2nd - ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 11 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$; both these sc sts are to be worked in the 11 ch of the 1 st round), 3 ch, sk 10: repeat, end 1 sl st.

3rd-11 sc, 3 ch, sk 5: repeat, and end with $1 \mathrm{~s} \mid$ st.
4th - 14 ch, sk $13,1 \mathrm{sc}$, in the 3 ch of last round: repeat.
5th - sk $1,7 \mathrm{sc}, 5 \mathrm{ch}, 7 \mathrm{sc}$ : repeat, end with $6 \mathrm{~s} \mid \mathrm{st}$.
6th - 7 sc, 9 ch, sk 12: repeat, and end with 3 s| st

7th - ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 9 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ both these sc sts in the centre st of the 7 sc in 6 th round), 7 ch , sk 7 , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 9 \mathrm{ch}$ : both these sc sts in the centre st of the 9 ch in 6 th round), $7 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 7$; repeat, end with 2 sl st.

8th - ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 7 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 9 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 7 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$; these 4 sc sts are worked in the 9 ch of the 7 th round); 5 ch , sk $4,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the centre of the 7 ch in 7 th round, 5 ch , sk 4 ; repeat, and end with 1 sl st.

9th - 7 sc, sk 1,9 sc, sk 1,7 sc, 3 ch, sk 13: repeat, and end with 4 sl st.
10th - 13 ch, sk $15,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{ch}$, sk 9 , 1 sc : repeat, at the end turn back, work 2 sl st on the last 3 ch ; turn back.

11th - 6 ch, 9 sc, 7 ch, 9 sc: repeat.
12th - ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 11 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 13 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 11 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ : these 4 sc in the 6 ch of 11 th round); 3 ch, sk $9,5 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 7 ch of the 11th round, $3 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 9$ : repeat, and end with 1 sl st.

13th - 9 sc , sk $3,11 \mathrm{sc}$, sk $3,9 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 7,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the centre of the $5 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{ch}$, sk 7 ; end 1 sl st: repeat, and fasten off.

## D'OYLEY No. 1 - in colours

Amber and dark green - commence with the amber, and work the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd rounds - green, 4th, 5th, and 6th rounds - amber, 7th, 8th, and 9th rounds - green, 10th and 11th rounds - amber 12th and 13th rounds.

## D'OYLEY No. 2



Ch of 8 sts, join with sl st.
1st round - 7 ch , and 1 sc 8 times in the foundation ch, then 3 sl st upon the last 7 ch .
2nd - ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 5 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ : both these sc in the 7 ch of 1 st round), 1 ch , sk 6: repeat 7 times, end with 1 sl st.

3rd - 1 ch, sk $1,5 \mathrm{dc}$ in the 5 ch of 2 nd round, $1 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 1 ch of 2 nd round repeat, end with $3 \mathrm{~s} \mid \mathrm{st}$.

4th - ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 6 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ : both these sc in the centre of the 5 dc in 3rd round), 5 ch , sk 7: repeat, end with $3 \mathrm{~s} \mid$ st.

5th - ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 7 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ : both sc in the 6 ch of the 4 th round), $3 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 5,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 5 ch of the 4th round, 3 ch , sk 5, repeat, and end with $2 \mathrm{~s} \mid$ st.

6th -1 sc in the $7 \mathrm{ch},(5 \mathrm{ch}$, and 1 sc in the same 7 ch 5 times), 5 ch , sk 9; repeat, and end with 1 sl st; turn back, and work 3 sl st on the last 5 ch , turn back.

7th $-6 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 5 ch of 6th round; repeat all around, end with 2 sl st on the 1st 6 ch.

8th -8 sl st, $5 \mathrm{ch}, 8 \mathrm{sl} \mathrm{st}$, ( 7 ch , put the needle into the 2 nd st of these 7 ch , and work a sc in it to form a round loop), 1 sc , sk 5: repeat, and end with $3 \mathrm{~s} \mid$ st.

9th -3 ch , sk 5, ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 7 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ : both these sc in the round loop of the 8th round), 3 ch , sk $5,1 \mathrm{sc}$, in the centre of the 8 sl st , repeat, and end with 3 sl st.

10th $-1 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 2,7 \mathrm{dc}$ in the 7 ch of the 9 th round, $1 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 2,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the $3 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{ch}$, sk $3,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 3 ch ; repeat, and end with 6 sl st.

11th - 13 ch , put the needle into the 4th st and work a sc in it to form a round loop, 3 ch , sk 9 , 3 sl st: repeat, and end with 3 sl st more.

12th -1 sc in the round loop, ( 5 ch , and 1 sc 5 times in the same round loop), 5 ch , sk 11 , repeat, end 1 sl st; turn back, work 3 sl st in the last 5 ch , turn back.

13th - same as 7 th.
14th - same as 8th, working sc instead of sl st.
15th -1 ch, sk 4 ( 1 sc, 5 ch, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 7 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 9 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 7 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 5 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ : these 6 sc are all to be worked in the 5 ch of 14th round), 1 ch , sk 4,1 sc: repeat, and work 1 sc . Fasten off.

D'OYLEY No 2 - in colours
Pink and Slate - commence with the pink, and work the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd rounds - slate, 4th, 5th, and 6th rounds - pink, 7th, 8th, 9th, and 10th rounds - slate, 11th and 12th rounds - pink, 13th, 14th, and 15th rounds.

## D'OYLEY No. 3



Ch 8, join with sl st.
1st round - 5 ch and $2 \mathrm{sc}, 6$ times in the foundation ch.

2nd - 2 ch, sk 1, (2 dc, 3 ch, and 2 dc, these 4 dc in the 5 ch sp ), 2 ch , sk 1,1 sl st between the 2 sc of the 1st round; repeat.

