## INTRODUCTORY REMARKS.

The Six D'Oyleys in this Book, forming a Set, should be made with the same Needle and Cotton, and the size of them may be varied as follows:-

1st $^{\text {st }}$ Size - $71 / 2$ inches in diameter - Use Walter Evans and Co.'s Boar's-Head Crochet Cotton No. 4, and Walker's Uncotopic Penelope Needle No. 2 (steel crochet hook sz 6).
$2^{\text {nd }}$ Size - $31 / 2$ inches in diameter - Boar's-Head Crochet Cotton No. 8, and Needle No. $21 / 2$ (steel crochet hook sz 7).
3rd Size - 5 inches in diameter - Boar's-Head Crochet Cotton No. 12, and Needle No. 3 (steel crochet hook sz 8).
The Slip Stitchs (SIst) at the end of the rounds in the following directions are to be worked through both sides of the stitches of the preceding round. This is necessary to be observed, as it makes the work neater and prevents the beginning and ends of the Pattern from being perceived.

Also, when directed - "To turn back and work 3 or more-SIst on the last stitches of the round," it is done to bring the thread to the centre of the chain stitches, its proper place to commence the next round.

Substitute ch3, dc into the beg ch 1 for the end of round 3 and ignore the sk4 on the beg of round 4 .

## THE CROCHET BOOK,

## D'Oyley No. 1

Work a chain of 7 stitches, and make it round.
$1^{\text {st }}$ round -11 chain and 1 sc in the foundation chain, 7 times; then 5 Slst on the $1^{\text {st }} 11$ chain.
$2^{\text {nd }}-\left(1 \mathrm{sc}, 11\right.$ chain, 1 sc : both these sc stitches are to be worked in the 11 chain of the $1^{\text {st }}$ round), 3 chain, miss 10 : repeat, end 1 Slst.

3 rd -11 sc , 3 chain, miss 5 : repeat, and end with 1 Slst.
$4^{\text {th }}-14$ chain, miss $13,1 \mathrm{sc}$, in the 3 chain of last round: repeat.
$5^{\text {th }}$ - miss 1,7 sc, 5 chain, 7 sc: repeat, end with 6 SIst.
$6^{\text {th }}-7 \mathrm{sc}, 9$ chain, miss 12: repeat, and end with 3 SIst.
$7^{\text {th }}$ - ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 9$ chain, 1 sc : both these sc stitches in the centre stitch of the 7 sc in $6^{\text {th }}$ round), 7 chain, miss $7,(1 \mathrm{sc}, 9$ chain: both these sc stitches in the centre stitch of the 9 chain in $6^{\text {h }}$ round), 7 chain, miss 7 ; repeat, end with 2 SIst.
$8^{\text {th }}-\left(1 \mathrm{sc}, 7\right.$ chain, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 9$ chain, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 7$ chain, 1 sc : these 4 sc stitches are worked in the 9 chain of the $7^{\text {th }}$ round); 5 chain, miss 4,1 sc in the centre of the 7 chain in $7^{\text {th }}$ round, 5 chain, miss 4 , repeat, and end with 1 SIst).
$9^{\text {th }}-7$ sc, miss $1,9 \mathrm{sc}$, miss $1,7 \mathrm{sc}, 3$ chain, miss 13 : repeat, and end with 4 Slst.
$10^{\text {th }}-13$ chain, miss $15,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3$ chain, miss $9,1 \mathrm{sc}$ : repeat, at the end turn back, work 2 SIst on the last 3 chain; turn back.
$11^{\text {th }}-6$ chain, $9 \mathrm{sc}, 7$ chain, 9 sc: repeat.
$12^{\text {th }}$ - ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 11$ chain, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 13$ chain, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 11$ chain, 1 sc : these 4 sc in the 6 chain of $11^{\text {th }}$ round); 3 chain, miss $9,5 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 7 chain of the $11^{\text {th }}$ round3 chain, miss 9 : repeat, and end with 1 Slst.
$13^{\text {th }}-9 \mathrm{sc}$, miss $3,11 \mathrm{sc}$, miss $3,9 \mathrm{sc}$, 3 chain, miss $7,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the centre of the $5 \mathrm{sc}, 3$ chain, miss 7 ; end 1 Slst: repeat, and fasten off.

## D'Oyley no 1, in colours

Amber and dark green - commence with the amber, and work the $1^{\text {st }}, 2^{\text {nd }}$, and $3^{\text {rd }}$ rounds - green, $4^{\text {th }}, 5^{\text {th }}$, and $6^{\text {th }}$ rounds amber, $7^{\text {th }}, 8^{8^{\text {th }}}$, and $9^{\text {th }}$ rounds - green, $10^{\text {th }}$ and $11^{\text {th }}$ rounds - amber $12^{\text {th }}$ and $13^{\text {th }}$ rounds.

## D'Oyley no 2

Work a chain of 8 sts, and make it round.
$1^{\text {st }}$ round - 7 chain, and 1 sc 8 times in the foundation chain, then 3 Slst upon the last 7 chain.
$2^{\text {nd }}-(1 \mathbf{s c}, 5$ chain, 1 sc : both these sc$)$ in the 7 chain of $1^{\text {st }}$ round $), 1$ chain, miss 6: repeat 7 times, end with 1 SIst.
$3^{\text {rd }}-1$ chain, miss $1,5 \mathrm{dc}$ in the 5 chain of $2^{\text {nd }}$ round, 1 chain, miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 1 chain of $2^{\text {nd }}$ round - repeat, at the end work 3 Slst.
$4^{\text {th }}-\left(1 \mathrm{sc}, 6\right.$ chain, 1 sc : both these sc in the centre of the 5 dc in $3^{\text {rd }}$ round $), 5$ chain, miss 7 : repeat, at the end work 3 SIst.
$5^{\text {th }}-\left(1 \mathrm{sc}, 7\right.$ chain, 1 sc : both sc in the 6 chain of the $4^{\text {th }}$ round), 3 chain, miss $5,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 5 chain of the $4^{\text {th }}$ round, 3 chain, miss 5 ; repeat, and end with 2 SIst.
$6^{\text {th }}-1$ sc in the 7 chain, ( 5 chain, and 1 sc in the same 7 chain 5 times), 5 chain, miss 9 ; repeat, and end with 1 Slst, turn back, and work 3 Slst on the last 5 chain, turn back.
$7^{\text {th }}-6$ chain, miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 5 chain of $6^{\text {th }}$ round: repeat all round, end with 2 SIst on the $1^{\text {st }} 6$ chain.
$8^{\text {th }}-8$ Slst, 5 chain, 8 SIst, ( 7 chain, put the needle into the $2^{\text {nd }}$ stitch of these 7 chain, and work a sc in it to form a round loop), 1 sc, miss 5: repeat, and end with 3 SIst.
$\mathbf{9}^{\text {th }}-3$ chain, miss 5 , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 7$ chain, 1 sc : both these sc in the round loop of the $8^{\text {th }}$ round), 3 chain, miss $5,1 \mathrm{sc}$, in the centre of the 8 SIst; repeat, and end with 3 SIst.
$10^{\text {th }}-1$ chain, miss $2,7 \mathrm{dc}$ in the 7 chain of the $9^{\text {th }}$ round, 1 chain, miss $2,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 3 chain, 1 chain, miss $3,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 3 chain: repeat, and end with 6 Slst.
$11^{\text {th }}-13$ chain, put the needle into the $4^{\text {th }}$ stitch and work a sc in it to form a round loop, 3 chain, miss 9,3 Slst: repeat, and end with 3 SIst more.
$12^{\text {th }}-1$ sc in the round loop, ( 5 chain, and 1 sc 5 times in the same round loop), 5 chain, miss 11; repeat, end 1 Slst; turn back, work 3 Slst in the last 5 chain, turn back.
$13^{\text {th }}$ - same as $7^{\text {th }}$.
$14^{\text {th }}$ - same as $8^{\text {th }}$, working sc instead of SIst.
$15^{\text {th }}-1$ chain, miss $4(1 \mathrm{sc}, 5$ chain, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 7$ chain, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 9$ chain, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 7$ chain, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 5$ chain, 1 sc : these 6 sc are all to be worked in the 5 chain of $14^{\text {th }}$ round), 1 chain, miss $4,1 \mathrm{sc}$ : repeat, and work 1 sc . Fasten off.

