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
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

# Crochet Book No. 6

**G**OING back to the Sixteenth Century we find the art of lace making at its height, and just about this time deft hands began to imitate the rich old laces in a crude way by means of crocheting. As time went on this method was greatly improved, and today it is possible to produce exquisite specimens of the rarest designs with just a simple little hook and a high grade crochet cotton.

Throughout this book will be found many delightful examples of Filet, Venise and Irish crochet with careful, concise instructions, but it must always be remembered that before beginning any piece of lace or crochet it is essential to have the proper working materials. The thread you use has as much, if not more influence than your skill in effecting satisfactory results. A piece of lace, for instance, is almost useless if it loses its shape or has that stiff, hard finish characteristic of laces made from inferior materials.

That Cordichet is so popular among needleworkers is due to its perfect manufacture. It is a six-cord, hard twisted crochet cotton of unusual smoothness, great strength and lustre. **CROCHET STITCHES** 

### CHAIN STITCH

1—Catch thread with needle, forming a loop. Pull the thread with the needle through this loop to form the first stitch. Continue chain to any desired length.

#### SLIP STITCH

2—Make row of chain stitches. Insert needle in last chain and pull thread through. Pull loop thus made through first loop.

### SINGLE CROCHET

3—Make row of chain stitches. Insert needle in last chain and pull thread through, thus having two loops on needle. Wind thread once over needle and pull through the two loops.

### HALF DOUBLE CROCHET

4—Wind thread once around needle, insert into chain and pull loop through. Wind thread around needle again and pull through three loops at once.

#### DOUBLE CROCHET

5—Wind thread once around needle. Insert needle into chain and pull through; this leaves three loops on needle. Wind thread once around needle and pull through two. Wind thread again over needle and pull through two.

#### **TREBLE CROCHET**

6—Make same way as Double Crochet, only at first wind thread twice over needle and pull thread through three times—two and two,

#### DOUBLE TREBLE CROCHET

7—Make same way as Double Crochet, only at first wind thread three times over needle and pull thread through four times—two and two and two.

### DOUBLE TRIPLE TREBLE CROCHET

8—Make same way as Double Crochet, only at first wind thread four times over needle and pull thread through five times—two and two and two and two.

#### PICOT

**9**—Make a chain. Skip three chains and make a Single Crochet. Chain four, catch back into first chain. Wind thread once around needle and pull through both loops. Make three or four Single Crochet stitches or enough to make desired distance between picots and repeat.

#### MESH

10-Used in filet crochet work. Chain two stitches, skip two stitches, one double crochet into next stitch.


### SHELL


11-Five double crochet in one stitch form a shell.



#### To Make Box.

To Make Box. After the crochet has been completed the box is made by mounting the crochet over a foundation of cardboard and is held in place by draw strings. For the foundation join the two strips of cardboard end to end, overlapping one-half inch. This is made easy by boring four small holes in each lap with some sharp pointed instrument and fastening with the pins. Slip the cardboard ring inside the crochet and draw up draw string securely around the top. Then slip a circle of cardboard inside to form the bottom. Stretch the crochet cover over the other circle and tie with drawstring on underside. Attach now to center of cover by a stitch through the cardboard. the cardboard. ROYAL SOCIETY CORDICHET, size 10, No. 3040, 4 balls, crochet hook, size 8.

#### Explanation.

**Open Mesh.**—1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c. into next st. **Closed Mesh.**—1 d.c. into d.c., 2 d.c. into 2 chs., 1 d.c. into next d.c. For founda-tion chain make 3 times as many chains as meshes and add 1 ch. Always make ch. 5, to turn, at top of d.c. take up both loops, and over open loop, if closed loop is indicated, work into chains, not around.

#### Bottom of Box.

Start with bottom of box by following black and white drawing for cover, omitting the design and making all open mesh, then work around 3 s.c. into 3 sts. of each hole, and 4 s.c. into 4 sts. of corner holes. This gives 300 d.c. all around. Join with sl.st.