3rd - 3 ch, sk 4, (2 dc in the 3 ch, 5 ch, turn, sk 4 , 1 sl st in the 5 th ch st, 2 dc in the same 3 ch as before), 3 ch , sk 4 , 1 sl st on the 1 sl st of last round; repeat, end with 5 sl st.

4th - 7 sc in the round loop, and for the 1st flower, 15 ch , turn, sk $7,1 \mathrm{sl}$ st, in the 8th st to form a round loop, turn, and leaving 7 ch for the stem, work 1 ch to cross it, 1 sc in
the round loop, 6 ch, join it to the 4th st of the 7 sc worked in the round loop of the 3rd round; turn, and on the 6 ch , sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{sl}$ st, 1 sc in the round loop, (then 6 ch , turn, sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{sl} \mathrm{st}$, and 1 sc in the round loop 5 times), and to form the 7 th division of the flower, work $1 \mathrm{sl} \mathrm{st}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sl st down the stem, leaving $2 \mathrm{ch},{ }^{*}$, then 2 ch , sk 11 sts of the 3rd round, 3 sc in the round loop, join it to the point of the 6th division of the flower, then 4 sc in the same round loop.

For the 2nd flower-15 ch, turn, 1 sl st in the 8 th st, 1 ch to cross the stem, 1 sc in the round loop, 6 ch , join it to the 4th st of the 7 tr sc, worked in the last round loop; turn, sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{sl}$ st, 1 sc in the round loop, 6 ch , join it to the point of the 5th division of the 1 st flower, turn, sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{sl}$ st, 1 sc in the round loop, (then 6 ch , turn, sk 1, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{slst}$, and 1 sc in the round loop, 4 times), and for the 7 th division of the flower, work 1 sl st, 3 dc , and 1 sl st down the stem, leaving 2 ch , repeat from *, 6 times more, then 2 ch , sk 11, 3 sl st on the 1st 7 sc of the round, join it to the 6th division of the 8th flower; then 11 sl st up the sides of the 2 first divisions of he 1 st flower and join it to the 5th division of the 8th flower.

5th - 6 ch, sk 11, 1 sc in the point of the 3rd division of the 1st flower; 6 ch, sk 11, 1 sc in the point of the 4th division of the flower; $6 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 11,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the point of the 5th division of the flower; repeat, end 4 sl st.

6th - 17 sc , and for the 1 st leaf -16 ch, turn, sk $4,1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{ch}$, sk $2,1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 2,1 \mathrm{sc}$, 1 ch to cross the stem; and on the other side, sk 1, 1 sc and 2 dc in the 2 ch, join it to the 12th st of the 17 sc , then 1 dc and 1 sc in the same 2 ch of the leaf as before; then (sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc in the 2 ch ), sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ and 2 dc in the 4 ch ; and before finishing this leaf, work 13 ch for the

1st flower - turn, sk $7,1 \mathrm{sl}$ st in the 8th st, turn, 1 ch to cross the stem; 1 sc in the round loop, ( 6 ch , turn, sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{sl}$ st in the 6 ch and 1 sc in the round loop 6 times), then to form the 7th division, work 1 sl st, 3 dc and 1 sl st down the stem; and to finish the leaf, work 1 dc and 1 sc in the same 4 ch as before, (sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc in the 2 ch twice) then 2 sl st down the stem, and for the -

2nd flower-15 ch, turn, sk 7, 1 sl st in the 8th st, 1 ch to cross the stem, 1 sc in the round loop, 6 ch , join if to the centre dc of the 1 st leaf, turn, sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{sl}$ st, 1 sc in the round loop, 6 ch , join it to the 6th division of the 1 st flower, turn, sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1$ $\mathrm{slst}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the round loop, ( 6 ch , turn, sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{sl}$ st, and 1 sc in the round loop 4 times), and down the stem 1 sl st, $3 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{sl}$ st; and 1 sc on the stem of the 1st leaf.

2nd Leaf - 13 ch, turn, sk $4,1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 2,1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 2,1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}$ to cross the stem, and on the other side sk 1 , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc in the 2 ch ), sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ and 2 dc in the next 2 ch , join it to the point of the 6th division of the $2 n d$ flower, 1 dc , and 1 sc in the same 2 ch , sk 1, ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc in the 4 ch ), turn, and down the other side, (sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc in the 2 ch , twice), 2 sl st down the stem, and 2 sc down the stem
of the 1st leaf; then 4 sc on the 5th round, join it to the centre of the last division of the 2nd leaf,**, 17 sc on the 5th round; and for the -

3nd Leaf - 16 ch, turn, sk $4,1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 2,1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 2,1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}$ to cross the stem, and on the other side, sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ and 2 dc in the 2 ch , join it to the 12th st of the 17 sc , then 1 dc and 1 sc in the same 2 ch of the leaf as before; then (sk 1, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 3$ dc and 1 sc in the 2 ch ), sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ and 2 dc in the 4 ch ; join it to the point of the 2 nd leaf, and before finishing this leaf, work 13 ch for the -

3rd Flower - turn, 1 sl st in the 8th st, 1 ch to cross the stem, 1 sc in the round loop, 6 ch, join it to the point of the 5th division of the 2nd flower, turn, sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{sl}$ st, 1 sc in the round loop, (then 6 ch , turn, sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{sl}$ st, and 1 sc in the round loop 5 times), and for the 7th division of the flower, work 1 sl st, 3 dc , and 1 sl st down the stem; and to finish the leaf, work 1 dc and 1 sc in the same 4 ch as before; (sk 1, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 3$ dc, and 1 sc in the 2 ch twice), then 2 sl st down the stem, and for the -

4th flower - 15 ch, turn, sk $7,1 \mathrm{sl}$ st in the 8 th st, 1 ch to cross the stem, 1 sc in the round loop, 6 ch , join it to the centre dc of the 3rd leaf, turn, sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{sl}$ st, 1 sc in the round loop, 6 ch , join it to the 6th division of the 3rd flower, turn, sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1$ $\mathrm{sl} \mathrm{st}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the round loop, ( 6 ch , turn, sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{sl} \mathrm{st}$, and 1 sc in the round loop 4 times), and down the stem, $1 \mathrm{slst}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{sl} \mathrm{st}$, and 1 sc on the stem of the 3rd leaf.