## D'Oyley no 2, in colours

Pink and slate - commence with the pink, and work the $1^{\text {st }}, 2^{\text {nd }}$, and $3^{\text {rd }}$ rounds - slate $, 4^{\text {th }}, 5^{\text {th }}$, and $6^{\text {th }}$ rounds - pink $^{7^{\text {th }}}, 8^{\text {th }}, 9^{\text {th }}$, and $10^{\text {th }}$ rounds - slate, $11^{\text {th }}$ and $12^{\text {th }}$ rounds - pink $13^{\text {th }}, 14^{\text {th }}$, and $15^{\text {th }}$ rounds.

## D'Oyley no 3

Work a chain of 8 stitches, make it round.
$1^{\text {st }}$ round -5 chain and $2 \mathrm{sc}, 6$ times in the foundation chain.
$2^{\text {nd }}-2$ chain, miss 1 , ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, 3$ chain, and 2 dc , these 4 dc in the 5 chain), 2 chain, miss 1,1 Slst between the 2 sc of the $1^{\text {st }}$ round; repeat.
$3^{\text {rd }}-3$ chain, miss $4,\left(2 \mathrm{dc}\right.$ in the 3 chain, 5 chain, turn, miss 4,1 SIst in the $5^{\text {th }}$ chain stitch, 2 dc in the same 3 chain as before), 3 chain, miss 4, 1 Slst on the 1 SIst of last round; repeat, end 5 Slst.
$4^{\text {th }}-7$ sc in the round loop, and for the $1^{\text {st }}$ flower, 15 chain, turn, miss 7,1 Slst, in the $8^{\text {th }}$ stitch to form a round loop, turn, and leaving 7 chain for the stem, work 1 chain to cross it, 1 sc in the round loop, 6 chain, join it to the $4^{\text {th }}$ stitch of the 7 sc worked in the round loop of the 3 rd round; turn, and on the 6 chain, miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{Slst}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the round loop, (then 6 chain, turn, miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{Slst}$, and 1 sc in the round loop 5 times), and to form the $7^{\text {th }}$ division of the flower, work $1 \mathrm{Slst}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 SIst down the stem, leaving 2 chain, ${ }^{*}$, then 2 chain, miss 11 stitches of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ round, 3 sc in the round loop, join it to the point of the $6^{\text {th }}$ division of the flower, then 4 sc in the same round loop.

For the $2^{\text {nd }}$ flower -15 chain, turn, 1 Slst in the $8^{\text {th }}$ stitch, 1 chain to cross the stem, 1 sc in the round loop, 6 chain, join it to the $4^{\text {th }}$ stitch of the $7^{\text {th }} \mathrm{sc}$, worked in the last round loop; turn, miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{Slst}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the round loop, 6 chain, join it to the point of the $5^{\text {th }}$ division of the $1^{\text {st }}$ flower, turn, miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{Slst}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the round loop, (then 6 chain, turn, miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3$ $\mathrm{dc}, 1$ Slst, and 1 sc in the round loop, 4 times), and for the $7^{\text {th }}$ division of the flower, work $1 \mathrm{Slst}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 Slst down the stem, leaving 2 chain, repeat from *, 6 times more, then 2 chain, miss 11,3 Slst on the $1^{\text {st }} 7 \mathrm{sc}$ of the round, join it to the $6^{\text {th }}$ division of the $8^{\text {th }}$ flower; then 11 SIst up the sides of the 2 first divisions of the $1^{\text {st }}$ flower and join it to the $5^{\text {th }}$ division of the $8^{\text {th }}$ flower.
$5^{\text {th }}-6$ chain, miss $11,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the point of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ division of the $1^{\text {st }}$ flower; 6 chain, miss $11,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the point of the $4^{\text {th }}$ division of the flower; 6 chain, miss $11,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the point of the $5^{\text {th }}$ division of the flower; repeat, end 4 SIst.
$6^{\text {th }}-17 \mathrm{sc}$, and for the $1^{\text {st }}$ leaf -16 chain, turn, miss $4,1 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ chain, miss $2,1 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ chain, miss $2,1 \mathrm{sc}, 1$ chain to cross the stem; and on the other side, miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ and 2 dc in the 2 chain, join it to the $12^{\text {th }}$ stitch of the 17 sc , then 1 dc and 1 sc in the same 2 chain of the leaf as before; then (miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc in the 2 chain), miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ and 2 dc in the 4 chain; and before finishing this leaf, work 13 chain for the
$1^{\text {st }}$ flower - turn, miss 7,1 SIst in the $8^{\text {th }}$ stitch, turn, 1 chain to cross the stem; 1 sc in the round loop, ( 6 chain, turn, miss 1,1 $\mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1$ Slst in the 6 chain and 1 sc in the round loop 6 times); then to form the $7^{\text {th }}$ division, work $1 \mathrm{SIst}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 Slst down the stem; and to finish the leaf, work 1 dc and 1 sc in the same 4 chain as before, (miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc in the 2 chain twice) then 2 Slst down the stem, and for the
$2^{\text {nd }}$ flower -15 chain, turn, miss 7,1 SIst in the $8^{\text {th }}$ stitch, 1 chain to cross the stem, 1 sc in the round loop, 6 chain, join it to the centre dc of the $1^{\text {st }}$ leaf, turn, miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{Slst}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the round loop, 6 chain, join it to the $6^{\text {th }}$ division of the $1^{\text {st }}$ flower, turn, miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$, $1 \mathrm{SIst}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the round loop, ( 6 chain, turn, miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{Slst}$, and 1 sc in the round loop 4 times), and down the stem $1 \mathrm{SIst}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{SIst}$; and 1 sc on the stem of the $1^{\text {st leaf. }}$