#### Side of Box.

1 row of 1 s.c. into each back rib, join, ch. 3, 1 row of 1 d.c. into each st., join, Ch. 5, sk. 2, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., continue around, and join to 3rd ch. at beginning of row. This gives 100 ms. and is the first row of the Filet band, con-tinue working around by following black and white drawing. I row of 1 d.c. into each st., join, 1 row of 1 s.c. into each st., join. 1 row of 1 d.c. into each st., taking up back rib, finish off. Make 1 row of sl.sts. into front rib between last 2 rows made, finish off.

1 row of s.c. into front rib at beginning of side. Pull thread through every other st. of last row at top of box for drawstring.

#### Cover.

For cover follow black and white drawing, then work all around 3 d.c. into 3 sts. of each hole, jcin, 1 row of 1 s.c. into each st., join. 1 row of 1 d.c. into each st., taking up back rib, join, ch. 5, sk. 4, 1 s.c., ch. 5, sk. 4, 1 s.c., continue all around. Into front rib before last row of d.c. 1 sc.st. inte each st. Through last row of loops, pull a thread for drawstring.

#### Knob.

Ch. 5, join to ring, ch. 3, 15 d.c. into ring, join with sl.st., ch. 3, 2 d.c. into each st., join, 1 row of 1 d.c. into each st. Put wooden mould inside and decrease by finishing always 3 d.c. together.

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#### ROYAL SOCIETY White CORDICHET, Size 30, 7 Balls.

Front.

1st row.—Ch. 170, sk. 7, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., continue until 15 m. are made, 4 d.c., 19 m., 4 d.c., 19 m., turn.

**2nd row.**—Ch. 5, 9 m., 1 bean st. into next hole (cotton over needle, pull through next m., repeat this 4 times more, pull through all loops on needle, ch. 1, 1 d.c. into next sp.), 8 m., 4 d.c., 1 m., 4 d.c., 8 m., 1 bean st., 8 m., 4 d.c., 1 m., 4 d.c., 8 m., 1 bean st., 5 m., turn.

**3rd row.**—Ch. 5, 4 m., \* 1 bean st., 1 m., 1 bean st., 6 m., 4 d.c., ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into next m., ch. 5, sk. 3, 4 d.c., 6 m. Repeat from \* to end of row, turn.

**4th row.**—Ch. 5, 7 m., \* 1 bean st., 1 m., 1 bean st., 1 m., 1 bean st., 4 m., 4 d.c., ch. 5, 1 s.c. into st. before tr.c. of previous row, 2 s.c. into 2 following sts., ch. 5, 4 d.c. into sts. of following m., 4 m., repeat from \* to end of row, turn.

**5th row.**—Ch. 5, 2 m., \* 4 bean sts., with always 1 m. between, 2 m., 4 d.c., ch. 6, 1 s.c. into st. before s.c. of previous row, 4 s.c. into following sts., ch. 6, 4 d.c. into sts. of following m., 2 m., repeat from \* to end of row, turn.

6th row.—Ch. 5, 7 m., \* 3 bean sts. with always 1 m. between, 2 m., 4 d.c., 1 m., 3 d.c. into next hole, ch. 6, sk. 1 s.c., ch. 6, 3 d.c. into hole, 1 d.c. into next sp., 1 m., 4 d.c., 2 m., repeat from \*to end of row, turn.

7th row.—Ch. 5, 4 m., \* 1 bean st., 1 m., 1 bean st., 2 m., 4 d.c., ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into next m., ch. 5, sk. 3 d.c., 1 d.c. into last st., 3 d.c. into hole, ch. 5, sk. 1 s.e., 1 tr.c., ch. 5, 3 d.c. into hole, 1 d.c. into next sp., ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into next m., ch. 5, sk. 3, 4 d.c., 2 m., repeat from \*. After last bean st., finish row with 8 m., turn.