4rd Leaf - 13 ch, turn, sk $4,1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{ch}$, sk $2,1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 2,1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}$ to cross the stem, and on the other side, sk 1 , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc in the 2 ch ), sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$, in the 2 ch , join it to the point of the 6th division of the 4th flower, 1 dc and 1 so in the same 2 ch , sk 1 , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc in the 4 ch ), turn, (sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc in the 2 ch twice), 2 sl st down the stem, and 2 sc down the stem of the 3rd leaf; then 4 sc on the 5th round, join it to the centre of the last division of the 4th leaf; repeat from **, and when the round is finished, work 11 sl st up the side of the last leaf; join it to the point of the 1 st leaf, then 12 sl st up the 1 st flower, joining it to the 5th division of the last fower. Fasten off.

## D'OYLEY No. 3 - in colours

Pink and Green - Commence with the green, and work 1st, 2nd, and 3rd rounds - pink, 4th round - green, 5th round. Pink and Green are used in the 6th round thus: work the sc sts and half of the 1st leaf with the green, carrying the pink under it. Work the 1st flower with pink, finish the leaf with green, carrying the pink under it. Work the 2nd flower with pink; leave it, and work the 2rd leaf with green; and then the sc sts on the 5 th round with green, carrying the pink under, repeat.

## D'OYLEY No. 4



Ch of 8 sts, join with sl st.
1st round - 13 ch and $1 \mathrm{sc}, 7$ times in the foundation ch, end 1 sl st on the 1 sr 13 ch .

2nd - 11 sc, sk 3; repeat, end with 6 sl st on the 1st 11 sc.
3rd- 8 ch, sk 9, 2 sc; repeat.
4th- 3 sc, and 2 sc in the 4th st: repeat, and end with 1 s| st.
5th $-5 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 2,3 \mathrm{sc}$; repeat and end with 3 sl st on the 1 st 5 ch .

6th - 6 ch, sk 6, 2 sc; repeat.
7th - 3 ch, sk 1, 1 sc; repeat.
8th - 6 ch, sk $7,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 3 ch ; repeat.
9th -3 ch, sk 5, ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, 4 \mathrm{ch}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$; these 4 dc are all to be worked in the 6 ch of the last round) in the 6 ch ; repeat.

10th -3 ch, sk 5, ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, 4 \mathrm{ch}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$; these 4 dc are to be worked in the 4 ch of the 9th round), 3 the 1 sc of the last round; repeat.

11th - same as 10th round, and at the end work 5 sl st
12th - ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 5 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ : both these sc sts in the 4 ch of the last round), 7 ch , sk 11, repeat, end 1 sl st, turn back and work 3 sl st on the last 7 ch , turn back.

13th - 2 ch, sk 4,1 dc in the 5 ch, ( 4 ch and 1 dc 4 times in the same 5 ch of the last round), 2 ch , sk 4 , 1 sc in the 7 ch of last round; repeat.

14th -1 ch, sk $3,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 2 ch , (sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc in the 4 ch 4 times), sk 1 , 1 sc in the 2 ch ; repeat, and fasten off.

## D'OYLEY No. 4 - in colours.

Blue and White - Commence with the blue, and work the 1st and 2nd rounds, then with white, work the 3rd and 4th rounds - blue 5th, 6th, and 7th rounds - white, 8th, 9th, 10, 11th rounds - blue 12th, 13th, and 14th rounds.

D'OYLEY No. 5


Ch 8 sts, join with sl st.
1st round $-6 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the foundation ch, 10 ch , turn, sk $5,5 \mathrm{sc}$ on the $10 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the foundation ch; repeat 7 times more, turn back; work 5 sl st up the last 5 sc , turn back.

2nd - 3 ch, sk 18, 1 sc in the round loop of the 1st round, ( 5 ch and 1 sc 5 times in the same round loop); repeat, and end with 2 sl st on the 1 st 3 ch .

3rd - 13 ch, sk 32,1 sc in the 3 ch ; repeat, end with 2 sl st.

4th - 11 sc on the 13 ch, 9 ch, turn, sk 5,4 sc on the 9 ch , sk 3 ; repeat, end with 5 sl st.
5th -1 sc in the centre st of the 11 sc , and for the 1 st Leaf, 11 ch , turn, sk $1,1 \mathrm{sl} \mathrm{st}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$, $4 \mathrm{dc}, 1$ Slst.

2nd Leaf - 8 ch, turn, sk 1, 1 sl st, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{sl}$ st.
3rd Leaf - 8 ch , turn, sk $1,1 \mathrm{sl}$ st, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{sl} \mathrm{st}, 3 \mathrm{sl}$ st down the stem, and 1 sc in the same centre st of the 11 sc of the 4th round as before, and for the Flower - 3 ch , sk 9,1 sc in the round loop, ( 5 ch and 1 sc 5 times in the same round loop), 3 ch, sk 9; repeat, end with 11 sl st up the stem and 1st leaf to the point.

6th -7 ch, sk $14,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the point of the 2 nd leaf; $7 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 14,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the point of the 3 rd leaf; 3 ch, sk 29, 1 sc in the centre 5 ch of the flower; 3 ch, sk 29, 1 sc in the point of the next leaf; repeat, end with 6 sl st.