[^3]$2^{\text {nd }}$ Leaf -13 chain, turn, miss $4,1 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ chain, miss $2,1 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ chain, miss $2,1 \mathrm{sc}, 1$ chain to cross the stem, and on the other side miss 1 , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc in the 2 chain), miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ and 2 dc in the next 2 chain; join it to the point of the $6^{\text {th }}$ division of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ flower, 1 dc , and 1 sc in the same 2 chain, miss $1,(1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc in the 4 chain), turn, and down the other side, (miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc in the 2 chain, twice), 2 SIst down the stem, and 2 sc down the stem of the $1^{\text {st }}$ leaf; then 4 sc on the $5^{\text {th }}$ round, join it to the centre of the last division of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ leaf, ${ }^{* *}, 17 \mathrm{sc}$ on the $5^{\text {th }}$ round; and for the
$3^{\text {rd }}$ Leaf -16 chain, turn, miss $4,1 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ chain, miss $2,1 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ chain, miss $2,1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 1$ chain to cross the stem; and on the other side, miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ and 2 dc in the 2 chain, join it to the $12^{\text {th }}$ stitch of the 17 sc , then 1 dc and 1 sc in the same 2 chain of the leaf as before; then (miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc in the 2 chain), miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ and 2 dc in the 4 chain; join it to the point of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ leaf; and before finishing this leaf, work 13 chain for the
$3^{\text {rd }}$ Flower - turn, 1 Slst in the $8^{\text {th }}$ stitch, 1 chain to cross the stem, 1 sc in the round loop, 6 chain, join it to the point of the $5^{\text {th }}$ division of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ flower, turn, miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc} 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{Slst}$, 1 sc in the round loop, (then 6 chain, turn, miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{Slst}$, and 1 sc in the round loop 5 times), and for the $7^{\text {th }}$ division of the flower, work $1 \mathrm{SIst}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 Slst down the stem; and to finish the leaf, work 1 dc and 1 sc in the same 4 chain as before; (miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc in the 2 chain twice), then 2 Slst down the stem; and for the
$4^{\text {th }}$ flower -15 chain, turn, miss 7,1 Slst in the $8^{\text {th }}$ stitch, 1 chain to cross the stem, 1 sc in the round loop, 6 chain, join it to the centre dc of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ leaf, turn, miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{Slst}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the round loop, 6 chain, join it to the $6^{\text {th }}$ division of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ flower, turn, miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{slst}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the round loop; ( 6 chain, turn, miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{slst}$, and 1 sc in the round loop 4 times), and down the stem, $1 \mathrm{Slst}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{Slst}$; and 1 sc on the stem of the $3{ }^{\text {rd }}$ leaf.
$4^{\text {th }}$ Leaf -13 chain, turn, miss $4,1 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ chain, miss $2,1 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ chain, miss $2,1 \mathrm{sc}, 1$ chain to cross the stem, and on the other side, miss $1,\left(1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}\right.$, and 1 sc in the 2 chain), miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$, in the 2 chain ; join it to the point of the $6^{\text {th }}$ division of the $4^{\text {th }}$ flower, 1 dc and 1 sc in the same 2 chain, miss $1,(1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc in the 4 chain), turn, (miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc in the 2 chain twice), 2 Slst down the stem, and 2 sc down the stem of the $3^{\text {dr }}$ leaf; then 4 sc on the $5^{\text {th }}$ round, join it to the centre of the last division of the $4^{\text {th }}$ leaf; repeat from ${ }^{* *}$, and when the round is finished, work 11 SIst up the side of the last leaf; join it to the point of the $1^{\text {st }}$ leaf, then 12 SIst up the $1^{\text {st }}$ flower, joining it to the $5^{\text {th }}$ division of the last flower. Fasten off.

## D'Oyley no 3, in colours

Pink and Green - Commence with the green, and work $1^{\text {st }}, 2^{\text {nd }}$, and $3^{\text {rd }}$ rounds - pink, $4^{\text {th }}$ round - green, $5^{\text {th }}$ round. Pink and Green are used in the $6^{\text {th }}$ round - thus, work the sc stitches and half of the $1^{\text {st }}$ leaf with the green, carrying the pink under it. Work the $1^{\text {st }}$ flower with pink, finish the leaf with green, carrying the pink under it. Work the $2^{\text {nd }}$ flower with pink; leave it, and work the $2^{\text {nd }}$ leaf with green; and then the sc stitches on the $5^{\text {th }}$ round with green, carrying the pink under: repeat.

## D'Oyley no 4

Work a chain of 8 stitches, and make it round.
$1^{\text {st }}$ round -13 chain and $1 \mathrm{sc}, 7$ times in the foundation chain, end 1 SIst on the $1^{\text {st }} 13$ chain.
$2^{\text {nd }}-11 \mathrm{sc}$, miss 3 : repeat, end with 6 SIst on the $1^{\text {st }} 11 \mathrm{sc}$.
3rd -8 chain, miss 9, 2 sc: repeat.
$4^{\text {th }}-3 \mathrm{sc}$, and 2 sc in the $4^{\text {th }}$ stitch: repeat, and end with 1 SIst.
$5^{\text {th }}-5$ chain, miss 2,3 sc: repeat and end with 3 SIst on the $1^{\text {st }} 5$ chain.
$6^{\text {th }}-6$ chain, miss 6, 2 sc: repeat.
$7^{\text {th }}-3$ chain, miss 1,1 sc: repeat.
$8^{\text {th }}-6$ chain, miss $7,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 3 chain: repeat.
9th -3 chain, miss 5, ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, 4$ chain, 2 dc: these 4 dc are all to be worked in the 6 chain of the last round); 3 chain, miss 5, 1 sc in the 6 chain: repeat.
$10^{\text {th }}-3$ chain, miss 5 , ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, 4$ chain, 2 dc ; these 4 dc are to be worked in the 4 chain of the 9 th round), 3 chain, miss $5,1 \mathrm{sc}$ on the 1 sc of the last round: repeat.
$11^{\text {th }}$ - same as $10^{\text {th }}$ round, and at the end work 5 SIst.

$13^{\text {th }}-2$ chain, miss 4,1 dc in the 5 chain, ( 4 chain and 1 dc 4 times in the same 5 chain of the last round), 2 chain, miss 4,1 sc in the 7 chain of last round: repeat.
$14^{\text {th }}-1$ chain, miss $3,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 2 chain, (miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc in the 4 chain 4 times), miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 2 chain: repeat, and fasten off.

## D'Oyley no 4, in colours

Blue and White - Commence with the blue, and work the $1^{\text {st }}$ and $2^{\text {nd }}$ rounds, then with white, work the $3^{\text {rd }}$ and $4^{\text {th }}$ rounds - blue, $5^{\text {th }}, 6^{\text {th }}$, and $7^{\text {th }}$ rounds - white, $8^{\text {th }}, 9^{\text {th }}, 10^{\text {th }}, 11^{\text {th }}$ rounds - blue $12^{\text {th }}, 13^{\text {th }}$, and $14^{\text {th }}$ rounds.