**Sth row.**—Ch. 5, 9 m., \* 1 bean st., 2 m., 4 d.c., ch. 5, 1 s.c. into st. before tr.c., 2 s.c. into 2 following sts., ch. 5, 1 d.c. into last of 4 following d.c., 3 d.c. into hole, ch. 2, 3 d.c. into next hole, 1 d.c. into next st., ch. 5, 1 s.c. into st. before tr.c., 2 s.c. into 2 following sts., ch. 5, sk. 3 d.c., 4 d.c., 2 m., repeat from \*. After last bean st., finish rew with 5 m., turn.

**9th row.**—Ch. 5, 7 m., \* 4 d.c., ch. 6, 1 s.c. into st. before s.c., 4 s.c. into following sts., ch. 6, sk. 3 d.c., 4 d.c., ch. 6, 5 s.c., ch. 6, sk. 3 d.c., 4 d.c., 3 m., repeat from \*. Finish row with 11 m., turn.

**10th row.**—Ch. 5, 9 m., 1 bean st., \* 2 m., 3 d.c. into hole, ch. 6, 3 s.c., ch. 6, 3 d.c. into hole, 1 d.c. into next sp., 1 m., sk. 2, 1 d.c., 3 d.c. into hole, ch. 6, 3 s.c., ch. 6, 3 d.c. into hole, 1 d.c. into next sp., 2 m., 1 bean st., repeat from \*. Finish row with 5 m., turn.

**11th row.**—Ch. 5, 4 m., 1 bean st., 1 m., 1 bean st. \*, 2 m., 4 d.c., ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into 2nd s.c., ch. 5, 4 d.c., ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into next m., ch. 5, 3 d.c. into hole, 1 d.c. into next st., 2 m., 1 bean st., 1 m., 1 bean st., repeat from \*. Finish row with 8 m., turn.

12th row.—Ch. 5, 7 m., 3 bean sts. always with 1 m. between, \* 2 m., 3 d.c. into hole, 1 m., 3 d.c. into next hole, 1 d.c. into next st., ch. 5, 3 s.c., ch. 5, sk. 3 d.c., 1 d.c., 3 d.c. into hole, ch. 2, 3 d.c. into next hole, 1 d.c. into next st., 2 m., 3 bean sts. always with 1 m. between, repeat from \*, finish row with 3 m., turn.

13th row.—Ch. 5, 2 m., \* 4 bean sts. with 1 m., between each, 3 m., 4 d.c., ch. 6. 5 s.c. on top of 3 s.c., ch. 6, 4 d.c. on top of next m., 3 m., repeat from \*, After last bean st., finish row with 6 m., turn.

14th row.—Ch. 5, 7 m., \* 3 bean sts. with 1 m. between each, 4 m., 4 d.c., ch. 6, 3 s.c. into center sts. of 5 s.c., ch. 6, 3 d.c. into hole, 1 d.c. into next st., 4 m., repeat from \* across. Finish row with 3 m., turn.

15th row.—Ch. 5, 4 m., \* 1 bean st., 1 m., 1 bean st., 6 m., 3 d.c. into hole, ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into center s.c., ch. 5, 3 d.c. into hole, 1 d.c. into next st., 6 m., repeat from \*. Finish row with 8 m., turn.

16th row.—Ch. 5, 9 m., \* 1 bean st., 8 m., 3 d.c. into hole, ch. 2, 3 d.c. into next hole, 1 d.c. into next st., 8 m., repeat from \*. Finish row with 5 m., turn. Repeat from beginning of instructions twice, this finishes front.

#### Under-Arm

After 16th row of front is repeated the 3rd time, turn.