7th - $14 \mathrm{sc}, 12 \mathrm{ch}$, and for the 1st Leaf, turn, sk 4,1 sl st in the 5 th st, turn back; ( 5 ch and 1 sc 3 times in the round loop), turn back; 1 sc in the 5 ch , ( 4 ch and 1 sc twice in the same $5 \mathrm{ch}, 2 \mathrm{ch}$, join it to the 5 th st of the $14 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the same $5 \mathrm{ch}, 4 \mathrm{ch}$ and 1 sc twice in the same 5 ch ), sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next 5 ch , ( 4 ch and 1 sc 5 times in the same 5 ch ), sk 1 , 1 sc in the next 5 ch , ( 4 ch and 1 sc 5 times in the same 5 ch ), 4 sl st down the stem - this finishes the leaf.

And for the 2nd Leaf, 9 ch and work as the 1st leaf, joining it to the centre 5 ch of the 3rd division of the 1st leaf, * and for the -

3rd Leaf, 9 ch , and work as the 1st leaf, joining it to the centre 5 ch of the 3rd division of the 2 nd leaf, when finished, work 3 sc down the stem of the 1 st leaf and 10 sc on the 6 th round, join it to the centre 5 ch of the 3rd division of the 3rd leaf; then $14 \mathrm{sc}, 12 \mathrm{ch}$, and for the -

4th Leaf, turn, sk 4, 1 sl st in the 5th st, turn back; (5 ch and 1 sc 3 times in the round loop), turn back, 1 sc in the 5 ch , ( 4 ch and 1 sc twice in the same $5 \mathrm{ch}, 2 \mathrm{ch}$, join it to the 5th st of the $14 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the same 5 ch 4 ch and 1 sc twice in the same 5 ch), sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next 5 ch , ( 4 ch and 1 sc twice in the same $5 \mathrm{ch}, 2 \mathrm{ch}$, join it to the centre 5 ch of the 2 nd division of the 3rd leaf, $2 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{ch}$ and 1 sc twice in the same 5 ch ), then 4 sl st down the stem; and for the -

5th leaf - 9 ch, and work as the 2nd leaf, then repeat from *, and for the last leaf - 9 ch and work as the 4th leaf, joining it first to the centre 5 ch of the last leaf worked; and secondly to the centre 5 ch of the 1st leaf worked; when finished work 3 sc down the stem, and 10 sc on the 6th round, join it to the centre 5 ch of the 3rd division of the last leaf. Fasten off.

## D'OYLEY No. 5 - in colours

Ponceau and Gold - Commence with the ponceau, and work the 1st and 2nd rounds gold, the 3rd and 4th rounds - ponceau, 5th round - gold, 6th and 7th rounds.

## D'OYLEY No. 6



Ch 8, join with sl st.
1st round -12 ch, turn, sk 5,2 sl st, and 5 dc on the $12 \mathrm{ch}, 1$ so in the foundation ch; repeat 7 times more, end with 7 sl st up the 1 st 12 ch .

2nd-1 sc in the round loop of the 1st round (ch 5 and 1 sc 3 times in the same round loop as before), 3 ch sk 15; repeat end 1 sl st.

3rd - 9 ch, tum, sk 1,1 sl st, 1 sc, 1 dc and 2 tr in the $9 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{ch}$, sk 19, 1 sc in the 3 ch of the 2 nd round, 8 ch , turn, sk $5,1 \mathrm{sl} \mathrm{st}$ in the $6 \mathrm{th} \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the same 3 ch of the 2nd round; repeat, end with 9 sl st up the 1st 9 ch.

4th - 5 Ch, sk 13, 1 sc in the round loop of the 3rd round, and for the 3 small leaves, (5 ch, turn, sk $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sl st on the $5 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the same round loop as before, repeat twice more); then $5 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 13,1 \mathrm{sl}$ st in the ch at the point of the star in the 3rd round; repeat.

5th - 8 ch , sk $17,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 2 ch at the top of the 2 nd small leaf in the 3rd round; 8 ch , sk $17,1 \mathrm{sl}$ st on the 1 sl st at the point of the star in last round; repeat, end 4 sl st on the 1st 8 ch .

6th - 14 sc , and for the 1st Flower, 11 ch , turn, sk $4,1 \mathrm{sl}$ st in the 5th st, turn, 1 ch to cross the stem, 2 ch, join it to the 11th st of the 14 sc ; then $2 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the round loop, ( 5 ch and 1 sc 4 times in the same round loop), 3 sl st down the stem, and for the 2nd Flower, 9 ch , turn, sk $4,1 \mathrm{sl}$ st, 1 ch to cross the stem; 2 ch, join it to the last 5 ch of the 1 st Flower, $2 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the round loop, ( 5 ch and 1 sc 4 times in the same round loop), 4 sl st down the stem, and 1 sl st down the stem of the 1st Flower; and for the 3rd Flower, 8 ch , turn, sk $4,1 \mathrm{slst}, 1 \mathrm{ch}$ to cross the stem, 2 ch , join it to the last 5 ch of the 2nd Flower, $2 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the round loop, (5 ch and 1 sc 4 times in the round loop), 3 sl st down the stem, and 2 sl st down the stem of the 1st Flower; then sk 1, and work 3 sc on the 5th round, join it to the last 5 ch of the 3rd Flower, repeat, at the end work 5 sl st on the 1 st 14 sc .

7th -5 ch, sk 15,1 sc in the centre 5 ch of the 1st Flower, 8 ch, sk 23,2 sc in the centre 5 ch of the 2nd Flower, 8 ch, sk 23, 1 sc in the centre 5 ch of the 3rd Flower, 5 ch, sk 15, 2 sc on the centre of the sc sts repeat, end 5 sl st on the 1 st 5 ch .