$1^{\text {st }}$ round - 6 chain, 1 sc in the foundation chain, 10 chain, turn, miss $5,5 \mathrm{sc}$ on the 10 chain, 1 sc in the foundation chain; repeat 7 times more, turn back; work 5 Slst up the last 5 sc, turn back.
$2^{\text {nd }}-3$ chain, miss 18,1 sc in the round loop of the $1^{\text {st }}$ round; ( 5 chain and 1 sc 5 times in the same round loop): repeat, and end with 2 Slst on the $1^{\text {st }} 3$ chain.
$3^{\text {rd }}-13$ chain, miss 32,1 sc in the 3 chain: repeat, end with 2 Slst.
$4^{\text {th }}-11$ sc on the 13 chain, 9 chain, turn, miss 5,4 sc on the 9 chain, miss 3 : repeat, end with 5 SIst.
$5^{\text {th }}-1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the centre stitch of the 11 sc , and for the $1^{\mathrm{st}}$ leaf, 11 chain, turn, miss $1,1 \mathrm{Slst}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{Slst}$.
$2^{\text {nd }}$ Leaf - 8 chain, turn, miss 1,1 SIst, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{dc}, 1$ Slst.
$3^{\text {rd }}$ Leaf -8 chain, turn, miss 1,1 Slst, 1 sc, $4 \mathrm{dc}, 1$ Slst. 3 Slst down the stem, and 1 sc in the same centre stitch of the 11 sc of the $4^{\text {th }}$ round as before, and for the Flower -3 chain, miss 9,1 sc in the round loop, ( 5 chain and 1 sc 5 times in the same round loop), 3 chain, miss 9 : repeat, end with 11 SIst up the stem and $1^{\text {st }}$ leaf to the point.
$6^{\text {th }}-7$ chain, miss $14,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the point of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ leaf; 7 chain, miss $14,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the point of the $3{ }^{\text {rd }}$ leaf; 3 chain, miss $29,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the centre 5 chain of the flower; 3 chain, miss 29,1 sc in the point of the next leaf: repeat, end with 6 SIst.
$7^{\text {th }}-14 \mathrm{sc}, 12$ chain, and for the $1^{\text {st }}$ leaf, turn, miss 4,1 Slst in the $5^{\text {th }}$ stitch, turn back; ( 5 chain and 1 sc 3 times in the round loop), turn back; 1 sc in the 5 chain, ( 4 chain and 1 sc twice in the same 5 chain, 2 chain, join it to the $5^{\text {th }}$ stitch of the $14 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ chain, 1 sc in the same 5 chain, 4 chain and 1 sc twice in the same 5 chain), miss 1,1 sc in the next 5 chain, ( 4 chain and 1 sc 5 times in the same 5 chain), miss 1,1 sc in the next 5 chain, ( 4 chain and 1 sc 5 times in the same 5 chain), 4 Slst down the stem - this finishes the leaf - and for the
$2^{\text {nd }}$ leaf, 9 chain and work as the $1^{\text {st }}$ leaf, joining it to the centre 5 chain of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ division of the $1^{\text {st }}$ leaf $-*$, and for the
$3^{\text {rd }}$ leaf, 9 chain, and work as the $1^{\text {st }}$ leaf, joining it to the centre 5 chain, of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ division of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ leaf, when finished, work 3 sc down the stem of the $1^{\text {st }}$ leaf and 10 sc on the $6^{\text {th }}$ round, join it to the centre 5 chain of the 3 rd division of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ leaf; then 14 sc, 12 chain, and for the
$4^{\text {th }}$ leaf, turn, miss 4,1 Slst in the $5^{\text {th }}$ stitch, turn back; ( 5 chain and 1 sc 3 times in the round loop), turn back; 1 sc In the 5 chain, ( 4 chain and 1 sc twice in the same 5 chain, 2 chain, join it to the $5^{\text {th }}$ stitch of the $14 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ chain, 1 sc in the same 5 chain, 4 chain and 1 sc twice in the same 5 chain), miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next 5 chain, ( 4 chain and 1 sc twice in the same 5 chain, 2 chain, join it to the centre 5 chain of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ division of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ leaf, 2 chain, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 4$ chain and 1 sc twice in the same 5 chain), then 4 Slst down the stem; and for the
$5^{\text {th }}$ Leaf -9 chain, and work as the $2^{\text {nd }}$ leaf, then repeat from *, and for the last leaf -9 chain and work as the $4^{\text {th }}$ leaf, joining it $1^{\text {st }}$ to the centre 5 chain of the last leaf worked; and 2ndly to the centre 5 chain of the $1^{\text {st }}$ leaf worked; when finished work 3 sc down the stem, and 10 sc on the $6^{\text {th }}$ round, join it to the centre 5 chain of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ division of the last leaf. Fasten off.

Ponceau and Gold - Commence with the ponceau, and work the $1^{\text {st }}$ and $2^{\text {nd }}$ rounds - gold, the $3^{\text {rd }}$ and $4^{\text {th }}$ rounds - ponceau, $5^{\text {th }}$ round - gold, $6^{\text {th }}$ and $7^{\text {th }}$ rounds.

## D'Oyley no 6

Work a chain of 8 sts, make it round.
$1^{\text {st }}$ round - 12 chain, turn, miss $5,2 \mathrm{SIst}$, and 5 dc on the 12 chain, 1 sc in the foundation chain; repeat 7 times more, end with 7 Slst up the $1^{\text {st }} 12$ chain.
$2^{\text {nd }}-1$ sc in the round loop of the $1^{\text {st }}$ round (chain 5 and 1 sc 3 times in the same round loop as before), 3 chain miss 15 ; repeat, end 1 Slst.
$3^{\text {rd }}-9$ chain, turn, miss 1,1 SIst, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ and 2 tc in the 9 chain, 3 chain, miss $19,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 3 chain of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ round, 8 chain, turn, miss 5,1 Slst in the $6^{\text {th }}$ stitch. 2 chain, 1 sc in the same 3 chain of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ round; repeat, end with 9 SIst up the $1^{\text {st }} 9$ chain.
$4^{\text {th }}-5$ Chain, miss $13,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the round loop if the $3^{\text {rd }}$ round. And for the 3 small leaves, ( 5 chain, turn, miss $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 SIst on the 5 chain, 1 sc in the same round loop as before, repeat twice more); then 5 chain, miss 13,1 Slst in the chain at the point of the star in the $3{ }^{\text {drd }}$ round; repeat.
$5^{\text {th }}-8$ chain, miss 17,1 sc in the 2 chain at the top of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ small leaf in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ round; 8 chain, miss 17,1 SIst on the 1 Slst at the point of the star in last round; repeat, end 4 SIst on the $1^{\text {st }} 8$ chain.
$6^{\text {th }}-14 \mathrm{sc}$, and for the $1^{\text {st }}$ Flower, 11 chain, turn, miss 4,1 SIst in the $5^{\text {th }}$ stitch, turn, 1 chain to cross the stem, 2 chain; join it to the $11^{\text {th }}$ stitch of the 14 sc ; then 2 chain, 1 sc in the round loop, ( 5 chain and 1 sc 4 times in the same round loop), 3 Slst down the stem; and for the $2^{\text {nd }}$ Flower, 9 chain, turn, miss 4,1 SIst, 1 chain to cross the stem; 2 chain, join it to the last 5 chain of the $1^{\text {st }}$ Flower, 2 chain, 1 sc in the round loop, ( 5 chain and 1 sc 4 times in the same round loop), 4 Slst down the stem, and 1 Slst down the stem of the $1^{\text {st }}$ Flower; and for the $3^{\text {rd }}$ Flower, 8 chain, turn, miss 4,1 SIst, 1 chain to cross the stem, 2 chain, join it to the last 5 chain of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ Flower, 2 chain, 1 sc in the round loop, ( 5 chain and 1 sc 4 times in the round loop), 3 Slst down the stem, and 2 Slst down the stem of the $1^{\text {st }}$ Flower; then miss 1 , and work 3 sc on the $5^{\text {th }}$ round, join it to the last 5 chain of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ Flower; repeat, at the end work 5 SIst on the $1^{\text {st }} 14 \mathrm{sc}$.
$7^{\text {th }}-5$ chain, miss 15,1 sc in the centre 5 chain of the $1^{\text {st }}$ Flower, 8 chain, miss 23,2 sc in the centre 5 chain of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ Flower, 8 chain, miss 23,1 sc in the centre 5 chain of the $3{ }^{\text {rd }}$ Flower, 5 chain, miss $15,2 \mathrm{sc}$ on the centre of the sc stitches repeat, end 5 Slst on the $1^{\text {st }} 5$ chain.
$8^{\text {th }}-5 \mathrm{sc}$ on the $7^{\text {th }}$ round, and for the $1^{\text {st }}$ leaf, 10 chain, turn, miss $2,4 \mathrm{dc}$, and 2 Slst on the 10 chain, leaving 2 chain for the stem, work 8 chain, (miss $2,4 \mathrm{dc}$ and 2 SIst on the 8 chain), 8 chain, turn, (miss $2,4 \mathrm{dc}$ and 2 SIst on the 8 chain); then 2 Slst down the stem, this finishes the leaf; ${ }^{*} 6 \mathrm{sc}$ on the $7^{\mathrm{h} h}$ round, and for the $2^{\text {nd }}$ leaf -9 chain; join it to the point of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ division of the last leaf, 1 chain, miss $1,4 \mathrm{dc}$ and 2 SIst, leaving 2 chain for the stem, ( 8 chain, turn, miss $2,4 \mathrm{dc}$ and 2 Slst twice), 2 Slst down the stem; then 6 sc on the $7^{\text {th }}$ round, and work the $3^{\text {rd }}$ leaf the same as the $2^{\text {nd }}$ leaf; then 5 sc and 5 Slst on the $7^{\text {th }}$ round; and for the $4^{\text {th }}$ leaf, 9 chain, join it to the last stitch of the $5 \mathrm{sc}, 1$ chain, turn, miss $1,4 \mathrm{dc}$, and 2 SIst on the 9 chain, and leaving 2 chain for the stem, work 7 chain; join it to the point of the 3 rd division of the 3 rd leaf, 1 chain, miss $1,4 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{SIst}, 8$ chain, turn, miss $2,4 \mathrm{dc}$ and 2 SIst; then 2 SIst down the stem, and 5 SIst on the $7^{\text {th }}$ round; join it to the point of the last division of the $4^{\text {th }}$ leaf, $5 \mathrm{sc}-5^{\text {th }}$ leaf same as the $2^{\text {nd }}$, joining it to the point of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ division of the $4^{\text {th }}$ leaf: repeat from ${ }^{*}$, and fasten off.

