9 d c), repeated across, ending with 4 d c.

**3rd Row.** Ch 3, turn, d c in next d c, \* (ch 2, d c in next space) twice, ch 2, skip 2 d c, d c in next 5 d c. Repeat from \* across. End with 2 d c.

**4th Row.** Ch 3 for a d c, turn, \* (ch 2, d c in next space) 3 times, ch 2, skip 2 d c, 2 d c in next d c. Repeat from \* across. Ch 2, d c in end st. Fasten off.

Stretch and press edging to exact width of towel, then whip to edge.

**MOTIF.** With White, ch 9, making 1st st larger than usual, tr c in long st (ch 2, tr c in long st), 10 times, ch 2, sl st in 3rd ch st from 1st tr c. Fasten off.

**2nd Row.** Join shaded cotton to one tr c, ch 1, s c in next space, ch 17, turn, sl st in s c, ch 2, turn and cover ring exactly the same as on Edging. \* S c in same space on center, s c in tr c, 3 s c in next space, s c in tr c, s c in next space, ch 17, turn, sl st in last s c, ch 2, turn (3 d c, ch 2, s c, ch 2 and 2 d c), in ring, ch 2, sl st back in 4th petal of last ring, ch 2, sl st back in last d c (3 d c, ch 2 and s c), in ring. Complete ring and repeat from \* around. Fasten off. Join 1st and last petals with 2-chs. Baste Motif in position and sew neatly.

### CROCHET-TRIMMED TURKISH TOWEL

No. 1920-B Illustrated on page 20

**Materials Required — AMERICAN THREAD COMPANY "STAR" PEARL COTTON Size 5.**

**1 Medium Ball Each of 3 Different Colors, or Light, Medium and Dark Shades of One Color.**

**Steel Crochet Hook Number 7.**

**EDGING.** With medium color, \* ch 13, skip last st, s c in next st, s d c in next st, 2 d c in next st, 1 d c in next st (2 tr c in next st, tr c in next st) twice, tr c in next st. Repeat from \* for required length. Fasten off.

**2nd Row.** Join dark color to starting st of last row, ch 7, s c in s c at tip of 1st scroll, \* (ch 2, d c in next st) 4 times, d c in next 2nd st, s c in tip s c on next scroll. Repeat from \* across. Ch 7, sl st in end tr c of end scroll. Fasten off.

**Heading.** Join light color to same tr c, ch 3, d c in same st, ch 4, 2 d c in st at left end of same tr c holding the last loop of each d c on hook, thread over and pull through all 3 loops on hook at once (a cluster) \* ch 2, a 2 d c cluster st in next 3rd ch st, ch 4, a 2 d c cluster st at left end of next tr c. Repeat from \* across. Fasten off.

**2nd Row.** Join same light color to 1st d c at start of last row, ch 3, a 2 d c cluster st in next ch st, \* ch 2, a 2 d c cluster st in next 3rd ch st, ch 4, skip next 2 clusters, a 2 d c cluster st in next ch st. Repeat from \* across. Fasten off.

Stretch and press to exact width of towel and whip to edge. Repeat for other end of towel.

**FLOWER.** With medium color (ch 8, skip last ch st, s c in next st, s d c in next st, 2 d c in next st, 1 d c in next st, 2 d c in next st, s d c in next st, s c in next st), 6 times. Sl st in starting st. Fasten off.

**2nd Row.** Join dark color to s c at tip of one scroll, \* (ch 2, d c in next st) 4 times, s c in s c at tip of next scroll. Repeat from \* around. Sl st in 1st st and fasten off.

**LEAF.** With dark color, \* ch 18, \*\* d c in 5th st from hook (ch 1, tr c in next 2nd st), twice, ch 1, d c in next 2nd st, ch 1, s d c in next 2nd st, ch 1, sl st in next 2nd st. \*\* Repeat from \* twice. Sl st in next 3 ch sts, ch 15 and repeat from \*\* to \*\*. Sl st in 3 ch sts between opposite leaves, ch 15 and repeat from \*\* to \*\*. Sl st in remaining 3 ch sts of stem. Fasten off. Make a 2nd leaf.

Sew flower on towel with a leaf on each side.

Repeat from \* around. Sl st to 8th s c and repeat from \*\* to \*\*. Fasten off.


Crochet the edges of Base and Pedestal together with 1 s c through each st (126 s c).

**2nd Row.** \* Ch 2 (d c, ch 3, tr c) in next 4th s c, ch 3 (tr c, ch 3, d c), in next s c, ch 2, s c in next 4th s c. Repeat from \* around (14 shells).

**3rd Row.** \* 2 s c in next 2-ch, 4 s c in 3-ch (3 s c, a p and 2 s c), in next 3-ch, 4 s c in next, 2 s c in 2-ch. Repeat from \* around. Fasten off.


**STARCHING.** Insert glass in basket. Turn basket upside down on ironing board and stretch and pin top down flat in a true circle. Dampen entire basket thoroughly by patting and rubbing with a cloth dipped in very thick cooked, hot starch made of half sugar and half starch. Tip glass-filled pedestal of basket over at an angle. Hold in place by running a thread through one of the scallops around base, tied down to a pin on ironing board. Allow to stand until thoroughly dry and set. Remove from board. Run a knife blade down between crochet and glass to loosen. Clean glass and return to basket.

Clear shellac can be used instead of sugar and starch. Apply shellac with a brush.

## SIMPLE CROCHET STITCHES



**No. 1—Chain Stitch (CH.)** Form a loop on thread, insert hook in loop and pull thread through tightening threads. Thread over hook and pull through last chain made. Continue chains for length desired.

**No. 2—Slip Stitch (SL ST)** Make a chain the desired length. Skip one chain, \* insert hook in next chain, thread over hook and pull through stitch and loop on hook. Repeat from \*. This stitch is used in joining and whenever an invisible stitch is required.

**No. 3—Single Crochet (S C)** Chain for desired length, skip 1 ch, \* insert hook in next ch, thread over hook and pull through ch. There are now 2 loops on hook, thread over hook and pull through both loops, repeat from \*. For succeeding rows of s c, ch 1, turn insert hook in top of next st taking up both threads and continue same as first row.

**No. 4—Short Double Crochet (S D C)** Ch for desired length thread over hook, insert hook in 3rd st from hook, draw thread through (3 loops on hook), thread over and draw through all three loops on hook. For succeeding rows, ch 2, turn.

**No. 5—Double Crochet (D C)** Ch for desired length, thread over hook, insert hook in 4th st from hook, draw thread through (3 loops on hook) thread over hook and pull through 2 loops thread over hook and pull through 2 loops. Succeeding rows, ch 3, turn and work next d c in 2nd d c of previous row. The ch 3 counts as 1 d c.

**No. 6—Treble Crochet (TR C)** Ch for desired length, thread over hook twice insert hook in 5th ch from hook draw thread through (4 loops on hook) thread over hook pull through 2 loops, thread over, pull through 2 loops, thread over, pull through 2 loops. For succeeding rows ch 4, turn and work next tr c in 2nd tr c of previous row. The ch 4 counts as 1 tr c.

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
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