**1st row.**—Ch. 5, 15 m., 4 d.c., 19 m., 4 d.c., 19 m., turn. **2nd row.**—Ch. 5, 9 m., 1 bean st., 8 m., 4 d.c., 1 m., 4 d.c., 8 m., 1 bean st., 8 m., 4 d.c., 1 m., 4 d.c., 8 m., 1 bean st., 3 m., turn.

**3rd row.**—Ch. 5, 2 m., 1 bean st., 3 m., turn. **3rd row.**—Ch. 5, 2 m., 1 bean st., 1 m., 1 bean st., \* 6 m., 4 d.c., ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into next m., sk. 4 d.c., 4 d.c., 6 m., 1 bean st., 1 m., 1 bean st., repeat from \*. Description of Filet.

Open Mesh.-1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c. into next st.

**Closed Mesh.**—1 d.c. into d.c. taking up both loops, 2 d.c. into chs. not around chs., 1 d.c. into next d.c.

For foundation chs. make three times as many chs. as m. Always make 5 chs. to turn.

For Filet parts follow black and white drawings. Around big center Medallion work 3 s.c. into one, 2 s.c. into the next m., 7 s.c. into the corners. Make one other row of 5 s.c., 1 p., 5 s.c. all around.

Around side panels, work 1 row of 5 s.c., 1 p., 5 s.c. At side which is to be joined to center Medallion, begin after 9th row from top of band. Catch into corner p. of center Medallion instead of making a p. At side band, 5 s.c. joined to next p. and continue.

Around pointed edge work 3 s.c. into each m., 9 s.c. into m. at point. (Make one other row of 3 s.c., one p., 3 s.c., the edge must have 5 points. At straight side of edge make one row of one d.c. into each st. Make one row of s.c. After every 5th s.c. catch into p. of center Medallion to join.

Sew a tassel at each point and one tassel between points.

At each point of side panel fasten a longer tassel.

#### Tassel.

Wind the cotton 80 times around cardboard one and three-quarter inches long, tie in center, tie again one-half inch from top and sew on.







ROYAL SOCIETY Ecru CORDICHET, size 20, 9 balls. Crochet hook size 11. For oval center follow black and white drawing. Work 3 s.c. into each m. all around. Make one other row of 5 s.c., one p., 5 s.c.

For pointed edge follow black and white drawing long enough to go around stamped line on pillow, then work around points 2 s.c., 1 p., 2 s.c. into each m. At straight edge of same one row of d.c. around, one row of m., and 2 rows of d.c. To finish make one row of 5 s.c., 1 p., 5 s.c.

#### To Finish Table Cover.

sew a piece of edging across each short side. Place the crochet medallions about two inches above edging and in the center of short sides and stitch firmly before cutting away material underneath.

ROYAL SOCIETY Tan CORDICHET, No. 3040, size 30, crochet hook size 11. For four Filet medallions follow black and white drawing.



Repeat from \* for 12 scallops in all.

This yoke is made of filet crochet, the design of which is clearly shown in black and white. Around the neck is a beading of ribbon and on outside edge of yoke a finish of picots. The sleeves have a tassel on the end of the point and edging to finish. Small straps of filet are used to run ribbon through, forming an empire waist line. Use ROYAL SOCIETY CORDICHET, Size 30-4 balls; 3015 Pink, 3010 Blue,

3000 Lavender.

Open Mesh.-1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c. into next st.

**Closed Mesh.**—1 d.c. into d.c., 2 d.c. into 2 chs., 1 d.c. into next d.c. For foun-dation chain make 3 times as many chains as meshes and add 1 ch. Always ch. 5 to turn. At top of d.c. take up both loops, and over open loop, if closed loop is indicated, work into chains, not around.