## Anti-Macassar, or Couvre Pied

## Diamond and Star Pattern

Materials - Walter Evans \& Co.'s Boar's-head Crochet Cotton No. 10, and Walker's Uncotopic Penelope Needle No. 2 (steel crochet hook sz 6)

First Diamond - Work a chain of 8 stitches, and make it round.
$1^{\text {st }}$ round - ( $1 \mathrm{dc}, 3$ chain, 1 dc , and $1 \mathrm{sc}, 4$ times, in the foundation chain.)
$2^{\text {nd }}-1$ chain, miss 1, ( $3 \mathrm{dc}, 3$ chain, 3 dc . These 6 dc in the 3 chain of the last round), 1 chain, miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ on the 1 sc of the last round: repeat 3 times more; then work 4 Slst.
$3^{\text {rd }}$ - ( $1 \mathbf{~ S c}, 8$ chain, $1 \mathbf{s c}, 9$ chain, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 8$ chain, $1 \mathbf{~ S c}$. These 4 Sc stitches in the 3 chain of the last round), ${ }^{*} 7$ chain, miss 9: repeat 3 times more, and end with 1 SIst, turn back; and work 3 SIst on the last 7 chain; turn back.*

- Substitute ch3, dc into the beg ch 1 for the end of round 3 and ignore the sk4 on the beg of round 4 .
$4^{\text {th }}$ - Miss $4,8 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc in the 8 chain of the last round, miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 10 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc in the 9 chain of the last round), miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ and 8 dc in the 8 chain of the last round; miss $4,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 7 chain: repeat 3 times more, and fasten off neatly at the back, by running this end down to the end left at the commencement, and knot them together. All the Diamonds are worked in the same manner; the variations of the direction being caused by the joining of the pattern.
$2^{\text {nd }}$ Diamond - Commence by working a chain of 8 stitches as before; and work the first 3 rounds of the pattern as in the $1^{\text {st }}$ Diamond; then work the pattern as in the $4^{\text {th }}$ round, repeating it only twice, and to finish this round, miss 4,8 dc, and 1 Sc in the 8 chain, miss 1 , ( 1 SC and 5 dc in the 9 chain; then 3 chain, and join it to the centre of the $2^{\text {nd }} 10$ dc of the $1^{\text {st }}$ Diamond; turn, and work 3 sc on the 3 chain, then 1 SIst) in the top of the last dc stitch; and to finish the Diamond - work 5 dc , and 1 sc in the same 9 chain as before); miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$, and 8 dc in the 8 chain, miss 4,1 sc , in the 7 chain. Fasten off, and repeat the $2^{\text {nd }}$ Diamond pattern as many times as may be required, always joining it to the last Diamond pattern worked.


## Star Pattern

Work a chain of 10 stitches, and make it round.
$1^{\text {st }}$ round -16 SC in the foundation round.
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$2^{\text {nd }}-8$ chain, turn, miss 5,1 SIst in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ stitch of the 8 chain to form a round loop; then chain $2,2 \mathbf{s c}$ on the $16 \mathbf{~ s c}$; repeat 7 times more, and end with 2 Slst up the first 2 chain.
$3^{\text {rd }}-7 \mathrm{Sc}$ in the round loop, 1 chain, miss 7 ; repeat 7 times more, and end with 1 SIst.
$4^{\text {th }}-8$ chain, miss 7,2 sc in the 1 chain of the last round; repeat 7 times more.
$5^{\text {th }}$ - (Miss $2,1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}, 7 \mathrm{tc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc ; these 11 stitches in the 8 chain of the last round, repeat 3 times more); then miss 2 , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and 4 tc in the next 8 chain; join it to the centre of the $1^{\text {st }} 8 \mathrm{dc}$ in the last Diamond Pattern worked; then $3 \mathrm{tc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc in the same 8 chain of the Star Pattern), miss 2, ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and 3 tc in the next 8 chain; join it to the centre of the last 8 dc of the same Diamond pattern; then $4 \mathrm{tc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc in the same 8 chain), miss 2 , ( $1 \mathbf{~ s c}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ and 4 tc in the next 8 chain; join it to the centre of the $3^{\text {rd }} 8 \mathrm{dc}$ of the next Diamond Pattern; then $3 \mathrm{tc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the same 8 chain), miss 2 , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ and 3 tc in the next 8 chain; join it to the centre of the $2^{\text {nd }} 8 \mathrm{dc}$ of the Diamond Pattern; then $4 \mathrm{tc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the same 8 chain), and fasten off. Repeat the Star Pattern, always joining them between the Diamond Patterns.

