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

The * is used in repeating - ' repeat from \bullet ' – means to repeat every—thing that follows the last *.

CROCHETED DOILIES

Chain = ch; slip stitch = sl st; single crochet = sc; treble crochet = tr.

This pattern contains directions for two matching crocheted doilies worked in a star design using very simple stitches. Use either fine or heavy cotton.

MATERIAL REQUIREMENTS AND SIZES

No. 50 Mercerized Crochet Cotton in 175 yard balls, and a No. 12 Steel Crochet Hook:

	Large	Small
Size in Inches	16	11
Approximate No. of Yards	400	195

No. 30 Mercerized Crochet Cotton in 325 yard balls, and a No. 10 Steel Crochet Hook:

	Large	Small
Size in Inches	18	13
Approximate No. of Yards	450	225

CAUTION: These doilies have some fullness which will be blocked out when the doilies are completed.

LARGE DOILY

1ST ROUND: Ch 22, join with a sl st into a ring, ch 4, 49 tr (thread twice around hook for a tr) into a ring, a sl st in top st of ch 4 at beginning of round. = 50 tr. 2ND ROUND: Ch 4, 1 tr in same st, sl st, * 1 tr in each of next 4 tr, 2 tr in next tr; repeat from * around, end with 1 tr in each of next 4 tr, a sl st in top st of first ch. = 60 tr

3RD ROUND: Ch 1, 1 sc in same st as sl st, * ch 8, 1 sc in next tr; repeat from * around, end with ch 8, sl st in first sc of round (there are 60 chain loops in round. 4TH ROUND: A sl st in each of next 4 sts in chain, 1 sc in same (ch 8) loop as sl sts, * ch 8, 1 sc in next (ch 8 loop); repeat from * around, end with ch 8, a sl st in first sc of round.

5TH - 7TH ROUNDS: Repeat last round 3 more times. 8TH ROUND: Ch 4, work (1 tr, ch 2 and 2 tr) all in same

chain loops, and a sl st in top of first ch 4 of round.

9TH ROUND: Ch 4, 1 tr in next tr, (2 tr, ch 3 and 2 tr) in (ch 2) loop, 1 tr in each of next 2 tr, skip next sc, sc in next chain loop, (ch 8 and 1 sc) in each of next 8 (ch 8) loops, skip next sc, 1 tr in each of next 2 tr; repeat from * around, end with a sl st in top st of first ch 4.

10TH ROUND: Ch 4, * 1 tr in each tr to next chain loop, (3, tr, ch 4 and 3 tr) in next chain loop, 1 tr in each tr to next chain loop, skip sc, 1 sc, 1 sc in next chain loop, (ch 8 and 5 s) in each chain loop to next tr group, skip sc; repeat from * around, end with sl st in top st of first ch 4.

11TH - 15TH ROUNDS: Repeat last round 5 more times.

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16TH ROUND: Ch 4, 2 tr in same st as last sl st, * 1 tr in each of next 21 tr, (3 tr, ch 5 and 3 tr) in next chain loop, 1 tr in each of next 21 tr, 3 tr in next tr, 1 sc in next chain loop, ch 8, 1 sc in next chain loop, skip sc, 3 tr in next tr; repeat from * around, end with a sl st in top st of first ch 4.

17TH ROUND: Ch 4, 2 tr in same st as sl st, * 1 tr in each of next 25 tr, 2 tr in next tr, (3 tr, ch 5 and 3 tr) in next chain loop, 2 tr in next tr, 1 tr in each of 25 tr, 3 tr in next tr, 1 sc in next chain loop, skip sc, 3 tr in next tr; repeat from * around, end with 1 sc in next chain loop, a sl st in top st of first ch 4.

18TH ROUND: Ch 1, turn; a sl st in next sc, ch 1, turn, 1 sc in same sc as last sl st made, work (ch 8, skip 3 sts, 1 sc in next tr) 8 times, * ch 8, skip a tr, 1 sc in next chain loop, ch 8, skip a tr, 1 sc in next tr, (ch 8, skip 3 tr, 1 sc in next st) 16 times; repeat from * around, end with (ch 8, skip 3 tr, 1 sc in next tr) 7 times, ch 8, skip 3 tr, a sl st in first sc of round. 19TH ROUND: Ch 4, (1 tr, ch 2 and 2 tr) in same sc as last sl st, * 1 sc, in next chain loop, (ch 8 and 1 sc) in each of next 8 chain loops, (2 tr, ch 2 and 2 tr) in next sc; repeat from * around, end with a sl st in top st of first ch 4.

20TH ROUND: Same as 9th round but work (ch 8 and 1 sc) in 7 chain loops.

21ST – 26TH ROUNDS: Repeat the 10th round 6 times.

27TH ROUND: Ch 4, * 1 tr in each tr to next chain loop, (3 tr, ch 5 and 3 tr) in chain loop, 1 tr in each tr, 1 sc in (ch 8) loop; repeat from * around, end with 1 sc in chain loop, a sl st in top st of first ch 4.

28TH ROUND: Ch 7, 1 tr in same st as last sl st, * work (skip 3 tr, 1 tr in next tr, ch 3, 1 tr in same tr as last tr) across to next chain loop, work (1 tr, ch 3, 1 tr, ch 3 and 1 tr) all in next chain loop, (1 tr, ch 3 and 1 tr) in next tr, (skip 3 tr, '1 tr, ch 3 and 1 tr' in next tr) a-cross to sc, skip sc, (1 tr, ch 3 and 1 tr) in next tr; repeat from * a¬round, end with a sl st in 4th st of first ch 7 of round.

29TH ROUND: A sl st in next chain loop, ch 9, 1 sc in 4th st from hook (this forms a picot), ch 1, 1 tr in same chain loop as last sl st, * ch 3, 1 sc in next (ch 3) loop, ch 3, 1 tr in next chain loop, ch 4, 1 sc in 4th st from hook, ch 1, 1 tr in same chain loop as last tr; repeat from * around, end with ch 3, a sl st in 4th st of first chain of round; breakoff.

SMALL DOILY


Follow the directions for the first 17 rounds of large doily. Follow di¬rections for 28th and 29th rounds of large doily; break off.

BLOCKING: Stretch and pin each doily to the correct size and shape on a padded surface; cover with a damp cloth; press with a warm iron. Remove when dry.

LUNCHEON SET: Using No. 30 Cotton make a large doily for center piece and a small doily for each plate mat. BUFFET SET: Using No. 30 Cotton make a large and two small doilies.


Details of Doilies are guides to check each round and row. Numbers in circles indicate the rounds. Numbers in squares indicate the rows.

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