8th - 5 sc on the 7th round, and for the 1st Leaf, 10 ch , turn, sk 2, 4 dc , and 2 sl st on the 10 ch , leaving 2 ch for the stem, work 8 ch , (sk 2, 4 dc and 2 sl st on the 8 ch ), 8 ch , turn, (sk $2,4 \mathrm{dc}$ and 2 sl st on the 8 ch ); then 2 sl st down the stem, this finishes the leaf, * 6 sc on the 7th round, and for the 2nd Leaf - 9 ch ; join it to the point of the 3rd division of the last leaf, 1 ch , sk $1,4 \mathrm{dc}$ and 2 sl st, leaving 2 ch for the stem, ( 8 ch , turn, sk $2,4 \mathrm{dc}$ and 2 sl st twice), 2 sl st down the stem; then 6 sc on the 7 th round, and work the 3rd Leaf the same as the 2nd leaf; then 5 sc and 5 sl st on the 7 th round; and for the 4th Leaf, 9 ch , join it to the last st of the $5 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}$, turn, sk $1,4 \mathrm{dc}$, and 2 sl st on the 9 ch , and leaving 2 ch for the stem, work 7 ch , join it to the point of the 3rd division of the 3rd leaf, 1 ch, sk 1, $4 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{sl}$ st, 8 ch , turn, sk 2, 4 dc and 2 sl st; then 2 sl st down the stem, and 5 sl st on the 7th round; join it to the point of the last division of the 4th leaf, $5 \mathrm{sc}-5$ th Leaf same as the 2nd, joining it to the point of the 2nd division of the 4th leaf: repeat from *, and fasten off.

## D'OYLEY No. 6 - in colours

Gold colour and Dark Blue. Commence with the Gold colour, and work the 1st and 2nd rounds - Blue, 3rd and 4th rounds - Gold 5th and 6th rounds - Blue, 7th round - Gold, and Blue, 8th round, working the leaves with the Gold and the sc sts on the 7th round with the Blue, working the gold under them.

ANTI-MACASSAR, OR COUVRE-PIED. Diamond and Star Pattern


Ch 8, join with sl st.

## First Diamond

1st round - ( $1 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and $1 \mathrm{sc}, 4$ times, in the foundation ch).
2nd - 1 ch, sk 1, ( $3 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$. These 6 dc in the 3 ch of the last round), 1 ch , sk 1, 1 sc on the 1 sc of the last round: repeat 3 times more; then work 4 sl st.

3rd - (1 sc, $8 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 9 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}, 8 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$. These 4 sc sts in the 3 ch of the last round). Ch 3 , dc into beg ch 1 of round 3 and ignore the sk 4 on the beg of round 4 .

4th - Sk 4,8 dc and 1 sc in the 8 ch of the last round, sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 10 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc in the 9 ch of the last round), sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ and 8 dc in the 8 ch of the last round; sk $4,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 7 ch: repeat 3 times more, and fasten off neatly at the back, by running this end down to the end left at the beg, and knot them together.
All the Diamonds are worked in the same manner; the variations of the direction being caused by the joining of the pattern.

2nd Diamond - Beg by working a ch of 8 sts as before; and work the 1 rst 3 rounds of the pattern as in the 1st Diamond; then work the pattern as in the 4th round, repeating it only twice, and to finish this round, sk 4, 8 dc , and 1 sc in the 8 ch , sk 1 , ( 1 sc and 5 dc in the 9 ch ; then 3 ch , and join it to the centre of the 2 nd 10 dc of the 1st Diamond; turn, and work 3 sc on the 3 ch , then 1 sl st ) in the top of the last dc st; and to finish the Diamond - work 5 dc , and 1 sc in the same 9 ch as before); sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$, and 8 dc in the 8 ch, sk $4,1 \mathrm{sc}$, in the 7 ch . Fasten off, and repeat the 2nd Diamond pattern as many times as may be required, always joining it to the last Diamond pattern worked.

## Star Pattern

Ch 10, join with sl st
1st round - 16 sc in the foundation round.
2nd - 8 ch, turn, sk $5,1 \mathrm{sl}$ st in the 3 rd st of the 8 ch to form a round loop; then ch 2 , 2 sc on the 16 sc repeat 7 times more, and end with 2 sl st up the first 2 ch.

3rd - 7 sc in the round loop, 1 ch, sk 7; repeat 7 times more, and end with 1 sl st.
4th - 8 ch, sk 7,2 sc in the 1 ch of the last round; repeat 7 times more.
5th - (Sk 2, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}, 7 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc ; these 11 sts in the 8 ch of the last round, repeat 3 times more); then sk 2 , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and 4 tr in the next 8 ch ; join it to the centre of the 1 st 8 dc in the last Diamond Pattern worked; then $3 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc in the same 8 ch of the Star Pattern), sk 2, ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and 3 tr in the next 8 ch ; join it to the centre of the last 8 dc of the same Diamond pattern; then $4 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc in the same 8 ch ), sk 2, ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ and 4 tr in the next 8 ch ; join it to the centre of the 3 rd 8 dc of the next Diamond Pattern; then $3 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the same 8 ch ), sk 2 , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ and 3 tr in the next 8 ch; join it to the centre of the $2 n d 8 d c$ of the Diamond Pattern; then $4 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{dc}, 1$ sc in the same 8 ch ), and fasten off. Repeat the Star Pattern, always joining them between the Diamond Patterns.

## 2nd Stripe of Diamond Pattern.

1st Diamond - Work the first 3 rounds as in first Stripe, then work the pattern as in the 4th round repeating it only once, and to finish the round, sk $4,8 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc in the next 8 ch , sk 1, ( 1 sc and 5 dc , in the $9 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{ch}$, join it to the centre of the 1 st 10 dc of the
last Diamond of the first Stripe worked, turn, 3 sc on the 3 ch , and 1 sl st on the top of the last dc st, then 5 dc and 1 sc in the same 9 ch$)$, sk 1 , ( 1 sc , and 4 dc in the 8 ch , join it to the centre of the 4th division of the first Star; then 4 dc in the same 8 ch ), sk 4,1 sc in the 7 ch , sk 4, ( 4 dc in the 8 ch , join it to the centre of 3rd division of the Star pattern, 4 dc and 1 sc in the same 8 ch ), sk 1 , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 10 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc in the 9 ch$)$, sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ and 8 dc in the $8 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 4,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 7 ch . Fasten off.