## $2^{\text {nd }}$ Stripe of Diamond Pattern.

$1^{\text {st }}$ Diamond - Work the first 3 rounds as in first Stripe, then work the pattern as in the $4^{\text {th }}$ round repeating it only once, and to finish the round, miss $4,8 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc in the next 8 chain, miss 1 , ( 1 sc and 5 dc , in the 9 chain, 3 chain, join it to the centre of the $1^{\text {st }} 10 \mathrm{dc}$ of the last Diamond of the first Stripe worked, turn, 3 sc on the 3 chain, and 1 Slst on the top of the last dc stitch, then 5 dc and 1 sc in the same 9 chain), miss 1 , ( 1 sc , and 4 dc in the 8 chain, join it to the centre of the $4^{\text {th }}$ division of the first Star; then 4 dc in the same 8 chain), miss 4,1 sc in the 7 chain, miss 4 , ( 4 dc in the 8 chain, join it to the centre of 3 rd division of the Star pattern, 4 dc and 1 sc in the same 8 chain), miss 1 , ( $1 \mathbf{s c}, 10 \mathrm{dc}$, and $1 \mathbf{s c}$ in the 9 chain), miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ and 8 dc in the 8 chain, miss $4,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 7 chain. Fasten off.
$2^{\text {nd }}$ Diamond - Work the first 3 rounds as before.
$4^{\text {th }}$ round - Miss $4,8 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc in the 8 chain, miss 1 , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 10 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc in the 9 chain), miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$, and 8 dc in the 8 chain, miss $4,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 7 chain, miss $4,8 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc in the 8 chain, miss $1,(1 \mathrm{sc}$ and 5 dc in the 9 chain, 3 chain, join it to the centre of the last 10 dc in the $1^{\text {st }}$ Diamond of this stripe, turn, 3 sc on the 3 chain, 1 Slst in the top of the last dc stitch, then 5 dc and 1 sc in the same 9 chain), miss $1,(1 \mathrm{sc}$ and 4 dc ) in the 8 chain, join it to the centre of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ division of the Star; then 4 dc in the same 8 chain), miss $4,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 7 chain, miss 4 , ( 4 dc in the 8 chain, join it to the centre of the $1^{\text {st }}$ division of the Star, then 4 dc and 1 sc in the same 8 chain), miss 1 , ( 1 sc and 5 dc in the 9 chain, 3 chain, join it to the top of the Diamond in the $1^{\text {st }}$ stripe, turn, 3 sc on the 3 chain, 1 Slst in the top of the dc stitch, then 5 dc and 1 sc in the same 9 chain), miss 1 , ( 1 sc and 4 dc in the 8 chain, join it to the centre of the $4^{\text {th }}$ division of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ Star pattern, then 4 dc in the same 8 chain), miss $4,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 7 chain, miss $4,\left(4 \mathrm{dc}\right.$ in the 8 chain, join it to the centre of the $3{ }^{\text {rd }}$ division of the Star, then 4 dc and 1 sc in the same 8 chain),
miss $1,(1 \mathrm{sc}, 10 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc in the 9 chain), miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ and 8 dc in the 8 chain, miss $4,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 7 chain. Fasten off.

Repeat this $2^{\text {nd }}$ Diamond until the Stripe is finished, and work alternately the Star and $2^{\text {nd }}$ Diamond Stripe until sufficient is made. Finish with a tassel between each Diamond.

## Anti-Macassar, or Couvre Pied

## Flower Pattern

Materials - Walter Evans \& Co.'s Boar's-head Crochet Cotton, No. 10, and Walker's Uncotopic Penelope Needle, No. 2 (steel crochet hook sz 6)

Make a chain of 17 stitches, and for the calyx of the Flower, turn, miss 6, 7 sc down the stem; work 1 chain to cross it and on the other side, 2 sc, 3 dc 2 Slst, and

For the Flower - work 10 sc in the round loop, turn back; ( 5 chain, miss 1 , and 1 sc 5 times on the 10 sc ), turn back; (miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$, these 7 stitches are worked in the 5 chain: repeat 4 times more), then 2 SIst, 3 dc , 2 sc down the calyx, and 1 SIst on the stem, leaving 3 chain for the centre stem; then 9 sc , join it to the centre of the last 5 dc of the Flower.

For the Leaf - *15 chain, turn, miss 4, 1 Slst in the $5^{\text {th }}$ stitch, turn back; (7 chain, and 1 SC 3 times in the round loop), turn back; (miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ and 3 tc in the 7 chain, join it to the centre of the $4^{\text {th }} 5 \mathrm{dc}$ of the Flower, and in the same 7 chain of the leaf work $6 \mathrm{tc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc ), then (miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}, 9 \mathrm{tc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc in the 7 chain twice), 5 Slst down the stem, which finished the Leaf, and leaving 5 chain for the centre stem, work 9 chain, join it to the $7^{\text {th }}$ tc stitch of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ division of the Leaf, and for the
$2^{\text {nd }}$ Flower and Calyx - 19 chain, turn, miss 6,7 SC, turn, work 1 chain to cross the stem, and on the other side, 2 $\mathbf{s c}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{Slst}, 10 \mathrm{sc}$ in the round loop, turn back; ( 5 chain, miss 1 , and 1 sc 5 times on the 10 sc ), turn back; miss 1, ( 1 sc , and 3 dc in the 5 chain, join it to the $7^{\text {th }}$ tc stitch of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ division of the Leaf, and in the same 5 chain as before, work 2 dc and 1 sc ), then, (miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc in the 5 chain, 4 times), and down the calyx, 2 Slst, $3 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathbf{~ s c}$, and 1 SIst on the stem, leaving 5 chain for the centre stem; work 9 chain, join it to the centre of the last 5 dc of the Flower; repeat from * until the required length is made (with the Knitting Cotton, 15 patterns, or with the Crochet Thread, 18 patterns for one yard). To form the

## Second Side

Work 3 chain, turn, miss 1, 2 sc on the 3 chain, and 12 sc down the centre stem which will be 9 on the 9 chain, and 3 on the 5 chain.
$1^{\text {st }}$ Leaf - 10 chain, and work a Leaf as directed on the other side, but joining it to the $6^{\text {th }}$ stitch of the 14 SC worked down the centre stem, **; then 14 sc down the centre stem, and for the