**Filet for Yoke**—Start at bottom of front, below the large rose, ch. 74, sk. 7, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., 21 more m., turn, ch. 5, 12 m., 7 d.c., 9 m., turn, ch. 5, These are the first 2 rows. Now follow diagram until first corner is reached, ch. 43, sk. 7, 1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c., continue for 13 more m.; the last d.c. is to be on top of last d.c. of previous row. Continue across center, following diagram. To top of last d.c. of previous row. Continue for 15 hole in, the last d.c. is 06 of increase for other side turn, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into same st, as last d.c., turn, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into 3rd ch. of last ch. 5; continue across, following diagram until 10 rows from last corner are made. 



**Closed Mesh.**—1 d.c. into d.c. taking up both loops, 2 d.c. into chains, not around chs., 1 d.c. into next d.c. For foundation chs. make 3 times as many chains as m. Always make 5 ch. to turn.







Side Petals. These are made the same as on large rose, but start with 7 s.c., which gives only 4 Bullion sts., and have 1 row of Bullion sts. less than on large rose. For scallops, have only 3 s.c., 3 h.d.c., 3 d.c. into loops, finish and join the same as on large rose.

Center Petal. Start as on large rose, but having between side petal and large petal only Bullion st., omit second row, and make 2 rows of 5 Bullion sts. instead of Bullion ste 7 Bullion sts.

7 Bullion sts. For 3 scallops, ch. 9, 1 s.c. on top of second Bullion st., ch. 6, 1 Bullion st. on top of next, finish row, reversing, turn, 3 s.c., 3 h.d.c., 3 d.c., 3 tr.e., 3 d.c., 3 h.d.c., 3 s.c. into first loop, 3 s.c., 3 h.d.c., 3 d.e. into next, 1 tr.c. into Bullion st., finish row, reversing, and finish petal as on large rose. **5th row.**—Into each loop, 1 s.c., 1 h.d.c., 8 d.c., 1 h.d.c., 1 s.c., join with sl.st. **6th row.**—1 s.c. around s.c. of 4th row, ch. 7, repeat 4 times more, join with sl.st. **7th row.**—Into each loop, 1 s.c., 1 h.d.c., 12 d.c., 1 h.d.c., 1 s.c., join with sl.st.

8th row.—Into each loop, I s.c., I h.dc., Is dc., I h.dc., I s.c., join with sl.st. 9th row.—Into each loop, 1 s.c., 1 h.dc., 15 dc., 1 h.dc., 1 s.c., join with sl.st. 9th row.—Into each loop, 1 s.c., 1 h.dc., 15 dc., 1 h.dc., 1 s.c., join with sl.st. 10th row.—3 sl.sts. into 3 following sts. of scallop, ch. 9, sk. 2, 1 s.c., repeat this 4 times more into same scallop, ch. 9, sk. 3, of next scallop, 1 s.c., ch. 9, sk. 2,

Pull cotton through every other back rib of last row made, stretch over card-board and fasten draw string on back. The last row of d.c. is to serve as turnover

Make 3 more rounds this way, join them at front rib between last two rows of d.c. with 20 sl.sts. To join next 2 rounds, leave 56 sts. for top of shade, then make 20 sl.sts., working downwards.

### Tassel.

Trim bottom of shade with small tassels. Wind cotton 50 times around cardboard 1¼ inches long, cut off, tie in center, work with same thread, ch. 1, 1 s.c., ch. 1, and repeat until 8 s.c. are made, tie again ¼ of an inch from top. Attach this tassel in between rounds to joining. Make one other tassel the same way, with only 6 s.c. for string, sk. 17 sts. from joining and attach. 1 tassel with 4 s.c. for string, sk. 15 sts. from last tassel and attach. One tassel with 2 s.c. for string, sk. 15 sts. and attach. This last tassel must be in the center of bottom of round. Finish other side of round the same way re-versing, and continue all around shade.

## No. 489-WORK BASKET

The basket is made by mounting the crochet over a cardboard foundation and is held in place by draw strings.

This basket may be used on the table for bread, cakes or rolls as it is very easily laundered by simply loosening the draw strings and removing the cardboards. It may also be used in the boudoir as a work basket by substituting colored card-boards to carry out the color scheme of the room. ROYAL SOCIETY White CORDICHET, size 30, 2 balls, Crochet hook size 11.