2nd Diamond - Work the first 3 rounds as before
4th round - Sk $4,8 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc in the 8 ch , sk $1,(1 \mathrm{sc}, 10 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc in the 9 ch ), sk 1 , 1 sc , and 8 dc in the $8 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 4,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the $7 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 4,8 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc in the 8 ch , sk 1 , ( 1 sc and 5 dc in the $9 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{ch}$, join it to the centre of the last 10 dc in the 1st Diamond of this stripe, tuen, 3 sc on the $3 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sl} \mathrm{st}$ in the top of the last dc st , then 5 dc and 1 sc in the same 9 ch ), sk 1 , ( 1 sc and 4 dc ) in the 8 ch , join it to the centre of the 2 nd division of the Star; then 4 dc in the same 8 ch$)$, sk $4,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 7 ch , sk 4, ( 4 dc in the 8 ch , join it to the centre of the 1 st division of the Star, then 4 dc and 1 sc in the same 8 ch ), sk $1,(1 \mathrm{sc}$ and 5 dc in the $9 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{ch}$, join it to the top of the Diamond in the 1 st stripe, turn, 3 sc on the $3 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sl}$ st in the top of the dc st , then 5 dc and 1 sc in the same 9 $\mathrm{ch})$, sk 1 , ( 1 sc and 4 dc in the 8 ch , join it to the centre of the 4th division of the 2nd Star pattern, then 4 dc in the same 8 ch ), sk $4,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 7 ch sk 4 , ( 4 dc in the 8 ch , join it to the centre of the 3rd division of the Star, then 4 dc and 1 sc in the same 8 ch ), sk $1,(1 \mathrm{sc}, 10 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc in the 9 ch ), sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ and 8 dc in the $8 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 4,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 7 ch Fasten off. Repeat this 2nd Diamond until the Stripe is finished, and work alternately the Star and 2nd Diamond Stripe until sufficient is made. Finish with a tassel between each Diamond.


Ch 17, and for the calyx of the Flower, turn, sk 6, 7 sc down the stem; work 1 ch to cross it and on the other side, $2 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc} 2 \mathrm{sl}$ st, and -

For the Flower - 10 sc in the round loop, turn back; ( 5 ch , sk 1, and 1 sc 5 times on the 10 sc ), turn back; (sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$, these 7 sts are worked in the 5 ch: repeat 4 times more), then 2 sl st, 3 d , 2 sc down the calyx, and 1 sl st on the stem, leaving 3 ch for the centre stem; then 9 sc , join it to the centre of the last 5 dc of the Flower.

For the Leaf - *15 ch, turn, sk 4, 1 sl st in the 5th st, turn back; (7 ch, and 1 sc 3 times in the round loop), turn back; (sk 1, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ and 3 tr in the 7 ch , join it to the centre of the 4th 5 dc of the Flower, and in the same 7 ch of the leaf work $6 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc ), then (sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}, 9 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc in the 7 ch twice), 5 sl st down the stem, which finishes the Leaf, and leaving 5 ch for the centre stem, work 9 ch , join it to the 7th tr st of the 3rd division of the Leaf, and for the -

2nd Flower and Calyx - 19 ch, turn, sk 6, 7 sc, turn, work 1 ch to cross the stem, and on the other side, $2 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{sl}$ st, 10 sc in the round loop, turn back; ( 5 ch , sk 1, and 1 sc 5 times on the 10 sc ), turn back; sk 1 , ( 1 sc , and 3 dc in the 5 ch, join it to the 7 th tr st of the $2 n d$ division of the Leaf, and in the same 5 ch as before, work 2 dc and 1 sc ),
then, (sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc in the $5 \mathrm{ch}, 4$ times), and down the calyx, 2 sl st, $3 \mathrm{dc}, 2$ sc , and 1 sl st on the stem, leaving 5 ch for the centre stem; work 9 ch , join it to the centre of the last 5 dc of the Flower; repeat from * until the required length is made (with the Knitting Cotton, 15 patterns, or with the Crochet Thread, 18 patterns for one yard). To form the -

Second Side - Work 3 ch, turn, sk 1, 2 sc on the 3 ch, and 12 sc down the centre stem which will be 9 on the 9 ch , and 3 on the 5 ch .

1st Leaf - 10 ch, and work a Leaf as directed on the other side, but joining it to the 6th st of the 14 sc worked down the centre stem, **; then 14 sc down the centre stem, and for the -

Flower - 14 ch, turn, sk 6, 7 sc down the stem, work 1 ch to cross it, and on the other side, $2 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{sl}$ st, then 10 sc in the round loop, tum back; ( 5 ch , sk 1, and $1 \mathrm{sc}, 5$ times), turn back; (sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$, and 3 dc in the 5 ch , join it to the 6 th st of the 14 sc worked down the centre stem, then 2 dc and 1 sc in the same 5 ch ), (sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ and 3 dc in the next 5 ch , join it to the 7 th tr st of the $3^{\prime \prime}$ division of the Leaf, then 2 dc and 1 sc in the same 5 ch ), (sk 1, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc in the 5 ch 3 times), and down the calyx, 2 sl st, $3 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$, and 1 sl st on the stem; then 14 sc down the centre stem; and for the -