[^9]Flower - 14 chain, turn, miss 6, 7 sc down the stem, work 1 chain to cross it, and on the other side, $2 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 2$ Slst, then $10 \mathbf{s c}$ in the round loop, turn back; ( 5 chain, miss 1 , and $1 \mathbf{s c}, 5$ times), turn back; (miss $1,1 \mathbf{s c}$, and 3 dc in the 5 chain, join it to the $6^{\text {th }}$ stitch of the 14 SC worked down the centre stem, then 2 dc and 1 sc in the same 5 chain), (miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ and 3 dc in the next 5 chain, join it to the $7^{\text {th }}$ tc stitch of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ division of the Leaf, then 2 dc and 1 sc in the same 5 chain), (miss 1, 1 sc, 5 dc and 1 sc in the 5 chain 3 times), and down the calyx, 2 Slst, 3 dc, $2 \mathbf{s c}$, and 1 Slst on the stem; then 14 sc down the centre stem; and for the
$2^{\text {nd }}$ Leaf - 10 chain, turn, miss 4, 1 Slst, turn back; (7 chain and 1 SC 3 times in the round loop), turn back; (miss 1, 1 $\mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and 3 tc in the 7 chain, join it to the $6^{\text {th }}$ stitch of the 14 sc worked down the centre stem; and in the same 7 chain, $6 \mathrm{tc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc ), then miss 1 , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and 3 tc in the next 7 chain, join it to the centre of the last 5 dc of the Flower, and in the same $7 \mathrm{chain}, 6 \mathrm{tc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc ), (miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}, 9 \mathrm{tc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc in the 7 chain); then 5 SIst down the stem; repeat from **, until the length is worked, and to form the INSERTION between the Stripes, work 14 SIst up the calyx and side of the first Flower worked; then work and along the edge of the Flowers and Leaves to form the foundation for the $1^{\text {st }}$ side of the insertion, thus:-
$1^{\text {st }}$ row - 4 chain, miss 6,1 SC on the centre of the $2^{\text {nd }} 5 \mathrm{dc}$ of the Flower *, 6 chain, miss 6, 1 SC on the centre of the $3^{\text {rd }} 5 \mathrm{dc}$ of the Flower, 5 chain, miss 8,1 sc on the $7^{\text {th }}$ tc stitch of the $1^{\text {st }}$ division of the Leaf, 6 chain, miss $7,1 \mathrm{sc}$ on the $2^{\text {nd }}$ division of the Leaf, 5 chain, miss 3,1 sc on the $2^{\text {nd }}$ division of the Leaf, 5 chain, miss 8,1 sc on the centre of the $2^{\text {nd }} 5 \mathrm{dc}$ of the next Flower; repeat from *, end with 6 chain, miss $6,1 \mathrm{sc}$ on the $3{ }^{\text {rd }}$ division of the Flower. Cut off the thread at the end of each row, and commence at the other end.
$2^{\text {nd }}-1 \mathrm{dc}$ on the $1^{\text {st }}$ chain stitch of the $1^{\text {st }}$ row *, 1 chain, miss $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$, repeat from *.
$3^{\text {rd }}-1 \mathrm{Sc}$ in the $1^{\text {st }}$ chain stitch, ${ }^{*}, 1$ chain, miss 3 , ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, 3$ chain, 2 dc , these 4 dc in the 1 chain of the last row), 1 chain, miss $3,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 1 chain; repeat from *.
$4^{\text {th }}$ - miss $1,1 \mathrm{Sc}$ in the 1 chain, 2 chain, miss 2, ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, 3$ chain, 2 dc in the 3 chain of the last row), 2 chain, miss 2 , 1 sc in the 1 chain, repeat and fasten off the ends. This finishes the $1^{\text {st }}$ Stripe.

The edging not being required on both sides of the first and last Stripes.

## Second Stripe

Work the same as the $1^{\text {st }}$ Stripe, and
For the Edging on the other side - Commence by working $1 \mathbf{s c}$ in the $5^{\text {th }}$ tc stitch of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ division of the first Leaf of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ side
$1^{\text {st }}$ row - 5 chain, miss 3,1 SC on the $2^{\text {nd }}$ division of the Leaf, 6 chain, miss 7,1 SC on the $3^{\text {rrd }}$ division of the Leaf, 5 chain, miss $8,1 \mathrm{sc}$ on the centre of the $3^{\text {rd }} 5 \mathrm{dc}$ of the Flower, 6 chain, miss $6,1 \mathrm{sc}$ on the centre of the $4^{\text {th }} 5 \mathrm{dc}$ of
the Flower, 5 chain, miss 8 , 1 sc on the Leaf, repeat, end with 5 chain, miss $3,1 \mathbf{s c}, 4$ chain, miss $7,1 \mathbf{s c}$. Cut off the thread and commence as before.
$2^{\text {nd }}-1 \mathrm{dc}$ on the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{sc}$ stitch *, 1 chain, miss $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$; repeat from *.
$3^{\text {rd }}-1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the $1^{\text {st }}$ chain stitch, ${ }^{*}, 1$ chain, miss 3 , ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, 3$ chain, 2 dc , these 4 dc in the 1 chain of the last row), 1 chain, miss $3,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 1 chain; repeat from *.
$4^{\text {th }}$ - In this row, the 2 Stripes worked are joined together, thus: - miss $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 1 chain, 2 chain, miss 2, ( 2 dc in the 3 chain, 1 chain, join it to the centre of the last 3 chain of the edging of the first Stripe worked; then 1 chain and 2 dc in the same 3 chain of the $2^{\text {nd }}$ Stripe as before), 2 chain, miss 2,1 sc in the 1 chain, repeat, joining to the opposite point each time. Fasten off. Continue working the $2^{\text {nd }}$ Stripe until sufficient width is made.

## Border for the Top

Commence by working 1 sc in the top of the centre stem of the last Stripe worked.
$1^{\text {st }}$ row - 5 chain, miss $7,1 \mathrm{SC}$ in the $7^{\text {th }}$ tc stitch of the $1^{\text {st }}$ division of the leaf, 7 chain, miss $8,1 \mathrm{SC}$ on the $2^{\text {nd }}$ division of the leaf, 5 chain, 1 sc in the side of the $3{ }^{\text {rd }}$ row of the edging between the Stripes; 13 chain, 1 sc in the side of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ row of the other side of the edging; 7 chain, 1 sc on the $3^{\text {rd }} 5 \mathrm{dc}$ of the Flower; 5 chain, miss 6,1 sc on the $4^{\text {th }} 5$ dc of the Flower, 7 chain, miss 8,1 sc on the centre stem of the next Stripe; repeat to the centre stem of the $1^{\text {st }}$ Stripe. Cut off the thread.
$2^{\text {nd }}$ - Commence on the 1 sC worked at the beginning of the $1^{\text {st }}$ row, 10 chain and work a Leaf the same as the Leaf in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ side of the stripe: when finished work 3 Sc on the $1^{\text {st }}$ row, ${ }^{*}$, and for the Flower, 15 chain, and work a Flower the same as the $2^{\text {nd }}$ Flower in the $1^{\text {st }}$ side of the Stripe: when finished work 9 SC on the $1^{\text {st }}$ row; join it to the last 5 dc of the Flower; then 5 sc on the $1^{\text {st }}$ row, and for the $2^{\text {nd }}$ LEAF 10 chain, and work as the Leaf on the $1^{\text {st }}$ side of the stripe: when finished work 9 sc on the $1^{\text {st }}$ row, join it to the $7^{\text {th }}$ tc stitch of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ division of the Leaf, then 5 sc on the $1^{\text {st }}$ row: repeat from *, but end with 1 SC instead of 5 on the $1^{\text {st }}$ row; then 15 chain, and work a Flower the same, joining the last division to the third tc stitch of the Leaf at the side before finishing it. Fasten off.