#### Center of Basket.

1st row.-Ch. 6, join to ring, ch. 3, 15 d.c. into ring, join with sl.st.,

**2nd row.**—Ch. 5, 1 d.c. into next, ch. 9, 1 d.c. into next, continue around, at end of row, join to 3rd ch. from beginning (this row has 15 holes).

**3rd row.**—1 s.c. into first hole, ch. 10, 1 tr.c. into same, 1 tr.c. into neg ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into same, continue all around. Join to 5th ch. from beginning. 1 tr.c. into next hole.

#### Explanation for Filet.

Open Mesh.—1 d.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 d.c. into next st. Closed Mesh.—1 d.c. into d.c., 2 d.c. into 2 chs., 1 d.c. into next d.c. For foun-dation chain make 3 times as many chains as meshes and add 1 ch. Always make ch. 5 to turn. At top of d.c. take up both loops, and over open loop. If closed loop is indicated, work with chains, not around. Follow black and white drawing for Filet ends, starting at one side and working up and down.

#### Tassels.

Wind cotton 100 times around cardboard 5 inches long. Cut and tie in center. With same thread make 2 ch., 1 s.c. into first ch., ch. 1, 1 s.c. into s.c., repeat twice more. Tie again one-half inch from top. Attach a tassel to each point on bottom of crochet.

11th row.—Ch. 4, sk. 1, 1 d.c., ch. 1, sk. 1, 1 d.c., continue to corner. For corner, ch. 3, 1 d.c. into same, continue ch. 1, sk. 1, 1 d.c. Join to 3rd ch. from beginning of row.

12th row .- 1 d.c. into each st., 5 d.c. into corner st.

13th row.—Taking up back rib, 1 d.c. into each st. At corners finish 5 d.c. together. Join with sl.st.

14th row.—Ch. 5, sk. 5, 1 s.c., ch. 5, sk. 5, 1 s.c. Continue all around, finish off. Pull thread through last row of loops for draw string.

#### Side of Basket.

Ch. 44, sk. 3, 1 d.c., ch. 5, sk. 3, 1 d.c., continue for 9 more holes, turn \* ch. 8, 1 d.c. into first hole, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into next hole, continue across, turn, repeat from \* once, turn, \* ch. 9, 1 d.c. into first hole, ch. 6, 1 d.c. into next hole, continue across, turn, repeat from \* twice, (6 rows of holes in all).

Work down the side, ch. 4, sk. 1, 1 d.c., ch. 1, sk. 1, 1 d.c., continue for 12 spaces, for corner ch. 3, 1 d.c. into same. Ch. 1, sk. 1, 1 d.c., continue across bottom, at corner, ch. 3, 1 d.c. into same. Repeat up the side for 13 spaces at corner of top, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into same, ch. 1, sk. 1, 1 d.c. across top, at corner ch. 5, 1 d.c. into same, ch. 1, join with sl.st. to 3rd cl. from beginning of row.

Ch. 4, 1 d.c. into first sp., ch. 1, sk. 1, 1 d.c. into next sp. Continue around the same as previous row, but at corners of top into the ch. 5, ch. 1, sk. 1, 1 d.c., ch. 1, 1 d.c. into next, ch. 3, 1 d.c. into same, ch. 1, 1 d.c. into next, ch. 1, 1 d.c. into following sp. At end of row, join with sl.st., ch. 3, 1 d.c. into each st., 5 d.c. into corner sts.

Make one other row of 1 d.c. into each st., taking up back rib, at corners, finish 5 d.c. together. Join with sl.st.

Ch. 4, sk. 1, 1 d.c., ch. 1, sk. 1, 1 d.c., continue all around. At corners, ch. 1, 1 d.c., pull thread once through 2 loops, sk. 1, 1 d.c., pull thread once through 2 loops, sk. 1, 1 d.c. Finish all 3 together. Finish off.