2nd Leaf - 10 ch, turn, sk 4, 1 sl st, tum back; ( 7 ch and 1 sc 3 times in the round loop), tum back; (sk 1, sc, 1 dc , and 3 tr in the 7 ch , join it to the 6 th st of the 14 sc worked down the centre stem; and in the same $7 \mathrm{ch}, 6 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc ), then sk 1 , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and 3 tr in the next 7 ch , join it to the centre of the last 5 dc of the Flower, and in the same $7 \mathrm{ch}, 6 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc ), (sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}, 9 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$, and 1 sc in the 7 ch ); then 5 sl st down the stem; repeat from **, until the length is worked, and to form the INSERTION between the Stripes, work 14 sl st up the calyx and side of the first Flower worked; then work along the edge of the Flowers and Leaves to form the foundation for the 1 st side of the insertion, thus:

1st row - 4 ch, sk 6,1 sc on the centre of the 2 nd 5 dc of the Flower *, $6 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 6,1 \mathrm{sc}$ on the centre of the 3 rd 5 dc of the Flower, 5 ch , sk 8 , 1 sc on the 7 th tr st of the 1 st division of the Leaf, 6 ch , sk 7, 1 sc on the 2 nd division of the Leaf, 5 ch , sk $3,1 \mathrm{sc}$ on the 2nd division of the Leaf, 5 ch , sk $8,1 \mathrm{sc}$ on the centre of the 2 nd 5 dc of the next Flower; repeat from *, end with 6 ch, sk 6,1 sc on the 3rd division of the Flower. Cut off the thread at the end of each row, and commence at the other end.

2nd - 1 dc on the 1 st ch st of the 1 st row *, 1 ch, sk 1, 1 dc, repeat from *.
3rd-1 sc in the $1 \mathrm{st} \mathrm{ch} \mathrm{st},{ }^{*}, 1 \mathrm{ch}$, sk 3, (2 dc, $3 \mathrm{ch}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$, these 4 dc in the 1 ch of the last row), 1 ch , sk 3, 1 sc in the 1 ch ; repeat from *

4th - sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the $1 \mathrm{ch}, 2 \mathrm{ch}$, sk 2 , ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{ch}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in the 3 ch of the last row), 2 ch , sk $2,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 1 ch , repeat and fasten off the ends. This finishes the 1st Stripe. The edging not being required on both sides of the first and last Stripes.

## Second Stripe

Work the same as the 1st Stripe, and -
For the Edging on the other side - Commence by working 1 sc in the 5th tr st of the 2nd division of the first Leaf of the 2nd side .

1st row - 5 ch, sk 3, 1 sc on the 2nd division of the Leaf, $6 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 7,1 \mathrm{sc}$ on the 3rd division of the Leaf, 5 chch, sk $8,1 \mathrm{sc}$ on the centre of the 3rd 5 dc of the Flower, 6 ch , sk 6, 1 sc on the centre of the 4th 5 dc of the Flower, $5 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 8,1 \mathrm{sc}$ on the Leaf, repeat, end with 5 ch , sk $3,1 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{ch}$, sk 7 , 1 sc . Cut off the thread and commence as before.

2nd - 1 dc on the 1 st sc st ${ }^{*}, 1 \mathrm{ch}$, sk $1,1 \mathrm{dc}$; repeat from *.
3rd - 1 sc in the 1 st ch st, ${ }^{*}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 3$, ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{ch}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$, these 4 dc in the 1 ch of the last row), 1 ch , sk $3,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 1 ch ; repeat from *.

4th - In this row, the 2 Stripes worked are joined together, thus - sk 1,1 sc in the $1 \mathrm{ch}, 2$ ch, sk 2, ( 2 dc in the $3 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{ch}$, join it to the centre of the last 3 ch of the edging of the first Stripe worked; then 1 ch and 2 dc in the same 3 ch of the 2nd Stripe as before), 2 ch, sk $2,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 1 ch , repeat, joining to the opposite point each time. Fasten off. Continue working the 2nd Stripe until sufficient width is made.

## Border for the Top

Commence by working 1 sc in the top of the centre stem of the last Stripe worked.
1st row - 5 ch , sk $7,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 7 th tr st of the 1st division of the leaf, 7 ch , sk $8,1 \mathrm{sc}$ on the 2nd division of the leaf, $5 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the side of the 3rd row of the edging between the Stripes; $13 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the side of the 3rd row of the other side of the edging; $7 \mathrm{ch}, 1$ sc on the 3rd 5 dc of the Flower; 5 ch , sk 6, 1 sc on the 4th 5 dc of the Flower, 7 ch , sk $8,1 \mathrm{sc}$ on the centre stem of the next Stripe; repeat to the centre stem of the 1 st Stripe. Cut off the thread.

2nd - Commence on the 1 sc worked at the beginning of the 1st row, 10 ch and work a Leaf the same as the Leaf in the 2nd side of the stripe: when finished work 3 sc on the 1st row, *, and for the Flower, 15 ch , and work a Flower the same as the 2nd Flower in the 1st side of the Stripe: when finished work 9 sc on the 1st row; join it to the last 5 dc of the Flower; then 5 sc on the 1st row, and for the 2nd LEAF 10 ch , and work as the Leaf on the 1 st side of the stripe: when finished work 9 sc on the 1 st row, join it to the 7 th tr st of the 3rd division of the Leaf, then 5 sc on the 1 st row: repeat from *, but end with 1 sc instead of 5 on the 1st row; then 15 ch , and work a Flower the same, joining the last division to the third tr st of the Leaf at the side before finishing it. Fasten off.

## Border for the Bottom

1st - Commence by working 1 sc on the end of the centre stem of the 1st Stripe; 5 ch, sk $6,1 \mathrm{sc}$ on the 1 st dc st of the calyx of the 1 st Flower, $7 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 9,1 \mathrm{sc}$ on the centre of the 1 st 5 dc of the Flower, $5 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the side of the 3rd row of the edging, $13 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the side of the 3rd row of the other side of the edging, $7 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ on the centre of the 3rd division of the Leaf, 5 ch , sk 5 , 1 sc on the same division of the Leaf, 7 ch , sk $7,1 \mathrm{sc}$ on the centre stem; repeat to the centre stem of the last Stripe. Cut off the thread.