## Border for the Bottom

$1^{\text {st }}$ - Commence by working 1 sc on the end of the centre stem of the $1^{\text {st }}$ Stripe; 5 chain, miss 6,1 sc on the $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$ stitch of the calyx of the $1^{\text {st }}$ Flower, 7 chain, miss 9,1 sc on the centre of the $1^{\text {st }} 5 \mathrm{dc}$ of the Flower, 5 chain, 1 sc in the side of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ row of the edging, 13 chain, 1 sc in the side of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ row of the other side of the edging, 7 chain, 1 sc on the centre of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ division of the Leaf, 5 chain, miss 5,1 SC on the same division of the Leaf, 7 chain, miss 7,1 sc on the centre stem; repeat to the centre stem of the last Stripe. Cut off the thread.
$2^{\text {nd }}$ - Commence on the 1 sc worked at the beginning of the $1^{\text {st }}$ row; then 15 chain, and work a Flower the same as the $2^{\text {nd }}$ Flower in the $1^{\text {st }}$ side of the Stripe, joining it to the centre of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ division of the Leaf at the side: when
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finished, work 3 sc on the $1^{\text {st }}$ row, and for the Leaf, 10 chain, and work a Leaf the same as in the $1^{\text {st }}$ side of the Stripe, joining it to the centre of the last 5 dc of the Flower, *; when finished, work 9 sc on the $1^{\text {st }}$ row, join to the $7^{7^{\text {th }}}$ tc stitch of the $3^{\text {rd }}$ division of the Leaf; then 5 SC on the $1^{\text {st }}$ row; and for the FLOWER, 15 chain: work as the $2^{\text {nd }}$ Flower in the $1^{\text {st }}$ side of the Stripe; when finished work 9 sc on the $1^{\text {st }}$ row, join it to the centre of the last 5 dc of the Flower, then 5 SC on the 1st row; and for the next LEAF, 10 chain; and work the Leaf in the $1^{\text {st }}$ side of the Stripe; repeat from *, but before working the last Leaf, work $2 \mathbf{S C}$ ) instead of 5 on the $1^{\text {st }}$ row, and in working the Leaf, join the centre of the last division to the $1^{\text {st }} 5 \mathrm{dc}$ of the Flower at the side. Fasten off.

## Anti-Macassar, or Toilet Cover

Materials - Walter Evans \& Co.'s Boar's-head Crochet Cotton No. 12, and Walker's Uncotopic Penelope Needle No. $21 / 2$ (steel crochet hook sz 7 )

Make a chain of 415 stitches for $3 / 4$ of a yard, or 23 stitches for each pattern: the thread is cut off at the end of each row. - See $2^{\text {nd }}$ Series.
$1^{\text {st }}$ row $-1 \mathrm{dc},{ }^{*}, 5$ chain, miss $5,4 \mathrm{dc}, 4$ chain, miss $4,4 \mathrm{dc}, 5$ chain, miss $5,1 \mathrm{dc}$ : repeat from * to the end.
$2^{\text {nd }}-4 \mathrm{dc}$, *, 3 chain, miss $3,2 \mathrm{dc}, 2$ chain, miss $2,2 \mathrm{dc}, 2$ chain, miss $2,2 \mathrm{dc}, 3$ chain, miss $3,7 \mathrm{dc}$ : repeat from *, end with 4 dc instead of 7 dc .
$3^{\text {rd }}-1 \mathrm{dc},{ }^{*}, 2$ chain, miss $2,3 \mathrm{dc}, 4$ chain, miss $4,4 \mathrm{dc}, 4$ chain, miss $4,3 \mathrm{dc}, 2$ chain, miss $2,1 \mathrm{dc}$ : repeat from *.
$4^{\text {th }}-2 \mathrm{dc}$, *, 2 chain, miss $2,4 \mathrm{dc}, 3$ chain, miss $3,2 \mathrm{dc}, 3$ chain, miss $3,4 \mathrm{dc}, 2$ chain, miss $2,3 \mathrm{dc}$ : repeat from *, end with 2 dc instead of 3 dc .
$5^{\text {th }}-3 \mathrm{dc},{ }^{*}, 2$ chain, miss $2,4 \mathrm{dc}, 6$ chain, miss $6,4 \mathrm{dc}, 2$ chain, miss $2,5 \mathrm{dc}$ : repeat from *, end with 3 dc instead of 5 dc .
$6^{\text {th }}-$ Same as the $4^{\text {th }}$ row $-7^{\text {th }}$ row, same as the $3^{\text {rd }}$ row $-8^{\text {th }}$ row, same as the $2^{\text {nd }}$ row: this finished one pattern. Repeat, and work 24 patterns for the Anti-macassar, or one yard; and to make the last pattern perfect, repeat as the $1^{\text {st }}$ row, and without cutting off the thread commence

## The Edging

$1^{\text {st }}$ round - Work a sc row down the side, working 3 stitches on the side of every dc stitch; then work along the foundation chain, thus - ( $2 \mathbf{s c}$ in 1 stitch, and $22 \mathbf{s c}$ : repeat to the other corner), and work asc row up the other side, working 3 stitches to every dc stitch as before; and along the last side, work 2 stitches in one and 22 sc .

## Repeat.

$2^{\text {nd }}$ - To form the corner - 1 chain, 5 tc in 1 stitch, 1 chain, 1 SIst, *, 1 chain, miss 2,5 tc in 1 stitch, 1 chain, miss 2, 1 Slst; repeat from * down the $1^{\text {st }}$ side, then work the corner, and repeat as before along the $2^{\text {nd }}, 3^{\text {rd }}$, and $4^{\text {th }}$ sides, working the corner at the beginning of each side: at the end, work 3 Slst on the $1^{\text {st }} 3$ stitches of the round.

[^11]$3^{\text {rd }}$ - For the corner - (9 chain, turn, 1 SIst in the $1^{\text {st }}$ stitch of the 9 chain to form a round loop, 5 times), miss 1,1 sc on the $5 \mathrm{tc}, 5$ chain, miss $6,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the centre of the 5 tc , *, 5 chain, miss $7,1 \mathrm{sc}$, $\left(9\right.$ chain, turn, 1 SIst in the $1^{\text {st }}$ stitch of the 9 chain to form a round loop, 5 times), miss $7,1 \mathrm{sc}, 5$ chain, miss $7,1 \mathrm{sc}, 5$ chain, miss $7,1 \mathrm{sc}$; repeat from * down the side, then work the corner. Repeat as before along the other sides, working the corners at the end of each side; at the end, turn back and work 3 Slst on the last 5 chain, turn back.
$4^{\text {th }}$ - For the corner - ( 9 chain, turn, 1 SIst in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ stitch of the 9 chain to form a round loop; 1 chain, miss 9,1 sc in the round loop of the last round; repeat 5 times), 9 chain, 1 Slst in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ stitch as before, 1 chain, miss $9,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 5 chain, *, 3 chain, miss 5,1 sc in the 5 chain, ( 9 chain, turn, 1 Slst in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ stitch as before, 1 chain, miss 9,1 sc in the round loop of the last round, 5 times), 9 chain, turn, 1 SIst in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ stitch as before, 1 chain, miss 9,1 sc in the 5 chain, 3 chain, miss 5,1 sc in the 5 chain; repeat from * along the sides, working the corners as before.
$5^{\text {th }}$ - For the corner - (miss $3,1 \mathrm{sc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc ; these 7 stitches in the round loop of last round, 6 times), ${ }^{*}$, miss 3,1 sc in the 3 chain, (miss $3,1 \mathrm{sc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc in the round loop, 6 times), miss $3,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 3 chain; repeat from * along the sides, working the corners as before. Fasten off.

## To Work the Anti-Macassar in Colours

## The Diamond or Star Pattern

This can be worked in two colours that contrast well, by making the Star with one colour, and the Diamonds with another.

## The Flower Pattern

Work Stripes of Flowers and Leaves in Pink, and the Insertion White or Drab, or in any two colours that contrast.