With sewing needle pull a thread through last row of spaces for draw string. Make 4 more sides the same way. Crochet them together, having turnover to hold cardboard in place at outside of basket on which side they are joined with s.c., taking up front rib between two rows of d.c.

Then join the 5 sides to the bottom the same way.

Stretch crochet over cardboards, draw up strings and tie securely.

Trim each of the 5 upper corners with a small medallion and tassel.

Ch. 5, join to ring, ch. 3, 3 d.c., ch. 2, 2 d.c. into ring, turn, ch. 3, 3 d.c., ch. 2, 2 d.c. into space, turn, ch. 3, and continue until  $4\frac{1}{2}$  inches long, sew to basket in between two scallops on opposite sides.

3rd row-Work around, 1 s.c. into each st., 3 s.c. into corner sts., 4 sl. sts. into next sts

4th row—3 s.c. into 3 corner sts., ch. 7, 1 tr.c. into center at side, 3 s.c. into 3 corner sts., repeat around. Join to first st. of row.

5th row-3 s.c. into sts., \* 8 s.c. into hole, 3 s.c. into sp., 8 s.c. into next hole, 3 s.c. into sts. Repeat from \* 3 times, join with sl. st.

6th row-2 s.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 2 s.c., continue around. At corners, 2 s.c., ch. 2, 2 s.c. into following sts., join with sl. st.

7th row—1 s.c. into each st., 2 s.c. into space, 3 s.c. into corner spaces. Join with sl. st.

**8th row**—Ch. 7, sk. 3, 1 tr.c., ch. 3, sk. 3, 1 tr.c. continue around. For hole before and after corner, sk, only 2 sts, 1 tr.c. into corner st., ch. 5, 1 tr.c. into same. Join to 3rd ch. at beginning.

9th row-4 s.c. into each hole, 7 s.c. into corner holes, join with sl. st.

10th row-2 s.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 2 s.c., ch. 2, continue around, 3 s.c. into corner sts. 11th row-1 s.c. into each st., 2 s.c. into each space, 3 s.c. into corner st. 12th row-5 s.c., 1 p., 5 s.c., all around.

#### Triangle.

**Triangle.** Ch. 50, turn, sk. 1, 42 s.c., turn, 29 s.c., turn, ch. 3, sk. 7, 1 d. tr.c., ch. 3, 1 d. tr.c.; ch. 3, 1 d. tr.c., ch. 3, 1 d. tr.c., all into next st., ch. 3, sk. 7, 1 s.c., turn, 4 s.c. into first hole, turn, \* four more rows of 4 s.c., 4 sl. sts. down the side, 4 s.c. into next hole, 4 s.c. into following hole, turn, and repeat from \* twice, 6 s.c. into following sts., turn, \* ch. 6, 4 s.c. into top of solid square, repeat from \* twice, ch. 6, sk. 5, 1 s.c., turn, 6 s.c. into first hole, 4 s.c. into sts., 6 s.c. into next hole, repeat across, 1 s.c. into next st., turn, ch. 5, sk. 4, 1 s.c., th. 5, and repeat for 8 loops in all, 1 s.c. into next st., turn, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into center of 1st loop, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into center of 2nd loop, ch. 5, 1 s.c. into center of 3rd loop, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into center of next loop, ch. 5, 1 d. tr.c., into st. between 2 loops, ch. 5, 1 d. tr.c. into same, ch. 5, 1 d.c. into center of next loop, repeat this side the same as other side, 1 s.c. into last st., turn. 6 s.c. into each of 5 lolowing loops, 7 s.c. into 2 first sts., ch. 2, sk. 2, 2 s.c. continue to center st., ch. 2, 1 s.c. into same, 1 s.c. into next, repeat at other side, turn, ch. 3, sk. 2, 2 s.c. into space of ch. 2, ch. 2, sk. 2, and repeat into center space, 3 s.c., repeat at other side. After last ch. 2, work around triangle, 1 d.c. into last st. of previous row, 2 tr.c. into 2 rows of beginning, ch. 6, 1 s.c. into each st. at other side of foundation ch., 1 s.c. into each stich, continue first row, 1 d.c. into next, 2 s.c. into first space, 1 s.c. into each stich, continue st. at other side of foundation ch., 1 s.c. into each sp., 6 s.c. into 6 chs., join with st. st.