2nd - Commence on the 1 sc worked at the beginning of the 1 st row; then 15 ch , and work a Flower the same as the 2nd Flower in the 1st side of the Stripe, joining it to the centre of the 3rd division of the Leaf at the side: when finished, work 3 sc on the 1st row, and for the Leaf, 10 ch , and work a Leaf the same as in the 1st side of the Stripe, joining it to the centre of the last 5 dc of the Flower, *; when finished, work 9 sc on the 1st row, join to the 7th tr st of the 3rd division of the Leaf; then 5 sc on the 1st row; and for the Flower, 15 ch: work as the 2nd Flower in the 1st side of the Stripe; when finished work 9 sc on the 1st row, join it to the centre of the last 5 dc of the Flower, then 5 sc on the 1st row; and for the next Leaf, 10 ch ; and work the Leaf in the 1st side of the Stripe; repeat from *, but before working the last Leaf, work 2 sc ) instead of 5 on the 1st row, and in working the Leaf, join the centre of the last division to the 1 st 5 dc of the Flower at the side. Fasten off.

## ANTI-MACASSAR, OR TOILET COVER



Ch 415 sts for $3 / 4$ of a yard, or 23 sts for each pattern: the thread is cut off at the end of each row.

1st row $-1 \mathrm{dc},{ }^{*}, 5 \mathrm{ch}$, sk $5,4 \mathrm{dc}, 4 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 4,4 \mathrm{dc}, 5 \mathrm{ch}$, sk $5,1 \mathrm{dc}$ : repeat from * to the end.

2nd - 4 dc, *, 3 ch, sk 3, 2 dc, 2 ch, sk 2, 2 dc, 2 ch, sk 2, 2 dc, 3 ch, sk 3,7 dc: repeat from * and end with 4 dc instead of 7 dc .

3rd - 1 dc, *, 2 ch, sk 2, 3 dc, 4 ch, sk 4 , 4 dc, 4 ch, sk 4,3 dc, 2 ch, sk 2, 1 dc: repeat from *.

4th - 2 dc, *, 2 ch, sk 2, 4 dc, 3 ch, sk 3, 2 dc, 3 ch, sk 3, 4 dc, 2 ch, sk 2, 3 dc: repeat from *, end with 2 dc instead of 3 dc .

5th - 3 dc, *, 2 ch, sk 2, 4 dc, 6 ch, sk 6, 4 dc, 2 ch, sk 2, 5 dc: repeat from *, end with 3 dc instead of 5 dc .

6th - Same as the 4th row.
7th - Same as the 3rd row.
8th - same as the 2nd row: this finished one pattern.
Repeat, and work 24 patterns for the Anti-macassar, or one yard; and to make the last pattern perfect, repeat as the 1st row, and without cutting off the thread commence -

## The Edging

1st round - Work ansc row down the side, working 3 sts on the side of every dc st; then work along the foundation ch, thus - ( 2 sc in 1 st , and 22 sc : repeat to the other corner), and work a sc row up the other side, working 3 sts to every dc st as before; and along the last side, work 2 sts in one and 22 sc.

Repeat.
2nd - To form the corner- $1 \mathrm{ch}, 5 \mathrm{tr}$ in $1 \mathrm{st}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{~s} \mid \mathrm{st},{ }^{*}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 2,5 \mathrm{tr}$ in $1 \mathrm{st}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk}$ $2,1 \mathrm{~s} \mid \mathrm{st}$; repeat from * down the 1 st side, then work the comer, and repeat as before along the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th sides, working the corner at the beginning of each side: at the end, work 3 s st on the 1 st 3 sts of the round.

3rd - For the corner - ( 9 ch , turn, 1 sl st in the 1st st of the 9 ch to form a round loop, 5 times), sk $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ on the $5 \mathrm{tr}, 5 \mathrm{ch}$, sk $6,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the centre of the $5 \mathrm{tr},{ }^{*}, 5 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 7,1 \mathrm{sc}$, ( 9 ch , turn, 1 sl st in the 1st st of the 9 ch to form a round loop, 5 times), sk $7,1 \mathrm{sc}, 5 \mathrm{ch}$, sk 7, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 5 \mathrm{ch}$, sk $7,1 \mathrm{sc}$; repeat from * down the side, then work the corner. Repeat as before along the other sides, working the corners at the end of each side; at the end, turn back and work 3 sl st on the last 5 ch , tum back.

4th - For the corner - ( 9 ch , turn, 1 sl st in the 2nd st of the 9 ch to form a round loop; 1 ch, sk $9,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the round loop of the last round; repeat 5 times), $9 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{sl}$ st in the 2nd st as before, 1 ch , sk $9,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the $5 \mathrm{ch},{ }^{*}, 3 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 5,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the $5 \mathrm{ch},(9 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{turn}, 1 \mathrm{sl} \mathrm{st}$ in the 2 nd st as before, $1 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 9,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the round loop of the last round, 5 times), 9 ch, turn, 1 sl st in the 2 nd st as before, $1 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 9,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the $5 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{ch}, \mathrm{sk} 5,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the 5 ch ; repeat from * along the sides, working the corners as before.

5th - For the corner - (sk 3, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc ; these 7 sts in the round loop of last round, 6 times), *, sk 3, 1 sc in the 3 ch , (sk 3, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 5 \mathrm{dc}$ and 1 sc in the round loop, 6 times), sk 3, 1 sc in the 3 ch ; repeat from * along the sides, working the corners as before. Fasten off.

## To Work the Anti-Macassar in Colours

The Diamond or Star Pattern can be worked in two colours that contrast well, by making the Star with one colour, and the Diamonds with another.

The Flower Pattern Work Stripes of Flowers and Leaves in Pink, and the Insertion White or Drab, or in any two colours that contrast.