sl. st. 1 row of 5 s.c., 1 p., 5 s.c. all around having 1 p. at each of 3 points. Make three more triangles.

#### Border With Fringes.

Ch. 75, sk. 5, 2 s.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 2 s.c., continue across, turn, ch. 3, sk. 2, 2 s.c. into 1st space, ch. 2, sk. 2, and continue across, turn, 1 s.c. into each st., 2 s.c. into each space, turn, 5 s.c., 1 p., 5 s.c. continue across. At other side of foundation ch., 1 s.c. into each st., 2 s.c. into each space, turn, 1 s.c. into first st., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 s.c., ch. 2, sk. 2, 1 s.c. continue across.

#### Fringes.

Size 1 CORDICHET, cut 2 threads each 22 inches long, fold in center, pull through small loop of last row from top to bottom, make ch., pull out. Repeat into each small loop.

#### Knotting.

Take strands of 2 first loops, make a buttonhole stitch with right hand strands, then repeat with left hand strands, continue alternating until solid bar is 2 inches long. When all the strands are knotted, take half of first and half of 3rd knotted bar, and work solomon knot over strands in between.

#### Solomon Knot.

Solomon Knot. Hold the center strand down straight between 2nd and 3rd fingers of left haud, bring left hand strand around over the middle strand, take right hand strand, bring it down over the left hand strand, across back of the middle one, up through the loop on left hand side. Repeat, starting with the right hand strand, bring the left hand strand up through the loop on the right hand side, holding the center one firmly, pull the two side strands to form a firm knot. Repeat with every three knotted bars, then tie inside strand of first solomon knot to next strand of following, and make a small tassel over each knot. Wind cotton 25 times over cardboard 5 inches long, put over knot and tie 1/2 inches

For Border going around point at end of scarf, follow instructions as for Border with fringes but instead of having one side with loops make 1 row of 5 s.c., 1 p., 5 s.c. Make Border long enough to go from fringe to fringe on stamped lines around point of linen.

#### Tassel.

Wind size 1 CORDICHET 75 times around cardboard 6 inches long, tie in er, tie again % of an inch from top and sew to point. Place crocheted pieces on stamped lines, cut linen away underneath. center,

They are highly mercerized, have a smooth, even finish, and time, wear or exposure will in no way affect their brilliant lustre. There is a size and twist for every use as described below and on the following page.

**Rope and India**—Soft, loose, highly mercerized twists in White and full lines of fast colors. India, being finer than Rope, is suitable for the finer embroidery stitches on linens, dresses, blouses, etc. Rope gives beautiful results on heavier materials, scarfs, cushions, centers, etc.

**Strand Floss**—Several strands loosely twisted together. Made in White and a complete line of fast colors. May be split or used in entire thread for a great variety of uses. Excellent for darning, loop and similar stitches.

Strand Floss Special—(can be split) is composed of six strands loosely twisted and can be divided or used in the full thread. It is suitable for darning, couching and almost all white work. Made in White only and put up in long skeins with blue labels.

**Coarse, Medium and Fine**—Soft, loose, highly mercerized twists. Used for buttonholing, eyeletting and all branches of French embroidery.

**A**, **B**, **C**, **D**, **E**—Hard twisted, highly lustrous threads, employed for fine or heavy scalloping, monograming and White needlework generally.






